

# BETTER RISK-REWARD IN SMALL AND MID-CAPS – RHB RESEARCH



According to RHB Research analyst Lee Meng Horng, it is time to be nimble in small and mid-caps on Bursa Malaysia given the better risk-reward ratio on current forward price to earnings (P/E). Both the FBM 70 and FBM SC are trading below their five-year means, and at about two times P/E discounts to that of the FBM KLCI – based on RHB’s stock coverage universe. In addition, the valuation of the MSCI Malaysia Small Cap Index is on par with the MSCI benchmark index, reversing the trend of the outperformance of small-cap indices in the past two years. This came as investors refocused on value-oriented big caps amid rising interest rates and greater market volatility. It is time to go long in this current sell-down with the expectation of a range-bound market amid a volatile backdrop and below-mean valuation. The investor’s strategy should be two-pronged – rotational play on sectors and bottom-up stock-picking – while continuing to look for ideas based on unique turnarounds, event-driven catalysts, exporters and politically linked thematic plays. The research house has a preference for the consumer discretionary, technology, logistics, oil and gas, and plantation sectors. The outperformance of the FBM SC (+5.3% year to date) continues in 2022, despite the market being range-bound overall in the absence of major positive catalysts, while uncertainties from external events linger. The FBM SC’s stronger performance has been underpinned by commodity-related stocks that benefited from the surge in various commodity prices. On the other hand, the FBM 70 (-5.8% year

to date) has underperformed the FBM KLCI (-0.2% year to date) so far this year, as heavyweights that consist of mainly technology sector-related stocks took a beating amid high inflation and rising interest rates. The return of foreign fund inflows has supported the FBM KLCI so far, thanks to the Malaysian market's defensive attributes, while the spike in commodity prices has been a boon. The market liquidity has declined, with the cautious tone from local institutions and a lack of participation from retail investors – further exacerbated by the risk-averse sentiment casting a further pall on the market. These factors were partially cushioned by the return of foreign fund inflows. Compounded by the resumption of intra-day short selling (IDSS), the market has witnessed a rather volatile market in the first quarter of 2022, especially for the small-mid cap space. In fact, year-to-date traded value for the FBM 70 and FBM SC declined by 32% and 61% respectively. Against the backdrop of a full-blown economic recovery in 2022, and supported by in-house gross domestic product (GDP) growth forecast of 5.5% year on year, certainly there are companies that are expected to perform well and record growth. However market volatility is expected to remain high for a large part of 2022, no thanks to the fluid situation and prevailing uncertainties. The upside is capped, as the expectation of a broad-based economic recovery seems priced in, while the downside continues to be supported by bottom-fishing activities. A 'buy' at the support level and 'sell' at the resistance level approach could thrive.

### **BNM RAISES OPR TO 2% FROM RECORD LOW OF 1.75%**


Bank Negara Malaysia's (BNM) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) on Wednesday (May 11) increased the overnight policy rate (OPR) by 25 basis points to 2% from a record low of 1.75% as global inflationary pressures have increased sharply and after taking into account that the sustained reopening of global economy and improvement in labour markets continue to support the recovery of economic activity from the impact of Covid-19-driven movement restrictions. The ceiling and floor rates of the OPR's corridor are correspondingly increased to 2.25%

and 1.75% respectively. Inflationary pressures have increased sharply due to a rise in commodity prices, strained supply chains and strong demand conditions, particularly in the US. For the Malaysian economy, latest indicators show that growth is on a firmer footing, driven by strengthening domestic demand amid sustained export growth. The OPR at 1.75% was the lowest dating back to 2004. The sustained reopening of the global economy and improvement in labour market conditions continue to support the recovery of economic activity. The global growth outlook will continue to be affected by the developments surrounding the conflict in Ukraine, Covid-19, global supply chain conditions, commodity price shocks, and financial market volatility. On the Malaysian economy, the latest indicators show that the country's economic growth is on a firmer footing, driven by strengthening domestic demand amid sustained export growth. The labour market is further lifted by a lower unemployment rate, higher labour participation and better income prospects. The transition to endemicity on April 1, 2022 is expected to strengthen economic activity, in line with further easing of restrictions and the reopening of international borders. Investment activity and prospects have also improved, underpinned by the realisation of multi-year projects and positive growth outlook. However, risks to growth remain, which include a weaker-than-expected global growth, further escalation of geopolitical conflicts, worsening supply chain disruptions, and adverse developments surrounding Covid-19. Malaysia's headline inflation, as measured by the consumer price index, is projected to average between 2.2% and 3.2% in 2022. Given the improvement in economic activity amid lingering cost pressures, the country's underlying inflation, as measured by core inflation, is expected to trend higher to average between 2% and 3% in 2022. Nevertheless, upward pressure on prices would be partly contained by existing price controls and the continued spare capacity in the economy. The inflation outlook continues to be subject to global commodity price developments, arising mainly from the ongoing military conflict in Ukraine and prolonged supply-related disruptions, as well as domestic policy measures on administered prices. Looking back over the course of the Covid-19 crisis, the OPR was reduced by

a cumulative 125 basis points to a historic low of 1.75% to provide support to the Malaysian economy. The unprecedented conditions that necessitated such monetary actions have since abated. With the domestic [economic] growth on a firmer footing, the MPC decided to begin reducing the degree of monetary accommodation. This will be done in a measured and gradual manner, ensuring that monetary policy remains accommodative to support a sustainable economic growth in an environment of price stability.

## EYE ON THE MARKETS

This week, on Friday (13May), the Ringgit opened at 4.3930 against the USD from 4.3760 on Monday (9May). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1476 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (13May). On Monday (9May), the FBM KLCI opened at 1563.80. As at Friday (13May) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 19.22 points for the week at 1544.58. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 103.81 points (-0.33%) to 31,730.30 whilst the NASDAQ added 6.73 points (+0.06%) to 11,370.96.

# A BRUTAL WEEK AS REALITY BITES

**T**he era of low-interest rates and benign inflation prints has indeed come to an end as even Bank Negara, which is always seen to take an accommodative stance as well as one that supports the economic growth, decided to move the needle and join other central banks globally in raising the Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) to 2.00% from 1.75%. The surprise move was seen as the central bank's decision to stay ahead of the curve and at the same time to help limit the weakness of the Ringgit, which has dropped some 5.5% year-to-date to 4.3940 to the Dollar. Meanwhile, Malaysia's international reserves recorded a steep decline of US\$1.9bil or RM8.25bil to US\$112.5bil at the end of April 2022 as compared with US\$114.4bil as at April 15, 2022. In Ringgit terms, the reserves dropped from RM480.85bil to RM472.6bil.

Even the US Federal Reserve recognized the changing financial landscape when it warned of the deteriorating liquidity conditions across key financial markets not only due to the current high global inflationary pressure but also stemming from the Russia-Ukraine war and monetary tightening moves by major central banks. Markets tumbled as investors see persistent inflationary pressure while sell-off in the tech sector, newly

listed start-ups, and cryptocurrencies, sent shivers across the globe while Dollar bulls sent the greenback to fresh 20-year highs.

## ECONOMY

Out of the US, the April jobs data was mixed as Non-Farm Payrolls came in at 428,000 and well above expectations of a 380,000 print. However, the unemployment rate held steady at 3.6% and missed the market estimate of a drop to 3.5%. Average Hourly Earnings rose by 5.5% y-o-y, which suggests that the US labour market remains tight. The much-awaited Consumer Price Index (CPI) prints for April saw headline and core inflation rising by 8.3% and 6.2% respectively. Although the readings were below the preceding month's pace of 8.5% and 6.5%, both the data came in much faster than the market forecast of an 8.1% and 6.0% jump respectively.

Meanwhile, the impact of China's battle against the resurgence in the number of Covid-19 cases showed in the external trade data released this week as exports growth slowed to just 3.6% y-o-y, against a y-o-y growth of 14.7% in March, while imports were unchanged y-o-y. Other data from China too are now beginning to show weakness as new home sales in 23 major cities fell by 33% y-o-y while new car sales tumbled 35.7% y-o-y in April due to restricted movements, which curtailed output and buyers' interest. Despite the softness in economic data points, China's inflation prints remain elevated as the headline CPI and Producer Price Index (PPI) surged to 2.1% and 8.0% in April from the 1.8% and 7.8% forecasted by the market.

In GDP data released this week, Indonesia's 1Q 2022 GDP of 5.01% y-o-y was within market expectations of a 5.00% print and just a tad slower than the preceding quarter's growth of 5.02%. The Philippines too saw a robust 1Q 2022 GDP data as the economy expanded 8.3% y-o-y, well ahead of the market forecast of a 6.8% jump. Meanwhile, Thailand and the Philippines had mixed inflation prints for April as the former saw headline inflation ease to 4.6% y-o-y from the preceding month's 5.7% pace, but the latter experienced a sharper reading of 4.9% y-o-y against the 4% in March.

Locally, the March labour market indicators continued to show strength as the number of employed persons increased by 38,500 to 15.77mil while the number of unemployed persons improved by another 2,600 to 669,200. Malaysia's unemployment rate held steady at 4.1%. Meanwhile, the March Manufacturing Sales jumped 13.9% y-o-y to RM144.6bil, driven by a 25.9% y-o-y surge in sales of Electrical and Electronic products and a 14.4% y-o-y increase in sales of Food, Beverage, and Tobacco sub-sector. Wholesale and Retail Trade too was firm, rising by 9.8% y-o-y to RM123.8bil, led by an 11.1% y-o-y rise in Motor Vehicle sales to RM16.7bil, and a 10.8% y-o-y rise in Retail Trade to RM49.9bil. Wholesale Trade improved 8.6% y-o-y to RM57.2bil.

In other news, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) for March saw a decent growth of 5.1% y-o-y, driven by a 6.9% y-o-y surge in the Manufacturing sector, while both the Mining and Electricity component expanded at a modest pace of 0.3% and 0.8% respectively.

Meanwhile, palm oil statistics for April saw production fall by 4.3% y-o-y to 1.47mil metric tonnes (MT) while stock level jumped 6.2% y-o-y to 1.64mil MT as exports for the month declined by 21.7% to just 1.06mil MT. In a related development, Malaysia is considering cutting the current export tax of 8% on palm oil to ensure the global market has sufficient supply as a result of Indonesia's move to ban the export of palm products since the end of last month.

## CORPORATE

SCGM entered into a share sale agreement to dispose of its wholly-owned subsidiary, Lee Soon Seng Plastic Industries (LSSPI,) for RM544.4m cash to Mitsui & Co Ltd and FP Corporation (FPCO). Upon the completion of the sale, SCGM will recognize a gain on disposal amounting to RM393.7m and intends to undertake a capital repayment and special dividend amounting to RM2.21 per share in total. In contract news, Uzma won a RM101.8m engineering, procurement, construction, and commissioning provision contract for the development of a 29.99 MW large-scale solar (LSS) photovoltaic plant project in Bestari Jaya, Selangor.

## EQUITY

It was carnage for global equity markets led by massive selling out of major US indices, which saw the Nasdaq Composite Index plunging by 12.3% for the week in review. All other major indices too fell with losses of between 0.2% to as much as 8.7% on the Jakarta Composite Index. The local bourse too dropped in tandem with the global market sell-off with the KLCI closing the week at 1,538.80 pts, down 44.18 pts or 2.8%. For the week ended May 12, retail market participants emerged as sole net buyers with an inflow of RM299.4mil while foreigners and local institutions turned net sellers with an outflow of RM174.1mil and RM125.3mil respectively.

## EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, Bank Negara will be releasing the 1Q 2022 GDP data, which the market expects to see Malaysia recording a GDP growth of 4% y-o-y, faster than the 3.6% pace in 4Q of 2021, but below the projected, 5.3-6.3% GDP print envisaged for the year.

Next week, on Monday, May 16, three key economic data out of China are due and they include the April IPI, which is expected to show a modest expansion of 0.4% y-o-y while Retail Sales data is expected to show continuous deterioration in consumption as the data is likely to show a contraction of 6% y-o-y. In addition, data for the cumulative fixed asset investment too will be released, which is expected to grow by 7% y-o-y. Out of the US, some key housing data are due on Wednesday, May 18. This includes the April Housing Starts data and Building Permits, which will likely show little change, while Existing Home Sales for April is due the next day.










