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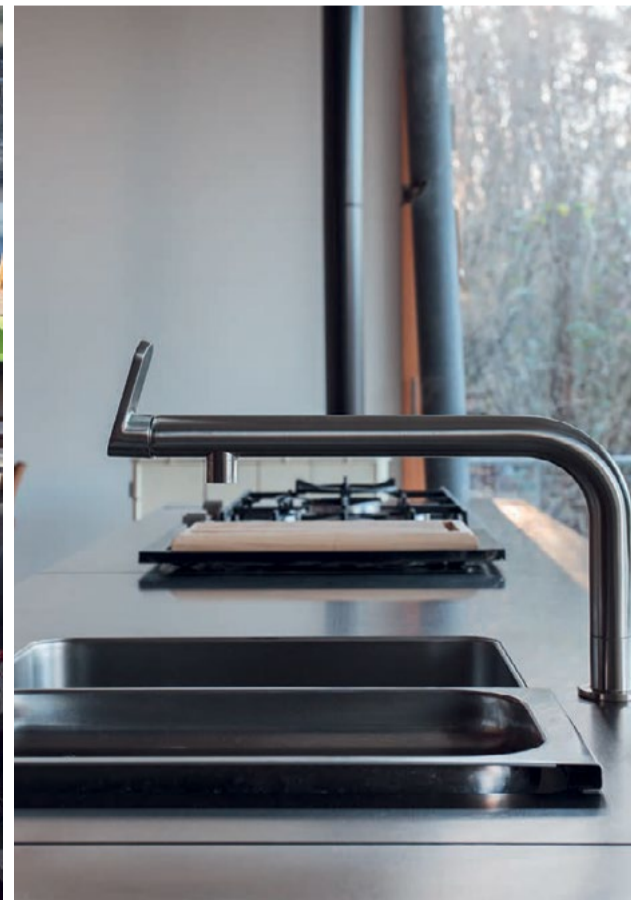

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Type XX, *the legend of the skies*

In the early 1950s, the French Air Force invited tenders for a chronograph wristwatch for its pilots, which it codenamed Type 20. One of the winning companies was Breguet, which would supply the aviation world with several timepieces meeting these specifications.

The year 1952 saw the birth of the Breguet instrument-watch: there were two military versions, the Type 20 for the Air Force and the Type XX for the Naval Aviation, as well as numerous Type XX variants created for the civilian market.

Inspired by this part of its history, Breguet introduced its own Type XX line into its current collections, with the 4th generation seeing the light of day in 2023. To continue this fascinating story, and to celebrate the company's 250th anniversary, Breguet presents the Type XX reference 2075, available in two versions.

A civilian model in gold, presented in 1955, provides the inspiration. According to the archives, this timepiece originally sported a satin-finish silver dial, which was later replaced by a black dial.

Today, Breguet is offering two reinterpretations: one with a black dial in aluminium, and the other, limited to 250 pieces, with a solid silver dial. A natural continuity between past and present.

With a diameter of 38.3 mm, identical to the historic 1955 timepiece, and a thickness of 13.2 mm, the case is crafted entirely in Breguet gold. A combination of gold enriched with silver, copper and palladium, this signature gold alloy was unveiled at the launch of the Classique Souscription 2025 watch.

The slim, bi-directional rotating bezel has numerals picked out in black for the black-dialled version and in blue for the silver-dialled version. The crown proudly bears the B of Breguet.

Both new models feature an interchangeable leather strap, gradient black for the black dial version and gradient blue for the silver dial version.

The calibres housed in these two models are variations of the high-performance, 5 Hz calibre 728 introduced by Breguet in 2023. They incorporate the flyback function that allows the watch to be reset to zero and a new count instantly started by a single press of the pusher located at 4 o'clock.

These two new models feature, for the first time, manually wound versions of the Breguet calibre 728, which are gilded in Breguet gold. The calibre 7279, for the black-dialled version, has a 15-minute counter at 3 o'clock, while the calibre 7278, for the silver-dialled version, has a 30-minute counter also at 3 o'clock.

Both models have a small seconds display at 9 o'clock. The transparent case back reveals an engraving entirely hand-crafted in the company's workshops.

It depicts the Breguet 19 aircraft in full flight accompanied by the precise route taken in 1930, the European and North American landmasses' frosted finishing contrasts against the smooth Atlantic Ocean.

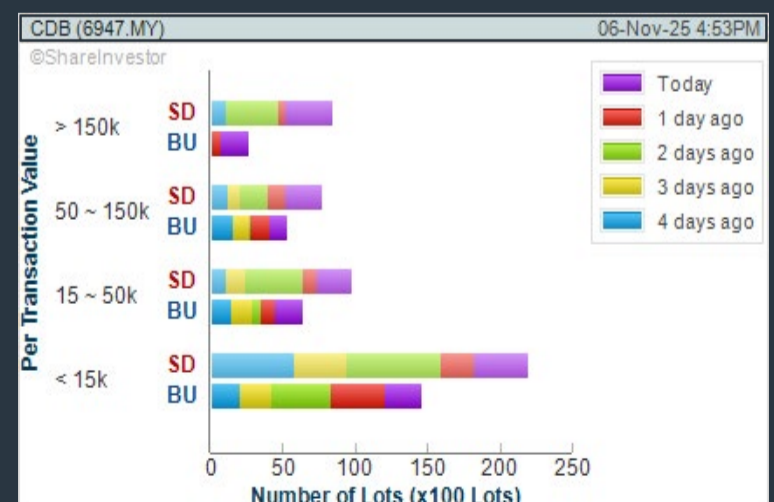

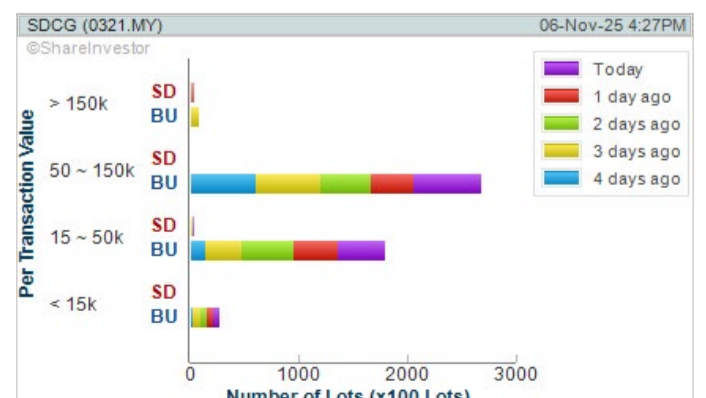

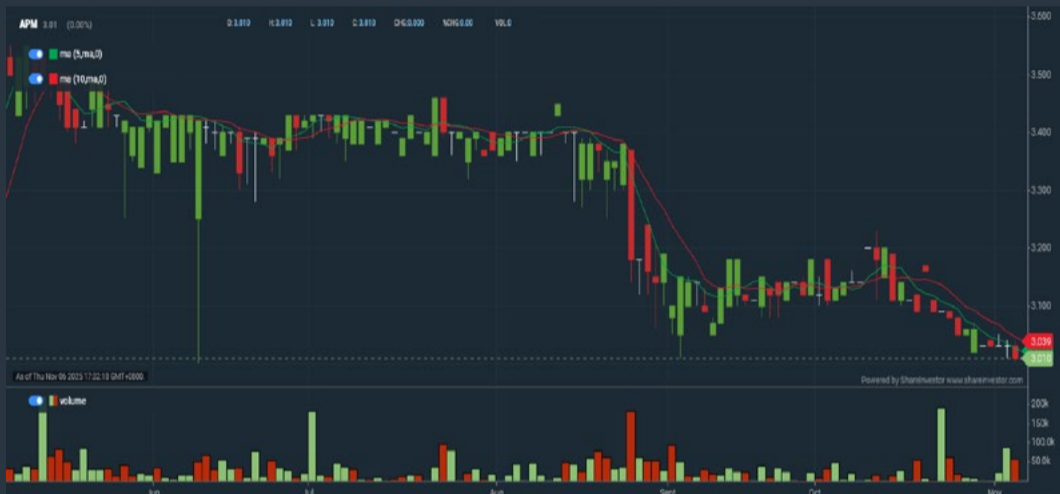

Long Game: Waiting for Efficiency to Deliver Value

SUMMARY

- KESM Industries Bhd (**BURSA:9334**) is the world's largest independent provider of semiconductor burn-in and test services, with core operations in Malaysia and a smaller presence in China. It has been scaling down its EMS segment since 2022.
- Revenue peaked in 2018 before declining sharply, while profits turned to losses by 2023. Over 12 years, average ROIC and ROE were below its WACC and cost of equity, reflecting value destruction.
- Despite weak profitability, KESM remains financially sound with high cash reserves, low debt, and strong operating cash flow. However, capital allocation efficiency is poor, with most cash flow absorbed by CAPEX.

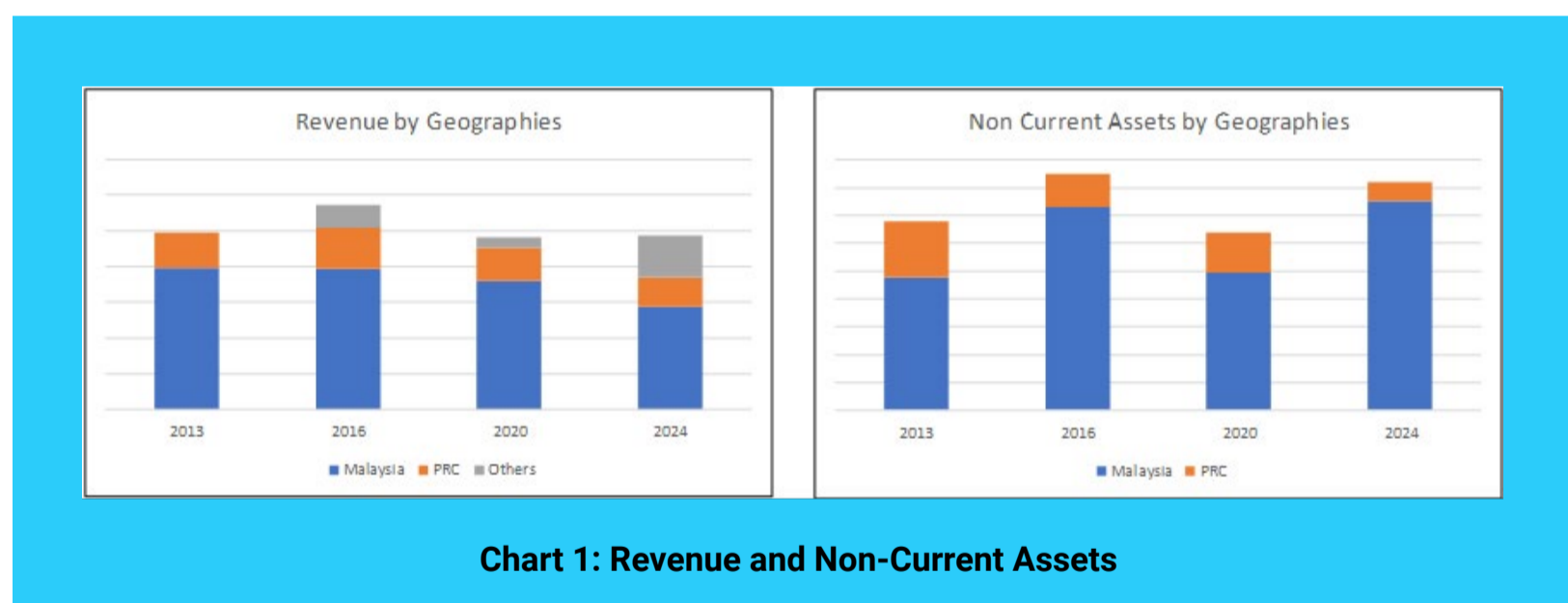
BACKGROUND

According to KESM, the Group's core business is ensuring the reliability and functionality of integrated circuits through burn-in and test services. It is recognized as the world's largest independent provider of these critical services.

Established in 1983 as a dedicated burn-in service provider, KESM expanded into electronics manufacturing services (EMS) in 1997. A decade later, in 2007, the Group set up a facility in Tianjin, China, to offer semiconductor burn-in and test services.

Although KESM did not disclose a detailed breakdown of its service segments, it began scaling down its EMS operations in 2022.

Most of the Group's operations - measured by customer revenue and non-current assets - are based in Malaysia (**see Chart 1**). In 2024, China contributed approximately 17% of total revenue and 9% of non-current assets.



OPERATING PERFORMANCE

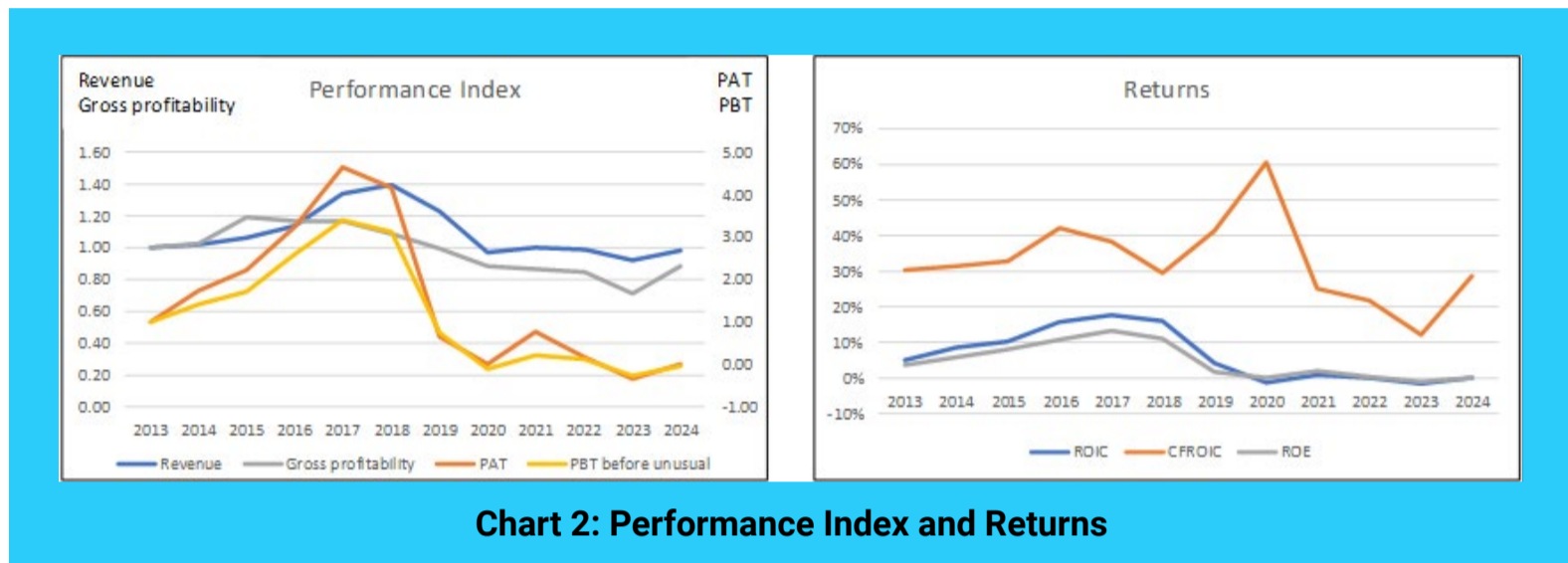
Over the past 12 years, KESM's revenue rose steadily from 2013 to a peak in 2018 before declining sharply. By 2024, it had fallen below 2013 levels (**see Chart 2**).

Profit was even more volatile. PAT quadrupled between 2013 and 2018 but deteriorated thereafter, turning into losses by 2023.

KESM attributed the downturn to external shocks - the US - China tech war (2019), the COVID-19 pandemic, and the subsequent

chip shortage as foundries prioritized consumer electronics over automotive demand. These headwinds, compounded by geopolitical and economic uncertainties, continued through 2024.

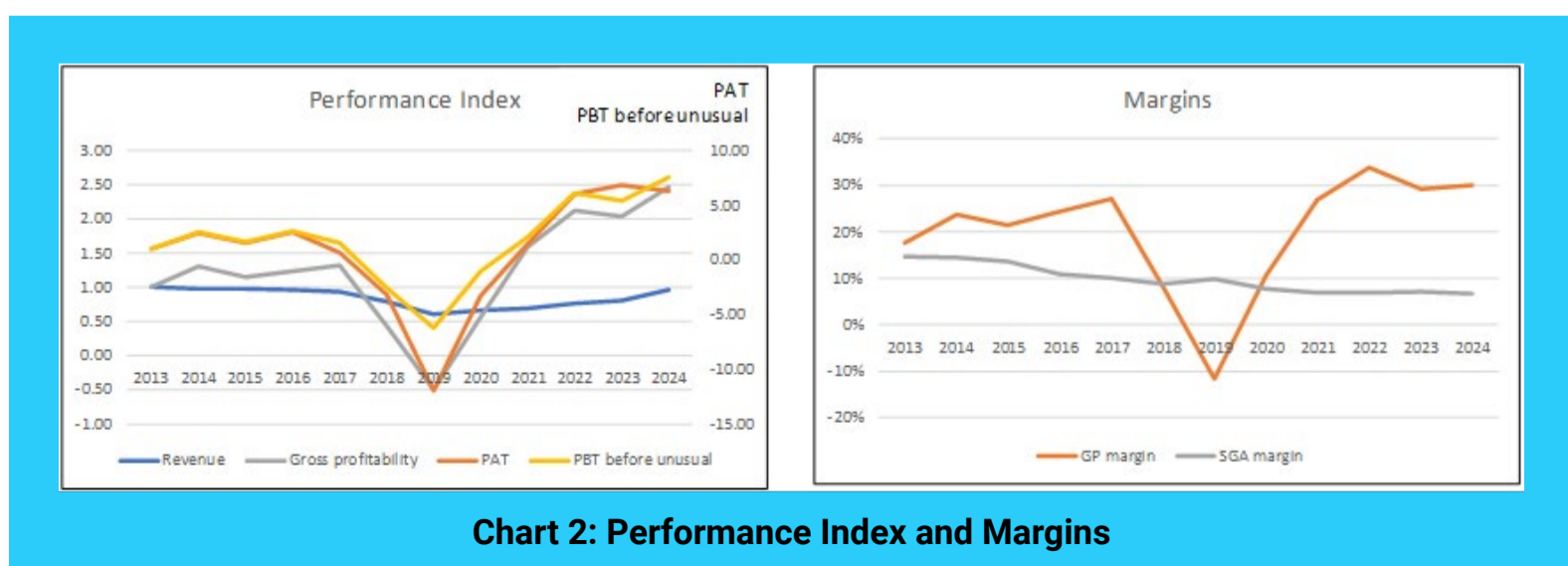
Over the 12 years, KESM delivered average returns of 6% ROIC and 5% ROE. These are both below the estimated 9% WACC and 10% cost of equity, indicating value destruction.



Revenue has since stabilized, likely due to its renewed focus on automotive semiconductors, a segment it has emphasized since 2016. Despite stable gross margins, gross profitability has declined since 2015, reflecting faster asset growth. Meanwhile, rising SGA costs compressed operating margins from about 7% in 2013/14 to under 1% in recent years.

KESM’s high fixed-cost structure results in a breakeven revenue of around RM250 million (around the 2024 revenue). This underscores the importance of cost control and efficiency gains.

While management has highlighted efforts to adopt automation and AI under its Industry 4.0 initiative, there is limited evidence of improvement in operating or capital efficiency metrics.

PEER COMPARISON

I compared KESM's performance with 4 other Bursa electronic companies, as shown in **Table 1**. You can see that KESM was the biggest among the peer groups in terms of the 2023 revenue. The 2 other peers with revenue data from 2013 also showed declining revenue. You can say that KESM had the lowest revenue decline.

I looked at the trends of 4 metrics to get a sense of how well KESM performed compared to its peers.

- I would rate KESM's return on capital and EBIT margin as average. Compared to its peers, it had a more stable return on capital.
- KESM's levered free cash flow margin seemed to have deteriorated over the past few years to be the worst in 2023.
- While it had the best EPS initially, it began to decline in 2019 to become the worst in 2023.

KESM appears to be facing significant challenges, particularly in cash flow generation and profitability, despite having stable capital returns relative to peers. The declining EPS and worsened cash flow margins suggest a need for strategic re-evaluation to enhance financial health and improve competitive positioning in the market.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate KESM as financially sound:

- As of Jul 2025, it had RM221 million in cash. This is equal to 53% of its total assets.

- It had a Debt Equity ratio of 0.11 as of Jul 2025. This has come down from its 2018 high of 0.21.
- Over the past 12 years, it has generated positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated RM743 million cash flow from operations compared to the total PAT of RM164 million. This is a very good cash flow conversion ratio.
- From 2013 to 2024, it had a negative Reinvestment. I defined Reinvestment = CAPEX + Acquisition – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital. The negative value implies that the amount spent on CAPEX and/or the increase in Net Working Capital was smaller than the Depreciation & Amortization. This is a good position as it means that the company did not have to allocate funds to support its growth.

KESM's main weakness is its capital allocation track record. **Refer to Table 1.** A big part of the cash flow from operations was used to fund its CAPEX. There was not much excess that could be returned to shareholders.

VALUATION

In valuing KESM, I adopted the following picture:

I assumed that there would not be high revenue growth. Rather, I assumed that growth would follow the long-term GDP growth rate of 4%.

There would not be any improvement in the operating and capital efficiency. Given the scaling down of the EMS operations in 2022, I assumed that the 2023/24 operating and capital efficiencies would be the long-term ones.

Given the high breakeven point, I looked at 2 scenarios.

- Scenario 1. This is based on the current revenue.
- Scenario 2. This assumes that the Group would be able to rebuild the revenue to the past 12 years' average level.

Under Scenario 1, I obtained an intrinsic value of RM5.05 per share, while it was RM12.08 per share under Scenario 2. Refer to the original article for the valuation details. The market price of the company at the end of July 2025 was RM2.73 per share. You can see that there are sufficient margins of safety under both Scenarios.

CONCLUSION

KESM has a strong balance sheet and a long operating history, but its performance over the past decade has been disappointing. The Group's profitability has eroded due to high fixed costs, weak operating leverage, and limited efficiency gains, resulting in returns below its cost of capital.

While management's shift toward the automotive semiconductor segment and Industry 4.0 initiatives may offer long-term promise, tangible improvements in operating and capital productivity have yet to materialize.

At current prices, the stock trades below intrinsic value based on conservative assumptions, suggesting some margin of safety. However, without clear evidence of revenue recovery or cost efficiency gains, you should monitor signs of sustainable turnaround before re-rating the stock.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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OPR maintained at 2.75% - MPC

The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of Bank Negara Malaysia decided to maintain the Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) at 2.75%.

For the Malaysian economy, latest developments indicate better-than-expected growth in 3Q2025, driven by sustained domestic demand, resilient electrical and electronics (E&E) exports, and recovery in commodity production. Looking ahead, resilient domestic demand will continue to support growth going into 2026. Employment, wage growth and income-related policy measures will remain supportive of household spending. The expansion in investment activity will be driven by the progress of multi-year projects in both the private and public sectors, the continued high realisation of approved investments, as well as the ongoing implementation of catalytic initiatives under national master plans and the Thirteenth Malaysia Plan (RMK13).

Measures under Budget 2026 will also support growth. This growth outlook remains subject to uncertainties, in particular surrounding global developments. Downside risks to the growth outlook remain from slower global trade, weaker sentiment, as well as lower-than-expected commodity production. Meanwhile, upside potential to growth could arise from a better global growth outlook, stronger demand for E&E goods, and robust tourism activity.

Year-to-date, headline and core inflation averaged 1.4% and 1.9%, respectively. Moving forward, headline inflation is expected to remain moderate in 2026 amid the continued easing in global cost conditions. Global commodity prices are expected to remain modest, contributing to contained domestic cost conditions. Meanwhile, core inflation in 2026 is expected to remain stable and

close to its long-term average, reflecting continued expansion in economic activity and the absence of excessive demand pressures. In this environment, the overall impact of the implemented domestic policy reforms on inflation in 2026 is expected to be limited.

For the global economy, the latest indicators point towards a continued expansion in global growth. While the impact of higher tariffs would continue to weigh on global growth, the outlook remains supported by resilient labour market conditions, moderating inflation, less restrictive monetary policy and supportive fiscal policy. The conclusion of more trade negotiations has, to some extent, eased global uncertainty. Downside risks remain, arising from potentially higher tariffs, especially product-specific ones, and escalation in geopolitical tensions. Additionally, there are concerns over the elevated valuations in financial markets. Upside potential includes a milder tariff impact on economic activity and pro-growth policies in major economies.

At the current OPR level, the MPC considers the monetary policy stance to be appropriate and supportive of the economy amid price stability. The MPC will continue to monitor ongoing developments and assess the balance of risks surrounding the outlook for domestic growth and inflation.

The meeting also approved the schedule of MPC meetings for 2026. In accordance with the Central Bank of Malaysia Act 2009, the MPC will convene six times during the year. 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ASEAN Capital Markets Forum Charts Next Phase of Growth with New Five-Year Action Plan

The ASEAN Capital Markets Forum (ACMF) unveiled a series of key initiatives at its ACMF International Conference 2025, hosted by the Securities Commission Malaysia (SC). The announcements follow the 43rd ACMF Chairs' Meeting, where ASEAN's capital market regulators endorsed the deliverables ahead of their public launch.

The centrepiece of the event was the ACMF Action Plan 2026–2030 (AP 2026) - a forward-looking roadmap to guide ASEAN's capital market development over the next five years. Building on the achievements of the 2021–2025 plan, AP 2026 outlines 11 Key Priorities and 24 Initiatives across five strategic thrusts:

1. Building a Sustainable ACMF
2. Building a Sustainable and Resilient ASEAN
3. Promoting Inclusivity and Financial Empowerment
4. Strengthening Regional Integration and Global Positioning
5. Driving Digitalisation

Dato' Mohammad Faiz Azmi, ACMF Chair for 2025, said "The next five years will be pivotal for ASEAN's capital markets. Through AP 2026, we are building the foundations for a more connected, credible and competitive region - one that not only attracts global capital but channels it toward inclusive, sustainable, and resilient growth. The collaboration and commitment we've seen among ASEAN regulators reaffirm our shared vision of making our markets stronger together."

The ACMF International Conference 2025, officiated by His Excellency Senator Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan, Minister of Finance II, Malaysia was attended by policymakers, regulators, and industry leaders to discuss the future of ASEAN capital markets. Discussions highlighted cross-border fundraising, climate transition finance, voluntary carbon markets, and the use of AI in regulatory supervision, underscoring ASEAN's growing leadership in sustainable finance and digital transformation.

Other key publications launched at the conference include:

- Version 2 of the ASEAN Simplified ESG Disclosure Guide (ASEAN SEDG) for SMEs in Supply Chains, which has been refined following public consultation and serves to provide guidance to SMEs in preparing their ESG disclosures;
- A White Paper for the mitigation co-benefit and Adaptation for Resilience (mARs) Guide, developed with the UN Environment Programme Finance Initiative (UNEP FI) in partnership with Sustainable Finance Institute Asia (SFIA), in close consultation with the ASEAN Taxonomy Board (ATB);
- Voluntary Carbon Market (VCM) Development Plan and ASEAN VCM Guidance, jointly developed with the Economic Research Institute for ASEAN and East Asia (ERIA) to enhance transparency, integrity, and interoperability in regional carbon markets; and
- ASEAN Taxonomy for Sustainable Finance Version 4, which included the technical screening criteria for the remaining three focus sectors and two enabling sectors of the ASEAN Taxonomy's Plus Standard, allowing complete coverage of Plus Standard.

A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between ACMF and ERIA to advance cooperation on research, policy development and capacity building in areas related to the 5 strategic thrusts within AP 2026. The two-day engagements concluded with the handover of the ACMF Chairmanship from the Securities Commission Malaysia to the Securities and Exchange Commission Philippines.

Malaysia aims to lead in semiconductor, advanced tech innovation - Chang

According to Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Chang Lih Kang, Malaysia is positioning itself as a high-tech, innovation-driven nation with a clear strategy to advance beyond manufacturing into technology creation and global semiconductor leadership.

He was speaking at the seventh edition of the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) Tech Talks at UCSI University when he said that Malaysia's technological future hinges on its ability to invest in talent, research and innovation, particularly in the fast-growing semiconductor sector.

He said, "We are in a global race not just to make technology, but to master it. That race will be won by countries that invest in talent, innovation and courage." He added that Malaysia's electrical and electronics (E&E) industry remains one of its strongest economic pillars, with semiconductor exports expanding from RM106 billion in 2015 to RM387 billion in 2023. The sector accounts for a quarter of Malaysia's gross domestic product (GDP) and supports around 100,000 jobs.

He added that through new investments, specialised training and strategic partnerships, we are building the full spectrum of semiconductor capability. The goal is clear to make Malaysia's semiconductor ecosystem not only competitive, but complete, resilient and future-ready.

The National Science, Technology and Innovation Policy (NSTIP) 2021–2030 forms the foundation of Malaysia's high-tech aspirations, comprising six policy thrusts and 40 cross-ministerial initiatives to strengthen research and innovation governance. Malaysia aims to raise R&D expenditure to 2.5% of GDP, with 70% driven by the private sector. Human capital is central to this mission, with a target of 200 researchers, scientists, engineers and technologists per 10,000 workers.

Malaysia ranked 34th in the 2025 Global Innovation Index, while Kuala Lumpur climbed from 93rd to 86th among the world's top science clusters, making Malaysia one of only 15 countries with two or more recognised innovation clusters. He noted that MOSTI agencies, particularly MIMOS, play a key role in advancing this agenda through R&D, technology transfer and talent development.

MIMOS's Semiconductor Technology Centre now offers world-class testing and reliability facilities, including an international automotive testing capability, while the MIMOS Junior Academy inspires young Malaysians to explore science and innovation from an early age.

He said that this journey cannot be achieved by the government alone. Public–private collaboration is key, bringing together government policy, industry expertise and academic innovation under one shared mission.

He added that MOSTI remains focused on ensuring every investment in innovation delivers measurable national value, and urged collective effort to position Malaysia as a leader in the global technology race, not merely a participant.



Heineken Malaysia Reports 3Q FY2025 Results

Heineken Malaysia Bhd (HEINEKEN Malaysia) announced its financial results for Q3 ended 30 September 2025, reporting an overall positive performance with higher revenue, PBT and net profit, driven by effective revenue management, enhanced distribution efforts, and disciplined cost management.

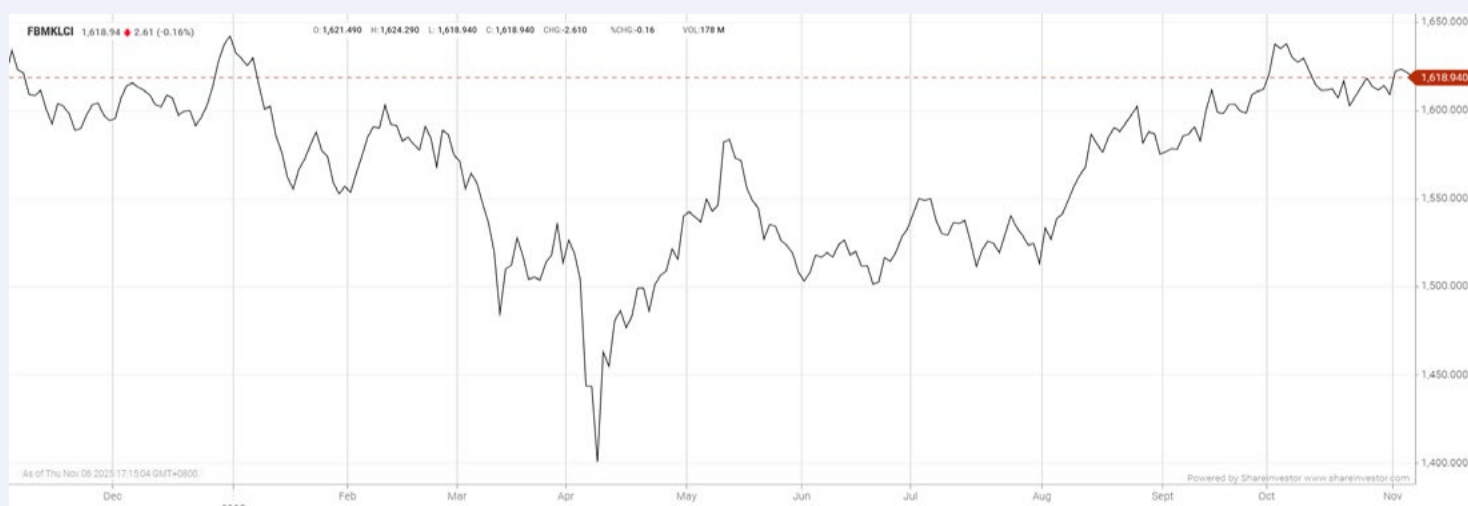
The Group recorded revenue of RM656 million, an increase of 6% y-o-y. PBT climbed 16% to RM149 million compared to the same period last year. For the nine-month period, the Group's revenue remained steady with a marginal decrease of 1%, compared to

the same period in 2024. Meanwhile, the Group PBT increased by 2% to RM419 million, reflecting the Group's operational resilience and contributing to a steady recovery in y-t-d performance, supported by improvements in the third quarter.

According to Martijn van Keulen, Managing Director of HEINEKEN Malaysia, the group is pleased with the strong third-quarter performance, which reflects the resilience of business fundamentals amid ongoing macroeconomic headwinds. However, he noted that the trading environment remains volatile, particularly considering the excise duty increase effective 1 November 2025. The group is proactively implementing strategic measures to safeguard profitability and value growth ambition into the final quarter of 2025. He added that the Board of Directors does not recommend any dividend in respect of the quarter ended 30 September 2025.

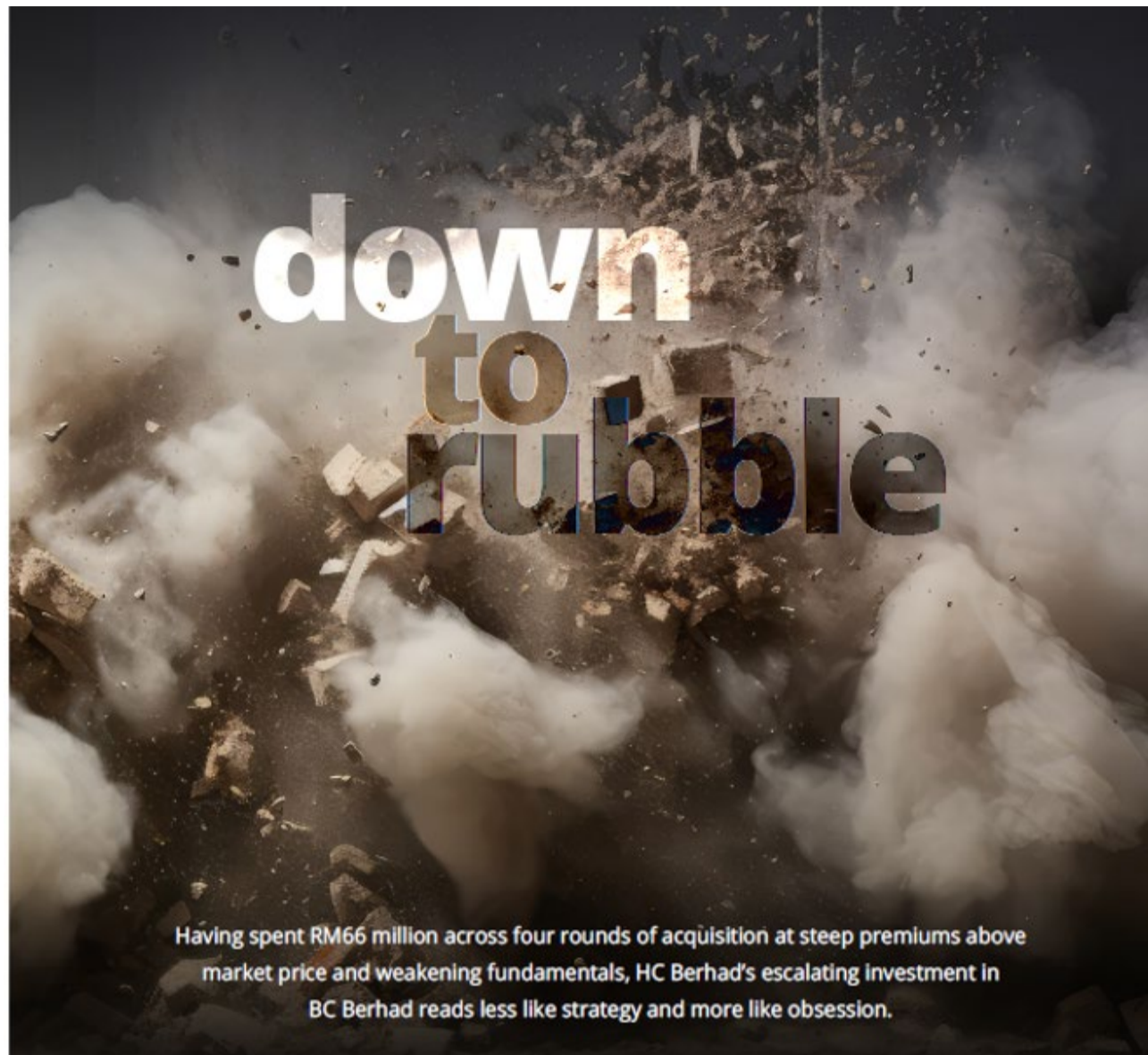

HC BERHAD - BC BERHAD PARADOX

Have you ever watched something fall apart in slow motion? Not a crash – no, not that kind of drama – more like... erosion. The kind you don't notice until there's nothing left but dust and denial. That's HC Berhad – and its shiny, obsessive love story with BC Berhad. The one that got away but didn't really want to stay.

See, HC Berhad didn't trip; it drifted. Like conviction melting under fluorescent lights. They spent sixty-six million ringgit – million, with an "M" – buying slices of BC Berhad. Not once. Not twice. Four times! A recent stealthy pick up of 19 million shares came at a 75% premium above the market price. Like an addict chasing that first high. RM0.56, RM0.21... always a little too much, always a little too late.

Now they own 34.6%. Not quite statutory control, not quite distance. Just enough to whisper in the boardroom, but not enough to trigger the big red button – the mandatory general offer. Creeping control. The kind of move that says, "I'm not touching you," while their finger hovers this close to your face.

And here's the genius part — with that slice, that perfect 34.6%, they can block special resolutions. The ones that need seventy-five percent approval. See? Not full control... just the power to say no. A veto dressed as a minority interest. It's not ownership — it's leverage.

They said it was strategic. Of course they did. BC Berhad is in telecom and utilities — 5G towers and shiny solar dreams, Malaysia's buzzwords of the decade. Sounds smart, right? "Synergy." "Growth." "Alignment." Boardroom bingo. Except that solar dream? It's gone. On 31 December 2024, BC Berhad quietly disposed of its 51% stake in its solar subsidiary for RM5.92 million.

Meanwhile, the numbers don't lie — they just bleed quietly. RM111.9 million in revenue, RM2.1 million in profit and negative operating cash flow of RM30.36 million during FY2024. A wafer-thin hope sandwich. Then — poof! — Q22025: losses, negative operating cash flow continued. And still... HC Berhad bought more. Paid more. Premiums above market, like a gambler betting on the same losing hand because the dealer wore a funny smile.

And when people asked why, oh — they had a story. Something about "avoiding undue impact on market pricing." Something about "the scarcity of sizeable shareholdings in the open market." They even added that acquiring such a large block through the open market could be time-consuming and more expensive. Translation? They overpaid on purpose. The irony writes itself — HC Berhad paid well above market price to avoid paying more. Because apparently, when the market doesn't agree with your valuation, the problem must be... the market.

Maybe it's not about profit. Maybe it's about power — or something darker that doesn't fit on a balance sheet. Because paying a premium four times isn't bad math — it's intent. Influence has a price tag.

And as if that wasn't enough self-inflicted comedy, HC Berhad turned its 34.6% dummy, BC Berhad, into a collector of vanity carcasses — overpriced, overrated, and magnificently futile.

Empire City, of all places – the graveyard of ambition wrapped in glass and debt. They called it “investment,” but it looked more like a slow-motion suicide pact. And when the bleeding wouldn't stop, they breathed “private placement” like a prayer, diluting themselves into oblivion to patch the holes they drilled with their own hands.

This isn't diversification anymore – it's empire building in disguise. A corporate hydra. Chemicals, agriculture, power generation, property, telecommunications – each head twitching in different directions, all connected to one brain humming: Expand. Expand. Expand.

And no one's breaking any rules! Oh no. The rulebook's intact, just... interpreted creatively. Independent directors nodding politely, while the valuation report is propped up like a shield to justify the insanity. HC Berhad's grand foray into BC Berhad doesn't look like vision anymore – it looks like obsession in a tailored suit, pacing the boardroom and mistaking compulsion for purpose.

The market sees through it. Always does. BC Berhad's share price didn't soar – it sank, dragged by its own story. Numbers don't bend for narratives.

And the silence... that's the most haunting part. The announcements are polished, perfumed, full of “synergy” and “collaboration.” But behind them? Nothing. No real progress. Just the murmur of optimism pretending to be logic. A cautionary tale written in ringgit and regret.

But here's the twist – it was always there. The warning signs. The margins. The valuations. The silence. The belief that the market was wrong and they were right. That's how stories like this end: not with an explosion, but with the quiet sound of confidence collapsing under its own weight.

You can't cheat gravity. Not even with synergy.

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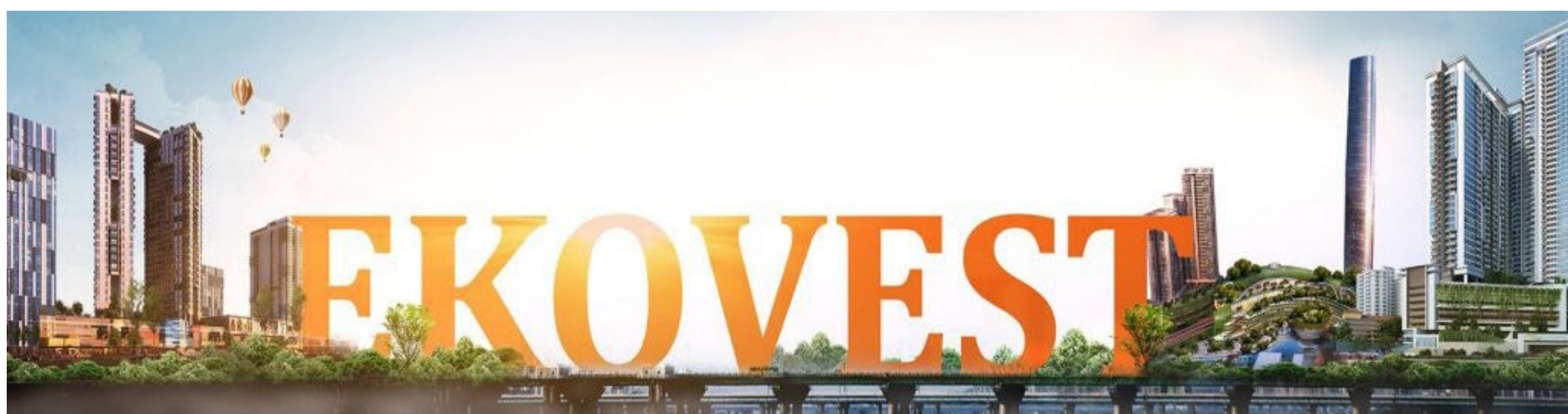
