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Bursa says retail-driven rally not debt-fuelled

According to Bursa Malaysia Chairman Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar the recent rush in retail participation that helped drive the strong rally in the local market is largely due to a re-allocation of cash by investors due to the current low-interest environment, and not fuelled by debt. Share margin financing levels seen across retail investors are not at elevated levels, as investors were merely switching their investments from term deposit into the share market in search of better yields. Bursa chief executive officer Datuk Muhamad Umar Swift added that the difference between previous bull runs and this bull run is that we have not seen growth in margin financing for shares and the trading is mainly funded by cash meaning mere reallocation of cash by investors.

Govt agrees to three-month loan moratorium extension, but only for the jobless

Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin announced that the government has agreed to further extend the bank loan moratorium for the public, following outcry from those affected by Covid-19 and the movement control order. In a special address today, he said the extension will run for three months but only for those who lost their jobs this year and are yet to find employment, after which period banks can further extend the help based on the situation.

Trade surplus rises to record RM20.89bil in June

According to International Trade and Industry Ministry, Malaysia saw its exports rebound in June, the first time since the Movement Control Order was imposed in mid-March, to post its highest monthly trade surplus ever. Malaysia's total trade expanded 2.2 per cent to RM144.84 billion, imports dropped 5.6 per cent to RM61.98 billion, resulting in a trade surplus of RM20.89 billion, a growth of 98.7 per cent y-o-y. Trade increases were recorded primarily with China, USA, Hong Kong and Vietnam. Major exports in June continued to be led by electrical and electronics (E&E) products, valued at RM32.55 billion and constituted 39.3 per cent of total exports. This was followed by palm oil and palm oil-based agriculture products (RM4.68 billion; 5.7 per cent) and petroleum products (RM4.5 billion; 5.2 per cent). On a month-on-month (m-o-m) basis, total trade, exports and imports recorded double digit growth of 26 per cent, 32.3 per cent and 18.6 per cent respectively, while trade surplus surged by 101.1 per cent.

Over 4,500 businesses ceased operations while 82,555 new business applications received during MCO period

According to Deputy Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Datuk Rosol Wahid, a total of 4,542 applications to cease

operations were processed by the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) between April 1 and July 19 this year. A total of 278 businesses ceased operations in April, followed by 1,565 in May, 1,595 in June and 1,107 in July. However, he pointed out that during the same period, the number of new businesses vastly exceeded the number of those ceasing operations as SSM received a total of 82,555 new business applications. He added that the new businesses mostly comprised e-commerce and online businesses as physical operations were not allowed during earlier phases of the movement control order (MCO) period.

Malaysia's PPI for local production drops 4% in June 2020

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) chief statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Malaysia's Producer Price Index (PPI) for local production dropped 4% in June 2020 to 100.30 as against 104.5 in the same month a year ago due to the highest rate of decline in the mining index at 42.5% followed by manufacturing (1.2%), water supply (1.2%) as well as electricity and gas supply (0.6%). Out of 1,063 items covered in the PPI, 39.5% items recorded price increases in June 2020. Meanwhile, 53.7% items showed a decline while 6.8% items were unchanged. On a monthly basis, the PPI for local production registered a marginal increase of 0.6% in June 2020 and was the first positive change for the year.

This week, on Wednesday (29July), the Ringgit gained slightly to 4.2490 against the USD from 4.2515 on Monday (27July). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0833 to the Sing Dollar on Wednesday (29July).

On Monday (27July), the FBM KLCI gained 1.87 points or 0.12% higher to 1591.48 from previous Friday's close of 1589.61. And as at Thursday (30July) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI was trending up towards near recent high for this week at 1604.68, potentially may break another high on next week, indicating market optimism on government ability to tackle COVID-19 pandemic.

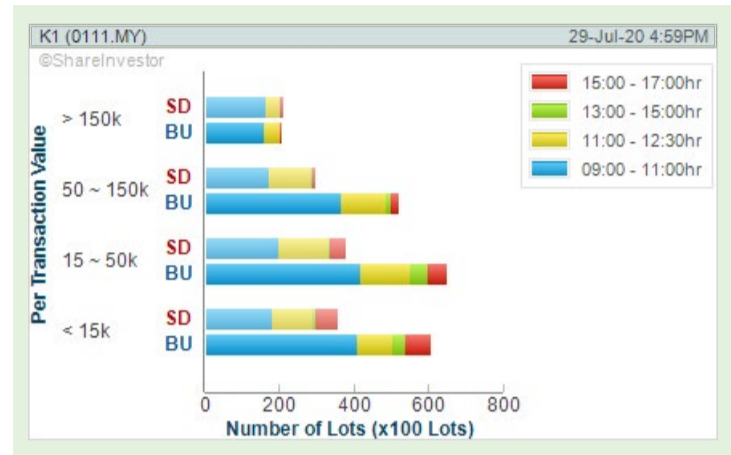
