

# *Is* **CJ** **CENTURY** an investment opportunity?

## SUMMARY

- **CJ Century Logistics Holdings Berhad (CJCEN: 7117. MY)** achieved a 10.1% CAGR in revenue over the past 12 years. But profitability declined due to margin compression and underperforming ventures like courier services.

- While operating efficiency has been mixed, CJ Century could benefit from digital transformation trends and its ties to CJ Logistics Korea.
- The Group has maintained positive operating cash flow every year, reduced its debt, and demonstrates disciplined capital allocation with good cash conversion.
- Its NTA is over 3 times the market price, offering a margin of safety. If the company can improve contribution margin and capital turnover by about 10%, it may offer long-term value.

## BACKGROUND

CJ Century provides an integrated suite of logistics services encompassing contract logistics, freight forwarding, transportation, and supply chain management. Its operations are grouped into two main segments:

- **Total Logistics:** This is the Group's core business, offering end-to-end, customized supply chain solutions. Services include freight forwarding, contract logistics, transportation, and oil logistics.
- **Procurement Logistics:** This segment focuses on sourcing, product assembly, packaging, warehousing, and distribution, particularly for home and electrical appliances.

As shown in Chart 1, Total Logistics was the largest contributor to both revenue and EBIT. However, in 2023, the segment experienced a downturn. According to the 2023 Annual Report: "...freight rates suffered a significant decline during FY2023, resulting in a substantial reduction in our revenue, particularly derived from our freight forwarding operations."

## OPERATING PERFORMANCE

Over the past 12 years, CJ Century's revenue grew at a 10.1% CAGR, but PAT declined. Refer to the left part of Chart 2.

Revenue growth accelerated after CJ Logistics Corporation of Korea entered in 2016, partly due to the expansion into courier services - a venture the Group exited in 2021 after underperformance.


Profitability, however, had already started to decline by 2015, with management citing cost pressures from a competitive environment. Since then, margins have continued to shrink:

- Total logistics EBIT margin: 15% (2015) to 2% (2023).
- Procurement logistics EBIT margin: 12% (2015) to 6% (2023).

Returns also deteriorated as shown in the right part of Chart 2.

- ROIC averaged 5% vs. 8% WACC.
- ROE averaged 6% vs. 10% cost of equity.

This indicates that value was not created for shareholders.

There was a mixed picture when it came to efficiency. Gross profitability showed no improvement, and both EBIT and gross margins declined. However, asset turnover and SGA efficiency improved, while contribution margin stabilized after earlier declines. Fixed costs remained modest at 19% of total costs, indicating low operating leverage.

EXTERNAL DYNAMICS

The logistics sector in Malaysia is neither a sunset nor high-growth one, with market growth forecasts ranging from 5.3% to 7.8% CAGR through 2030. CJ Century likely holds about a 5% market share based on current estimates.

While growth projections seem modest, the rise of online trading has transformed logistics demands. This is driving the need for faster delivery, cross-border capabilities, fulfilment services and real-time tracking. This shift suggests significant digital disruption potential.

Though the disruption is unlikely to mirror the collapse of industries like newspapers, logistics players must adapt. Global leaders like DHL, CJ Logistics (Korea), and Lotte Global Logistics are embracing automation, AI, and smart logistics solutions. Given CJ Century’s Korean ties, it is well-positioned to draw on this experience to reinvent itself and stay competitive.

PEER PERFORMANCE



in revenue among its peers and recorded the highest revenue growth rate. However, over the past 12 years, its performance was slightly below average in terms of return on capital and EBIT margin. Refer to Chart 3.

## FINANCIAL POSITION

I would consider CJ Century as financially sound based on the following.

- It had RM91 million in cash and short-term investments as of the end of December 2024. This is about 14% of the total assets.
- As of the end of Dec 2024, it had a debt-to-equity ratio of 36%. This had reduced from its 64% high in 2019.
- Over the past 12 years, it has had positive cash flow from operations every year.
- From 2013 to 2024, it generated RM446 million cash flow from operations compared to the RM189 million PAT. This is a good cash conversion ratio.
- Over the past 12 years, it had an average negative Reinvestment rate. I defined Reinvestment as = CAPEX + Acquisition – Depreciation & amortization + Increase in Net Working Capital. The negative Reinvestment arose because, in many years, the amount spent on CAPEX + Acquisitions was more than offset by Depreciation & amortization. This is a good sign as it meant that

NOPAT need not be used to fund growth but can be returned to shareholders.

- It has a good capital allocation plan as shown in Table 2. You can see that the cash flow

from operations was enough to fund its CAPEX and acquisitions.

VALUATION

The NTA of CJ Century was RM0.72 per share (as of Dec 2024) compared to its market price of RM0.22 per share (as of the end of Dec 2024).

While there is more than a 30% margin of safety under the Asset Value, the issue is whether this is a realistic picture. I posit that this is a reliable estimate of the intrinsic value if the Group can continue to improve its performance.

In this context, the challenge for CJ Century is not revenue growth but operating improvements. In the context of my valuation, it is about improving 2 key parameters – contribution margin and capital turnover (revenue / total capital employed).

According to Prof Bruce Greenwald, in a competitive environment, the Asset Value = Earnings Power Value. Along this line, I look at the performance where the Earnings Power Value = NTA. On such a basis, I estimated that the RM0.72 per share implied that the Group must deliver 10% improvements to the past 2 years' average contribution margin and capital turnover. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

If you believe that the Group can deliver this improvement over the few years, then this is not a value trap but an investment opportunity.

## CONCLUSION

CJ Century is not a broken business, but neither is it a clear-cut value opportunity yet. While its strong revenue growth and sound financial position are positives, long-term profitability and efficiency remain concerns. The Group has not consistently created shareholder value, with returns falling short of capital costs over the past decade.

However, its improving cash flow profile, Korean strategic backing, and potential to leverage digital transformation present a credible turnaround narrative. If CJ Century can improve its contribution margin and capital turnover modestly, by about 10%, the current market price suggests meaningful upside based on the Earnings Power Value.

This is a stock for patient investors who believe in operational recovery. If you are confident that it can execute on efficiency improvements, CJ Century may prove to be a hidden gem rather than a value trap.

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# OPR maintained at 3%; vigilant on domestic inflation and growth outlook - BNM

**A**ccording to Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM), the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has decided to maintain the Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) at 3%. The latest indicators point towards continued global growth and trade, supported by domestic demand and front-loading activities. Global growth outlook would remain supported by positive labour market conditions, less restrictive monetary policy and fiscal stimulus. However, the tariff measures announced by the US and retaliations have weakened the outlook on global growth and trade. This outlook remains subject to considerable uncertainties, which include outcomes of trade negotiations and geopolitical tensions. Such uncertainties could also lead to greater volatility in the global financial markets.

For Malaysia, economic activity expanded further in the first quarter, driven by sustained domestic demand and continued

export growth. Moving forward, the escalation in trade tensions and heightened global policy uncertainties will weigh on the external sector. The continued demand for electrical and electronic goods and higher tourist spending, however, will provide some cushion to exports. Overall, growth is expected to be anchored by resilient domestic demand. Employment and wage growth, particularly within domestic-oriented sectors, as well as income-related policy measures, will support household spending. The expansion in investment activity will be sustained by the progress of multi-year projects in both the private and public sectors, the continued high realisation of approved investments, as well as the ongoing implementation of catalytic initiatives under the national master plans.

Overall, the balance of risks to the growth outlook is tilted to the downside, stemming mainly from a deeper economic slowdown in major trading partners, weaker sentiment amid higher uncertainties affecting spending and investments, as well as lower-than-expected commodity production. Meanwhile, favourable trade negotiation outcomes and pro-growth policies in major economies, as well as more robust tourism activity could raise Malaysia's growth prospects.

Headline and core inflation averaged 1.5% and 1.9% in the first quarter of 2025 respectively. Overall, inflation in 2025 is expected to remain manageable, amid moderate global cost conditions and the absence of excessive domestic demand pressures. Global commodity prices are expected to continue to trend lower, contributing to moderate cost conditions. In this environment, the overall impact of the announced domestic policy reforms on inflation is expected to be contained. Risks to inflation would be dependent on the extent of spillover effects of domestic policy measures, as well as external developments surrounding global commodity prices, financial markets and trade policies.

The Ringgit performance will continue to be primarily driven by external factors. Malaysia's favourable economic prospects and domestic structural reforms, complemented by ongoing initiatives to encourage flows, will continue to provide enduring support to the Ringgit.

At the current OPR level, the monetary policy stance is consistent with the current assessment of inflation and growth prospects. Recognising that there are downside risks in the economic environment, the MPC remains vigilant to ongoing developments to inform the assessment on the domestic inflation and growth outlook. The MPC will ensure that the monetary policy stance remains conducive to sustainable economic growth amid price stability. 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# **SRR Ratio to be lowered to 1%; approx RM19bil to be released into banking system - BNM**

**A**ccording to Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM), it will lower the Statutory Reserve Requirement (SRR) Ratio by 100 basis points, from 2% to 1%, effective 16 May 2025. The decision to reduce the SRR is part of BNM's continuous efforts to ensure sufficient liquidity in the domestic financial system. This will facilitate banks to better manage liquidity in an environment of greater financial market volatility and provide continued support for financial intermediation activity. The SRR reduction will release approximately RM19 billion worth of liquidity into the banking system.

The SRR is an instrument to manage liquidity and is not a signal on the stance of monetary policy. The Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) is the sole indicator used to signal the stance of monetary policy and is announced through the Monetary Policy Statement released after the Monetary Policy Committee meeting.

# HEINEKEN Malaysia Sustains Momentum in 1QFY2025

**H**eineken Malaysia Berhad (HEINEKEN Malaysia) announced its financial results for the first quarter ended 31 March 2025 (1QFY25), delivering steady performance and sustaining its momentum in a dynamic market




landscape. In the first quarter, the Group experienced a decline in revenue by 3% compared to the same quarter in 2024. The decrease is primarily influenced by the timing of Chinese New Year (CNY), with this year's festive period occurring in January, resulting in an earlier sell-in activity that took place in the fourth quarter of last year. In comparison, CNY in 2024 occurred in February, driving a more concentrated sales period within the first quarter as sales momentum spanned over two months.

Despite the slight decline in revenue in 1QFY25, the Group maintained a steady Profit Before Tax (PBT) of RM161 million and net profit of RM122 million, demonstrating strength and stability.

According to Managing Director of HEINEKEN Malaysia, Martijn van Keulen, the company is resilient in maintaining profitability which is reflected on disciplined cost management and a focus on financial efficiency.

## EYE ON THE MARKETS

On Thursday (08May), the Ringgit closed at 4.2765 against the USD and 3.2966 to the Sing Dollar. On Monday (05May), the FBM KLCI opened at 1541.78. As at Thursday (08May) 5:00pm, the FBM KLCI closed up 0.96 points at 1542.74. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 254.60 points (+0.62%) to 41,368.57 whilst the NASDAQ added 189.98 points (+1.07%) to 17,928.14.

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**W**idad's recent deal with Hextar Technologies may offer a long-term growth narrative, but it comes at the cost of immediate earnings and shareholding dilution, and heightened uncertainty over who is truly steering the ship.

## CAUGHT BETWEEN A ROCK AND A HARD PLACE

Widad Group Berhad, a company weighed down by mounting losses and high debt, is probably in a quandary. It desperately needs a lifeline, but at the expense of its near-term prospects.

On 15 April 2025, Widad inked a deal with Guper Bonded Warehouse Sdn Bhd (GBW) to acquire four parcels of freehold industrial land measuring 10.395 acres in Negri Sembilan (the Subject Land) for RM31.3 million. GBW is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hextar Technologies Solutions Berhad (HexTech).

The land is slated to become the foundation of Widad's entry into property development, a diversification play that envisions a RM135.29 million commercial development. The planned developments include labour quarters, showrooms, nursing homes, and retail spaces. The project is expected to begin in 2027 and reach completion by 2029. It is worth noting that the estimated gross development cost amounted to RM105.5 million.

On the surface, this may look like a calculated long-term bet. But the catch of the deal is the manner of settlement of the transaction. The purchase will not be funded by cash but by issuing 993.65 million new shares at 3.15 sen apiece to the vendor, GBW. This will grant HexTech a 24.15% stake, making it Widad's largest shareholder.

Dato' Ong Choo Meng, Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director of HexTech, already holds a 4.9% stake in Widad<sup>1</sup>. His sister Tzu Chuen owns another 2.39%. Including the new issuance to HexTech, Ong's effective influence in Widad will rise substantially. Meanwhile, Widad's founder and Group Executive Chairman, Tan Sri Muhammad Ikmal Opat Abdullah, will see his stake diluted to 10.32% from 13.61%.

The potential shift in shareholder power dynamics hints at a realignment of control. And then here lies the dilemma – HexTech has no intention to stay on. In its filing, HexTech openly stated that it would gradually divest its Widad shares to fund its technology ventures and working capital.

No timeline was given for the complete disposal of shares. But surely the incoming controlling shareholder will soon turn seller, putting Widad shares under selling pressure. Already, Widad was hammered down to a penny stock a year ago.

For minority shareholders, the large issuance of new shares to finance the acquisition will significantly dilute their ownership and may lead to short-term value erosion. For Widad, the expanded share base will result in substantial dilution of earnings per share.

## **IS THE SEREMBAN LAND A PROMISING BUY?**

The Subject Land is located approximately 5km to the north of Pekan Nilai and approximately 30km to the north-west of Seremban town centre. It is said that industrial parks were built within the vicinity, surrounded by large residential townships and commercial developments. The land seems attractive based on the details given.

Yet, the question persists: If this land is so promising, why is HexTech offloading it?

According to HexTech's announcement, the disposal is meant to "unlock value" and "monetise" the land. If the land holds such untapped value, wouldn't HexTech be better off developing the land itself, since the Company is part of the Hextar Group with a presence in the property industry?

Instead, it is settling for shares in a loss-making construction firm with high gearing and a challenging outlook. This calls into question the commercial logic of the transaction and whether the land is as valuable as pitched. Was Widad sold a "hidden gem" or risk being a vehicle to offload some least desirable assets?

For HexTech, holding Widad shares subjects it to price volatility. There remains a market risk that when the shares are sold in the open market, the actual price recovered may be less than the transaction value due to the difference between the actual realised price and the issue price.

## NO APPARENT TURNAROUND IN SIGHT

Financially, Widad is still in deep water. It has been loss-making since FY2022, with net losses ballooning to RM23.9 million in FY2024 from RM6.13 million two years ago. Revenue has been hovering between RM137.74 million and RM230.61 million, and cash reserves fell 15.5% year-on-year to RM131.73 million.

Though borrowings decreased slightly to RM422.63 million, the debt-to-equity ratio remains alarming at 0.98 times. Widad has begun asset disposal to pare down its borrowings. It inked a sale and purchase agreement recently to dispose at loss of a 12- storey office building in Damansara Heights for RM41.5 million cash.

Upon completion of the Proposed Acquisition of Seremban Land, Widad will likely incur additional financial commitments for the planned development, including construction costs, consultant fees, etc. It intends to fund the proposed development via a combination of internally generated funds, equity fundraising and debt financing.

Given its high gearing and persistent losses, there may be a challenge for Widad to secure the necessary financing for the proposed development. In addition, higher financing costs on account of its financial condition will also significantly increase the costs of the project and in turn affect Widad's cashflows and profitability in the future.

Besides, minority shareholders are advised to clarify with the board and management on the level of internal rate of return (IRR) and payback period that they have deliberated and considered before proposing the transaction.

Shares of Widad closed unchanged at 3.5sen on 28 April 2025, giving the company a market capitalisation of RM109 million. The counter has experienced a decline of 12.5% so far this year.

## WHAT NOW?

From a corporate governance perspective, the change in shareholdings invites concerns about a looming leadership vacuum.

With Muhammad Ikmal's influence waning and HexTech planning an exit, Widad risks drifting without clear strategic leadership. This begs questions of who will be at the helm, the potential changes to the board or management, and its future strategy.

While the deal may offer a long-term growth narrative, it comes at the cost of immediate earnings and shareholding dilution, and heightened uncertainty over who is truly steering the ship. Until further clarity is provided, Widad remains in limbo.
