



KWAP Targets RM200b Gross Fund Size By 2025, Eyes Private Market

According to The Retirement Fund (Incorporated) (KWAP) CEO Nik Amlizan Mohamed, the fund plans to achieve RM200 billion target in total gross fund size by 2025 from RM159 billion currently through increasing its investments in the private market, which include equity, infrastructure and property domestically and internationally. It is seeing double-digit growth of return in the private market space while the return from the public market has not been on a high trajectory. Currently the fund's asset allocation is towards the public market, that is listed equity as well as the fixed income space. Moving forward the focus is very much on the private market side. He was speaking at the launch of KWAP's three-year programme Teras 5, which was officiated by Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Tengku Abdul Aziz.

Currently, KWAP's public and private investment portfolios are at 90% and 10% respectively. Through Teras 5, it plans to increase its private investments to 20% by 2025. KWAP intends to stretch the total return to 7% in three years from 6%, which was its return each year for the past 10 years. Teras 5 is part of the fund's long-term plan to increase the size

of the fund more effectively and sustainably and further strengthen its capability to benefit government retirees at present and in future.

The programme is based on elevating five enablers, namely structure, governance, people, processes and digital to drive eight workstreams, including organisational structure, enterprise, investment, contribution and retirement services, digital, people and culture, corporate services, and risk, governance and oversight. The programme was entirely developed by the KWAP team with no involvement from external consultants.

FOREIGN INVESTORS TURNED NET BUYERS, PARTLY LIFTING FBMKLCI IN JULY - CGS-CIMB


According to CGS-CIMB, foreign investors, which turned net buyers in July, helped contribute to the 3.3% month-on-month (m-o-m) gain of the benchmark FBMKLCI last month. The gain was also partly fuelled by expectation that concerns over a US recession may have been priced in after the recent market selloff. The research house noted that foreign investors emerged as net buyers in the local bourse after Bursa Malaysia witnessed an inflow of RM175 million from foreign funds across all Malaysian securities last month. The net buying by foreign investors comes after a RM1.3 billion net sell in the previous month which was also the highest monthly net sell since July 2021. In total, the cumulative foreign net inflows for the first seven months of the year (7M2022) amounted to RM6.3 billion, which is a stark contrast to the 7M2021 net sell of RM5.5 billion. Citing Bursa Malaysia statistics, sectors that attracted the highest foreign investment last month were financial services (RM237.63 million), healthcare (RM120.31 million) and utilities (RM53.12 million). Local retailers and institutional investors turned net sellers for July at RM16 million and RM41 million respectively. Local retailers 7M2022 net buy of Malaysian equities amounted to RM1.7 billion, compared to 7M2021 net buy of RM9 billion. As for local institutional investors, 7M2022 net sell amounted to RM7.9 billion, higher than the 7M2021 net sell of RM6.3 billion. On average daily trading value (ADTV), the broking firm highlighted ADTV in July fell 29% m-o-m to RM1.4 billion, representing the lowest monthly ADTV since December 2012. The average daily trading volume fell 20% m-o-m

to 2.2 billion units in July. The market capitalisation of Bursa Malaysia's main board grew 2.7% m-o-m to RM1.65 billion as at end-July, a smaller gain than the KLCI's 3.3% m-o-m. Notably, at 3.3% m-o-m gain in July, the KLCI outperformed the MSCI All Country ex-Japan index. Among the benchmark indices of neighbouring countries, namely Indonesia, Singapore and Thailand, it was also the second best performing market in July after Singapore's, which gained 3.5% m-o-m. For the month of August, the performance of the KLCI tends to be negative based on historical data, with average of -0.3% m-o-m returns over the past 10 years. It expects the KLCI to be range-bound in August, with possible downside risk if there are negative surprises from the earnings season. The 2Q22 results seasons have been mixed so far. On the market outlook, the key negative surprises during the results season so far came from glove makers, while REITs that reported results posted better-than-expected earnings. Its top three picks include Genting Malaysia Bhd (target price: RM3.30, MR DIY Group Bhd (target price: RM2.40) and RHB Bank (target price: RM7.70).

EYE ON THE MARKETS

This week, on Friday (5Aug), the Ringgit opened at 4.4565 against the USD from 4.4505 on Monday (1Aug). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.2380 to the Sing Dollar on Friday (5Aug). On Monday (1Aug), the FBM KLCI opened at 1492.67. As at Friday (5Aug) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is up 7.12 points for the week at 1499.79. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 85.68

points (-0.26%) to 32,726.82 whilst the NASDAQ added 52.42 points (+0.41%) to 12,720.58.

HEIGHTENED GEOPOLITICAL RISK

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The historic visit by US House Speaker, Nancy Pelosi to Taiwan was surely one of the highlights of the year as far as Sino-American ties are concerned. Her visit to Taiwan, the first by a high-ranking US official in 25 years, was not only watched live by hundreds of thousands around the globe on flight-tracking devices but caused a significant level of alertness between the Chinese military force and the US air and sea defence. With China later announcing plans to conduct military drills near Taiwan, markets turned cautious as attention shifted to rising geopolitical risk. However, as Pelosi left Taiwan in less than 24 hours, the tension between Beijing and Washington cooled off for the time being although China continued its drilling exercise.

ECONOMY

A flurry of Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) data was also released the past week. The key J.P.Morgan Global Manufacturing PMI revealed that manufacturing activities are slowing down as the July gauge fell to just 51.1, a fresh two-year low. Similarly, the J.P.Morgan Global Composite PMI too fell sharply, down to just 50.8 in July from 53.5 in the preceding month. Interestingly, some of the leading indicators within the J.P.Morgan Global Manufacturing PMI index showed glaring contraction as both New Orders and New Export Orders readings came in below the 50-neutral zone, dropping to 49.0 and 48.0 respectively.

Meanwhile, the Chinese Manufacturing and Non-manufacturing PMI slowed to just 49.0 and 53.8 in July from 50.2 and 54.7 in June respectively. Both the readings were also lower than the market's estimate of 50.4 and 53.9 respectively. The US Institute for Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing PMI for July dipped to 52.8 from 53.0 in the preceding month, but well ahead of the market's estimate of 52.1, while the ISM Services Index rose to 56.7 in July from 55.3 in June. The final Eurozone S&P Global Manufacturing PMI for July fell off the cliff as the monthly gauge came in at just 49.8, a 25-month low, from the preceding month's print of 52.1, while the final Eurozone S&P Global Composite PMI for the same month fell to a 17-month low of 49.9 from 52.0 in June. However, the ASEAN region showed promising data as the S&P Global Manufacturing PMI for the region rose to 52.2 in July from 52.0 in June.

Out of the US, the June headline Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) expanded by 6.8% y-o-y – a fresh 40-year high and within the market forecast. Meanwhile, the core PCE expanded by 4.8% y-o-y, marginally faster than the consensus estimate of a 4.7% gain. In other news, the final University of Michigan Consumer Sentiment Index was slightly firmer than the preliminary reading, coming in at 51.5 against 51.1.

The Eurozone 2Q GDP preliminary data was also out this week, coming in ahead of expectations as the economy expanded at a seasonally

adjusted y-o-y growth rate of 4.0% and a q-o-q growth of 0.7% against forecasts of 3.4% and 0.2% respectively. As expected, both the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) and Bank of England (BoE) raised their respective benchmark Cash Rate by another 50bps to 1.85% and 1.75% respectively. The RBA and BoE have now raised rates by as much as 175bps and 150bps this year respectively. Over in Indonesia, headline and core inflation prints remained stubbornly high as the July Consumer Price Index (CPI) rose by 4.9% and 2.9% y-o-y respectively.

Locally, Malaysia's banking statistics showed further improvement as loan growth accelerated by 5.6% y-o-y with the household sector seeing loans growth expanding by 5.9% y-o-y while the non-household segment grew by 5.3% y-o-y. In other news, the S&P Global Manufacturing PMI for Malaysia rose to 50.6 in July from 50.4 in June, suggesting that manufacturing activities have picked up momentum in the final month of the 2Q period.

Meanwhile, the cost of undertaking the multi-billion ringgit Mass Rapid Transit 3 or MRT3 is now estimated at RM50.2bil, inclusive of RM34.3bil in construction cost. In other news, the highly controversial Control of Tobacco Products and Smoking Bill 2022 will now be referred to Parliamentary Special Select Committee after members from both sides of the aisle demanded the bill be further fine-tuned. Parliamentary proceedings this week also revealed that Malaysia's total federal government debt, excluding contingent liabilities, amounted to RM1.045 trillion, translating to a debt to GDP ratio of 63.8% as at 30 June 2020. The Malaysian Rubber Gloves Manufacturers Association was in the news this week as it expects demand for rubber gloves to expand by 12-15% next year after an estimated 19% decline this year to 399bil pieces from 492bil pieces in 2021.

CORPORATE

Ivory Properties has now been classified as an affected issuer under Practice Note 17 of Bursa Malaysia Listing Requirement after its auditors flagged material uncertainties on the company's ability

to continue as a going concern. In contract news, Kellington won a RM117mil contract to undertake bulk and specialty gas system distribution works for a facility in Singapore.

EQUITY

Despite the investors' nervousness about Pelosi's visit to Taiwan, global markets still managed to pull-off solid gains over the past week except for the markets directly impacted by the 24-hour drama, which fell by between 1.3% to as much as 2.8% on the Shanghai Stock Exchange Composite Index. Markets that rose gained between 0.4% to as much as 5.3% on the Nasdaq Composite Index. Locally, the KLCI closed the week mostly firmer, marking the third week of gains, as the index added another 16.51 pts or 1.1% to close at 1,507.71 pts, thanks largely to the strong gains posted on Thursday.

For the week ended August 3, foreign market participants were again net buyers in the market with an inflow of RM164.5mil while local institutions and retailers were net sellers with an outflow of RM59.1mil. and RM105.4mil respectively.

EYE ON WEEK AHEAD

Later today, Bank Negara will be releasing the international reserves position as at 29 July 2022 while out of the US, the all-important July jobs report is due as the market is looking at non-farm payrolls to come in at just 250,000 against June's number of 372,000 while the unemployment rate is expected to be held steady at 3.6%. On Sunday, August 7, China will be releasing the July external trade data while on Wednesday, August 10, China's CPI and Producer Price Index for July is due, which is expected to show slight moderation in growth to 2.4% and 6.0% from 2.5% and 6.1% respectively in June. On the same day, the US

too will be releasing the headline CPI is due, with the consensus expecting a slight dip to 8.9% from 9.1% in June. However, the Core CPI is expected to continue to rise, increasing to 6.1% y-o-y from 5.9% in the preceding month.

Locally, on Monday, August 8, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the Services Producer Price Index for June while the next day a slew of reports for June are also due, which among others include the Monthly Manufacturing data, the Malaysian labour market report and the Industrial Production Index. On Thursday, August 11, the Wholesale and Retail Trade data is also due.

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RISING SHAREHOLDER ACTIVISM ACROSS ASIA

Commonly associated with companies in the West, shareholder activism is gradually gaining traction in other jurisdictions, especially in Asia. Often seen as a relative backwater for shareholder activism, Asian companies have not faced the same level of activism that Western companies have been accustomed to. However, the region is becoming a breeding ground for activist shareholders as the latter seek more opportunities beyond their traditional stronghold in the West. Furthermore, the rise of shareholder activism in the East is also fuelled by growing focus and heightening scrutiny on corporate governance and transparency from the investing public. According to figures from Insightia - a data provider on shareholder activism, shareholder voting and corporate

governance, the number of US companies subjected to activist demands has been falling since 2016 from 662 companies to a new low of 461 companies in 2021. Meanwhile, the number of Asian companies subjected to activist campaigns rose from 95 in 2016 to 134 in 2021. The Asian continent has gone from representing 7.3% of global activist targets in 2015 through consecutive increases to 14.5% in 2021.

BOOMING DEMANDS FROM ACTIVISTS

Shareholder activism is back on the upswing in the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic. Notably, the scale of activists' campaigns reached a new height in the first half of 2022 with the number of Asian companies subjected to activists' demands increasing by 34% to 126, compared to 94 companies in the previous corresponding period. (Source: Insightia's Shareholder Activism in H1 2022 report).

In contrast, the number of US companies targeted by activists merely grew 7.4% to 390 in the first half from 363 in the year before. Over the six months, activist shareholders have made 256 demands to Asia-based investee companies. The report showed that most of the demands revolved around the appointment and removal of personnel (28.9%), environmental, social and governance (ESG, 27.34%) and return of cash to shareholders (20.3%).

Sector-wise, companies from the industrial, consumer cyclical and technology industries were subjected to activists demands the most with 25%, 18% and 17% of total companies involved. Japan and Korea continued to top the chart of shareholder activism in Asia by making up more than half of the activist campaigns launched.

SHAREHOLDERS' CONCERN SHIFT TO ESG

On the other hand, we have seen the ESG agenda which has quickly risen in activists' priorities when launching their campaigns against Asian companies. There is an apparent shift in shareholder activism

towards ESG in 2022 (referring to table below). Across Asia, the number of corporate actions related to ESG has grown by approximately 60% in the first half of 2022 from 44 in the previous period. Above all, the number of ESG proposals (70) targeted at Asia-based companies in the first six months of 2022 alone, has surpassed the total ESG proposals (58) tabled in 2021.

Governance continues to be a central issue and board oversight on ESG matters is increasingly important to investors, including heightened interest in specific themes related to climate risk oversight and board composition. Year-to-date, the focuses of activist shareholders in 2022 were highly concentrated on the environmental and governance aspects of the ESG agenda/framework. Of the 22 Asian companies that were subjected to environmental proposals in H1 2022, a majority (18) of them were subjected to demands related to climate change and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Activist shareholders would push their agenda by requesting companies to either amend a policy, provide information, or address a concern relating to climate change and GHG emissions.

On top of that, activists had levelled governance-related demands at 68 companies with most of them related to the amendment of company policy (24), disclosure of information (19), change of board composition (8) and board independence (7). Some of the requests made by activists in making their governance-related claims are: - call for amendment or repeal of bylaw/policy relating to the company's corporate governance - call for reconfiguration of boardroom structure, usually by appointing more independent directors - calls for greater transparency or for the company to clarify certain information, usually regarding the company's books and records, or the results of investigations.

DRIVING CHANGE FROM THE BOTTOM UP

Minority shareholders are often seen in a vulnerable position by virtue of their minority interest in a company. Under the majority rule principle, minority shareholders do not have sufficient voting power to exert their control over a company nor cast a significant influence over the direction of a company. However, gone are the days when minority shareholders passively wait for boards and managements to make the change at the top. Given the global backdrop of rising shareholder activism, minority shareholders too could make changes in companies' policy and management by making their concerns and displeasures known.
