With a unique architecture that brings its precision mechanism to the fore, crowned by a hand-made, enamel dial, the Tradition 7035 epitomises Breguet's 250 years of technical and aesthetic innovation.



Abraham-Louis Breguet or the birth of an *international network*

In addition to his technical innovations, A.-L. Breguet worked constantly to widen access to timekeeping innovations, enabling an increasingly broad and cosmopolitan clientele to know the time at any moment. His intuition, combined with a desire to produce in small series, led him, in 1796, to propose Souscription watches. These were simple and robust, single hand timepieces, sold in a distinctive way. Clients were introduced to Souscription watches by means of an advertising leaflet, a first for its time and the precursor of the first commercial catalogue, which Breguet would go on to create. Another particularity was the use of a deposit: Having selected the timepiece from the leaflet, the client would pay a quarter of the price when the order was placed.

In 1799, he introduced Tact watches, which further enhanced his status amongst his peers and clients.



Featuring an external hand and markings placed around the case they allowed the time to be "read" by touch, in perfect discretion.

The synthesis of these two timepieces is the Tradition collection, born in 2005. This line features a unique architectural structure, exposing the bridges, gears and mechanisms of this marvel of precision microengineering. Inspired by the work of A.-L. Breguet, this easily recognisable configuration offers the same uninterrupted view of the inner workings of the watch that a watchmaker sees when working on a watch.

A decorative technique that was often used on watch cases, guilloché has become an art in its own right. A.-L. Breguet was the first to use this technique to delineate the different displays on watch dials, and it remains, to this day, one of Breguet's core areas of expertise.

Breguet currently owns the largest collection of working guilloché lathes in the world. These carefully renovated period machines can be used to create a wide range of motifs, from the most traditional, such as the Clou de Paris, to the most contemporary, the new Quai de l'Horloge design, which has been incorporated on the dial of this Tradition model.

This new guilloché motif was inspired by the graceful lines of the Seine as it flows around the Île de la Cité, where A.-L. Breguet's workshop once stood, and the Île Saint-Louis, both in the heart of Paris. The precise contours of this motif are modelled on the Turgot map, a highly-detailed, perspective view of the city of Paris produced in the eighteenth century. For its time it was remarkably accurate: it included all the streets, buildings and even every tree in the centre of Paris.

Quai de l'Horloge: a unique guilloché decoration

The Tradition collection incorporates for the first time two "in-house" colour codes: Breguet gold and Breguet blue

Gold, silver, copper and palladium are skilfully fused into an alloy that radiates a warm, golden glow: Breguet gold. This exclusive alloy, created by Breguet, was introduced earlier this year with the Classique Souscription 2025 watch. The 38 mm diameter case for the Tradition 7035 has been crafted from this new alloy. A specially-developed plating treatment ensures that the mainplate and bridges are of the same hue as the case. The silver-coloured gears, blued screws and ruby-red jewels provide visual contrast and further accentuate the radiance of Breguet gold. The bridges of this new anniversary model feature, for the first time in the Tradition collection, a silky, hand-applied satin finish on their upper surfaces.

The striking focal point of this model is the finely engine-turned dial, resplendent in Breguet blue. The chosen motive is the Quai de l'Horloge. Its tinted, translucent, grand feu enamel is of the same deep, blue as the retrograde seconds hand and screws, which are made of blued steel. In contrasting silver, the Breguet Arabic numerals, the minute track, with its stylised fleurs-de-lis, and the unique serial number at 4 o'clock stand out effortlessly against the shimmering azure of the enamel.

Crescent moon-shaped
oscillating weight:
a tribute to watchmaking genius

The back of the new Tradition 7035 reveals a golden landscape as fascinating as the front. The oscillating weight spins above the bridges' satin-finished surfaces, which provide an elegant contrast to the shot-blasted mainplate below.

The crescent moon-shaped weight, made of vertical brushed platinum, is reminiscent of those used in A.-L. Breguet's time. He established the use of platinum in watchmaking, using it to optimise the automatic winding of what he referred to as his "perpétuelle" watches, one of the first innovations from this master watchmaker.

A discrete "Pt950" engraved on the weight's upper left-hand flank acts as a reassuring gauge of quality, as well as a knowing nod to Breguet's patrimony.

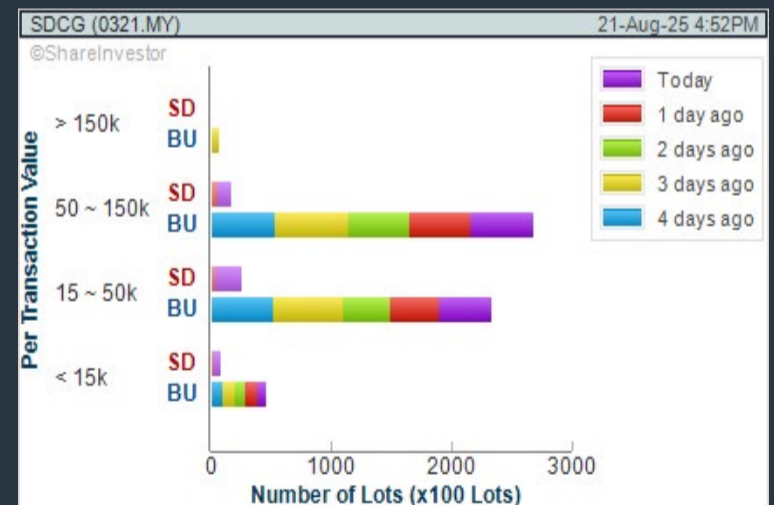

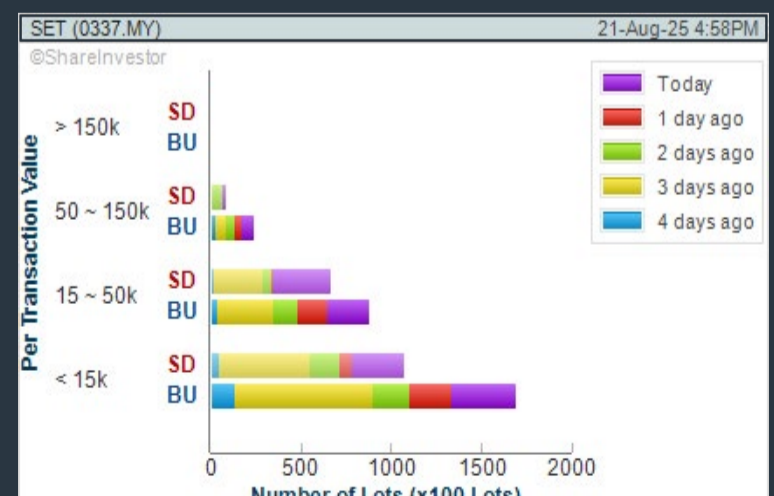

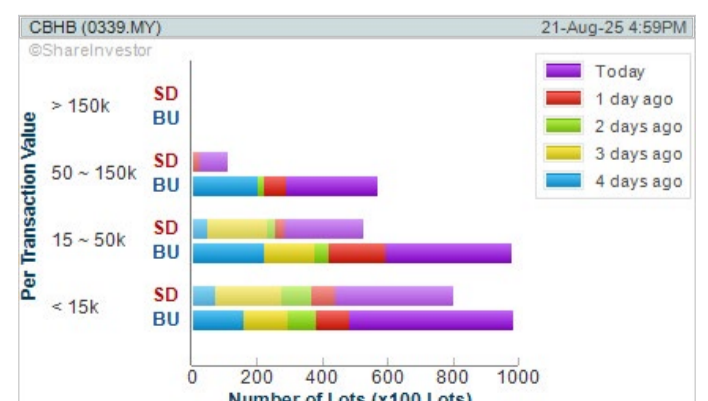

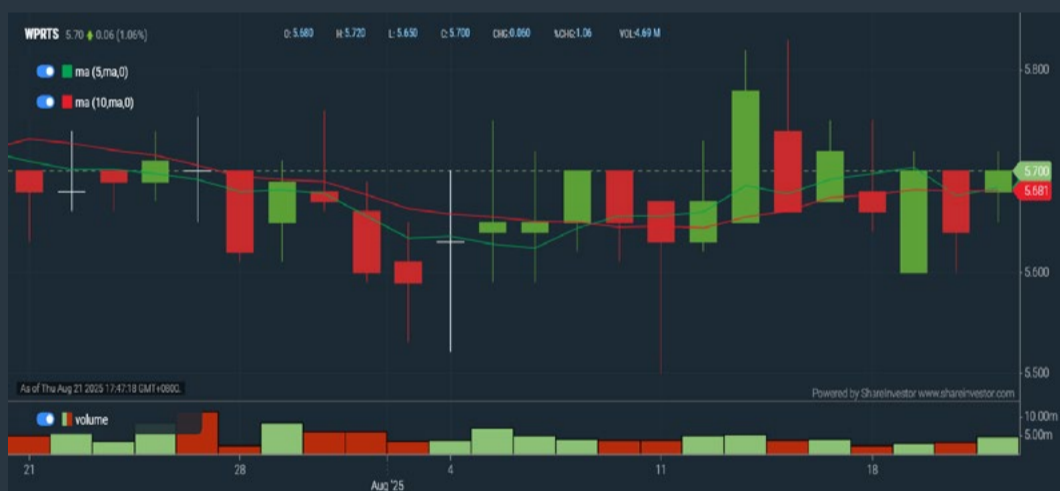

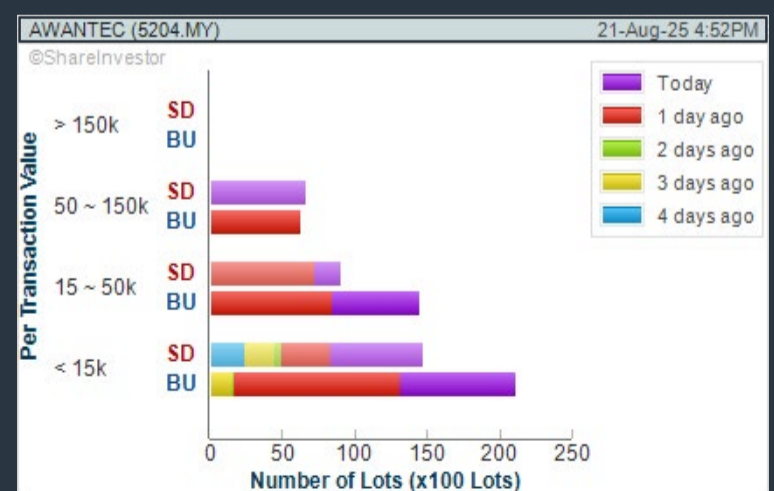

Is there an investment opportunity in Ceragon Networks?

SUMMARY

- Ceragon Networks Ltd's (**NASDAQ:CRNT**) strategic shift in 2020 from wireless backhaul to broader wireless transport and connectivity drove a revenue rebound and margin expansion.

- Among wireless transport specialists, Ceragon is a top revenue player and one of the few with positive growth since 2016. It maintains a sound balance sheet, achieves good cash conversion, and allocates capital in a disciplined manner.
- My valuation resulted in a more than 30% margin of safety. Any upside depends on sustaining structural improvements while managing CAPEX cyclicality, supply chain volatility, and Indian market concentration.

BACKGROUND

Ceragon provides high-capacity wireless connectivity solutions to telecom operators, private network owners, and government agencies. From 2015 to 2019, it focused on wireless backhaul solutions (point-to-point microwave) for mobile operators. In 2020, it broadened its scope to wireless transport and connectivity, introducing multi-technology solutions to ease the transition from legacy systems to 4G/5G.

This strategic shift marked a turning point. Revenue, which had declined since 2015, bottomed out in 2020 and grew at a 9.5% CAGR through the September LTM 2024. Profit recovery lagged by two years, and while 2024 revenue hit a decade high, PAT remained below the 2018 peak. **(Refer to the left part of Chart 1).**

The rebound is notable, but in a fast-changing tech sector, the question is whether post-2020 gains signal a cyclical upswing or sustainable growth. To assess this, I will examine:

- Sector growth.
- Operating trends.
- Peer performance.

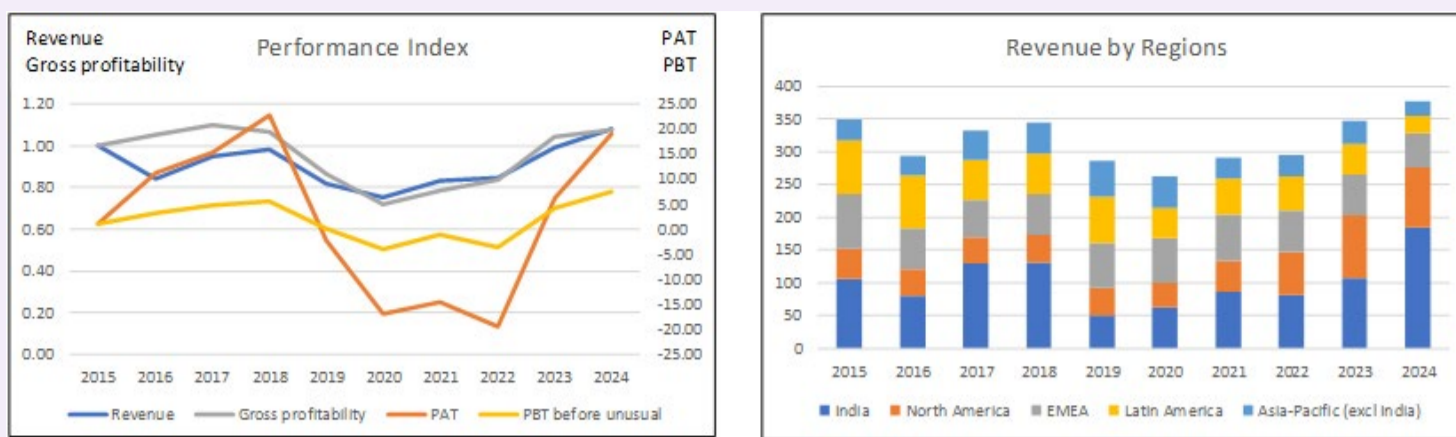


Chart 1: Performance Index and Revenue by Regions

SECTOR

Ceragon operates in the telecommunications and wireless networking sector - not a sunset market, but also not one with double-digit growth. Industry data points to moderate expansion:

- **Future Market Insight:** Global telecom network infrastructure grew at a 4.1% CAGR (2017–2022) and is forecast to grow 5.8% annually from 2023–2033, reaching USD 100.1 billion in 2023.
- **Allied Market Research:** Valued at USD96.9 billion in 2022, with a projected 6.3% CAGR through 2032.

Given Ceragon’s heavy telco exposure, revenue is closely tied to telco CAPEX cycles. Here, the outlook is weaker:

- **Dell’Oro Group:** Global telecom CAPEX to decline mid-single digits in 2024 and contract at a –2% CAGR by 2026.
- **PWC:** Network CAPEX growth rates expected to decline (2018–2027).

Ceragon’s post-2020 revenue recovery aligned with the 2019–2022 CAPEX up-cycle. With the industry now entering a CAPEX downturn, growth may slow. That said, its push into private networks and enterprise solutions could help offset some headwinds.

OPERATING TRENDS

Ceragon was initially profitable but posted operating losses in 2020 and 2022 before recovering strongly. Since 2022, it has operated well above breakeven, driven by higher revenue, improved contribution margin, and stable fixed costs.

As shown in Chart 2, the contribution margin gains stemmed from higher gross margins, attributed to:

- Supply chain cost improvements.
- Greater revenue share from higher-margin North America.
- Shift toward higher-value solutions beyond wireless backhaul.

Fixed costs account for roughly one-third of total expenses, meaning revenue growth translates efficiently into profit. This is evident in the declining SGA margin in recent years (*Chart 2, right*). That said, supply chain gains and cost cuts have limits. If revenue growth slows, further SGA margin declines will also be constrained.

Conclusion - Profit growth to date has come from margin expansion and cost efficiency, which should taper over time. However, these gains appear structural rather than cyclical, suggesting they can be sustained.

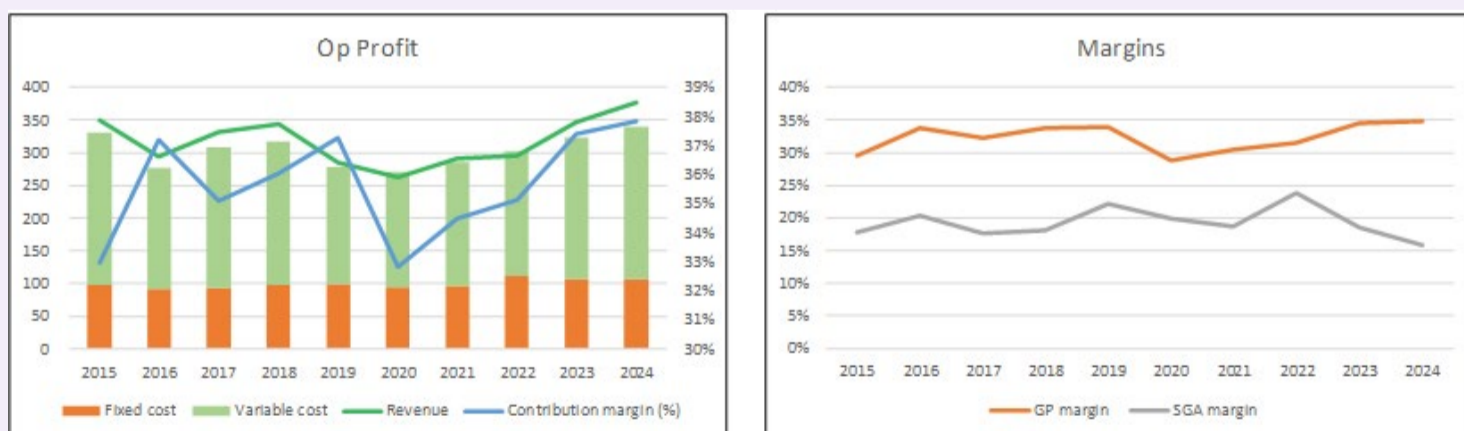


Chart 1: Performance Index and Revenue by Regions

Notes to operating profit: I broke down the operating profits into fixed costs and variable costs.

- Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization and Others.
- Variable cost = Cost of Sales - Depreciation & Amortization.
- Contribution = Revenue - Variable Cost.
- Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.

PEERS

Ceragon’s SEC filings identify two competitor groups: generalists (e.g., Huawei) and wireless transport specialists (e.g., Aviat Networks). Given the generalists’ much larger scale and broader product portfolios, I focus on the specialists for peer comparison (**Table 1**).

Ceragon ranks among the larger players by 2024 revenue and is one of only two peers with positive revenue growth from 2016 - 2024. This underscores the sector’s challenging growth environment.

Using four performance metrics – return on capital, EBIT margin, free cash flow margin, and EPS - Ceragon’s past decade results appear average. However, early indicators suggest its post-2023 trajectory could outpace peers.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Ceragon as sound financially based on the following:

- As of March 2025, it had USD29 million in cash. This is equal to 12% of its total assets.
- As of March 2025, it had a 22% debt-equity ratio. This has come down from its 2022 high of 45%.
- Over the past decade, it has had 2 years with negative cash flow from operations. During this period, it generated USD133 million

in cash flow from operations compared to the USD23 million cumulative profit. This is a good cash conversion ratio.

- It had a good capital allocation plan. **Refer to Table 2.** The cash flow from operations was more than sufficient to cover its CAPEX and acquisitions.

The only concern I have is the Reinvestment that averaged about USD41 million annually over the past decade. This exceeded its average 2023/24 NOPAT.

Reinvestment = CAPEX + Acquisition – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital.

I suspect that the problem is with the low NOPAT rather than the high Reinvestment. In the long run, I would expect the Reinvestment rate (Reinvestment/NOPAT) to follow that given the fundamental growth equation of Reinvestment rate = growth/ROIC.

VALUATION

Ceragon’s valuation hinges on its revenue trajectory and margin expansion. I adopted the following in valuing the company:

- Revenue – 2024 marks a “mature” base; growth of 4% in perpetuity.
- Margins – Contribution margin to improve 10% above the 2023–2024 average.

- Reinvestment – Improved efficiency to align with the fundamental growth equation.
- Tax rate – 24%, assuming no incentives and no benefit from accumulated losses.

Under these parameters, the intrinsic value is USD6.14 per share versus a market price of USD4.46 (29 Jan 2025), implying a >30% margin of safety. (Refer to the original articles for the valuation details)

- My valuation assumes Ceragon has established a sustainable business model resilient to telco CAPEX cycles. Model projections vs. 2024 actuals show:
 - ROIC: 23% vs 18%
 - EBIT margin: 13% vs 10%
 - EPS: USD0.44 vs USD0.22

These gains imply a structural shift, though global telco CAPEX remains cyclical - an element not reflected in the projections. While niche positioning and innovation could buffer downturns, risks include supply chain volatility, component shortages, and FX fluctuations.

Customer/geographic concentration is another factor: Indian clients remain significant despite improved diversification. Refer to the right part of Chart 1. A sharp drop in Indian telco spending could still pressure revenue

Upside exists - if 2025 revenue growth reaches 10% before tapering to 4% by Year 6, the margin of safety would expand substantially.

CONCLUSION

Ceragon has executed a clear strategic shift since 2020, delivering stronger margins, healthier cash generation, and a solid financial base. My valuation suggests a >30% margin of safety, supported

by structural improvements in its business model and an ability to compete effectively among wireless transport specialists.

However, the sector's cyclical CAPEX patterns, ongoing supply chain risks, and geographic concentration in India temper the outlook. The company's diversification into private networks and higher-value solutions could help mitigate these headwinds, but sustained outperformance will require continued innovation and disciplined cost management.

For long-term value investors, Ceragon offers an attractive opportunity - provided one is comfortable with the inherent industry and customer concentration risks.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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SkyWorld: Pioneering Malaysia's Next Era of Urban Living with PPVC Technology

When Lee Chee Seng, CEO of SkyWorld Group, talks about the future, his eyes light up. “We’re not just building homes,” he says, “we’re reshaping how people live, work, and connect in the city.” This isn’t just corporate optimism, it’s their DNA, and as he puts it, ‘it’s the start of a new era, the company’s next chapter, where innovation, efficiency, and human-centric design converge.’

The award-winning developer is stepping into a new era, one where innovation, sustainability, and scale are front and centre. SkyWorld has recently been in the limelight with the announcement of the nation’s first large-scale affordable home project in Penang that will pioneer the Prefabricated Prefinished Volumetric Construction (PPVC) method of building technology. This development is also set to change the real estate landscape, introducing the first vertical school concept in partnership with the government.

Yet, Lee remains remarkably measured, almost guarded. For him, these milestones are not victory laps but stepping stones toward an even bigger prize: the successful rollout of Malaysia's first PPVC-built homes, a move set to redefine how the nation builds. "Being first is just the beginning," he tells Inve\$. "Sustaining it, and delivering it flawlessly is what really matters."

SKYWORLD'S NEXT ASCENT

Think of SkyWorld's journey as an S-curve, a slow, deliberate climb in the early years, a burst of acceleration that took the company to its listing peak in 2023, and then a purposeful pause. Behind the scenes, the team was laying steel-strong foundations, building capabilities, refining strategies, and positioning for a bigger leap forward.

That leap is a new era defined by scale, precision, and vision. Last year, the company secured nearly 200 acres of prime Penang land with a combined gross development value (GDV) of RM13 billion. SkyWorld’s portfolio is anchored by three distinctive home series, each catering to a different lifestyle and life stage. **SkyAwani** is the affordably priced series, ideal for first-time buyers or young families, with five projects already completed. **SkySignature**, the mid-range series, offers resort-style facilities, and also boasts seven completed developments in its portfolio. **X-Premier** is the pinnacle, delivering bespoke amenities, prime locations, and exemplified luxury.

SKYWORLD PEARLMONT - FIRST PPVC-BUILT HOMES AND A NATIONAL GOLD STANDARD FOR AFFORDABLE HOMES

SkyWorld's debut in Penang, SkyWorld Pearlmont marks a bold leap for the Group, and the nation, introducing multiple cutting-edge concepts – including Malaysia's first 10-acre elevated park within a master-planned township built on the '15-minute city' concept, Malaysia's first vertical school, exceptionally low maintenance fee, and the Pay-Per-Use Clubhouse facilities.

Designed for smart, connected living, the development integrates green spaces, community parks, and the SkyWorld Connects app, a one-stop solution, to foster stronger neighbourly ties and healthier lifestyles, reflecting SkyWorld's strategic focus on creating sustainable, high-value communities that enhance quality of life while driving long-term asset value.

The integration of the 10-acre elevated park sets a gold standard in the industry for affordable homes with premium features and quality, bringing verdant spaces for healthy living and encouraging social integration. Another key feature of this development is its exceptionally low maintenance fee of just RM0.18 per sq ft, for 10 years. SkyWorld will introduce a 'Pay-Per-Use' model for Clubhouse facilities such as the gym, swimming pool, and recreational amenities, ensuring residents pay only for what they use. This approach keeps fees affordable by capping costs to essential and shared facilities.

THE FUTURE IS PPVC

SkyWorld is betting big on PPVC as the future of Malaysian homebuilding, and it's building the infrastructure to make it happen. The Group has already secured 26 acres in Penang to establish its first PPVC factory designed to supply close to 40,000 units for the flagship SkyWorld Pearlmont and SkyWorld Cassia townships. While the initial investment is hefty, over RM200 million for the factory alone, the long-term economics are clear: scale and standardisation will drive costs down, enabling SkyWorld to deliver high-quality, affordable homes at unmatched price points.



PPVC's competitive edge lies in its precision and quality control. In Malaysia, QLASSIC scores in the industry score averages 74–75%, with top-tier projects reaching 85–86%. SkyWorld is committed to 85% QLASSIC score for its Penang developments built using PPVC technology. In Singapore, where PPVC is widely adopted, the CONQUAS benchmark hits an extraordinary



95%, near perfection. SkyWorld's factory environment mirrors this approach, using robotics, advanced machinery, and consistent moulding to eliminate common defects like water leakage. By casting window and door frames directly into the concrete modules, SkyWorld offers an unprecedented 10-year leak-proof warranty, compared to the industry's typical 24 months.

This method isn't just about quality, it's ESG-compliant and clean. With 75% of the build completed offsite, PPVC sites generate less noise, dust, and waste, while drastically reducing construction timelines by up to 30%.

Many developers avoid the affordable housing segment due to thin margins and rising compliance costs, but SkyWorld's model can supply modules to other developers as well, at lower costs than conventional builds, unlocking an entirely new revenue stream.



“ SkyWorld sees PPVC technology as the solution to Malaysia’s affordable housing bottleneck. We’re not just preparing for the next project, we’re preparing for the next decade. ”

Looking ahead, the developer does not discount the possibility of a second PPVC plant in the Klang Valley once volumes exceed 10,000 units, cementing its role as Malaysia’s leader in industrialised homebuilding.

"Moving forward, labour costs will rise, compliance will tighten, and automation will become essential. By the time the market shifts, we’ll already be years ahead," Lee points out.

With Penang’s mega projects, PPVC’s debut, and a sharpened focus on sustainability and execution, SkyWorld’s next wave is already gathering force. And Lee? He’s keeping his head down, intent on proving that being first is just the start of something far bigger.



THE VERTICAL SCHOOL – REDEFINING EDUCATION IN URBAN LIVING

Water and energy supply key to drawing investors to Malaysia – PM Anwar

According to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, the ability to provide sufficient water and energy supply is among the main attractions for investors in the semiconductor, data centre and artificial intelligence (AI) sectors in Malaysia. This was further strengthened by the country's capacity to provide professional manpower expertise, which was a key strategic requirement for investors.

Speaking when officiating the Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant (LRA2), he said that water and energy are very strategic resources. He further emphasised that to be able to maintain Malaysia's credibility as a peaceful and competent nation, we must resolve matters related to water and energy.

He added that it is not only about providing water and electricity facilities to investors, but also about how we manage the prices of water and energy at reasonable levels without burdening the people. He noted that Malaysia continued to face wastage issues,

particularly involving non-revenue water (NRW) due to usage practices and weaknesses in the old piping system.

He said that Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof, who is also the minister responsible for energy transition and water transformation (Petra), had raised the matter numerous times during Cabinet meetings and that it would be made one of the priorities under the 13th Malaysia Plan.

The PM said in terms of water management, ensuring comfort and meeting the people's needs remained the government's main priority. He said, "How can a country with an abundance of water, with floods two or three times a year, still face water shortages? That means something is wrong, not because of Allah's will, but due to a lack of human ingenuity."

He added, "Take Jordan, for example. They may only have heavy rain two or three times a year, but they are able to store water for times of need. That is why our technology must not only focus on advancement but also ensure water-saving measures are in place."



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KLIA international traffic up 10% in July on network expansion - MAHB

According to Malaysia Airports Holdings Bhd (MAHB) managing director Datuk Mohd Izani Ghani, Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) recorded a 10.3% rise in international passenger traffic in July, reaching 3.9 million from 3.6 million in June. The increase was driven in part by network expansion, including the launch of Loong Air's (GJ) tri-weekly service between Kuala Lumpur and Xi'an, strengthening KLIA's links to key Chinese markets. The stronger Chinese connectivity is helping power Malaysia's broader economic growth while reinforcing KLIA's role as Southeast Asia's preferred hub.

He added that direct air links with emerging cities like Xi'an not only boost passenger traffic but also open wider trade and investment opportunities. This positions Malaysia as a vital gateway for China-Southeast Asia movement, supporting growth in aviation, tourism and commerce, and accelerating regional integration.

Across its network of local airports, MAHB handled 8.9 million passengers in July, comprising 4.6 million international and 4.3 million domestic travellers. The Istanbul Sabiha Gökçen International Airport, the group's wholly owned asset in Türkiye, recorded 4.4 million passengers during the month, including 2.3 million international and 2.1 million domestic passengers. Combined, the group's airports handled 13.3 million passengers in July, up 5.7% from June 2025.

HEINEKEN Malaysia Reports 2Q & 1H FY2025 Results



Heineken Malaysia Berhad announced its financial results for Q2 and 1H ended 30 June 2025, reflecting a minor decline in revenue and profit compared to the same period in 2024, amid evolving market dynamics.

In Q2 2025, the Group recorded revenue of RM539.7 million, a 5%

decrease compared to 2024, reflecting the expected normalisation of demand post-festive season and more cautious consumer sentiment. The Group's PBT stood at RM109.4 million, a 9% decrease from the same period last year, primarily due to softer revenue and increased cost pressures.

For 1H 2025, the Group recorded revenue of RM1.30 billion, a 4% decrease when compared to the same period last year. PBT also eased by 4% compared to the same period last year. This performance reflects a combination of more measured consumer demand and the Group's continued strategic investments in digital infrastructure and commercial initiatives to support long-term growth, in line with its EverGreen strategy to future-proof the business.

In FY2024, a staggering 174 workers lost their lives on the job across 709 PLCs. These numbers are not some cold hard facts but a grim reminder of the human cost behind corporate profits.

WHEN GOING TO WORK SHOULDN'T COST YOUR LIFE

Behind every corporate profit announcement and glossy sustainability report lies a reality that is far less polished: workers who never make it home. Each death is more than a statistic; it is a story of a life cut short, a family shattered, and a workplace where safety measures failed to prevent the unthinkable. For investors and stakeholders, these tragedies are not only a human cost but also a test of whether companies truly value the people who keep their businesses running.

The scale of this problem became clearer in FY2024 when public listed companies (PLCs) disclosed a combined 174 work-related

fatalities from a sample size of 709 PLCs. In certain industries, fatalities are a recurring and predictable reality, with rates many times higher than the market norm, raising uncomfortable questions about safety governance, compliance, and whether boards are truly fulfilling their duty of care.

These figures were not volunteered; they came to light only because Bursa Malaysia requires companies to disclose such data under its Common Sustainability Matters in the Bursa Malaysia Sustainability Reporting Framework. Without this mandatory reporting, much of this information would have remained hidden, depriving stakeholders of a transparent view of workplace safety performance.

DIFFERENT INDUSTRIES, SAME DEADLY LESSONS

The sectoral breakdown of FY2024 disclosures is anything but uniform. Some industries manage to keep fatalities rare, while others are grappling with risks that seem woven into their daily operations.

The Plantation sector is the most alarming, with 34 PLCs in the sector reporting a combined total of 79 fatalities. This is no statistical quirk; it is a red flag waving loudly. Plantations stretch across vast, remote landscapes where workers operate heavy harvesting machinery, climb tall trees, handle sharp tools, and navigate rough terrain in all weather conditions. It is physically demanding work, and when accidents happen far from medical help, the outcome can turn fatal. In these conditions, safety cannot be treated as a box-ticking exercise; it has to be adapted to environments where hazards are part of the landscape and help is not always close at hand.

The Industrial Products and Services sector, with its 208 PLCs, reported 58 fatalities. It is a sprawling sector that covers manufacturing plants, engineering workshops, and industrial facilities of every shape and size. The common thread is risk: machinery that can crush, chemicals that can burn, and heights

that can kill. Production floors often move at a relentless pace, and while procedures may be in place, they are only effective if every worker understands them and every supervisor enforces them. In high-pressure environments, the temptation to take a shortcut can be deadly

Utilities are small in number but big in risk. With just 11 PLCs, it recorded four fatalities. Employees here work with high-voltage electricity, maintain complex infrastructure, and enter confined spaces where a single oversight can have irreversible consequences. The sector's scale may be small, but its hazards are unforgiving.

Construction recorded eight fatalities among 40 PLCs, while the Energy sector reported three fatalities across 20 PLCs. These industries are no strangers to danger. Work at height, crane lifts, offshore rigs, welding, and hazardous energy sources are part of daily life. Safety cultures in these sectors may be stronger than in the past, but the margin for error remains razor thin. One lapse or overlooked procedure can change the course of lives and projects overnight.

Other sectors, including Consumer Products and Services, Financial Services, Property, Technology, and Transportation and Logistics, report lower averages between 0 and 0.1 fatalities. However, low does not mean safe enough. In workplace safety, the only acceptable number is zero. Anything else means lives are still being lost.

WHAT WE HEARD AT AGMS

During the recent AGM season, MSWG put the fatality data on the table with selected PLCs, especially those in high-risk sectors. MSWG pointed out that while some companies recorded fatalities, there were also companies, particularly in the oil and gas sector, that managed to maintain zero fatalities and a zero incident rate despite operating in dangerous environments. The responses

from companies revealed a mix of accountability, explanation, and, at times, deflection.

Some companies acknowledged the harsh reality: fatalities occurred because employees failed to follow safety rules, despite the companies having policies, standard operating procedures, and training in place. This serves as a reminder that a safety policy is only as effective as its daily enforcement. In their annual reports, one PLC disclosed that two workers died on 9 September 2024 following a slope collapse, and stated that lessons learned had been implemented while safe working conditions were reinforced under a Goal Zero commitment. Another PLC described an initiative led by its Sustainability and Safety department, which organised seven human-wildlife conflict workshops, covering snake species in townships, safety measures, snake behaviour, venom types, antivenoms, and first-aid responses, to reduce injuries and fatalities from snake encounters.

Others pointed out that their fatality numbers included commuting-related death incidents that occurred while employees were travelling to or from work. Under certain reporting frameworks, these still count as work-related fatalities.

Then there were the roadside tragedies. Workers carrying out repairs or maintenance near roads were struck by vehicles. In many cases, these accidents were caused by third-party drivers, making them hard to prevent entirely.

MSWG's message to all these companies was consistent: commit to a zero-fatality target. Encouragingly, several PLCs gave their word. But a commitment on paper is not enough; resources, enforcement, and leadership from the top must back it.

SAFETY ISN'T GLOBAL UNTIL IT'S LOCAL

Workplace fatalities are not confined to any one country. Globally, the International Labour Organisation estimates that 3 million women and men die at work from an occupational injury or

disease. The Asia-Pacific region has the highest work-related mortality (63% of the global total) because of the size of the region's workforce¹.

Malaysia is no exception. The Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) records 94 fatal accidents from January to May 2025 (5 months), with the construction, manufacturing, and plantation sectors consistently featuring among the highest risk categories. Investigations often reveal familiar causes: falls from height, inadequate safety barriers, insufficient supervision, and lapses in following standard operating procedures. In some cases, companies have well-written safety manuals but fail to ensure that the rules are applied in practice.

For shareholders, this is not simply a worker welfare issue; it is a governance and sustainability challenge that strikes at the heart of corporate value. A fatality can tarnish a company's reputation, erode investor confidence, and lead to penalties, lawsuits, and lost contracts. More importantly, a pattern of fatalities may be a symptom of more profound governance weaknesses; inadequate oversight, poor risk management, or a lack of board engagement on environmental, social, and governance (ESG) matters.

ZERO MUST BE THE NORM

MSWG believes that every PLC must commit to a zero-fatality target; not as a vague aspiration, but as a measurable and enforceable standard. Boards must take ownership of this goal, review safety performance regularly, commission independent audits, and be fully transparent with stakeholders. High-risk sectors must tackle their hazards with targeted measures, while roadside and commuting dangers must be addressed through defensive driving programmes, route risk assessments, and protective infrastructure.

Transparency in reporting must extend beyond narrative statements. Companies should provide measurable indicators, such as year-on-year fatality trends, near-miss data, and training completion rates, enabling shareholders to track progress rather than relying solely on assurances.

The FY2024 fatality figures are more than statistics. They represent colleagues, friends, and family members who never returned home from work. Some sectors face higher risks than others, but no sector is immune, and complacency is never an option. Whether a life is lost in the field, on a factory floor, during a commute, or in a roadside accident, the impact is the same. Boards and management must lead from the front, embedding a safety-first culture, committing the necessary resources, and holding themselves accountable.

A zero-fatality mindset is not an idealistic dream. It is the only acceptable standard.

Anything less is unacceptable.
