The House of Breguet celebrates its 250th anniversary in 2025, with the unveiling of the Classique Souscription 2025 wristwatch in Paris, home to Abraham-Louis Breguet's workshop, which saw the birth of the master watchmaker's great inventions.

Dressed in immaculate enamel, the dial symbolises the refined aesthetic intended by the master watchmaker. Based on simplicity and contrasts, it is easy to read. At its centre is a unique, steel, open-tipped Breguet hand, which has been flame-blued and curved entirely by hand. Its tapered tip hovers over the famous, slightly inclined Breguet Arabic numerals, as well as the circular "chemin de fer" (railroad track) with its specially designed sectoring indicating the hours and the 5, 10, 15 and 30-minute markings. The numbers and minute markers are in black, petit feu enamel, the same as the Breguet signature placed at 12 o'clock.

Depending on the light, the inscriptions "Souscription", the unique serial number and the secret signature appear discreetly between the centre of the dial and 6 o'clock.

Generalised on the original Souscription watch, this signature served to authenticate the work of the Breguet workshops and fight against counterfeiting. It is produced, as it was in A.-L. Breguet's day, using a precision tool equipped with articulated arms: the diamond-point pantograph, which makes it possible to delicately engrave this guarantee of authenticity into the enamel.

This face, with its classic features, is protected by a sapphire crystal with a "chévé" profile. This innovation is also the work of A.-L. Breguet. This format, thinner and less domed than those then in vogue, has a relatively flat surface that gently curves towards the edges to blend harmoniously into the case, which was unprecedented at the time. This distinctive shape, like Breguet numerals and hands, has become part of the vocabulary of contemporary watchmaking.

Abraham-Louis Breguet,

...in search of a wider audience

To protect himself from the violence of the French Revolution, A.-L. Breguet returned to Switzerland in 1793, staying in Neuchâtel and Le Locle. In 1795 he went back to Paris where, in 1775, he had set up his workshop, on the Île de la Cité, and had already achieved fame. On his return, he set about turning his company around, developing numerous projects, including the Souscription watch.

A beating heart, ...of mechanical art

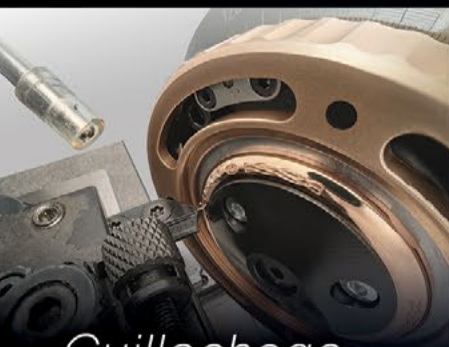

On the back of the case, the generously sized, slightly domed, sapphire crystal reveals the mechanical construction of the new VS00 calibre in gilded brass in the same shade as Breguet gold. It is decorated with an entirely new type of guilloché pattern unveiled this year, called Quai de l'Horloge. This new design is inspired by the singular curves of the Île de la Cité and the slender refinement of the Île Saint-Louis to create a harmonious rhythm that can be infinitely modulated. This new creation celebrates guilloché as a living art, sublimated by Breguet's expertise. The structural typology of the movements in the first Souscription watches produced by A.-L. Breguet was the inspiration for this calibre.

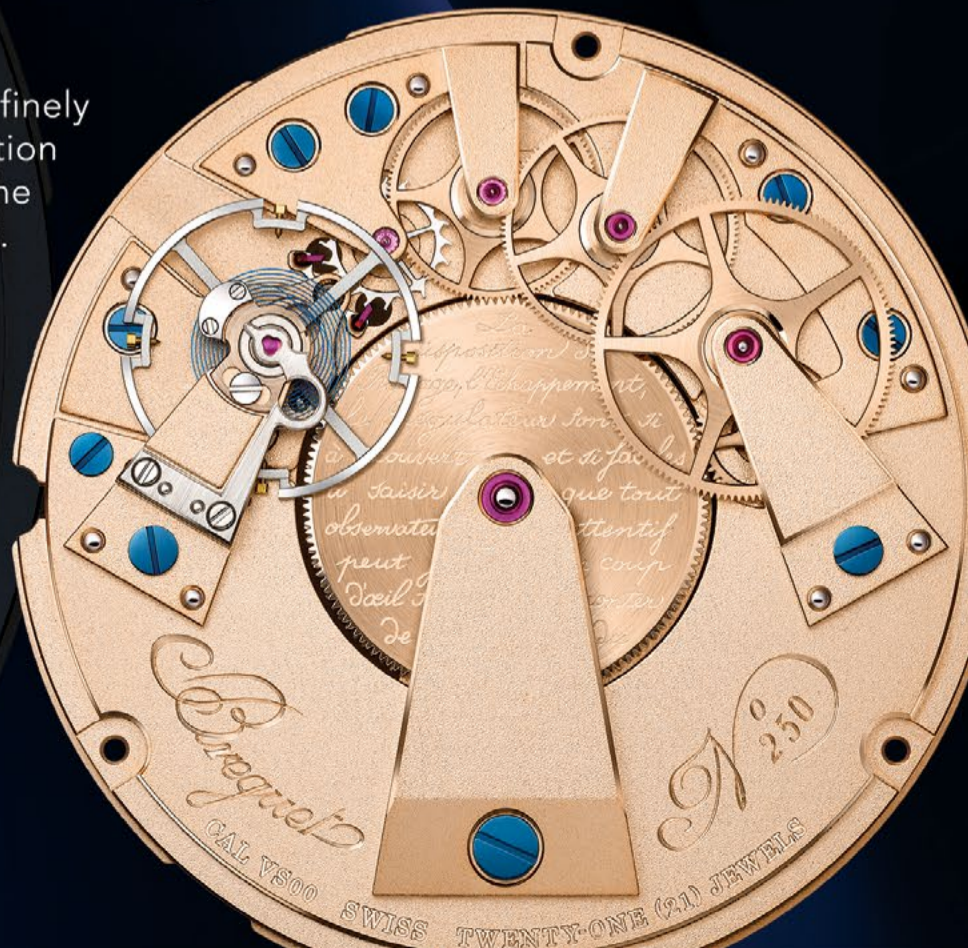

The result of a meticulous development process, this movement beats at a frequency of 3Hz (21,600 vibrations per hour) and delivers an impressive four-day power reserve using only a single barrel. The balance spring, a small, coiled spring that is at the heart of the precision timekeeping of the watch, is blued and features a Breguet overcoil. It is made from Nivachron™, a non-magnetic alloy essentially composed of titanium. This makes the movement more resistant to temperature variations, magnetic fields and shocks.

The plate and bridges are finely shot-blasted, a new decoration directly inspired by the movements of A.-L. Breguet. Blued steel screws and rubies further enhance the movement. At the centre sits the imposing ratchet wheel, which features an engraved inscription: the founder's words, explaining the design of the Souscription movement and taken from his advertising brochure, are faithfully reproduced in his characteristic cursive script.

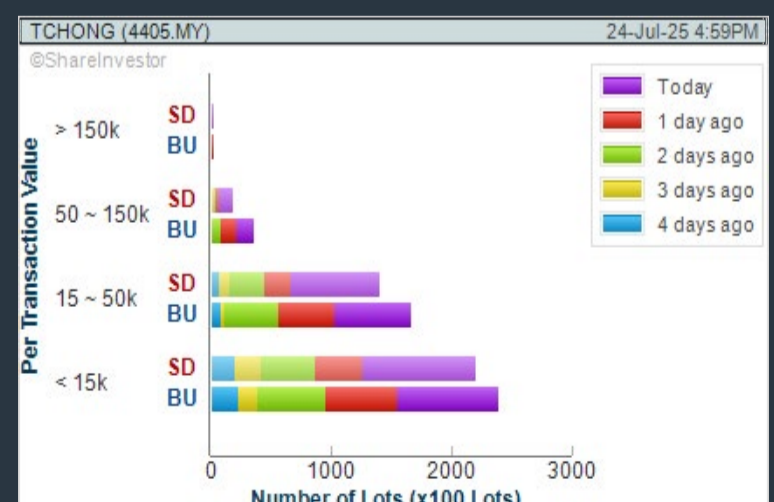

Is there an investment opportunity in Microchip Technology?

SUMMARY

- From 2016 to 2025, Microchip Technology Inc. (**Nasdaq: MCHP**) grew revenue at an 11% CAGR, far above industry averages. But this was largely fuelled by acquisitions rather than organic growth.

- Since 2023, revenue and profits have declined sharply. With fixed costs making up over two-thirds of expenses, falling sales have hit margins hard, revealing the risks of its high operating leverage.
- Compared to peers, Microchip Tech's recent revenue drop, and slower EPS growth suggest challenges that go beyond the general economic slowdown, likely tied to weaker product innovation cycles.
- Despite these issues, Microchip Tech trades at higher P/S and EV/EBIT multiples than many peers. A turnaround may require more than cost cuts - it hinges on delivering new products, which could take years.

BACKGROUND

Microchip Tech is a notable player in the semiconductor sector, specializing in the embedded control market. The company provides critical building blocks - such as microcontrollers, analogue, and mixed-signal devices - alongside the development tools that engineers use to create increasingly sophisticated electronic systems.

According to its positioning, Microchip Tech competes "principally based on the technical innovation and performance of our embedded control products." This competitive edge is supported by:

- A broad product portfolio of solutions that serve a wide array of industries, from automotive to industrial automation and consumer electronics.
- An extensive portfolio of US and international patents, reinforcing its technological moat and helping to protect differentiated designs.

- Significant manufacturing assets, including wafer fabrication plants and facilities for wafer probe, testing, and assembly.

However, after years of growth, Microchip Tech's revenue trajectory has reversed since 2023. Management attributes this decline largely to "adverse economic conditions... which resulted in many customers having higher levels of inventory than needed," dampening near-term demand as these customers work through existing stock.

Yet the broader context warrants a closer look. The semiconductor industry, particularly segments tied to embedded control, is characterized by short product life cycles and relentless innovation cycles. In such an environment, robust new product development is essential to sustaining growth.

This raises critical questions for investors:

- Is Microchip Tech's recent revenue decline mainly a consequence of temporary macroeconomic and inventory headwinds?
- Or does it signal deeper challenges in keeping pace with evolving product requirements and innovation cycles?

If it is the former, the company could be poised for a relatively swift rebound as demand normalizes. If the latter, the recovery might be prolonged, involving heavy investment and time to restore competitive momentum. Understanding which of these dynamics is at play is central to assessing the risk-reward balance of investing in Microchip Tech at this stage.

Note that the company has March as its financial year-end. In this article, unless stated otherwise, the year refers to the financial year. Furthermore, the 2025 performance was based on the LTM Sep 2024 results.

REVENUE GROWTH

From 2016 to 2025, Microchip Tech delivered an impressive 11% CAGR in revenue, well above the broader embedded systems market growth of roughly 6% to 7% over similar periods. This helped the company secure an estimated 5% share of the global embedded systems space.

However, a closer look reveals that this growth was driven largely by acquisitions. Over the past decade, Microchip Tech spent about USD11 billion on acquisitions, compared to just USD2 billion on CAPEX. This suggests organic growth accounted for only a small fraction of its expansion. This became clear from 2020 to 2025, when acquisitions virtually stopped, and revenue growth slowed to around 1% CAGR.

More recently, in fiscal 2024, while the global semiconductor sector grew, Microchip Tech's revenue fell by 9.5%, raising concerns that internally developed products have struggled to gain traction. This is notable in a sector defined by rapid innovation and short product life cycles, where sustained growth typically relies on a strong pipeline of new offerings.

To its credit, Microchip Tech has maintained a robust R&D investment, averaging 15% of revenue over the past three years, similar to earlier periods, indicating the issue is not underfunding. Instead, the challenge may lie in converting R&D into commercially successful products.

In short, Microchip' Tech's strong historical growth appears heavily acquisition-led, and its recent struggles highlight questions about the effectiveness of its organic innovation. Whether the revenue decline is merely due to temporary economic headwinds or reflects deeper competitive challenges will be critical in shaping its future trajectory.

COST STRUCTURE

While Microchip Tech delivered steady revenue growth from 2016 through 2022, things began to unravel in 2023. As shown in Chart 1, revenues started to decline that year, but even more concerning was the sharp drop in profits from 2023 to 2025. A key reason lies in the company's cost structure.



Chart 1: Performance Index and Operating Profit

Notes to operating profit. I broke down the operating profits into fixed costs and variable costs.

- **Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization and Others.**
- **Variable cost = Cost of Sales - Depreciation & Amortization.**
- **Contribution = Revenue - Variable Cost.**
- **Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.**

On average, fixed costs made up more than two-thirds of Microchip Tech's total operating costs, leaving profits highly sensitive to changes in revenue. As sales fell, the heavy fixed cost base meant that profits were hit disproportionately hard, which also drove a notable decline in contribution margins. This margin erosion started back in 2020, the same time the company halted its acquisition-driven growth, which suggests the weakening leverage of its existing operations.

To its credit, Microchip Tech has recognized this structural vulnerability. In December 2024, it announced plans to shut down its wafer fabrication plant (Fab 2) in Tempe, Arizona. This move is expected to save around USD90 million annually, an important step toward better aligning its cost base with revenue realities.

In short, while past growth masked underlying cost rigidity, the recent revenue downturn has exposed how sensitive Microchip Tech’s profitability is to volume declines. The proactive closure of Fab 2 should help, but it underscores the challenges of managing a high fixed-cost operation in a cyclical, innovation-driven industry.

PEER COMPARISON

When comparing Microchip Tech to other listed players in the semiconductor embedded control space, a few clear patterns emerge. As shown in Table 1, Microchip Tech is the smallest among its peers by 2025 revenue, but it stood out with one of the strongest revenue growth rates over the past decade.

However, more recent trends paint a less favourable picture. From 2023 to 2024, the peer group’s revenues shrank by an average of 0.9%, yet Microchip Tech’s decline was among the steepest. This suggests its challenges may go beyond the general economic slowdown affecting the sector.

Looking at other performance metrics, Microchip Tech stacks up reasonably well against peers overall.

- Return on capital showed an encouraging upward trend from 2020 to 2023, though it seemed to plateau or dip slightly in 2024.

- The company's EBIT margin improved markedly after 2020, making it the strongest among the peer set by 2024.
- Its free cash flow margin also generally outperformed several competitors.
- The exception was EPS growth, where multiple peers pulled ahead, indicating that while Microchip Tech's profitability ratios held up, its bottom-line growth lagged.

In short, while Microchip Tech has demonstrated solid capital returns, operating margins, and cash flow relative to peers, its recent revenue drop, and slower EPS growth highlight competitive pressures that may not be solely tied to broader market conditions.

VALUATION

Before turning to valuation, it is worth noting that while Microchip Tech attributed its revenue decline mainly to macroeconomic factors and inventory corrections, the financial trends suggest deeper challenges. In my view, the company's turnaround likely depends on strengthening R&D and bringing new products to market, not just cost cuts.

The mixed efficiency picture since 2020 underscores this.

- Operating expenses have improved, but inventory turnover has fallen, and margins and ROA have declined since 2023.
- On the capital side, asset turnover and reinvestment margins look better, yet the cash conversion cycle has worsened, and free cash flow has merely flattened.

All these point to a recovery that may require more than simply selling existing products. Given typical new product timelines, a true turnaround could take several years, with cost control crucial in the meantime, though past execution raises questions here, too.

With that context, we can now explore whether Microchip Tech's current valuation adequately prices in these risks and the path to potential recovery.

The valuation of Microchip Tech largely hinges on how long it will take to reverse its declining revenue trend. Without a clear basis to forecast this timing, I have opted against a DCF approach and instead focused on comparable valuation multiples. As shown in Table 2, Microchip Tech traded at higher Price-to-Sales and EV/EBIT multiples than many peers, making it one of the more expensive stocks in its segment.

My investment caution stems from the view, based mainly on financial trends, that Microchip Tech's challenges may be tied to product development rather than purely macroeconomic factors. This view contrasts with the company's narrative, though it does list product development as a general risk in its 10-K: "We may be unable to design, develop, and introduce competitive products, which could adversely impact our future operating results."

However, this appears to be a standard caution rather than an explicit concern in its turnaround strategy.

CONCLUSION

Microchip Tech presents a mixed investment picture. Over the past decade, it delivered impressive growth largely through acquisitions. The company maintained solid margins and returns on capital relative to peers. However, the recent sharp decline

in revenue and profits, coupled with evidence of heavy reliance on acquisitions rather than organic innovation, raises concerns about whether the company is adequately positioned for the next cycle.

The numbers suggest that Microchip Tech's challenges may run deeper than just cyclical headwinds. This potentially reflects issues in product development and competitiveness.

With a cost structure heavily weighted toward fixed expenses, any prolonged revenue weakness could continue to pressure margins. While management's cost-cutting initiatives, like closing Fab 2, are sensible steps, they did not address the underlying need for stronger new product momentum.

Given its premium valuation relative to peers, investors appear to be pricing in a relatively swift turnaround. From a long-term value perspective, this makes Microchip Tech a company worth watching closely, particularly for signs that it can convert its substantial R&D spend into commercially successful products.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

Malaysia's foreign tourist arrivals up 20.4% from Jan to May this year - Tiong

According to Tourism, Arts and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing, Malaysia recorded a significant 20.4% rise in foreign tourist arrivals from January to May 2025, with a total of 16.94 million visitors, compared with 14.07 million during the same period last year.

In a written parliamentary reply, he noted that Singapore remained the largest source market, contributing 8.34 million visitors, a 26.5% increase from last year. Indonesia ranked second with 1.82 million visitors, up 10.3%, followed by China with 1.81 million, representing the highest growth rate among all markets at 38.8%. Thailand contributed 1.06 million visitors, a 5.2% increase, while arrivals from India grew by 32% to 664,811 visitors. He added that

long-haul markets also showed strong performance, with Australia and the United Kingdom posting arrivals of 198,968 and 185,197 respectively.

These numbers proved the effectiveness of government initiatives, including the Visa Liberalisation Plan, targeted support and incentives for industry players, and high-impact promotional campaigns. These efforts also include digital promotions and strategic collaborations with online platforms and airlines, which have helped position Malaysia as a top tourism destination in the region.

Tiong said his ministry is now working towards the Visit Malaysia 2026 (VM2026) campaign, with a target of 47 million foreign visitors. And to achieve this, the focus will be on key high-potential markets such as Central Asia, the Middle East, Asean, Europe and Oceania.

US Tariffs Cloud ASEAN+3 Outlook; Regional Integration Gains Urgency - AMRO

The ASEAN+3 Macroeconomic Research Office (AMRO) forecasts the ASEAN+3 region to grow at 3.8 percent in 2025 and 3.6 percent in 2026, according to the latest quarterly update of its flagship ASEAN+3 Regional Economic Outlook (AREO).

Reflecting heightened global uncertainties, particularly the evolving US tariff measures, the growth forecasts represent a downward revision from AMRO's April projections of 4.2 percent in 2025 and 4.1 percent in 2026 which did not include the impact of then newly announced US tariffs.

“Encouragingly, the ASEAN+3 region enters this period of global trade turbulence from a position of relative strength and resilience,” said AMRO Chief Economist Dong He. “Most regional policymakers have acted early to cushion the impact of the trade shock, and policy space remains available for further support if needed.”

Inflation in the region continues to moderate, despite a temporary spike in oil prices driven by Middle East tensions. The region’s financial markets have also shown resilience, with regional currencies generally appreciating against the US dollar amid growing market concerns over US policy uncertainty.

The economic outlook for ASEAN+3 remains clouded by significant uncertainties, with escalating US tariffs posing the most salient risk. Uneven progress in tariff negotiations and the potential expansion of tariffs to additional products could further disrupt trade activities and weigh on growth for the region.

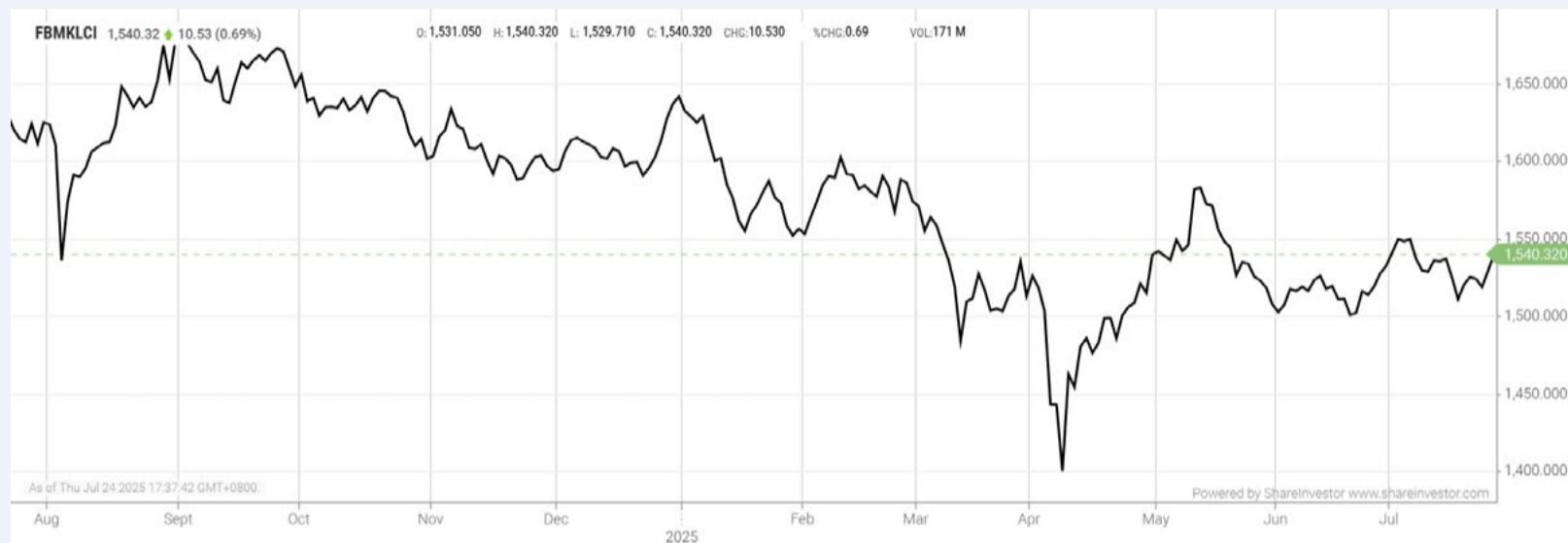
Ongoing geopolitical tensions add an additional layer of complexity, while a sharper-than-expected economic slowdown in the US and Europe, along with tighter global financial conditions from prolonged high US interest rates could further dampen growth prospects.

“In a world that is increasingly being reshaped by fragmentation, deeper regional integration is both urgent and necessary,” Dr. He noted. “By strengthening regional cooperation while maintaining openness to the world and standing firm on rules-based multilateralism, ASEAN+3 can build resilience against external shocks and create new growth opportunities.”

While most AGMs met and, in some cases, exceeded expectations, many have further room of improvements.

A WRAP-UP OF 2025 AGM SEASON - A MIXED REPORT CARD

Having attended the recent April-June peak Annual General Meeting (AGM) season, the Minority Shareholders Watch Group (MSWG) feels compelled to share a few noteworthy observations that it believes can further enhance the standards and quality of AGM conduct among the 1,060 Bursa Malaysia public listed companies (PLCs) (figure as of end-2024).

All in all, MSWG attended a total of 182 AGMs and 33 Extraordinary General Meetings (EGMs) during that busy three-month period. Most PLCs conducted their general meetings in a manner that met and, in some cases, exceeded shareholder expectations. Many took the opportunity to deliver comprehensive industry updates and strategic overviews during the business presentations, offering valuable insights into market trends, operational performance, and future outlook.

In addition, several PLCs demonstrated a commendable level of professionalism in their logistical arrangements, from seamless transportation services to efficient registration processes.

Furthermore, many companies extended warm hospitality by providing shareholders with refreshments and meals, reflecting a thoughtful approach to stakeholder engagement and creating a more positive and inclusive meeting experience.

To our surprise, several PLCs stepped up their game in enhancing the overall sensory experience for attendees. Malayan Banking Berhad offered complimentary health screening and neck and shoulder massages – perhaps a thoughtful gesture to ease the physical strain from long hours of meetings. Meanwhile, CIMB Group Holdings Berhad added a touch of elegance to its AGM with a melodious performance by the Malaysian Philharmonic Youth Orchestra, enriching the auditory ambience of the event.

For the benefit of readers, we shall share our various observations below in a chronological order, i.e., the typical flow of an AGM beginning with the registration process:

DENIED ENTRY DUE TO LATE ARRIVAL

A brouhaha was sparked at the Kossan Rubber Industries Bhd's AGM when a minority shareholder was denied entry by the share registrar on the grounds that he arrived only after registration had closed. Unsatisfied with the treatment received, the shareholder

“barged” into the meeting hall, so to speak, and raised the issue with the company’s chairman at the commencement of the meeting.

The shareholder argued that the registration and participation of latecomers should be allowed so long as the voting process has not yet commenced. The chairman took note of the concern and, in a gesture of shareholder inclusiveness, instructed that the registration counter be reopened to allow the shareholder to register and participate in the meeting. The ensuing situation raises a procedural concern. Ensuring access and participation in general meetings is critical to upholding the rights of minority shareholders.

To be clear, MSWG encourages prompt attendance at general meetings. However, restricting entry solely based on rigid registration cut-offs, particularly before any resolution has been voted on, may risk limiting the rights of minority shareholders while undermining the principles of transparency and equitable treatment.

AGM HOT TOPICS: ESG, BOARD COMPOSITION, BOARD REMUNERATION

Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) continues to be featured prominently in corporate disclosures, with many PLCs incorporating ESG narratives in their annual reports. However, few provided concrete metrics or disclosed measurable progress against meaningful key performance indicators (KPIs). Given that feedback on ESG reporting remained limited, MSWG has emerged among the few who are actively calling for more robust and transparent ESG disclosures.

Secondly, board composition and independence continued to be a key focus area. Prolonged board tenures, over-boarding and lack of gender diversity continue to draw attention, consistent with the expectations outlined in the Malaysian Code on Corporate

Governance (MCCG). PLCs with entrenched boards and minimal refreshment faced greater scrutiny in tandem with increasing expectations for board renewal and diversity.

Thirdly, remuneration transparency remains a concern. Many Annual Reports continued to lack granularity and clear justifications in cases where directors' remunerations appeared misaligned with the PLC's performance, particularly among PLCs reporting weaker results. In one notable instance, Sarawak Oil Palm Berhad has sought approval for directors' fees and benefits without specifying the actual amount, thus raising fundamental concerns over transparency and the ability of shareholders to make informed voting decisions.

VOTING COMES FIRST?

Main Market-listed semiconductor outfit Mi Technovation Berhad conducted its AGM in a rather unusual way. It began its AGM with a voting session, followed by a business presentation and a Q&A session. However, a minority shareholder protested and expressed his dissatisfaction with the sequence of the AGM, citing the lack of a proper process.

In response, Mi Technovation's CEO explained that the sequence was designed to maximise his interaction with shareholders without time constraints. Nevertheless, its Chairman acknowledged the feedback by contending that adjustments would be made accordingly in the next AGM.

The typical sequence begins with a business presentation, followed by a Q&A session and the tabling of resolutions (or vice versa), before concluding with the voting process. This ensures that shareholders are equipped with all relevant information before casting their votes, thereby enabling them to make informed decisions.

Q&A SESSION: TIGHT-LIPPED BECAUSE OF THE ARBITRATION PROCESS

Meanwhile, MSWG took note of certain developments that occurred during the Q&A sessions, which may detrimentally affect the rights and interests of minority shareholders.

This was evident at the recent Cahya Mata Sarawak Berhad AGM, where the company's board and management refrained from answering certain questions, citing ongoing legal proceedings. Although shareholders were free to raise questions, most went unanswered due to multiple ongoing lawsuits and the arbitration process. The constraint was affirmed repeatedly by its legal counsel, even though the board welcomed the questions raised. With a slew of legal battles and no access to critical information, minority shareholders were in the dark about the future of CMSB.

On another note, MSWG raised objections to the proposed amendment to its constitution (tabled as a Special Resolution), which, if passed, would allow CMSB to have a larger board and allow board circular resolutions to be passed by a simple majority instead of a unanimous vote. The very fact that the proposed amendment to its Constitution to allow decisions to be made by a simple majority of directors rather than by unanimous consent triggered concerns over whether boardroom checks and balances were being weakened under the guise of operational efficiency.

The Special Resolution was not carried with 67.03% of the voted shares in favour and 32.97% voted against.

VOTING COMES FIRST?

MSWG also observed a trend among boards and management to limit the time and number of questions from shareholders during AGMs, often citing time constraints. This happens in a few AGMs, including at ARB Berhad, Kronologi Asia Berhad, Kumpulan

Perangsang Selangor Berhad (KPS), and CB Industrial Product Holding Berhad.

AGMs should serve as a vital platform for meaningful shareholder engagement. One would expect boards and management to welcome questions because open and transparent dialogue is fundamental to good corporate governance and accountability. Such is the expectation unless the companies and boards that impose a restriction have hesitation or concerns that some questions could pave the way to opening a Pandora's box.

INSUFFICIENT JUSTIFICATION FOR PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS

This is related to the remuneration package accorded to directors. At its 48th AGM, KPS sought shareholders' approval for an ex gratia payment of RM1 million to five independent and non-executive directors "in recognition of their contributions leading to the successful divestment of Kaiserkorp Corporation Sdn Bhd". Ex gratia payment is made out of goodwill at the discretion of a company. The board justified the payment as a recognition of the board's ongoing contribution to KPS's long-term value creation journey, which began in 2016 with the launch of the group's Business Transformation Programme (BTP).

The resolution sparked heated debates among the Board and shareholders. First of all, the compensation received by independent directors should have been sufficient to remunerate their roles and duties; hence, no ex gratia payment should be granted.

Secondly, contrary to the justification given by the board, none of the involved directors were appointed as early as 2016. Only two served over seven years, whereas the rest joined later, thus undermining the claim of sustained oversight over KPS' BTP journey and raising concerns over fairness and governance

consistency. MSWG called upon the controlling shareholder to abstain from voting, and only minority shareholders vote for the resolution.

Over at HeiTech Padu Berhad's AGM, it sought shareholders' approval for directors' benefits from 26 June 2025 until the next AGM, including a newly proposed RM80,000 special monthly allowance for Dato' Sri Mohd Hilmey Mohd Taib, the non-independent non-executive director, founder, and advisor of the Company. Hilmey was redesignated from Executive Deputy Chairman with effect from 1 March 2025. However, the proposal lacks transparency, with no disclosed responsibilities, performance criteria, oversight mechanisms, or even a justification for the performance benchmark to support the quantum or rationale of the benefit.

While both resolutions were carried, MSWG regarded them as lacking sufficient and transparent justification to support the proposed remuneration. MSWG voted against the two resolutions.

RECLAIMING THE AGM'S PURPOSE

The 2025 AGM season offered both encouraging progress and areas that warrant immediate attention. While some PLCs demonstrated exemplary shareholder engagement and professionalism, others fell short of basic governance expectations, particularly in transparency, accountability, and inclusiveness.

MSWG remains steadfast in its role as a vigilant advocate for minority shareholders. We urge boards and management to treat AGMs not as procedural obligations, but as meaningful opportunities to build trust, communicate transparently, and uphold the spirit of corporate democracy.

As we reflect on this year's AGM season, one message is clear: good governance is not just about compliance, it is about conduct, culture, and the courage to be accountable.

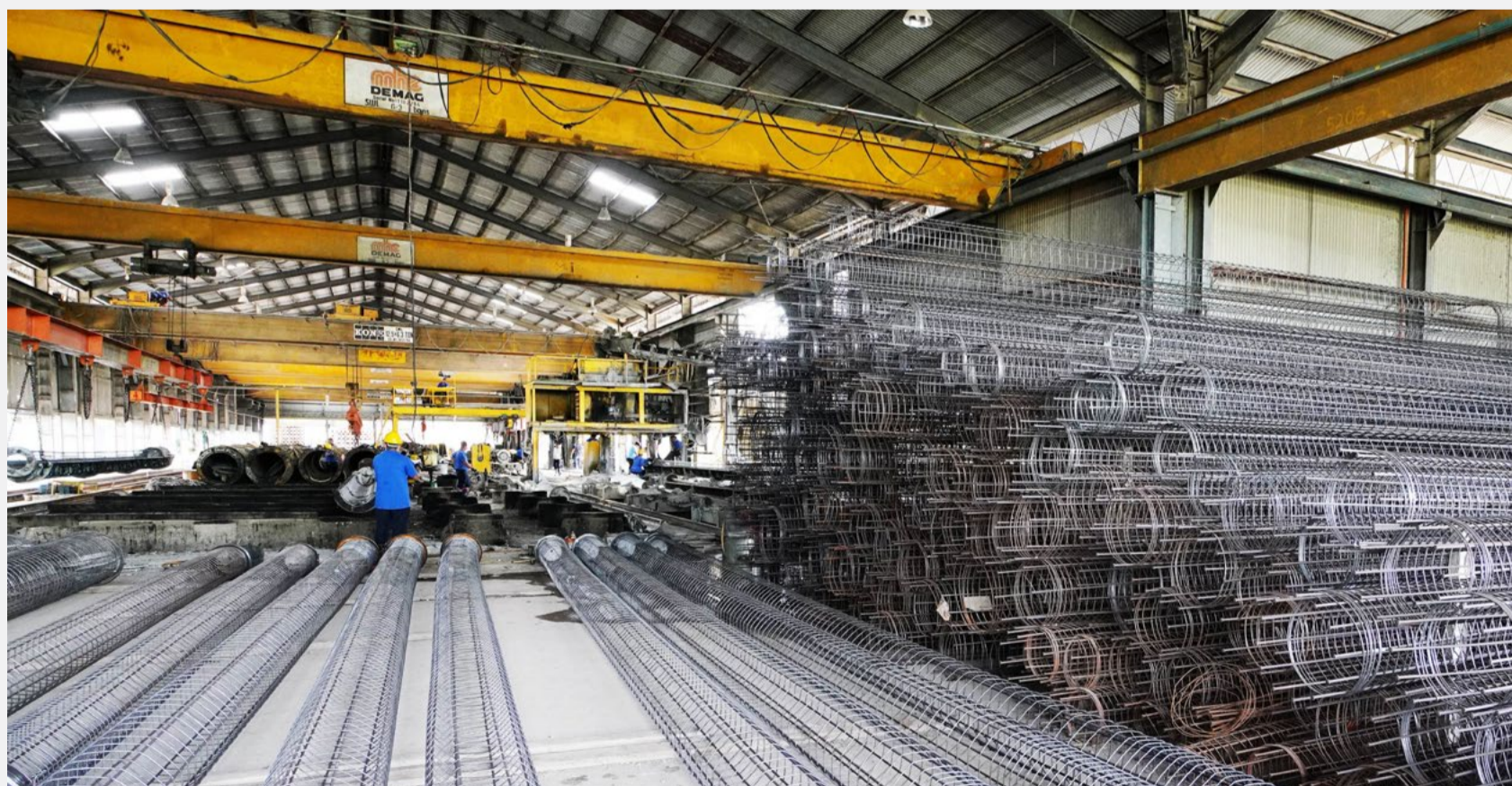
