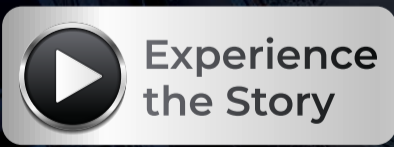

SUMMARY

- Jaya Tiasa Holding Berhad (Bursa:4383) has shifted from being timber-led to palm oil-driven, with oil palm now the main revenue and profit contributor, while timber remains constrained by sustainability policies and weak margins.
- Revenue was flat from 2013-2024, but profit grew sixfold, driven by palm oil price strength and cost discipline. Timber losses in 2018-2019 caused a sharp dip, but recovery came with palm oil in 2021.
- The Group is financially sound, with low debt, strong cash generation, and prudent capital allocation. However, long-term ROIC and ROE remain below the cost of capital, signalling no value creation for shareholders.

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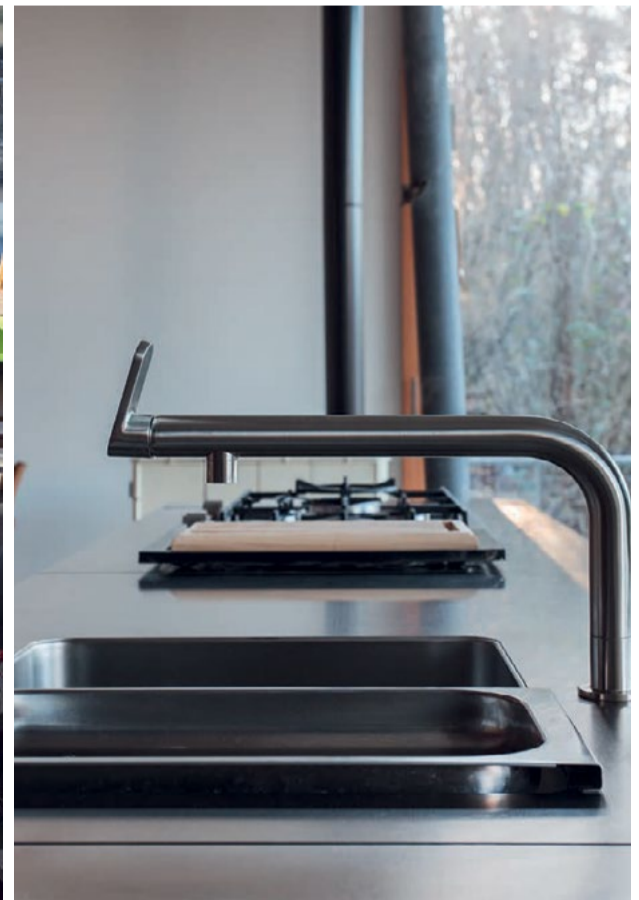

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Type XX, *the legend of the skies*

In the early 1950s, the French Air Force invited tenders for a chronograph wristwatch for its pilots, which it codenamed Type 20. One of the winning companies was Breguet, which would supply the aviation world with several timepieces meeting these specifications.

The year 1952 saw the birth of the Breguet instrument-watch: there were two military versions, the Type 20 for the Air Force and the Type XX for the Naval Aviation, as well as numerous Type XX variants created for the civilian market.

Inspired by this part of its history, Breguet introduced its own Type XX line into its current collections, with the 4th generation seeing the light of day in 2023. To continue this fascinating story, and to celebrate the company's 250th anniversary, Breguet presents the Type XX reference 2075, available in two versions.

A civilian model in gold, presented in 1955, provides the inspiration. According to the archives, this timepiece originally sported a satin-finish silver dial, which was later replaced by a black dial.

Today, Breguet is offering two reinterpretations: one with a black dial in aluminium, and the other, limited to 250 pieces, with a solid silver dial. A natural continuity between past and present.

With a diameter of 38.3 mm, identical to the historic 1955 timepiece, and a thickness of 13.2 mm, the case is crafted entirely in Breguet gold. A combination of gold enriched with silver, copper and palladium, this signature gold alloy was unveiled at the launch of the Classique Souscription 2025 watch.

The slim, bi-directional rotating bezel has numerals picked out in black for the black-dialled version and in blue for the silver-dialled version. The crown proudly bears the B of Breguet.

Both new models feature an interchangeable leather strap, gradient black for the black dial version and gradient blue for the silver dial version.

The calibres housed in these two models are variations of the high-performance, 5 Hz calibre 728 introduced by Breguet in 2023. They incorporate the flyback function that allows the watch to be reset to zero and a new count instantly started by a single press of the pusher located at 4 o'clock.

These two new models feature, for the first time, manually wound versions of the Breguet calibre 728, which are gilded in Breguet gold. The calibre 7279, for the black-dialled version, has a 15-minute counter at 3 o'clock, while the calibre 7278, for the silver-dialled version, has a 30-minute counter also at 3 o'clock.

Both models have a small seconds display at 9 o'clock. The transparent case back reveals an engraving entirely hand-crafted in the company's workshops.

It depicts the Breguet 19 aircraft in full flight accompanied by the precise route taken in 1930, the European and North American landmasses' frosted finishing contrasts against the smooth Atlantic Ocean.

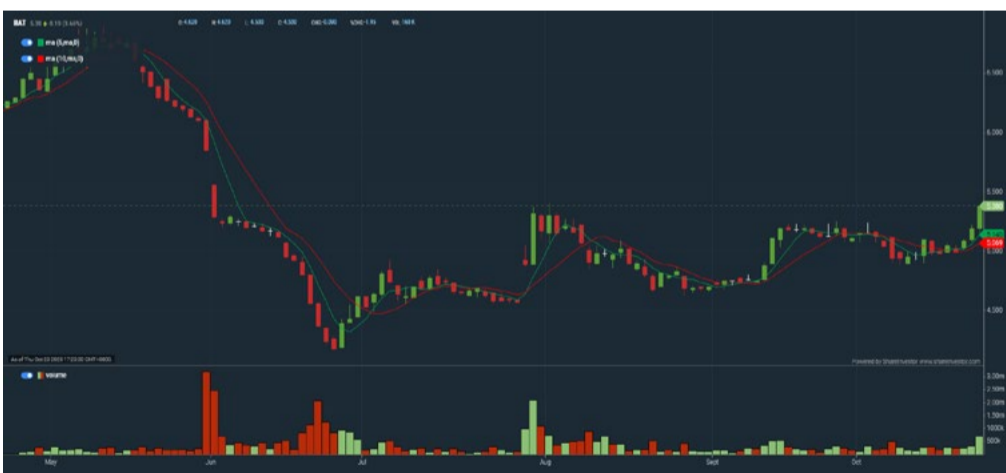
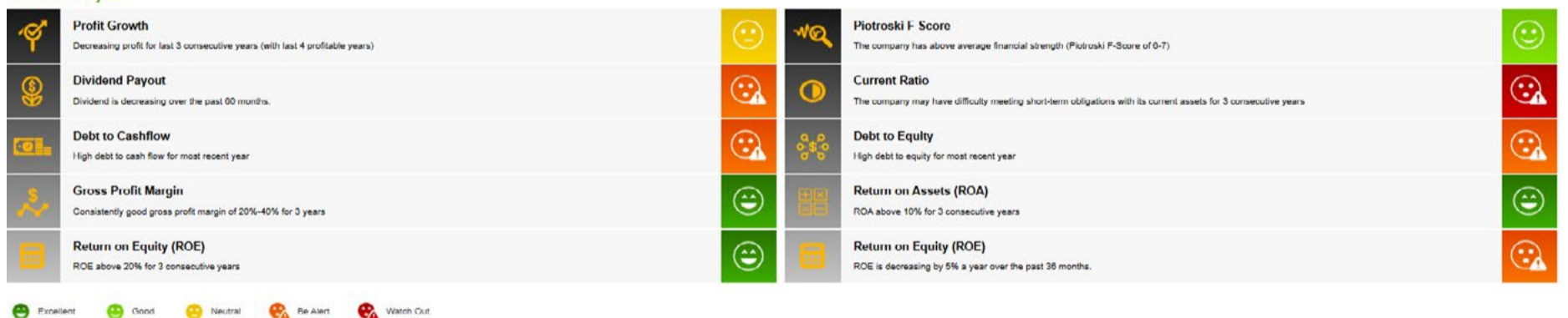
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COMPANY BACKGROUND

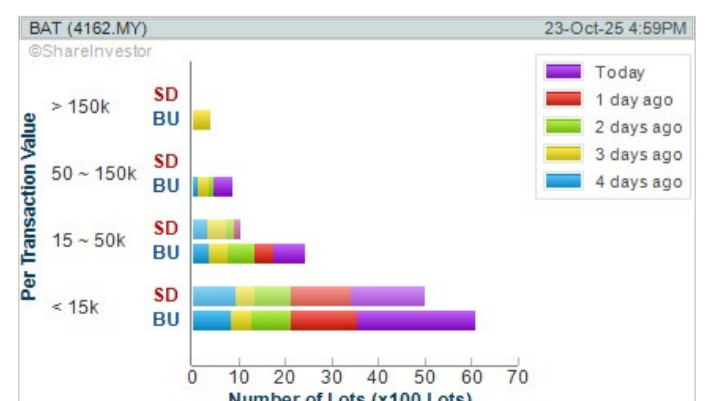

Jaya Tiasa an investment opportunity?

SUMMARY

- Jaya Tiasa Holding Berhad (**Bursa:4383**) has shifted from being timber-led to palm oil-driven, with oil palm now the main revenue and profit contributor, while timber remains constrained by sustainability policies and weak margins.
- Revenue was flat from 2013–2024, but profit grew sixfold, driven by palm oil price strength and cost discipline. Timber losses in 2018–2019 caused a sharp dip, but recovery came with palm oil in 2021.
- The Group is financially sound, with low debt, strong cash generation, and prudent capital allocation. However, long-term ROIC and ROE remain below the cost of capital, signalling no value creation for shareholders.

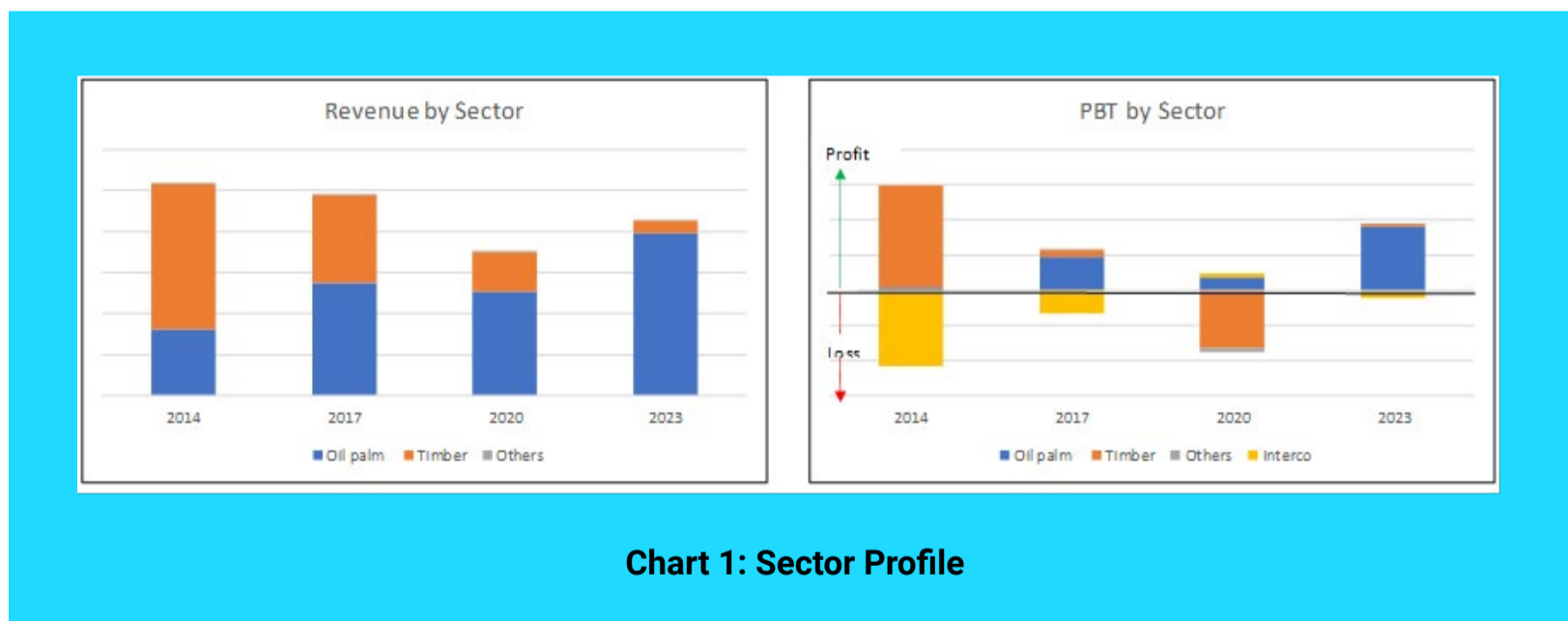
BACKGROUND

Jaya Tiasa began its journey in the 1980s as a timber company, thriving on the vast forest resources of Sarawak. For many years, timber logging and processing were the backbone of the Group's revenue and profit.

But as environmental regulations tightened and market dynamics shifted, the company recognized the need to diversify. In the 2000s, it ventured into oil palm plantations, setting the stage for a gradual transformation of its business model.

Today, Jaya Tiasa stands as a diversified group with two distinct pillars: oil palm and timber.

The oil palm operations have emerged as the clear growth engine, with a land bank of over 83,000 hectares, nearly 70,000 of which are already planted and mature, supported by four crude palm oil mills. This division has overtaken timber to become the main revenue and earnings contributor. **Refer to Chart 1.**



Meanwhile, the timber segment remains significant in terms of assets but has struggled to match past performance. The Group controls concessions covering more than 400,000 hectares - around 12 percent of Sarawak's production forest - and is managing over 120,000 hectares of reforestation to ensure long-term sustainability.

However, downstream activities such as plywood and veneer manufacturing have been downsized since 2017 and were temporarily halted by 2023 due to limited log supply.

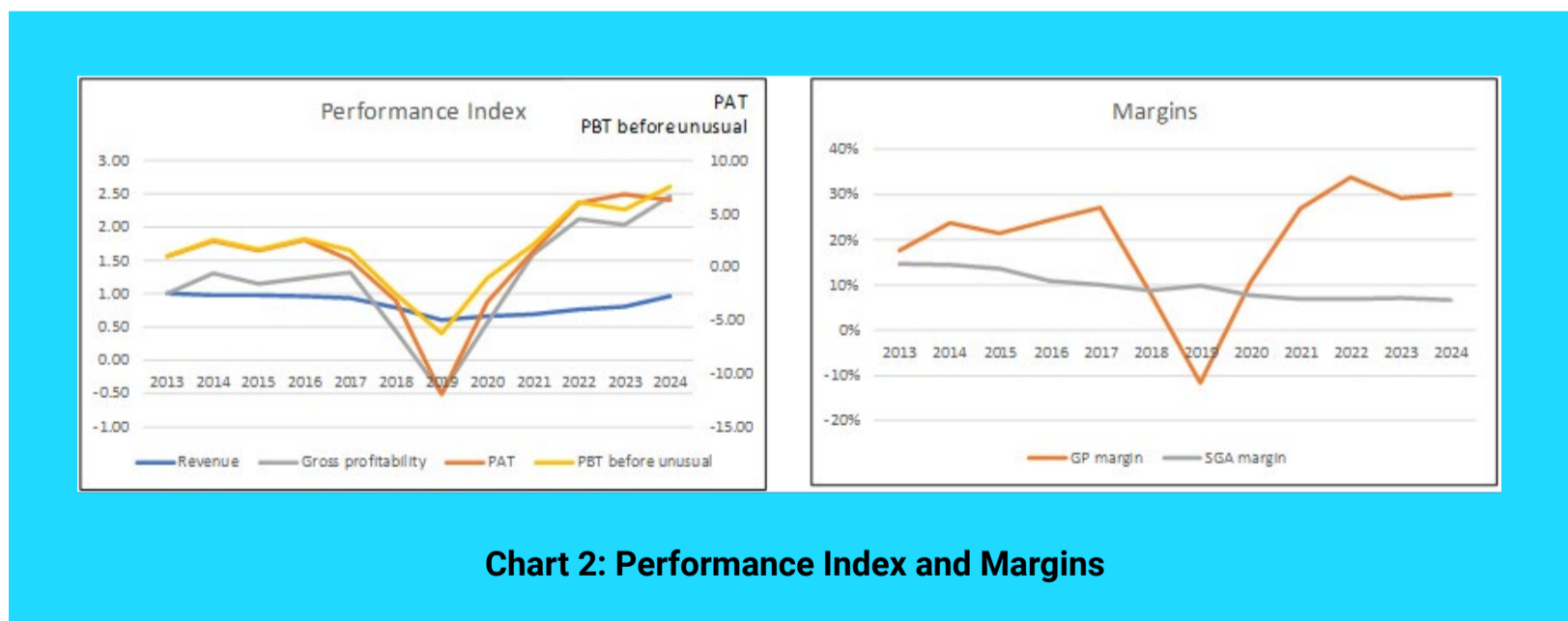
A decade ago, timber was the profit driver. Today, its returns are only about half of those from palm oil, and margins are lower. While a sizeable portion of Jaya Tiasa’s net assets remains tied to timber, the reality is that palm oil now powers the Group’s earnings, with the timber business largely in a holding pattern until its reforestation efforts mature enough to provide commercial-scale logs.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

Between 2013 and 2024, Jaya Tiasa’s revenue was flat. Gains from palm oil could not offset the decline in timber, leaving the top line unchanged for more than a decade.

Yet, profits told a more encouraging story. **Refer to Chart 2.**

Despite a steep drop in 2018–2019, net profit in 2024 was more than six times that of 2013. The setback during 2018–2019 reflected heavy timber losses from lower volumes and higher costs, alongside weak palm oil prices. Recovery came in 2021, driven almost entirely by palm oil, as higher crude palm oil and fresh fruit bunch prices lifted margins, while timber remained constrained under stricter sustainability rules.



This shift underscores a structural transformation in the Group’s profile. Timber, once its core business, has struggled under Malaysia’s changing forest policies, while palm oil has benefited from stronger commodity prices. The post-2022 price levels were 40-50% higher than pre-2021.

Returns improved with better operating and capital efficiencies: contribution margins rose from 27% in 2013-2014 to 41% in 2023-2024, reflecting both higher palm oil prices and tighter cost control.

However, the Group has not created shareholder value. Over the past 12 years, the average ROIC of 3% and ROE of 1% were far below the cost of capital. Even in the stronger 2022–2024 period, returns of 10-11% remained below funding costs. The result is a business more efficient and palm oil-driven than before, but still facing structural challenges in value creation.

PEER COMPARISON

I compared Jaya Tiasa's performance with 3 other Bursa timber cum plantation companies, as shown in Chart 3. You can see that only Ta Ann had revenue growth from 2013 to 2023.

This was because Ta Ann had a much larger oil palm operation compared to its timber one. You can see from the right part of **Chart 3** that all the companies experienced a drop in revenue in 2018/19. There is also the 2020 decline due to COVID-19.

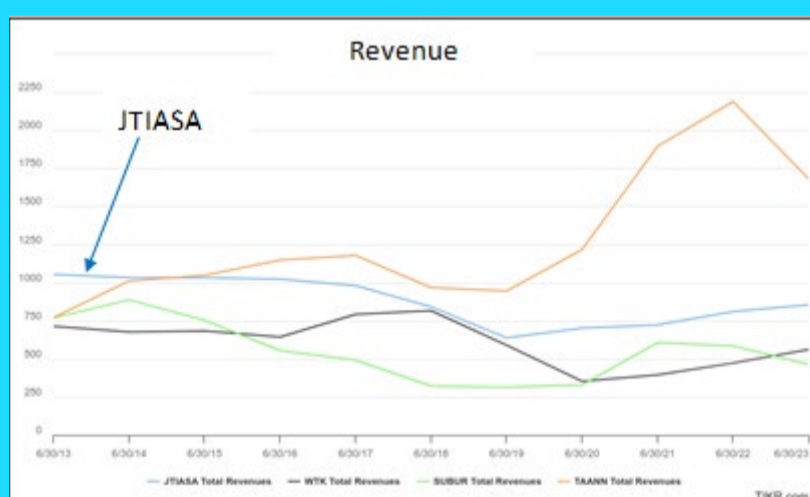


Chart 3: Peer revenue

The overall peer picture can be summarized as follows:

- **Operational strength:** Jaya Tiasa is improving its operational efficiency, as indicated by the better EBIT and cash flow margins.
- **Financial health:** The growth in Jaya Tiasa's levered free cash flow is a strong positive signal for financial health and flexibility.

- **Room for improvement:** While Jaya Tiasa’s operational metrics are strong, the average return on capital and EPS suggest there is still room for improvement in capital allocation and overall profitability.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Jaya Tiasa as financially sound based on the following:

- As of Jun 2025, it had RM 290million in cash. This is equal to 15% of its total assets.
- It had a Debt Equity ratio of 0.2% as of Jun 2025. This has come down from its 2019 high of 81.8%.
- From 2013 to 2024, it generated positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated RM2.3 billion cash flow from operations compared to the total PAT of RM236 million. This is a very good cash flow conversion ratio.
- From 2013 to 2024, it had a negative Reinvestment. I defined Reinvestment = CAPEX + Acquisition – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital. The negative value implies that the amount spent on CAPEX and/or the increase in Net Working Capital was smaller than the Depreciation & Amortization. This is a good position as it means that the company did not have to allocate funds to support its growth.
- It had a good capital allocation plan. **Refer to Table 1.** The cash flow from operations was sufficient to fund its CAPEX, and the excess was returned to shareholders as well as to reduce its debts.

VALUATION

Over the past 12 years, Jaya Tiasa's performance was weighed down by its timber operations. To assess its outlook, two scenarios were considered. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

- Scenario 1 assumes the current business profile continues, with little change in timber. Using 2024 as the base year, revenue is projected to grow in line with long-term GDP at 4% annually. Margins and capital efficiency are assumed to reflect the 2017-2024 cycle, with fixed costs also growing at 4%.
- Scenario 2 assumes the forest plantation matures and begins to contribute meaningfully to the log supply. On top of Scenario 1's growth, an additional RM238 million in timber revenue is added. Capital efficiency remains the same, but the contribution margin is adjusted downward by 4% to account for lower timber profitability. Fixed costs again rise by 4%.

Under Scenario 1, the intrinsic value was RM0.89 per share, while it was RM1.23 per share under Scenario 2. The market price of Jaya Tiasa at the end of Jun 2025 was RM1.07 per share. You can see that there was only a margin of safety under Scenario 2.

In short, the analysis suggests that under the current structure, Jaya Tiasa offers little upside. Even if timber plantations begin contributing, the potential margin of safety remains thin.

CONCLUSION

Jaya Tiasa has undergone a clear transformation from being timber-driven to palm oil-driven. Yet its long-term performance still reflects the weight of its legacy timber operations.

The Group has improved its operating and capital efficiency, strengthened its balance sheet, and maintained strong cash generation. However, despite higher palm oil prices and better margins in recent years, returns have consistently fallen short of the cost of capital, meaning that shareholder value has not been created.

Looking forward, the valuation scenarios highlight limited upside. Under the current structure, the stock provides no margin of safety, while even with the optimistic assumption of meaningful contributions from forest plantations, the margin of safety is modest.

In essence, Jaya Tiasa is financially sound and operationally more efficient than in the past. But it remains a challenging investment case unless structural improvements in timber or sustained palm oil tailwinds can shift returns above the cost of capital.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results “noisy” and focus on long-term trends.

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Malaysia to strengthen ASEAN's central role at upcoming RCEP Summit - PM

According to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, Malaysia intends to reinforce ASEAN's central role in guiding the implementation of the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) during the upcoming 5th RCEP Leaders' Meeting on October 27, to be held on the sidelines of the 47th Asean Summit from Oct 26 to 28.

He said RCEP represents far more than an economic arrangement and that it is a strategic affirmation that open regionalism remains the pathway to shared prosperity. Speaking during the closing of the DHL GoTrade Summit 2025, he said RCEP to serve not just the interests of large MNCs, but also to deliver concrete benefits to SMEs, workers, and communities.

He noted that the success of RCEP will depend on our ability to translate commitments into opportunities which include addressing non-tariff barriers, enhancing trade facilitation, and ensuring that the digital economy, green transition, and services sectors are fully integrated into the framework.

He added that in advancing this vision of deeper integration, it is timely that ASEAN, and the world at large, turn their attention to

RCEP, the world's largest trade agreement, encompassing nearly one-third of global GDP. The RCEP member countries include the 10 ASEAN countries plus their free trade agreement partners - China, Japan, South Korea, Australia and New Zealand.

The ASEAN region has become a crucial link in the global supply chain, a hub for manufacturing, and a vibrant market of 680 million people. Within the next five years, ASEAN is expected to become the world's fourth largest economy, and must continue to uphold the principles of openness and unity amid global uncertainties.

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Malaysia's inflation increased 1.5% in September 2025

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), Malaysia's inflation increased 1.5% in September 2025 with the index points at 135.2 as against 133.2 in the month of September 2024. The increase was mainly driven by a higher increase in the group of Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services at 4.8% as compared to August 2025 (4.0%), followed by Food & Beverages, 2.1%; Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels, 1.5%; Health, 1.3% and Transport, 0.7%. Meanwhile, Restaurant & Accommodation Services, 3.3% and Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco, 0.3% recorded a slower increase as compared to the previous month.

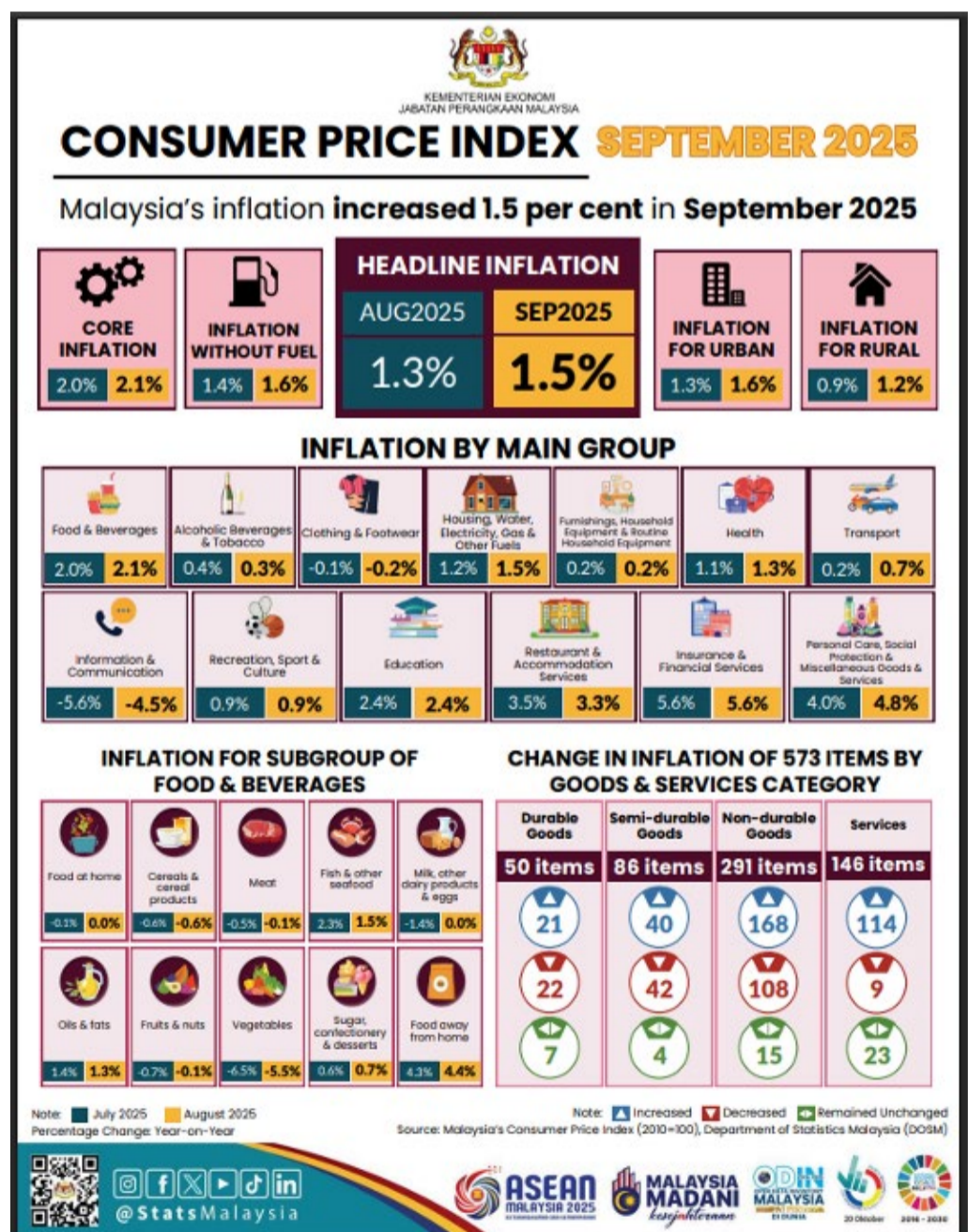
In addition, Insurance & Financial Services (5.6%); Education (2.4%); Recreation, Sport & Culture (0.9%) and Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance (0.2%) remained at the same rate as recorded in August 2025. However, Information & Communication and Clothing & Footwear remained in the negative territory at negative 4.5% and negative 0.2% respectively. The Food & Beverages group increased 2.1% as against August 2025 (2.0%). The inflation for subgroup of Food away from home recorded an increase to 4.4% as against 4.3% in August 2025. Meanwhile, the inflation for subgroup of Food at home did not record any changes as compared to August 2025 (-0.1%).

Five states recorded increases above the national inflation level (1.5%) namely Johor (2.0%), Negeri Sembilan (1.9%), Melaka (1.8%), Selangor (1.8%) and Terengganu (1.7%). However, the other 11

states recorded increases below the national inflation rate with Kelantan recording the lowest inflation (0.5%) in September 2025.

The inflation for 3Q 2025 increased 1.3% as compared to the same quarter of 2024. The increase was attributed by Insurance & Financial Services, 5.6%; Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services, 4.2%; Restaurant & Accommodation Services, 3.3% and Education, 2.3%. The monthly headline inflation in September 2025 recorded an increase of 0.2%. This was contributed by the increase of Information & Communication group, 1.1%; Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services, 0.8% and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels, 0.3%. Meanwhile, core inflation increased to 2.1% in September 2025 as compared to 2.0% recorded in August 2025. The increase was driven by increases in Insurance & Financial Services (5.6%); Personal Care, Social Protection & Miscellaneous Goods & Services (4.8%) and Food & Beverages (3.6%).

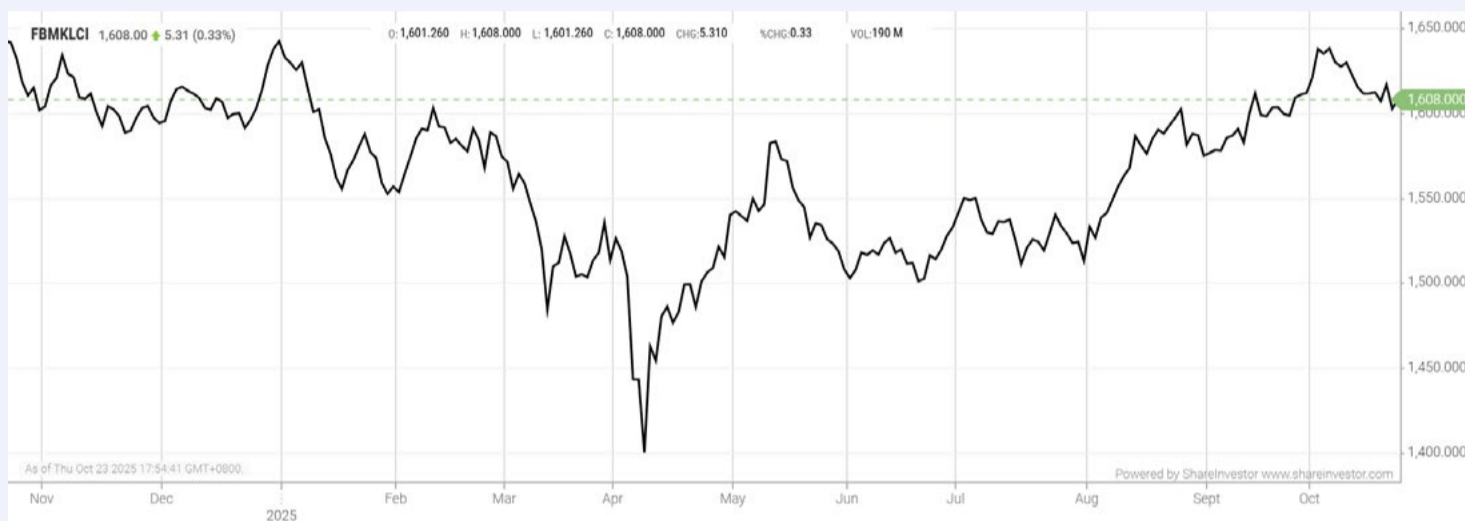

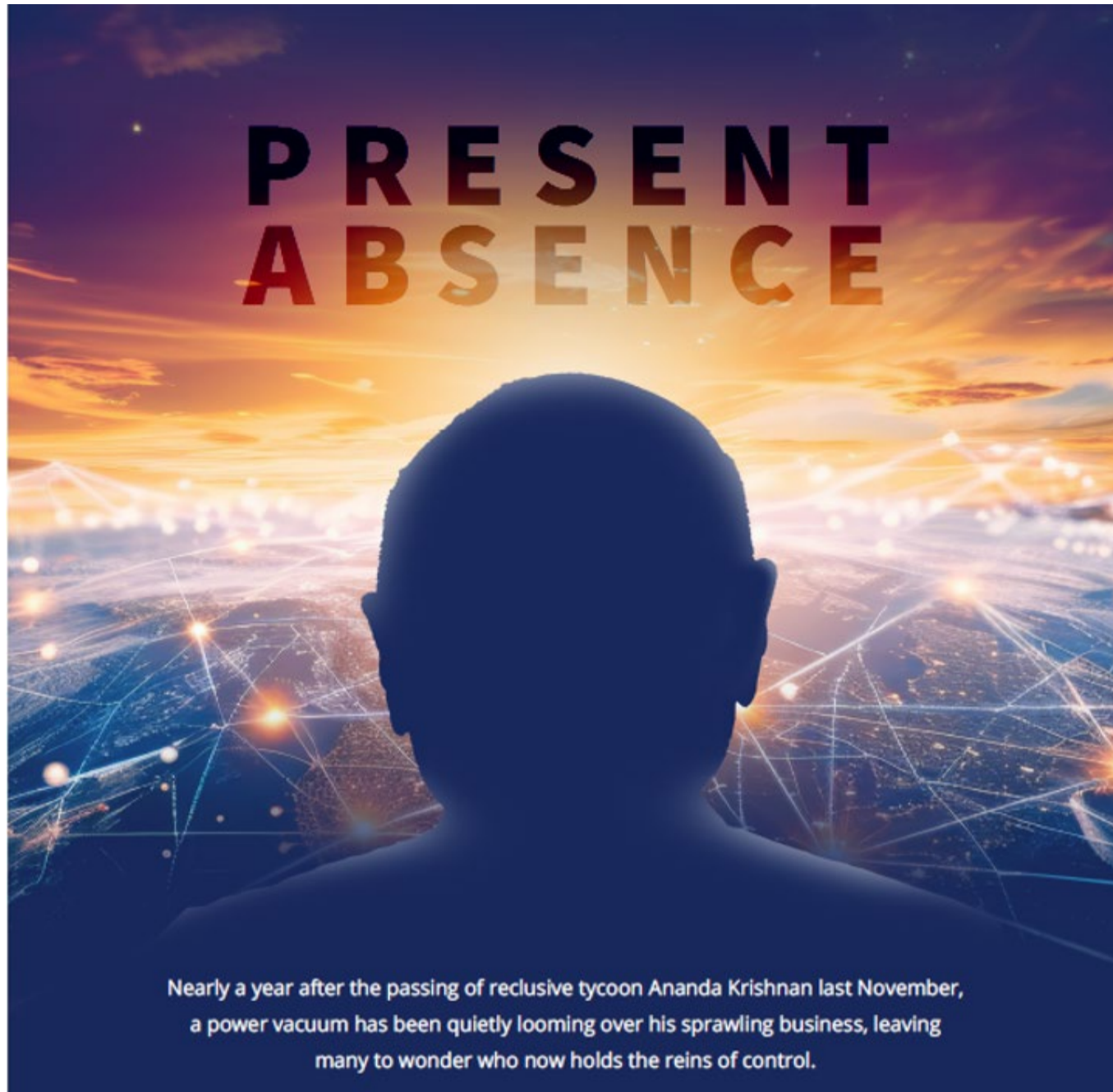

IN THE WAKE OF THE KEY MAN'S PASSING

ALMOST a year into the demise of reclusive business magnate Tatparanandam Ananda Krishnan at the age of 86 on 28 November 2024, there seem to be signs that his absence marks the end of a defining chapter in Malaysia's corporate history.

Ananda's success was deeply rooted in Malaysia. Born in Brickfields, Kuala Lumpur, he built his fortune from the ground up, growing from an oil trader into one of Asia's most influential tycoons through his flagship company, Usaha Tegas Sdn Bhd.

His vast interests spanned telecommunications (Maxis Berhad), media (Astro Malaysia Holdings Berhad, Tanjong plc which was delisted from Bursa Malaysia in August 2010 and unlisted TGV Cinemas Sdn Bhd), oil and gas (Bumi Armada Berhad), power (via Tanjong plc) as well as satellite operations (Measat Global Bhd, which was delisted in October 2010).

POWER VACUUM

With almost a year having lapsed since Ananda's passing, a quiet but palpable power vacuum looms over his once tightly held business empire. What is obvious from a succession planning perspective is that his three children – two daughters and a son – have shown no inclination to helm the businesses he left behind.

His only son, Venerable Ajahn Siripanyo, has long renounced worldly pursuits to embrace a monastic life as a Theravada Buddhist monk. Now serving as the Abbot of the Dtao Dam hermitage on the Thai-Myanmar border, he represents a spiritual legacy rather than a corporate one.

As a result, stewardship of Ananda's vast interests has effectively fallen to a cadre of professional managers within his investment holding vehicle, Usaha Tegas.

For now, it may appear to be business as usual with the machinery of his empire continuing to run while key executives maintain operational continuity. Yet beneath this surface lies a sense of uncertainty.

The complex and opaque shareholding structures surrounding his listed entities, coupled with the absence of a visible or declared successor, have fueled speculation about who truly holds the reins.

The strategic direction of flagship companies such as Maxis, Astro Malaysia and Bumi Armada now hangs in a delicate balance. While day-to-day operations remain steady, the long-term vision, which once guided by Ananda's decisive influence appears less certain.

Undoubtedly, much of the current operations are deemed left in an uncertain state despite the existence of temporary stability.

WHO'S THE BRAIN BEHIND USAHA TEGAS NOW?

Recall that Usaha Tegas was instrumental in publicly conveying the death of Ananda sans the name of the spokesman who otherwise

would have left a clue as to who would today be calling the shots in the investment holding company.

At its core, the Kuala Lumpur-headquartered company, founded in 1984 by Ananda, is linked through a maze of local and offshore companies, whether registered in Labuan, Cayman Islands, British Virgin Islands, etc, following which public records reveal little about their ultimate shareholding or succession arrangements.

Despite being a major shareholder in several PLCs, transparency into ownership and control remains opaque for Usaha Tegas with regard to its control structure.

What is known is that there are four primary vehicles directly held by the Krishnan Family Trust which were incorporated in the family office-friendly Channel Islands in the 1990s. They are PanOcean Management Ltd, Pacific States Investment Ltd (PSIL), Excorp Holdings NV and Pexco Holdings (US)¹.

PanOcean Management holds 100% of Excorp, which in turn controls PSIL. PanOcean is a discretionary trust in which the beneficiaries are members of Ananda's family and foundations, including charitable trusts (i.e., Yu Cai Foundation, which Ananda founded in January 2015). Pexco used to be the company that held the family's interest in the US. PSIL further controls Usaha Tegas which holds 62.3% equity interest in Maxis, Bumi Armada (34.6%) and Astro Malaysia (41.3%).

Apart from Usaha Tegas, the other company that holds Ananda's private assets is consultancy outfit MAI Holdings Sdn Bhd – his first entrepreneurial venture. It was from here that Ananda set up Exoil Trading, which went on to acquire oil-drilling concessions in various countries.

Later, Ananda moved into the gambling industry in Malaysia (horse racing and betting operations) through Usaha Tegas which subsequently injected the gaming unit, Pan Malaysian Pools Sdn

Bhd, PMP, into the now delisted Tanjong plc. Then, Genting Berhad acquired PMP from Tanjong plc in 2011.

It was in the early part of the 1990s that Ananda started diversifying into the multimedia-cum-telecommunications realms “to be ahead of the curve”.

UNSPOKEN CONCERNS OF BANKERS, INVESTORS

Fast forward to today, it can be envisaged that the shareholdings of Ananda's listed companies involve several layers of locally incorporated and offshore companies.

However, nobody really has a clue as to Ananda's actual interest in these PLCs or whether others are also shareholders in his offshore ventures.

“So who is pulling the strings now?”

“Although the businesses are professionally run now, under whose instructions or for whom are they managed?”

These seem to be the lingering question within financial circles as concerns mount over the long-term direction, governance structure and stability without Ananda's direct oversight.

Notwithstanding this, it can be safely assumed that banks and institutional investors are already quietly assessing their respective risk exposure and possible restructuring scenarios in the near term.

What lies ahead for Maxis, Astro Malaysia and Bumi Armada and their related holdings? What are the prospects of M&A (merger and acquisition), consolidation, divestment or a new controlling force in the pipeline?

If their current share price can serve as a gauge, challenges facing Ananda's staples of companies warrant concern, especially with regard to Astro Malaysia whose declining performance is reflected by its share price languishing near its all-time low of 12.5 sen, with analysts rating what used to be Malaysia's maiden satellite TV station a “SELL”.

Maxis, too, is not spared as the telco faces intensifying competition in a saturated market, while Bumi Armada – like Astro Malaysia – is now trading near its 52-week low of 33.5 sen - further down south after the axing of a proposal to merge with the floating offshore production unit of MISC Bhd.

WHAT DOES THE FUTURE HOLD?

While Ananda's PLC trio continue to run as usual, what is certain is that running beneath this calm surface is the tacit concern that this business empire is in a state of power vacuum.

Key strategic decisions revolving around M&A, divestments, shareholding structure, governance and succession planning, to name a few pre-requisites of sustaining a profitable business venture, will need to be made soon.
