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# MALAYSIA'S ECONOMIC RECOVERY ON TRACK BUT RISKS ABOUND – SERC

According to Socio Economic Research Centre Malaysia (SERC) executive director Lee Heng Guie, Malaysia's economic recovery remains on track with a 5.2% growth forecast, but it could be dampened by prolonged supply chain disruption, persistent high inflation, and sharp slowdown in China with global stagflation pressures now a serious risk. The supply chain disruption is worsened by Russia's invasion of Ukraine, which has induced massive negative supply and price shocks. Persistent high inflation and high oil price shock represent a double blow to the world economy that could impact growth momentum. The sharp slowdown in China and the lockdown in its major cities could have further impact on the regional supply chain and hence on Malaysia. He was speaking during SERC's first-quarter 2022 (Q1'22) economy tracker briefing. The country's economic recovery rides on the back of a stronger revival in domestic demand and a rebound in the services and the construction sectors. Services such as tourism, retail, transport, and aviation will see faster growth (6.1%) on border reopening and pent-up demand amid increased operating costs and other risks including climate change, stagflation and geopolitical tension. The construction sector is estimated to see 6.5% growth due to ongoing large infrastructure projects and small-scale projects. Private consumption is estimated to see a 6.5% growth due to Employee Provident Fund withdrawals as well as a recovery in income and employment, but inflation and living cost concerns will dampen consumer sentiment. The labour market is gradually recovering with the unemployment rate in February 2022 at 4.2% compared with 5.3% in May 2020. Private investment (5.0% growth) continues to remain in cautious mode while public investment is forecast to see 9.4% growth. Exports are estimated to grow moderately

(4.4%) on continued external demand from key trade partners, strong global demand for electrical and electronic products and improvement in commodity production. However, external demand will slow if the global economy tanks, with higher freight and container rate and logistic costs, supply chain disruptions, as well as workers' shortage and higher cost of doing business. Imports are estimated to expand at a 4.9% rate on the continued expansion of manufactured exports and improved domestic demand. Although trade with Russia is only at 0.4% (Ukraine at 0.1%) of Malaysia's total trade, the war has caused prices of wheat, corn and chemical fertiliser to rise, which means costlier feed, fertiliser, pesticides and other raw materials. But the European Union may purchase more palm oil as a result of shortages in rapeseed and sunflower oil supply from Ukraine. Besides, Malaysia benefits from higher crude oil-related revenue, although it would be offset by bloated fuel subsidies and other subsidies. The financial market can expect volatility due to the war and the situation in the commodity market. There will be a flight to quality as investors lighten their portfolios. To reform the economy beyond the pandemic, the country must be prepared to withstand any future shocks, whether financial, economic, or non-economic. Now there's a reserve coming from oil and from commodity prices, the surplus of which should be saved for future shocks. The ringgit is also expected to remain weak for the rest of the year.

## **BANKS EXPECTED TO SEE HIGHER EARNINGS THIS YEAR – MOODY'S**

According to Moody's Investors Service, the pre-tax profitability of banks is expected to see an improvement this year on bigger net interest margins (NIMs) and lower loan-loss provisions. This is supported by an anticipated increase in interest rates in the later part of the year and quicker loan growth, which will then lend support to an increase in NIMs. Banks may continue to take precaution against potential credit losses from loans that are under the repayment assistance programme. This would see loan-loss provision declining but remaining higher than pre-pandemic levels. It expects impaired loans to increase in 2022, but only moderately because the economic recovery and continued aid from the government will support

borrowers' repayment capacity. Regulatory measures such as the targeted repayment assistance programme for vulnerable borrowers affected by the pandemic helped banks maintain stable asset quality. The asset-weighted average of the six largest Malaysian banks' impaired loan ratios decreased modestly to 1.8% as of Sept 30, 2021 from 2% a year earlier, although about 28% of total loans at the banks were under the repayment assistance scheme, some of which can become impaired. Meanwhile, an earlier announced one-off prosperity tax will see some impact to sector-wide net profitability of the banks, but its impact will be partially offset by the strong pre-tax earnings growth. It expects banks' capital ratios to be broadly stable at high levels in 2022 because internal capital generation will keep pace with increases in capital consumption due to faster loan growth. Prudent dividend policies and dividend reinvestment plans will help banks preserve capital to fund an acceleration of credit growth. The industry's common equity tier 1 ratio was at a strong level and stood at 14.6% at the end of last year. The research house is also expecting industry-wide loan growth to strengthen to 6%-7% in 2022 from 4.5% last year, supported by recovering credit demand from the retail and corporate segments. Loan growth will be supported by the country's real gross domestic product (GDP) growth, which would accelerate to around 6% in 2022 from 3.1% in 2021. It would be driven by increases in domestic consumption amid an improving labour market and export growth. The government has set its expansionary budget to RM332bil for this year from the previous year, and this will further support economic recovery. On another matter, the debt servicing capacity of corporates and households will remain strong and support banks' asset quality.

## FOREIGN INFLOWS POSITIVE - MIDF

According to MIDF Research data, the foreign inflow to Bursa Malaysia continued last week, with net buying of RM312.4mil. The positive trend was in line with Asean markets, which has continued to see net inflows albeit at a slower pace. Cumulatively for the week, Indonesia, Malaysia and Thailand registered a total net inflow of US\$421.3mil (RM1.7bil), which was slightly more than half the net inflow recorded in the previous week. On the Malaysian market, foreign investors

have been net buyers for 12 of the first 14 weeks of 2022, recording a net purchase of RM6.97bil of local equity so far this year. The most favoured sectors by foreign investors last week continued to be financial services, industrial product and services, and plantation. These saw net inflows of RM329.9mil, RM57.3mil and RM45.1mil respectively. Meanwhile, local institutions remained net sellers on Bursa Malaysia with RM303.19mil in net equities sold over the past week. Retailers also adopted a net selling position with RM9.21mil net of equities sold over the last five trading sessions. Year-to-date, local institutions are net sellers to the tune of RM7.38bil while local retailers are net buyers with a RM410mil surplus in equities. In terms of market participation, foreign investors saw a 10.39% decline in average daily traded value over the past week while local institutions and retailers saw an increase of 13.5% and 13.66% respectively.

## **MALAYSIA RECORDS HIGHEST IPO PROCEEDS AMONG ASEAN MEMBERS IN Q1 2022 - EY**

According to Ernst & Young (EY), Malaysia led other Asean countries in initial public offering (IPO) proceeds during the first quarter (Q1) of 2022 as exchanges in the bloc recorded a year-on-year (y-o-y) decline of 57 per cent in total proceeds for the period. Asean's exchanges saw a higher number of IPOs – 29 IPOs in Q1 2022 versus 22 a year earlier – but proceeds fell to US\$1 billion (RM4.23 billion) from US\$2.4 billion previously. During this quarter, the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) was most active by deal numbers (12 IPOs raising US\$219 million), while Malaysia's exchanges led by proceeds (US\$362 million via five IPOs). ET attributed the marked decline in Asean's IPO proceeds to the lack of a mega IPO being posted in Q1 2022, compared to one mega IPO a year ago.


According to Max Loh, Ernst & Young LLP's Singapore and Brunei managing partner and EY Asean IPO leader, geopolitical tensions, the ongoing Covid-19 situation, supply chain woes, tightening of monetary policy and escalating costs were a few factors weighing down economic and IPO activity in Asean. The IPO market remains receptive to quality high-growth companies, but volatility, uncertainty and valuation expectations will need to be tempered before a resurgence in IPO activity can happen. Meanwhile, the global IPO market also witnessed a

weaker performance in Q1 2022, with 321 deals raising US\$54.4 billion in proceeds – a decrease of 37 per cent and 51 per cent y-o-y, respectively. In contrast, the Asia-Pacific region surpassed its Q1 2021 IPO proceeds performance – when it raised the highest Q1 proceeds in 21 years – by recording 188 IPOs raising US\$42.7 billion (19 per cent higher proceeds) in the quarter under review. The region accounted for 78 per cent of global IPO proceeds due to the listing of four mega IPOs.

According to EY global IPO leader Paul Go, a decrease in IPO activity was not unexpected when compared with Q1 2021 as the latter was the most active quarter in the last 21 years. However, the market shock from geopolitical tensions and other economic concerns in the second half of the quarter created volatility and impacted the capital markets. The global IPO market would remain volatile in Q2 2022 amid many uncertainties, with a backlog of IPO candidates, and pipelines would continue to build up. With the prevailing headwinds arising from geopolitical tensions and conflicts, inflation and interest rate hikes, it will be imperative for IPO-bound companies to take a fresh look at how these challenges will affect their markets, customers and suppliers to their business.

## EYE ON THE MARKETS

This week, on Friday (15Apr), the Ringgit opened at 4.2335 against the USD from 4.2280 on Monday (11Apr). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1195 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (15Apr). On Monday (11Apr), the FBM KLCI opened at 1607.95. As at Friday (15Apr) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 13.27 points for the week at 1594.68. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 113.36 points (-0.33%) to 34,451.23 whilst the NASDAQ shed 292.51 points (-2.14%) to 13,351.08.

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# RISK-OFF AS BOND YIELDS GOES PARABOLIC

The most anticipated economic data this week showed no sign of slowing down as the US headline Consumer Price Index (CPI) hit 8.5% in March while core inflation surged to 6.5%. While headline inflation print came in at a higher rate than expected, the core rate was a tad below the forecast of 6.6%. The bond market, turned ugly over the past few days as investors kept repricing risk with the 10-year US bond yields surging to multi-year highs of 2.78% and the highest since January 2019. However, rates eased by late Thursday to 2.67%.

For Malaysia, the global fixed income market sell-off was also felt in Malaysia as foreigners not only turned sellers but the net fixed income outflows surged to RM4bil in March 2022, the highest in two years. In other news, the Human Resources Ministry may allow certain sectors, especially the informal sector, to be exempted from the RM1,500 minimum wage, which comes into effect on May 1, 2022.

## ECONOMY

The World Bank estimates that the Ukrainian economy will be devastated by the Russian invasion as it predicts the country's GDP to shrink as much as 45.1% this year. For Russia, the World Bank estimates the war on Ukraine will cause the

world's 11th largest economy to contract by 11.2% in 2022. In other US economic news, Retail Sales for March increased at a slower than expected pace of 0.5% compared with the preceding month, against the market's forecast of a 0.6% rise.

Out of China, the March inflation data was mixed as the headline CPI increase of 1.5% y-o-y was much quicker than anticipated and higher than the preceding two months' print of 0.9% increase, while the Producer Price Index (PPI) eased to 8.3% y-o-y from 8.8% in February, but well ahead of the market forecast of an 8.1% jump. Meanwhile, external trade data came in weaker than expected as exports registered a growth of 14.7% while imports fell by 0.1% y-o-y against a forecast of 20.5% and 17.3% y-o-y increase predicted by economists.

Meanwhile, the Philippines' external trade data for February showed growth momentum is easing as both exports and imports expanded at a slower pace of 15.0% y-o-y and 20.1% y-o-y respectively while the Reserve Bank of New Zealand and Bank of Canada raised their respective benchmark rate by 50bps each to 1.5% and 1% respectively to fend off inflationary pressure. The hike for both the central banks was the steepest in 22 years. Meanwhile, Singapore announced that it is taking steps to strengthen the Singapore Dollar as the Monetary Authority of Singapore uses the exchange rate to fend off the rising inflation threat. Singapore is not only raising the slope of appreciation of the Dollar but re-centering its policy band higher. In other rate decisions, although the European Central Bank left the key rates unchanged, it assured the market that it is ready to end its bond purchase program in the 3Q.

Out of the UK, the March headline inflation hit a three-decade high as CPI increased by 7% y-o-y. The reading was well ahead of the market forecast of a 6.7% jump and from the preceding month's print of 6.2%.

Locally, as expected, the Department of Statistics (DOSM) February 2022 labour market report showed an improvement in the unemployment rate to 4.1% from 4.2% in the preceding month. The number of unemployed persons improved by 8,600 to 671,800 from January's total of 680,400, while total employment increased by 44,800 to 15.73mil from the preceding month's total of 15.69mil persons. In other news, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) improved by 3.9% y-o-y

driven by a 5.2% y-o-y increase in the Manufacturing Index while the Electricity Index rose by 3.9% y-o-y, as the Mining Index eased by 0.4% y-o-y. Speaking of the manufacturing sector, the DOSM statistics for February Manufacturing Sales were impressive as growth of 11.2% y-o-y was achieved with total sales value reaching RM131.6bil. The two main drivers of growth were the Food, Beverage & Tobacco sub-sector, which saw an increase of 16.4% y-o-y growth, while the Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber, and Plastics sub-sector expanded by 12.6% y-o-y.

Meanwhile, Malaysia's Wholesale and Retail Trade data for February improved significantly as total sales value jumped 8.5% y-o-y to RM117.2bil. The increase was led by a 12.5% y-o-y jump in Motor Vehicle sales while the Wholesale Trade and Retail Trade data too were significantly higher, rising by 6.2% y-o-y and 10.2% y-o-y to RM55.9bil and RM48.8bil respectively. In other news, Malaysian palm oil stocks fell by 3% m-o-m to 1.473mil metric tonnes (MT) as production leapfrogged 24.1% m-o-m to 1.411mil MT while exports surged 14.1% m-o-m to 1.265mil MT. Nevertheless, the March output was lower by 0.9% y-o-y while the stock level was higher by 2% y-o-y.

## CORPORATE

Axis Real Investment Trust (REIT) agreed to acquire a logistic warehouse with a total built-up area of 1.55mil sq. ft. for RM390mil. Meanwhile, the Serba Dinamik saga saw some light with the Securities Commission (SC) issuing a compound notice of four key personnel of the company with a maximum fine of RM3mil each for submitting a false statement with regards to the company's revenue of RM6.01bil for the financial year ended December 31, 2020. In other news, the auditor for Parkson Holdings, Grant Thornton PLT, has reported a material uncertainty that may cast significant doubt on the company's ability to continue as a going concern. Grant Thornton also flagged similar concerns on Sealink International for the company's financial statement ended December 31, 2021 while the auditor for FSBM Holdings, Moore Stephens Associates PLT, has expressed a disclaimer of opinion on the company's financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2021. In other news, Telekom Malaysia has inked a RM2bil 10-year fibre leasing services agreement with Digital Nasional Bhd (DNB), which will enable the latter to provide 5G services to their customers.

## EQUITY

For the week in review, equity markets closed on a mixed note as selling pressure on the back of rising risk aversion was met with light bargain hunting activities. Markets that closed on a positive note saw gains of between 0.1% to as much as 1.5% on the Jakarta Stock Exchange Composite Index, while markets that retreated during the past week witnessed losses of between 0.3% to 2.1% on Singapore's Straits Times Index. Stocks on Bursa Malaysia closed the week relatively flat with mild selling pressure. The KLCI fell by 5.09 pts or 0.3% to close at 1,595.70 pts.

For the week ended April 14, foreign net buying interest dwindled to just RM41.4mil while retail market participants emerged as the largest group of net buyers with an inflow of RM165mil. Local institutions maintained their net selling pressure with an outflow of RM206.4mil.

## EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Locally, on Monday, April 18, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the March 2022 external trade data. On the same day, China will be releasing its 1Q GDP data, with the market expecting a growth rate of 5.3% y-o-y. China will also be releasing the March Fixed Asset Investment, Retail Sales, and Industrial Production data points. The next day, the US will see the release of data from the US housing market with data on Building Permits and Housing Starts for March. The market's attention will again switch to China on Wednesday, April 20, as the People's Bank of China (PBoC) may move the needle on the 1-year Loan Prime Rate, which was last moved down by 10bps in January 2022 to 3.7%. On the same date, data on the US Existing Home Sales too are due, with the market looking at a softer reading due to a hike in mortgage rates. The US Federal Reserve will also be releasing the Beige Book next Wednesday as the market may get a better feel of the current US economic condition.



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
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# MSWG-UKM RESEARCH: ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT BECKONS FOR AGM CONDUCT BY PLCs

**A**n effective two-way communication between public listed companies (PLCs) and their shareholders is essential to create a transparent environment for businesses to thrive. In fact, the board of PLCs should ensure effective, transparent, and regular communication with its stakeholders. Such communication or interaction channel allows stakeholders to communicate their views, feedback or complaints appropriately. Principle C of the Malaysian Code on Corporate Governance (MCCG) 2021 highlights that a company should have an ongoing engagement and communication with stakeholders to facilitate mutual understanding of objectives and expectations. Such engagement allows stakeholders to be aware of the company's business, its policies on governance, the environment, and its social responsibility.

For minority shareholders, the annual general meeting (AGM) is one of the best platforms for them to raise their concerns or to channel the grouses that they have in relation to PLCs that they have invested in. Concerned stakeholders

should therefore prepare themselves by getting to know issues related to the company's appointment or re-appointment of directors and remuneration policy. In addition, they should also peruse the annual report, the adoption of corporate governance best practices and sustainability/ESG best practices, the external audit report, risk management and internal audit issues, and anti-corruption policies and practices. Moreover, stakeholders, especially minority shareholders, can play their role to query the board during AGMs if they are dissatisfied with the company's governance and performance, or rather, the non-performance. On their part, board members of PLCs and the respective board sub-committees cannot simply ignore issues raised by shareholders, especially minority shareholders.

MCCG 2021 further highlights that the board must ensure that shareholders are able to participate in all sessions and engage with them throughout the meeting. Companies may provide better facilities such as new technology for virtual communication, multimedia presentation, and better cyber-hygiene at general meetings. The actual practice, however, is far from perfect as evident from the findings of our recent study entitled Report on 2020 Annual General Meeting of Public Listed Companies. This research was jointly undertaken by MSWG and the Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia's Centre for Governance Resilience and Accountability Studies.

Some concerns on the current AGM practices relating to three areas were highlighted in this report, namely:

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS (Q&A)**

The MSWG-UKM study highlighted the importance of allowing both the (i) calling for questions from shareholders prior to the AGM; and (ii) allowing of sufficient time to take questions during the AGM.

In this regard, it is inevitable that the presentation made by the management and questions posed by shareholders, and the answers provided during the meeting, could trigger additional questions from shareholders. Secondly, companies can consider using virtual platforms available in the market such as Zoom, Webex or Microsoft Teams with a

chat function as an engagement platform.

Companies should respond to the Q&A – either posted by the shareholders or MSWG before or during the AGMs. Better PLCs can choose to adopt the practice of uploading Q&A transcripts of all submitted questions and their responses onto their respective corporate websites following the conclusion of their AGMs (not later than 30 days after the AGM). This initiative to respond indicates that the board values shareholders' questions and comments on the company's performance. In fact, companies should provide enough time for shareholders to submit questions to ensure active participation by shareholders. It is acknowledged that some companies group the questions received from shareholders if they are alike in nature. However, the grouping method may lead to the overlooking of some questions. Therefore, if a company is considering the grouping approach, it should be made clear in advance with reasons for this approach – which normally is to save time and avoid repetitive questions.

## **BOARD ATTENDANCE**

Principle A of the MCCG 2021 indicates that the board is collectively responsible for the long-term success of a company and the delivery of sustainable value to its stakeholders. It boils down to the Chairman of the board who is responsible for instilling good corporate governance practices, leadership and effectiveness in meeting the company's goals and objectives. Given that the board's engagement with the shareholders is important, the Chairman must ensure that all board members are present at the AGM so that all questions raised by the shareholders can be answered during the AGM itself as some of the other directors may be in a better position to address the shareholders queries.

## **ROLE OF CHAIRMAN AT AGM**

The Chairman should play an exemplary role on all occasions during the AGM. Thus, it is important for the Chairman to chair the AGM as required by the Companies Act 2016 and take responsibility for

all strategic matters presented and discussed in the meeting. The Chairman should also be seen as a person of high integrity. Therefore, he/she should not be allowed to propose his/her own re-election or re-appointment or even propose any resolutions in which he/she has an interest in.

## OF PHYSICAL, VIRTUAL, HYBRID AGMS

Following the advent of the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak in 2020, the MSWG-UKM findings reveals that out of 280 PLCs assessed, 67.5% (n=189) had fully virtual meetings whereas 32.5% (n=91) had physical meetings. These physical meetings were held in Penang, Klang Valley, Johor, Perak, Melaka, Negeri Sembilan and Sarawak. Fully virtual meetings are general meetings that are conducted online without a physical venue. The only venue involved in the conduct of a fully virtual general meeting is the broadcast venue where only the essential individuals are physically present. The essential individuals would include the chairperson of the general meeting, board members, the CEO, the chief financial officer, the company secretary, the auditor, the scrutineer, and those providing audio and visual support for the meeting. All shareholders in a fully virtual general meeting participate in the meeting remotely.

It is also worthwhile noting that the advocated best practice in the MCCG is a hybrid general meeting. This is conducted at a physical meeting venue with shareholders physically present while at the same time it is also broadcast virtually for the benefit of shareholders who prefer to attend and vote at the meeting remotely.



### Volume Distribution Chart


