SUMMARY

- The Mosaic Company (Mosaic) (NYSE:MOS) evolved from a North American fertilizer producer into a global, vertically integrated player with a major presence in Brazil following the 2018 acquisition of Vale Fertilizantes.
- The fertilizer industry is low-growth and cyclical. From 2015 to 2024, Mosaic's revenue grew at a 2.5% CAGR, with profits declining sharply, except for a temporary 2022 price-driven spike.
- Mosaic is financially sound, generating positive operating cash flow every year and maintaining moderate leverage. It behaves like a cash cow, using excess cash to fund CAPEX and shareholder returns.

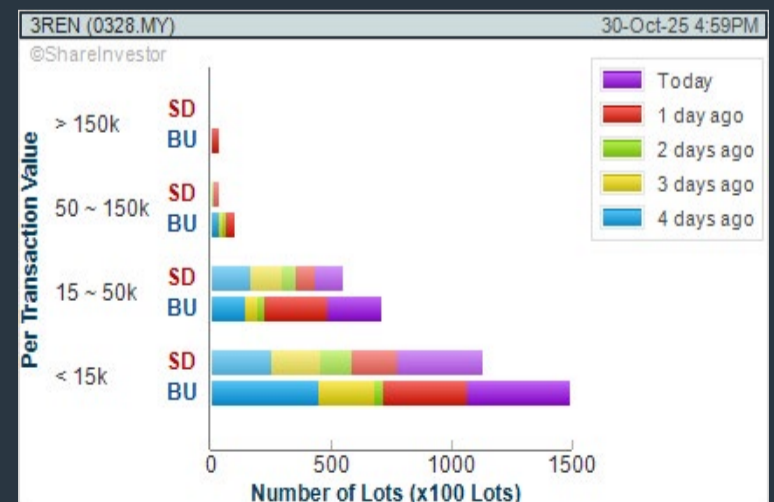

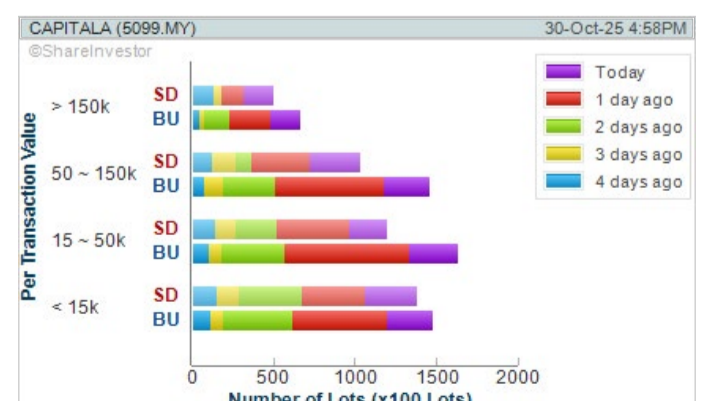

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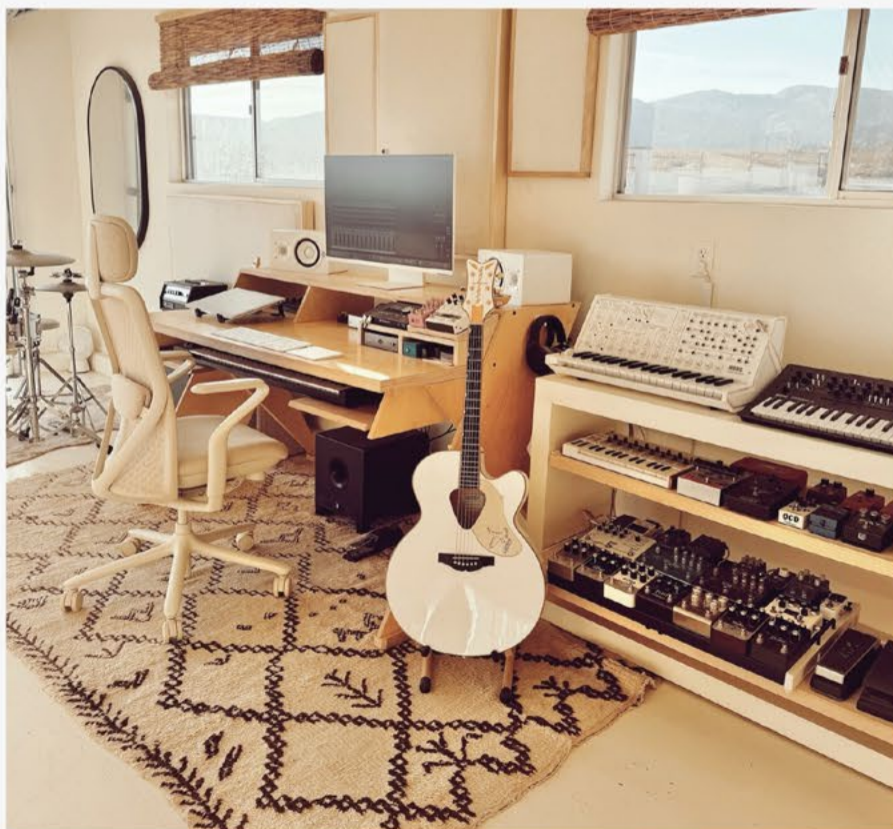

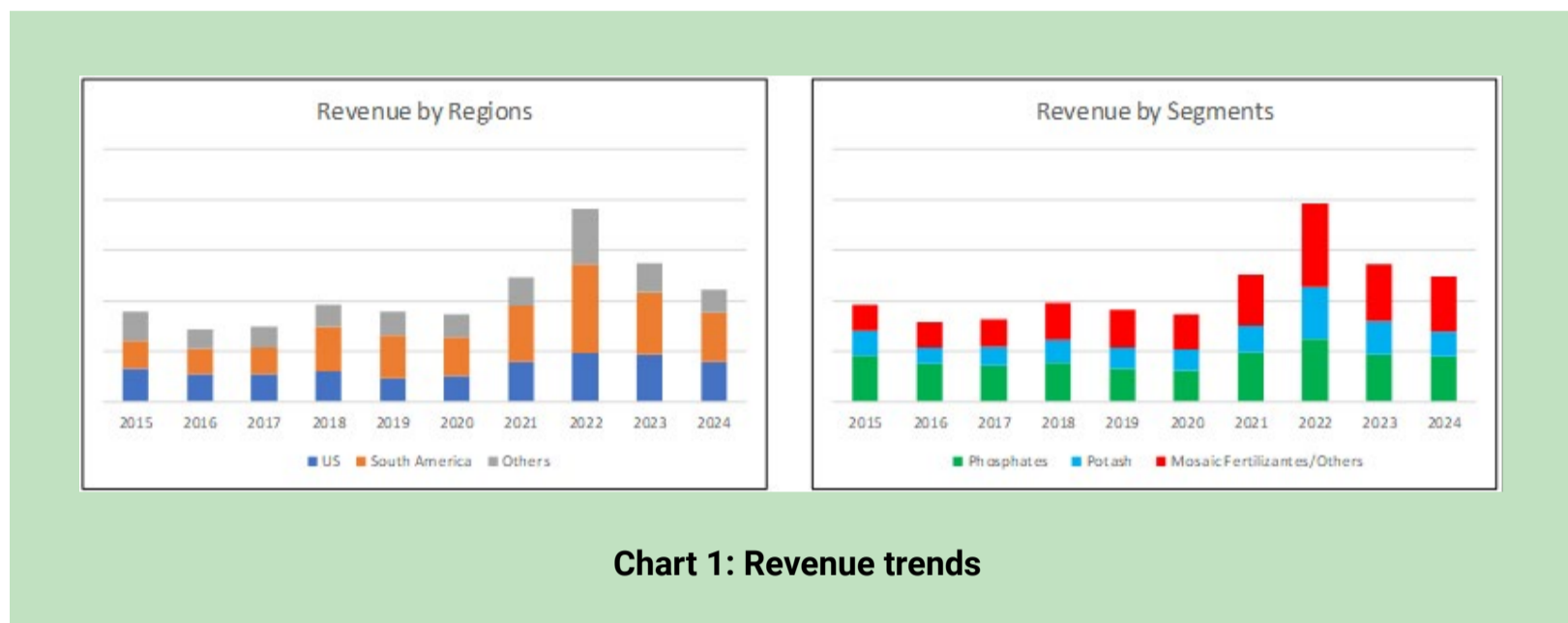
SUMMARY

- The Mosaic Company (Mosaic) (**NYSE:MOS**) evolved from a North American fertilizer producer into a global, vertically integrated player with a major presence in Brazil following the 2018 acquisition of Vale Fertilizantes.
- The fertilizer industry is low-growth and cyclical. From 2015 to 2024, Mosaic's revenue grew at a 2.5% CAGR, with profits declining sharply, except for a temporary 2022 price-driven spike.
- Mosaic is financially sound, generating positive operating cash flow every year and maintaining moderate leverage. It behaves like a cash cow, using excess cash to fund CAPEX and shareholder returns.

BACKGROUND

Mosaic is a global producer and marketer of concentrated phosphate and potash fertilizers with vertically integrated operations - from mining phosphate rock and potash to manufacturing, blending, and distribution. Over the past decade, Mosaic has transformed from a North American-focused producer into a globally integrated fertilizer company with a major presence in South America (**see Chart 1, left**).



Mosaic operates under three segments: Phosphates, Potash, and Mosaic Fertilizantes. **Refer to Chart 1, right.** The Mosaic Fertilizantes segment was created in 2018 following the acquisition of Vale Fertilizantes, replacing the former International Distribution segment and expanding Mosaic’s operations in Brazil.

- This deal made Mosaic a leading fertilizer producer in South America.
- Phosphates account for roughly half of Mosaic Fertilizantes’ revenue, potash about 5%, with the remainder from other nutrients.
- The segment also distributes products from Mosaic’s Phosphate and Potash divisions.

TARIFF EXPOSURE

- **Phosphates:** No impact expected from the US tariffs on Canadian goods, as all North American phosphate production is based in the U.S.

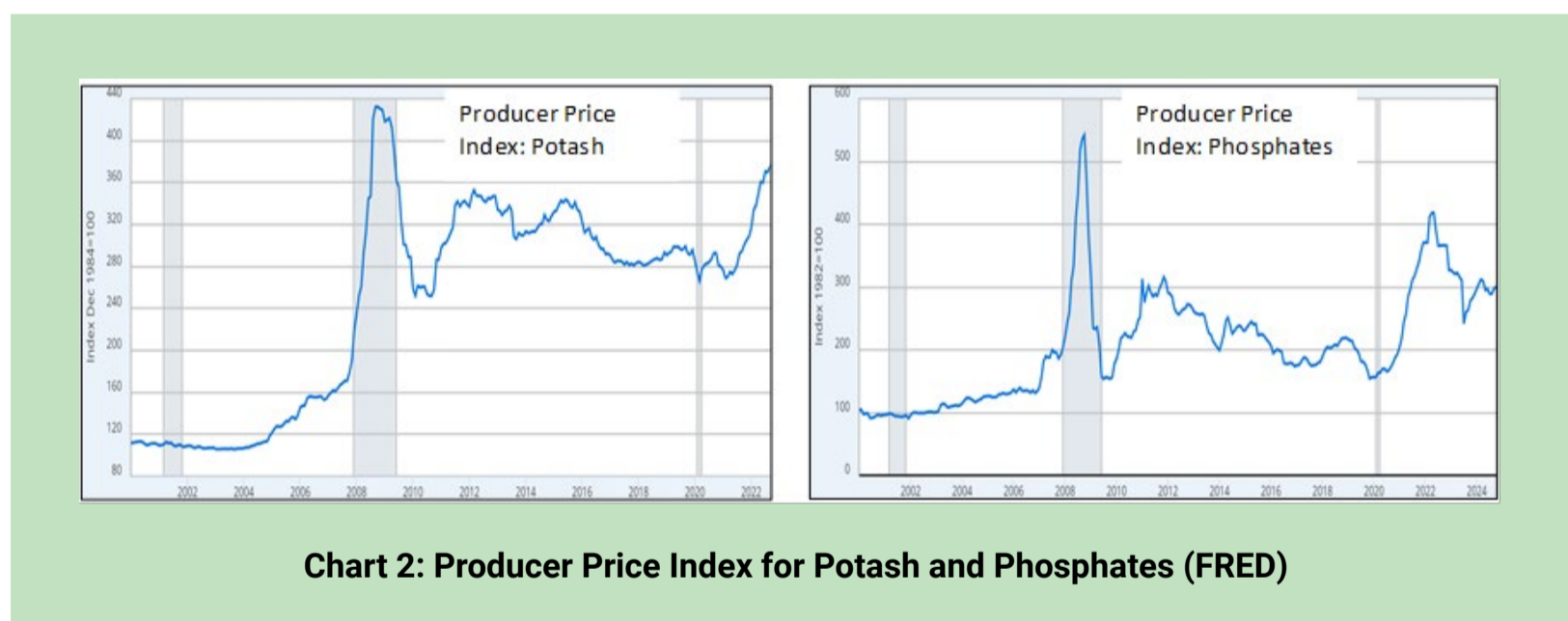
- **Potash:** Significant exposure, since most North American potash facilities are in Canada. The Potash segment contributed about one-fifth of total revenue over the past two years.
- **Mosaic Fertilizantes:** No impact, as operations serve non-U.S. markets from Latin America.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

The global fertilizer industry is a low-growth, cyclical sector that experienced a sharp price surge in 2022 (see **Chart 2**).

Mosaic's performance mirrors this trend. From 2015 to 2024, its revenue grew at only a 2.5% CAGR, with minimal volume growth.

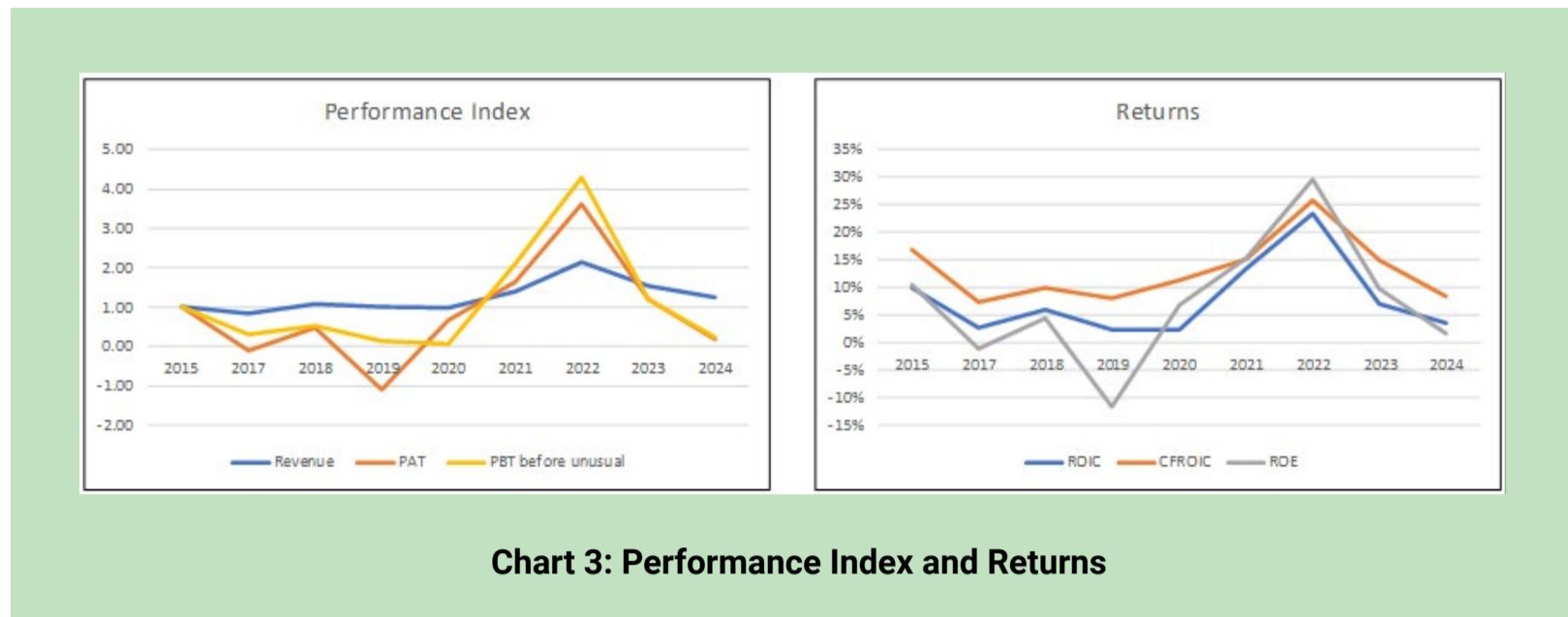
- **Phosphates:** Sales volume contracted at 1.5% CAGR, while average selling prices rose 4.7% CAGR.
- **Potash:** Volume grew modestly at 1.1% CAGR, with little change in selling prices.



Despite modest revenue growth, profitability declined sharply. The 2024 PAT was only about 20% of 2015 levels (**Chart 3, left**). Profits trended downward from 2015, bottoming out in 2019/20.

- The 2019 loss was mainly due to USD1.4 billion in restructuring and goodwill impairment charges.
- The 2022 profit spike reflected temporary price-driven gains, not volume growth.

A similar pattern is seen in returns (**Chart 3, right**). All three return metrics in 2024 were lower than in 2015.



Profit fluctuations were largely driven by changes in gross profit margins, not operating efficiency. Mosaic maintained tight control over SGA expenses, and this discipline is also visible in its contribution margins and fixed cost trends.

The key takeaways are:

- Mosaic’s results were externally driven by global fertilizer prices and supply shocks, rather than internal efficiency changes.
- The 2022 spike stemmed from war-related supply constraints and elevated prices.
- Impairments and restructuring charges signaled internal challenges.
- No structural efficiency improvements were evident: gross profitability in 2024 was below 2015 levels, and asset turnover remained unchanged.

PEERS

Mosaic’s performance was benchmarked against several global fertilizer producers (**see Table 1**). Based on 2024 revenue, Mosaic ranks as a mid-sized player within the group. Consistent with the industry’s low-growth nature, most peers also reported modest top-line expansion over the past decade.

Mosaic's peer performance is broadly average, based on four key metrics - return on capital, EBIT margin, levered free cash flow margin, and EPS.

All peers showed a sharp profitability spike in 2022, driven by the same fertilizer price surge. However, by 2024, returns and margins had normalized to near or below 2015 levels for most companies.

Except for CF Industries, 2024 values for return on capital, EBIT margin, and EPS for the panel were comparable to or weaker than 2015, underscoring that this remains a difficult sector in which to sustain profitability.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Mosaic as financially sound based on the following performances:

- As of the end of December 2024, it had USD273 million in cash, equivalent to about 1% of its total assets. Furthermore, its Debt Equity ratio of 36% at the end of 2024 had come down from its 2017 high of 54%.
- From 2015 to 2024, it generated positive cash flow from operations every year. It had a good cash flow conversion ratio during this period, with USD18.2 billion cash flow from operations compared to its USD7.9 billion PAT.
- From 2015 to 2024, it had a low Reinvestment rate of 35%. I defined Reinvestment rate as $\text{Reinvestment} / \text{NOPAT}$, where $\text{Reinvestment} = \text{CAPEX} \& \text{Acquisition} - \text{Depreciation} \& \text{Amortization} + \text{increase in Net Working Capital}$.

I would consider it a cash cow with a good capital allocation plan, as shown in **Table 2**. The cash flow from operations was sufficient to cover its CAPEX and acquisitions, with excess returned to shareholders.

VALUATION

Mosaic is a low-growth, cyclical company operating in a similarly low-growth industry. In valuing the company, I looked at its performance over the cycle. The 2015–2024 averages

were used to reflect these cyclical values.

The valuation was based on the following key assumptions:

- **Growth:** Mosaic is a mature business, expected to grow at a 2.5% CAGR in perpetuity. The 2024 revenue serves as the base year.
- **Profitability:** Cyclical margins and reinvestment rates are based on the 2015–2024 averages.
- **Tax Rate:** The effective tax rate is the average from 2015–2024, excluding 2016, 2017, and 2020 to remove years with abnormal (negative or >100%) tax effects.
- **Tariffs:** No impact given Mosaic’s operating structure.

On this basis, the intrinsic value was estimated at USD24 per share, versus a market price of USD23 (as of 3 March 2024). This implies a 3% margin of safety. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

CONCLUSION

Mosaic is a financially solid but cyclically constrained fertilizer producer. Over the past decade, it has transformed into a global player with a strong South American presence. Yet its long-term fundamentals remain shaped by external market forces rather than internal efficiency gains.

While management has maintained prudent financial discipline, the company’s growth and profitability remain modest, reflecting the structural realities of a low-growth, commodity-driven sector.

The 2022 price surge provided only temporary relief, as returns and margins normalized by 2024. With limited evidence of sustained operational improvement and an estimated intrinsic value of USD24 per share versus a market price of USD23, the stock offers minimal margin of safety relative to long-term value targets.

From a value investor's perspective, Mosaic appears fairly valued. Its cyclical nature, capital intensity, and dependence on fertilizer price trends suggest that better entry opportunities may emerge in the next downcycle.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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Fed cuts rates by 25 basis points; jury still out on year-end rate cut

The US Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) has cut interest rates by 25 basis points marking the second cut this year with no commitment for another cut in December. The FOMC lowered its benchmark rate to a range of 3.75% to 4% in support of its goals and in light of the shift in the balance of risks.

In a statement, the FOMC noted that in considering additional adjustments to the target range for the federal funds rate, it will carefully assess incoming data, the evolving outlook, and the balance of risks. It has decided to conclude the reduction of its aggregate securities holdings on December 1 and is strongly committed to supporting maximum employment and returning inflation to its 2 percent objective.

It added that available indicators suggest that economic activity has been expanding at a moderate pace. Job gains have slowed this year, and the unemployment rate has edged up but remained low through August; more recent indicators are consistent with these

developments. Inflation has moved up since earlier in the year and remains somewhat elevated.

The FOMC seeks to achieve maximum employment and inflation at the rate of 2 percent over the longer run. Uncertainty about the economic outlook remains elevated. The FOMC is attentive to the risks to both sides of its dual mandate and judges that downside risks to employment rose in recent months.

In assessing the appropriate stance of monetary policy, the FOMC will continue to monitor the implications of incoming information for the economic outlook. It would be prepared to adjust the stance of monetary policy as appropriate if risks emerge that could impede the attainment of its goals. The FOMC's assessments will take into account a wide range of information, including readings on labour market conditions, inflation pressures and inflation expectations, and financial and international developments.



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US to give special consideration to Malaysia's semiconductor sector in tariff negotiations - MITI Deputy Minister

According to the Deputy Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) Liew Chin Tong, the US will give special consideration to Malaysia's semiconductor sector in tariff negotiations under Section 232 of the US Trade Expansion Act of 1962. The tariffs on semiconductors are sectoral and were not included in the recently signed Malaysia-US Agreement on Reciprocal Trade (ART).

He elaborated, during a question-and-answer session in the Dewan Rakyat, that the ART which was negotiated was with the US Trade Representative and does not include sectoral tariffs. He added that semiconductors fall under Section 232, which is under the consideration of the US secretary of commerce.

BNM explores tokenisation, invites feedback

According to Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM), it is exploring tokenisation to co-create a safe and sustainable roadmap for the development of tokenised financial services in Malaysia. In supporting a collaborative approach, the central bank has issued a discussion paper and aims to gather feedback that will inform and help shape BNM's regulatory and development approach.

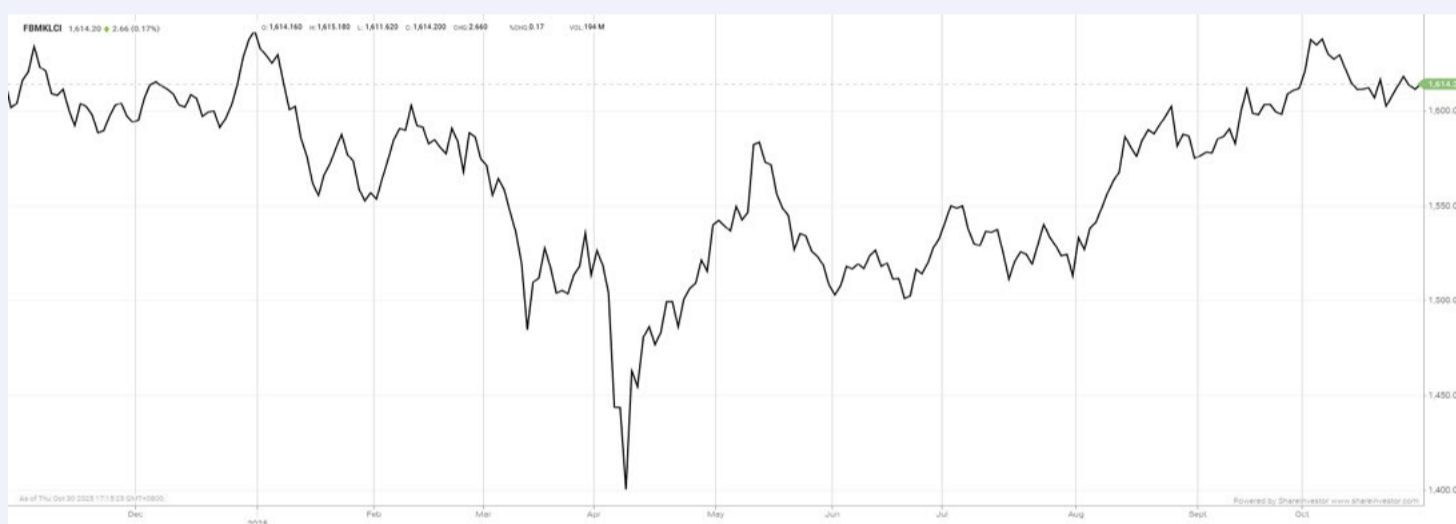


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EYE ON THE MARKETS

LOVE, INHERITANCE, AND LITIGATION: THE CMSB CHRONICLES

Board infighting is a common occurrence, particularly in the context of family business, often stemming from blurred lines between personal and professional matters, which eventually lead to conflicts over strategy, compensation and succession, among others.

Unclear job descriptions, roles and responsibilities coupled with a blurred understanding of how to keep personal conflicts out of the boardroom can spark disruption at the board level, especially among family members who are ill-prepared or unqualified for their board role.

Family dysfunction, as in the case of siblings/close relatives who cannot see eye-to-eye, can bleed into the boardroom with such animosity, not only impeding the decision making/ voting process

but eventually spilling over onto outside directors who will get embroiled in choosing sides.

The disruptive nature of a crippled board dynamics, epitomised by inheritance disputes and sibling rivalry, can be best illustrated by Cahya Mata Sarawak Berhad (CMSB) – once Sarawak's biggest conglomerate on Bursa Malaysia.

In fact, CMSB is an ideal testbed to gauge how prolonged and ongoing internal conflicts among family members can drag boards of listed entities into a quandary with disruption to day-to-day group operations, which could potentially lead to reduced company value and erosion of shareholders' trust, which ultimately jeopardises the business.

A LEGACY THAT DIVIDES THE FAMILY

Even before the death of patriarch Tun Abdul Taib Mahmud at the age of 87 on 21 February 2024, there was a legal suit pending between Taib's sons and his wife Toh Puan Raghad Kurdi Taib over shares in the family's flagship company, CMSB.

In 2023, Taib's sons, Datuk Seri Mahmud Abu Bekir Taib and Datuk Seri Sulaiman Abdul Rahman Taib, filed a suit to block the transfer of 50 million CMSB shares to their stepmother, Raghad, arguing that the shares were part of the estate of their late mother, Datuk Patinggi Dr. Hajjah Lejla Taib.

And within his own family, there appear to be differences among his children. For example, Taib's daughters - Jamilah Taib Murray and Datuk Hanifah Hajar Taib are not part of the legal suit involving Mahmud, Sulaiman and 45-year-old Syrian-born Raghad. Interestingly, the sisters controlled Majaharta Sdn Bhd, the single largest shareholder in CMSB today with 12.6% interest.

That CMSB had some three years ago filed a civil suit against several individuals, including the Hanifah's husband, Datuk Syed Ahmad Alwee Alsree, further explaining a strain in the siblings' stance pertaining to the inheritance squabble.

Syed Ahmad was an executive director of CMSB between 2006 and 2019. He joined the group when the Taib family was exiting the banking industry with the disposal of a 32.8% stake in RHB Banking Group to the Employees Provident Fund (EPF). He even took over from Sulaiman as CMSB head honcho after the latter won the Kota Samarahan parliamentary seat in the 2008 national polls and briefly served as deputy minister of Tourism.

Eldest son Abu Bekir, 61, is currently CMSB's deputy group chairman and non-independent non-executive director, while Sulaiman, 57, is the group managing director (GMD) of CMSB. Both sit in CMSB's 10-member board helmed by senior independent director Gen. (R) Tan Sri Mohd Zahidi Zainuddin.

Following Syed Ahmad's departure in 2019, CMSB was managed by two professionals, including the long-serving Datuk Isaac Lugun. After Sulaiman re-joined the CMSB board in June 2021, CMSB had in July 2022 filed a suit against six individuals – including Syed Ahmad and Isaac – for alleged breach of fiduciary duties in relation to the construction of an integrated phosphate additives plant in Samalaju, Sarawak. This followed an investigative audit by an accounting firm.

DEEPENING DIVIDE ON CORPORATE FRONT

While the inheritance squabble with their stepmother has somehow united both Abu Bekir and Sulaiman, such cordiality is seemingly missing at the corporate front, with strain having reared its ugly head between both brothers at the board level of CMSB.

In fact, both are embroiled in a slew of legal battles preceding and post Taib's demise. These include the following:

- On 6 March 2025, Abu Bekir filed an originating summons against CMSB to inspect the Company and its subsidiaries' accounts. In an affidavit to oppose the proceedings brought by Abu Bekir dated 13 March 2025 and sighted by a local news portal, Sulaiman claimed that *"it would not be far-fetched to*

allege that Mahmud is attempting to launch a coup to remove me as a director."

- Later on, 20 March 2025, CMSB initiated a legal suit against Abu Bekir and five others for breach of trust and fiduciary duties related to a failed Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system, part of the Company's digital transformation project awarded in 2019. The project involved Abu Bekir and former chief information officer Karl Vink @ Khalid Abdullah, who in turn were shareholders of Vienna Advantage GmbH (VAG), the entity awarded the digital transformation project by CMSB. Disputes ensued as CMSB claimed VAG failed to deliver and implement the ERP system.

In April 2021, CMSB launched an investigation into allegations of conflict of interest involving Abu Bekir and Vink. Subsequently, Abu Bekir took leave of absence from all his positions in the Group. However, in a statement dated 6 May 2021, the Board clarified that Abu Bekir need not to do so, deeming the allegations baseless.

TOLL ON FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

Mirroring the waning political clout of the late Taib and bitter ongoing family feud, CMSB now trades at around RM1.55 per share, a far cry from its record high of RM5.60 a decade ago. Such a steep decline in share price underscores not just cyclical business challenges, but also the destructive impact of family disputes that have spilt into corporate affairs, eroding investor confidence and long-term shareholder returns.

As the siblings remained embroiled in internal squabbles, CMSB's operations have been anything but smooth. The most glaring example came in July 2023, when Syarikat SESCO Bhd – the Sarawak state utility – cut off power supply to CMSB's phosphate plant in Bintulu's Samalaju Industrial Park following disagreements over the power purchase agreement.

The phosphates division has since become a major financial drain, posting persistent losses since FY2020. For the first half of FY2025,

the segment's losses ballooned to RM87.19 million, more than double the RM40.45 million in the corresponding period of the prior year. It had earlier chalked up pre-tax losses of RM156.70 million and RM96.80 million in FY2023 and FY2024, respectively.

Financially, CMSB posted a 12% year-on-year (y-o-y) rise in net profit to RM128.19 million (FY 2023: RM114.44 million) during its financial year ended 31 December 2024. However, its revenue dwindled slightly to RM1,196 million (FY2023: RM1.201 million).

However, the Group's financial performance has since headed south with 1HFY2025 net earnings dwindling 80.44% to RM14.01 million (1HFY2024: RM71.61 million), while revenue retreated 11.2% to RM493.05 million (1HFY2024: RM555.36 million).

For shareholders, the return has been uninspiring in recent years. Return on equity improved marginally to 3.83% in FY2024 from 3.51% in FY2023, while the five-year ROE range of 3.51% and 9.20% illustrated dismay shareholders' capital deployment efficiency. Dividend payouts have also been lacklustre, averaging 2–3 sen per share over five years.

Even as optimism surrounds the imminent restarting of the phosphate plant, the real test lies not just in production metrics but in governance resilience.

If there isn't a robust family governance initiative in place, family issues are bound to seep into the boardroom. Time spent focusing on family issues inevitably reduces the board's effectiveness, for it profoundly impacts how much value a board can bring to the company and shareholders.

After all, board dysfunction emanating from family conflict is a complex matter for it can be a hot rod for a boardroom to handle. For CMSB, restoring market confidence requires not just operational turnaround, but a rebuilding of trust within the family and among shareholders.

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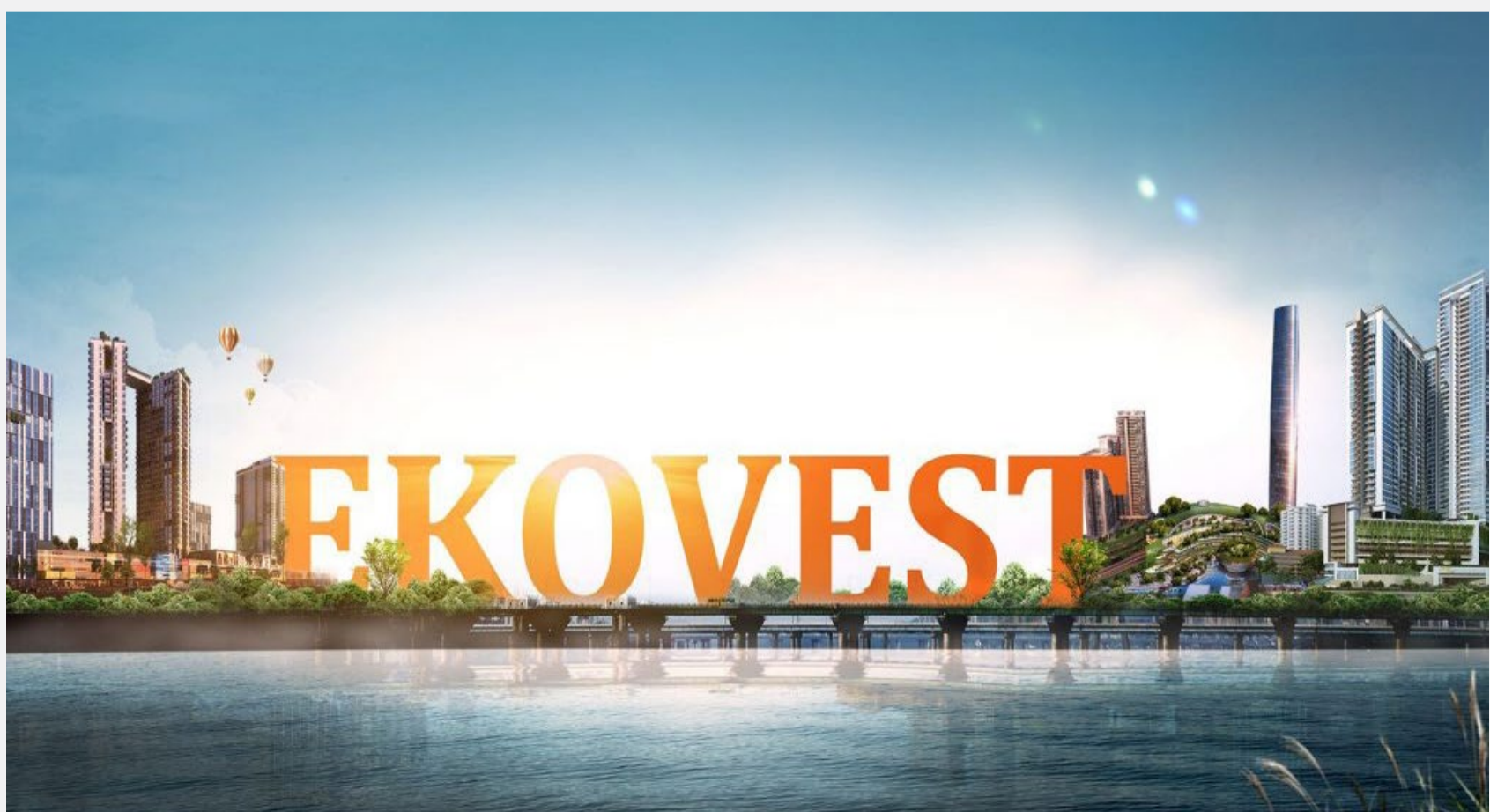
