# RISING CYBER-ATTACKS STOKE THE NEED FOR BETTER SECURITY AS HACKERS GET MORE SAVVY.

Enter LGMS office and you'll be greeted by two life-sized figurines of Darth Vader and a Storm Trooper, flanking a larger-than-life cut-out from a Star Wars scene. A floor-to-ceiling showcase holds more memorabilia from battle ships to droids and yes, this includes the beloved C3-P0 and R2-D2.

**A**vid Star Wars fan, Fong Choong Fook, Executive Chairman of LGMS Berhad speaks with much pride about his collection as he does the success of LGMS, the only Bursa-listed independent cybersecurity tester.

Fong's industry experience spans over two-decades. He started LGMS 17 years ago and has successfully grown it to be a renowned cybersecurity player in the international arena. It is currently the only company in Malaysia that does independent penetration testing in a secured lab, with dedicated network for enhanced security.

Servicing some of the nation’s largest and most prominent MNCs, GLCs and banks, LGMS’ strength lies in the provision of preventive services. The company intends to expand into Cambodia by Q1 2023, followed by Vietnam and Singapore.

“The further we go into

digitalisation, the more dependant we are on computers, networks and cybersecurity. The number of cyber-attacks in the future is only going to go up,” Fong remarked.

Ten years ago, hacking activities were targeted, but today hackers deploy automated software to continuously pound on the doors of enterprises to try to hack in, putting home-users, small and large organisations in a very vulnerable position.

“We are in a race against the bad guys every day,” described Fong of the state of cybersecurity today.

He noted that cybersecurity awareness in Malaysia was not as mature as it was in markets like South Korea and Singapore. He also attributed this to the lack of regulation and mandates in disclosure if a company had been hacked.

LGMS provides preventive services, consulting and coordination or incidence response. Consulting services entail the provision of assessment to find out where the system’s weakness is, while incidence response encompasses digital forensics to find out how the system was hacked into, coordination during a cyber-attack and negotiation with the hackers.

LGMS debuted on the ACE Market in June this year, and rose to a 20% premium or 60sen at opening, 10sen above its 50sen initial public offering price. The exercise raised gross proceeds of RM45.7 million.

“The primary objective of our listing is to reward our staff, who have been very loyal to us. The second reason is we want to replicate the labs we have to create more of such labs so we can take on more projects,” he explained.

“If an organisation wants to protect itself, we come in and do a health check, we assess the system and let them know their vulnerabilities and potential risk they face,” explained Fong.

## **DEDICATED LABS TO TAKE ON MORE PROJECTS**

This assessment is done at dedicated labs, which are central to LGMS’ core business of offering preventive cybersecurity services and contributes more than 50% to its revenue base. The labs are a safe haven that facilitate preventive security testing.

“Each lab has a dedicated network, so it is a standalone system that is not susceptible to ransomware or any other external hacking interference. This is important because the testing phase essentially

provides access deep into the clients' back-end network," Fong explained.

He added that LGMS is the only company in Malaysia that utilises a lab environment to do testing and is ISO 17025 certified for this service.

Fong said LGMS' comprehensive lab set up, beyond the ISO

requirements has attracted international organisations scouting cybersecurity services, for example Alibaba Cloud.

“We have been appointed as security testers for their customers in Australia, Japan, basically anywhere their customers need security testing,” Fong explained.

He also revealed that European labs and European certification bodies that issue ISO certification also outsource their testing to LGMS to certify their customers.

## **NEW BUSINESS PROSPECTS**

Fong noted that the digitalisation wave is driving a new clientele from the hospital, hotel and manufacturing industry as the increased use of computers and networks have increased the incidence of hacking in these industries.

“Medical equipment are embedded with Internet of Things (IoT), they have sensors and collect data, and therefore they can be hacked like any other computer. So we have been engaged to do preventive testing on these equipment, and this is crucial because medical equipment involves lives,” he said.

Similarly, he noted that the rise of automation brought on by the Fourth Industrial Revolution (IR 4.0) meant the automated manufacturing equipment, with IoT functions and cloud connectivity could be hacked, affecting production and losses up to millions of ringgit. Similarly, as more companies migrate to the cloud infrastructure, security becomes paramount.

According to Fong, when companies migrate from physical data storage to cloud, many do not realise the need for security, as the perception is that the cloud provider will manage the security for the cloud infrastructure.

“You are only given a space for rental and you are responsible for the security of that space. We always stress that prevention is better than cure,” Fong stated.

Fong also noted that many Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) were lackadaisical in their approach to cybersecurity adopting the perception that cyber-attacks ‘do not happen to them’ since they are not an e-commerce business.

“Sometimes, they get hacked and I have seen businesses get wiped out. Invoices and POs get encrypted. It’s a mess,” he said.

On future prospects, Fong said LGMS will continue to go deep into the provision of cybersecurity services, but simultaneously it is developing the breadth of its offerings as well.

“If you want to invest in the future of cybersecurity, LGMS is the only independent cybersecurity assessment service provider on Bursa. We are branching out to extend our offering, instead of just providing services, we are coming up our own tools for subscription, like Project Mercury and Project Mars,” said Fong.


Project Mercury is a software that helps banks and payment gateways minimise their risk by ensuring the merchants that connect to them are compliant with the global security standards, PCI DSS.

“The software we have developed is to help these merchants simplify the whole process so they just click on the compliance factors. The software also issues certification, since we are also a global certification body,” Fong explained.

This software is an annual subscription, and once rolled out, will provide LGMS a recurring annual revenue. It is currently being used by several clients and LGMS is working with them to onboard their merchants onto the platform.

“In other words, we are helping our clients’ clients to be secured,” Fong said.

Another subscription model LGMS is working on is Project Mars, a hardware that will be deployed to SMEs to carry out similar cybersecurity monitoring as it does for bigger organisations but at a fraction of the cost.



“In the second phase of this project, we will have a smaller scale of project Mars for the home-users,” he said.

Fong said the product is now at beta testing stage with several listed companies and LGMS is gathering feedback and fine-tuning before distribution to its partners.

Fong said a similar offering will be developed for home users as a plug-and-play hardware via internet providers like Time.com and Celcom. It will be made available from these partner organisations as part of the home-users’ subscription.

# MALAYSIA WILL AVERT TECHNICAL RECESSION - RHB IB

**A**ccording to RHB Investment Bank Bhd (RHB IB) group chief economist and head of market research Dr Sailesh K Jha and associate research analyst Wong Xian Yong, their third quarter of 2022 (3Q2022) GDP estimate is 10-12% year-on-year (y-o-y). In a note on Wednesday (Nov9), the two economists revised their 2022 GDP growth estimate to 7% y-o-y from 6% on the back of stronger-than-anticipated consumer spending in 3Q2022 and resiliency of the consumer in 4Q2022. The balance of risks is tilted towards Bank Negara Malaysia hiking the overnight policy rate (OPR) at every MPC (Monetary Policy Committee) meeting in 1H2023 to 3.5%.

Jha and Wong said despite all the “doom and gloom” prevalent in global financial market sentiment as it pertains to the outlook for US and global growth, with fears of a deep and prolonged recession in place, they are firmly in the camp that Malaysia’s business cycle is headed for a cyclical slowdown from 4Q2022 to 2Q2023 to trend or slightly

below trend, on average. They don't anticipate a technical recession on the horizon. They estimate for Malaysia's trend GDP (gross domestic product) growth at around 5% y-o-y. In 2H2023, they expect a recovery in Malaysia's GDP growth led by the consumer.

The economists said Malaysia's business cycle peaked in 3Q2022. The leading indicator for GDP (LEI) suggests that the 3Q2022 print could be in the 10-12% y-o-y range and 4Q2022 could print around 2.30-5.83% versus the 1H2022 print of 7%. These forecasts have taken into consideration that the LEI has underestimated GDP growth by 1-2 percentage points, on average, historically. Hence, these are the forecasts generated from a top down perspective. From a bottoms up perspective, for 3Q2022 GDP we obtain an estimate of around 11% and for 4Q2022 GDP it's around 4%.

Jha and Wong also said they forecast that a technical recession is unlikely in 2023. The Malaysian stock market is in a sustained bear market on an annualised basis for more than two quarters. Consumer sentiment as measured by the Malaysian Institute of Economic Research Consumer Sentiment Index (MIER CSI) drops well below the 80-85 range. Quarterly real exports of electrical and electronic products exhibit contractions on a year-on-year basis.

## **BURSA MALAYSIA COMPLETES RETAIL CX ANALYTICS POC**

Bursa Malaysia Berhad, in a statement (8Nov) announced the successful completion of its Retail Customer Experience (CX) Analytics Proof-of-Concept (PoC), a data-driven analytics project piloted on the exchange's cloud and artificial intelligence (AI) platform. Bursa Malaysia said the PoC was undertaken in collaboration with four participating organisations (POs), namely Hong Leong Investment Bank Bhd, CGS-CIMB Securities Sdn Bhd, Malacca Securities Sdn Bhd and RHB Investment Bank Bhd, with the aim of advancing the development of the capital market's investor base.

It said leveraging its in-depth industry-wide datasets, the Exchange developed a machine learning model built on its AI and cloud platform while also tapping into participating POs' deeper understanding of their retail customer segments and distinct behaviours. A hyper-personalisation approach was applied to aid in the design of customised initiatives to cater to distinct retailers' needs with the aim of bridging information gaps and improving retailers' financial literacy. It added, this cloud-enabled model facilitates multi-party collaboration in an efficient and cost effective manner while driving a 'single-source-of-truth' perspective in the metrics used to identify trends and insights.

Chief executive officer Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift said the exchange would invest in accelerating its digital transformation journey in new technology and data analytics for successful customer outcomes in an effort to better understand the increasingly complex and changing investor behaviour. This collaboration served as a platform for Bursa Malaysia and participating POs to explore and co-create more solutions on areas that are impactful to the industry, capitalising on data-driven and digital capabilities. He said, the exchange is committed to investing in advanced technology that will improve the data solutions and CX experience we provide to our stakeholders.

Meanwhile, head of bursa data business Wong Chiun Chiek said in addition to the PoC, Bursa Malaysia has established a Minimum Viable Product (MVP) that included a decision-making framework. This is in line with Bursa Malaysia's strategic intent to offer new and innovative services to the industry using data and digital technologies. The Exchange added that with the completion of the PoC, it is moving closer to turning the MVP into a market-ready product and Bursa Malaysia would work closely with participating POs in order to continuously improve and refine the solution.



## HEINEKEN MALAYSIA REPORTS 3QFY22 RESULTS

Heineken Malaysia Berhad announced its financial results for the third quarter and nine months ended 30 September 2022, once again reporting an improved performance against pre-pandemic levels. The results demonstrated the brewer's continued efforts in driving sustainable growth amidst the improving external environment post-pandemic. Compared to the same period in 2019, HEINEKEN Malaysia's revenue and net profit increased by 26% and 39% respectively in the first nine months of 2022.

Compared to the same quarter in 2021, Group revenue in Q3 grew by 85% to RM720.5 million, mainly due to strong post-COVID recovery following the reopening of international borders, increased on-trade consumption as well as positive mix impact from the Group's premium portfolio growth. Net profit in Q3 grew significantly by 113% to RM108.7 million. The growth was driven by revenue growth as highlighted above as well as driving efficiency through cost and value initiatives whilst the Group continued to invest behind its brands and capabilities in line with its EverGreen strategy.

For the nine-month period, Group revenue and net profit increased by 60% and 106% respectively versus the nine months ended 30 September 2021, mainly driven by low volume last year as the brewery was closed due to the Movement Control Order. In addition, the Group's performance was enhanced by a strong Chinese New Year festive period, steady recovery for the on-trade business, better revenue and cost management.

Commenting on the results, Roland Bala, Managing Director of HEINEKEN Malaysia, said, "Our performance for Q3 2022 was commendable as the economy continues to open up, on-trade

business and tourism sectors continue to recover compared to a weaker Q3 2021 due to widespread MCO. We are truly grateful for the strong support of our consumers, customers and trade partners for our brands. We thank our team at HEINEKEN Malaysia for their passions and courage in transforming our operations and quickly adapt to the new business challenges. We will continue to focus on executing our EverGreen Strategy to drive sustainable growth.”

# INSTITUTIONAL INVESTORS' VOTING GUIDANCE

**O**n 23 September 2022, the Institutional Investors Council (IIC) published the Malaysian Code for Institutional Investors 2022 (MCII 2022). Institutional investors who are signatories to the Code are expected to advocate the adoption of good corporate governance (CG) and sustainable practices by investee companies. When signatories engage the boards of their investee companies, their engagement they must go beyond performance to cover areas such as corporate culture and conduct.

As of September 2022, there are 38 signatories to the MCII 2022. Under MCII 2022, there is a section called Stewardship Spotlight. The section highlights what is expected of investee companies in relation to crucial CG and sustainability matters. The signatories are

expected to focus on these issues in their monitoring and engagement activities as well as their voting decisions. Institutional investors, by virtue of their substantial shareholdings, can influence the market – their sell-downs may affect the share price of investee companies, and their investments would raise the profiles and brand-values of their investees.

So, how will our big brothers, who are signatories to the MCII, vote when it comes to some CG issues? Below are some of the issues and voting recommendations highlighted in the Stewardship Spotlight.

## **BOARD DIVERSITY**

Diversity has found its niche in CG. And to that end, the composition of a board is expected to be diverse with the right mix of experience, skills, and gender, as well as generational differences. This is to bring different perspectives and challenges to the board's deliberation and decision-making process and mitigate the risk of groupthink. And when it comes to gender diversity, the Code states that the board should comprise at least 30% women directors.

Where women's participation is below 30% at the board level, there should be a disclosure of measures and a reasonable time frame to achieve the 30% target. Since the word 'reasonable' is subjective, a time frame of not more than three years is considered reasonable. There should be clear policies to support the participation of at least 30% women at the senior management level too. Such policies should be publicly disclosed. And the board should be able to demonstrate its commitment to take concrete action to implement these policies. If any of the above four aspects are not addressed by an investee company, the institutional investor will either "abstain" or vote "against" the re-election of members of the Nomination Committee (NC).

## **SUCCESSION PLANNING**

There must be a policy and process for succession planning at the directors, CEO and key senior management levels. Again, failure to address this will result in an “abstain” or “against” vote on the reelection of NC members.

## **BOARD EVALUATIONS**

The appointment of active politicians is discouraged. An active politician is defined as anyone who is a Member of Parliament, State Assemblyman or office bearer who holds office whether at the national level, state level or divisional level. Here, again, the institutional investors will either “abstain” or vote “against” the election/re-election of active politicians.

## **TENURE OF INDEPENDENT DIRECTORS**

The tenure of an independent director (ID) should be limited to nine years. Investee companies are expected to have a policy that sets a nine-year tenure limit for an ID. The Stewardship Spotlight discourages the re-appointment of an ID who had previously served on the board for more than 12 years despite having served the required 3-year cooling-off period. Again, the voting stance will be either an “abstain” or “against” in relation to the retention of an ID who has served more than nine years.

## **REMUNERATION OF DIRECTORS AND KEY MANAGEMENT STAFF**

Investee companies are required to disclose the remuneration component of nonexecutive directors (NEDs). These include the fees

for board and board committees, meeting allowances and other emoluments. However, share options and/or performance-based incentives should not be paid to NEDs. This is taken very seriously as institutional investors are expected to vote “against” the payment of such performance-based incentives to NEDs. In this case, “abstain” is not an option. NEDs are not executives. IDs’ independence may be compromised by granting them share options as they may be fixated on share price considerations when making decisions. Likewise, the allocation of performance-based incentives may cause them to be engrossed with the bottom-line performance figures.

Besides, there should be a remuneration policy that clearly explains how the remuneration of executive directors, including the CEO and key management staff, is determined. The Code encourages detailed disclosure of senior management’s remuneration on named basis. There is a marked reluctance by public-listed companies to adopt this practice. The two commonly cited reasons for non-adoption are that:

- there will be internal disharmony if senior management knows each other’s remuneration
- such disclosure will result in an increased risk of the senior management being ‘poached’ by others by offering a higher remuneration package

Signatories to the Code will have to “abstain” or vote “against” the re-election of the Remuneration Committee members if the remuneration paid to executive directors and/or CEO is found to be excessive and not commensurate with performance or the agreed KPIs.

And so, that is how the signatories to the MCII are expected to vote. There is sufficient latitude when it comes to voting as the voting recommendations are generally “abstain” or “against” - except for the payment of any share options or performance based incentives to NEDs, in which instance, it is a vote of “against”.

## CONCLUSION

The Stewardship Spotlight serves as another helpful guidance for minority shareholders when exercising their voting rights. By voicing their concerns and making their dissatisfaction known through adverse voting, minority shareholders too can influence the corporate governance practices of a company.
