









Is there an investment opportunity in Leidos

SUMMARY

- · Leidos Holdings, Inc. (NYSE: LDOS) grew revenue at a 6.9% CAGR from 2017 to 2024, driven primarily by acquisitions.
- While LDOS does not emphasize efficiency in its plans, margins and capital turnover improved post-2020 acquisitions, suggesting successful integration and cost control.

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- LDOS underperforms peers in EBIT margin, ROIC, and EPS. But it is financially sound with strong cash generation, modest reinvestment needs, and a solid capital return track record.
- With an intrinsic value of USD185 per share providing a 28% margin of safety, the stock warrants a "wait and watch" stance for long-term value investors.

BACKGROUND

LDOS is a science, engineering, and technology company that delivers products and services primarily in defense, aviation, IT, and biomedical research. In 2024, LDOS restructured its operations into four segments - National Security and Digital; Health & Civil; Commercial & International; and Defense Systems.

From 2017 to 2023, it operated under three segments: Defense Solutions, Civil, and Health.

Despite this change in segment reporting, the company's core customer base remains the same: the US government, which accounted for an estimated 87% of total revenue in 2024, consistent with 2023 (Chart 1).

LDOS remains heavily US-focused, with an estimated 92% of 2024 revenue coming from the US operations.

Note: 2024 estimates are based on extrapolated YTD Sep 2024 data.


Over half of the company's US government revenue comes from the Department of Defense and the intelligence community, indicating that LDOS's fortunes are closely tied to US defense spending. However, this is not a high-growth segment. Statista states US defense outlays are projected to grow at less than 2% CAGR over the next decade.

To address this limited growth outlook, LDOS appears to be expanding its presence in commercial and international markets, though these remain relatively small parts of its business today.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

From 2017 to 2024, revenue grew at a CAGR of 6.9%, driven by a mix of organic growth and acquisitions. Refer to the left part of Chart 2. A rough sense of the growth drivers can be inferred from capital allocation.

Over the past eight years, LDOS spent approximately USD3.5 billion on acquisitions, versus only USD0.9 billion on capital expenditures. This suggests that acquisitions were the primary engine of growth - a logical strategy given the modest long-term growth in US defense spending.



From 2017 to 2024, LDOS generally experienced a profit uptrend, except for a dip in 2023. (Chart 2, left). The main reason for the 2023 drop was a USD596 million goodwill impairment, equivalent to roughly 9% of the company's 2022 goodwill balance. Excluding this one-off charge, 2023 net income would have exceeded 2022 levels.

EFFICIENCY GAINS DESPITE LACK OF STATED FOCUS

The underlying profit growth was supported by improvements in both gross profit margins and Selling, General and Administration (SGA) efficiency. Given LDOS's modest revenue growth outlook, one might expect a strategic focus on efficiency improvements. However, a review of the company's past seven years of business plans, as disclosed in its statutory filings, reveals no explicit mention of such initiatives.

That said, the financials tell a different story, with multiple indicators pointing to improving operating and capital efficiency:

- Gross margins have improved steadily (Chart 2, left).
- SGA margins have declined, signalling better cost control (Chart 2, right).
- Both operating margins and capital turnover have improved in recent years.
- These trends combined to drive an improving contribution margin from 2020 to 2024.

Although 2023 included some goodwill write-offs, the broader picture suggests that LDOS did not overpay for these acquisitions and successfully realized cost and margin synergies.

For a company that relies heavily on acquisitions and divestitures as part of its growth strategy, the ability to integrate deals without bloating its cost structure is a critical competitive strength.

PEER COMPARISON

I benchmarked LDOS against a group of defense-focused peers, as shown in Table 1. While LDOS is one of the smaller players in terms of revenue, it delivered one of the strongest revenue growth rates between 2017 and 2023.

However, its operating performance tells a different story - LDOS ranks among the weakest in the group:

- It recorded one of the lowest EBIT margins and returns on capital.
- While LDOS led the group in levered free cash flow margin in 2020, this metric has since deteriorated.
- Its EPS performance also lagged peers.

As a defense contractor, LDOS has not distinguished itself in terms of profitability or efficiency. It is unclear whether this underperformance reflects the company's role as a subcontractor or support provider, rather than a prime contractor directly engaged with the US government.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate LDOS financially sound based on the following.

- It had USD943 million in cash and short-term investments as of the end of December 2024. This was about 7% of its total assets.
- From 2017 to 2024, it delivered positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated USD8.2 billion cash flow from operations, compared to its USD5.1 billion net income. This is a very good cash conversion ratio.
- From 2017 to 2024, it had a Reinvestment rate of 35%. Excluding the acquisitions, it had a negative average Reinvestment rate.
 This meant that a big part of the NOPAT could be returned to shareholders.
- It had a good capital allocation plan as shown in Table 2. It is a cash cow where there were a lot of excess funds after CAPEX and acquisitions that were returned to shareholders.

While it had a debt-capital ratio of 55 % as of Dec 2024, this has decreased from its 2020 high of 57%. I would not worry too much about this debt level, given its historical cash generation ability as illustrated in Table 2.

VALUATION

I adopted the following picture in valuing the company. Refer to the original article for the details.

- Revenue growth of 10% in Year 1, gradually tapering to a terminal growth rate of 4% by Year 6. This results in an average CAGR of 7% over the forecast period, in line with its historical 8-year average.
- The starting revenue was based on projected 2024 revenue, extrapolated using a log-normal best-fit trend line on historical revenue data.
- For margins and efficiency, I assumed no further improvements in operating or capital efficiency. Both the contribution margin and capital turnover were set at their 2021–2024 averages to reflect the stabilized business profile following the major acquisitions in 2020.
- The Reinvestment margin followed the 2017–2024 average, consistent with LDOS's historical capital allocation behaviour.
- The tax rate was based on the 2019–2022 and 2024 average, excluding the abnormally low rates in 2017–2018 and the spike in 2023 due to goodwill impairments.

Based on these assumptions, I estimated an intrinsic value of USD 185 per share, versus the market price of USD 144 as of the end of December 2024. This implies a margin of safety of just 28 %, within striking distance of my 30 % target.

CONCLUSION

Leidos has delivered respectable revenue growth over the past eight years, primarily through acquisitions. This is a rational strategy given the low-growth nature of the US defense sector.

While there are signs of improving operational and capital efficiency, these were not explicitly articulated as strategic priorities in the company's filings. A good sign is that LDOS has shown discipline in integrating acquisitions without compromising its cost structure.

That said, when benchmarked against defense peers, LDOS lags in terms of profitability, return on capital, and earnings per share. Nonetheless, the company is financially sound.

LDOS has the fundamentals of a sound business. Its margin of safety is close to my 30% target, suggesting a stock to watch closely.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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SST revision &expansion for equitable taxation for protection of vulnerable groups - Amir Hamzah

ccording to Finance Minister II Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan, the SST revision and expansion exemplify the government's commitment to progressive and equitable taxation that strengthens fiscal position while protecting those who need it most. He said that as the government works towards the country escaping the middle-income trap, progressive taxation becomes an important tool for sustainable and inclusive growth.

This approach is deliberately targeted where every day Malaysians continue to enjoy zero per cent sales tax on essential and everyday goods like for instance chicken, rice, vegetables, cooking oil, and medicine. He added that basic construction materials remain untaxed, and small businesses with revenue below key thresholds are protected through carefully calibrated exemption.

The government had recently announced that it would implement a targeted revision of the sales tax rate and expansion of the service tax's scope which will be effective from July 1. The sales tax rate will remain unchanged for essential goods while a rate of either 5% or 10% will be imposed on non-essential or discretionary goods.

The scope of the service tax will be extended to include new services such as rental or leasing, construction, finance, private healthcare, education, and beauty services. He said the SST revision and expansion reflect an increasingly sophisticated tax system that reflects values of shared prosperity and, importantly, prevents the rich-poor gap from widening further.

The government is asking those with greater capacity to contribute more, which is why discretionary luxury items and imported premium goods will bear modest tax rates. This includes top-tier private education and premium medical services for non-citizens, ensuring that only the wealthiest citizens and residents contribute their fair share to the country's revenue base.

He noted that the additional revenue will flow directly back to rakyat-centric initiatives such as enhanced cash assistance via the Sumbangan Tunai Rakyat (STR) and Sumbangan Asas Rahmah (SARA) programmes, improved infrastructure, and better public services that benefit all Malaysians.

Since announcing the planned SST expansion in Budget 2025, the government has conducted extensive stakeholder engagements with industry groups and tax practitioners. The result is a policy that is both fiscally responsible and socially conscious.

He added that while it is not easy to balance between broadening the country's revenue base and protecting the majority of Malaysians, this latest initiative is a progressive step in that direction.

Malaysia's IPI to grow moderately at 2.0% in 2025 -MIDF Amanah

ccording to MIDF Amanah Investment Bank Bhd, Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI), which expanded at a slower pace of 2.7 per cent year-on-year (y-o-y) in April, is expected to grow moderately at 2.0 per cent in 2025.

The investment bank stated in a note that it is maintaining its forecast for the IPI to moderate to 2.0 per cent after the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) announced that the index rose by 2.4 per cent y-o-y in the first four months of 2025 (Jan-April 2024: 3.6 per cent).

It added that continued uncertainties from higher tariffs and intensified trade tensions, production of export-oriented products,


particularly manufactured goods, will be adversely impacted by weaker external demand and slower global manufacturing activities. Nevertheless, the frontloading and a temporary boost to trade activities could still support these vulnerable sectors which are exposed to the external slowdown.

It added that although there could be short-term support following the United States' decision to pause the implementation of reciprocal tariffs, encouraging progress from the ongoing trade talks will be crucial to reduce the adverse impacts of trade tensions on future demand outlook and production activities.

The investment bank maintains a positive growth (forecast) for the IPI for now as it expects production, especially in the domesticoriented sectors, to continue growing on the back of expanding domestic demand.

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ahya Mata Sarawak's quest to amend its Constitution faced opposition from shareholders amid corporate governance concerns.

FAST DECISIONS, SLIPPERY SLOPES? CMSB'S BOARDROOM BID BLOCKED

Sarawak-based conglomerate Cahya Mata Sarawak Berhad (CMSB) recent quest to amend the Group's constitution, which seeks to expedite or leave decision-making matters to its board of directors, has been rejected by its shareholders.

The outcome signals a growing awareness among shareholders of the need to uphold sound corporate governance practices, particularly in light of the ongoing legal proceedings and internal disputes within the controlling shareholder family.

For the record, 12 out of the 13 resolutions set out in CMSB's Notice of 50th AGM dated 30 April 2025, which were tabled at the 50th AGM, were duly passed at the Company's AGM held at the Waterfront Hotel in Kuching on 30 May 2025.

The resolution rejected by CMSB's shareholders was Special Resolution 1, pertaining to the proposed amendments to CMSB's constitution, with 67.03% of the voted shares in favour (comprising 297.10 million shares by 81 shareholders) and 32.97% voted against (comprising 146.12 million shares by 14 shareholders). Under the Companies Act 2016 (CA 2016) of Malaysia, a special resolution requires the support of at least three-fourths (75%) of the members entitled to vote.

According to the note accompanying its Notice of 50th AGM, the proposed Special Resolution 1, if passed, would have enabled CMSB to have a larger board, ensuring stronger oversight and increasing the variety of experiences, skills, and perspectives that lead to more comprehensive decision-making and better problemsolving.

It further justified the board's decision by noting that majority voting allows for quicker resolutions and is capable of avoiding delays, while providing a more streamlined and efficient decisionmaking process, especially when unanimous consent is not feasible or practical due to a large board size.

However, the very fact that the proposed amendment to its Constitution to allow decisions to be made by a simple majority of directors rather than by unanimous consent triggered concerns over whether boardroom checks and balances were being weakened under the guise of operational efficiency.



CIRCULAR RESOLUTION IN MOTION

A circular resolution is a mechanism that allows a company to pass resolutions (decisions) without the need for a formal meeting. It involves a written document setting out the resolution, which is circulated to the directors or members who need to approve it. They then sign the document to signify their agreement, thus effectively passing the resolution.

However simplistic it may sound, the concept of circular resolution somehow contradicts or runs afoul of the Third Schedule of the Companies Act 2016 (CA 2016), which serves as a model constitution for companies, whereby all directors must approve board circular resolutions.

In a nutshell, the Third Schedule of CA 2016 outlines the default procedures for the board of directors, including voting rights, resolution passing, committee formation, and the appointment of managing directors. This Schedule acts as a fallback if a company's constitution (or articles of association) does not explicitly address these matters.

Obviously, PLCs can deviate from this standard through constitutional amendments, which is precisely what CMSB attempted to do. To be fair, there is no doubt that sometimes administrative resolutions require urgent board approval and may not necessitate a board meeting.

CMSB'S PROPOSALS

Deemed Sarawak's biggest PLC in Bursa Malaysia, CMSB's business portfolio spans over 35 companies involved in cement manufacturing, phosphates manufacturing, oil tools, green technology, construction materials, trading, construction, road maintenance, property development, financial services and telco infrastructure, among others.



What could have triggered the discontent of its shareholders, of which MSWG fully sided with the opposition to the circular resolution mechanism, is the clause to allow board circular resolutions to be passed by a simple majority instead of a unanimous vote.

In this regard, CMSB contended that the change was necessary to enhance operational efficiency and expedite the Group's decision-making processes. However, this proposal raises broader questions about whether the governance framework was being re-shaped in favour of board convenience over transparency and accountability.

MSWG'S INTERVENTION, OBSERVATION AT AGM

MSWG had formally raised concerns about CMSB's proposed amendment, both in writing and during the AGM itself. We highlighted that the use of circular resolutions should not be seen as a substitute for real-time board discussions, particularly on complex or material matters.

We further argued that it may not be appropriate for directors, especially independent non-executive directors (INEDs), to often rely solely on a few pages of information provided by management to make decisions.

More so, reducing the approval threshold to a simple majority may be seen as an attempt to curb or bypass dissenting voices, especially if its Board has become more polarised or dominated by a particular bloc. Allowing such resolutions to pass by majority may dilute the quality of oversight and weaken the checks and balances of the board process.

In its responses to our questions, CMSB asserted that under its Company's Constitution, the Third Schedule shall not apply to the Company. It added that circular resolutions are typically used for



straightforward matters such as changes in signatories. Still, it is noted that delays occurred when certain board members refused to sign their names, thus resulting in significant holdups.

Whatever the case may be, CMSB further justified that its directors are not prevented from seeking clarification from the management or requesting an emergency board meeting, if needed, to facilitate their decision-making process.

We are not certain if this parameter is being formalised. Still, we felt jubilant that other minority shareholders, too, echoed similar concerns by questioning whether the proposed amendment would dilute the board's oversight role. Shareholders ultimately voted against the proposed amendment, resulting in the motion's defeat.

EFFICIENCY MUST NOT UNDERMINE OVERSIGHT

The defeat of the resolution sends an important signal that shareholders are prepared to stand up for stronger governance if proposals risk eroding transparency or bypassing meaningful deliberation.

While CMSB may have had legitimate intentions in proposing the change, corporate governance must always be evaluated not just for efficiency but for integrity. As the board is ultimately a steward of shareholders' interests, its decisions must always be made with accountability and inclusiveness.

As an advocate for good governance and shareholder rights, MSWG will continue to monitor similar proposals across corporate Malaysia to ensure that efficiency does not come at the expense of oversight.
