



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

NO CHANGES TO FBM KLCI CONSTITUENTS AFTER SEMI-ANNUAL REVIEW

The reserve list will be used if one or more constituents are deleted from the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI in accordance with the index ground rules during the period up to the next semi-annual review.

Meanwhile, eight new constituents would be added to the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Mid 70 Index, namely Aeon Co (M) Bhd, Boustead Plantations Bhd, Chin Hin Group Bhd, Farm Fresh Bhd, Hengyuan Refining Company Bhd, Hextar Global Bhd, Hibiscus Petroleum Bhd and Ta Ann Holdings Bhd. As a result, Allianz Malaysia Bhd, ATA IMS Bhd, Cahya Mata Sarawak Bhd, GDEX Bhd, Hong Leong Industries Bhd, Magnum Bhd, Sapura Energy Bhd and YTL Hospitality REIT will be deleted from the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Mid 70 Index. For the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Hijrah Shariah Index, two new constituents will be added - FGV Holdings Bhd and Sunway Bhd - while Inari Amertron Bhd and Press Metal Aluminium Holdings Bhd would be deleted from the index. All constituent changes take effect at the start of business on June 20. The next review will take place in December 2022.


AMINVEST LAUNCHES NEW CHINA SECTORS INDEX FUND

While China's traditional sectors such as energy, materials and industrials have shown signs of a slowdown in growth, new sectors such as consumer, communications, healthcare and technology are driven by the continued growth of consumer demand. Meanwhile, according to AmFunds Management Bhd chief executive Goh Wee Peng, demographics and consumer trends will continue to shape China's consumer landscape for the next decade of growth. AmInvest is excited to again partner with CSOP, which is

one of the largest and most active ETF issuers in Hong Kong. China's annual growth rate of disposable income per capita, driven primarily by the rise of the middle class, has exceeded 8%. Singles' Day, the world's biggest online shopping event in November last year, garnered an outstanding total spending of 965.1 billion yuan (about RM629.4 billion) despite the slowdown in China. BROAD STAGNATION

Economic headwinds remain for major economies despite some recent positive momentum. The Federal Reserve Beige Book released this week showed the US economy has downshifted in recent weeks on the back of rising interest rates and inflation pressure. Jamie Dimon, the JPMorgan Chase & Co-Chief Executive Officer warned of a “hurricane” as the US economy is seen to be struggling against fiscally induced growth, quantitative tightening, and Russia’s invasion of Ukraine.

Meanwhile, Shanghai announced that it will end its two-month lockdown with effect from June 1, paving the way for economic activities to return to normalcy. The Chinese government too stepped up to boost the local economy by ordering state-owned banks to provide some US\$120bil line of credit for infrastructure-related projects.

ECONOMY

Out of the US, the headline and core Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) Index for April moderated to 6.3% and 4.9% on a y-o-y basis from

the preceding month's pace of 6.6% and 5.2%. On a month-on-month basis, headline PCE slowed down to register a growth of 0.2% against the preceding month's pace of 0.9%. In other news, the final University of Michigan's Consumer Sentiment Index fell to 58.4 in May against the initial reading of 59.1. Similarly, the Conference Board's Consumer Confidence Index fell to 106.4 from 108.6 in April, but much higher than the market's forecast of a 103.9 print.

Meanwhile, the Institute for Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) increased to 56.1 in May from 55.4 in the preceding month and beat market expectations of a drop to 54.5. In other PMI indicators for May, the S&P Global ASEAN Manufacturing PMI dropped to 52.3 from 52.8 in April while the S&P Global Eurozone Manufacturing PMI fell to 54.6 from 55.5 in April. However, the JPMorgan Global Manufacturing PMI improved marginally to 52.4 from the preceding month's print of 52.3.

The Bank of Canada wasted no time in raising rates yet again with a 50bps hike to 1.5% and warned that it may act more aggressively if needed to tame rising inflation. Out of Europe, inflation readings hit fresh record highs as the May Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the 19-nation Eurozone surged to 8.1% y-o-y from 7.4% in the preceding month and well ahead of the market's forecast of a 7.7% increase. Germany too saw record-high inflation as headline CPI surged 8.7% y-o-y, beating market estimates of an 8.1% rise.

Data from China continues to show weakness as China's official manufacturing and non-manufacturing PMI for May came in at 49.6 and 47.8, which was higher than the 47.4 and 41.9 seen in the preceding month respectively but both the key barometers are still below the 50-point mark.

Locally, Malaysia's Producer Price Index (PPI)-Local Production for April rose by 11% y-o-y against the preceding month's increase of 11.6% y-o-y. Two key sectors continue to see pricing pressure as the Mining sector saw an 18.4% y-o-y jump in April, while the Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishing sectors saw an increase of 18.0% y-o-y. In other news, Malaysia's banking sector saw loan growth expanding by 5.0% y-o-y

in April against the 4.6% pace seen in the preceding month. Business loan growth expanded by 5.7% y-o-y while households saw a 4.9% y-o-y growth in April. Meanwhile, the S&P Global Malaysia Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index for May fell to 50.1 from 51.6, which showed broad stagnation in manufacturing operating conditions, leading to a potential slowdown in domestic economic activity.

There was also an update on the Malaysian plantation sector this week as the Malaysian Palm Oil Council raised its production outlook for Malaysia to 18.6mil from 18.1mil and envisaged that crude palm oil price will remain above RM6,000 a tonne this year.

CORPORATE

Malaysia's oil giant, Petronas reported a net profit of RM23.44bil for the 1Q 2022 as revenue surged almost 50% y-o-y to RM78.75bil. Teanga Nasional too was in the news this week as it inked a US\$3bil or RM13.1bil deal to secure coal supplies from Indonesia over the next three years. Sapura Energy entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with Safeen Feeder Company – Sole Proprietorship LLC, a company in the Abu Dhabi Ports Group of Companies, for the disposal of its pipe-laying and crane vessel known as Sapura 3000 for a total cash consideration of USD71.5m or RM312.8m. In a related development, the auditor for Sapura Energy, Ernst & Young PLT, has expressed its unqualified opinion with material uncertainty related to the company's ability to continue as a going concern. In addition, Sapura Energy is now an affected listed issuer under PN17 as the prescribed criteria under Paragraph 2.1(e) of PN17 has been triggered, due to the company's shareholders' equity of RM85mil as at January 31, 2022, being less than 50% of its share capital of RM10,872mil.

In other news, Comintel Corporation won two sub-contracts related to the construction and completion of reinforced concrete framework, and architectural and infrastructure works for two development projects worth RM275.4m. Meanwhile, AirAsia X made headlines with its reported 3Q net profit of RM33.6bil as it wrote-back provisions that were previously made under its debt restructuring exercise.

Rubberex entered into a conditional share sale agreement with Law Eng Lim and Revongen Corporation to acquire 100% equity interest in Reszon Diagnostics International for RM180.0mil, a test kit manufacturer. The purchase consideration will be satisfied via RM54.0mil in cash and the balance RM126.0 million via the issuance of 177.7mil new Rubberex shares at RM0.7091 per share. The purchase consideration is also subjected to a profit guarantee of RM50mil each for the financial years 2022 and 2023.

YTL Power was also in the news as it completed the purchase of Tuaspring Pte Ltd, the beneficial owner of a 396MW combined cycle power plant in Singapore, at a reduced price of S\$270mil against the original purchase price of S\$331.45mil.

EQUITY

Markets were firmer across the globe as buying interest accelerated from the recent selling pressure on the back of some signs that inflation may have just peaked in the US as PCE data tops estimates while the pace of growth in the data on a month to month basis has slowed down. Markets that rose gained between 0.5% to as much as 4.9% on the Nasdaq Composite Index. Over on Bursa Malaysia, stocks closed mixed to higher as the KLCI added 8.75 pts or 0.6% to 1,549.90 pts.

For the week ended June 1, foreigners stepped-up their buying momentum aggressively especially over the past three market days resulting in a net inflow of RM668.1mil for the week. Both the local institutions and retailers were net sellers in the market with an outflow of RM552.0mil and RM116.1mil respectively. With a net inflow of RM77.3mil for May, net foreign buying interest for the first five months of 2022 is now at RM7.37bil, while local institutions' net selling interest last month of RM583.2mil has increased the net outflow year-to-date to RM8.55bil. Retailers' net inflow of RM505.9mil in May brought the year-to-date net buying to RM1.18bil.


EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, the US will be releasing the May labour market indicators with the market expecting slower growth in Non-Farm Payrolls at 325,000 against 428,000 last month. The unemployment rate is expected to improve to 3.5% from 3.6% last month, while Average Hourly Earnings is expected to grow 5.2% y-o-y from the 5.5% pace seen in April. The ISM Services PMI is also due later today with consensus looking at 56.4 from April's print of 57.1.

Next week, on Tuesday, June 7, the Reserve Bank of Australia meets to decide on the benchmark Cash Rate, which was last raised by 25bps to 0.35%. On Thursday, June 9, the focus will again be on China as the world's second-largest economy reports the key external trade figures for May. On the same day, the European Central Bank is also due to meet and will decide on its key benchmark rate, especially with the recent heightened inflationary pressure across the Eurozone.

Locally, on Wednesday, June 8, Bank Negara will be releasing Malaysia's international reserves position as at end of May 2022 while on Thursday, June 9, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the labour market report and the performance of Wholesale & Retail Trade for April.

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THE ROLE OF ALTERNATE DIRECTORS – AN ALTERNATE VIEW

The Companies Act 2016 (CA 2016) defines “directors” as any person occupying the position of director of a corporation by whatever name called and includes a person in accordance with whose directors or instructions the majority of directors of a corporation are accustomed to act and an alternate or substitute director. This means alternate directors are acknowledged and allowed under the CA 2016. But their presence may be a relic of the past. With the prevalence of virtual meetings (including board meetings), surely the need for an alternate director is redundant. The principal director can attend board meetings virtually by audio or video conferencing. What is telling is that the director who has an alternate director has given the game away by signaling that he may not have enough time to attend board meetings regularly – and hence the need for an alternative.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Boards should not allow for the appointment of alternate directors as the distinct personalities of the principal and alternate director could cause numerous issues. Firstly, they may have different opinions on some issues. They may not have completeness of knowledge as they split their attendance between themselves - they will not have the complete thread of discussions at board meetings. Besides, alternate directors may not have the benefit of understanding context (including the history of previous discussions), nor would they take ownership of past decisions. The principal director would be aware of the key agenda of those meetings he attended but the alternate director would not, and vice versa.

Then there is the issue of ascribing liability when things go wrong, whether both should be sanctioned or should sanction be apportioned. Then again, the principal director can blame the alternate director, claiming that the alternate did not brief him adequately and vice versa. The permutation and combination of issues and problems almost seem limitless.

The definition of “director” under the CA 2016 includes alternate or substitute director. An alternate director is subject to the same directors’ liabilities under the CA 2016 when carrying out his/her functions as an alternate. Also, the effectiveness of the board is in doubt as the alternate director may not have the same level of commitment given his role as an alternate. Chances are he may end up attending fewer meetings compared to the principal director. Shareholders must ask the Board about the rationale behind the appointment of alternate directors. Why was it necessary for the appointment of the alternate director? Would the Board’s effectiveness be compromised during their tenure? Will the appointment of alternate directors be prolonged? And lastly, considerations on the skill of the alternate director and other relevant issues.

From a good corporate governance point of view, while the practice is allowed, MSWG tends to take a precautionary view on the appointments of alternate directors. We urge shareholders to question companies about their appointments. Anyone who consents to act as an alternate director should also understand the implication of doing so. He is

subject to the same statutory and fiduciary duties as a director when carrying out his/her functions as an alternate. After all, the alternate is still a director and owes the duties required of a director and will be subject to the sanctions that may be imposed on a director.

An alternate director is entrusted with the powers, rights, duties, and responsibilities only when he is acting in place of the director for whom he is an alternate. At other times, when he is not acting as an alternate, he may not have such powers and rights. This creates interesting scenarios. After a board meeting, could both the director and alternate ask for information from management? The alternate will phrase the request by a preamble that pursuant to the last board meeting that he attended, he needs information from management. Also, it is interesting to note that there are no specific provisions in the CA 2016 on the appointment of an alternate director. No alternate director may be appointed unless the authority to appoint is provided in the company's constitution. No shareholders' approval is required for the appointment of an alternate director. As such, the alternate director is not shareholders' choice but the choice of the principal director who in turn is approved by the board. Directors are required to seek re-election if they retire at the upcoming AGM. But this is not the case with alternate directors. The alternate director avoids the vote of the shareholders he claims to represent. The alternate remains the choice of the principal director duly endorsed by the board – never the shareholders' choice.

Boards should do away with the practice of appointing alternate directors. If a director cannot commit the time to be a director, then he should retire – not appoint an alternate. Ultimately, the boards play a powerful role in dissuading the appointment of alternate directors. And if the appointment of alternate directors is enshrined in the constitution, it is time for the shareholders to pass the special resolution to remove such a clause. Ideally, the board should get this done hand in hand with the shareholders. Presently, there is inconclusive case law as to how much liability will be imposed on the alternate director. Maybe, the alternate director should think twice also before accepting an alternate-director position.

DEFINITION: Insider Activity shows the trades made by substantial shareholders or directors of the company. Purchases by the directors and company share buyback may indicate the share price is undervalued and brings confidence to the price trend of the share price.


