# BURSA POSTS LARGEST YTD ON-MONTH DROP IN LISTED FIRMS' MARKET CAP

**A** ccording to Bursa Malaysia's research arm Bursa Digital Research, the total market capitalisation (market cap) of companies listed on the bourse was lower at RM1.648 trillion as at end June 2022 compared to RM1.774 trillion a month earlier amid lingering concerns on a potential recession in the US and global monetary policy tightening or interest rate hikes to fight inflation. At RM1.648 trillion as at end June 2022, Bursa-listed companies' market cap had fallen RM126 billion from RM1.774 trillion a month earlier to post the largest year-to-date (YTD) on-month drop in Bursa-listed firms' market cap so far in 2022. Fear over recession in the US market and tightening monetary policy continued to linger over market sentiment. In June, trading on the local bourse was weaker as monthly ADV (average daily traded value) moderated to RM1.9 billion (May: RM2.39 billion). Trading momentum was lowered across all investor segments, with the

largest decline in the foreign ADV. Local institutions became net buyers of local equities in June 2022 after selling for the past five months. In June, local institutional inflow (into local equities) amounted to +658 million. Meanwhile, foreign investors were net sellers of local equities with a net outflow of RM1.28 billion in June 2022. However, they remained as net purchasers up to June (2022) with +RM6.08 billion. Research data shows that so far in 2022, Bursa-listed companies' market cap had fallen on-month in January, March, May and June. In January 2022, the figure fell RM58 billion from a month earlier while the March figure dropped RM11 billion. In May, Bursa-listed companies' market cap was down RM52 billion from a month earlier. At the bourse's 12:30pm break on Tuesday, its share price settled down one sen or 0.16% at RM6.24 with 41,600 shares traded. At RM6.24, Bursa has a market cap of about RM5.05 billion based on the group's 809.3 million outstanding shares. Bursa has scheduled to release its financial results for the second quarter ended June 30, 2022 on July 28, 2022.

## **BUDGET 2023 TO FOCUS ON SUSTAINABLE SUBSIDIES, BOOSTING COUNTRY'S RESILIENCE – TENGKU ZAFRUL**

According to Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, Budget 2023 will focus on a more sustainable subsidy management, strengthening the country's resilience against future shocks and fiscal consolidation. This is in view of increasing inflationary pressures, especially on commodity and food prices. Budget 2023 will take into consideration sustainability-related initiatives as the world grapples with challenges involving geopolitical uncertainties and climate change. This was in a written parliamentary reply to Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail (PH-Kulim-Bandar Bharu), who wanted to know how the policies, strategies and approach in drafting Budget 2023 differ from past budgets. He continued that economic reform efforts will also be given priority to enhance business competitiveness and the value chain. In line with the post-Covid-19 economic recovery momentum, Budget 2023 will also continue to focus on the people's well-being agenda, especially in terms of income and social protection. The inclusivity

agenda, in line with the Shared Prosperity Vision 2030's objectives, will be emphasised as well, to ensure a fair and equitable wealth distribution. Throughout the Budget 2023 preparation process, the government is committed to holding stakeholder engagement sessions especially to gain public views and feedback in line with the priorities set. The theme of Budget 2023 is "Strengthening Recovery, Facilitating Reforms Towards Sustainable Socio-Economic Resilience of Keluarga Malaysia".


## **PETROCHEMICAL INDUSTRY TO SEE FASTER GROWTH - MPA**

According to the Malaysian Petrochemicals Association (MPA) president Akbar Md Thayoob, the country's petrochemical industry is poised to grow at a faster rate in future, considering petrochemical is an important element for the world to move towards energy efficiency and net zero emission. The industry is expected to record an average compound annual growth rate of 5% to 6%, which is higher than the country's gross domestic product (GDP), despite numerous external economic uncertainties like the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Petrochemicals will always be growing at above the GDP rate and some industries will be growing much faster than the others but on average, overall, it is an important growth engine for the country. He was speaking at the press conference on the upcoming Oil and Gas Asia 2022 conference. While noting that petrochemicals offer solutions that many are not familiar with, he dismissed the notion that the industry is on a downcycle and reiterated that it is stabilising after the Covid-19 pandemic. However, there is a lot of uncertainty still, moving forward. The cycle in today's era is no longer the same as the last time, where every 10 years, you see a very clear trend. Now, there are blips in between and it's no longer like before, where one can simply say that we are riding up. He observed that the petrochemical industry in Malaysia is also moving from commodities-based towards specialties, with many companies also going into merger and acquisitions to accelerate the acquisition of knowledge and capability towards offering the kind of solutions they

can bring to the market. Citing Petronas' downstream unit, Petronas Chemical Bhd, which recently purchased Swedish company Perstorp Holding AB, he said this is very important for the state oil company to leapfrog and acquire such capability and bring that over throughout the region and replicate it.

# TIME TO TIGHTEN OUR BELTS

**W**hile Malaysia has dismissed any notion that the country is anywhere near bankruptcy, the country's finances remain tight due to an increase in subsidies. According to the Minister of Finance, Malaysia is set to generate an additional RM20bil in tax revenue, thanks largely to the higher crude oil and crude palm oil prices as well as higher direct and indirect taxes due to improved economic activity. Despite the increase in revenue, Malaysia may not be able to meet the 2022 budget deficit targets due to a surge in subsidies, and hence the government has issued a directive to cut operating expenditure for the rest of the year by approximately RM5-6bil.

Meanwhile, the Asian Development Bank (ADB) has slashed Developing Asia's forecast GDP growth to 4.6% for this year from 5.2% previously as it cut China's outlook by a full percentage point to 4% from 5% earlier.

**ECONOMY**

Out of the US, the preliminary July University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment Index rose to 51.1 from 50 last month. US June Retail Sales beat expectations with a gain of 1.0% m-o-m against the 0.8% forecasted. Meanwhile, data released this week showed some cracks in the US housing market. Although the US Housing Starts came in below expectations at a 1.56mil annualized rate against the market's estimates of 1.58mil, Building Permits was surprisingly better, rising to 1.69mil against a forecast of 1.65mil. However, both data were lower than the preceding month's print of 1.59mil and 1.7mil respectively. Similarly, Existing Home Sales data for June too was weak, as it fell by 5.4% m-o-m and 14.2% y-o-y to an annualized rate of 5.12mil and below market expectations of a 5.36mil print.

Out of China, the 2Q GDP growth, which came in at just 0.4% y-o-y, was a third of what the market was expecting while other monthly economic data was a mixed picture. The June Industrial Output increased by 3.9% y-o-y, missing the market forecast of a 4% gain but Retail Sales were surprisingly strong, rising by 3.1% y-o-y against the consensus estimate of a mere 0.3% increase. Meanwhile Fixed Asset Investments for the first six months of 2022 improved by 6.1% y-o-y. In other news, the People's Bank of China (PBoC) left both the 1-year Loan Prime Rate (LPR) and the 5-year LPR unchanged at 3.7% and 4.45% respectively.

UK inflation rates hit a fresh 40-year record high as June Consumer Price Index surged 9.4% y-o-y, while the core inflation rate jumped 5.8% y-o-y. The European Central Bank (ECB) finally had a lift-off with a higher-than-expected 50bps move against market expectations and earlier guidance by the ECB itself for a 25bps move. Across the causeway, Singapore's June Non-Oil Domestic Exports slowed down to register a growth of just 9% y-o-y against the preceding month's pace of 12%, mainly due to slower growth in electronics exports. Over in Indonesia, the central bank, Bank Indonesia, left key rates unchanged at 3.50% to support economic growth.

Locally, Malaysia's exports hit a fresh record high as June exports leapfrogged 38.8% y-o-y to hit RM146.2bil while imports surged 49.3% y-o-y to reach RM124.2bil. However, as imports growth outpaced exports, the June trade surplus declined by 0.8% y-o-y to RM21.9bil. For the first six months of 2022, Malaysia's total exports jumped 26.1% to RM739.1bil, while imports increased 30.9% to RM616.0bil, resulting in a total trade surplus of RM123.1bil, up 6.7% y-o-y from RM115.1bil recorded in the first six months of 2021. Meanwhile, to boost homeownership, the government announced a 100% stamp duty exemption for first-time homeowners of properties priced RM500,000 and below for properties purchased between June 1, 2022, and December 2023, while for properties priced above RM500,000 to RM1mil, a stamp duty exemption of 50% will be given.

In other news, the Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister revealed that the plantation sector lost approximately RM10.5bil in revenue in the first five months of 2022 due to insufficient manpower to harvest fresh fruit bunches. From the automotive sector, the Malaysian Automotive Association (MAA) has raised its Total Industry Volume (TIV) forecast by 5% to 630,000 units from 600,000 estimated earlier to take into consideration the strong demand growth in the 1H of 2022. For the first six months period of the year, new car sales jumped 33% y-o-y to 331,386 units

## CORPORATE

In contract news, Southern Cable Group won a RM293.8mil contract from Tenaga Nasional for the supply of power cables for one year, with an option to extend for another year, while Gadang will undertake RM680mil worth of subcontract works for the Rapid Transit System Link (RTS) in Johor Bahru awarded by Adil Permata Sdn. Bhd.

## EQUITY

Global markets were generally firmer the past week as commodity prices continue to weaken while the 2Q earnings season that has kicked

off in the US still managed to pull some surprises on the upside. Other than a 0.9% and 0.3% drop in the Hang Seng Index and the Shanghai Stock Exchange Composite Index respectively, most global markets were higher with gains of between 0.1% to as much as 5.8% on the NASDAQ Composite Index. The KLCI closed the week on a firmer note as well and in line with the global equity market rebound. The 30-stock benchmark index closed the week 30.26 pts or 2.1% higher at 1,450.32 pts.

For the week ended July 20, foreigners returned as net buyers with an inflow of RM142.5mil, while local institutional and retailers turned net sellers with an outflow of RM63.6mil and RM42.2mil respectively.

## EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the headline and core inflation data for June, which may see a further pick-up from the preceding month's prints of 2.8% and 2.4% y-o-y increase respectively. Meanwhile, Bank Negara will also be issuing a statement later today on Malaysia's International Reserves position as at 15 July 2022. In other economic data outside Malaysia, the S&P Global Flash Eurozone Composite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for July is due today as well.

Next week, on Tuesday, July 26, the US Conference Board's Consumer Confidence Index for July is expected to be released, which is expected to show a lower reading of 98.5 against 98.7 in June, while New Home Sales data is also due on the same day will likely see a slight dip to 675,000.

Meanwhile, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) too will be in the news as it is expected to slash global GDP growth to below 3% from the April forecast of 3.6% when it releases the latest World Economic Outlook report.

The next day, the US Durable Goods Order for June will likely show a slight contraction of 0.2% m-o-m while Pending Home Sales data for June will likely see a 3.7% contraction on a m-o-m basis. On the same day, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) meeting will see the US Fed Fund Rate raised by 75bps to between 2.25%-2.5% from the current rate of 1.5%-1.75%. The tone of the FOMC on future rate hikes will also be delivered right after the rate hike decision, which will likely set the pace for market expectations for the next FOMC meeting in September. On Thursday, July 28, the US Bureau of Economic Analysis will be releasing the preliminary US 2Q GDP data, which the market expects to see a GDP growth of 0.9% y-o-y, reversing the 1.6% y-o-y contraction seen in the 1Q of 2022.

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# MITIGATING THE SLIPPERY PATH OF PALM OIL PRICE SWINGS

**A**s with the glove and technology stocks rallies in recent times, history has been proven right yet again with regard to the meteoric rise of plantation stocks' prices: progressive rises will be followed by regressive falls. Whether a minority shareholder is smiling or not depends on when he bought into the stock and when he sold the stock. The danger is when retail investors enter close to the peak and as such suffer huge downside (or become a long-term shareholder). When asked why they did not enter earlier, the reply will most probably be that they were 'monitoring' the stock. And when the fear of missing out kicked in, they would have finally decided to buy the stock near its peak.

Analysis paralysis has been a weakness for many minority shareholders. Then again, 'fools rush in where angels fear to tread'. Somewhere in between lies the right time to buy a stock and the right time to sell a stock. Hardly ever will a shareholder be able to buy a stock at its absolute low and sell it at its absolute high - though we always hope for this.

To recap, crude palm oil (CPO) prices have fallen by about 50% from its peak of about RM8,000/metric tonne (MT) in early March to about RM4,000 per MT currently (as in Bursa Malaysia CPO futures contract for spot month September 2022) due to wide-ranging factors:

- Rising palm oil exports from Indonesia (following Jakarta's move to flush out palm oil inventories accumulated since March 2022)
- Improved supply visibility on major vegetable oils
- Rising stockpile in Malaysia on higher output and lower exports
- Easing concerns on labour shortage in Malaysia
- Seasonal uptrend in the palm oil output cycle; and
- Recent aggressive interest rate hikes by the US Fed which have dampened overall market sentiment

The rally originating from geopolitical concerns over the disruption of global edible oil supply, which stemmed from the Russia-Ukraine conflict, has been short-lived. Another external event that triggered the CPO price rally was the imposition of an export ban on palm oil by Indonesia – the world's largest palm oil producer – to curtail its domestic price hike of cooking oil in early April 2022. However, the export ban was lifted barely two months later, leading to the plantation stock price rally fizzling out as CPO prices eased to RM5,105/MT in June and eventually to RM4,157/MT on 8 July. The sharp plunge in CPO prices after 10 June was attributed to the replacement of the export ban with the Domestic Market Obligation (DMO) by the Indonesian government. The DMO requires firms to supply a portion of their

products to the domestic market via the government's bulk cooking oil programme and links DMO volumes to their export permits and quotas/rights. Indonesia later said it has issued export permits for a total of 2.44 million MT of palm oil from May till 5 July.

Given the excess stockpile, Indonesia's palm producers will need to entice buyers by lowering CPO prices – causing local and international CPO prices to fall significantly in recent weeks. On the same note, most research houses expect Malaysia's palm oil stockpile to rise due to competition from Indonesia palm oil – as such, the CPO price outlook in Malaysia will mirror closely developments in Indonesia. More recently, the Malaysian Palm Oil Board's (MPOB) June 2022 stockpile hit a seven-month high of 1.66 million MT on higher palm oil output and lower exports which was partly offset by higher domestic consumption. With bloated inventories in Indonesia, analysts expect Malaysia's palm oil to lose market share to Indonesia in the coming months, resulting in a gradual pick up in MPOB's inventory. As such, CPO prices would probably remain under pressure in the second half of 2022.

While Indonesia's move to flush out palm oil inventories will likely suppress near-term CPO prices, some are of the view that the recent severe CPO price decline is overdone. This is given that the supply prospects of major vegetable oil remain uncertain while demand prospects have turned more favourable on the back of improved CPO price competitiveness following the recent correction.

## **EXTERNAL FACTORS OVERWHELM FUNDAMENTALS**

Against the declining CPO prices, analysts have mixed opinions of what the future holds for Bursa Malaysia-listed planters. It is a case of the blue sky turning cloudy overnight. There is no denial that minority shareholders who bought into plantation counters near their peak could easily be staring at a paper loss of around 30%, if not more. In all frankness, this misfortune has little to do with greed but with how one reads the market for the commodity. It also depends on how one

rides through the volatile commodities market whose prospects differ from one commodity to another. This is surely a tricky ‘mind game’ considering that there is no guarantee that even the most seasoned or learned investor can walk away unscathed from the short-lived plantation stock rally. Above all else, it must be acknowledged that most plantation counters are backed with fundamentals.

Nevertheless, oil palm planters are price takers. They have no control over pricing. The best they can do is to keep costs low and raise their yields and productivity. In essence, with rising concerns of inflation and recession spooking the entire capital market ecosystem, what is certain is that planters will have to brace for higher cost structure and possibly more subdued CPO prices moving forward.



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
