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11 Malaysian firms in Forbes Asia's 200 Best Under A Billion list

According to Forbes Asia, a total of 11 Malaysian firms were recognised under their 2021 Best Under A Billion list. The list highlights the resilience of 200 public-listed small and mid-sized companies in the Asia-Pacific region with sales under US\$1bil (RM4.16bil). The Malaysian companies that made the list this year were Comfort Gloves Bhd, D&O Green Technologies Bhd, Dancomech Holdings Bhd, Dufu Technology Corp Bhd, FoundPac Group Bhd, Frontken Corp Bhd, Revenue Group Bhd, Scientex Bhd, Thong Guan Industries Bhd, UG Healthcare Corp Ltd and ViTrox Corp Bhd.

The top-three performing Malaysian firms in terms of total sales were Scientex (US\$834mil or RM3.47bil), Thong Guan Industries (US\$229mil or RM952mil) and Comfort Gloves (US\$225mil or RM936mil). In terms of total net income, the top-three performers were Scientex (US\$92mil or RM383mil), Comfort Gloves (US\$67mil or RM279mil) and ViTrox (US\$25mil or RM104mil).

Scientex manufactures and sells plastic products and also engages in property development. Thong Guan Industries is primarily involved in the manufacture of plastic packaging, while Comfort Gloves is engaged in the manufacture and trading of natural and synthetic specialty examination gloves. ViTrox specialises in designing and developing automated vision inspection systems and equipment testers for the semiconductor and electronic packaging industries, as well as electronic communications equipment.

The sound financial figures of the 200 companies on the list reflected how well they coped in the midst of a global pandemic. No surprise, healthcare and pharmaceutical-related companies were standouts while tech and logistics firms linked to the global e-commerce boom also benefitted. The list was meant to identify companies with long-term sustainable performances across a variety of metrics. From a universe of 20,000 publicly traded companies in the Asia-Pacific region with an annual revenue above US\$10mil (RM41.58mil) and below US\$1bil (RM4.16bil), only these 200 companies were selected. The companies on the list, which were unranked, were selected based on a composite score that incorporated their overall track record in measures. These include debt, sales and earnings-per-share growth over both the most recent fiscal one and three-year periods, as well as the strongest one and five-year average returns on equity. Aside from the quantitative criteria, qualitative screens were used as well, such as excluding companies with serious governance issues, questionable accounting, environmental concerns, management issues or legal troubles. State-controlled and subsidiaries of larger companies were also excluded. The criteria also ensured a geographic diversity of companies from across the region. The list used full-year annual results, based on the latest publicly available figures as of Aug 12, 2021, compiled by FactSet. FactSet is a United States-based financial data and software company that provides integrated data and software. All other research was done by Forbes Asia.


Relief measures delay recognition of problem loans - RAM

According to RAM Ratings co-head of financial institution ratings Wong Yin Ching, in conjunction with the publication of the rating agency's Banking Quarterly Roundup Q2'21, the emergence of bad loans in the banking system is expected to be delayed in view of the sizeable proportion of loans under relief. With the reintroduction of the six-month blanket loan repayment moratorium for all retail, microenterprise and affected

SME borrowers, impaired loans will continue to be suppressed for the rest of the year and even in the first half of 2022 (H1'22). The latest regulatory support measure – on an opt-in basis but automatically approved – came into effect in July following a rise in infections and stricter lockdowns which resulted in major disruptions to business activity. Targeted relief programmes offered by banks were already available prior to this. Based on data obtained during the recent bank results briefings, the average proportion of domestic loans under relief or restructuring and rescheduling programmes doubled to about 26% (ranging from 22% to 32% for individual banks) from the previous quarter for eight selected banking groups. This figure may creep up in the coming months although it understands the number of applications has already slowed in recent weeks. Not all relief loans will turn problematic as some borrowers took the payment holiday as a precaution. This is evident from the high percentage of relief loans with no arrears or held by the T20 income group, as shared by some banks. The system's underlying asset quality however will only become clearer after forbearance measures are phased out, with bad loans likely to peak in late 2022 or early 2023. As at end-July 2021, the banking industry's gross impaired loan ratio stood at a still-low 1.67%. All eight banks posted a higher year-on-year pre-tax profit in Q2'21, largely due to a low base effect, but performance was mixed on a quarter-on-quarter (q-o-q) basis. Results for the previous corresponding period were marred by a sharp squeeze in net interest margins (NIMs) because of substantial modification charges arising from the first loan moratorium and multiple policy rate cuts. NIMs have since staged a strong recovery (Q2'21: 2.33%; Q2'20: 1.83%), but the q-o-q improvement was modest (+2bps) as most deposits had already been repriced lower by Q1'21. The system's NIM is envisaged to hover at the current level in the coming quarters and may even see slight compression. Banks are expected to book some modification losses in Q3'21 on account of the recent moratorium, but the quantum will be significantly lower than last year's. In Q2'21, the average credit cost ratio (annualised) of the eight banks moderated q-o-q to 52bps from 61bps. RAM is maintaining its full-year projection of 60-70bps (2020: 84bps) it is foreseen that banks will continue or step up efforts to build up provision reserves as the protracted lockdown has dampened nascent economic recovery. Despite heightened uncertainties, profit performance for the full year is expected to be better than previous year's, driven by NIM recovery and to a lesser extent, lower provisioning charges.

Eye On The Markets

This week, on Friday (10Sep), the Ringgit opened at 4.1475 against the USD from 4.1440 on Monday (6Sept). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0886 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (10Sep). On Monday (6Sept), the FBM KLCI opened at 1590.67. As at Friday (10Sep) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 11.87 points for the week at 1578.80. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 151.69 points (-0.43%) to 34,879.38 whilst the NASDAQ shed 38.40 points (-0.25%) to 15,248.30.


Based on the weekly chart, its share price has been on a rising trend since September 2020. This can be seen from the various candlesticks trading near or above the upper limit of the Bollinger Band, coupled with high buying volume, as seen from the volume bar chart.

The trend went on until February 2021, where its share price started to fall back and breached the 20-Day Moving Average in March 2021. However, its MACD line is still above zero at that time, which indicates that the uptrend is still intact.

Coupled with the TenderFresh's acquisition, Kimly's share price continued to march on in May 2021 and trade above the upper limit of the Bollinger Band. Subsequently, with the Relative Strength Index (RSI) at overbought territory, its share price started to fall back and has since recovered to above the 20-Day Moving Average.

With that, investors will have to take note of whether Kimly's share price will fall below the 20-Day Moving Average, as this could indicate further weakness in the share price.

Past Financial Performance

For FY2020, Kimly's revenue grew by a mere 1.19% year-on-year to S\$210.77 million. The slightly higher revenue can be attributed to:

- Higher revenue contribution from Food Retail Division as a result of an increase in food delivery sales. In addition, heightened food delivery demand during Singapore's Circuit Breaker period further drove up food delivery sales.
- Revenue contribution from the Group's newly diversified Outlet Investment Business Division.

Despite the low single digit revenue growth, Kimly's profit after tax jumped by 25.79% year-on-year to S\$25.22 million, mainly due to lower cost of sales.

For its trailing 12-month financial performance, Kimly's revenue grew by 7.24% to S\$226.03 million. The higher revenue can be seen from all 3 business divisions:

- Food Retail
- Outlet Investment Business
- Outlet Management

With the further reduction in cost of sales and other operating expenses, Kimly's profit after tax grew by 44.51% to S\$36.45 million.

Conclusion & Management Outlook

To conclude, Kimly's financial performance has been resilient amid the COVID-19 pandemic and is set to have another leg of growth once the majority stake in TenderFresh takes place.

Analysts are also bullish on the prospects of Kimly, given the positive consensus estimates.

In terms of management outlook, Kimly mentioned that they will continue taking precautions in ensuring the safety of its staff and viability of operations as new strains of the virus have emerged in some parts of Asia this year.

Furthermore, despite the lingering uncertainties, the Group aims to continue seeking opportunities available in the market to grow its revenue streams while monitoring the situation cautiously.

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

In Lower Gear

Markets

The Federal Reserve Beige Book that was released on Wednesday showed that the US economy has downshifted slightly as a result of a resurgence in the number of new Delta-variant Covid-19 cases. Nevertheless, despite the disruptions, job hirings remain robust. Meanwhile, the New York Fed President opines that it would be appropriate for the Fed to begin its tapering plan of its bond-buying program this year.

Locally, the heart of the nation's economic pulse, the Klang Valley, has finally moved to Phase 2 of the National Recovery Plan with effect from today.

Economy

Last Friday, data from IHS Markit showed that the global economy continues to lose momentum as the J.P. Morgan Global Composite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) fell to a 7-month low of 52.6 in August, from July's reading of 55.8. Meanwhile, the IHS Markit Final Eurozone Composite PMI eased to 59.0 in August from the preceding month's print of 60.2.

The August US labour market statistics released last Friday was surely one of the biggest misses of the year as non-farm payrolls came in at just 235k against the market forecast of 733k. However, the rate of unemployment topped the forecast at 5.2%. Other data out of the US saw trade deficit for July fell by 4.3% to US\$70.1bil as imports fell by 0.2% to US\$282.9bil while exports rose by 1.3% to US\$212.8bil.

Out of China, external trade data came in surprisingly strong for August as exports surged 25.6% y-o-y to US\$294.3bil while imports jumped 33.1% y-o-y to US\$236bil, giving rise to a trade surplus of US\$58.3bil, up 3.1% from July's US\$56.6bil. Meanwhile, China's inflation data for August showed China's Producer Price Index (PPI) rose by 9.5% y-o-y in August, much faster than the 9% rise in July. However, China's inflation increased at a slower pace of 0.8% y-o-y in August compared with a 1% gain in the preceding month.

Locally, the Monetary Policy Committee, which met for the fifth time this year, left the key Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) unchanged at 1.75%, a decision that was well within market expectations. Bank Negara reported that Malaysia's international reserves rose to US\$116.3bil as of Aug 30, 2021, an increase of 4.5% or US\$5bil from US\$111.3 billion recorded a fortnight before. The higher reserve level is due to an allocation of Special Drawing Rights (SDRs) to Malaysia of SDR3.5bil, which is equivalent to US\$5bil by the International Monetary Fund. In Ringgit terms, Malaysia's international reserves stood at RM483.6bil as at end of August, a new record high. On the local labour market front, the Department of Statistics revealed that July unemployment remained unchanged at 4.8%, despite a 1.2% increase in the number of unemployed persons.

Corporate

Genting Plantation (GENP) is now a major shareholder in PUC Bhd, a company that is part of a consortium bidding for a banking licence to be issued by Bank Negara. GENP, via its wholly-owned subsidiary, GPVF Sdn. Bhd. said it is acquiring 162.5mil shares at 12.5 sen per share for RM20.3mil. PUC had earlier announced that it had teamed up with the Sabah and Pahang state government to bid for one of the five licenses.

In major shareholding changes, Khazanah Nasional sold 138.4mil shares in CIMB Group Holdings at RM4.80 per share, raising gross proceeds of RM664.5mil. Meanwhile, the independent adviser for MMC Corporation proposed privatization of the company at RM2.00 per share by its major shareholder opines that the offer is not fair but reasonable. It also recommends entitled shareholders to vote in favour of the proposal.

In other news, 11 Malaysian corporates made it to the Forbes "Asia's 2021 Best Under A Billion" list. This includes Comfort Gloves, D&O Green Technologies, Dancomech Holdings, Dufu Technology Corp, FoundPac Group, Frontken Corp, Revenue Group, Scientex,

Thong Guan Industries, UG Healthcare Corp, and ViTrox Corp.

Equity

World equity markets were mostly lower this week with losses ranging from between 0.1% and 1.9%. However, some markets continued to scale new heights and among them was the Nikkei 225, which gained 5.1%, following the announcement that Prime Minister Yoshihide Suga will not seek re-election of his party's leadership, paving the way for a new Prime Minister to be appointed. Other markets that rose gained between 0.8% and 2.7%. On the local front, despite the sustained net buying interest among foreign institutional funds, the local bourse closed on a weaker note with the KLCI down by 3.30 pts at 1,578.89 pts week-on-week.

For the week ended September 8th, foreign net inflow posted its fourth consecutive week of net inflows of RM571.3mil. Retail momentum too reversed as net buying interest of RM205mil was registered, leaving the local institutions as net sellers in the market with an outflow of RM776.3mil for the week.

Eye on Week Ahead

Next week, attention will shift to the US inflation data for August, which will be out on Tuesday, Sept 14, while China will be releasing three key data the next day and this includes the fixed asset investment, industrial production, and retail sales for August as well. On the same day, Japan's external trade data too will be released.

Locally, the focus will be on some key July economic data to be out today and this includes the Industrial Production Index (IPI), followed by the manufacturing statistics and the performance of wholesale and retail trade. Next week, the market's attention will also shift towards the re-opening of Parliament on Monday. Other economic data points for next week include the rubber statistics for July 2021, which will be released on Tuesday, Sept 14.

Shareholder activism in a pandemic

As of July 2021, there were 946 companies listed on Bursa Malaysia and understandably for many of them, the past two years have been a tremendous strain. The current situation is a stark reminder of the importance of having holistic corporate strategies and adequate business continuity management processes. Having good governance means having a strategic business continuity plan to identify the potential threats, as well as having strong contingency plans to safeguard business functions in the event of business disruption. Companies should be mindful of the direction they are heading to, whether it is navigating the business out of the woods or positioning themselves for growth beyond the pandemic. Good corporate governance is also about keeping stakeholders informed without being prompted, particularly in the current environment. Companies should be aware that timely disclosures are especially paramount during this unprecedented time. Thus, PLCs should constantly engage their stakeholders to keep them abreast of new and significant developments.

In addition, PLCs must equip themselves with the capability of holding virtual meetings and remote voting. Interestingly, numbers have shown that virtual meetings have expanded the reach for shareholders to participate in meetings. Shareholders should continue actively participating in virtual meetings so that their voices are

heard by the Board and management. As for the PLCs, they should do their part in providing a sufficient notice period and explaining the procedures of virtual meetings. While MSWG advocates physical AGMs for better shareholders activism, we hope companies will continue to enable remote access i.e., a hybrid meeting, even after the COVID-19 pandemic subsides, to encourage remote participation from shareholders. This pandemic presents a tenacious testing ground for listed entities to manage their businesses while ensuring their governance is not compromised. Amid this, companies with better governance are better prepared to survive and deal with the long-term effects of a pandemic. Their action will inevitably reflect on their reputation, leadership, investability and consequently, the future growth trajectory of our capital market.

Sustainability is the new norm

When crisis strikes, naturally companies would focus on financial related sustainability agenda such as business continuity, cash flow, business model and employees. Other sustainability agenda such as environment and climate change will usually be side-lined. Corporates tend to consider sustainability only when there are cost savings and risks to their business long-term survival. Now, it is not an option but a must for corporates to incorporate environmental, social, and governance (ESG) risks and opportunities into their business strategies. In this new

normal, businesses are expected to be more responsible towards its stakeholders which include the employees, suppliers, customers, community and environment. The Board and management are responsible for the governance of sustainability in the company including setting the company's sustainability strategies, priorities and targets. Studies have shown ESG funds tend to hold up better during a downturn. As reported by Morningstar, like equity funds, ESG based equity funds suffered large and sudden losses during the first quarter of 2020. However, they held up better than conventional funds. Seven out of 10 sustainable equity funds finished in the top half of their Morningstar Categories, and 24 of 26 ESG-tilted index funds outperformed their closest conventional counterparts.

In addition, a research project by Fidelity identified a "remarkably strong" correlation between stronger market performance in companies with higher environmental, social and governance ratings. This reflects that ESG is an expectation and stakeholders will reward it. Sustainability will matter more now and play a greater role in the new norm. In this new age, it will be about doing business sustainably and responsibly.

Volume Distribution Chart is a statistical interpretation of the current sentiment on each stock in graphical format.
