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East Malaysia CPO Futures contract enables greater price transparency & better risk management

According to Bursa Malaysia Bhd CEO and Bursa Malaysia Derivatives Bhd chairman Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift, the East Malaysia Crude Palm Oil Futures (FEPO) will provide greater price transparency for palm oil and risk management for oil palm players in Sabah and Sarawak. Compared with the crude palm oil futures (FCPO), FEPO has physical delivery ports in Sabah and Sarawak, which efficiently eliminates the logistical cost barrier that prevented East Malaysian firms from hedging with the existing futures contracts. This will improve the cost effectiveness of managing price risk for palm oil industry players in East Malaysia, both upstream and downstream. As a result, their refining margins and competitiveness in selling end products to their customers will also improve. Aside from the physical delivery location, trading of the East Malaysia futures contract begins at 9am compared with FCPO's start of 10.30am. In his welcome address at the virtual launch of FEPO, he explained that this is designed to meet the needs of participants who have exposure to East Malaysian palm oil as well as to meet the demand of arbitrageurs trading in China's market. The Covid-19 pandemic has greatly affected the global commodities sector, in production and demand, besides creating supply chain and market disruptions. In a highly volatile environment, it is critical for businesses to consider implementing a more robust price risk management strategy to mitigate against fluctuating commodity prices while remaining competitive. Looking ahead to 2022, market participants need to brace themselves for another uncertain year, with numerous key elements having the potential to cause heightened price volatility. These include the unpredictable weather conditions, uncertain economic recovery, and potential changes to global trade policy. Despite the volatile conditions, Bursa's derivatives market continued to see remarkable growth as it grew 35% in 2020 to hit a total trading volume of 18.2 million contracts. In addition, the year saw a record 14.6 million FCPO contracts traded, which is equivalent to 365 million tonnes of crude palm oil, representing five times the world's production.

Malaysia expected to see renewed interest in SPAC listing

According to Deloitte Malaysia IPO leader Wong Kar Choon, Malaysia may see a renewed interest in the special purpose acquisition company (SPAC) listing moving forward. One key reason is that SPACs is seen as a faster alternative in raising capital than the traditional initial public offerings (IPOs). There is no denying that certain businesses flourished and have been doing well in this trying time. To seize the opportunities, technology-based

start-up companies are also seeking a different type of fundraising. Over the last couple of months, we have heard an increasing buzz on SPAC. There were also announcements made on a number of Southeast Asian (SEA) technology-based start-ups seeking a SPAC merger in the capital market in the United States. Based on data from Spacktrack.net, the current SPAC trust funds available in the US that is still searching for a viable business merger is about US\$114 billion. Last month, the Securities Commission Malaysia said it was still in the midst of reviewing its framework for SPAC listings amid developments in other markets. On the capital markets in Malaysia and SEA, there is continued support from retail investors. Although the average trading volumes have decreased from a high peak in 2020, it is hoped that the average trading volume would pick up towards the tail end of 2021 as vaccination rate increases for most countries and businesses open. In the first six months of 2021, Malaysia recorded 14 listings, of which two were on the Main Market, seven on the ACE Market, and five on the LEAP Market. They raised about RM395 million with a market capitalisation of RM1.5 billion.

Bursa Anywhere app now has eGO feature

According to Bursa Malaysia Bhd chief executive officer Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift, the exchange has introduced a new feature called electronic General Offer (eGO) to its Bursa Anywhere mobile application. eGO is aimed at providing convenience to investors by fast-tracking their general offer applications. Previously, investors were required to submit a transfer form to their brokers in order to transfer the securities and followed by the submission of an offer document for the acceptance of the offer. Now all applications and submission of documents can be performed via eGo. The shareholders no longer need to physically go to their brokers, or deal with the traditional method of delivering the physical transfer form to the broker for transfer execution, and share registrar for submission of the offer document. The new feature is timely as the COVID-19 outbreak had prompted most investors to switch to electronic investing options for improved security and convenience. It also offers investors tremendous cost and time savings by providing secure access to investment opportunities and services anytime anywhere, in line with the evolving demands of modern investors. Bursa Anywhere was developed to provide investors ease of accessibility in managing their central depository system (CDS) accounts remotely. The eGO feature complements the mobile app's existing extensive services, such as facilitating CDS account openings, rights issue subscriptions, as well as reactivation of dormant and inactive CDS accounts. The app

has garnered over 210,000 downloads since its release in June 2019.

RHB provides more than RM20.3b in financial assistance to SMEs

According to Jeffrey Ng, Managing Director of Group Community Banking of RHB Banking Group, the RHB Group continues to take a holistic approach to building resilience amongst Small and Medium Enterprises during this challenging economic environment through the Group's financial relief facilities and repayment assistance programmes, providing access to new working capital, as well as implementing various targeted programmes to further stimulate SME business growth. 

Commodities On A Tear

Markets

Global markets were mostly mixed to lower this week as investors turned cautious on the back of a rally in commodities, which spooked inflationary fears yet again. The debt-ceiling stand-off in the US Congress did not help sentiment either but the Democrat's offer to raise the ceiling for the short-term raised hopes of avoiding a potential default within the next ten days. This helped markets to rebound from the selling pressure over the past few days.

Globally, economic data were mixed. The September J.P. Morgan Global Composite Output Index rebounded from a 7-month low to 53.0 from 52.5 in the preceding month, but the J.P. Morgan Global Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for the same month stayed unchanged at 54.1. On a positive note, the ASEAN IHS Markit Manufacturing PMI for September registered a reading of 50.0 and higher than the preceding month's print of 44.5.

In politics, Japan got its 100th Prime Minister with the appointment of Fumio Kishida, who has immediately called for snap polls at the end of the month. Meanwhile, the International Monetary Fund expects global economic growth in 2021 to fall slightly below its July forecast of 6%, citing risks associated with debt, inflation, and divergent economic trends due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

While markets were mixed this week, rebounding from earlier sell-off, it was commodities that took the shine out of the equity markets as crude oil surged to a multi-year high of more than US\$80 per barrel while crude palm oil (CPO) spot-month October contract hit an all-time high of RM5,000 per metric tonne.

Meanwhile, investors are still on the lookout for further fallout among Chinese property developers even as the dust on Evergrande Group has yet to settle. This was after Fantasia Holdings declared that it had failed to make a US\$206 million debt payment on time.

Economy

Out of the US, the headline and core US Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) for August rose to 4.3% and 3.6% y-o-y respectively. While the headline PCE reading came in marginally ahead of forecast and at a fresh 30-year high, the core PCE was well within the forecast. In other news, the September US Institute of Supply Management (ISM) PMI for the manufacturing and the non-manufacturing sector came in well ahead of forecast at 61.1 and 61.9 against 59.9 and 61.7 in August respectively. In other news, the US trade deficit surged to US\$73.3bil, a new record high, as imports of goods and services grew 1.4% while exports of the same showed a tepid growth of just 0.5%.

Meanwhile, the Final Eurozone IHS Markit Composite and Manufacturing PMI for

September registered a reading of 56.2 and 58.6, -0.1 and +0.1 firmer than the previously reported Flash readings respectively. On rates, New Zealand became the latest to hike interest rates with a 25bps move to 0.5% - the first rate hike in seven years, as it battles against a rising inflationary trend.

Locally, Malaysia's IHS Markit Manufacturing PMI for September bounced back to 48.1 from the August print of 43.4, signalling the return of business activities as the economy begins to open up after being disrupted by lockdowns. In other news, the international reserves of Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) amounted to US\$115.2 billion as at end of 3Q 2021, a drop of US\$1 billion from a fortnight ago, after taking into account the quarterly foreign exchange revaluation changes. Meanwhile, except for two new criteria, Malaysia has reverted to the original conditions imposed on the existing Malaysian My Second Home (MM2H) programme. However, the ten new conditions will remain in place for new applicants.

Corporate

Recently listed CTOS Digital came under some selling pressure after BNM issued a directive to temporarily suspend all credit reporting agencies' access to the central credit reference information system in light of the alleged data leak of several governmental bodies.

In diversification-related news, Rubberex Corporation intends to diversify into property investments with a proposal that will see it emerging as a 20% shareholder in a newly established joint-venture (JV) company that will own the Empire City Mall. Subject to the approval of its shareholders at an EGM to be convened, Rubberex will invest RM180mil via subscription of new shares in the JV company.

In other deals, Landmarks is selling its Bintan-based hospitality assets to Singapore-listed Blumont Ltd in an all-share deal valued at S\$63.4mil or RM195mil. The transaction will see Landmarks emerging as a substantial shareholder of Blumont with a 29.3% stake.

Meanwhile, Insas, SYF Resources, and Mieco Chipboard entered into several separate agreements, which will see Insas injecting its 100% stake in M & A Securities to SYF for RM222mil in an all-share deal while SYF will be disposing of its furniture-related business and two parcels of lands to Mieco for a total consideration of RM71.2mil. In addition, SYF has also proposed a special dividend and capital repayment of 7 sen and 11 sen respectively, and a rights issue on the basis of one new share for every two shares held at 14 sen per share. SYF will then be renamed as M & A Capital Bhd, to reflect its financial services-related business, and will be 75.9% owned by Insas.

Not to be missed, Country Heights Holdings (CHHB) has entered into several Head of Agreement to acquire several assets privately owned by its major shareholder. In a deal worth some RM554mil, CHHB will acquire

the assets via the issuance of new shares at RM1.20 per share.

In contract news, Crest Builder won the award to undertake the development of two blocks of a condominium located in Mont Kiara valued at RM192.1mil, while Ireka Corporation clinched a RM196mil contract for the fibre-to-home connectivity project in Langkawi, Kedah. AirAsia was also in the news this week as it obtained approval from Danajamin Nasional for an 80% guaranteed loan of up to RM500mil.

Equity


World equity markets were mostly weaker this week as investors feared rising inflationary trends and slower global growth on the back of a rally in commodities. Nevertheless, week-on-week, most South-East Asian markets, except for the Philippines market, were firmer with gains ranging between 0.5% and 2.1%, while other markets that closed higher rose by between 0.1% and 0.9%. Markets that closed lower were mainly from North Asia, led by a steep 6% drop in the Nikkei 225. Other markets that were down for the week under review declined by between 0.1% and 3.6%. Locally, the KLCI closed 23.49 pts firmer at 1,561.29 pts as buying interest picked up among commodity-based stocks, led by the plantation and oil and gas stocks. For the week ended Oct 6th, foreigners turned net sellers with an outflow of RM399.5mil, while local institutions and retailers were net buyers with an inflow of RM346.7mil and RM52.8mil respectively.

Eye on Week Ahead

Out of the US, later today, the key data will be the September labour market report with eyes on both the unemployment rate and non-farm payrolls, which the market is expecting at 488,000 and 5.1% respectively. On Wednesday, Oct 13, China will be releasing its September trade data with consensus expecting a growth of 17.1% and 26.8% for the country's exports and imports respectively. On the same day, all eyes will be on US headline inflation with consensus expecting a 5.4% y-o-y print. In addition, the minutes of the last Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) too will be made available on the same day. Investors are likely to pick up any additional hints on the timing of the US tapering move, which is expected to start next month onwards. On Thursday, Oct 14, China will be releasing its inflation data for September as the market awaits any signs of further inflationary pressure, mainly due to the higher commodity prices.

Later today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will be releasing the August monthly labour statistics, with a focus on the rate of unemployment. Next week Tuesday, Oct 12, the DOSM will announce the performance of the Malaysian Manufacturing Sector, Wholesale and Retail Trade, and the Industrial Production Index (IPI) for August.

Exceptionally low cost of the internal audit function – a concern

In the past few years, MSWG has been raising questions at AGMs on the exceptionally low cost spent by PLCs on their internal audit (IA) function. MSWG considers a cost of below RM24,000 per annum as exceptionally low. During the last year, a few of the PLCs queried have stated that the low IA cost was due to less or no audit work performed during the year because of movement controls arising from the COVID-19 pandemic. Meanwhile, most of the other PLCs replied that they felt that the cost was reasonable, and that the scope covered by the internal audit function was sufficient to ensure that internal control systems were adequate and effective.

Some of the other reasons provided for the low IA cost include:

- The management and CEO were also undertaking necessary steps to ensure internal control procedures are being followed.
- The Audit Committee was receiving assurance from the management that risk management and internal control systems were adequate and effective.
- The reduction was due to cost cutting measures due to difficult times.

Unreasonable reasons for low cost

The reasons provided by the PLCs for the low cost incurred for their IA function does not hold water. One of the reasons given was that management and CEO were also undertaking necessary steps to ensure that the internal control procedures were being followed. Another was that the Audit Committee was receiving assurance from the management that risk management and internal control systems were adequate and effective. In both these instances, the Audit Committee was relying on management for assurance on management when it should be relying on someone independent of management for that assurance – only an independent IA function, correctly positioned, can provide such independent assurance. Internal audit provides assurance on management – it does not make sense to ask management to provide assurance on itself – this is an obvious conflict of interest.

Another common reason given for the low IA cost was that it was due to cost-cutting exercises due to difficult times. The IA function should not just be regarded as any other 'cost centre' that can be downsized during difficult times. It is exactly in such difficult times that there should be a robust IA function. It appears that some companies maintain an IA function just to 'tick the box' to say that they have complied with the listing requirement to have an IA function.

Findings of the MSWG-ASEAN CG Scorecard 2020 assessment

The findings of the MSWG-ASEAN CG Scorecard 2020 assessment revealed that 158 PLCs had exceptionally low IA costs of RM24,000 per annum (or equivalent to RM2,000 per month) or less. The lowest cost incurred for the IA function was RM1,752 per annum (2019: RM1,488).

All the 5 PLCs listed above had outsourced their internal audit functions.

The finding of the MSWG-ASEAN scorecard assessment revealed that out of the 158 PLCs with IA cost of less than RM24,000 per year, 154 of them relied on outsourced service providers for their IA functions. An IA cost of RM1,752 per year for a PLC with more than RM10 million revenue and RM6,000 for a PLC with almost RM200 million revenue should spark concerns on the adequacy of the scope of work and the effectiveness of the IA function. For that matter, even the 158 PLCs which had IA cost of RM24,000 per annum or less should also be viewed with concern.

The role & function of internal audit

The IA function is considered as one of the four cornerstones of good corporate governance – the other three being the board, the management and external audit. IA is considered important enough to be mandated by the listing requirements. Chapter 15, Paragraph 15.27 of the Main Market Listing Requirements (MMLR) requires a listed issuer to establish an IA function that reports directly to the audit committee. The plans and scope of the IA function are determined by the audit committee of the PLC. As such, the role, the function, and the scope of the IA function could vary among PLCs. IA provides independent assurance to the board, through the audit committee, that all is well when it comes to risk management, control processes and governance structures and processes of organisations. Business organisations are susceptible to fraud and all kinds of wrong. As such an effective IA function is essential to safeguard the interest of the shareholders and other stakeholders.

Internal audit – the unregulated function

Unlike the external auditors of PLCs, who are regulated by the AOB, (and the Malaysian Institute of Accountants), under the purview of the SC, the internal auditors are unregulated. There is the Institute of Internal Auditors Malaysia, but it is not mandatory for an internal auditor, or for the head of an internal audit function, to be a member of that Institute. The unregulated nature of IA could be a reason for the low cost of the IA function. All things being equal, the lower the cost the lesser the quality, the competence and effectiveness. That which is unregulated tends to fall into disarray. Important professions are always regulated. With regulations, there is higher quality and more accountability.

It is well and good to realise the importance of IA and make it mandatory for listed companies. If the IA function is indeed that important enough to be acknowledged as a mandatory requirement under the listing requirements, then, surely, it is important enough to be regulated – just like any other profession worth its salt.




