SUMMARY

- Despite operating in the high growth enterprise data management and cloud storage markets, NetApp's (NASDAQ:NTAP) revenue grew only 1.7% CAGR from 2016 to 2025. A big part of its growth came from acquisitions that focused more on product realignment than topline expansion.

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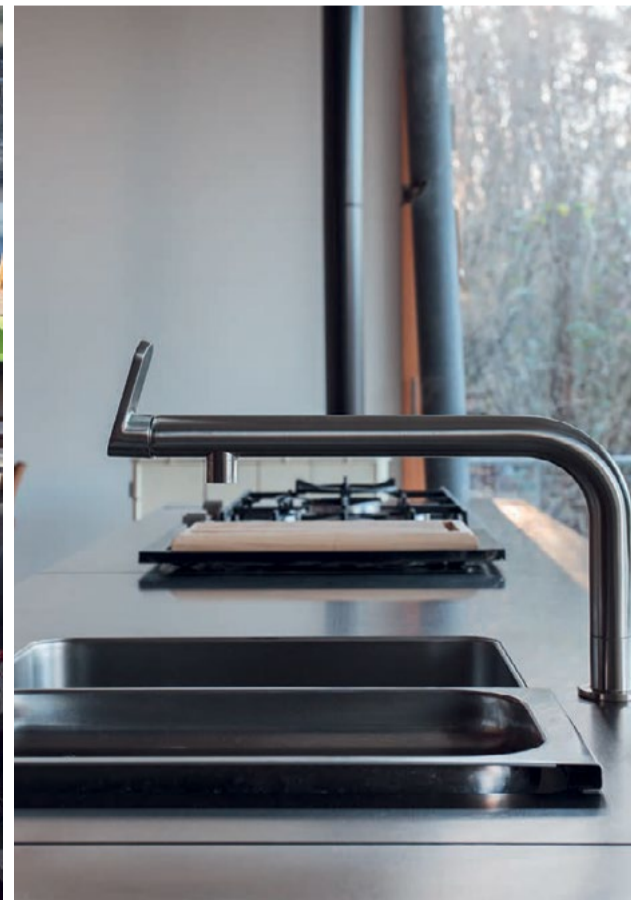

A decorative technique that was often used on watch cases, guilloché has become an art in its own right. A.-L. Breguet was the first to use this technique to delineate the different displays on watch dials, and it remains, to this day, one of Breguet's core areas of expertise.

Breguet currently owns the largest collection of working guilloché lathes in the world. These carefully renovated period machines can be used to create a wide range of motifs, from the most traditional, such as the Clou de Paris, to the most contemporary, the new Quai de l'Horloge design, which has been incorporated on the dial of this Tradition model.

This new guilloché motif was inspired by the graceful lines of the Seine as it flows around the Île de la Cité, where A.-L. Breguet's workshop once stood, and the Île Saint-Louis, both in the heart of Paris. The precise contours of this motif are modelled on the Turgot map, a highly-detailed, perspective view of the city of Paris produced in the eighteenth century. For its time it was remarkably accurate: it included all the streets, buildings and even every tree in the centre of Paris.

Quai de l'Horloge: a unique guilloché decoration

The Tradition collection incorporates for the first time two "in-house" colour codes: Breguet gold and Breguet blue

Gold, silver, copper and palladium are skilfully fused into an alloy that radiates a warm, golden glow: Breguet gold. This exclusive alloy, created by Breguet, was introduced earlier this year with the Classique Souscription 2025 watch. The 38 mm diameter case for the Tradition 7035 has been crafted from this new alloy. A specially-developed plating treatment ensures that the mainplate and bridges are of the same hue as the case. The silver-coloured gears, blued screws and ruby-red jewels provide visual contrast and further accentuate the radiance of Breguet gold. The bridges of this new anniversary model feature, for the first time in the Tradition collection, a silky, hand-applied satin finish on their upper surfaces.

The striking focal point of this model is the finely engine-turned dial, resplendent in Breguet blue. The chosen motive is the Quai de l'Horloge. Its tinted, translucent, grand feu enamel is of the same deep, blue as the retrograde seconds hand and screws, which are made of blued steel. In contrasting silver, the Breguet Arabic numerals, the minute track, with its stylised fleurs-de-lis, and the unique serial number at 4 o'clock stand out effortlessly against the shimmering azure of the enamel.

Crescent moon-shaped
oscillating weight:
a tribute to watchmaking genius

The back of the new Tradition 7035 reveals a golden landscape as fascinating as the front. The oscillating weight spins above the bridges' satin-finished surfaces, which provide an elegant contrast to the shot-blasted mainplate below.

The crescent moon-shaped weight, made of vertical brushed platinum, is reminiscent of those used in A.-L. Breguet's time. He established the use of platinum in watchmaking, using it to optimise the automatic winding of what he referred to as his "perpétuelle" watches, one of the first innovations from this master watchmaker.

A discrete "Pt950" engraved on the weight's upper left-hand flank acts as a reassuring gauge of quality, as well as a knowing nod to Breguet's patrimony.

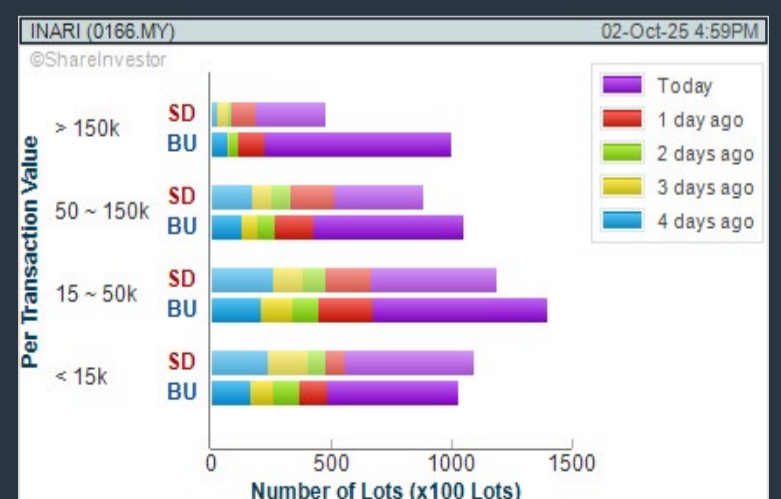

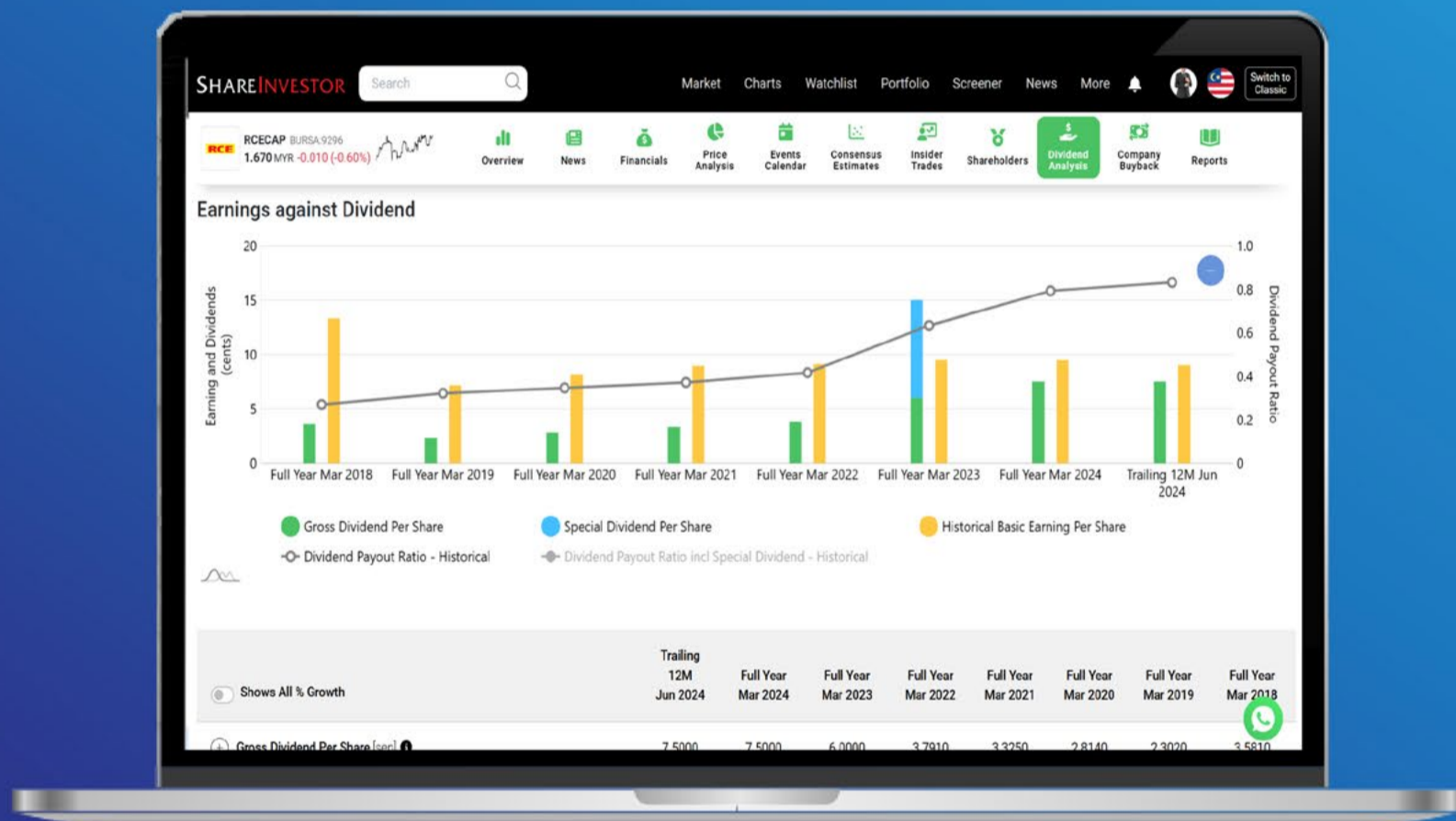

Is there an investment opportunity in **NetApp?**

SUMMARY

- Despite operating in the high growth enterprise data management and cloud storage markets, NetApp's (**NASDAQ: NTAP**) revenue grew only 1.7% CAGR from 2016 to 2025. A big part of its growth came from acquisitions that focused more on product realignment than topline expansion.

- The business mix moved from hardware to software and services, supported by acquisitions and cloud subscriptions. Contribution margin rose from 65% in 2016 to 74% in 2025, lifting profitability.
- NetApp is financially sound. It maintained low reinvestment (5% of NOPAT), solid cash generation, and reduced net debt. Shareholder returns were supported by buybacks and a sound balance sheet.

BACKGROUND

NetApp is a global technology company that combines unified data storage, integrated data services, and CloudOps solutions to make data infrastructure intelligent.

Historically, the US accounted for about half of the revenue (**Chart 1, left**). From 2016 to 2025, revenue grew at only a 1.7% CAGR, with most of the growth coming from non-US operations.



Chart 1: Revenue Profile

Although topline growth was modest, the revenue mix shifted significantly. NetApp provides both hardware and software, but over the past decade, the contribution from software and services rose from 46% of total revenue in 2016 to 55% in 2025 (Chart 1, right). This reflects how NetApp reinvented itself to stay competitive in the cloud era.

A key milestone came in 2022, when cloud-related revenue was broken out separately from software maintenance. NetApp supported this transition with acquisitions such as Spot.io (cloud cost optimization) and InstaClustr (managed open-source database services).

Together with Keystone and cloud subscriptions, this pushed more revenue into recurring services rather than one-time hardware sales. The result was a steady rise in contribution margin from 65% in 2016 to 74% in 2025 (**Chart 2, right**).

The company faced a setback in 2020, when COVID-19 caused a revenue decline. Recovery was only completed by 2022, which delayed the rebound in profits until 2023. This lag also shaped the return profile (**Chart 2, left**). Interestingly, returns spiked in 2020 despite lower profits, due to a large stock buyback that reduced equity from USD1,090 million in 2019 to just USD242 million in 2020.

Despite these fluctuations, NetApp has delivered growing returns over the past decade, driven by its shift toward cloud services, recurring revenue, and higher margins.

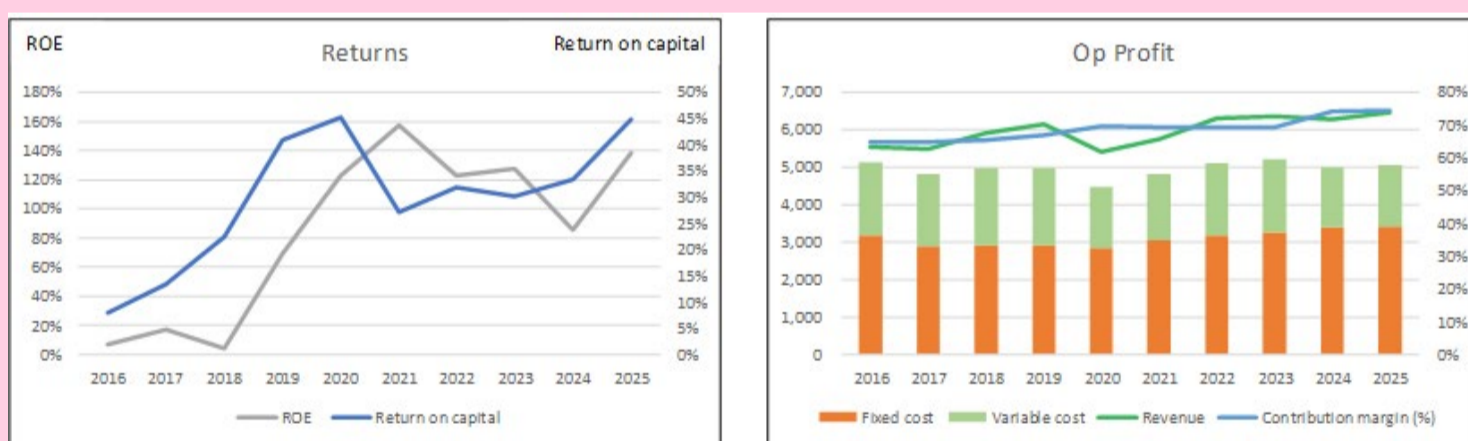


Chart 2: Returns and Operating Profit Profile

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

NetApp operates in the enterprise data management and cloud storage industry, a sector that has been expanding at high single to double-digit rates. Against this backdrop of robust industry growth, NetApp’s revenue grew at only 1.7% CAGR over the past decade.

Over the same period, NetApp spent about USD2.2 billion on cash acquisitions. These acquisitions appear to have been driven more by product realignment - shifting the business mix - rather than by top-line expansion.

Despite sluggish revenue growth, NetApp managed to expand PAT from USD229 million in 2016 to USD1,151 million in 2025. This improvement was largely due to margin expansion and cost control. However, these levers have natural limits, raising questions about how much further profitability can be pushed without stronger revenue growth.

There is, however, a silver lining. Growth typically requires reinvestment, and one way to measure this is through the Reinvestment Rate = Reinvestment/NOPAT, where:

Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisitions – Depreciation & Amortization + Increase in Net Working Capital.

Over the past decade, NetApp's average reinvestment rate was just 5%, leaving a large portion of NOPAT available for returns to shareholders.

The picture that emerges is of a mature company operating within a growth sector. While it has not kept pace with the industry's topline expansion, NetApp has still delivered solid returns through operational discipline and capital efficiency.

PEERS

I compared NetApp's performance with several publicly listed cloud-native and traditional IT vendors. I excluded the giants such as IBM, Amazon Web Services, Microsoft, and Alphabet.

As shown in Table 1, NetApp ranked as the largest among these peers by 2024 revenue. However, it also delivered the weakest revenue growth rate. This reinforces the earlier point that NetApp's top-line expansion has been well below the broader market growth rates in enterprise data management and cloud storage.

To evaluate relative performance, I used four key metrics: return on capital, EBIT margin, EPS, and levered free cash flow margin.

On this basis, NetApp emerged as the top performer in three of the four categories - return on capital, EBIT margin, and EPS - highlighting its profitability and operating efficiency.

The one area where NetApp was less impressive was in levered free cash flow margin, where it performed only at an average level. This indicates that while the company is strong in generating earnings and returns, its cash flow conversion efficiency lags behind its peers.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate NetApp as sound financially based on the following criteria. It is also a cash cow.

- As of April 2025, it had USD3.8 billion in cash. This is about 36% of its total assets.
- It had a debt-capital ratio of 77% at the end of April 2025. This has come down from its past decade high of 88% in 2020. It had almost zero net debt.
- Over the past decade, it has had positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated USD12.7 billion in cash flow from operations compared to the USD7.9 billion cumulative PAT. This is a good cash conversion ratio.
- It had a low Reinvestment rate with a good capital allocation plan. Refer to Table 2. The cash flow from operations was more than sufficient to cover its CAPEX and acquisitions. A significant part of the excess was returned to shareholders.

VALUATION

In valuing NetApp, I adopted the following assumptions:

1. I treated NetApp as a mature company with a perpetual growth rate of 4%, roughly in line with long-term GDP growth. Given its historical performance, it did not seem realistic

to project a much higher revenue growth rate. The 2025 revenue served as the base year for this projection.

2. I assumed the company would continue improving operating efficiency, such that by the terminal year, the contribution margin would be 10% higher than the base margin. For this purpose, I took the average contribution margin from 2023 to 2025 as the base.
3. I assumed the company would maintain its historically low reinvestment rate, consistent with past practice.
4. I applied the average positive tax rate of 26.8% from the past decade.

Based on these assumptions, I arrived at an intrinsic value of USD114 per share, compared to a market price of USD120 per share as of 11 February 2025. On this basis, there is no margin of safety. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

CONCLUSION

NetApp presents a mixed investment case. On the one hand, it operates in a high-growth industry. But it has consistently underperformed peers in revenue expansion, achieving only a 1.7% CAGR over the past decade. Its acquisitions have helped reposition the business rather than accelerate growth. Its reliance on margin improvement and cost control has natural limits.

On the other hand, NetApp's strengths are clear. The company has successfully shifted its business model toward recurring revenue

and higher-margin services. This has delivered strong returns on capital and maintained robust financial discipline with low reinvestment needs. Its sound balance sheet and consistent cash generation have enabled substantial shareholder returns.

Valuation is the deciding factor. With an intrinsic value of USD114 per share versus a market price of USD120 (as of February 2025), the stock appears fairly valued, offering no margin of safety.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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Mizuho Bank commits nearly US\$600m to support Johor- Singapore SEZ - Amir Hamzah

According to Finance Minister II Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan, Mizuho Bank (Malaysia) Bhd is committed to supporting the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone (JS-SEZ), providing nearly US\$600 million (RM2.52 billion) in financing for clients investing in the area.

Amir Hamzah, who also serves as the acting minister of economy, said Mizuho Bank noted investment interests in food and beverage manufacturing, data centres, power generation, and chemical-related manufacturing.

Speaking at his keynote address during the exchange of the letter of intent between the Iskandar Regional Development Authority (IRDA) and Mizuho Bank, he said that financial institutions like Mizuho Bank play crucial roles in building investors' confidence, enhancing visibility and opening new channels of investment.

Also present were Ministry of Economy secretary general Datuk Nor Azmie Diron, IRDA chief executive Datuk Mohd Noorazam Osman, Mizuho Financial Group Inc and Mizuho Bank Ltd managing executive officer and chief executive officer for Asia-Pacific Koichi Zaiki.

IRDA serves as the facilitation agency for investments in the JS-SEZ, while Mizuho Bank is reportedly one of Japan's largest and most established financial services institutions.

Amir Hamzah noted that with IRDA as the facilitator and Mizuho Bank (Malaysia) as a trusted financial partner, JS-SEZ will attract new investments, create jobs and strengthen Malaysia's role as a regional economic hub. He said that in May 2025, the JS-SEZ secured strategic partnerships with six financial institutions.

He added that a continuous strategic partnership is essential for attracting high-value investments, strengthening cross-border connectivity and creating opportunities that benefit not only Johor but also Malaysia. Mizuho Bank is uniquely positioned to channel catalytic projects into the 11 promoted sectors of the JS-SEZ through its extensive network of Japanese clients.

He believes that this initiative would translate into real benefits for the rakyat as a whole, citing an example that when a Japanese automotive manufacturer sets up its plant here, it not only creates high-skilled engineering jobs but also opportunities for the local small- and medium-sized enterprises to supply components and services. For investors, this means a more supportive ecosystem, easier access to financing and faster facilitation of projects.

Meanwhile, Koichi added that a pipeline of 10 to 20 Japanese companies had expressed interest in coming to the JS-SEZ.



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Domestic Trade Ministry to amend Direct Sales Act, to boost consumer protection

According to Deputy Minister Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh, the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) is preparing to amend the Direct Sales and Anti-Pyramid Scheme Act 1993 (AJLSAP 1993) to provide better protection to consumers and legitimate sales representatives so that they are not trapped by problematic companies.

This move is important as the global direct selling industry continues to grow rapidly and Malaysia needs to ensure its laws are on par with other countries. KPDN is committed to continuing to guide and ensure the integrity of the direct sales industry in Malaysia through legal compliance and prevention efforts against illegal activities.

In a statement, she said that although the industry was showing positive developments, industry players needed to work harder to overcome the public's perception that was still confused between legitimate direct selling and pyramid schemes. This stigma undermined consumer confidence and this situation affected the reputation of legitimate direct sales companies.

Therefore, KPDN offered several solutions, including assistance in consumer advocacy to provide awareness and education to

consumers to prioritise local products, including licensed direct sales products, and at the same time avoid pyramid schemes or counterfeit products. This is to improve the image of the industry so that it is seen as one of the contributors to the economy and entrepreneurial opportunities for the people.

KPDN also encouraged direct sales entrepreneurs to cooperate with the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia (MyIPO) by registering businesses, products or scientific discoveries that require patent protection. She added that registered trademarks can become a company's asset, and can even be licensed or used as investment holdings. In addition, products registered with the MyIPO trademark are seen as more legitimate, trustworthy and not easily counterfeited.

She said intellectual property protection can also ensure that companies that sell products based on natural resources such as tongkat ali, kacip fatimah, sea cucumber, virgin coconut oil can operate legally, as well as help companies take action against parties who imitate or sell counterfeit products.

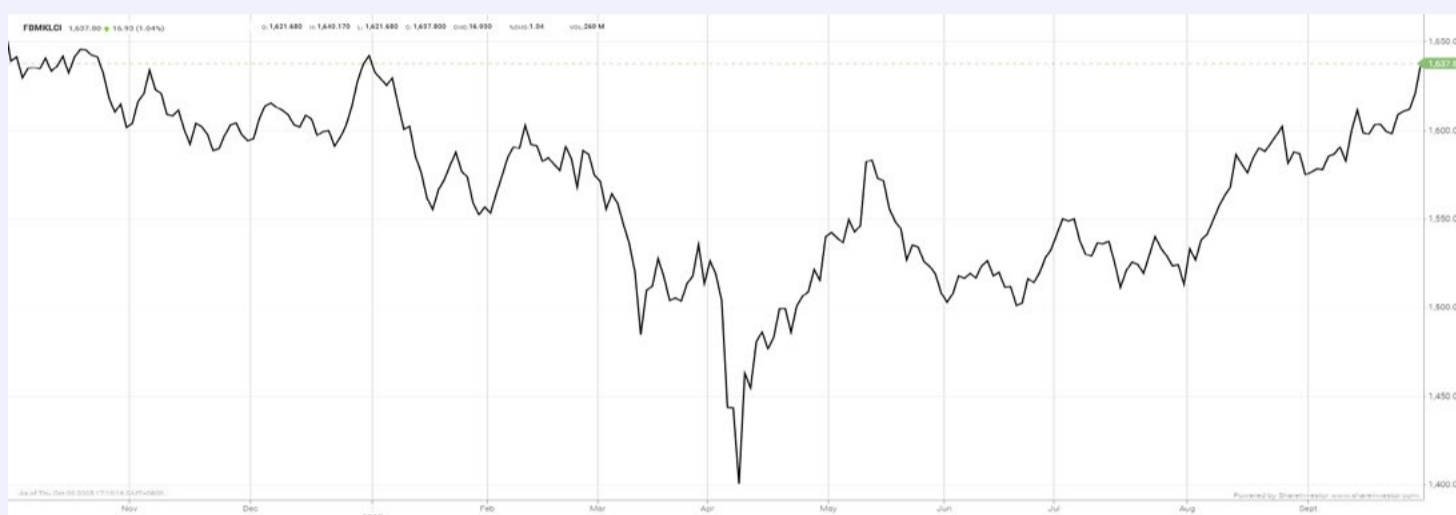
She added that one of KPDN's main agendas to support local products, including those from the direct selling industry, is through the Buy Malaysian Goods Campaign (KBBM). It is not just a slogan, but an advocacy and marketing tool that helps promote locally made direct selling products, supports Malaysian entrepreneurs and sales representatives and paves the way to the global market.

She noted that last year, the direct sales industry recorded a sales value of RM34.4 billion, an increase of 7.4% compared to the previous year, placing Malaysia in sixth place in the world and fourth in Asia Pacific, with the highest market penetration rate in the world of 2.28%.

Earlier, Fuziah had received a courtesy call from representatives of the Malaysian Direct Selling Industry Development Association (MDSIDA) led by its president Datuk Seri Barani Karunakaran. MDSIDA, formerly known as the Malaysian Direct Distribution Association (MDDA), is a strategic partner of KPDN in promoting the direct selling industry at the national and international levels.

JET-SET LIFESTYLE FOR DXN'S MEMBERS NOW EXTENDS TO THE WORLD'S TALLEST BUILDING, BUT SHAREHOLDERS ARE LEFT GROUNDED

DXN Holdings Bhd., an integrated health and wellness products manufacturer and distributor, is again under the spotlight for another intriguing related party transaction (RPT). This time, the Company is spending RM7.37 million on a luxury apartment in Dubai's Burj Khalifa – the world's tallest building at 829.8 metres – a deal tied to its executive chairman (EC) and founder, Datuk Lim Siow Jin and a substantial shareholder.

Lim holds a direct stake of 9.19% and an indirect stake of 54.196% stake in DXN, including shares held under his wife Datin Leong Bee Ling and LSJ Global Sdn Bhd, a private company in which the couple are substantial shareholders.

This follows closely on the heels of last year's controversy highlighted by MSWG in our newsletter dated November 29 2024, when DXN proposed chartering a Gulfstream G550 corporate jet,

which is owned by Lim, for US\$6.60 million (RM29.06 million) annually, before scaling it down to a 12-month lease at US\$6.15 million (RM26.96 million).

Collectively, the jet and Burj Khalifa apartment acquisitions – both linked to its EC – have stirred unease among some investors and reignited concerns over DXN's governance, priorities, and the balance of value creation across DXN's stakeholders.

TWO RPTS WITHIN A YEAR

The entity involved in the recent RPT is a 1,888 square feet apartment unit in Burj Khalifa.

In justifying the purchase, DXN argues that the purchase will bolster its incentive and lifestyle offerings to members, keeping its members motivated and engaged. It would also offer capital appreciation potential, cost savings on member accommodation, and supplementary revenue through rental income. Ultimately, DXN said the purchase will contribute to its overall financial performance through enhanced brand value and strategic asset utilisation.

To further illustrate its point, DXN said its current properties, i.e., Boulder Valley Glamping in Teluk Bahang, Penang and the DXN Cyberville in Cyberjaya, already serve as retreat and activity hubs for its MLM members from around the world. Members are allowed to redeem stays using accumulated points as a form of recognition and motivation for sales performance.

Just back in November 2024, DXN chartered a Gulfstream G550 corporate jet, which in turn was owned by LSJ Logistics Ltd, a wholly owned unit of LSJ Global, from Luxaviation San Marino Srl and Execujet Asia Pte Ltd for US\$6.15 million. The lease amount was tantamount to about 11% of its FY2024's net profit of RM310.99 million.

The rationale offered by DXN back then was that the charter would lead to more convenient and flexible connectivity when travelling

and improved overall productivity, especially given its global presence of 11 of its 13 manufacturing facilities located outside Malaysia, as well as substantial revenue contribution of 57.9% from the Latin American market.

On top of this, the corporate jet would also be used by key management and high-performing members of the group who have achieved "Crown Ambassador" status.

JUSTIFICATION UNDER SCRUTINY

Certainly, such perks are undeniably motivating for DXN members. But for shareholders, the math is harder to justify. The jet lease alone amounted to nearly 11% of DXN's FY2024 net profit, while the Burj Khalifa purchase, though small relative to its RM1.26 billion net assets, has sent signals that fuel unease about management priorities.

Some key concerns raised include:

- **Return on investment:** How do these lifestyle perks to members tangibly translate into higher sales, profit and shareholders' return?
- **Governance:** Are these RPTs conferring indirect benefits to insiders rather than maximising shareholder value? Who proposed the transactions?
- **Balance of interests:** Are MLM members being rewarded at the expense of shareholders' capital growth?

Financially, DXN has held its ground with resilient revenue at RM479.1 million for Q1FY2026, ended 31 May 2025 (Q1FY2025: RM475.1 million). However, quarterly profit declined by 13.6% year-on-year (y-o-y) to RM73.91 million, compared to RM85.56 million previously, which it blamed on foreign exchange losses due to a stronger ringgit.

DXN maintained a dividend of 0.9 sen per share, which is consistent with the previous year. Thus far, the Group has

maintained a dividend payout ratio of more than 50%, giving it an attractive yield of 7.4%. Yet capital appreciation remains elusive – its share price is stuck at 51 sen year-to-date, well below the IPO price of 70 sen.

This divergence underscores a symbolic imbalance. While members enjoy elevated rewards, shareholders are still waiting for meaningful equity gains.

STRIKING THE RIGHT BALANCE

At a glance, there is no doubt that the RM7.37 million spent to acquire the Burj Khalifa asset is just a small price compared to DXN's net assets valued at RM1.26 billion.

But the symbolism of these high-profile purchases cannot be ignored. In markets, perception often matters as much as fundamentals, and DXN's spending choices risk feeding a narrative that distributor rewards are prioritised over shareholder value creation.

No doubt, an inspired distributor network is critical to driving DXN's topline. But the Company must ensure this does not come at the cost of sidelining shareholder interests particularly those of minority investors who lack boardroom influence.

Going forward, DXN's challenge is to demonstrate that investments in member incentives also deliver measurable financial outcomes and long-term shareholder value. Otherwise, the widening perception gap may erode investor confidence – grounding its share price even as its MLM network continues to soar.

After all, an AGM is not a private dinner party where latecomers miss the soup course; it is a meeting of owners. To lock the door on shareholders before voting begins is to forget who actually owns the house.

DEFINITION: Insider Activity shows the trades made by substantial shareholders or directors of the company. Purchases by the directors and company share buyback may indicate the share price is undervalued and brings confidence to the price trend of the share price.
