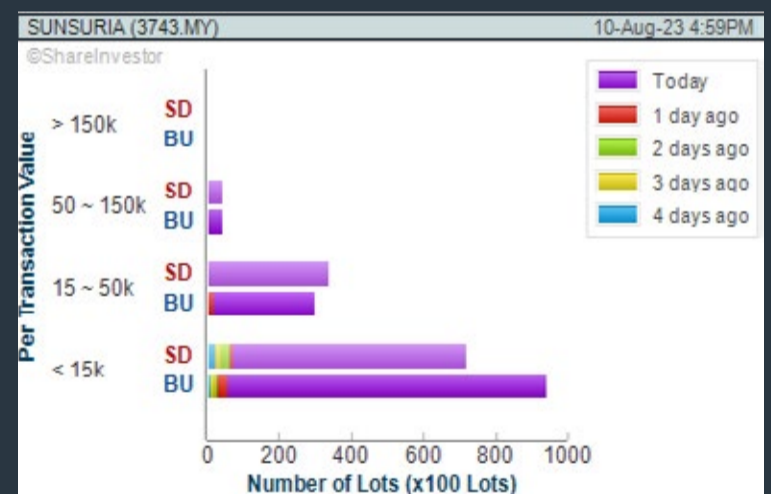

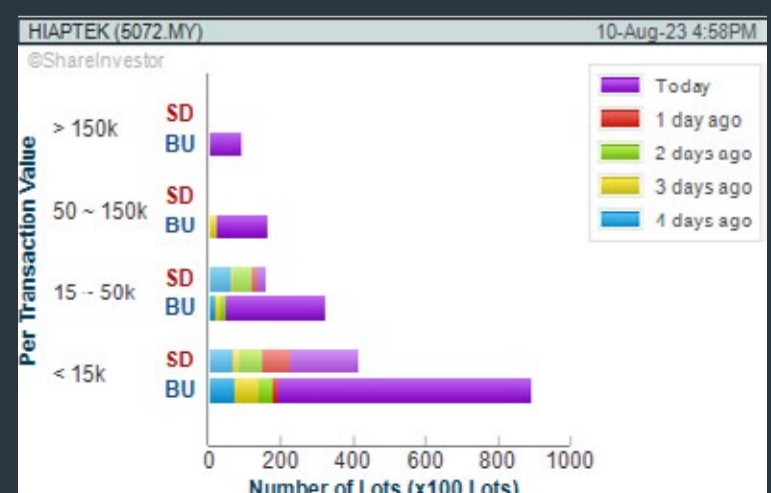

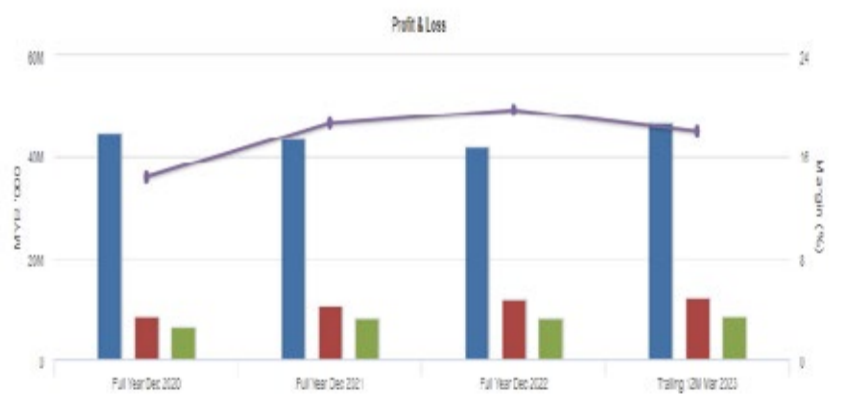

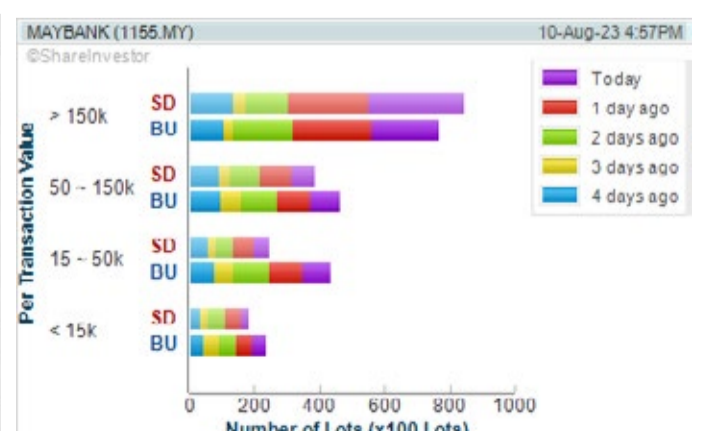

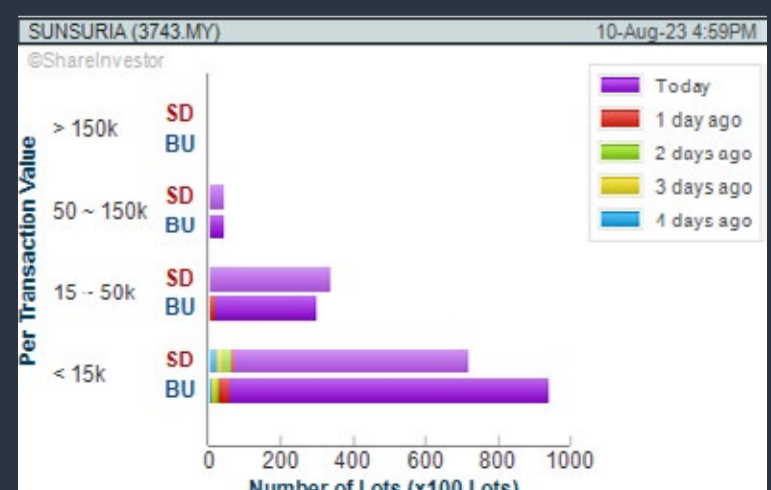

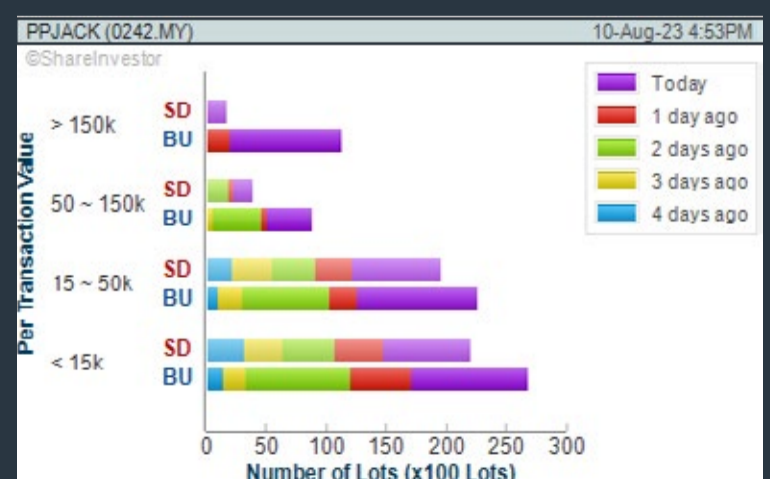

How Daythree Digital Berhad fast tracked growth with innovation and technology

Raymond talks about his first entrepreneurial journey, how he took a team of 100+ people, and bootstrapped the company into a listed, tech-based venture.

Raymond Davadass, founder and managing director of Daythree Digital Berhad knows something about growth. After all he did take a call centre business with a team of about 100, and turned it around in just seven years, to become a listed entity, servicing some of the nation's biggest brands and the bourse's blue-chip counters.

Daythree debuted on the ACE Market in July at 65sen a share, 116% premium above its initial public offering (IPO) price of 30 sen a share. The listing raised RM33.1 million largely to finance its working capital needs, office expansion and to grow the business.

How did it all begin? After a stint in accounting at one of the 'Big 4s' and a career in IT industry, Raymond saw an opportunity to embark on an entrepreneurial journey. While in IT, he observed how the emerging technology had the potential to revolutionise the shared services industry, and he was eager to lead the charge in Malaysia. Through a management buyout in 2016, he started Daythree, inheriting a telemarketing company with a staff of about 100. Call it beginner's luck or a stroke of mastery, in just seven years, Raymond grew that company



into a listed, 2,000-staffed Global Business Services (GBS) provider with plans to grow further.

Home-grown and proudly so, Daythree, in Raymond's words, 'is in the business of managing the service journey of our customers' customers.' In the past, businesses used to delegate routine, repetitive, process-oriented tasks to shared service centres. Over time, these centres have transformed into what we now know as GBS.

"In the past, things at the contact centres were very transactional. A customer wants a SIM card, we inform the telco. Today, we manage the entire journey, from the point of request for the SIM card to tracking its journey to the customer, right to the point when the customer physically inserts it into their phone," he explained.

The primary role of GBS has consistently been to enhance operational effectiveness and generate cost advantages. However, GBS has now taken on an additional role as the driving force behind overall business transformation, and as technology evolves, digitalisation takes on an added dimension. Larger, services driven organisations increasingly turn to GBS for assistance in implementing innovations, automation, enriched and sophisticated services, and novel work methodologies. In essence, GBS has evolved into more than just an efficiency hub; it has become a catalyst for broader business evolution, giving the company agility to respond quickly to their customer needs and industry changes. In Malaysia, the GBS industry is projected to grow from RM24.8 billion in 2023 to reach RM31.7 billion in 2027, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.3% during this period.

“ I was looking for a name for my company, and realised this was the third phase of my career. After being an accountant for nearly a decade, and being in the IT industry for another decade, this was my attempt at entrepreneurship. So Daythree, the third phase in my work life. ”

“The GBS industry is growing at a CAGR of about 6.3% per year, Daythree’s growth rate is about 20% every year.”

Tech enabled for advanced service offering

According to Raymond, with the huge amounts of data emerging from the both voice and non-voice customer interactions, data capture and processing requires technology. Daythree builds its own technology tools to manage all these processes.

Citing large amounts of data, the transactions are not only customer conversations, but entailed touch-points with buyers, suppliers, supply chain, stockists, courier companies and many more. The ability to capture and effectively process the data into useful information differentiates Daythree from its competitors.

Raymond notes that nascent technologies will spur the growth of the industry as GBS buyers want new ways of doing things - faster, cheaper and more efficient. The trajectory of Big Data teamed with the new technology gives rise to the importance of data capture and processing, or as Raymond puts it “how you give a story to that data.”

“The tools we have today like Robotic Process Automation, generative AI, sentiment analysis, and blockchain are all new technologies coming in. We are moving into the new economy and everything is becoming digital. Even the country is talking about digitalisation. So larger companies are also looking at vendors and people like us who have the capabilities of managing the processes, and have digital tools,” he told Inve\$t.

“If a client gives you a list of 10 people to sell their product to and only two buy, in the past the transaction ends there. Today you want to go back to that client and tell them why the other eight did not buy. This tells the client if they should tweak their marketing approach, change their pricing strategy or if the other eight had already contracted with another provider. This is the story we tell from the data,” he added.

Daythree uses three internally developed tools to automate and streamline business processes – Saige, Daisy and Faith - all these intentionally carrying the alphabets ‘a’ and ‘i’ to represent the AI technology embedded in the applications.

Faith is an employee engagement, web-based application that facilitates internal communication to manage work and productivity efficiently, while Daisy allows for seamless and quick interaction between the customer and Daythree’s Customer Experience (CX) executives. Saige is a business intelligence tool with integrated data analytics and reporting platform, embedded with AI digital assistant tool. It gathers data from every customer’s interaction and captures it into one platform for analysis, interpretation, and recommendation for improvement.



Charting a growth path

Firmly rooted with 22 clients in Malaysia and a healthy profit of RM6.2 million for the financial year ended Dec 31, 2022, what's next for Daythree?

Raymond has set his sights on growth and expansion, after all isn't that what the IPO is all about? For most of its years in operation, Daythree has been bootstrapping, practising prudent financial management and reinvesting proceeds to grow the business. However, Raymond realises the potential in the market and is ready to expand.

"The IPO is also to give us brand visibility and brand credibility, and this will catalyse our reach beyond Malaysia," he said.

Raymond elaborated that with access to client's proprietary data, it was important for the clients to know that Daythree as their GBS provider, has governance in place as this adds a layer of assurance for data protection.

At present, most of Daythree's client-base are Malaysian brands, while the brands on-boarded over the past twelve months are regional brands, reinforcing its focus to expand beyond national shores.

The largest outsourcers and demand for the GBS industry, according to Raymond are from North America, UK and Australia. While attracting clients from these regions are a priority, Daythree does not discount the possibility of setting up CX delivery centres in the region to take advantage of the cost arbitrage.

"We may have clients who want specialised language skillsets on a larger scale – then we are looking at expanding beyond Malaysia to other markets like Indonesia, Philippines, Vietnam and Thailand," he revealed.

“The focus was to grow the business and drive the business first. So we never even had a dividend policy, but we see the need for one now and this is something in the making which we will announce soon.”



Raymond emphasised that, in the end, conducting operations from Malaysia remained highly favourable because of the value creation combined with the cost advantage it offered. Additionally, the advantages of being situated in Malaysia stem from its position as a hub for the CX delivery industry, supporting an impressive array of 47 distinct languages and dialects. Notably, Malaysia has emerged as a worldwide CX focal point for prominent global new economy companies, many of which operate their Asia Pacific hubs from here.

Expanding while remaining competitive within its niche

During the previous financial year, a significant portion of Daythree's revenue, approximately 42%, originated from services offered within the energy and utilities sector, while 31% was attributed to the telecommunications and media segment. This effectively implies that over 70% of the income is concentrated within these two specific industries. Raymond, however, reassures that in the GBS industry, exhibiting deep mastery in one or two sectors is a means to establish expertise, especially considering the unique intricacies each vertical presents.

“I believe focusing on one or two segments demonstrates a commendable level of expertise. Certain industries demand a high level of technical proficiency. Acquiring mastery in specific verticals, particularly those encompassing intricate complexities like the energy sector, is beneficial. Being recognised for excellence in a few verticals is well-regarded within the industry and bolsters our reputation as a young and fast growing GBS company,” he elaborated.

Raymond also envisions refining Daythree’s expertise in existing sectors such as fintech and construction, along with an aspiration to extend into novel and emerging segments like e-commerce and retail, as well as the travel and leisure industries.

“We recently on-boarded a regional brand that provides online travel agency(OTA) support,” he informed.

While Daythree is certainly committed to diversifying its clientele base, as a relatively new entrant in a mature industry, and a recently listed entity, the intention is to broaden its scope while still retaining a strong foothold in its core sectors.

Talent development at the heart of operations

A significant portion of Daythree’s costs is allocated to personnel costs. Raymond points out that being a people-intensive industry, the company places a strong emphasis on engaging and nurturing its staff.

While the company does leverage bots and AI, the importance of human interaction in certain situations is still prioritised. For instance, when a traveller’s baggage goes missing at the airport, they seek

human assistance to address their concerns and frustrations.

According to Raymond, new hires undergo a comprehensive six to eight-week training program, followed by specialisation in the selected areas. While Daythree sees itself as a tech company infusing AI and automation into its services, it also sees the need to train its people to use these new tools and technologies, and to be more digital savvy.

“Every staff is trained to be guided by the Daythree Way – Service from The Heart! This explains our service culture and the operating principles on how we grow together”, said Raymond. “We strive to build trust for the brands we serve by delivering a connected experience with empathy and passion. We harness the power of data and innovation to provide impactful insights and deliver exceptional customer experience”, he adds.

Based on this, the company's training consists of three core components beginning with building foundational skills, including soft skills and effective management. The second core skills it focuses on is equipping the new hires with the relevant technical expertise required to manage projects efficiently.

Finally, the third skill trained is to facilitate comfort and competence while working alongside nascent technologies such as software bots, a crucial aspect due to the extensive automation efforts.



Raymond stresses that employee retention holds paramount importance. Given the inherent challenges of handling customer interactions, the CX teams often face negativity, causing significant mental strain.

Apart from monetary incentives, Daythree conducts numerous activities, including celebrations of festivities, diverse cultures, and achievements. "Our staff engagement calendar of activities is aligned to the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations, including promoting good health and well-being, and upskilling and reskilling our people."

"We have a People Happiness Manager, who ensures our CX'ers are happy and satisfied on the job. This is very important for us. We provide mentoring and counselling sessions to support them through challenges," he elaborated.

Viewing the GBS industry as an emerging potential industry

for graduates seeking a career, Raymond notes that in some countries, it is a highly respected and encouraged pathway. He pointed out that the industry offers multiple career pathways for CX executives, from managerial positions, team leaders, quality assurance to training and development.

LIST ISLAMIC UNITS ON BURSA MALAYSIA, LOCAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS URGED – BURSA CHAIRMAN

Bursa Malaysia Bhd chairman Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar is urging local financial institutions to list their Islamic banking subsidiaries on its exchange to add more shariah-compliant equity instruments to the market as there is a shortage in the financial services sector.

He said that well-known local banks are categorised as conventional, despite a big portion of the businesses are now shariah compliant. Citing Maybank, CIMB, Public Bank and RHB Bank as examples, he said they remain categorised as conventional despite a portion of their

business being shariah-compliant.

He was speaking at the Invest Shariah Conference 2023 organised by CGS-CIMB Securities Sdn Bhd when he told reporters that he would like to encourage these banks to list their Islamic banking subsidiary with a view to have more shariah-compliant equity instruments in the financial services sector.

He also noted that many of the banks operate on a leverage model, whereby their Islamic banking business is leveraging on their branch network, which includes their management team. Moreover, when a bank lists separately, it has to consider its minority shareholders and may encounter issues of related party transactions.

“That’s why we have to start thinking about the possibility of other instruments, which will enable a portion of the equities to be traded on the shariah-compliant side and that’s something that we have to talk about”, he said. There is a need to think about designating some of the shares as shariah-compliant shares by ringfencing and earmarking income from the Islamic banking operations as a source for payment of the dividends,” he added.

In terms of outlook, the general Islamic market is expected to be more positive in 2H2023 as global interest rates reach their peak during the period and the reversal of investment flows away from developed markets into emerging markets happens. That will mean that there will be more investments coming to the emerging markets, not just in Malaysia but also other ASEAN countries, such as Thailand and Indonesia. That will help support the market and when they come into the market, it will bolster not just the shariah-compliant equities but also the broader market.

Still space to improve range and depth of Shariah-compliant financial instruments – Bursa Investor Development Head

According to Bursa’s Investor Development head Stephanie Tan, there is still space to improve the range and depth of shariah-compliant

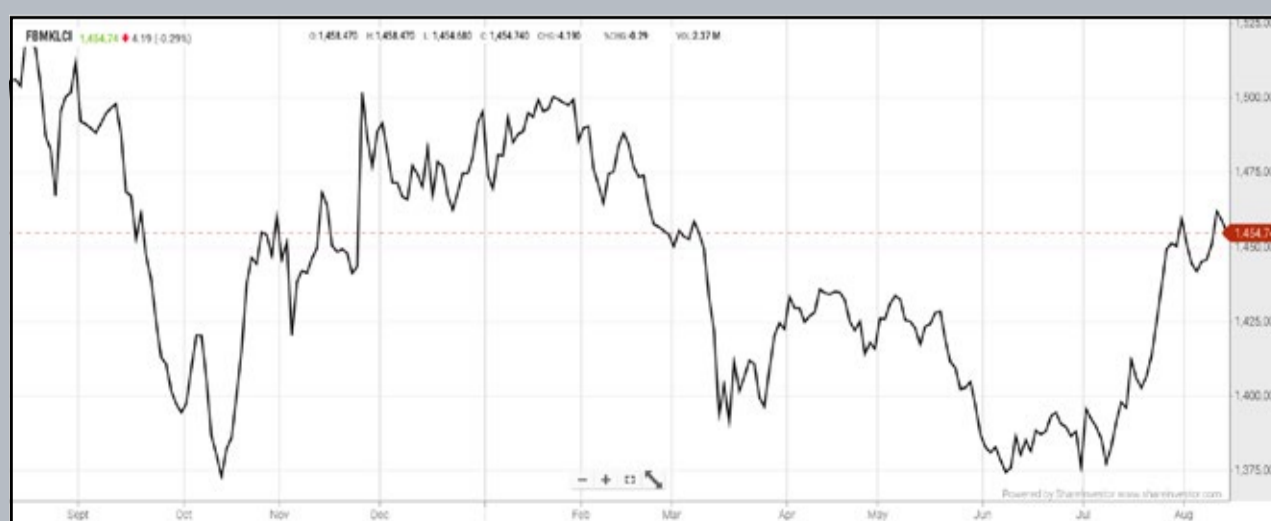
financial instruments to meet investors' demand. In order to meet the demands of the evolving market landscape, the need for modernisation becomes apparent as emerging asset classes, financial instruments and investment strategies present opportunities to thrive in this evolving environment.

Embracing a broader array of financial instruments – such as sukuk, Islamic ETFs and Islamic REITs – expands our access to diversified investment opportunities, enhances liquidity and accommodates varying risk profiles adding that 81.9% of the total market cap on Bursa is shariah-compliant as of June 2023. At the same time, the total market cap for the five Islamic REITs made up 43% of the 19 REITs listed on the exchange while there are six i-ETFs, making up 18.9% of the NAV of the 20 Exchange Traded Funds listed on Bursa.

The future for shariah investments appears exceedingly promising, due to the emergence and significance of shariah-compliant technological solutions.

The Madani Economy Framework recently announced by the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim includes three facets that will benefit the capital market in general and Bursa Malaysia and minority shareholders specifically.

REDUCED BOARD LOTS

The framework mentions reducing lot sizes and allowing fractional share investment. Currently, a board lot, the minimum lot size for trading, is 100 shares. But there are some companies that shareholders desire, but buying a board lot of

it may be too expensive (in terms of entry costs) for them. Take Nestle (Malaysia) Berhad, the most expensive stock (by share price) listed on Bursa Malaysia, as an example. It closed at RM133 per share on 4 August 2023. Buying a board lot of Nestle shares would cost RM13,300 – well above the monthly salaries of most Malaysians and much more above their disposable income. It would take at least a few months of savings to buy one board lot of Nestle.

Besides, there are many other stocks traded in the RM20 to RM30 price range; buying a board lot of these would cost RM2,000 to RM3,000. Thus, reducing the board lot size will make the pricey shares cheaper to buy. If the board lot is reduced to, say, ten shares, then a board lot of Nestle will cost RM1,330. And the board lots costing RM2,000 to RM3,000 would then cost RM200 to RM300 – a level that is more affordable for retail shareholders.

In Bursa Malaysia, there are 10 counters that trade between RM20 to RM30 per share, and another 11 counters trade between RM10 to RM20 per share. The rest trade at below RM10. Notwithstanding this, two collateral issues must be addressed. Firstly, there are also penny stocks that would become much cheaper, possibly a fraction of a sen if reduced board lots are implemented across the board. Secondly, the transaction cost may be more than the cost of a reduced board lot. But all things being equal, reduced board lot means more minority shareholders can now afford to nibble at certain stocks, which could translate into increased trading volume and value, thus contributing to greater liquidity.

On the other hand, enabling fractional share trading by investors is another much discussed topic. We have a somewhat illiquid odd lots market where odd lots are traded. But fractional share investment is a different ball game altogether. Fractional share investments allow investors to buy a portion, or fraction, of a stock based on a nominal amount that the investor can afford – not based on a particular number of shares. Fractional shares make investing in companies with a steep price tag more accessible. So, investors may be able to buy, say RM10

of a certain counter. This is a game changer and much thought and research need to be done as there may also be substantial system and rule changes, and transaction cost considerations to enable this.

AUTOMATIC TRANSFERS TO MAIN MARKET

In terms of pecking order in the Malaysian equities market, it is the Main Market followed by the ACE Market and then the LEAP Market. And there are frameworks in place for the latter two to ascend to the next level. The automatic transition of listings from the ACE Market to the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia announced under the Madani Economy Framework will be advantageous for ACE market companies, as being listed on the Main Board carries a premium – an implied accreditation of sorts.

There should be a set of criteria to be met, and if these are fulfilled, then the promotion from the ACE Market to the Main market should be automatic or near automatic. The ease of mobility, the timeliness, and the seamlessness to migrate from the ACE Market to the Main Market will greatly motivate more companies (mostly SMEs) to seek listing on the ACE Market. They can see the Main Market is within their reach – the light at the end of the tunnel - and they know what exactly needs to be done to reach the light.

ACE Market companies are no strangers to the regulators as they are already under the purview of the Securities Commission (SC) and Bursa Malaysia. The rules that apply to them are substantially similar. As such, there should be no need for protracted evaluations, laborious assessments, and extensive due diligence. The collateral benefit that Main Market companies have is that they can come under the radar of institutional investors. This is because some institutional investors are restricted by their investment mandates to invest only in Main Market companies. The benefits of having institutional investors are manifold. There is the implied accreditation that comes with such institutional investment. There is stronger financial support for fund-raising corporate exercises. There is the participation of professional nominee

directors in the investee's board if the investment stake is substantial enough. These alone are enough motivation for ACE companies to want to migrate to the Main Market.

GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES

The Madani Economy Framework also wants to fund small and medium industries to take advantage of new growth opportunities. But the impetus must be attractive enough to whet the appetites of the SMEs. There are a whole lot of SMEs that form the backbone of the Malaysian economy which can become a ready pipeline for listing on the ACE and Main Markets. The result will be more listed companies, more sub-sectors, higher market capitalisation, more market volume, and more choices for shareholders to invest in.

There is no reason why SMEs would not seek listing as the cost of share capital is nil compared to bank borrowings if impediments are removed. To this end, a frank and open discussion with SMEs, and their representative organisations, will enable the identification of the impediments that hinder them from seeking listing.

In conclusion, the Madani Economy Framework announcements can move the needle and provide a substantial impetus to the stock exchange and trading volume. And the spillover benefits are there for many stakeholders, especially for shareholders. But, as always, execution is key.

MR D.I.Y. Group Berhad

(MRDIY) continues its growth trajectory, reporting steady progression on all key metrics in 2QFY2023 when compared to the corresponding period in 2022. The Group delivered RM1.1 billion in revenue in



2QFY2023, a 4.9% increase compared to 2QFY2022, primarily attributed to positive contributions from new stores. In tandem with this, total transactions rose 13.1% y-o-y to 40.9 million transactions in 2QFY2023. Gross profit margin for 2QFY2023 rose a significant 5.3 percentage points y-o-y to 46.3%. This notable improvement is due to a significant decline in freight costs, which has normalised to pre-pandemic levels, as well as the impact of the price adjustment exercise carried out in FY2022. GP increased 18.5% y-o-y to RM509.0 million, primarily driven by the increase in revenue and higher GP margin. Profit before tax for the period rose 9.8% y-o-y to RM201.3 million, partially offset by higher operating expenses, particularly from higher employee cost incurred following a 25% increase in the minimum wage rate, which came into effect on 1st May 2022. Consequently, net earnings rose 11.2% y-o-y to RM150.3 million in 2QFY2023, while net earnings margin increased 0.8 percentage points to 13.7% compared to 12.9%.
