

MALAYSIA'S BANKING SYSTEM REMAINS WELL CAPITALISED TO SUPPORT ECONOMIC RECOVERY - BNM

A ccording to Bank Negara Malaysia, Malaysia's banking system remains well capitalised to support economic recovery. The capital ratios rose marginally in May 2022, driven by valuation gains on available-for-sale financial instruments as bond yields eased temporarily during the period. As at end-May 2022, the banking system recorded RM121.5 billion in excess capital buffers. The overall gross and net impaired loans ratios remained broadly stable at 1.6% and 1% respectively, reflecting the marginal increase in impairments from the business and household segments, following the tapering of repayment assistance measures since the first quarter of 2022. Total provisions remained at a prudent level, accounting for 1.8% of total banking system loans and 109.1% of impaired loans. As of end-May 2022, total provisions and regulatory reserves stood at RM40.7 billion (end-April: RM40.2 billion). On the domestic financial market, market adjustments remained orderly, following a decrease in the 10-year Malaysian

Government Securities yield by 21 basis points (bps) during the month, supported by foreign portfolio inflows into the domestic bond market. By contrast, regional bond yields rose by 24.5bps on average. The local financial market was also driven by tighter global financial conditions due to expectations for faster and larger policy rate hikes by advanced economies, especially the US, amid higher and more prolonged inflationary pressures.

MALAYSIA'S ECONOMIC RECOVERY REMAINS IN SIGHT AMID GLOBAL UNCERTAINTY - DOSM

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia Chief statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, economic recovery remains in sight with a better trend as signalled by Malaysia's macroeconomic performance in April 2022 amid global uncertainty. More than two years after an unprecedented global health crisis that profoundly altered the world's socioeconomic landscape, nations had started the recovery process with extensive exit strategy activities to boost economic viability and public health. While the public had started to adjust to endemicity, a new threat comes in the form of supply chain disruptions due to the ongoing geopolitical tension between Russia and Ukraine; uncertain weather conditions; and escalating demand following the easing of health restrictions in most countries. Based on Malaysia's macroeconomic performance in April 2022, the country is blessed with natural resources and commodities such as petroleum products and palm oil. As a net commodity exporter, Malaysia also benefits from higher commodity prices resulting in total trade chalking up a double-digit annual growth of 21.3 per cent to RM231.4 billion. Exports rose 20.7 per cent to RM127.5 billion while imports went up 22.0 per cent to RM103.9 billion. The trade balance rose 15.7 per cent and continued to remain in surplus at RM23.5 billion. Malaysia's trade performance in May 2022 remained resilient, recording the fastest growth since November 2021, with total trade surpassing RM1 trillion. Going forward, Malaysia is expected to maintain a better economic recovery in the upcoming months. The Leading Index (LI) for April recorded 110.8

points with an improved negative growth of 0.5 per cent year-on-year compared to negative 1.4 per cent in March 2022. It is hoped that the economic recovery remains in sight with a better trend amid global uncertainty. In line with this, the S&P Global Ratings recently revised Malaysia's long-term sovereign credit ratings outlook to 'stable' from 'negative' as it believes Malaysia is on a strong economic recovery path compared to other countries at similar income levels.


EPF OUTSOURCED RM167.63B TO FUND MANAGERS AS AT DEC 31, 2021

According to the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) chairman Tan Sri Ahmad Badri Mohd Zahir, the fund outsourced RM167.63 billion to external fund managers as at Dec 31, 2021, representing an increase of 8%, compared with RM155.18 billion at end 2020. This allocation, invested across equity and fixed-income instruments, represented 16.66% of EPF's total investment assets. EPF's line of external fund managers fared well in 2021 and delivered commendable results that were within the fund's objectives and expectations for the year. The fund managers have been instrumental in enhancing the performance of EPF's assets and as the funds grow, EPF will continue with this diversification strategy and leverage on their insights and skillsets that complement EPF's own internal fund management capabilities. In conjunction with the EPF External Fund Managers Awards, EPF announced 22 awards presented to the top external fund managers in recognition of their performance in managing EPF's portfolios in 2021. For the financial year ended 2021, EPF delivered a dividend rate of 6.10% with a payout of RM50.45 billion for Simpanan Konvensional, and a rate of 5.65% with a payout of RM6.27 billion for Simpanan Syariah. Cumulatively, the total payout for 2021 was RM56.72 billion.

EYE ON THE MARKETS

This week, on Friday (1 July), the Ringgit opened at 4.4060

against the USD from 4.4010 on Monday (27 June). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.1684 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (1 July). On Monday (27 June), the FBM KLCI opened at 1438.82. As at Friday (1 July) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is up 9.95 points for the week at 1448.77. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 253.88 points (+0.82%) to 30,775.43 whilst the NASDAQ shed 149.16 points (-1.33%) to 11,028.74.

IT IS TOUGH

As inflation prints continue to scale new heights, with the latest June data out of Spain hitting a new record high of 10%, the work of any central banker is not an easy one, a point recognized by Jerome Powell, the Federal Reserve (Fed) Chair. While the Fed acknowledges the “strong shape” of the US economy and the Fed believes that it can reduce inflation to the targeted 2% rate, it is getting tougher to do so in recent months. Meanwhile, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) believes that the US will likely avoid recession this year and in 2023 on the back of the Fed’s aggressive interest rate hike stance in tackling inflation pressure.

Domestically, Malaysia got a boost from S&P Global Ratings as the rating agency revised upwards Malaysia’s long-term sovereign credit rating to stable from negative. The agency was also rather bullish in its projections for Malaysia’s GDP growth outlook with a forecast of 6.1% this year as Malaysia stands to gain from firm commodity prices.

ECONOMY

Out of the US, the final June University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment Index fell to a record low of just 50.0 from the preliminary reading of 50.2. It was also the same story for the Conference Board's Consumer Confidence indicator, which came in at just 98.7 against the market forecast of a 100.0 print. In other news, the May 2022 New Home Sales leap-frogged by 10.7% m-o-m to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 696,000 units, flatly beating market expectations of 590,000 units. Pending Home Sales rose by 0.7% m-o-m but were still down 13.6% y-o-y, while Durable Goods Order surged 0.7% m-o-m in May, beating market expectations of just a 0.2% increase.

More importantly, the headline and core Personal Consumption Expenditure for May surged by 6.3% and 4.7% y-o-y, which was a tad slower than the market expectations of a 6.4% and 4.8% gain, giving some room for investors to believe that we may have seen peak inflation prints but remain elevated for now.

Meanwhile, China's June official manufacturing and non-manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) rose above the 50 threshold mark to 50.2 and 54.7, well above last month's print of 49.6 and 47.8 respectively. However, the manufacturing PMI was slightly below the market forecast of a 50.5 reading while the non-manufacturing PMI for June was ahead of the market forecast of 50.5.

Down south, Singapore's inflation rate accelerated in May with the headline Consumer Price Index (CPI) hitting 5.6% y-o-y, spiking higher from the 5.4% y-o-y jump in the preceding month, while core inflation expanded by 3.6% y-o-y, the highest in 13 years, from 3.3% gain in April. Meanwhile, Vietnam was the first to present the 2Q 2022 GDP report card with a growth of 7.72%, well above the market estimate of 5.9% expansion and an acceleration from the revised 5.1% GDP growth in the preceding quarter.

Locally, Malaysia's May headline and core CPI too surged, with the former rising by 2.8% y-o-y while the latter increasing by 2.4% y-o-y. In other news, the May 2022 Producer Price Index-Local Production surged 11.2% y-o-y, mainly driven by a 20.6% jump in the mining index,

while the banking sector saw loans growth expanding by 5.0% y-o-y, the same as in April. Meanwhile, due to a surge in fuel cost, the government is expected to spend some RM5.8bil in electricity subsidies, of which some RM2.3bil is for domestic consumers. The subsidy is equivalent to 11.81 sen/KWh, which would have been otherwise charged to consumers under the imbalance cost pass-through (ICPT) surcharge.

CORPORATE

Inari Amertron is expected to invest RM283.3mil to take up a 54.5% stake in a joint venture with China Fortune-Tech Capital Co. Ltd (CFTC), which will undertake Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test (OSAT) in China. Reach Energy has proposed a debt settlement exercise involving some RM206.5mil owed to Super Racer Ltd via the issuance of some 1.03bil new shares at RM0.20 each. Meanwhile, the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission has issued a notice of no objection to the proposed merger between Digi and Celcom Axiata. In related news, six local telcos have agreed to take up a combined 70% equity stake in Digital National, the special purpose vehicle set up by the government to roll out the 5G network and related infrastructure.

EQUITY

Global markets were firmer on what is seen as a technical bounce from the recent selling pressure. Except for a 1.2% and 2.3% fall on the Jakarta Stock Exchange Composite Index and Taiwan Stock Exchange Weighted Index respectively, major markets saw gains of between 0.6% to as much as 2.8% on the Hang Seng Index. Stocks on Bursa Malaysia too rallied led by gains in the telco sector. The 30-stock KLCI added 13.17 pts or 0.9% to close at 1,444.22 pts.

For the week ended June 29, retail market participants and local institutions slowed with an even smaller net inflow of just RM92.3mil and RM6.7mil respectively, leaving the foreign market participants as sole net sellers in the market with an outflow of RM99mil. With one day to go for the June monthly tally, net foreign selling of RM1.086bil recorded up to yesterday is the first monthly net outflow this year.

Year-to-date, foreigners and local retail market participants remain net buyers with an inflow of RM6.28bil and RM1.68bil respectively, leaving local institutions as net sellers with an outflow of RM7.96bil.

EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, a slew of S&P Global Manufacturing PMI for June is expected to be out and this includes those for the Eurozone, ASEAN, Malaysia, the JPMorgan Global Manufacturing PMI, and the US Institute for Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing PMI, which is expected to ease to 55.0 from 56.1 in May. On Tuesday, July 5, the S&P Global Eurozone Composite PMI is due while the JPMorgan Global Composite PMI and the US ISM Services PMI are scheduled to be released on Wednesday, July 6.

As for interest rate, the Reserve Bank of Australia will make its rate decision on Tuesday, July 5, which consensus is expecting another 25bps hike in the Cash Rate, while the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) is expected to raise its Fed Fund Rate by 75bps to between 2.25-2.5% on Wednesday, July 6. The market watchers will also pay close attention to Jerome Powell's press statement following the FOMC meeting.

Locally, the key event to watch will be the Monetary Policy Statement to be released on Wednesday, July 6, as Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) is likely to raise the Overnight Policy Rate by 25bps to 2.25% from 2.00% currently. The next day, all eyes will again be on BNM too as Malaysia's international reserves as at June 30 will be released. The 2Q-ended international reserves position will also see adjustments made to the ringgit value of Malaysia's reserves as BNM typically makes the translation adjustment every quarter.

On Thursday, July 7, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the May employment data, which will see further improvement in employed persons as the unemployment rate will likely hold steady at 3.9%, as in the preceding month.

INVESTING IN INFLATIONARY AND CHALLENGING ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT

That the US Federal Reserve (Fed) has gone on an overdrive to stem inflation by rising interest rate has sent Wall Street into a bear market or a situation whereby an index like the S&P 500, the Dow Jones Industrial Average (DJIA), Nasdaq Composite or even an individual stock has fallen 20% or more from their recent high. In the week ended 17 June, the S&P 500 dropped 5.8%, its biggest weekly loss since March 2020 – dipping deeper into bear market territory. Meanwhile, the blue-chip DJIA slid 4.8% to fall below 30,000 for the first time since January 2021. During the same period, the tech-heavy Nasdaq slipped 4.8%, down 33% from its record high. The market retreat at Wall Street is in tandem with the Fed’s hawkish measure of raising its benchmark interest rates by 0.75% in its most

aggressive hike since 1994. This came about after the US consumer price index (CPI) rose 8.6% in May from a year ago, the highest increase since December 1981. Core inflation excluding food and energy rose 6%. Both were higher than expected. Having brought the level of its benchmark funds rate to a range of 1.5%-1.75% – the highest since just before the COVID-19 pandemic began in March 2020 – the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) now is expected to further hike existing rate to 3.40% by end-2022 which is higher than the initial expectation of 1.90% forecasted in March 2022.

THE RIPPLE EFFECTS

The Fed's incessant stance of tightening the interest rate rather than normalisation will create considerable pressure on Asian central banks to accelerate their rate hikes, especially in the context of recent portfolio investment outflows across the region. US Fed chairman Jerome Powell had also indicated a 50 to 75 basis points (bps) rate hike for the next FOMC meeting on 26th to 27th July. Back home, Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) is expected to increase the overnight policy rate (OPR) by 25bps in its next Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting from 5th to 6th July after the 25bps hike at the previous 10th and 11th May meeting. Economists expect "hawkish" pivots among ASEAN central banks after the Fed's frontloading its interest rate hikes. They now projected another 25bps hike by end-2022 to raise the OPR to 2.5% versus the previous view of another 25bps hike later in 2H 2022 to 2.25%.

INFLATIONARY IMPACT ON INVESTORS

The above chain of events has resulted in Bursa Malaysia being shrouded in volatility as investors recalibrate risks around (i) elevated inflation, (ii) potential capital outflows amidst an aggressive Fed, (iii) protracted Russia-Ukraine war, (iv) heightened US-China conflict and (v) political fluidity amid speculation of 15th General Election in 2H22. Briefly, inflation diminishes the purchasing power of consumers while

inflating input prices resulting in manufacturers having to pass their higher production cost to consumers. Unless their incomes rise in tandem and adequate measures are put in place to contain inflation and preserve employment, consumers may see an erosion in their purchasing power.

When the purchasing power of consumers goes down, they are only able to purchase less with the same amount of money. Such development is normally negative for consumer-driven stocks like FMCG (fast moving consumer goods) or consumer durables as the ability of consumers to spend goes down. These companies may have to absorb higher production costs or even reduce their profits if they are unable to pass the increased costs to consumers. When inflation goes up and the interest rates also go up, the cost of capital will also move up in tandem. Cost of capital is a combination of cost of equity and the cost of debt. When the bond yields go up, the cost of capital goes up, too, hence the future cash flows of the company will be valued lower. Given that discounting future cash flows is one of the equity valuation methods, whenever the rate of discounting goes up obviously equity valuations go down.

GROWTH VS VALUE STOCK

Although there is no perfect inflation hedge, historical data shows that value investing strategies have performed very well – on average – during inflationary periods but generally do not fare that well during periods of low inflation. As its name implies, growth investing values companies on their future earnings as opposed to their past or present earnings while inflation is the process by which money in the future becomes less valuable in the present. Therefore, in high inflation periods, future earnings become less valuable and current earnings become correspondingly more valuable. Since “value stocks” are valued on their current earnings, it has been said that inflationary periods are better for value stocks (e.g., banks) than for growth stocks (e.g., tech companies) and vice versa.

In a calm economic climate, investors expect growth stocks to earn substantial capital gains because of strong growth in the underlying company. This expectation can result in these stocks appearing overvalued because of their generally high price-to-earnings (PE) ratios. On the contrary, value stocks are often under-rated or ignored by the market, but they may eventually gain value. Investors also attempt to profit from the dividends they typically pay. Value stocks tend to trade at a low PE ratio.

BEST STOCKS FOR INFLATIONARY PERIODS

More broadly, stocks are expected to take a hit when inflation spikes, but inflation can also mean that the economy is growing. Since inflation increases the cost of goods, businesses with less reliance on raw materials could be expected to perform better than those with cost-intensive products. Blue-chip stocks may also perform better than growth stocks during inflationary periods because they generally carry less debt. Also, any rise in interest rates will increase financing costs for a company that depends on debt-fueled growth. Banks are on the other end of that equation – their profit on loans increases when interest rates rise. However, higher interest rate may also suppress credit demand from consumers. While theoretically inflation may be negative for bonds and equities, a certain degree of rising inflation is synonymous with growth in gross domestic product (GDP). Even in major economies like the US and Japan, efforts are being placed to revive inflation back to the 2% level. That is supposed to be the cut-off level which will spur growth. Looking back at world growth over the last 20 years, one would notice that GDP has never grown substantially when the inflation was at very low level. While obscenely high inflation can wreak havoc on economy, certain threshold of inflation is required to incentivise producers and businesses. Henceforth, rising inflation has certain downside risks, but it is also essential for growth.

Striking this delicate balance is essential to keep the macro economy on a right footing.


