



Sit down for a chat with Tan Sri Ir. Kuna Sittampalam, and you will get a historical overview of the nation's infrastructure network. After all, HSS Engineers Bhd (HEB) has designed and project managed over 800 highway, road, rail and water projects in Malaysia, and it is involved in many of the nation's tolled highway projects since it commenced operations in the 1980s.

In 2018, the engineering consultant acquired SMHB Engineering Sdn Bhd, a key player in the nation's water sector with history dating back to the British colonial days. More than three quarters of the nation's water projects were under the purview of SMHB and now, Tan Sri Kuna aspires to take the water specialist's expertise onto the regional and international platform.

Considering its humble beginnings, born of the dream of two young men with neither the experience, network, nor the capital to run an engineering consultancy, HSS Engineers has come a long way. Founded by Tan Sri Kuna and the late Dato' Shantha Kumar, HEB's story, immortalised in its biography 'HSS – The Engineering DNA of Malaysia' is more aptly a



tale of the nation's infrastructure progression, changing the landscape and the people's lives over the past three decades. HSS Engineers is synonymous with infrastructure development in Malaysia and continues to be the leading choice of the government for project management and engineering consultancy services in mega projects, a testament to its success in the past, building better highways, railways, bridges, ports and infrastructure. Flip through the pages of its biography and it will take you not only on a historical journey of the progression of the infrastructure networks and buildings in Malaysia, but the company's persistence in embracing technology in charting its trajectory.

Ask Tan Sri Kuna what lies at the heart of his organisation's success and in a breath, he will tell you it's his people. Behind his people lie the company's ability to continuously adapt to the rapid acceleration of technology.

"We invest in our people through training, upskilling and reskilling. We tend to always be ahead of the curve in technology. We were one of the pioneers using AutoCAD drawings back in the day, and now it is Building Information Modelling (BIM), which we began using back in 2012," he explained.

DIGITALISATION DRIVING URBAN SOLUTIONS

Tan Sri Kuna, who is HEB's Executive Vice Chairman, said BIM is a key tool incorporated in the delivery of its services. He cited Kwasa Damansara Township development as an example where HEB's project management services include the use of advanced technology solutions like 3D Modelling of Infrastructure, Clash Detection and Resolution and Bill of Quantities.

He also revealed that the group has an office in Chennai, India specialising in the provision of Building Information Modelling (BIM) for the rest of the world. Merging drone technology with its BIM services, Tan Sri Kuna excitedly explained how the 3D models of the future would superimpose drone images to produce higher degree of accuracy in engineering modelling.

"The technology is at infancy stage still, but with 5G rollout, technology capabilities have expanded," he added.

He disclosed that HEB has begun to use drones on the SUKE and Pan Borneo Highway projects to obtain aerial site intelligence in real time for mapping purposes.

With a legacy built on its role as a trendsetter in engineering technology, HEB is poised to acclimatise digital transformation to lead its revenue diversification. On the radar of Malaysia's largest listed engineering firm are up-and-coming sectors that offer promising possibilities involving projects in renewable energy, data centre and highway privatisations. HEB has been shortlisted for two project management consultancy bids for upcoming data centres in Malaysia, while through a collaborative partnership approach

with leading global data centre specialists, it is pursuing engineering and project management opportunities locally and within Southeast Asia.

THE FOURTH VERTICAL A FORMIDABLE GROWTH STRATEGY

HEB is a significant player in the MRT 3 project, the critical final loop in Klang Valley's urban rail network. The project management consultancy (PMC) contract award of close to RM1 billion contributes to its unbilled order book of RM1.5 billion as of 30 September 2022, its highest yet, ensuring healthy earning visibility for the next eight years. Besides the MRT 3 PMC, the order book includes consultancy services for Malaysia's 5G infrastructure and network by Digital Nasional Berhad (DNB), upgrading of Sungai Marang bridge in Marang, Terengganu and

the extended appointment for water treatment plant upgrade by the Kedah state government.

HEB has charted its trajectory and future revenue diversification on the foundation of three key verticals – Engineering Services, Project Management and Building

Information Modelling. However, peering further into the future, HEB is set on creating a Fourth Vertical – Recurring and Long Term Income Based Contracts in the Renewable Energy sector.

“We are setting our long-term sights on establishing a recurring revenue stream for the Group which is our Fourth Vertical with a focus in the Renewable Energy space,” Tan Sri Kuna explained.

He added that HEB has also inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Shizen International Inc in September last year to collaborate on a preferred partner basis in the development of solar projects up to a capacity of 250MW in the ASEAN region. The collaboration also

opens up avenues for involvement in RE pioneer projects under the Asia Energy Transition Initiative (AETI). The AETI is a US\$10 billion fund offering financial support for pioneer and research-based projects testing the RE ecosystem to advance the RE and energy efficient agenda in Asia.

“This MoU sets us on the path of establishing our recurring revenue stream, as we explore investing into assets that will provide longer-term sight on earnings,” he said.

On the other three verticals, Tan Sri Kuna said the engineering firm is rapidly developing new service provisions in digital transformation and digital technology by venturing into the data centre and telecommunications service infrastructure locally and within the region.

”

HEB has also established a foothold in Sarawak, and is positioned to reap the benefits of its flourishing economy, driven by the relocation of Indonesia's capital to Kalimantan. Foreign investment into the logistic sectors are likely to intensify, paving the way for opportunities in HEB's core strength.

Another area of growth and source of revenue diversification comes from HEB's strategic partnership with Japanese consultants and government agencies. With Japan investing US\$367 billion in Southeast Asia's infrastructure, HEB's strategic partnership with three key Japanese investment agencies, gives it an advantageous position to vie for infrastructure projects in ASEAN, Middle East and North Africa (MENA) and India.

The three investment agencies are Japan Bank for International Corporation (JBIC), Japan International Agency Corporation (JICA) and Japan Overseas Infrastructure Investment Corporation for Transport and Urban Development (JOIN).

The MoU will form a partnership in the sectors of transportation, water resources and supply management, flood mitigation and roads, highway and bridges.

BANKING ON SMHB'S CORE COMPETENCY

Water management projects are anticipated to intensify in coming years as water becomes an increasingly scarce and important asset.



Tan Sri Kuna reminds that SMHB’s core expertise in water management will position the group to fully utilise its core competencies to design and project manage the entire spectrum of a water management project.

“We have the expertise and experience to design and project manage the whole value chain starting at the capture of raw water, water treatment, and right down to the water distribution to consumers,” he explained.



Tan Sri Kuna is optimistic of the potential ahead banking on the rising need for clean, potable water in Sabah, Sarawak and regionally. He also disclosed that HEB Group is looking at incorporating sustainable designs in the built environment and highways which include sustainable methods to capture runoff water, mitigating flood and utilising rainwater harvesting techniques.

“Moving forward, foundational to the design of the future will be water and transportation, and we are well equipped in both areas of growth and we are striving to incorporate sustainable and renewable energy elements into our designs,” Tan Sri Kuna noted.

MALAYSIAN ECONOMY SET TO MODERATE IN 2023 BUT UNLIKELY TO TIP INTO RECESSION - MAYBANK IB

According to Maybank IB chief economist Suhaimi Ilias, Malaysia's economic growth is poised to moderate this year amid the lingering environment of high inflation and interest rates globally, but the country is unlikely to fall into a recession as local monetary policy remains non-restrictive, while softening of consumer spending cushioned by excess savings built up over the last two years. The investment bank is forecasting a 4% gross domestic product (GDP) growth for 2023, versus the estimated 8% growth last year. Although consumer spending growth is estimated to slow down to around 6% this year versus slightly above 11.5% in 2022, consumers are expected to tap into their excess savings built up during the pandemic years.

He said that consumers have built up excess savings since 2020, amidst lockdowns and economic stimulus measures, such as cash handouts, financial aids and of course the RM145 billion worth of pre-retirement EPF (Employees Provident Fund) withdrawal schemes, that has turned into drawdown of excess savings since May 2022, and this is providing a buffer and support for consumer spending growth. He was speaking at the Maybank IB 2023 Market Outlook media briefing.

Additionally, inbound tourism is expected to sustain a reopening tailwind this year, while robust approved investment growth is likely to continue amid supply chain relocation and rising capital expenditure for data centres, 5G infrastructures as well as automation to address labour shortage issues. Before Covid-19, in 2019, tourism accounted for almost 12% of GDP. As a result of the pandemic and lockdown, closure of international borders, tourism's contribution to the economy has drastically dropped to less than 4% of GDP on average in 2021 and 2020.

China will be a wildcard as with every one percentage point change in the world's second largest economy's GDP, Malaysia's growth will be affected by swinging 0.5 percentage point accordingly. China's growth is expected to improve to 4% this year from the estimate of 3.3% last year, on the assumption of unwinding of zero-Covid policy there. This is short of the official figure of 5% growth.

The investment bank remains cautious especially in the real estate sector in China, which makes up 30% in GDP when various related activities in the value chain are included, and also account for a quarter of banking system loans. With the slump in property prices or default and trouble in repaying loans or coupon rate, there is a risk of a major ripple and systemic effect on China's economy, banks and markets if there is going to be a major meltdown in real estate, irrespective of the unwinding of zero-Covid policy. Hence China remains a wildcard.

Given that the manufacturing and services sectors' wages and salaries growth remained elevated in the third quarter of last year, Bank Negara Malaysia is expected to raise its overnight policy rate by another 25

basis points to 3% before pausing for the rest of this year. This basically means BNM's monetary policy is not as restrictive as seen in major advanced economies, specifically the US. So, that means BNM is trying to strike a balance in addressing inflation and supporting growth. He also takes the view that recent improvements in the ringgit against the US dollar eases the pressure on BNM's interest rate policy.

The ongoing high inflation has eroded consumers' purchasing power despite the high wage growth since the third quarter of 2021. Therefore, it is unlikely for the government to introduce Goods and Services Tax (GST) in the upcoming Budget 2023. It is never popular to raise or introduce tax at a time when people are impacted by higher cost of living. In any case, any extra revenue needed for the government can come from non-tax revenue, and that basically boils down to Petronas dividend.

Since 2019, consistently every year the government has been getting a special dividend from Petronas anyway, above what was originally budgeted. Although crude oil price has come under pressure to US\$80 level recently, current prices are still positive for Malaysia. In times of global downturn, or sharp slowdown, crude oil price typically drops to around US\$25-US\$45 per barrel range. It is still around US\$80 per barrel, so it is not currently behaving in a manner consistent with global downturn in the past.

Another key focus in Budget 2023 would be subsidy measures, as it would affect domestic inflation, which is forecasted to be 3.0% this year, down from 3.3% last year. Budget 2023, which was tabled in October last year, hinted at subsidy rationalisation via a targeted mechanism against the current blanket system. It is indicated in a way looking at allocation for subsidies and social assistance for this year, that it was proposed to be cut by almost 30%. The move towards targeted subsidy is perhaps taking shape already, with the revised electricity tariff for the first half of 2023, where there are hikes to MNCs (multinational corporations) and medium-to-high voltage users, but no change to domestic and low voltage users.

BURSA AMENDS BUSINESS RULES TO FACILITATE MARKET OPERATIONS ON “SURPRISE HOLIDAYS”

Bursa Malaysia Berhad has announced amendments to its Business Rules and Listing Requirements to facilitate the continued operations of Bursa Malaysia and its subsidiaries on days declared as surprise holidays. A “surprise holiday” refers to a public holiday declared in the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur that has not been gazetted as a public holiday at the start of the calendar year. The amendments were made in response to instances of unplanned or unanticipated holidays that took place in Kuala Lumpur in recent times.

By remaining open on a surprise holiday, Bursa Malaysia will ensure that all transactions that occurred prior to the surprise holiday can and will be delivered and settled as scheduled. This would accord greater certainty to the capital markets and mitigate any potential market or investment risk that investors may face as a result of the surprise holiday. Pursuant to the amendments, if Bursa Malaysia operates on a surprise holiday, a regulated person must comply with, and give effect, to the rules or any requirements imposed by Bursa Malaysia on such day, or within the stipulated timeframe that falls on or includes the surprise holiday.


Bursa Malaysia will be prudent and exercise due care in deciding whether to remain open on a surprise holiday, after consulting the relevant authorities. The Exchange will only remain open subject to the Real-Time Electronic Transfer of Funds and Securities System (“RENTAS”), which is the financial market infrastructure, being operational on the surprise holiday, in order to facilitate the clearing and settlement service. In the event Bursa Malaysia decides to operate on a surprise holiday, market participants and the general public will be informed in a timely manner via a media release, circulars or electronic notification. The amendments, which incorporate feedback and comments received from the industry, will become effective on 10




