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BNM evaluating potential of central bank digital currency

According to Deputy Finance Minister I Datuk Mohd Shahar Abdullah, Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) is actively evaluating the potential of a central bank digital currency (CBDC) driven by the growing technology and payment landscape. He was speaking during a winding-up debate on the motion of thanks for the Royal Address for his ministry in the Dewan Negara. The CBDC is different from a cryptocurrency in that the former would be a digital currency issued by the central bank to achieve public policy objectives, such as increasing efficiencies of cross-border payments and progressing financial inclusion. As an example, BNM has recently cooperated with the central banks of Australia, Singapore and South Africa through the Dunbar project to develop a shared platform prototype which enables international settlements using various CBDCs by reducing dependency on intermediaries. This prototype platform has the potential to reduce the cost and time taken to carry out cross-border transactions. The outcome of the project would be used by BNM and the other central banks to develop a more efficient next-generation payment infrastructure. In line with the government's stand, cryptocurrencies such as Bitcoin are not suitable for use as payment instruments due to various obstacles, including price fluctuations, exposure to cyberthreats, lack of scalability and negative impact on the environment. Hence, such currencies are not recognised as legal tenders in Malaysia.

Sustainability theme key to recovery, ESG a driving force for upcycle phase – CGS-CIMB Research

According to CGS-CIMB Research, a new recovery theme for the local construction sector could likely come from sustainability practices. The rising adoption of sustainable construction will emerge as a longer-term sector recovery theme. This will happen on the back of new macro policy measures and the reactivation of the RM31bil MRT 3 project. These would mitigate short-to-medium term sector risks, such as weak visibility in other new mega jobs, limitations in the government's fiscal space and uncertainties surrounding mega contracts due to the political landscape. Malaysia's construction sector has been one of the biggest casualties of the Covid-19 pandemic, with much work and projects experiencing severe slowdowns or even coming to a complete halt as a result of the movement control orders and stringent standard operating procedures. The industry is now struggling to get back on its feet as new jobs dry up largely due to cutbacks in government spending. A sustainability theme may provide better

visibility and an alternative view in terms of resetting the government's strategy in rolling out new contracts and better positioning for contractors in tendering for upcoming new mega projects. It will also provide investors with a better perspective on the potential longer-term winners and beneficiaries of the rollout of new contracts that are more aligned to the sustainability agenda. While historically sector-wide sustainability strategies and plans were somewhat fragmented, the government has placed greater emphasis on the domestic construction sector's pathway to higher sustainability standards, as seen in the 12th Malaysia Plan (12MP). These sustainability initiatives will cause Malaysia's construction industry to enter into a "transformation phase" this year as the research house was seeing a shift towards climate action and sustainable mega projects. Water, flood mitigation and transport projects are key potential beneficiaries of this theme, which bodes well for Gamuda Bhd, IJM Corp Bhd and HSS Engineers Bhd. The construction sector accounts for 6% of global gross domestic product which implies that development activities will always be an integral part of economic activity and growth. This is particularly so for developing countries like Malaysia. Also the construction sector is the largest global consumer of building materials and accounts for 25% to 40% of global carbon emissions. This directly relates to the building material supply chain and the manner in which main building materials are produced. Cement and steel historically make up 30% to 40% of total construction input. Construction activities have been linked to up to 50% of climate change, 40% of global energy usage and 50% of landfill waste. This also extends to air, water and noise pollution and the destruction of natural habitats. The research house's assessment of the sustainability theme on the overall local construction sector's environmental, social and governance (ESG) spectrum points to opportunities to further transform and revamp the sector in its post-Covid-19 pandemic recovery phase in 2022 and potentially back to its upcycle phase over the longer-run. If policy and implementation of the various sustainability initiatives under the 12MP and the National Construction Policy 2030 gain greater traction in the later part of the 12MP period (2021 to 2025). This, and with proper planning and execution, could translate into several positives, mainly a revival in private and public sector job flows coupled with the emergence of new infrastructure project proposals beyond the legacy contracts. Other positives include a revisit of other legacy mega developments such as the estimated RM50bil to RM100bil

gross development value Bandar Malaysia, the emergence of new growth areas such as those proposed under the RM5bil Penang South Islands project and the rollout of backlog water infrastructure projects. Issues like labour shortage and a continuous rise in raw material prices will continue to impact earnings for some time.

Malaysia needs underlying structural economic transformation to boost productivity – World Bank

According to World Bank's East Asia and Pacific regional vice president Manuela V Ferro, Malaysia needs an underlying structural economic transformation to increase productivity growth. While the country has done relatively well compared to its regional peers, it has lagged its global aspirational peers that have nearly three times the productivity levels. Further, there are significant variations in productivity levels among firms within Malaysia. Pre-pandemic estimates suggest that smaller firms generally lag significantly behind their larger counterparts. Firms in the top 25% of the productivity distribution are nearly 12 times more productive than those in the bottom 25%. The pandemic has further exacerbated these differences. In recent years, spending on research and development (R&D) activities in Malaysia has decreased after a steady increase until 2016. Gross public expenditure on R&D has dropped from 1.4% of gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016 to 1.0% of GDP in 2018. This falls short of Malaysia's envisaged goal of 2.0% of GDP and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) average of 2.6%. The World Bank also found that Malaysian firms are also less likely to spend on R&D compared to their regional peers. Its engagement with the government has provided opportunities to look at relevant policy areas to assist in charting a path forward. One aspect of this which it focussed on in its recent work relates to increasing small and medium enterprises' (SMEs) contribution to Malaysia's economic growth. Based on analysis undertaken in the 'SME Program Review', Malaysia could consider realigning its public support for SMEs to not only enable a private sector-led

recovery from the pandemic but also support firm-level innovation. Another World Bank study titled 'Assessment of the Malaysian Start-Up Financing Ecosystem' revealed that Malaysia's venture capital activities are relatively low compared to the region, in relation to its level of economic development. Thus funding activities are performing below potential, affecting investible deal flow down the line. As public support is concentrated on the more advanced stages of innovative activities, she called for a possible need to rebalance this to earlier and hence the riskier stages of the innovation cycle. Meanwhile, the assessments on the effectiveness of public research institutions found that while the linkages between academia and industry have increased over time, it broadly remains weak, hence affecting commercialisation of research outputs. It has been encouraging to see that in response to the report's recommendations, the government established a Research Management Unit to reorient its technology transfer and commercialisation programmes to be more responsive to industry needs. Based on the reports, the World Bank recommended the government to enhance evidence-based policymaking for SME development by increasing monitoring and evaluation of government programmes and coordination among agencies, to recalibrate SME programmes to support needs on digitalisation and skills upgrading, and to rebalance the policy mix towards the ideation stage with programmes that crowd in private investments.


SC registers two initial exchange offering operators

The Securities Commission Malaysia (SC) has registered two initial exchange offering (IEO) operators to promote responsible innovation in the digital space. The two IEO operators are Kapital DX Sdn Bhd and Pitch Platforms Sdn Bhd. The registered IEO operators will provide an alternative avenue for eligible companies to raise funds via the issuance of digital tokens in Malaysia. An issuer may raise funds up to RM100 million from retail, sophisticated, as well as angel investors, subject to the investment limits provided in

the SC's Guidelines on Digital Assets. These new operators will be required to carry out the necessary assessments, among others, to verify the issuer's digital value proposition, review the issuer's proposal and disclosures in its whitepaper, and undertake a comprehensive due diligence on the issuer and its token offering, prior to hosting the issuer's digital token on their platform. In addition, they will be given up to nine months to comply with all the regulatory requirements before commencing operations, and these include putting in place a robust and effective Anti-Money Laundering/Combating the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) process to mitigate Money Laundering and Terrorism Financing (ML/TF) risks. Furthermore, the SC reminded members of the public that they are not permitted to offer, issue or distribute any digital assets — which have been prescribed as securities in Malaysia — without obtaining a registration or authorisation from the SC. In this regard, a person convicted may be liable to a fine not exceeding RM10 million or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years or both. Members of the public are also advised to be mindful of the risks related to investing in digital assets, including risks of investing on platforms not registered with the SC.

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Markets

As the Russia-Ukraine conflict rages on, it was the Federal Reserve Chair, Jerome Powell, who took the limelight for the week as a more hawkish comment in relation to the future rate hikes saw investors turning cautious. With the short end yields continuing to rise, yield spreads narrowed with the 10s5s in inversion – a sign that investors expect a slower growth ahead with the likelihood of recession rising, while the 30s5s are now at their smallest yield spread since 2007. With Russia stepping up its game plan on the war in Ukraine, this time using the Ruble as a requirement for its oil and gas exports, energy and other commodities prices resumed their upward trajectory with Brent oil last seen at US\$121.54 per barrel.

Locally and over the last weekend, the government announced plans to raise the current minimum wage of RM1,200 to RM1,500 per month effective May 1, 2022. However, at the same time, the government is reportedly considering allowing some micro-businesses as well as small and medium enterprises (SMEs) to defer increasing the new wage structure. Separately, the Ministry of Communication and Multimedia has proposed to the government to recognize digital currencies such as cryptocurrencies to be adopted as legal tender. However, according to Deputy Finance Minister I, Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) is actively evaluating the potential of a Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC), which is also driven by improvements seen in the technology and payment gateway field. He further added that cryptocurrencies such as Bitcoin are not suitable for use as payment instruments due to various obstacles, including price fluctuations, exposure to cyber threats, lack of scalability, and negative impact on the environment. Meanwhile, in a related development, the Securities Commission (SC) announced the registration of two Initial Exchange Operators (IEO), Kapital DX Sdn Bhd and Pitch Platforms Sdn Bhd, to provide a platform for companies to raise funds via digital tokens.

Economy

The US February Existing Home Sales came in below market expectations at just 6.02mil annualized rate, down 7.2% m-o-m against consensus expectations of a 6.1mil. Coming in below expectations was also the February New Home Sales, which fell by 2% to 772,000 and against the market forecast of a rise to 810,000 from the revised 788,000 in January. Out of Europe, the S&P Global Flash Eurozone Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for March eased to 54.5 from the February print of 55.5, while the Flash Eurozone Manufacturing PMI dropped to 57.0 in March from the 58.2 reading in the preceding month.

Meanwhile, the People's Bank of China (PBoC) left its key 1-year Loan Prime Rate (LPR) and the 5-year LPR unchanged at 3.7% and 4.65% respectively. In other news, the UK inflation data came in ahead of expectations as the February Consumer Price Index (CPI) surged to 6.2% y-o-y, which was higher than market expectations of a 6% rise and the preceding month's print of 5.5%. The Producer Price Index (PPI) too, rose steeply, rising to 10.1% y-o-y and a tad below market expectations of a 10.2% increase.

Down south, Singapore's CPI for February sustained its upward trajectory as headline inflation rose to 4.3% y-o-y. However, the core inflation reading eased to register a growth of 2.2% y-o-y against a 2.4% increase in January.

Locally, the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) expects the Malaysian economy to expand by 6% this year, before slowing down to 5.5% in 2023. Malaysia's February trade data came in slightly below expectations as both exports and import growth slowed down to 16.8% and 18.4% y-o-y to RM102.3bil and RM82.5bil respectively. The trade surplus widened by 10.7% to RM19.8bil. For the first two months of 2022, total exports amounted to RM213.3bil, up 20.4% y-o-y, while imports surged 22.6% to RM175.0bil, giving rise to a trade balance of RM38.3bil, an increase of 11.2% y-o-y. Meanwhile, Bank Negara reported that Malaysia's International Reserves as at mid-March fell to US\$115.2bil from US\$115.8bil. In Ringgit terms, reserves stood at RM479.9bil against RM482.3bil a fortnight ago.

Corporate

Sapura Energy reported a full-year net loss of RM8.9bil for the financial period ended January 31, 2022, as it made provisions for impairment of goodwill and on property, plant, and equipment, amounting to RM3.29bil and RM2.3bil respectively. Meanwhile, IHH Healthcare is expected to increase its market presence with a conditional, non-binding indicative proposal to acquire 100% equity interest in Ramsay Sime Darby Healthcare for RM5.67bil or US\$1.35bil, free of cash and debt. Sime Darby Plantation (SDP) too was in the news this week as an Indonesian-based company, PT Asa Karya Multi Pratama (AKMP), sued the Malaysian company for Rp5.88 trillion (RM1.72bil) for failure to complete the sale of two plantation companies owned by SDP to AKMP.

In other news, TDM accepted an offer from Ikkhasas CPO to acquire two of its loss-making Indonesian plantation for RM115mil cash. Press Metal Aluminium Holdings too was in the news this week as it proposed to make a private placement involving 163.4mil new shares, which is expected to raise some RM1bil in equity. Meanwhile, Berjaya Corporation announced the surprise departure of its Group Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Abdul Jalil Abdul Rasheed, and in place, two internal promotions were made

where the company will now be run by them as joint Group CEOs.

A consortium comprising Ancom, Nylex, LBS Bina, Sinar Bina Infra, and Thailand's BTS Group Holdings intends to undertake a Light Rail Transit (LRT) project for Johor Bahru, subject to a feasibility study being conducted and subsequent award of a project concession by the state government.

Equity

Global markets were generally mixed to firmer the past week as investors poured monies back into the market after the recent selling pressure, especially on the battered technology sector while some global tech giants rallied on the news of fresh buy-backs. Markets that rose gained between 0.5% and as much as 5.5% on the Nikkei 225 Index, while markets that fell saw losses of between 0.1% and 1.2%.

On Bursa Malaysia, the benchmark 30-stock index closed firmer for the week in review on the back of renewed buying interest, especially among plantation and technology stocks. The KLCI added 8.09 pts or 0.5% higher to close at 1,598.97 pts.

For the week ended March 24, foreigners sustained their net buying interest but with a lower net inflow of RM527.5mil. Retail market participants and local institutions continue to be net sellers with outflows of RM117.5mil and RM410mil respectively.

Eye on Week Ahead

Later today, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the February CPI print, which the market will be watching as far as the pace of core inflation is rising, as January saw the key barometer rising by 1.6% y-o-y.

Next week, on Thursday, the official Chinese Manufacturing and Non-Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for March will be out, with the market looking at a mixed picture with the former easing to 49.8 from 50.2, but the latter rising to 53.2 from 51.6. On the same day, the US will be releasing the February headline and core Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) data, which is expected to hit 6.7% and 5.1% respectively.

Locally, the PPI-Local Production for February is due on Tuesday, March 29. It is also a big week for the local financial market as Bank Negara will be releasing its 2021 Annual Report and along with it, the Economic & Monetary Review 2021 as well as the Financial Stability Review for 2H of 2021. These reports will be released on Wednesday, March 30. Bank Negara is also expected to announce the five digital bank license winners from the 29 that had submitted their bids, while the usual month-end banking statistics and detailed disclosure of the central bank's international reserves will be released the next day, Thursday, March 31.

From gender equality in boardrooms to gender equality in equity market

With Malaysia's Top 100 public listed companies (PLCs) inching closer to the benchmark 30% figure for women's boardroom representation (currently at 26.5%), the focus is gradually shifting to propelling gender diversity in the equities market. Recently, Bursa Malaysia revealed that Malaysian women are increasingly engaged in investing activities, accounting for 36% of new Central Depository System (CDS) accounts opened year-to-date, up from 34% in 2021 and 32% in 2020. In addition, female investors made up close to 30% of the total traded value in 2021 with a 178.4% increase in total traded value and a 194.1% increase in total traded volume between 2018 and 2021. Notwithstanding the encouraging findings, Bursa Malaysia Berhad chief executive officer Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift said there is still much work to be done to improve financial awareness and participation in investing activities among women. The bourse would continue to advance the gender equality practices to closing the gender investing gap. This includes providing both men and women equal access to investment opportunities available in the equities market.

Better investment return among female investors

Numerous studies have found that women investors tend to deliver better investment returns as compared to men. For instance, the Fidelity Investments' 2021 Women and Investing Study found that despite their lacking confidence, women's investment portfolios tend to outperform their male counterparts. On average, female investors achieved positive returns and surpassed men by 40 basis points or 0.4%, an analysis of annual performance across 5.2 million accounts from January 2011 to December 2020 shows. This study is also aligned with Fidelity's past research showing women may outshine men with a buy-and-hold investing strategy versus frequent trading, which tends to stunt investment performance. Women have also made strides beyond retirement accounts with two-thirds now investing extra savings outside of emergency funds, a 50% increase since 2018, the findings show. In another survey dated March 2021 by ET Money, women investors were found to have generated better returns than men every year from 2017 to 2020. In fact, during the pandemic in 2020, they recorded 14% returns while men generated only 11%. Another study by Warwick Business School in 2018 found that among 2,800 investors in its study, not only did the female investors outperform the FTSE 100 over the last three

years but they also outshone their male counterparts.

While annual returns on investments for men were on average a marginal 0.14% above the performance of the FTSE 100, annual returns on the investment portfolios held by women were 1.94% above it. This means returns for women investing outperformed men by 1.8%. In another classic research entitled "Boys Will Be Boys: Gender, Overconfidence and Common Stock Investment" which was published in 2001, men's tendency to be more psychologically overconfident regarding investments compared to women has put them at a disadvantage. The theory suggests that over-confidence in financial acumen leads to more trading and changing of investments which in turn leads to lower returns. Studies also revealed that female investors focus on longer-term as well as non-monetary goals by keeping the "bigger picture" in mind. Instead of simply viewing money as a mean to purchase something, women view money as a representation of something more, i.e., independence and financial security. Additionally, they are more likely to ask for guidance and direction, thus enabling a more educated and balanced approach to investing.

Inherent investing abilities

In fact, specific behavioural and psychological traits have given women an outperformance edge over men in the realm of investing. Compared to their male counterparts, women are more risk-averse, trade less often, research more diligently, are more disciplined and less over-confident. The repercussions are also lesser as they tread with caution, investing more in mutual funds rather than stocks; remain invested for the long term without frequent trades and switches; and are disciplined about their asset allocations without any impulsive decisions or knee-jerk reactions. That women not only have an outcome-based approach to investing but also take a longer-term view doubles their chances of making it to the finish line with the fruits of their investment tightly secured. Unlike men, women are more focused on the financial goal and not on the mere thrill of investing – they invest in a manner that helps them achieve goals in the given time. The bottom line is that financial empowerment is one of the most important reasons why women should start investing. Financial literacy and awareness not only help secure their financial futures but also that of their family without having to feel lost due to their ignorance or be forced to depend on others for financial guidance when disaster strikes.



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


