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
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#### BNM maintains OPR at 1.75% as global economy continues to improve

ank Negara Malaysia's (BNM) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has decided to maintain the overnight policy rate (OPR) at 1.75%, with the central bank citing the continued improvement in the global economy given the easing of containment measures across more economies and strong policy support. In its Monetary Policy Statement, the bank said that the reopening of production facilities led to a resumption of manufacturing and trade activities, although the recovery in the service sector has been slower. Financial conditions have improved, although risk aversion remains elevated. The outlook is still subject to downside risks and uncertainties, primarily due to the risk of a resurgence of the pandemic and weaker labour market conditions. Economic activity in Malaysia continues to recover from the trough in April and the latest high frequency indicators show that labour market conditions, household spending and trade activity have continued to improve. The economic recovery is also supported by the fiscal stimulus packages, as well as monetary and financial  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right) +\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right) \left( 1\right) +\left( 1\right) \left( 1$ measures. Looking ahead, the improvement is expected to continue into 2021, supported by the recovery in external demand and expansion in private sector expenditure. However, the pace of recovery will be uneven across sectors, with economic activity in some industries remaining below pre-pandemic levels, and a slower improvement in the labour market. The outlook is still subject to downside risks, given the ongoing uncertainties surrounding the course of the pandemic domestically and globally. Inflationary pressures are expected to remain muted in 2020 with headline inflation likely to average negative in 2020 amid lower global oil prices, although it is expected to average higher in 2021. However, the outlook will continue to be affected by global oil and commodity prices. The cumulative 125 basis points' (bps) reduction in the OPR this year will continue to provide stimulus to the economy. Given the outlook for growth and inflation, the MPC considers the stance of monetary policy to be appropriate and accommodative.

#### No return of a nation-wide movement control order (MCO)

According to Minister (Defence) Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, the government will not impose a nation-wide movement control order and instead is adopting a targeted approach to control the spread of Covid-19 infections. However the government has taken a drastic approach to restrict trips to and from high risk countries, considering the possibility of a third wave during winter months. Based on the Health Ministry's Scoring Board: Merit System that uses data from the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control as well as Our World in Data, there are several criteria to consider. He was referring to entry bans on citizens from 23 countries. These include the number of Covid-19 cases, incident rate per million residents and death rate per million residents, all during the last 14 days, cumulative death rate, recovery index, and cases over 150,000. The restrictions are necessary to control the number of import cases and to protect Malaysians from the third Covid-19 wave. However diplomats and their families and delegations coming here for bilateral discussions are exempted. Expatriate pass holders and skilled workers will also be allowed entry into Malaysia soon. But they are required to get approval from the immigration department and a supporting letter from the Malaysian Investment Development Authority or relevant agencies prior to entry.

#### Service providers encouraged to use digital signatures

According to Deputy Communications and Multimedia Minister Datuk Zahidi Zainul Abidin, service providers are advised to use digital signatures regulated under the Digital Signature Act 1997, in the management of their companies. The move was necessary to prevent the company's network system from being exposed to cyber threats. The digital signatures can improve the efficiency of management and service delivery by any public or private sector agencies without having face-to-face interactions. The use of digital signature was safer because the public or users who wanted to use it had to register first with the Certification Authority (PBP) for identity verification. By using a digital signature, the identity of a user has been verified by the PBP and the recipient of the documents signed with digital signatures can use it with confidence as it is safe

#### Nation's economy improving - MoF

According to Deputy Finance Minister II Mohd Shahar Abdullah, the early economic indicators for July 2020 have shown that the nation's economy is improving. Exports have increased by 3.1 per cent year-on-year while sales of passenger cars and commercial vehicles also rose by 27.3 per cent and 44.8 per cent respectively, during the month, compared to June 2020. Meanwhile domestic passenger movement also increased by 215.8 per cent compared to the previous month and the number of cars on tolled highways rose by 7.4 per cent month-on-month. The contraction in the GDP had gradually reduced from 28.6 per cent in April, 19.5 per cent in May and down to 3.2 per cent in June. This clearly shows economic improvement in line with the reopening of economic sectors which started in May and the recovery is expected to continue especially in the second half of the year (2H 2020). Based on the better projections for 2H 2020, Bank Negara Malaysia has announced that the nation's economic growth for the whole of 2020 is expected to be between -5.5 per cent and -3.5 per cent, but will grow by about 5.5 per cent to 8.0 per cent next year. The government will continue to implement various initiatives to improve the people's well-being, support businesses and revitalise the economy.

#### Moratorium worth RM81.9bil granted as of Aug 28

According to Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, the value of the loan moratorium on loan repayments to financial institutions which came into effect on April 1  $\,$ is estimated at RM81.9 billion as of Aug 28, 2020. Of the total amount, RM28.6 billion was  $\,$ utilised by the business sector and the remaining RM53.3 billion by individual borrowers. A total of 732,000 borrowers who took the automatic moratorium have resumed their monthly loan repayment instalments compared with 336,000 borrowers in April 2020. As of Aug 28, banks have contacted over 2 million borrowers comprising individuals, small and medium enterprises (SMEs) and other companies, including corporate entities and commercial businesses, to offer loan repayment assistance. With the loan moratorium expiry on Sept 30, banking institutions are ready to continue to provide assistance to borrowers who are still affected by the Covid-19 outbreak, in the form of a loan moratorium extension and targeted assistance from Oct 1. The initiatives are aimed at ensuring access to financing for businesses and households who really need assistance. As commercial manufacture of a Covid-19 vaccine will take time, the nation's banking system needs to stay robust and resilient in order to be ready for any future eventuality.

This week, on Thursday (10Sep), the Ringgit slipped to 4.1655 against the USD from 4.1485 on Monday (7Sep). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0460 to the Sing Dollar on Thursday (10Sep). On Monday (7Sep), the FBM KLCI gained 0.52 points or 0.03% to 1516.38 from previous Friday's close of 1515.86. But as at Friday (11Sep) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI continued its slide to 1485.81 which started last week. It appears that the recent bull run fuelled by the surge in new retail investors is losing steam due to the soon ending moratorium, forcing them cash out from the market in preparation to resume repaying their loans. Additionally the severe correction in the local glove sector the tech sector rout in the US market which saw NASDAQ down to 10,919.59 and the Dow continue its drop to 27,534.58 have had an impact on the regional markets.
