# Is AFFIN a value trap?

## **SUMMARY**

- Affin Bank Berhad's (AFFIN 5185.MY) performance, measured against a panel of 10 Bursa Malaysia banks, is below the sector median across key metrics such as returns, efficiency, and loan performance. However, it has improved its capital adequacy ratio.
- Affin is not considered a value trap as it remains profitable with a margin of safety over 30% based on the asset value. However, it lacks a sufficient margin of safety under the earnings value.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Affin is a commercial bank and the financial holding company of its Islamic bank, investment bank, and money broker subsidiaries. It also has 2 insurance associates. Affin's operations are principally conducted in Malaysia and comprises the following main segments:

- · Commercial banking: Its activities are generally structured into three key areas, corporate banking, enterprise banking, and community banking. In 2023, this segment accounted for 82% of the group PBT (before inter-company elimination).
- Investment banking: This segment focuses on the business of a merchant bank, stock-broking, fund and asset management. In 2023, this segment accounted for 13 % of the group PBT (before inter-company elimination).
- Insurance: This segment includes underwriting all classes of general and life insurance businesses in Malaysia. In 2023, this segment contributed 5% of the group PBT (before inter-company elimination).

Others: This includes the operation of investment holding

companies, money-broking, and other related financial services.

To assess Affin, I compared its performance with a panel comprising of 10 Bursa Malaysia banks (including Affin) as shown in Table 1. What is presented here is a purely quantitative analysis. I have not assessed the qualitative

aspects such as the adoption of digital technology, customer satisfaction, and brand performance.

#### **INDUSTRY BACKGROUND**

The Malaysian banking landscape is characterized by a diverse array of institutions. These ranged from domestic giants to international players. There are currently 10 banks listed under Bursa Malaysia.

- In terms of total assets, they ranged from RM70 billion to RM1,001 billion with an average of RM359 billion.
- In terms of market capitalization, they ranged from RM5 billion to RM109 billion.

In global terms, except for CIMB and Maybank, the Bursa Malaysia banks are small. To give you a sense of the scale on a global basis, I used HSBC as a reference. HSBC in Malaysia has a network of more than 50 branches. HSBC Holdings Ltd which is listed on the LSE has a total asset of RM1,581 billion and a market cap of RM718 billion.

Secondly, many of the Bursa-listed banks are universal banks. Universal banks diversify their offerings beyond traditional banking services. They may provide retail banking services (loans, deposits, and basic financial services), insurance products, investment banking services (underwriting, mergers and acquisitions), and stock broking services.

#### PEER COMPARISON

I looked at several metrics to assess Affin's performance relative to the peers. I classified the performance into 4 – returns,

efficiency, loan performance, and capital adequacy. Based on these 4 groups of metrics, I would rate Affin's performance as below the sector median.


- The gap in the returns between Affin and its peers widened over the past 18 years.
- While the gap in the net interest margin (NIM) did not widen over the past 18 years, we cannot say this for the efficiency ratio. Affin was a less efficient company in 2023 compared to 2018.
- Affin was more conservative than its peers when it came to lending. However, this did not prevent it from incurring higher non-performing loans (NPL) from 2017 to 2020.
- The only positive sign was that Affin's capital adequacy ratio had improved relative to its peers over the past few years.

From an outsider's perspective, I would say that while this is a safe bank from a capital adequacy perspective, there is room for significant improvements. I hasten to add that because of their universal banking model, we may not be comparing apples to apples by looking at NIM and loan performance.

Summaries of the key metrics are presented in the following sections. Note that in the following charts, the left part shows the panel performance. The right part compares the panel performance with that of Affin.

#### RETURNS

You can see from the left part of Chart 1 that the sector ROE grew from 2009 to peak in 2010/11. It then began to decline to reach the bottom in 2020/21. Compared to the peers, Affin's performance was worse than the peer median ROE. Refer to the right part of Chart 1.



The main reason for the declining trend was the declining macroeconomic environment. The following extracts from Affin's Annual reports give you a picture of this.


"...private consumption contracted...which was also reflected in the services sector...This translated into lacklustre domestic demand, easing loan growth, greater pressure on earnings, and concerns over asset quality from the possible rise in impaired loans." - 2017 **Annual Report** 

"...Macroeconomic conditions remained volatile and the banking sector continued to accommodate and adjust to regulatory and industry changes. Business and household lending were tepid, while deposits growth moderated further..." - 2019 Annual Report.


#### **NET INTEREST MARGINS AND EFFICIENCY**

The net interest margin (NIM) is a key determinant of a bank's overall profitability. A wider margin suggests that the bank is more efficient in earning interest income compared to its funding costs. Chart 2 shows the sector and Affin NIM. You can see that the NIM in 2023 was lower than that in 2009. One of the reasons for the declining NIM was the higher cost of funds. The drop in 2011 was explained by Affin as follows:

"...lower net interest income following a contraction in net interest margin as Bank Negara Malaysia raised the Overnight Policy Rate by 25 basis points." - 2011 Annual Report.



I also looked at another efficiency metric – the efficiency ratio. This measures the operational efficiency of a bank by evaluating how well it manages its operating expenses relative to its revenue. It is expressed as a percentage and provides insights into the cost-effectiveness of a bank's operations. When you look at the operating efficiency, you can see from the left part of Chart 3 that there were no significant trends for the sector. However, Affin experienced a deteriorating efficiency ratio. Its non-interest expense as a ratio of its net revenue was higher in 2023 compared to that in 2009. With the worst NIM and efficiency ratio of its peers, it does not look good for Affin.




#### **LOAN PERFORMANCE**

I looked at two metrics here - Gross loan-to-deposit ratio (GLDR) and Non-performing loans (NPL) ratio. The GLDR is an important indicator for assessing a bank's liquidity and risk exposure. A lower GLDR suggests a more conservative approach to lending.


A higher GLDR may indicate a higher risk for the bank, as it suggests a larger portion of the bank's funds are tied up in loans. If a significant portion of these loans becomes non-performing, the bank may face challenges in meeting its obligations.

Looking at the left part of Chart 4, you can see that over the past 15 years, there was an increase in the GLDR in 2015. This ratio then remained about the same over the next 8 years. We see the same pattern for Affin. But Affin's ratio was consistently lower than the sector median ratio.



While the GLDR focuses on the quantity of loans about deposits, it doesn't directly address the quality of the loans. I thus look at the NPL ratio. A higher NPL ratio suggests a larger proportion of the bank's loan portfolio is at risk of default, indicating potential credit risk and deteriorating asset quality. The positive sign is that when you look at the NPL ratio performance over the past 15 years,


we see an improving trend for the sector. Refer to the left part of Chart 5. Unfortunately for Affin, its NPL ratio increased from 2017 to peak in 2020 before declining. Overall Affin did worse than the sector median.




## **CAPITAL ADEQUACY RATIO (CAR)**

I looked at 2 ratios - Tier 1 capital adequacy ratio and total capital adequacy ratio. These measures are used to assess a bank's capital adequacy. Investors and rating agencies often consider the Tier 1 CAR when evaluating a bank's financial health and risk profile. A strong Tier 1 CAR is generally seen as a positive indicator of a bank's stability and prudential risk management.

In this context, the Tier 1 capital adequacy ratio for the Malaysian listed banks has been improving over the past 15 years. Refer to the left part of Chart 6. We also see improvements for Affin when since 2019, the Affin ratio was better than the median of its peers.



The total capital adequacy ratio is a financial metric that measures a bank's overall capital adequacy and its ability to absorb potential losses arising from various risks. The total CAR takes into account both Tier 1 and Tier 2 capital, providing a comprehensive assessment of a bank's capital strength. You should not be surprised to see that the trends for the total capital adequacy ratio show a similar pattern as that for the Tier 1 capital adequacy ratio. Refer to Chart 7.



#### **VALUATION**

I carried out a comparative valuation of the panel companies based on the following metrics. Refer to the original article for the details.

- Earnings value (EV) derived from 3 DCF methods dividends, notional dividends, and residual income.
- Asset value (AV) based on its tangible book value.

The margins of safety for the various companies were obtained by comparing the respective market prices in Feb 2024 with the corresponding AV and EV. Since assets and liabilities are marked to market for banks, the tangible book value serves as a floor value. This is especially true if the companies have been profitable every year.

Table 2 summarizes the margins of safety for the 10 banks. I look for a 30% margin of safety.

Only BIMB, HLFG, and RHB meet the 30% margins of safety under the Earnings value. Some banks have negative margins of safety under the Asset Value.

In the case of Affin, there is not

enough margin of safety under the Earnings Value. You should not be surprised given its low and declining returns. But there is more than a 30% margin of safety under the Asset Value.

#### CONCLUSION

A value trap is a company that while appearing cheap is cheap because it is facing fundamental issues. While Affin has not been performing well relative to its peers, it is not a loss-making bank. While it has low returns, it has been profitable every year. If the dividends paid are less than the profits, the equity of the bank will continue to grow.

The other metric in assessing whether it is a value trap is the margin of safety. Affin has a margin of safety of over 30 % based on its tangible book value. However, there is not enough margin of safety based on its Earnings Value. While it may not be a value trap, you may be overpaying for the bank based on its Earnings Value. The reality is that the market places more emphasis on the Earnings Value rather than the Asset Value. So, if you are investing hoping for a re-rating, there must be some expectation of better

performance. In this respect, the Sarawak State Government has recently acquired a substantial stake in Affin. I see this as a potential catalyst for improving the business performance of Affin.

You can understand why I do not consider Affin a value trap.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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# SC-KHAZANAH MOU TO CATALYSE MID-TIER COMPANIES ACCESS TO CAPITAL MARKET

he Securities Commission Malaysia (SC) has inked a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Khazanah Nasional Bhd to support the growth and expansion of Malaysian mid-tier companies (MTCs). A joint statement on Thursday said this would be done via the Dana Impak Fund to raise funding access and to help MTCs familiarise with the capital markets to catalyse their growth and expansion. The aim is to build a strong pipeline of capital market-ready MTCs.

The MOU will focus on measures to support MTCs' next growth phase and joint programmes and initiatives to raise their awareness and access to the capital market. This includes fundraising incubation for 60 to 100 MTCs to enhance capital market readiness, specialised capacity-building programmes to



raise competitiveness and innovative capacity and investments to spur growth. The MOU supports the SC's five-year road map "Catalysing micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) and MTC Access to the Capital Market (2024-2028)".

According to SC chairman Datuk Mohammad Faiz Azmi, SC appreciates Khazanah's support of the MSME and MTC Roadmap and SC's long-term goal to ensure an inclusive and holistic capital market fundraising ecosystem. MTCs are significant domestic employers and economic contributors. However, they have been identified as the 'missing middle', as they often face difficulties in accessing financing for growth. This MOU will address such challenges to ensure sustainable growth and resilience.

Meanwhile, Khazanah, via Dana Impak, has earmarked an initial RM500 million to provide funding to MTCs. This funding will be directed to high-potential MTCs via the private markets, be it private equity or private credit funds, ensuring greater access to capital.

# BEV SALES SURGED 112% IN 1H2024 - ZAFRUL

ccording to Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, a total of 6,617 batterypowered electric vehicles (BEVs) were sold in 1H2024, marking a significant 112% y-o-y surge in the electric vehicle (EV) market. In comparison, he said 3,117 units of BEVs were sold in



1H2023. He added that the ministry should be on track to meet the target of having 20% of total industry volume (TIV) comprising EVs by 2030.

Speaking at the launch of Stellantis C10 SUV, he said this remarkable growth not only signals the consumers' growing interest, but also demonstrates Malaysians' general buy-in to contribute to the national and global environmental agendas.

On charging stations, he said that as of Sept 30, 2024, more than 3,171 charging stations have been installed nationwide, including 813 DC fast chargers. He hopes to reach the goal of 10,000 charging stations by end-2025.

The automotive industry remains a vital pillar of Malaysia's economic growth, contributing an impressive 4% to 5% to national gross domestic product (GDP) annually, and supporting over 700,000 jobs. In 2023, Malaysia's automotive sector recorded total import value of RM62.14 billion, with RM37.15 billion attributed to the import of automotive parts and components.

On the export side, the sector recorded total value of RM18.01 billion, with RM13.26 billion from exports of automotive parts. The significant disparity between imports and exports has led to a trade deficit for the sector.

He said that as the world's fourth-largest automaker and a leading mobility solutions provider, Stellantis' choice of Malaysia as the first market in Southeast Asia for Leapmotor reflects the confidence that global players have in the country's growing role as a hub for new energy vehicles.


He added that he was thrilled when Stellantis announced its decision to establish Malaysia as a regional manufacturing hub as part of its 'Built in Asean for Asean' strategy, alongside a regional headquarters for Asia Pacific. He is optimistic that this decision will significantly boost the automotive industry, facilitate advanced technology transfer and enhance our exports.

Stellantis Leapmotor launched its new all-electric SUV, the C10, marking its first major entry into the Southeast Asian market with its launch in Malaysia. The C10 is part of Leapmotor International, a 51:49 joint venture between Stellantis and Leapmotor.

The all-new electric C10 is offered at a limited-time introductory price of RM149,000 on the road, excluding insurance, for bookings made until Nov 30, 2024. After this period, the price will be set at RM159,000. It is available in four exterior colours - glazed green, pearly white, canopy grey, or Tundra grey — and two interior options: criollo brown (exclusive to glazed green) and midnight aurora.

#### **EYE ON THE MARKETS**

On Thursday (170ct), the Ringgit closed at 4.3130 against the USD and 3.2810 to the Sing Dollar. On Monday (140ct), the FBM KLCI opened at 1637.17. As at Thursday (170ct) 5:00pm, the FBM KLCI closed up 4.27 points at 1641.44. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 161.35 points (+0.37%) to 43,239.05 whilst the NASDAQ added 6.46 points (+0.04%) to 18,373.54.

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t is common to see board Chairman involved in committee meetings, but their presence may give rise to potential conflict of interest and undue influence during deliberations of committee matters.

## **MSWG ENGAGES WITH CLIMATE GOVERNANCE MALAYSIA ON CLIMATE CRISIS**

The pivotal role of the Chairman cannot be understated in corporate governance. As the board's leader, a Chairman is responsible for fostering collaboration and overseeing boardroom conduct and practices that align with corporate governance standards. However, when the chairman becomes directly involved in committee meetings, it can blur the lines of responsibility and create governance concerns.

# **EXISTING REQUIREMENTS**

The Malaysian Code on Corporate Governance (MCCG) sets clear guidelines to mitigate such conflicts. Practice 1.4 of the MCCG stipulates that the chairman of the board should refrain from holding membership in the Audit Committee (AC), Nomination Committee (NC), or Remuneration Committee (RC). According to the regulator, attending these committee meetings by invitation is also viewed as a departure from this Practice, as it may compromise the independence and objectivity required for effective governance.

Whilst Practice 1.4 only explicitly restricts the board Chairman from chairing the AC, NC or RC, a "substance over form" approach would suggest that the same position should also extend to other board committees instituted by the company, e.g., Risk Committee, Investment Committee, and Tender Committee. This broader application helps prevent potential conflicts and governance issues.

Additionally, this Practice aligns with Paragraph 12.4 of Bank Negara Malaysia's (BNM) Policy Document on Corporate Governance, which clearly outlines that the board Chairman must not chair any board committees.

The board Chairman's involvement in any board committee may induce risks of self-review and compromise the objectivity required when deliberating the board committees' observations and recommendations. The Chairman should refrain from participating in these committees to uphold adequate checks and balances.



These guidelines complement the segregation of roles between Chairman and Chief Executive Officer (CEO), as outlined in Practice 1.3 of MCCG and Paragraph 11.3 of BNM's Corporate Governance Policy. The board's Chairman must not be an executive or have not served as the financial institution's CEO in the past five years.

This requirement is not unique to Malaysia but is practised globally. For example, the UK Corporate Governance Code, updated in January 2024, reinforces these principles. It advises that the board chairman should not be a member of AC and should not chair the NC when appointing his successor. Furthermore, the Chairman may only be a member of the RC if he is independent at the time of his appointment, but he cannot chair this committee either. This consistent guidance across multiple governance frameworks highlights the importance of safeguarding independence and avoiding conflicts of interest in board leadership.

## WHY IT MATTERS?

Ensuring the integrity and effectiveness of the boardroom is paramount for sound corporate governance. The separation of the Chairman from board committees is crucial to achieve this. The importance of this approach lies in the factors below:

- Risk of self-review: When the same individual serves as both Chairman of the board and Chairman of key committees such as the Audit, Nomination, or Remuneration Committee, it creates a risk of self-review, potentially compromising the Chairman's objectivity and the board's decision-making process. To safeguard the integrity of board deliberations and maintain a robust system of checks and balances, the Chairman should not chair these committees. Instead, the Chairman should hear the committee's recommendations for the first time during board



meetings, as this enhances objectivity, removes potential bias, and ensures an independent and impartial review.

- Potential conflict of interest: The Chairman may have vested interests in certain outcomes, which could bias the committee's decisions. This potential conflict of interest can undermine the committee's ability to make impartial and objective decisions that prioritise the company's best interests.
- The presence of the dominant Chairman: The Chairman's presence in committees may stifle open discussion and discourage the expression of diverse viewpoints. A domineering Chairman may suppress innovation and critical thinking, as committee members may feel intimidated or reluctant to voice differing opinions.
- Time commitment: Juggling attendance between multiple committees requires significant time and focus. If the Chairman is spread too thin, they may be unable to dedicate sufficient attention to each committee, which could impair the overall decision-making process.
- **Ineffectiveness:** Extending the Chairman's involvement across various roles may dilute his ability to juggle his primary duties and committee responsibilities.

## IT IS CHALLENGING TO ADOPT FOR SOME ...

Companies with a small board size often require the Chairman's involvement in board committees, as each committee typically requires at least three members. These companies may find it challenging to exclude the Chairman from these roles, mainly if the Chairman is an independent director. Additionally, companies with an Executive Chairman who also plays the role of the company's Managing Director or Chief Executive Officer will find it hard not



to participate in the meeting as he or she will be representing the management to table the board papers.

We also noted a situation where the board Chairman attended the board committee meetings to facilitate leadership transition. For instance, the **Executive Chairman of Hexza Corporation** Berhad was invited to participate in NC and RC meetings to ensure a smooth transition for the newly appointed Group CEO.

# **MSWG'S OBSERVATION**

Our data shows that 179 (38%) of the 470 companies in 2023 did not adopt Practice 1.4 of MCCG, compared to 375 (42%) out of 883 companies in 2022<sup>1</sup>. The common justification for their departure from this Practice is the perceived value of the Chairman's contributions. Many companies argue that their Chairmen have provided valuable insights and

contributions during board and committee meetings, thus retaining the chairman's involvement at the committee level.

(excerpt from the PLCs CG reports)

"The Chairman's participation at the committee level should be determined by his ability to contribute and participate, as much as the need for objectivity. The Board also believes that the objectivity in receiving or assessing committee reports has not been diminished."

"The Chairman is the most isolated person among board members and without the benefit of attending committee meetings, the chairman has limited access to information and the benefits of the detailed deliberations and discussions at the Committee stage, the Chairman's presence at committee meetings therefore allows him the opportunity to certify and validate certain matters of the company to fulfil his fiduciary duties."

"... for efficiency purposes to enable the Chair of the Board to have the benefit of hearing the deliberations held to understand the rationale of recommendations made by these Board Committees, without having the discussion points repeated at Board meetings. This approach makes effective use of all of our Directors' valuable time to facilitate quicker Board discussions."

What did they say ....

Additionally, these companies believe their Chairmen have consistently demonstrated objectivity and professionalism in deliberating board matters, ensuring their recommendations and observations are well-founded and impartial. Some companies also argue that sufficient safeguards are in place to maintain checks and balances when the board chairman participates in committee meetings, either as a member or an invitee. A common justification is that the Chairman abstains from deliberations and voting on matters where they have an interest, thus mitigating potential conflicts of interest.

# MSWG'S QUESTIONS TO PLCS

During a recent virtual AGM, we raised concerns with Company H about their departure from Practice 1.4 of the MCCG. Although the Company's Independent Non-Executive Chairman was not a member of AC, NRC and Risk Management Committee, he regularly attended these meetings by invitation.

In its Corporate Governance Report, the Company explained that this practice was intended to streamline decision-making by eliminating the need for briefings during board meetings, leading to more efficient, informed, and balanced outcomes.

While the Board acknowledges our comments and the requirements of the Practice, it justified that the Chairman has limited access to information without the benefit of attending committee meetings. His presence at committee meetings, they argued, allows him to better certify and validate board matters, enabling him to fulfil his fiduciary duties more effectively.

During the AGM, MSWG questioned the Board committee's decision to invite the Chairman, a former regulator, to join the committee meetings. This was particularly notable given that the Chairman himself had previously established the guideline that the



Chairman of the board should not sit on the board committees, and his current presence at these committee meetings appeared to contradict the standards he had once enforced. The Company responded, "... while guidelines suggesting that a Chairman should not serve on these committees may be appropriate in situations where the Chairman is also a major shareholder, reconsideration is needed in cases where the Chairman is non-executive and independent."

## TIME TO MAKE A CHANGE

We strongly urge PLCs to adopt Practice 1.4 as a critical measure to safeguard the independence of board committees, minimise conflicts of interest, and ensure a clear distinction between governance and oversight roles. When the same individual serves as both Chairman of the board and Chairman of key committees such as the Audit, Nomination, or Remuneration Committees, it poses a significant risk of self-review. This dual role may diminish the Chairman's objectivity, creating the potential for bias and impairing the quality of the board's deliberations on matters crucial to the company's governance. The involvement of the Chairman in these committee processes may lead to an undue concentration of power, undermining the checks and balances essential for effective corporate governance. To preserve the integrity of the board's oversight, the Chairman must remain independent from these committees, thereby ensuring more impartial and robust decision-making.

By excluding the Chairman from chairing these committees, PLCs can strengthen internal governance mechanisms, preventing individuals from wielding excessive influence over crucial



decisions that impact the company's strategic direction and performance. This separation allows the Chairman to encounter the committee's recommendations for the first time during board meetings, which not only enhances objectivity but also removes the risk of pre-emptive bias or perceived conflicts of interest. This fresh perspective contributes to more transparent and balanced discussions at the board level, as the Chairman can evaluate matters with an independent viewpoint that has not been influenced by prior involvement in committee deliberations. In turn, this promotes a culture of fairness, where governance is led by a broader range of voices and not overly dominated by any single individual.

Furthermore, excluding the Chairman from committee meetings fosters a diversity of perspectives within the committees themselves. Including various viewpoints is critical for ensuring that discussions are well-rounded, unbiased, and reflective of different expertise and insights. The independence of these committees allows them to operate without undue pressure, leading to more thorough and balanced evaluations of issues related to audit, nominations, and remuneration. When committee members are free to express their viewpoints without the presence of the Chairman, it cultivates a governance environment where decisions are made based on merit and collective wisdom rather than being influenced by hierarchical dynamics.

Ultimately, embracing these governance practices will contribute to the establishment of a more effective and independent board structure. By reinforcing the separation of roles, PLCs can enhance transparency and accountability, ensuring that governance decisions are made in the company's and its shareholders' best interest. This strengthens investor confidence and aligns with global corporate governance best practices, positioning PLCs to achieve sustainable growth and long-term success in an increasingly complex business landscape.
