SUMMARY

- Lysaght Galvanized Steel Berhad (9199.MY) operates in the specialized steel pole sector. This is a mature but stable industry with global demand growth driven by infrastructure and utility investments.
- Over the past 12 years, revenue grew marginally while PAT declined, with no clear signs of improved productivity or capital efficiency. Cash flow generation was also inconsistent.

 Lysaght also underperformed local and international peers in EBIT margin and return on capital. Despite its weaknesses, Lysaght's stock appears undervalued relative to its asset and earnings-based valuations.


BACKGROUND

Lysaght was originally focused on manufacturing corrugated steel pipes, guardrails, and highway furniture. But it has since expanded into the design and production of poles, masts, transmission poles, telecommunication and transmission towers, and substation structures.

The company operates under a single business segment and therefore does not present a breakdown by segment. In 2023,

exports accounted for approximately 54% of total production, continuing to rise over the past 12 years, as illustrated in Chart 1.

Lysaght operates in the specialized steel pole sector. This appears to be a mature but stable industry with steady



growth prospects rather than a declining one. Market research supports this view:


- The high mast lighting market is expected to grow at a 4.8% CAGR from 2024 to 2034.
- The utility poles market was valued at USD 57.65 billion in 2023 and is projected to grow at a 4.0% CAGR through 2030.

These trends suggest a modest demand outlook for Lysaght's core products.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

Over the past 12 years, revenue grew at a modest CAGR of 0.6%, while PAT declined at a compounded annual rate of 0.4%. Performance during this period was inconsistent and can be grouped into three distinct phases:

- 2012–2017. As shown on the left side of Chart 2, during this period, PAT trended upward despite a decline in revenue, driven by improvements in gross profit margins that more than offset the lower top line.
- 2017–2020. During this period, both revenue and PAT declined, largely due to weakening gross profit margins (right side of Chart 2).
- Post-2020, revenue recovered, ending 2023 about 6% higher than in 2012. However, gross margins, while improved from the 2020 low, remained below 2012 levels. As a result, PAT in 2023 was still lower than in 2012.



The company did not provide product-level revenue breakdowns, making it difficult to assess whether margin changes were driven by product mix or operational efficiency. However, the declining trend in gross margins and contribution margins suggests a lack of productivity or efficiency gains.

A DuPont analysis reinforces this view: asset turnover remained flat. Nonetheless, there were two encouraging signs:

- Leverage increased as total assets grew faster than total capital employed.
- · Selling, General, and Administrative (SGA) expenses remained stable as a percentage of revenue over the decade (right side of Chart 2).


PEER PERFORMANCE

Among Bursa-listed companies, only Mestron Holdings Bhd shares Lysaght's focus on the steel pole business.

However, given Lysaght's significant export exposure, I also included several international peers for comparison. These include Valmont Industries (VMI) and Hill & Smith Holdings (HILS).

- VMI is a US-based global manufacturer specializing in infrastructure and agricultural solutions, including utility poles, lighting structures, and mechanized irrigation systems.
- HILS is UK-based international group providing infrastructure products and galvanizing services, focusing on enhancing the resilience and sustainability of vital infrastructure and the built environment.

As shown in Chart 3, Lysaght consistently recorded the lowest EBIT margin and ranked near the bottom in terms of return on capital among this peer group, indicating relatively weak financial performance.



FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Lysaght as financially sound. As of the end of December 2024,

- It had a debt-equity ratio of 0.3%.
- It had RM89 million in cash, equal to 50% of its total assets.
- Over the past 12 years, it also had an average Reinvestment rate of 32%.
- It had a reasonable capital allocation plan as shown in Table 1. The cash flow from operations was more than sufficient to fund its CAPEX, and the excess was returned to shareholders.

My main concern was with its cash flow generation track record. Over the past 12 years, there were 3 years with negative cash flow from operations. During this period, its total cash flow from operations amounted to RM112 million compared to its total PAT of RM130 million. This is not a good cash conversion ratio. However, I think the positive points outweigh the cash flow from the operations.

VALUATION

I would summarize the fundamental position of Lysaght as follows:

 While profitable throughout the past 12 years, returns were volatile.

- There does not seem to be any improvement in operating or capital efficiencies.
- Compared to its peers, I would rate it as below average.

Despite its lacklustre fundamentals, there were sufficient margins of safety compared to the market price as of the end of December 2024 of RM 2.74 per share. Refer to the original article for the details.

- I estimated Lysaght's Asset Value to be RM4.08 per share based on its Book Value as of Dec 2024.
- Its Earnings Power Value, based on its past 3 years' average contribution margin and capital turnover, was estimated to be RM4.76 per share.
- Its Earnings Value, assuming a 4% perpetual growth rate, was estimated to be RM5.26 per share. I also assumed the past 3 years' average contribution margin and capital turnover.

Is Lysaght a value trap?

A value trap occurs when a stock appears undervalued but remains depressed due to hidden structural issues. In Lysaght's case, the stock trades with over a 30% margin of safety, prompting the question: is this discount driven by sentiment or by deeper problems?

My analysis suggests the latter is unlikely. While Lysaght may not qualify as a "wonderful company" in the Buffett sense, it operates in a mature - not sunset- industry. There is no sign of digital disruption, and it faces no fundamental business distress.

Its Asset Value approximates its Earnings Power Value, indicating a competitive but stable environment with efficient asset utilization. The company is also financially robust, with cash making up half of its asset base.

In short, Lysaght does not appear to be a value trap. The discount likely reflects market pessimism rather than business weakness.

CONCLUSION

Lysaght operates in a mature industry with stable long-term demand, underpinned by global infrastructure growth. While the company has remained profitable and maintains a solid balance sheet with prudent capital allocation, its operational performance has been lacklustre.

Over the past 12 years, revenue growth has been minimal, profit margins have deteriorated, and cash conversion has been weak. Furthermore, compared to both local and international peers, Lysaght ranks below average in terms of returns and efficiency.

Despite these concerns, the current market price reflects a significant margin of safety relative to its intrinsic value estimates.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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EPF Records Total Investment Income of RM18.31 billion for Q1 2025

he Employees Provident Fund (EPF) recorded a total investment income of RM18.31 billion for Q1 2025 ended 31 March, a 13% decline from RM20.99 billion in the corresponding period in 2024. The total investment income includes RM1.02 billion mark-to-market gains on securities that have not been realised, due to foreign exchange rate fluctuations. In line with the EPF's policy, these gains will not be distributable as dividends.

According to EPF Chief Executive Officer Ahmad Zulgarnain Onn, global markets turned volatile early in 2025 on renewed trade frictions and policy uncertainty. Whilst the announcement of tariffs was made by the US administration on 2 April, uncertainties surrounding US trade policies had begun to affect major stock markets throughout the quarter. Despite the moderation of inflationary pressures in many economies, the pace and timing of



monetary policy easing differed across regions, dampening risk appetites. He noted that the diversified global portfolio cushioned the impact and kept the EPF on course for long-term value creation.

During the quarter under review:

- Equities contributed RM10.81 billion, a 23% decline from RM14.02 billion recorded in Q1 2024. The drop was mainly due to weaker performance across global equity markets and a challenging investment climate. The asset class continued to be the highest contributor, accounting for 59% of total investment income.
- Fixed Income continued to anchor capital preservation, contributing RM5.99 billion or 33% of total investment income. Fixed income, comprising Malaysian Government Securities and Equivalents, Loans and Bonds, continues to fulfil its dual mandate of delivering stable returns and as a counterbalance to equity market fluctuations. This underscores its strategic importance in safeguarding members' savings across market cycles.
- Real Estate and Infrastructure recorded an income of RM1.08 billion in Q1 2025.
- Money Market Instruments generated RM0.43 billion, in line with return expectations for these asset classes.

Of the total investment income, RM15.87 billion was generated for Simpanan Konvensional, and RM2.44 billion for Simpanan Shariah.

As of March 2025, EPF's total investment assets stood at RM1.26 trillion, with 38% invested internationally. During the period, international investments generated RM8 billion or 44% of the total investment income.

The EPF's domestic investments, which account for 62% of total assets, continued to provide long-term income stability through dividends, interests and profits from sukuk. The EPF remains committed to supporting Malaysia's economic growth by continuing to invest over 70% of its annual allocation in the domestic market. This reflects its role as a long-term investor and aligns with the Government's Ekonomi MADANI framework. Through the GEAR-uP initiative, the EPF is focused on building investment opportunities in the healthcare sector. This aims to capture long-term growth, address critical system gaps and support healthier retirement for Malaysians.

EPF ADOPTS CAUTIOUS OUTLOOK AMID HEIGHTENED GLOBAL UNCERTAINTY

Global economic conditions are expected to remain challenging amid persistent geopolitical tensions and the risk of high tariff and non-tariff barriers between major economies, particularly the United States and China. While some central banks have begun to ease monetary policy, concerns over global political instability, fiscal imbalances, and regional conflicts continue to dampen market sentiment and undermine investor confidence.

The International Monetary Fund has lowered its global growth forecast for 2025 to 2.8%, down 0.5 percentage point from its January projection. Correspondingly, Malaysia's real GDP growth forecast for 2025 is expected to be slightly lower than the original forecast of 4.5% - 5.5%, alongside a broader downward revision across the region. The downward revisions in global and regional growth forecasts, including Malaysia's, reflect rising external risks amidst shifting global trade dynamics.

In a more challenging and uncertain market environment, the EPF maintains a dynamic and well-diversified portfolio to help safeguard value and manage downside risks. It continues to

actively explore investment opportunities across both domestic and international markets to strengthen its portfolio and support long-term, sustainable returns for our members.

DRIVING OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE WITH FOCUS ON LONGEVITY FOR RETIREMENT SECURITY

Malaysia's resilient economy continued to support the labour market, with the unemployment rate decreasing to 3.1% in Q1 2025, from 3.3% a year earlier. During the period, the EPF registered 140,111 new members, raising total membership to 16.3 million. Of these, 8.88 million are active members. (Active members refer to members who contributed at least once in the last 12 months, representing 51.3% of the 17.31 million labour force. Department of Statistics Malaysia, Labour Force Malaysia March 2025.) The EPF's active-to-inactive member ratio remained stable at 54:46 in Q1 2025.

New employer registration reached 19,600 in Q1 2025, increasing total active employers registered with the EPF to 616,558. Total contributions increased by 15.1% to RM33.54 billion, up from RM29.13 billion in Q1 2024 (see Chart 1). Meanwhile, total voluntary contributions increased by 62% to RM7.02 billion, from RM4.33 billion a year earlier. The number of formal sector members contributing above the statutory rate was 10,990 in Q1 2025, compared to 6,771 in the same period last year.



SC Warns Public on Cloned Public Register Scam

he Securities Commission Malaysia (SC) has alerted the public on a new investment scam, involving a cloned version of the SC's Public Register of License Holders and Registered Persons.

This method of deceiving investors sees scammers falsely claiming to represent entities purportedly licensed by the SC. To support these false claims, potential victims are directed to a fraudulent website that mimics the SC's official Public Register portal.

Upon entering the name of the fake entity into this cloned site, the search result will show that the fake entity is legitimately licensed by the SC. The fake listing includes fabricated company registration numbers, license details, and other fictitious credentials.


Victims are persuaded to transfer funds into mule bank accounts allegedly for the purpose of investing. Since the discovery of this new investment scam, the SC has taken immediate steps to bring down the identified cloned websites.

Notwithstanding, the SC urges the public to be alert and never click on random links received from unknown sources. Investors should only use SC's official **Public Register** directly at **www.** sc.com.my to verify the legitimacy of an entity.

Investors are also reminded to avoid transferring funds into bank accounts of suspicious entities, which may possibly be mule accounts used by scammers. 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he publication of errata by PLCs has become rampant in both frequency and quantity recently. In May 2025 alone, 23 PLCs issued errata for incorrect information in their annual reports. MSWG urges PLCs to be more vigilant in vetting their annual reports to minimise errors and omissions before making them public.

MSWG RUES SURGE IN ANNUAL REPORT ERRATA

It is a fine line between making an honest mistake and committing an oversight on such a vital document as an annual report which necessitates the publication of an errata.



Issued after the official publication of annual reports, errata are typically intended to identify and rectify any 'serious' factual inaccuracies, omissions, miscalculations or typographical errors in the annual report.

Towards this end, MSWG wishes to express its dismay that an increasing number of public listed companies (PLCs) seemingly take corporate reporting lightly, resulting in the need to furnish amendments later.

In recent months, it seems the publication of errata has become rampant in both frequency and quantity. In May 2025 alone, 23 PLCs issued errata for incorrect information in their annual reports, according to announcements made on the Bursa Malaysia website.

Some errors appear minor, such as incorrect director nationalities or omitted explanatory remarks to allow shareholders to better understand the related figures.

Meanwhile, some are significant and potentially misleading. These include differing financial figures in the Management Discussion & Analysis section of an annual report and those of financial statements, omission of key disclosures such as the ESG Performance Data table, and material misstatements in financial ratios.

For instance, a major healthcare player reported inconsistent historical return on equity (ROE) figures across different sections of its annual report. Similarly, an aviation company disclosed inaccurate financial ratios, including return on total assets, operating profit margin, and net profit margin, with significant discrepancies between the original and corrected figures. The examples of these errata are available in Appendix A.

Inevitably, such stark differences raise concerns about the rigour of internal review processes and fall short of the standards expected from large-cap PLCs, which are presumed to uphold high levels of disclosure accuracy and corporate governance.



Some PLCs even issued errata without pinpointing what was being amended, leaving shareholders in the dark about what changes were made.

Such inconsistencies undermine the integrity of corporate disclosures and can mislead investors relying on annual reports for sound financial and strategic insights.

P.I.E. INDUSTRIAL'S 'SERIES OF BLUNDERS'

For awareness purposes more than anything else, MSWG draws particular attention to P.I.E. Industrial Berhad, an electronics manufacturing services (EMS) provider, whose AR2024 contains a few inconsistencies and factual errors, yet remains uncorrected at the time of writing.

That PIE Industrial AR2024 reveals significant shortcomings in ensuring accuracy and attention to detail (refer to the table below) is most regrettable. However, no errata have been issued as yet by the PLC at the time of writing.

The Group's failure to proofread the document, which resulted in numerous errors, has raised questions about its due diligence process, which could potentially erode shareholders' trust.

As highlighted by MSWG's scrutiny of PIE's AR2024, the glaring disparity between figures from its MD&A and Notes to Financial Statements can spark confusion, especially to learned investors, as some of the value differentials extend to as much as RM4.2 million.

Another glaring inconsistency in PIE's AR2024 entails the details of PIE Industrial's Thai subsidiary and the Group's shareholding, notably between "Pan International Electronics (Thailand) Co Ltd -55%" and "Pan International Electronic (Thailand) Sdn Bhd - 100%" found in the Group Corporate Structure section and Corporate Governance Overview Statement respectively.

These lapses raise serious questions about the company's internal controls, review processes, and commitment to corporate governance standards. More critically, such inaccuracies risk eroding shareholder confidence and damaging the company's market credibility.

MSWG had brought the matter to the Group's Board during its recently held AGM, and had also followed up after the meeting. To-date, we are still waiting for a response from PIE Industrial over the actions to be taken on the inconsistency of its information.

REPEATED DISCLOSURE LAPSES

As it is, recall that PIE Industrial had in April 2024 been found to have delayed material disclosure regarding the onboarding of a sizeable AI server client, despite such development being already exposed in an analyst report and reflected in the Company's

share price surge then1. Meanwhile, PIE Industrial also informed the press that the new customer was expected to contribute an additional RM2.5 billion in revenue to the Group for FY2025 and FY2026.

Prompted by sharp rise of its share price given analysts and the media were already aware of its lucrative contract wins than the investing public, PIE Industrial eventually disclosed some two weeks later that its wholly-owned subsidiary Pan-International Electronics (M) Sdn Bhd had on 31 March 2024 secured an overseas manufacturer specialising in servers and switches.

The delay raises concerns about timeliness and fairness of disclosure, especially when analysts and select media had earlier access to price-sensitive information than the investing public.

Such selective disclosure practices run counter to the principles of transparency, equitable treatment of shareholders, and accountability, as enshrined in the fundamentals of good corporate governance practices.

In this regard, MSWG calls on both the PIE Industrial management and its board to urgently review and strengthen their internal processes for ensuring disclosure accuracy, conducting materiality assessments, and effective stakeholder communication. A proactive, transparent response in the form of timely issuance of errata and a clear explanation of rectifications is vital for shareholders' benefits.

As for all PLCs, MSWG urges them to be more vigilant in vetting their annual reports to minimise errors and omissions before making them public. We call for stringent quality control and internal review processes in the publication of announcements. Lastly, we expect PLCs to come forward and promptly communicate amendments to shareholders and investors when errors are discovered.

Auditors also play a critical role in upholding disclosure integrity. While the primary responsibility for accurate and timely disclosure lies with management and the board, external auditors are expected to exercise professional scepticism and evaluate whether material information, particularly developments that may significantly impact future earnings is adequately reflected in the financial statements and accompanying disclosures. A lapse in this regard not only raises questions about the robustness of the audit process but also risks undermining investor confidence in the company's overall reporting ecosystem.

Corporate Malaysia must not treat reporting obligations lightly. The list of errata, particularly without adequate disclosure of what has changed, reflects poorly on governance standards.

After all, annual reports are not mere formalities. They are statutory disclosures and critical instruments of corporate accountability. Stakeholders, particularly minority shareholders, deserve accurate and comprehensive information to make informed decisions
