- Hap Seng Consolidated Berhad (HAPSENG:3034.MY) is a diversified group, but about 70% of its assets are tied to property. Revenue grew at a 4% CAGR over the past 12 years, though recent performance was weighed down by weak property sales and reliance on land disposals.

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A decorative technique that was often used on watch cases, guilloché has become an art in its own right. A.-L. Breguet was the first to use this technique to delineate the different displays on watch dials, and it remains, to this day, one of Breguet's core areas of expertise.

Breguet currently owns the largest collection of working guilloché lathes in the world. These carefully renovated period machines can be used to create a wide range of motifs, from the most traditional, such as the Clou de Paris, to the most contemporary, the new Quai de l'Horloge design, which has been incorporated on the dial of this Tradition model.

This new guilloché motif was inspired by the graceful lines of the Seine as it flows around the Île de la Cité, where A.-L. Breguet's workshop once stood, and the Île Saint-Louis, both in the heart of Paris. The precise contours of this motif are modelled on the Turgot map, a highly-detailed, perspective view of the city of Paris produced in the eighteenth century. For its time it was remarkably accurate: it included all the streets, buildings and even every tree in the centre of Paris.

Quai de l'Horloge: a unique guilloché decoration

The Tradition collection incorporates for the first time two "in-house" colour codes: Breguet gold and Breguet blue

Gold, silver, copper and palladium are skilfully fused into an alloy that radiates a warm, golden glow: Breguet gold. This exclusive alloy, created by Breguet, was introduced earlier this year with the Classique Souscription 2025 watch. The 38 mm diameter case for the Tradition 7035 has been crafted from this new alloy. A specially-developed plating treatment ensures that the mainplate and bridges are of the same hue as the case. The silver-coloured gears, blued screws and ruby-red jewels provide visual contrast and further accentuate the radiance of Breguet gold. The bridges of this new anniversary model feature, for the first time in the Tradition collection, a silky, hand-applied satin finish on their upper surfaces.

The striking focal point of this model is the finely engine-turned dial, resplendent in Breguet blue. The chosen motive is the Quai de l'Horloge. Its tinted, translucent, grand feu enamel is of the same deep, blue as the retrograde seconds hand and screws, which are made of blued steel. In contrasting silver, the Breguet Arabic numerals, the minute track, with its stylised fleurs-de-lis, and the unique serial number at 4 o'clock stand out effortlessly against the shimmering azure of the enamel.

Crescent moon-shaped
oscillating weight:
a tribute to watchmaking genius

The back of the new Tradition 7035 reveals a golden landscape as fascinating as the front. The oscillating weight spins above the bridges' satin-finished surfaces, which provide an elegant contrast to the shot-blasted mainplate below.

The crescent moon-shaped weight, made of vertical brushed platinum, is reminiscent of those used in A.-L. Breguet's time. He established the use of platinum in watchmaking, using it to optimise the automatic winding of what he referred to as his "perpétuelle" watches, one of the first innovations from this master watchmaker.

A discrete "Pt950" engraved on the weight's upper left-hand flank acts as a reassuring gauge of quality, as well as a knowing nod to Breguet's patrimony.

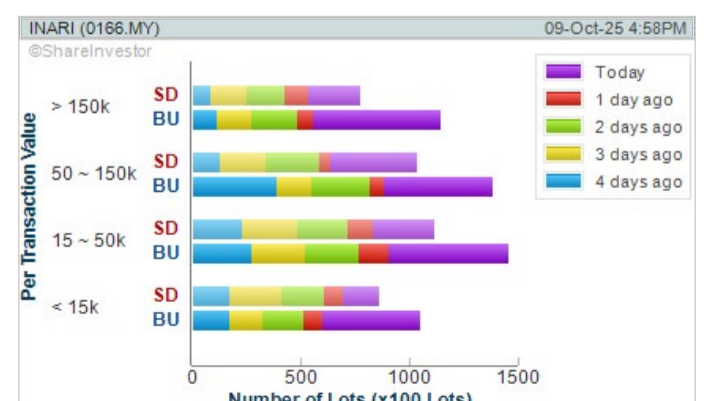

Is Hap Seng an investment opportunity?

SUMMARY

- Hap Seng Consolidated Berhad (**HAPSENG:3034.MY**) is a diversified group, but about 70% of its assets are tied to property. Revenue grew at a 4% CAGR over the past 12 years, though recent performance was weighed down by weak property sales and reliance on land disposals.

- ROIC, ROE, and CFROIC all trended downward since mid-decade peaks. Efficiency metrics showed little improvement, highlighting the need for better operating and capital discipline.
- The Group has strong cash reserves and manageable leverage, but weak cash flow conversion and dividend funding through debt and divestments reveal shortcomings in capital allocation.

BACKGROUND

Hap Seng is a diversified investment holding company with operations that span multiple industries. While the Group maintains a regional presence in Singapore, Indonesia, China, and the United Kingdom, Malaysia remains its core market, accounting for about three-quarters of revenue in 2023.

The Group's performance reflects the diversity of its portfolio.

- **Plantation:** Cultivates oil palm and processes fresh fruit bunches into crude palm oil.
- **Property Investment & Development:** Holds and develops residential, commercial, and industrial properties. This segment is the largest contributor to earnings.
- **Credit Financing:** Offers financial services such as hire purchase, leasing, and term loans for small and medium enterprises. This segment delivered the highest returns on capital.
- **Automotive:** Operates as a dealer for Mercedes-Benz vehicles, including trucks, buses, and passenger vehicles, as well as spare parts. Despite its established Mercedes-Benz dealership, this segment struggled with weak results, particularly due to losses during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Trading:** Supplies various fertilizers and trades in building materials like steel bars, cement, tiles, and more. This segment

contributed the largest share of revenue, underscoring the breadth of its distribution networks.

- **Building Materials:** Produces and sells quarry and asphalt products, clay bricks, and agro-chemicals.

When viewed from the perspective of asset allocation, Hap Seng's strategic focus becomes clearer. In 2023, approximately 70% of the Group's net assets were tied up in its property operations.

Refer to Table 1. This heavy concentration suggests that, despite its diversified activities, Hap Seng's core identity is more akin to that of a property company.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

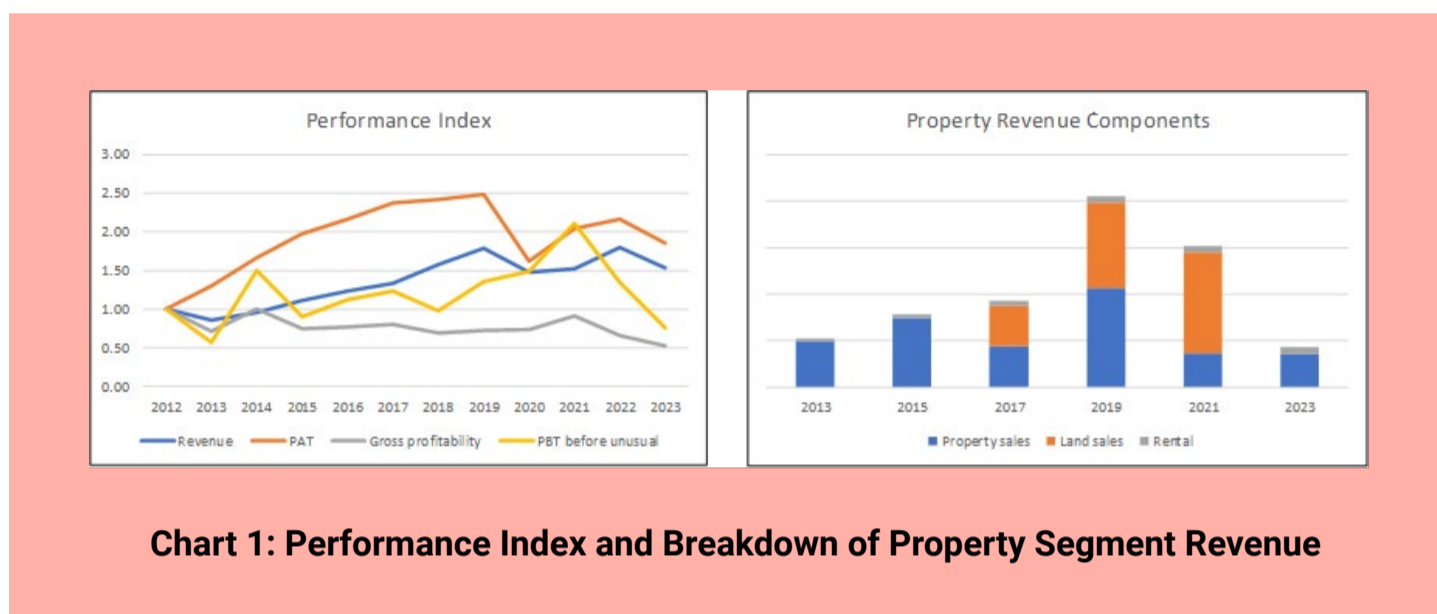
Hap Seng can be viewed as a mature company, with revenue growing at a steady 4% CAGR over the past 12 years. The trajectory, however, has not been without setbacks.

Revenue fell in 2020, reflecting the widespread slowdown and negative sentiment caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, before recovering in subsequent years. Another decline followed in 2023. This time it was driven by a correction in crude palm oil and fertilizer prices, though partially offset by higher sales volumes. **Refer to Chart 1, left.**

A closer look at segment performance reveals that much of the revenue weakness from 2019 to 2023 stemmed from the Property Investment & Development division. To cushion the impact of slower

property sales, the Group turned to land disposals between 2017 and 2022. **Refer to Chart 1, right.**

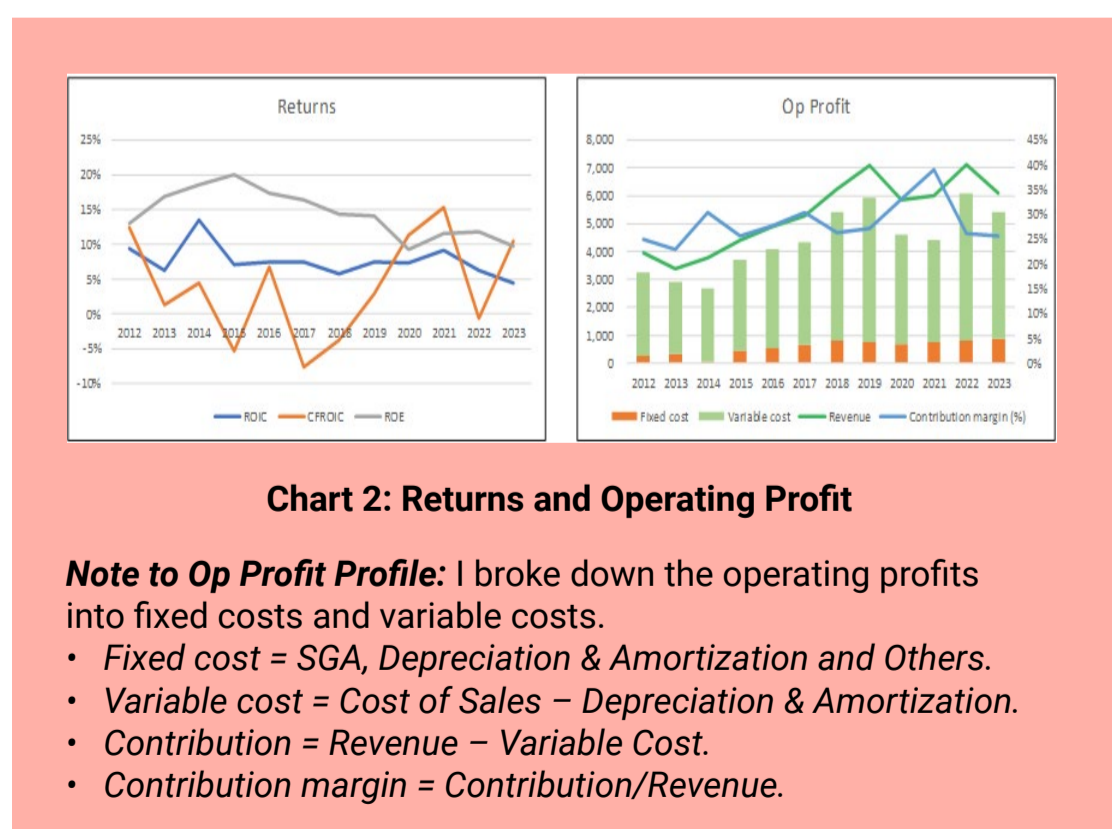
While these transactions supported both revenue and profits, they are not a sustainable long-term strategy for a property developer. The absence of land sales in 2023 exposed this vulnerability, resulting in losses for the property segment and the near disappearance of its profit contribution.



Given this revenue picture, you should not be surprised to see a clear deterioration in Hap Seng’s returns over the past decade. **Refer to Chart 2, left.** By 2023, all three key metrics - ROIC, ROE, and CFROIC - were lower than their 2012 levels.

- ROIC, which peaked in 2014, held steady for several years before sliding in the past three. Over the 12 years, it averaged 7.6%, roughly in line with the current WACC of 7.7%.
- ROE saw an even sharper decline, falling steadily after its 2015 peak, though the 12-year average of 14.4% still exceeds the current cost of equity of 9.9%.

CFROIC, in contrast, was highly volatile, averaging only 4%.

Despite the return downtrend, Hap Seng has been able to generate shareholder value since average returns exceeded the cost of funds. However, with revenue growth remaining limited, the challenge now lies in enhancing both operating and capital efficiencies. The data offers little encouragement:

- Contribution margins have shown no improvement. **Refer to Chart 2, right.**
- Gross profitability (gross profit relative to total assets) has also declined, and most measures of operating efficiency display no upward trend.
- Capital efficiency tells a similarly mixed story. Both capital turnover and asset turnover weakened, while the cash conversion cycle improved up to 2020 but has since lengthened.

PEER COMPARISON

Given its focus on property, I compared Hap Seng's performance with diversified Bursa property companies as listed in Table 2. Hap Seng had the largest 2023 revenue, with reasonable revenue growth from 2016 to 2023.

I looked at the trends of 4 metrics to get a sense of how well Hap Seng performed compared to its peers – return on capital, EBIT margin, Free Cash Flow margin, and EPS.

Hap Seng demonstrated strong financial performance, achieving the highest return on capital and ranking second in EBIT margin among the four companies. Additionally, it boasted the best earnings per share (EPS) and secured a second-place ranking for its levered free cash flow margin.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Hap Seng's financial position as average. While there were some positive points, they were offset by the negative ones. Its positive points were:

- i) As of Dec 2024, it had RM3.6 billion cash and marketable securities. This is equal to 19% of its total assets.
- ii) As of Dec 2024, its Debt Equity level stood at 78%. This is about the average level over the past decade.
- iii) From 2012 to 2023, it had a negative Reinvestment rate (Reinvestment/NOPAT). I defined Reinvestment = CAPEX + Acquisition – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital.
 - The negative value implies that the amount spent on CAPEX and/or the increase in Net Working Capital was smaller than the Depreciation & Amortization. This is a good position as it means that the company did not have to allocate funds to support its growth.
 - But I do not think that any company can grow in the long-term with a zero or negative Reinvestment rate. The negative rate was due to the divestments. If I excluded these, the Reinvestment rate would be 37%. This is a reasonable rate.

iv) It had an improving Free Cash Flow to the Firm (FCFF). From 2012 to 2023, FCFF grew at 6% CAGR. One of the reasons for the high FCFF is the negative Reinvestment rate

Its negative points were:

- i) Over the past 12 years, it generated positive cash flow from operations for only 8 of the 12 years. During this period, it generated RM4.8 billion cash flow from operations compared to the total PAT of RM11.3 billion. This is not a good cash flow conversion ratio.
- ii) It did not have a good capital allocation plan. Refer to Table 3. The cash flow from operations was not sufficient to fund its CAPEX. Dividends were funded by debt and divestments.

VALUATION

I based my valuation of Hap Seng on the following picture.

- This is a mature Group with revenue growth at the long-term GDP growth rate of 4%.
- Its different business segments are impacted by different economic factors. As such, its past 12 years of performance provide a good picture of its long-term performance in terms of its operating and capital efficiencies.
- The property sector is cyclical, and it is more appropriate to “normalize” the performance over the cycle. The past 12 years' average performance represents this normalized performance.

On such a basis, I estimated Hap Seng’s intrinsic value to be RM4.13 per share compared to its market price (end Dec 2024) of RM3.50 per share. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

CONCLUSION

Hap Seng is best understood as a mature, property-centric group with a diversified business base. While revenue has grown steadily over the long term, recent performance has been constrained by property market weakness and the unsustainable reliance on land disposals.

Returns, though once strong, have trended downward, with ROIC now barely exceeding the cost of capital. Operating and capital

efficiencies also show little improvement, suggesting that growth will depend more on disciplined management than on top-line expansion.

Financially, Hap Seng maintains a solid balance sheet, supported by a healthy cash position and manageable leverage. However, cash flow conversion remains weak, and dividend payments have historically relied on debt and divestments rather than operating strength.

On a normalized basis, the Group's intrinsic value exceeds its current market price, offering some margin of safety for long-term investors.

For value investors, Hap Seng presents a case where patience is essential. The core property business requires a turnaround to restore consistent profitability, while the other divisions provide diversification and stability.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

Healthcare today is one of Malaysia's most dynamic and resilient growth engines, a sector often on the radar of an investor's portfolio. Shaped by powerful structural forces: an ageing population with expanding healthcare needs, increasing private expenditure on healthcare, rising medical inflation and a thriving medical tourism market.

Even the numbers are equally compelling. Malaysia's healthcare market is forecasted to grow at a CAGR of 8.7% through 2028 and it is expected to more than double to RM127.9 billion by 2027. For investors, this signifies a sector where demand is not only sustainable but accelerating.

Born from the lived struggles of its founders, who had personally experienced the burden of inadequate access to care, PMC became a testament to vision, grit, and purpose. That pioneering spirit continues to define PMCK Berhad (PMCK), its holding company, as it positions itself to capture the immense opportunities of Malaysia's rapidly transforming healthcare landscape.

A PERSONAL CALLING TO TRANSFORM HEALTHCARE IN KEDAH

It was this experience, combined with a chance encounter with PMCK's present Deputy Executive Chairman and co-founder, Dato' Dr Lim Kim Huat, a physician equally motivated by his mother's healthcare struggles, that crystallised the vision for PMCK.

Dato' Dr Lim had been running a 24-hour polyclinic in Alor Setar but with the good doctor focused on healing, the clinic's financials were in despair until Dato' Lee joined him and turned it around. Then came the decision to open a medical centre. Despite scepticism from banks and difficulty recruiting qualified doctors and nurses to work outside major cities, they persevered.

Today, PMCK has evolved into a regional healthcare provider, anchored by Putra Medical Centre in Alor Setar, offering specialist consultant services, emergency care and clinical support with 40 consultants across 17 specialisations. It is complemented by the Polyclinic Unik network and RYM DX Lab in Kulim. This integrated model creates a seamless patient pathway, from outpatient visits to diagnostics and hospital care.

BUILDING AN AFFORDABLE, ACCESSIBLE HEALTHCARE MODEL

PMCK began its journey in 1995 with the establishment of Putra Medical Centre (PMC) in Alor Setar, Kedah. What started as a 40,000 sq ft facility within a modest four-storey block has since grown into a 144,558 sq ft medical centre and the cornerstone of a diversified healthcare group.

PMCK’s model balances affordability with quality of services. By paneling with seven insurance providers, 12 third-party administrators and more than 32 corporations; and offering preventive health programmes and affordable screenings, it has cultivated patient loyalty. “More than 85% of our caseload today consists of repeat patients, with occupancy rates of around 71%,” affirms Dato’ Lee.

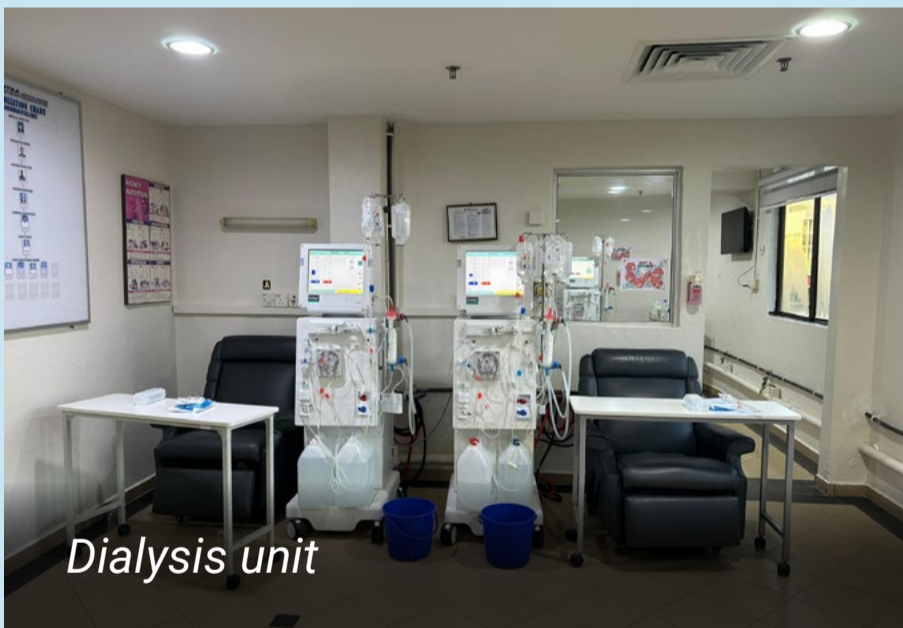
This consistency underscores trust in the PMCK brand and provides investors with confidence in its recurring revenue base. PMC also plays an active role in supporting the public healthcare system through the government’s Healthcare Service Provider (HSOP) programme.

The HSOP is an initiative by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia which began this year to reduce patient congestion, waiting time and improve the quality of healthcare provided. Government hospitals outsource public patients to private hospitals for specialised services unlocking opportunities for private healthcare providers to capture higher demand, particularly in specialist and complex treatments.

This not only alleviates the burden on public facilities but also provides PMC with a steady pipeline of patients and a recurring revenue stream. In addition, PMC participates in other government-linked schemes such as SOCSO, further reinforcing its position as a trusted partner to the healthcare ecosystem.

PMC KULIM, THE PROMISE OF TRANSFORMATIONAL GROWTH IN HEALTHCARE

The Group's most ambitious project to date is PMC Kulim scheduled to open in Q1 2028. It will be a 12-storey private medical centre, the first 5-star MyCrest Certified green hospital, complemented by a seven-storey mixed-use development featuring a hotel, food court and carpark. Strategically located near Kulim Hi-Tech Park, it is designed to serve not just Kulim town, but also Padang Serai, Serdang, Macang Bubok, Sungai Kob, Tasik Gelugor, and the broader industrial belt.

Beyond healthcare, it will catalyse the local economy and draw cross-border patients from southern Thailand and northern Indonesia seeking affordable quality treatment. "PMC Kulim will provide Malaysians from the north with medical backgrounds, the opportunity to return to their home region and contribute their expertise and services to strengthen local healthcare and development," Dato' Lee pointed out. PMCK is poised to capture the rapidly growing unmet demand in the northern states, while diversifying its patient base regionally.

The year marked a pivotal chapter in PMCK's history following its successful listing on the ACE Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. Closing its first trading day 4.6% higher in a time of tumultuous market conditions, the listing is both a validation of PMCK's 30-year track record in delivering trusted healthcare, and a strategic platform to fund the Group's next phase of expansion.

PMCK’s dividend policy underscores the Group’s commitment to balancing growth investment with shareholder returns. For the financial year ended 30 June 2025, the company declared a single-tier interim dividend of 0.61 sen per ordinary share, amounting to RM5.0 million.

PMCK is a story of resilience and foresight. ASEAN+3 Remains Resilient Amid Heightened Global Uncertainties - AMRO

The ASEAN+3 Macroeconomic Research Office (AMRO) released its ASEAN+3 Financial Stability Report (AFSR) 2025 and the ASEAN+3 Regional Economic Outlook (AREO) October Update, highlighting the region's broad resilience in the face of heightened uncertainties driven by US trade policy shifts and geopolitical tensions.

It said that growth in the ASEAN+3 region is projected at 4.1 percent in 2025 and 3.8 percent in 2026, an upward revision from July's forecast, supported by robust first-half performance and stronger-than-expected export momentum. Market pressures have gradually eased since peaking in April following the announcement of the "Liberation Day" tariffs.

AMRO Chief Economist Dong He said that while intra-regional trade and domestic demand have become increasingly important growth drivers across ASEAN+3, the region remains deeply connected to the global financial system and is therefore not insulated from global shocks. He added that overall, the region's financial system remains resilient, although pockets of vulnerabilities persist.

The report noted that export-oriented corporate sectors - particularly smaller firms with high exposure to US demand - may face pressures

on profit margins amid shifting trade dynamics. Inflation pressures in the US could persist amid higher import tariffs, complicating the Fed's monetary policy stance and potentially triggering spillovers to other parts of the world. Additionally, growing uncertainty around the US dollar's safe-haven status could further fragment the global financial landscape.

Despite these challenges, ASEAN+3 economies remain well-positioned to navigate global headwinds. Well-calibrated policy mixes and strong fundamentals—including robust banking systems, deepening financial markets, ample foreign reserves, and available policy space—have provided critical buffers. With inflation largely subdued and expectations well-anchored in most economies, central banks can maintain accommodative monetary policy to support growth.

At the same time, macroprudential tools, along with foreign exchange and capital flow management measures, offer additional safeguards to maintain financial stability and mitigate external spillovers. However, AMRO underscores that support should be carefully targeted to vulnerable sectors and deployed prudently to preserve policy space amid elevated external uncertainty.

Meanwhile, Runchana Pongsaparn, AMRO Group Head for Financial Surveillance said that beyond near-term risks, the region is undergoing deeper structural transitions. Most notably, the rapid digitalization of financial services presents opportunities for greater financial inclusion and efficiency, while also introducing new challenges to financial stability.

Digitalization of the banking sector is reshaping the market structure, offering new pathways for inclusion and efficiency. But that it also alters the nature and distribution of financial stability risks. Policymakers must adopt a multi-pronged strategy that promotes innovation while managing risks, calibrated to the maturity of each market segment.

As ASEAN+3 manages near-term uncertainties, AMRO emphasizes the importance of reinforcing policy frameworks, improving

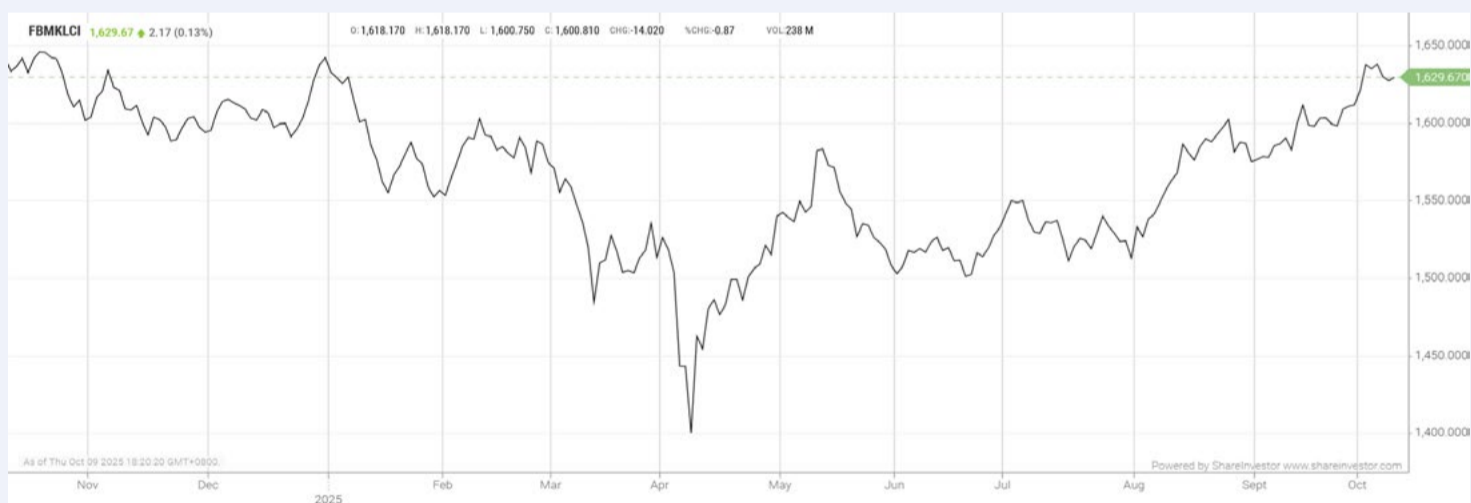
transparency, and deepening domestic markets and buffers to mitigate spillover risks from external shocks.

Dr. He concluded by stating that with coordinated actions and deeper financial cooperation and integration, ASEAN+3 can turn today's challenges into tomorrow's opportunities, and emerge stronger, more connected, and more resilient.

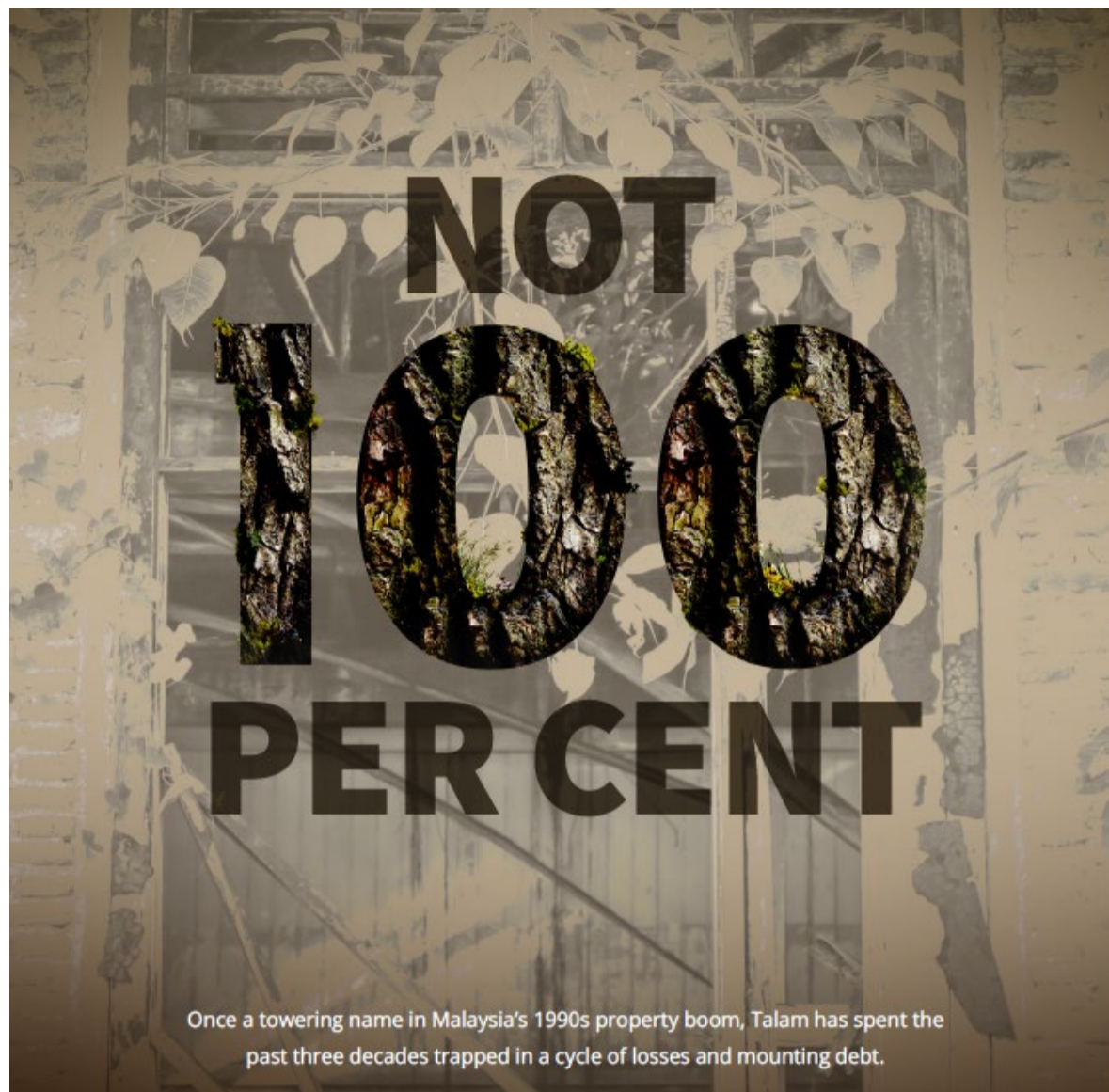

A CENTURY LATER, STILL RUNNING ON HOPE

If you grew up in Pandan Indah in the 1990s, you probably carry a piece of Talam in your memories. Maybe you played football on the dusty neighbourhood field, queued at the mamak shop after school, or watched rows of houses sprout from empty land almost overnight. Talam wasn't just another property developer then; it was a builder of townships, a company whose name was stamped across the Klang Valley like a signature.

From Bandar Baru Ampang to Ukay Perdana, Talam shaped the way many communities lived, worked, and grew. Entire neighbourhoods came alive under its watch, and at its peak, the Company symbolised Malaysia's booming property dream. For a generation of homebuyers, Talam meant access to affordable homes and an opportunity to be part of something bigger: a thriving city.

Fast forward to 2025, and the same company, now known as Talam Transform Berhad, just held its 100th Annual General

Meeting (AGM). Turning 100 should be a moment of pride; a story of resilience and reinvention across generations. Instead, the mood is sobering. The conversation is no longer about expansion, but about survival.

A century on, this once-dominant name finds itself on shaky ground. Despite having lived through the Great Depression, the Japanese Occupation, the Asian Financial Crisis and countless property cycles, Talam is still restructuring debts, recording losses, and delaying projects. For minority shareholders, the centenary is a milestone tinged with mixed feelings: pride in its long history, but also concern over whether the Company can find firmer footing for the years ahead.

THE NUMBERS AND THE WAITING GAME

The numbers tell their own story. For the fifth year in a row, Talam is in the red. In FY2025, the Company reported a loss before tax of RM12.77 million, an improvement from the RM27.9 million loss the previous year, but still a loss nonetheless. Management highlights that losses have “narrowed by 54%.” Factually correct, but for shareholders, narrowing losses is not the same as creating value.

“Less bad” is not the same as good. A company that continues to bleed year after year is not turning the corner; it is merely buying time. And with revenue falling 29% to RM43.7 million due to the completion of projects not being replaced by new ones, the cracks are evident. Once the taps ran dry, there was nothing to keep the water flowing.

The most telling fact of all is that no new projects were launched in FY2025. Instead, Talam secured just two construction contracts worth RM10.3 million, a modest sum in an industry where billion-ringgit launches dominate headlines. Its much-talked-about land banks at Bukit Beruntung and Puncak Jalil remain on the drawing board. Yes, revised layout plans have been submitted.

Yes, promises of “affordable landed homes” sound reassuring. But until approvals are in, they are just lines on paper.

And this is not new. Shareholders have heard the same story for years: once the plans are approved, projects will launch, sales will roll in, and profits will follow. But time and again, the cycle repeats - land, plans, waiting. Like waiting for a bus that never arrives, "potential" has become the permanent excuse.

THE COST OF MONEY: LOANS THAT BLEED

If the income statement looks worrying, the balance sheet offers little comfort. Debt remains Talam's heaviest burden. Recall that at one point, Talam's debt ballooned to RM3.7 billion in the early 2000s.

In FY2025, the Company had to roll over two major term loans, RM29.06 million from TA First Credit and RM13.5 million from Insas Credit & Leasing, both carrying an eye-watering 12% interest rate. To put that in context, 12% is the kind of rate charged on personal loans, not corporate borrowings for a listed company. Blue-chip peers refinance at 4–6%. Talam pays double. It's not just expensive financing; it suggests lenders remain cautious about extending cheaper terms to the group.

Then there's the matter of a related-party advance that raised eyebrows. A RM240,000 payable to Puan Sri Datin Thong Nyok Choo, a non-executive director and substantial shareholder, carried an 8.1% reimbursement rate per annum. The Company clarified this wasn't profit for her, but reimbursement of overdraft costs when she stepped in to cover urgent payments. Fair enough. But the optics are troubling: why is a listed company leaning on a director's overdraft while reporting RM5.09 million cash on hand?

Management answers that the cash wasn't "surplus," but earmarked for operations. Perhaps. However, the result remains the same: cash is tight, loans are costly, and shareholders are left footing the bill for financing that is unsustainable.

For long-suffering shareholders, every AGM comes with the same sense of déjà vu. Losses continue, debts remain, and management

repeats the same explanations. The frustration is not just the numbers; it is the sense of being stuck in a cycle where the Company pays credit-card interest rates while competitors refinance mortgages.

THE NEW PITCH: INVESTORS AND PARTNERS

So where does Talam go from here?

In its formal reply to MSWG, the Company admitted what many already suspect: the turnaround now hinges on *“new synergies and collaborations with investors and partners.”* At its 100th AGM, the board added that it will make the necessary announcement on Bursa Malaysia once any of these developments are finalised.

Sceptics will say this sounds familiar. Over the years, new partners have been touted, plans rebranded, and optimism rolled out like fresh paint over old walls. Yet perhaps this time, with its back firmly against the wall, Talam may finally seize the opportunity. Fresh investors could bring not only money, but also discipline, credibility, and execution strength, the very qualities the company has long lacked.

The RM84 million Putra Perdana land disposal to an IJM unit, if completed, could provide a much-needed shot of cash and confidence. Meanwhile, long-delayed approvals at Bukit Beruntung and Puncak Jalil remain potential catalysts. The ingredients for revival exist; the challenge is whether Talam can finally turn them into reality.

For shareholders, the hope is that this is not just another episode of “jam tomorrow.” Perhaps new collaborations could, at last, break the cycle.

A DYNASTY AT A CROSSROADS

Talam's centenary is more than nostalgia; it is a mirror. It shows that a company can live for a hundred years and still struggle to create value. Repeated restructuring without reinvention is not

a strategy; it is a slow drift. Governance that looks tidy on paper does not always translate into good decisions in practice. And pinning everything on “new partners” may sound promising, but without delivery, it is just another gamble.

Once a builder of townships and a shaper of communities, Talam now stands more as a cautionary tale, a dynasty on shaky ground, heavily reliant on loans, land sales, and promises. Yet even in its frailty, there remains a chance. If fresh partnerships are real and if long-promised projects finally materialise, this centenary could mark not just survival, but revival.

A hundred years is proof of endurance. The next ten will determine whether Talam's story is one of renewal or whether it simply adds another decade to a long cycle of waiting. For minority shareholders, the centenary raises a sobering but hopeful question: after 100 years, is Talam finally ready to transform, or will history repeat itself yet again?
