SUMMARY

- DKSH Holdings (Malaysia) Berhad's (5008 MY) profitability improved significantly after acquiring Auric Pacific in 2019 and implementing operational efficiency measures.
- While gross margins and contribution improved, other efficiency metrics (e.g., asset turnover, capital turnover) showed limited progress, suggesting gains have levelled off.

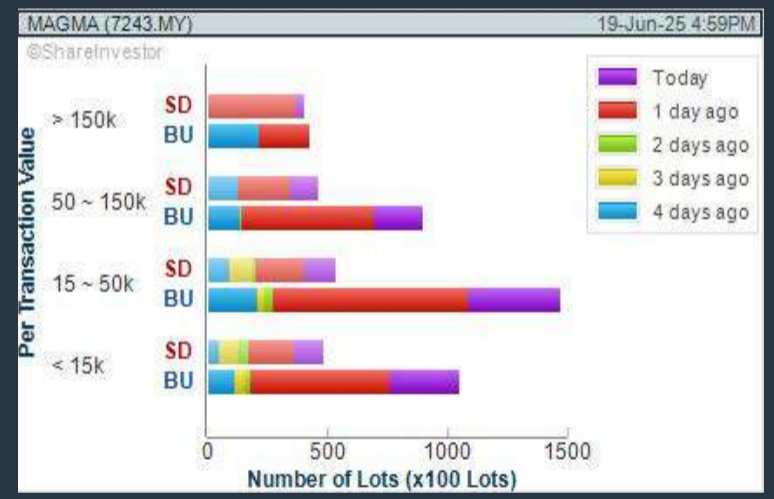

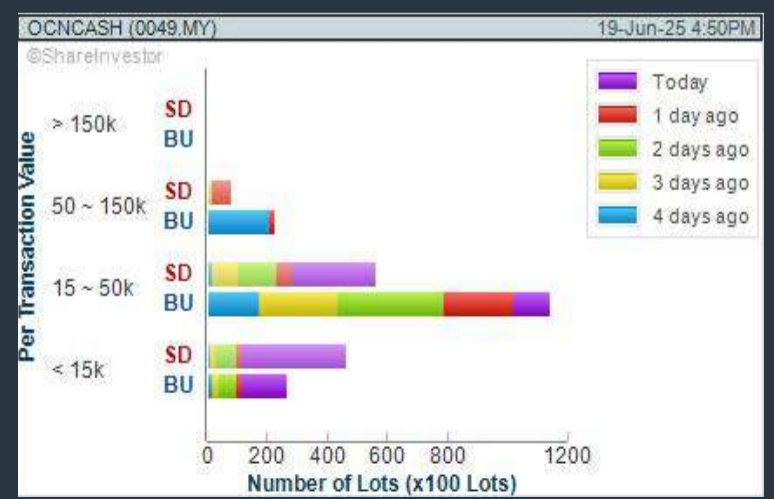

SUMMARY

- DKSH Holdings (Malaysia) Berhad's (5908.MY) profitability improved significantly after acquiring Auric Pacific in 2019 and implementing operational efficiency measures.
- While gross margins and contribution improved, other efficiency metrics (e.g., asset turnover, capital turnover) showed limited progress, suggesting gains have levelled off.

- Compared to similar Bursa-listed companies, DKSH delivered decent returns on capital but trailed in EBIT margins and capital allocation effectiveness.
- Despite an average financial position, DKSH's share price of RM5.00 (end Dec 2024) is well below its estimated intrinsic value (RM7.19 to RM9.60).

BACKGROUND

DKSH partners with companies seeking to grow their presence in the Malaysian market across consumer goods, healthcare, performance materials, and technology. The Group today provides:

- Full distribution services to small and medium-sized companies, who would normally outsource all aspects of their business except manufacturing;
- Bespoke, tailor-made solutions to large and some medium-sized companies.

The Group reported its business under 3 segments:

- **Consumer Goods:** In 2024, this segment accounted for about 54% of the Group's revenue and 58% of the segment's results.
- **Healthcare:** In 2024, this segment accounted for 45% of the Group's revenue and 42% of the segment's results;
- **Others:** Famous Amos chocolate chip cookie business and central overheads.

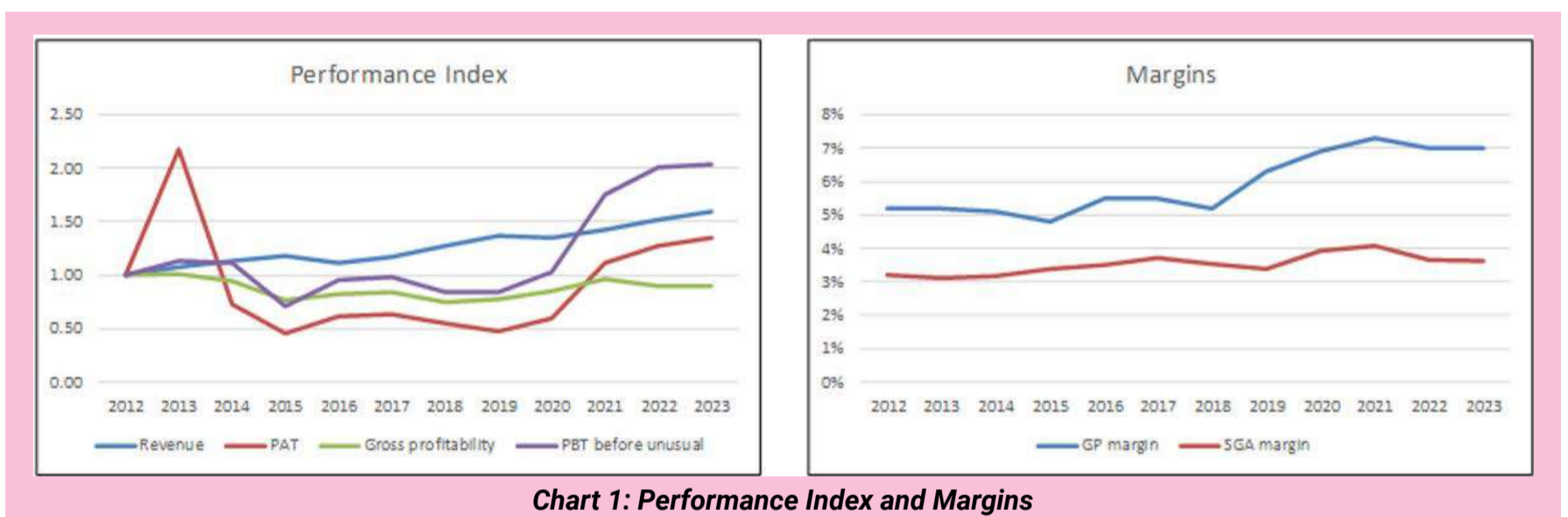
OPERATING PERFORMANCE

2019 was a crucial year for the Group as it acquired Auric Pacific (M) Sdn Bhd and undertook a major improvement project within

the Consumer Goods segment. Auric had a strong presence in the food service channel, serving hotels, restaurants, and cafes throughout Malaysia. It also covered chilled and frozen products in both food service and grocery channels.

From 2012 to 2023, while there was a continuous revenue uptrend, there was hardly any growth in profits till post-2019, following the Auric Pacific acquisition and profit improvement programme. Refer to the left part of Chart 1. Note that the spike in earnings in 2013 was due to a gain from an asset sale.

Looking at the right part of Chart 1, you can see that the profit growth post-2019 was due more to an increase in the gross profit margin than a decline in the Selling, General, and Administration (SGA) margin.



EFFICIENCY FOCUS

DKSH has consistently emphasized efficiency across its annual reports:

2020 Annual Report: “The improvement project has led to improved operating costs, working capital management, client portfolio, route-to-market development, sales force efficiency, inventory management...”

2021–2023 Reports: Continued focus on route-to-market optimization, sales force efficiency, receivables collection, productivity, and inventory control.

This focus translated into improving gross and contribution margins. However, other efficiency metrics show a mixed picture.

- **Operating Efficiency:** Operating profit margin and ROA improved. However, operating expense ratio, asset turnover, and inventory turnover remained flat.
- **Capital Efficiency:** Gross profitability rose, but capital turnover (revenue/TCE) showed little change, and the cash conversion cycle worsened.

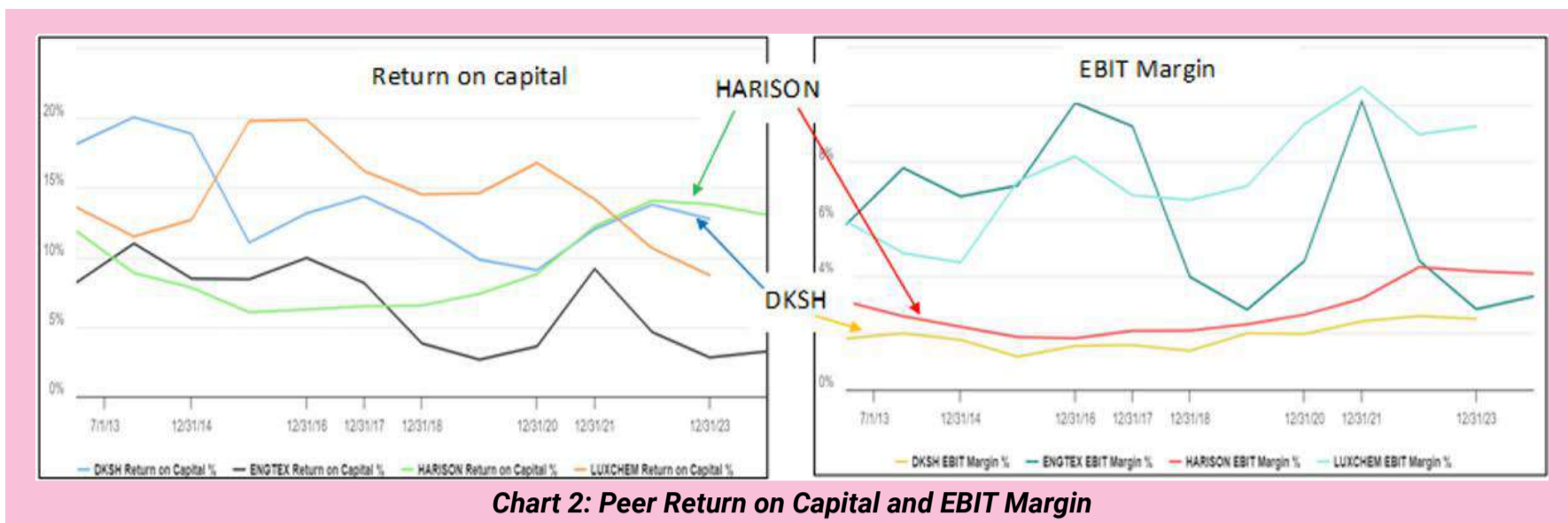
The data suggests the 2019 Auric Pacific acquisition gave a one-time boost. Beyond that, efficiency gains appear to have plateaued.

PEER PERFORMANCE

DKSH is fundamentally a trading and distribution company. Among Bursa-listed peers, Harrison's Holdings is the closest in terms of product mix. For comparison, I compared the DKSH with these peers based on the return on capital and EBIT margin:

- **Engtex Group** – Distributes pipes, fittings, steel, and construction materials.
- **Harrison's Holdings** – Distributes consumer goods, chemicals, and liquor.
- **Luxchem Corporation** – Distributes petrochemicals.

As shown in Chart 2, DKSH had the lowest EBIT margin, but this could be due to the differing product types. Harrison's EBIT margin was most comparable. On return on capital, DKSH ranked second, behind Harrison's on margin but ahead of it in capital efficiency over time. I would rate DKSH's performance as good but not leading.



FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate DKSH's financial position as moderately sound based on the following:

- **It had a volatile cash flow from operations.** Over the past decade, despite being profitable every year, there was 1 year with negative cash flow from operations. During this period, DKSH generated RM488 million cash flow from operations compared to the cumulative PAT of RM701 million. This is a poor cash flow conversion rate.
- As of the end of December 2024, **it had a debt-equity ratio of 66%** with RM103 million in cash (equal to 3% of its total assets).
- From 2012 to 2023, **it had a high average Reinvestment rate** (Reinvestment/NOPAT) of 85%. Of course, part of this was due to the acquisition of Auric Pacific.
- **Its capital allocation was not good.** Refer to Table 1. You can see that its cash

flow from operations was not sufficient to fund the CAPEX and dividends.

VALUATION

In estimating the intrinsic value of DKSH, I considered the 2019 to 2023 performance as a good representation of the future. Refer to the original article for the details. Based on this, I estimated the value of DKSH to be as follows:

- Asset Value of RM5.91 per share based on its Book Value as of Mar 2024. It has substantial goodwill in its books. As such, DKSH's NTA came to RM3.62 per share.
- Earnings Power Value (earnings value assuming zero growth) of RM7.19 per share.
- Earnings Value with 4% growth of RM9.60 per share.

The market price as of the end of 2024 was RM5.00 per share. You can see that there is a substantial margin of safety based on both the Asset Value and Earnings Value.

To estimate DKSH's intrinsic value, I used the contribution margin and capital turnover figures from 2019 and 2023, which I believe better reflect the Group's long-term sustainable performance. Had I used the averages from the broader 2012 to 2023 period, inclusive of weaker pre-2019 results, the estimated intrinsic value would have been much closer to the market price.

As discussed earlier, the Group's performance from 2019 to 2023 reflected genuine improvements driven by operational efficiencies and strategic acquisitions. In this context, using these years as the valuation baseline is not overly optimistic but rather a reasonable reflection of DKSH's normalized earnings potential.

CONCLUSION

DKSH presents a mixed but intriguing investment case. The 2019 acquisition of Auric Pacific and subsequent operational improvements significantly boosted profitability, but further efficiency gains appear to have plateaued.

While the Group demonstrates solid return on capital and competitive performance relative to peers like Harrisons, it lags in EBIT margins and capital allocation effectiveness. Its financial position is serviceable but not strong, marked by volatile cash flows and high reinvestment needs.

However, at RM5.00 per share, the stock trades well below both its estimated earnings value and asset value, offering a compelling margin of safety.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results “noisy” and focus on long-term trends.

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Malaysia's banking sector outlook maintained 'neutral', revised outlook for some Asian countries – Fitch Ratings

Fitch Ratings has maintained its “neutral” outlook on Malaysia’s banking sector for 2025 while adjusting the outlooks for several Asia-Pacific countries amid trade war exposures. The rating agency said it has adjusted its outlook for the banking sectors in South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam to reflect weaker prospects for banks in 2025 amid exposures

related to the US trade policies, though the overall banking sector outlook for Asia-Pacific remains “neutral”.

Meanwhile, it downgraded the outlook for South Korea, Taiwan and Thailand to “deteriorating” from “neutral” at the start of 2025, while the outlook for Vietnam was revised to “neutral” from “improving” previously.

In a statement, Fitch stated that it would maintain the ‘deteriorating’ outlook on China’s banking sector, reflecting persistent challenges for banks, as government policies weigh on profitability and banks experience asset quality pressure from a weaker economy and property sector.

Among the emerging markets, it has kept a “neutral” outlook on banking sectors in India, Indonesia, Philippines, and Mongolia.

On the “deteriorating” outlook for banking sectors in South Korea, Taiwan and Thailand, Fitch said that this is partly because banks’ loan growth, asset quality and profitability will likely weaken in these markets as tariffs rise, given their higher export exposure and sales to the US.

It added that there is great uncertainty around the ultimate trajectory of US tariffs, but Asia-Pacific’s high degree of trade openness and its exposure to US demand leave it particularly vulnerable to potential US tariff increases. For the most affected banking systems, lower profitability and weaker asset quality would be key channels for contagion from the tariffs.

It noted that the ultimate effects of the trade war on regional bank sectors would depend on final tariff outcomes, their impact on local economic growth, banks’ exposure to vulnerable sectors, and the potential for changes in fiscal, monetary or credit policy.

SST expansion will have minimal impact on house prices - Works minister

According to Works Minister Datuk Seri Alexander Nanta Linggi, the expansion of the sales and service tax (SST) which will take effect from July 1, will have a limited impact on house prices. The government has taken a measured approach to minimise the impact on housing construction costs, stating that public and residential housing developments are exempt to curb rising house prices.

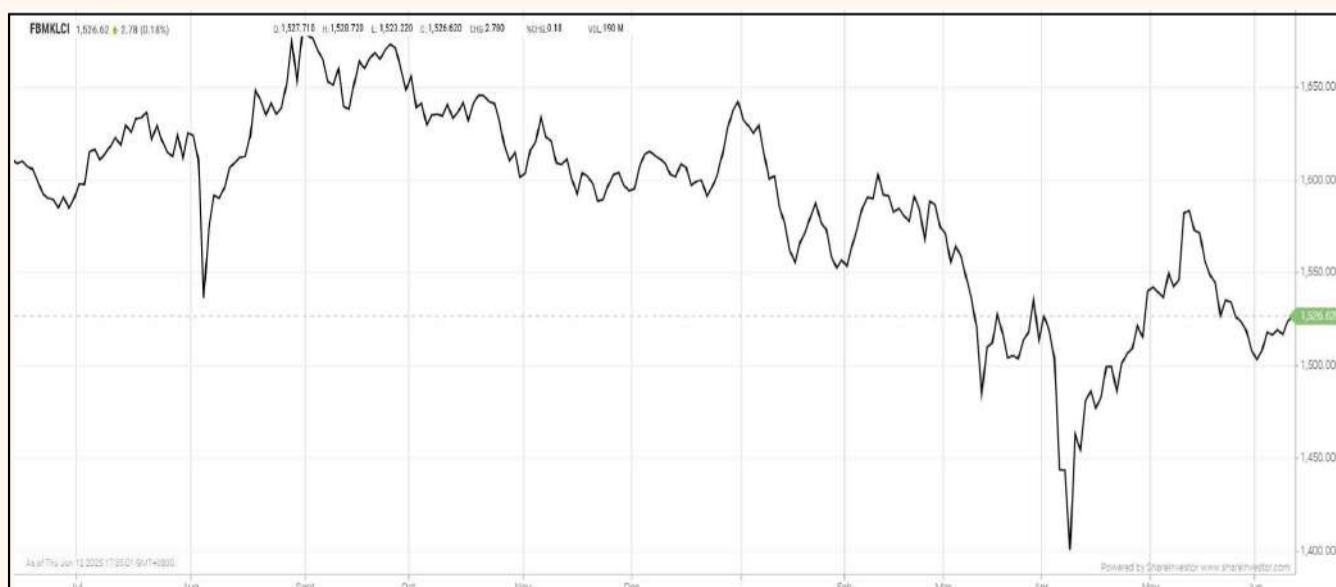
Speaking to reporters at the opening of the 27th International Surveyors Congress, he reassured that despite concerns over rising costs, the SST expansion will have a limited impact on house prices. The government's transitional measures are

designed to preserve momentum while ensuring a fairer and more sustainable tax system.

He added that the 12-month tax exemption will be granted to non-renewable contracts, giving contractors time to adjust pricing and project scopes. Moreover, double taxation will be avoided through specific transaction exemptions. He also highlighted that SST on basic construction materials remains at 0%, which ensures that essential supplies remain affordable.

On Thursday (19 June), the Ringgit closed at 4.2595 against the USD and 3.3099 to the Sing Dollar. On Monday (16 June), the FBM KLCI opened at 1517.87. Effective meeting goes beyond simply following an agenda—it's about fostering an open and inclusive environment where everyone feels encouraged to speak up and engage. When done well, meetings become productive platforms for collaboration, idea-sharing, and driving progress toward clear objectives.

ORCHESTRATING THE BOARDROOM: THE ART AND ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE CHAIRPERSON

The findings from the recent *Report on Board Culture & Leadership in Licensed Financial Institutions (LFIs) in Malaysia 2025* bear direct semblance to many typical aspects of corporate

governance, suggesting that recommendations put forth in the study can be adopted by Bursa Malaysia-listed PLCs.

In a nutshell, the study commissioned by the FIDE (Financial Institutions Director's Education) Forum has examined how board dynamics, behaviours, leadership styles and external influences affect strategic oversight and decision-making at a time when expectations for transparency, accountability and resilience are rising.

The report assumes that board leadership resides with the chairperson, while the board is tasked with exercising authority over governance and strategy, which reinforces the importance of setting a strong and ethical tone from the top.

In fulfilling this role, boards are commonly responsible for overseeing risk appetite and business plans, assessing the CEO's performance and remuneration, as well as that of senior management, maintaining the governance framework, and fostering an ethical culture throughout the organisation.

Additionally, they are also expected to promote sustainability by incorporating environmental, social, and governance (ESG) considerations into their business strategy, as well as overseeing recovery and resolution planning to ensure timely and effective communication with regulators.

OVERSIGHT ROLE

To effectively fulfil their role, the FIDE Forum findings state that every board chairperson must first shape up the board culture by ensuring that every board meeting is supported by high-quality board papers, which are submitted on time.

Secondly, the chairperson is expected to foster a culture of open and robust discussions, creating an environment where directors

and management actively listen to one another. Thirdly, chairmen are expected to encourage their fellow board members to engage in continuous learning.

This is perhaps where PLC chairmen should emulate their LFI counterparts, who generally appear effective in managing board agendas and meeting structures, with approximately 96% of 152 respondents affirming the effectiveness of this aspect.

Feedback from directors has pointed to clear communication, structured information sharing, efficient time management, timely distribution of board papers and a focus on strategic – rather than operational – matters which are hallmarks of well-run meetings.

However, directors also cautioned that overly long meetings, excessive agenda items or delays in receiving board papers may lead to fatigue. Such conditions risk impairing directors' ability to think critically, engage fully, and identify flaws in reasoning during discussions.

CHAIRPERSON'S ESSENTIAL CHARACTERISTICS

Doubtlessly, the chairperson's character is critical as knowledge and integrity are essential to earning the trust and respect of both the board and management. In this regard, the chairperson must remain mindful of this to exercise effective and credible board leadership.

Towards this end, the FIDE Forum report identified five traits that are crucial for chairpersons to fulfil their fiduciary responsibility.

Integrity: Not to use the position to dominate or for self-promotion.

Receptive: Not to be authoritarian but to always be willing to listen to other directors' and the management's views before giving his or her opinion.

Committed: Be prepared to give time and effort to the organisation and to require the same of the rest of the board.

Empathetic and firm: Be prepared to coach or mentor a new CEO or director, as well as to have difficult conversations with non-performing or challenging board members, including the CEO, regarding their departure from the board or non-reappointment.

Humility: Understanding that the solution to a problem lies with the entire board and not with the chairperson per se.

The characteristics of especially domineering chairpersons raise the question of whether boards can become too dependent on them to manage board dynamics.

This is considering that directors may be reluctant to assume leadership in managing board dynamics even when they perceive dysfunction. In this context, the role of a chairperson to balance differing viewpoints is critical to ensuring that all directors are heard.

There may be friction here amid sensitivity to Malaysia's cultural values, where assertiveness is not customary; polite submission and respect for senior or dominant voices are common, and in-group affiliations provide comfort and security.

Therefore, the FIDE Forum report urges chairpersons to actively encourage contributions from newer or less experienced directors, including those without prior financial sector backgrounds to ensure a diversity of perspectives.

Above all else, chairpersons are expected to remain alert to signs of tension or conflict among board members and intervene

promptly to prevent such issues from undermining decision-making.

HANDLING BOARD-MANAGEMENT RAPPORT

The FIDE Forum study emphasises that chairpersons bear the ultimate responsibility for ensuring board effectiveness. A critical part of this responsibility is establishing and communicating a clear understanding of the board's role to both directors and management. Boards typically operate across three key roles: supervisory, collaborative, and supportive. In the supervisory role, the board sets strategic direction by overseeing corporate and management performance, requiring directors to act as 'specialists' who demand comprehensive, data-backed proposals.

In its collaborative role, the board works alongside management to shape strategic plans, often engaging beyond formal meetings to clarify implementation efforts. Meanwhile, in the supportive role, the board challenges and validates management's proposals to ensure they are robust and risk-aware, thus enhancing the credibility of the leadership.

Importantly, there is no universally correct board role, but chairpersons must define and communicate a clear management-board relationship framework to maintain alignment, foster mutual understanding, and drive purposeful governance.

MANAGING BOARD BEHAVIOUR

The study also highlights that a chairperson's leadership extends beyond engaging with management; it also includes the often delicate task of managing difficult board members to preserve a culture of collaboration and mutual respect.

From setting expectations on speaking time and constructively wrapping up repetitive discussions, to addressing disruptive

behaviours both privately and, when necessary, openly during meetings, the chairperson plays a pivotal role in maintaining order and focus.

Encouraging quieter directors to participate, onboarding new members through informal pre-meeting discussions, and ultimately making tough decisions on re-nomination when behavioural issues persist, are all part of the chairperson's toolkit in upholding board effectiveness.

In the end, chairing a meeting is not merely about keeping to an agenda; it is a nuanced art that demands a delicate balance of planning, facilitation, active listening, and timely intervention. The goal is to create a psychologically safe environment where all voices are heard, diverse insights are valued, and the board functions as a cohesive unit in pursuit of shared objectives.

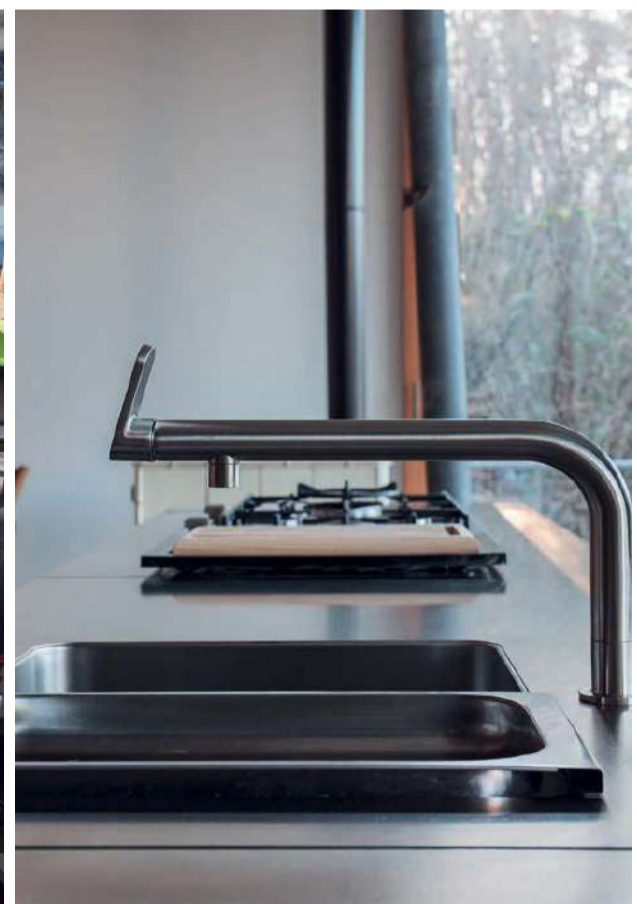
