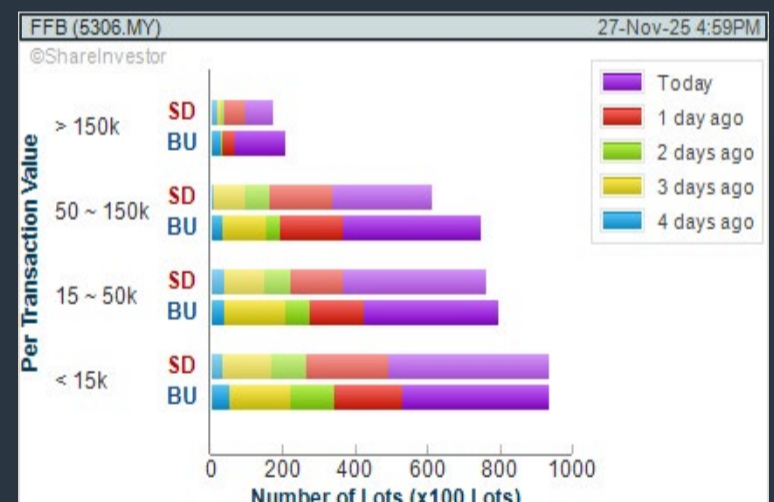

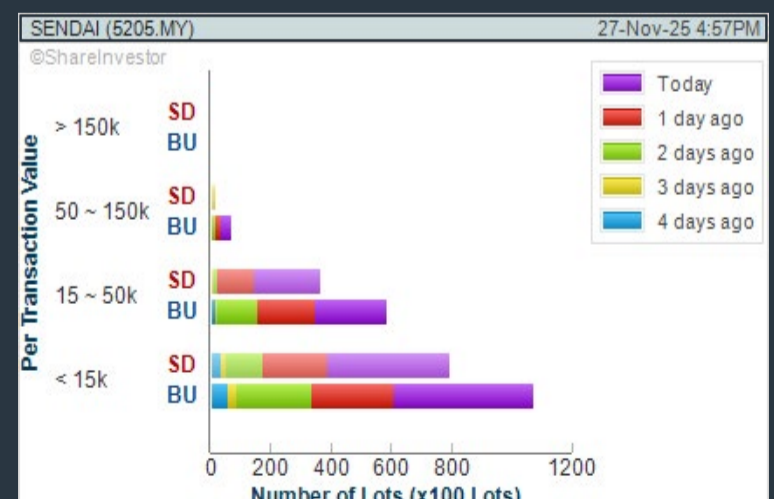

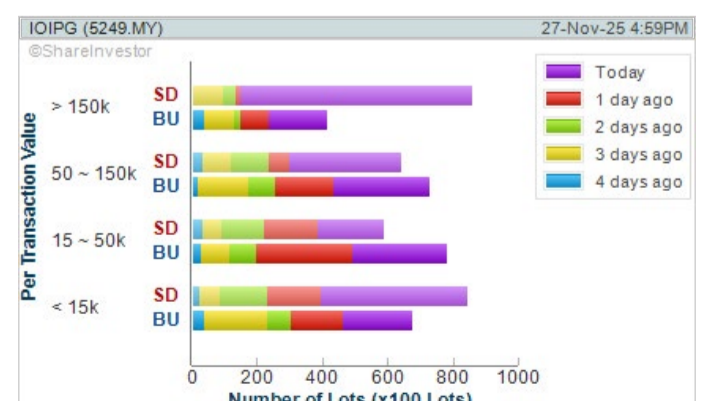

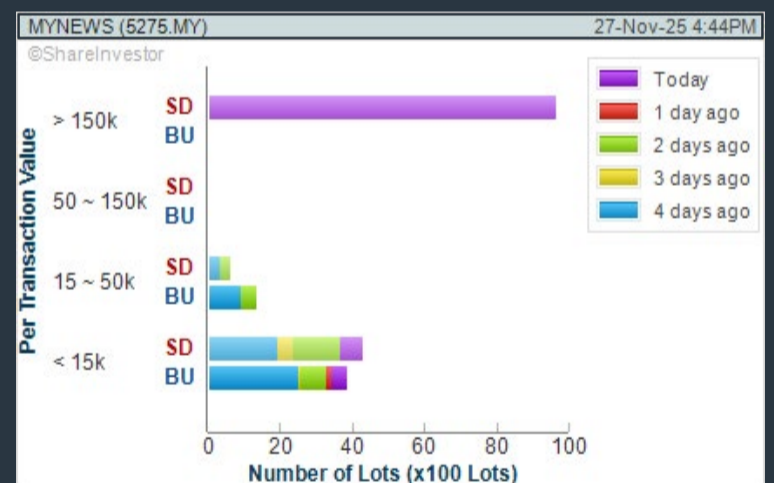

BACKGROUND

Onto is a global leader in process control, inspection, and metrology solutions for the semiconductor industry. Its tools and software help semiconductor manufacturers improve yields, reduce costs, and accelerate time-to-market.

Onto operates in the semiconductor process control and metrology market. This is a sector characterized by steady, single-digit growth. Onto likely holds approximately 8% of the global market.

The company in its current form was established in October 2019 through the merger of Nanometrics and Rudolph Technologies. Since then, Onto has achieved significant progress in several areas:

- **Global expansion:** Onto has strengthened its international presence. In 2024, non-U.S. operations contributed approximately 89% of total revenue, up from 79% in 2015
- **Technological advancement:** The company introduced next-generation process control solutions designed for AI-driven metrology.
- **Financial growth:** The merger fuelled both revenue and earnings growth. From 2020 to 2024, revenue grew at a 15% CAGR, while PAT expanded at an impressive 60% CAGR.

In 2023, Onto experienced a temporary decline in revenue and profit, reflecting the global semiconductor downturn. However, the company rebounded strongly in 2024, supported by accelerating demand for artificial intelligence (AI) applications.

POST-MERGER PERFORMANCE

The improvement in Onto's earnings following the 2019 merger can be attributed to three key factors: revenue growth, cost control, and low tax rates.

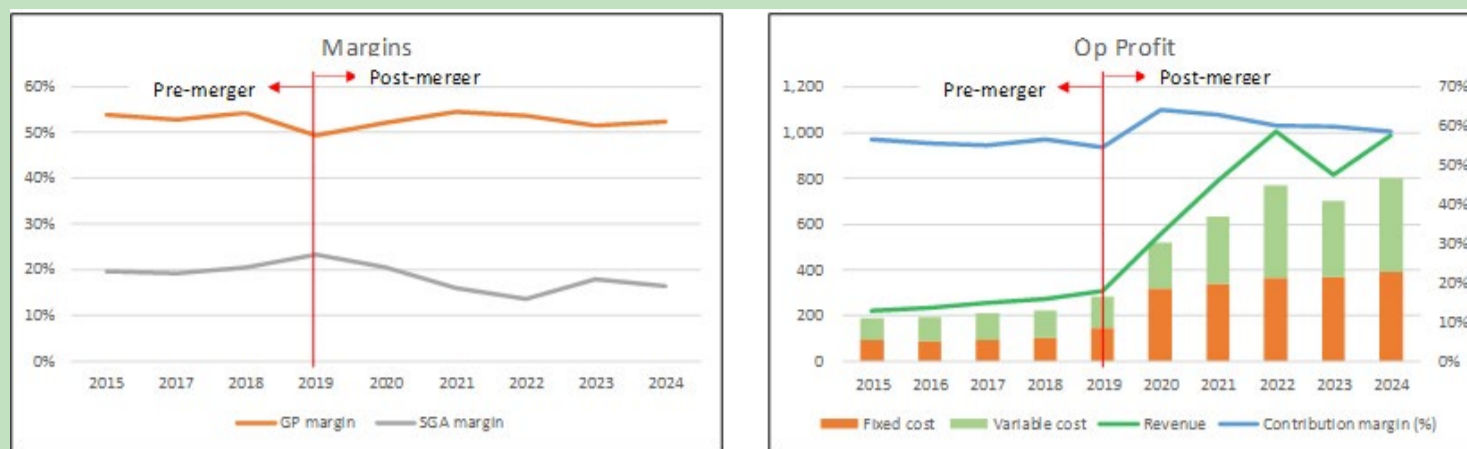


Chart 1: Margins and Operating Profit

Note to Op Profit Profile: I broke down the operating profits into fixed costs and variable costs.

- Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization, R&D and Others.
- Variable cost = Cost of Sales – Depreciation & Amortization.
- Contribution = Revenue – Variable Cost.
- Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.

There was limited margin expansion, as shown in the **left part of Chart 1**. This is also reflected in the contribution margin on the **right side of Chart 1** - although there was a spike in 2020, the trend has been declining since then. Nevertheless, the company demonstrated strong control over its fixed costs:

- The Selling, General and Administrative (SGA) margin has been steadily declining since 2019 (see the left part of Chart 1).
- From 2020 to 2024, fixed costs grew at only 5% CAGR, versus 15% CAGR for revenue.
- Fixed costs account for roughly half of Onto's total cost base (fixed + variable). With this structure, profits expand at a faster rate than revenue during periods of topline growth.

Another contributor to Onto's earnings performance has been its consistently low effective tax rates. Excluding the one-time tax credit in 2020, the company's effective tax rate remained below 10% from 2021 through 2024. This favourable rate primarily reflects R&D tax credits and Foreign-Derived Intangible Income deductions under U.S. tax law. I interpret these factors as structural advantages rather than one-off events, implying that the low effective tax rate could persist barring any major policy changes.

Onto also stands out for its low reinvestment rate (Reinvestment/NOPAT). I defined Reinvestment as = CAPEX + Acquisitions – Depreciation & Amortization + changes in Net Working Capital. Since the merger, Onto has maintained an average reinvestment rate of 19%. This means that approximately 81% of NOPAT was available for shareholder returns - a strong indicator of both capital efficiency and cash-generative operations.

PEERS

I compared Onto’s performance with some listed companies offering similar solutions, as shown in Table 1. Onto is one of the bigger companies in terms of 2024 revenue. It also had one of the better revenue growth rates.

I would not consider Onto’s performance as good when compared to the panel.

- Onto had the worst return on capital and EBIT margin.
- While Onto’s levered free cash flow margin was initially the worst, it has improved to be about the average over the past year or so.
- Onto had lower than average EPS

FINANCIAL POSITION

I consider Onto financially sound and a cash cow based on the following:

- i) It had cash of USD895 million as of the end of Jun 2025. This was equivalent to about 42% of its total assets.
- ii) It had a very low debt level of USD13 million as of the end of Jun 2025, resulting in a 0.7% Debt-Equity ratio.
- iii) It had a low reinvestment rate as mentioned earlier.
- iv) From 2020 to 2024, it generated positive cash flow from operations every year. It also had a good cash flow conversion ratio. From 2020 to 2024, it generated USD836 million cash flow from operations, compared to its cumulative PAT of USD720 million.
- v) It had a good capital allocation plan as per **Table 2**. The cash flow from operations was more than sufficient to cover its CAPEX, with some of the excess returned to shareholders as buybacks.

VALUATION

Onto Innovation holds a strong position in the semiconductor metrology market. Despite operating in a single-digit growth industry, its competitive advantages support the potential for continued double-digit revenue growth in the near term. For valuation, I assumed:

- i) Revenue growth: 15% CAGR in Year 1, gradually declining to 4% by Year 6, based on 2024 as the base year.
- ii) Margins: Starting from the 2020 to 2024 average, with a 10% improvement in contribution margin by the terminal year due to operating leverage and cost control.
- iii) Reinvestment rate: Equal to the 2020 to 2024 average.
- iv) Tax rate: The 2020 to 2024 average effective rate of 8.3%.

Under these assumptions, the intrinsic value was estimated at USD126 per share. Its market price at the end of Jun 2025 was USD101 per share. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

CONCLUSION

Onto Innovation has emerged as a financially strong and operationally efficient player in the semiconductor metrology sector. The company's disciplined cost structure, low Reinvestment needs, and favourable tax profile have translated into strong earnings growth and robust cash generation since the 2019 merger. From a long-term investor's standpoint, Onto represents a high-quality business with enduring competitive advantages.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

Malaysia has no plans to renegotiate US trade deal - Zafrul

According to Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, Malaysia has no plans to renegotiate its trade deal with the US. The government is focused on making sure all ministries follow the agreement. He said all trade agreements, including free trade agreements, allow for periodic reviews, but these can only happen after Malaysia ratifies the deal and require both parties' consent. Speaking at a news conference after addressing a bipartisan parliamentary caucus to address the Malaysia-US trade agreement, he said any review requires mutual agreement where both parties must consent.

He added that for now, the government is focused on making sure all ministries and agencies follow the agreement, with MITI coordinating the process. Malaysia will only proceed with ratification once all parties are ready, noting that no legal amendments are required. This shows that the agreement does not affect the country's sovereignty.

He reiterated that allegations that the deal threatens Malaysia's sovereignty are completely untrue, noting that the agreement's

preamble explicitly affirms both countries' commitment to sovereignty, economic prosperity and resilient supply chains. He further rejected claims that the pact could harm Malaysia-China relations, stressing that it is a trade agreement, not a geopolitical alliance.

He said Malaysia will continue to maintain and expand trade through platforms such as the Asean-China Free Trade Agreement, the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) and the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP).

He also responded to former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's allegation that the agreement grants Bumiputera status to American companies by dismissing it as a fabrication, saying Bumiputera rights were a red line throughout negotiations with the US.

Malaysia's PPI continues to ease with 0.1% decline in October - DOSM

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) chief statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Malaysia's producer price index (PPI) continued its downward trend, recording a 0.1% decrease in October, after a 0.8% decline in the previous month.

In a statement, he noted the manufacturing sector fell by 0.6% in October (September: -2.1%), mainly due to a drop in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (-5.1%) and the manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products indices (-1.6%). The mining sector also contracted by 1.0% (September: 1.1%), weighed down by the extraction of crude petroleum index (-2.2%).

The agriculture, forestry and fishing sector increased by 2.7% (September: 7.8%), supported by the growing of perennial crops and the animal production indices (3.0%). In the utilities sector, the electricity and gas supply and the water supply indices posted increases of 4.3% and 10.8% respectively.

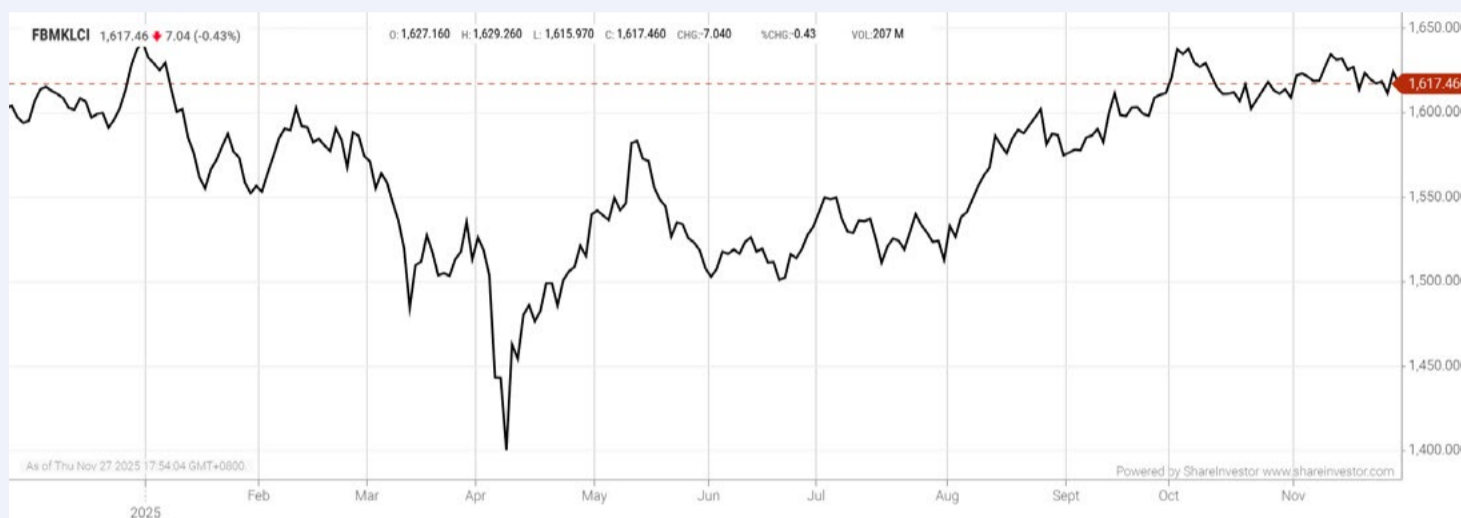
IHH Healthcare delivers double-digit growth for Q3 2025

IHH Healthcare Berhad's revenue rose 16% to RM6.6 billion for 3QFY2025 supported by stronger contributions from day care services and improved cost containment, particularly in Malaysia and India. 3QFY2025 EBITDA grew 16% to RM1.5 billion while PATMI increased by 15% to RM616 million. The Group reported sustained progress on its transformation plan to be less capital intensive and future ready. It also continued to double down on its differentiated clinical and care excellence. Having recently completed its acquisition of Fortis in India, it paves the way for greater flexibility to explore future growth and more efficient capital structures.

According to Dr Prem Kumar Nair, Group Chief Executive Officer, IHH Healthcare, the Group reported strong financial performance even as it continues the multi-year transformation to anticipate changes and capture longer term opportunities in the industry. He added that despite payor pressures and cost inflation, Malaysia grew strongly as it pivots towards a daycare focus and as medical tourism share rises. In India, Fortis and Gleneagles are realising synergies through their closer operational partnership, while Singapore saw its flagship Mount Elizabeth Orchard fully reopen during the quarter. He noted that as IHH continues to drive capital efficient growth through transformation and clinical leadership, the Group expects to maintain solid margins and returns.

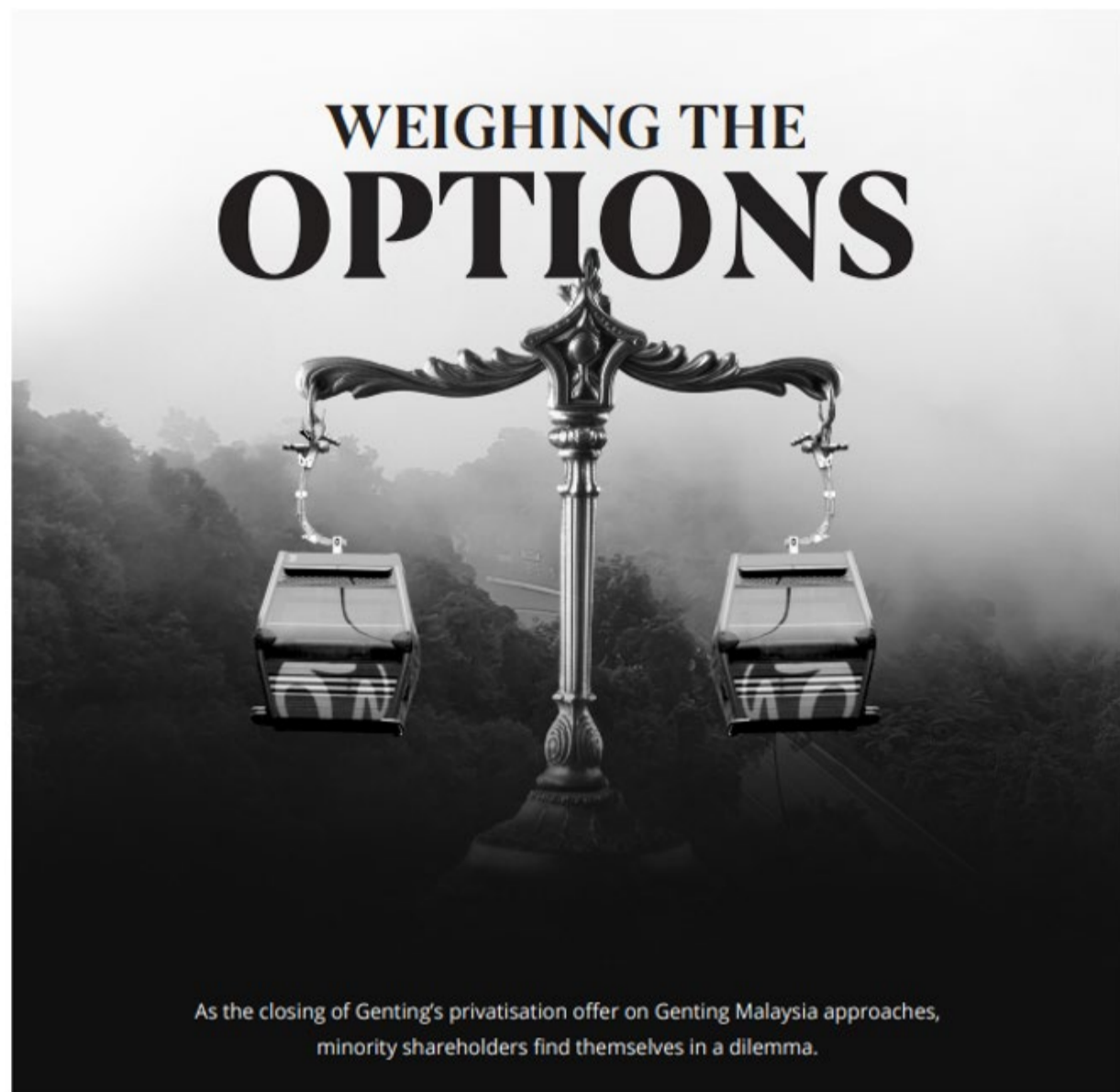

A BIRD IN HAND OR TWO IN THE BUSH?

To the minority shareholder fraternity, Genting Berhad's privatisation bid for Genting Malaysia Berhad (GenM) delivers a sobering reminder that patience may not always yield fruit when the controlling shareholder decides to take home the crown jewel on its terms.

On paper, the RM2.35 offer price per share allows some investors to lock in a modest premium and sidestep future volatility. Rejecting it, however, keeps alive the possibility of material upside, especially the profound value that could come from GenM winning a full casino licence in New York downtown. But that choice also exposes minority shareholders to prolonged uncertainties.

For years, both Genting and GenM's share prices languished. Then, on 13 October 2025, Genting jolted the market with its RM6.7 billion proposal to buy out GenM, or RM2.35 per share – at only a 10% premium to its last traded price prior to the date of the Notice of the offer.

The offer is conditional upon Genting receiving enough acceptance to raise its shareholding above 50% of its voting shares in GenM. Genting held a 49.36% stake in GenM when the said deal was announced.

If successful, the RM6.7 billion privatisation exercise would mark the exit of a company listed on the Malaysian stock exchange almost four decades ago. It is also the largest privatisation deal since the takeover of Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad, worth RM12 billion early this year.

Then known as Resorts World Bhd, GenM assumed its present name in 2009 – some 20 years after its shares were first traded on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia on 22 December 1989. Meanwhile, Genting was listed on the local bourse much earlier on 28 December 1971.

PECULIAR TIMING

The timing of the offer raised immediate eyebrows. It coincided almost perfectly with GenM's high-stakes bid for a full casino licence in the borough of Queens, New York, where decisions are expected as early as 1 December.

GenM proposed a US\$5.5 billion resort next to the Aqueduct racetrack in Queens, offering US\$600 million for the licence and taxes of 56% on slots and 30% on table games.

GenM, once a market darling, never recovered to pre-COVID levels, partly weighed down by legacy related-party transactions (RPTs) that gradually saw the Company take control of the loss-making Empire Resorts LLC from the founding Lim family.

To aggravate matters, both Genting and GenM have also been booted out of the FBM KLCI, Malaysia's benchmark equity index on 6 December 2024.

Against this backdrop, analysts were unsurprised that Genting's offer was met with scepticism. With the potential upside and massive free float, many expected resistance from shareholders who consider RM2.35 per offer share deeply unattractive.

On the contrary, critics argue GenM's ambitious expansion plans in New York may be far less promising than portrayed, especially following the withdrawal of major contenders such as Wynn Resorts and MGM Resorts from the bidding race.

Nonetheless, the buyout exercise has been responsible for breaking GenM's stagnant share price. It has somehow provided GenM with some tailwind effect as its share price has found stability around the RM2.36 zone, which enables the Group to record a 7.2% gain year-to-date (YTD).

In the post-earnings update as of 29 August 2025, most research houses remained cautious. There were 11 'hold', four 'sell', and only three 'buy' calls on the stock.

In the same update, Bloomberg's consensus target price was RM2.06, implying a potential 12.34% decline over the next 12 months from the current share price (21 November) of RM2.35.

NOT FAIR AND NOT REASONABLE

On 13 November 2025, Kenanga Investment Bank Berhad, the independent adviser (IA) for the exercise, recommended that shareholders reject Genting's offer price of RM2.35 per share to privatise its unit.

Kenanga IB concluded that the offer price is "not fair" as it is below GenM's sum-of-parts derived valuation. The offer price represents a discount of between 32.47% and 37.67% to GenM's estimated value of RM3.48 and RM3.77, and a 3.69% and 19.52% discount to the stock's one-year and two-year high market prices.

The IA is also of the opinion that GenM shares are relatively liquid with a two-year average monthly trading volume of 219.21 million shares, which represents 8.08% of free-float, which is above the FBM KLCI's average of 7.10%.

All in all, Kenanga IB contended that Genting's offer is "not reasonable" on the grounds that investors could sell shares on the open market if Genting can't acquire 90% to delist GenM. The price

also disregards the Group's prospects tied to the New York licence and Empire Resorts restructuring.

GenM's non-interested directors echoed this view. They concur with Kenanga IB's opinion that the offer is "not fair" and "not reasonable", recommending shareholders reject the offer.

ACCEPT OR REJECT?

The offer turned unconditional on 3 November 2025 after the cumulative stake held by Genting and its parties acting in concert crossed the 50% mark.

As of 18 November, Genting owned 3.44 billion, or 60.61% of GenM shares.

The deadline has been extended to 1 December 2025, but minority shareholders now find themselves boxed in. The controlling shareholder has time, resources, and multiple levers. Minority shareholders have only one question left: accept now, or fight and hope?

On the one hand, GenM's minority shareholders must surely be glad to see that the estimated value of their stock is much higher than the takeover price, reaffirming the notion that the counter indeed has significant upside. It further reinforces the belief to hold out for a potentially better deal.

Conversely, many long-time GenM shareholders have endured years of suppressed valuations, controversial corporate manoeuvres, and missed opportunities to unlock value. Now, just as the Company approaches a potentially game-changing milestone in the US, the buyout lands. To accept means crystallising a value that is far below the Company's intrinsic worth, but without future volatility.

In the end, each investor must measure their risk appetite and decide whether to take the "bird in hand" or hold out for the "two in the bush".
