

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## Malaysia's economy further improving in Q2 - Statistics Dept

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DoSM) chief statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Malaysia's economy is expected to further improve in Q2 2021 especially on the back of a low base as the economy contracted 17.1 per cent in the second quarter of 2020, based on the performance of several key economic indicators. However, the recovery is also highly dependent on the extent to which the infection of Covid-19 could be brought under control and the consequence of movement control order (MCO) 3.0 with tightened standard operating procedures for the economic sectors and social aspects. Further to this, the leading index (LI) for March 2021 achieved strong growth at 17.3 per cent, mainly due to the low base effect of March 2020 following a nationwide lockdown and the better performance of LI components. Taken together, the LI performance and the current state of Covid-19 outbreak, it seems that the near term economic prospect is encouraging but prevailing challenges persist. The utmost commitment in easing the current pandemic situation is vital so as to regain the economic momentum in the upcoming months. Malaysia's economic situation, gross domestic product (GDP) declined marginally by 0.5 per cent in Q1 21, continuing its recovery from a contraction of 3.4 per cent in the preceding quarter. The improvement was supported by the expansion in the manufacturing sector, the rebound of the agriculture sector and the better performance recorded by all economic sectors compared to the last two quarters. Malaysia's economy in this quarter gradually recovered as more economic activities were allowed to operate following MCO 2.0, less stringent than the MCO 1.0 imposed in March 2020. Various stimulus packages introduced also steered the economic recovery and cushioned the potential economic losses of this country. Adding to this, the encouraging economic environment during Q1 2021 was largely driven by the better performance of key economic indicators in March 2021. Malaysia's current account balance continued to record a surplus registering RM12.3 billion in the Q1 2021 compared to RM18.6 billion in the previous quarter, contributed by the positive momentum of the net exports of goods. Whereas foreign direct investment recorded a higher inflow of RM9.1 billion against RM6.8 billion in the preceding quarter owing to higher inflow in equity and reinvestment of earnings and lower inflow in debt instruments. Concurrently, direct investment abroad by Malaysian companies has also increased, gaining from the reopening of the global economy, posting RM7.8 billion in Q1 2021 from RM5.2 billion in the preceding quarter due to the high investment in equity abroad and retained earnings in this quarter. Meanwhile, Malaysia's trade continued to rise, with total trade recording a double-digit increase of 14.8 per cent year-on-year (y-o-y). In line with this, Malaysia's trade balance remained surplus at RM58.6 billion. In terms of the labour market, amid targeted measures to manage the Covid-19 pandemic in the country, uneven recovery momentum in the labour market was observed as the number


of employed persons decreased slightly y-o-y by 0.04 per cent to 15.24 million persons while the unemployment rate remained high above four per cent registering 4.8 per cent in the Q1 2021. From the view point of labour demand, the number of jobs in the economic sector decreased marginally as filled jobs declined while vacancies posted a small increase. Overall, the labour market remains in a challenging situation as it has not returned to the way it was during pre-Covid times.

#### Malaysia to see 6% to 7.5% GDP growth in 2021 if Covid-19 can be stabilised — Mustapa

According to Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economy) Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Malaysia can achieve its 2021 gross domestic product (GDP) growth target of between 6% and 7.5% if the Covid-19 health crisis can be stabilised after the eventual lifting of the Movement Control Order (MCO 3.0). The availability of vaccines and a comprehensive vaccination rollout for Malaysians would have a positive impact on the country's economy. If assuming that the percentage of Malaysians vaccinated goes according to schedule or can be accelerated, while the Covid-19 situation can be placed under control, then we will be able to see a positive decline in infections. And this will definitely have a positive impact on the position of the Malaysian economy. The Leading Index (IP) surged 17.3% in March 2021, much higher than an increase of 8.2% in January and 8.6% in February. The good performance was in line with the country's GDP growth of 6% in March 2021. This growth momentum would be affected if the government decided to implement full-scale movement restrictions from May 25 to June 7, 2021. Full-pledged movement restrictions will cause the unemployment rate to rise sharply, the number of poor households will increase, the performance of small and large companies will be affected, and the fiscal position will be in a more challenging condition. During an engagement with industry representatives, micro, small and medium enterprises, and hawker associations on May 22 and 23, 2021, most of them agreed with the government's decision to implement MCO 3.0.

#### Eye On The Markets

This week, on Thursday (27May), the Ringgit was 4.1390 against the USD from 4.1425 on Monday (24May). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1257 to the Sing Dollar on Thursday (27May). On Monday (24May), the FBM KLCI opened at 1563.78. As at Friday (28May) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is up 19.66 points for the week at 1583.44. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 141.59 points (+0.41%) to 34,464.64 whilst the NASDAQ shed 1.72 points (+0.01%) to 13,736.28.

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

## Risk to Economic & Earnings Growth

### Markets

The Sino-US relationship has taken a new twist since President Joe Biden took office in January. Kurt Campbell, the US coordinator for Indo-Pacific affairs on the National Security Council was quoted as saying that the US is entering into a period of intense competition with China and that the period that was broadly described as engagement has come to an end. With this, there is a strong likelihood that the US-China trade war may escalate again as both nations strive for domination and to remain competitive. Despite the consistent fear of inflationary threat, global markets remained in an upbeat mood as investors weigh in several data points that perhaps reinforced the view that the current rise in commodity prices may be transitory.

### Economy

Over in the US, the US consumer confidence came in at 117.2 for May – a figure that was not only lower than the expected 118.8 but down from 117.5 in the preceding month, while the US housing market saw several disappointing data points. New home sales dropped 5.9% in April to an annualized rate of 863,000, which was way below the forecast of 950,000. The disappointing data came about on the back of rising home prices, which are now higher by some 20% y-o-y. On rates this week, Indonesia left interest rates unchanged as the nation is still battling with the Covid-19 pandemic and in the absence of inflationary pressures.

Locally, while the government avoided a total lockdown under the tighter Movement Control Order (MCO) 3.0 effective May 25, 2021, the corresponding economic and earnings impact may be more than expected for the current 2Q period as restricted movement will probably result in lower aggregate demand. Nevertheless, the current GDP estimate of between

6-7.5% remains on the table for now on the assumption that the current Covid-19 wave can be stabilized within the MCO 3.0 period, which ends on June 7. In other economic news, Malaysia's headline inflation surged to 4.7% y-o-y for April from the preceding month's reading of 1.7% y-o-y, but core inflation remains stable at 0.7%. Meanwhile, Malaysia's international reserves position stood at US\$110.6bil as at May 12, 2021, down US\$0.2bil from the end of April position of US\$110.8bil.

### Corporate

AirAsia X made Bursa Malaysia history when it reported the largest net loss for a quarterly period by a listed issuer of RM5.67bil, mainly due to impairment of its assets, bringing its 15-month financial period net loss to RM7.01bil. Genting and Genting Malaysia too had a bad 1Q period with a net loss of RM331.8mil and RM483.6mil respectively.

On a positive note, several key index-linked stocks saw significant 1Q earnings with Petronas Chemical reporting a net profit of RM1.46bil, up 88.7% y-o-y, while Maybank's 1Q earnings rose by 16.7% y-o-y to RM2.39bil. Tenaga Nasional's 1Q earnings jumped 33.5% to RM958.7mil, while Sime Darby and IOI Corporation too reported strong earnings, as nine months net profit surged by 88.8% and 185.4% y-o-y to RM1.21bil and RM1.03bil respectively. Other stellar results were from Hong Leong Financial and Hong Leong Bank as their nine-month cumulative results rose by 27% and 12.8% to RM1.69bil and RM2.17bil respectively.

Serba Dinamik, a company with more than RM18bil in order book, announced to the Exchange that it is conducting a special independent review after the board was informed by its external auditors on some matters related to its statutory audit.

In corporate exercises this week, Pimpinan Ehsan (PEB) came to the limelight as it

finally announced the details of its plan to acquire renewable energy assets owned by reNIKOLA Holdings Sdn. Bhd. for RM373mil, via the issuance of new PEB shares at RM1.07 per share. Still, on power-related business, KPower, which is also involved in solar power and small hydro projects, plans to undertake a private placement that is expected to raise as much as RM100mil to fund. Other companies that announced plans to raise funds include KNM's private placement of up to 30% of its current share base, to raise up to RM167.9mil.

### Equity

Equity markets were buoyant this week as all markets were firmer, rising by between 0.1% to as much as 7.5% on the Philippines Stock Exchange Composite Index. The KLCI too was firmer this week, rising by 1.2% to close at 1,593.90 pts, aided by some strong quarterly results of key index-linked stocks. For yet another holiday-shortened week, the local retailers and foreigners emerged net buyers with a total inflow of RM106mil and RM81.3mil respectively, leaving the local institutions as net sellers with an outflow of RM187.3mil.

### Eye on Week Ahead

Next week, the Purchasing Managers' Index across Europe, China, Asia, and the US will be the centre of attention while trade data from Malaysia and the US too will be closely watched. Local economic data points include the banking statistics and detailed disclosure of Malaysia's international reserves for April to be released on May 31. On the corporate front, despite the extension granted by Bursa Malaysia for the release of the quarterly results period ended March 31 by a month, most corporates are expected to meet the original deadline and hence expect a slew of quarterly results over the next two market days.

## Unanswered questions loom at Cahya Mata

THE recent U-turn by the board of Cahya Mata Sarawak Bhd (CMS) that culminated in the swift return (on 6 May) of deputy group chairman Datuk Seri Mahmud Abu Bekir Taib from his 22 April leave pending an investigation into allegations of conflict of interest by the authorities has surely sparked many unanswered questions in the minds of minority shareholders. Further pitted against the fall of the company's share price, questions abound whether there has been a proper investigation by the authorities, internally by the board or by independent parties.

While Mahmud's case seems to have been cleared, the chief financial officer (CFO) of the company was suspended for allegation of possible financial mismanagement in relation to the Company's investment and operations. As such, many seasoned investors would have readily assumed that CMS is besieged with both a deep and delicate internal predicament. This is especially so considering the shares of CMS tumbled 33 sen or 16.26% to close at RM1.70 with 80.48 million shares traded on 6 May.

### What is brewing in CMS?

Recall that on 22 April, the Sarawakian conglomerate which is closely linked to the family of Sarawak Governor Tun Abdul Taib Mahmud announced that Mahmud had voluntarily taken leave of absence from all his positions in the group to facilitate a full and transparent investigation by the authorities. This follows allegations of conflict of interest made through the Group's whistleblower channel involving him and former CIO Karl Vink @ Khalid Abdullah. Apparently, the allegations were received through the Group's whistleblower channel. Upon receipt of the whistleblower complaints – and prior to reporting to the authorities – Cahya Mata said its board has acted immediately by conducting a full investigation to discharge its fiduciary duties to protect the best interest of the company and all its stakeholders. In a media statement, the company requested all stakeholders to allow the investigations to proceed and patiently await the outcome. On its part, the board said it would cooperate fully with the authorities and has requested the management to also extend its fullest cooperation. At this juncture, the action

of Mahmud is praiseworthy as he had voluntarily asked to go on leave as opposed to the company 'asking' him to go on leave. After all, leave of absence would allow the company to investigate allegations and conclude investigations on time without the fear of interference – perceived or real – by those involved in the allegations.

### Unresolved questions

Interestingly, as Mahmud went on his voluntary leave, another event was unfolding within CMS. Coming hot-on-the-heels of the conflict of interest allegation against Mahmud, the company's Board suspended its Group CFO Syed Hizam Alsagoff on 5 May with immediate effect for 30 days after receiving a formal complaint from investors on possible financial mismanagement pertaining to the investment and contract losses in the Pan Borneo Highway from 2016 to 2020. At an analysts' briefing, CMS' group managing director clarified that matters relating to its deputy group chairman and Group CFO were unrelated. In relation to Mahmud's position, the Company's Board said it was satisfied that the allegation involving Mahmud had no basis, thus he would be allowed to resume his duties. "The board of directors of CMS has passed a resolution requesting Mahmud to continue his service with the group and not to take leave of absence as announced on April 22," the company pointed out, noting that the issue was related to the award of a contract by CMS I-Systems Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of CMS, to Vienna Advantage GmbH. What is intriguing here is that the latest media statement of CMS made no mention of the role of the whistleblower or the whistleblower's allegations nor how the board or the authorities (presumably SC and Bursa Malaysia) validated the allegation levelled at Mahmud and former CIO Karl Vink @ Khalid Abdullah.

### Two intertwined issues

Back to the Group CFO's suspension, CMS said Syed Hizam's duties have been temporarily taken over by Madam Tan Mei Fung, the general manager in group finance, who has been with the company for 24 years. "Based on management's guidance, the total loss

incurred was about RM54 million which had already been recognised in the previous financial years," noted TA Securities Research analyst in a company update dated 7 May. "The management guided that no further loss is expected from this incident in the foreseeable future."

Moreover, CMS is said to be in the midst of appointing an external independent party to investigate the allegations and principally to perform internal control reviews, especially on its construction division. This would, among others, entail drawing the terms of reference (ToR) to appoint a consultant, the target of which is by mid-May 2021. "As the ToR would also include a review of the group's control system and risk mitigation measures to ensure no future recurrences, we think that the consultant's work could take a while," opined Maybank IB Research in a company update dated May 7. "Meanwhile, a potential share buyback exercise may cap its (CMS) share price near-term downside."

### A note on whistleblowing

Regarding the allegation of conflict of interest which came about through the CMS group's whistleblower channel, MSWG wishes to point out that whistleblower policies are a powerful tool to weed out wrongdoings if they operate transparently. Proper protection should be accorded to whistleblowers and they should never be victimised, for fear of non-protection and victimisation often hinders potential whistleblowers from coming to the fore to divulge wrongdoings. On this note, it may be worthwhile to encourage anonymous whistleblowing although this may pose some disadvantages like the inability to identify the whistleblower for further information. There are good people out there who want to highlight wrongdoings but do not trust the system despite the promises of non-disclosure and non-victimisation. There is also the risk that something may happen to them and/or their families if their identities are known.

Anonymous whistleblowing allows such risk-averse whistleblowers to highlight wrongdoings. Surely the probative effect of a robust anonymous whistleblowing policy clearly outweighs its prejudicial effect; the ends surely justify the means.




