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
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
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Bursa inks MoU with OCBC, Alliance to introduce sustainable financing for PLCs

According to Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift, chief executive officer (CEO) of Bursa Malaysia, the exchange operator and regulator has entered into a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Alliance Bank Malaysia Bhd and OCBC Bank (Malaysia) Bhd to establish #financing4ESG, an initiative to improve Malaysian public listed companies' (PLCs) environmental, social and governance (ESG) adoption. Bursa Malaysia said it will collaborate with both banks to develop sustainable financing options that recognise PLCs' ESG credentials in accordance with the FTSE4Good assessment criteria. The initiative enables PLCs the opportunity to accelerate their ESG adoption while also improving their ESG ratings for inclusion into the domestic capital market's ESG index, FTSE4Good Bursa Malaysia Index. FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index constituents are eligible for the sustainability financing under the initiative as they form the FTSE4Good ESG assessment universe. The signing of the MoU with Alliance Bank and OCBC Bank underscores Bursa's commitment towards accelerating ESG adoption among PLCs, in line with the aspiration to elevate PLCs as regional leaders in this space. He is optimistic that this collaboration will spur the growth of sustainable finance while also enhancing PLCs' appeal to investors. He noted that for PLCs, ESG is no longer nice-to-have but has become need-to-have. Joel Kornreich, group CEO of Alliance Bank, speaking at the event, noted that it is important to help business owners adopt ESG practices and innovation to reduce carbon footprint as the sustainable choices they make can be a force for good for the community and environment. He added that sustainable choices will result in positive climate impact, social outcomes, and business profitability in the long term and that their collaboration with Bursa Malaysia will enable them to help businesses, large and small, innovate and grow sustainably. Also present at the MoU was Tan Ai Chin, managing director, senior banker and head of investment banking of OCBC Bank, who said that the bank will collaborate with Bursa Malaysia by synergising OCBC Bank's leading experience in pioneering various sustainable finance transactions and capitalising on Bursa Malaysia's ESG database to provide optimal financing solutions for PLCs. They aim to mainstream the adoption of sustainable finance to further accelerate the PLCs' sustainability agendas, as a means to support the Malaysian government's commitment towards achieving carbon neutrality by 2050. Besides the competitive financing from Alliance Bank and OCBC Bank, PLCs will obtain non-monetary benefits from the collaboration's branding and capacity building exercises. Bursa Malaysia will also provide access to its investor relations engagements and event platforms, along with the opportunity to participate in specialised technical workshops on climate-related disclosures. The #financing4ESG initiative sets the foundation for Bursa Malaysia to collaborate with other ecosystem players to advance the nation's ESG adoption, which is in line with the Exchange's vision to be a leading sustainable and globally connected marketplace. 
Govt to unveil MSC 2.0 to attract more digital investment — Mustapa

According to Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economy) Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, the government will unveil MSC 2.0 with a new branding and further improvements to address the digital divide, meet current challenges and constraints, and enhance Malaysia's value proposition to attract more digital investment nationwide. This effort is in line with the 12th

Malaysia Plan (12MP), Malaysia Digital Economy Blueprint (MyDIGITAL), and United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. He said the decision was made at the fourth meeting of the National Digital Economy and Fourth National Industrial Revolution (4IR) Council, which was chaired by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob. For 25 years, the Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation (MDEC) through the MSC Malaysia initiative, has succeeded to increase the contribution of the digital economy from 0% to more than 20% to gross domestic product by 2021. As at Dec 31, 2020, MSC Malaysia had helped the country raise investments of more than RM384 billion and revenue of RM588 billion. The country has grown into a global digital economic power, having been ranked among the top three of the Kearney Global Services Location Index since 2004 through this initiative. Hence, efforts to digitise the people's economy and popularise the digital economy will continue. The government was satisfied with the implementation of the National Digital Network Plan (JENDELA) through the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) with a total of 6.427 million premises covered with fibre optic, average mobile broadband speed increased to 31.34 Mbps, and 4G coverage increased to 94.03% in populated areas until the third quarter of 2021. The 5G network throughout Malaysia will be implemented aggressively to achieve the target of 80% coverage in populated areas by 2024 to ensure the country is back on par with neighbouring countries in the near term. To encourage the adoption of digital technology by micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), the MyDIGITAL Corporation will be organising the National MSME Digitisation Empowerment Programme 2021 from Nov 21 to 23. The programme will be held in collaboration with the Ministry of Communications and Multimedia, Ministry of Entrepreneur Development and Cooperatives, Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI), MDEC, MCMC, and other relevant government agencies and private entities. The prime minister will be launching the programme which will be held in Bera, Pahang. The programme aims at sharing information on the stimulus or support packages provided by the federal and state governments, the private sector, as well as to share the experiences of entrepreneurs who have achieved success from the various assistance. It was decided that the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation, through early-stage start-up influencer Cradle Fund Sdn Bhd, would coordinate and monitor the implementation of the Malaysia Startup Ecosystem Roadmap (SUPER) 2021-2030 through the MYStartup platform in an effort to place Malaysia in the top 20 of the global start-up ecosystem by 2030. It was also decided that the achievements of the MyDIGITAL initiative be used as a key performance indicator (KPI) for ministers and department heads, in line with the importance of the digital economy.

Eye On The Markets

This week, on Friday (19Nov), the Ringgit opened at 4.1800 against the USD from 4.1640 on Monday (15Nov). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0804 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (19Nov). On Monday (15Nov), the FBM KLCI opened at 1531.38. As at Friday (19Nov) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 7.59 points for the week at 1523.79. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 60.10 points (-0.17%) to 35,870.95 whilst the NASDAQ added 72.10 points (+0.45%) to 15,993.70.

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

Greed Vs. Fear

Markets

It is rather rare to hear the CEO of a top investment bank commenting on markets and where it is today. Hence, when Goldman Sachs' CEO, David Solomon, said that markets could face a rocky time ahead as the global economy seeks to emerge from the abrupt impact of the pandemic, it did not go unnoticed. He reckons that there is now a greater concern of accelerating inflation posing a bigger challenge to a sustained recovery, as central banks may be forced to raise interest rates sooner rather than later.

Economy

Out of the US, the preliminary University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment for November registered a lower than expected reading of just 66.8 against 71.7 in the preceding month, reflecting consumers' concern about rising prices. However, it was a different scenario on retail spending as the US October Retail Sales surged 1.7% m-o-m and 16.3% y-o-y. Meanwhile, the US housing market continues to show weakness as October Housing Starts fell by 0.7% m-o-m to an annualized rate of 1.52mil units, which was lower than the market forecast of 1.576mil units. Nevertheless, the Building Permits trend remains positive as October data showed an increase of 4% m-o-m to an annualized rate of 1.65mil units.

Japan's 3Q of 2021 economic performance was well below expectations as the world's third-largest economy contracted by 3.0% annualized rate against the market forecast of a 0.8% decline, as global supply disruptions and fresh Covid-19 cases hit business and consumer spending. Key data from China this week saw the release of the October data points for retail sales and industrial production, which grew by 4.9% and 3.5% y-o-y respectively, as well as fixed asset investment data, which expanded by 6.1% for the first ten months of 2021.

Meanwhile, Thailand's 3Q GDP came in slightly ahead of expectations as the reported 0.3% contraction was smaller than the consensus estimate of a 0.8% y-o-y decline. The kingdom's economy for the quarterly period was mainly dragged by a 3.2% y-o-y contraction in private consumption. Across the causeway, Singapore's October non-oil domestic exports surged to the fastest pace in four years as growth accelerated to 17.9% y-o-y.

Locally, Malaysia's 3Q GDP came in well below expectations as the economy contracted by 4.5% y-o-y, mainly dragged by a 20.6% dive in construction-related activities while the services sector too was weak, contracting by 4.9% y-o-y, as economic closure

due to Covid-19 impacted domestic demand. Technically, Malaysia is back into recession, as on a q-o-q basis, the economy contracted for the second consecutive quarter with a 3.6% decline, larger than the preceding quarter's 1.9% q-o-q fall. In other news, the Malaysian Automotive Association reported October Total Industry Volume (TIV) at 63,489 units, up 43.4% m-o-m and 10.0% y-o-y. For the first 10 months of 2021, TIV is now at 382,379 units, down 4.8% y-o-y.

Corporate

WZ Satu is exploring the potential of acquiring Citaglobal Engineering Services Sdn Bhd (CESSB) for RM140mil via the issuance of RM80mil new WZ Satu shares and RM60mil new WZ Satu Redeemable Convertible Preference Shares (RCPS), to be issued at RM0.19 each.

In contract news, Yinson has been awarded two Letters of Intent (LOI) by Petrobas for the provision of floating production storage and offloading facility and operation and maintenance services during the charter phase with an aggregate value of US\$5.2bil for a period of 22.5 years from the date of the final acceptance. Kimlun Corporation too was in the news this week as it won a RM780mil construction and maintenance contract for the Sarawak-Sabah Link Road project (the Lawas-Long Lopeng junction).

In quarterly results, Supermax Corporation's 1Q FY2022 performance was again impacted by the declining Average Selling Price (ASP) of gloves as revenue and net earnings fell by 22.4% and 33.4% q-o-q, while compared to a year ago, although 1Q FY2022 revenue improved by 7.6% y-o-y to RM1.46bil, net earnings fell by 19.1% y-o-y to RM638.5mil. Despite the drop in ASPs, Supermax's EBITDA margin remains healthy at 63.9% in the 1Q of FY2022 against 65.6% in the preceding quarter and a high of 77.6% a year ago. Meanwhile, Dato' Seri Stanley Thai will assume the position of Executive Chairman of the company with effect from December 8, 2021.

Other corporate news was on KNM Group as the company informed Bursa Malaysia that a non-payment event has occurred on the bonds issued by KNM in Thailand amounting to THB2.78bil or RM 352.6mil. These bonds are guaranteed by a trust fund managed by the Asian Development Bank. The bonds had matured on 18 November and KNM has up to 14 days, being 2 December 2021, to pay the principal sum, and up to 21 days after the maturity date, being 9 December 2021, to make the coupon payments, failing which, an event of default shall be deemed to have occurred.

Equity

World equity markets closed mostly mixed to firmer this week. Markets that rose gained between 0.3% and 2.2% while markets that fell declined by between 0.1% and 0.8%. Locally, the benchmark index closed marginally firmer after several weeks of losses on the back of light bargain hunting activities. At the close of Thursday's trading session, the KLCI gained 4.94 pts or 0.3% higher at 1,523.79 pts. For the week ended November 17, foreigners maintained their net buying interest in the local bourse with an inflow of RM359.1mil, followed by a net inflow of RM211.1mil among retail investors. This left the local institutions as the largest net sellers with an outflow amounting to RM570.2mil.


Eye on Week Ahead

Later today, the European Central Bank's President, Ms. Christian Lagarde is scheduled to speak at the 31st Frankfurt European Banking Congress and the market will likely be paying attention to her narrative on current economic and financial market conditions. Next week, on Monday, November 22, the US October Existing Home Sales data is due with the market looking at a 6.2mil annualized rate. On Tuesday, November 23, the IHS Markit Flash November Eurozone Composite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) and the Manufacturing PMI will be released.

Next week Wednesday, November 24 is a heavy day for markets as the market's attention will first switch to the Reserve Bank of New Zealand as there is a possibility that RBNZ may hike the interest rate for the second time in a row, having raised rates by 25bps last month to 0.5%. On the same day, the US October Durable Goods Order data, the headline, and the core Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) economic data are due as well. This will give investors a greater grip on the rate of inflation in the US as it is the key barometer watched by the Fed for any rate decisions. Not to be missed, the US October New Home Sales and the University of Michigan Final November Consumer Sentiment print will be out as well. In addition, markets will also be on the lookout for the minutes of the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) latest meeting, just ahead of the Thanksgiving weekend.

Locally, on Monday, November 22, Bank Negara will release Malaysia's International Reserves position as at November 15.

When things come to a head – the Serba Dinamik saga

On 8 November 2021, Serba Dinamik Holdings Berhad announced that it had taken legal action against the frontline regulator of capital market Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad (Bursa Securities). This action is unprecedented based on the facts of the case. One of the factors on which the legal action pivots, is the contents of the 'Factual Finding Update' of the Special Independent Review (SIR) conducted by Ernst & Young (EY) Consulting Sdn Bhd (who incidentally is also being sued by Serba Dinamik).

On 22 October 2021, Bursa Securities suspended the trading of securities (including all structured warrants) of Serba Dinamik and issued a directive to the Company to disclose the contents of the 'Factual Finding Update' by 26 October 2021. The non-compliance to the directive would result in the continued trading suspension of Serba Dinamik's securities on the next market day (27 October 2021) after the directive deadline. In a media release, Bursa Securities noted that the findings from the 'Factual Findings Update' as at 30 September 2021 on the SIR have been communicated to 3 out of 4 Serba Dinamik's independent non-executive directors, on 21 October 2021. It was also reported that the presentation by EY Consulting was also attended by representatives from Bursa Securities.

Bursa Securities was of the view that the contents of the 'Factual Finding Update' are material enough to be disseminated to the public to ensure the orderly and fair trading of Serba Dinamik's securities. However, Serba Dinamik disagreed. Consequently, Serba Dinamik did not disclose the findings of the 'Factual Finding Update'. The Company gave its reasons why it was unable to disclose the contents. There is thus a difference of opinion between Serba Dinamik and Bursa Securities. Bursa Securities then continued to maintain the suspension on the trading of Serba Dinamik's securities due to this non-disclosure. MSWG is not aware of the contents of the 'Factual Finding Update' and as such is unable to opine on the materiality of the findings.

On 12 November, 2021, the SC, as the statutory regulator of the capital market, has assured the investing public that it has made progress on its investigation into Serba Dinamik and additional resources have been added to the team to ensure the investigation is completed in a timely manner. As Serba Dinamik has taken legal action against Bursa Malaysia (and EY Consulting), the issue is now in the realm of the courts and MSWG awaits the timely resolution of the case in the interest of minority shareholders.

Concocting a winning formula: Convergence of Shariah and ESG investing

Environmental, Social, Governance (ESG) and Shariah-compliant investing are often viewed as distinctly separate investment approaches. This is despite both sharing similar principles: the promotion of stewardship, social responsibility and value creation.

In fact, adopting an ESG screening process with a Shariah overlay can offer attractive sustainable returns over time. After all, Shariah investing seeks to promote responsible behaviour by being good stewards of the society and environment. In a nutshell, Shariah investing focuses on:

- i. the prohibition of interest-bearing instruments, security lending and short selling;
- ii. the use of negative screening to exclude high leverage companies, prohibited goods or services defined by rules of Shariah such as (industries involved in tobacco, alcohol, weapons and non-halal products).

Similarly, ESG investing seeks to promote responsible behaviour by integrating responsible investing elements to achieve sustainable outcomes. The ESG approach focuses on more intricate issues to mitigate risks, hence enhancing long-term returns. In so doing, a screen might be used to exclude the highest emitters of greenhouse gases from a portfolio (negative screening) or to target only the lowest emitters (positive screening). "Shariah and ESG both promote ethical considerations and social responsibility due to the selection criteria for their underlying investments," justified RHB Investment Bank's regional head of research Alexander Chia in a recent market strategy note. "For example, Shariah principles call for justice, empowerment for all stakeholders, ethical practices and social responsibilities – the same philosophies at the centre of ESG investing." As such, investors who are concerned about ESG factors in their investments can consider Shariah funds as an alternative considering such funds can also be classified as ESG-based investments. "Inversely, enforcing ESG values within the practices of Shariah investments will motivate investors to not only deliberate on the Shariah principles, but also question the purposes and impacts of the business on society and the environment," opined Chia.

When comparing both investing methodologies, ESG investing tends to be a broad approach where there are no widely accepted guidelines while Shariah investing is clearly defined and regulated with clear guidelines based on acknowledged Shariah principles. "This is due to the relative maturity of Islamic finance development as compared to the more recent emergence of ESG integration in investing," Chia pointed out. Zooming into the future, RHB Research foresees that Shariah investing will not merely consider compliance alone but will go beyond – taking into account social and environmental impacts in order to contribute to the community as a whole. "It should no longer be viewed from an Islamic legal perspective alone as Shariah makes no distinction between legal imperatives and moral obligations," envisages Chia. "A good starting point is Bursa Malaysia's recently launched FTSE4Good Bursa Malaysia Shariah Index which will meet the investment community's sustainable and Shariah-compliant investment needs."

Bright prospects

Globally, demand to invest in funds which focus on ESG factors accelerated in 2020, driving assets under management up 29% in 4Q 2020 to nearly US\$1.7 trillion, according to industry tracker Morningstar. Inflows into sustainable funds also hit a record high during the same period, up 88% to US\$152.3 billion with Europe-domiciled funds accounting for almost 80% of the total inflows. According to Eastspring Al-Wara Malaysia's head of investments Tan Ming Han, there are currently

a total 22 ESG funds with 12 Islamic funds focused on ESG. As of end-December 2020, Islamic ESG funds make up about RM2.1 billion or 1% of the total Shariah assets under management of RM216.8 billion in Malaysia. "Going forward, the demand for Islamic ESG funds is expected to increase from both retail and institutional investors," projected Tan. "Institutional investors such as the Employee Provident Fund (EPF) have announced their commitment towards ESG best practices. The pension fund became a United Nations Principles for Responsible Investment (UN PRI) signatory in 2019." In fact, EPF is expected to announce a sector-specific sustainability policy framework by end-2021 as part of its guidance for future investments that will comply with ESG practices. Its chief investment officer Rohaya Mohammad Yusof said a lot of investors are now looking at integrating ESG into their investment making decisions, and that ESG practices as well as sustainability have become extremely important in mitigating risk and value enhancement. "We have identified three important sectors in Malaysia and come up with sectoral policies as well as issue policies, and one of the key issues is climate change," she told a recent panel session on "How Malaysia has Developed an Equity Market that Emphasises Sustainability" at the virtually-staged Sustainable Finance Week held in conjunction with Malaysia's participation at the Expo 2020 Dubai.

Malaysia's first ESG index also known as FTSE4Good Bursa Malaysia index has outperformed both the FBM EMAS index and FBM KLCI index but came in second to the FBM EMAS Shariah index, suggesting that the combination of both ESG screening side-by-side and a Shariah overlay can offer attractive sustainable returns over time.

Formulating the right combo

In 1996, the Malaysian Government established a Shariah Advisory Council (SAC) as part of its overall initiative to develop an Islamic banking and finance industry in the country. The primary task of the council is to advise the Securities Commission (SC) on all matters related to the development of the Islamic capital market as well as to function as a reference body for Shariah-related issues. Given the growing importance of Islamic and ESG policy, Eastspring's Tan expects further cooperation and education between regulators and investment professionals which will lead to policies and initiatives such as promoting transparency and disclosure from investors, fund managers and companies on integrating ESG issues. "Fiscal incentives to improve the practice plus adoption of sustainable standards for corporations and integrating Islamic principles into ESG policies would facilitate greater adoption," he reckoned. "Both Shariah and ESG investing are becoming popular. Both Muslim and non-Muslim investors are placing increasing emphasis on the impact of climate change on their portfolios and allocating their portfolios accordingly."

As such, potential investors should consider the fact that Islamic principles combined with ESG investing offers competitive risk-adjusted returns across multiple time periods. This supports the belief that it is possible to do well while doing good.
