Mega First:

A Single-Asset Power Story Tied to Laos

SUMMARY

- Mega First Corporation Berhad (Mega First) (**BURSA:3069**) has evolved into a renewable energy-led company, with the Don Sahong hydropower plant in Laos now dominating earnings, capital deployment, and returns, while Packaging and Resources provide secondary diversification.
- The post-2020 results reflect a more stable phase, with 16% revenue CAGR, strong cash flow conversion, and ROIC averaging 14%, comfortably above WACC, although returns have been boosted by temporary tax exemptions.
- Earnings are highly concentrated in a single long-life asset tied to the Laotian economy. Key challenges include limited future growth, tax incentives that expired in 2025, and relatively high reinvestment rates.

BACKGROUND

Mega First has had a chequered operating history, with multiple ventures across resources, property, manufacturing, and energy over the past four decades. After several rounds of corporate restructuring, Mega First today operates through three core divisions.

- The **Renewable Energy** division builds and operates the 260 MW Don Sahong hydropower plant in Laos and undertakes solar photovoltaic investments.
- The **Resources** division focuses on limestone quarrying and the manufacture and trading of lime products, calcium carbonate powder, and bricks.

The **Packaging** division produces printed labels, stickers, paper bags, and flexible packaging products for a wide range of industries.

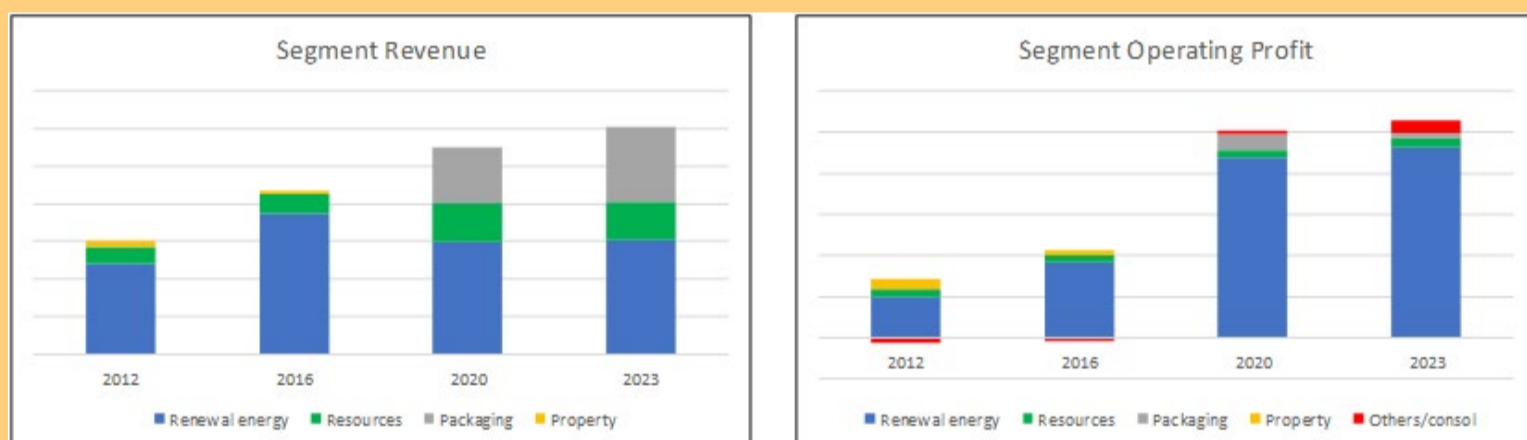


Chart 1: Segment Performance

Over the past 12 years, Renewable Energy has become the dominant earnings driver. In 2023, it contributed about half of Group revenue and 88% of operating profit, and accounted for the majority of equity deployed. **Refer to Chart 1.**

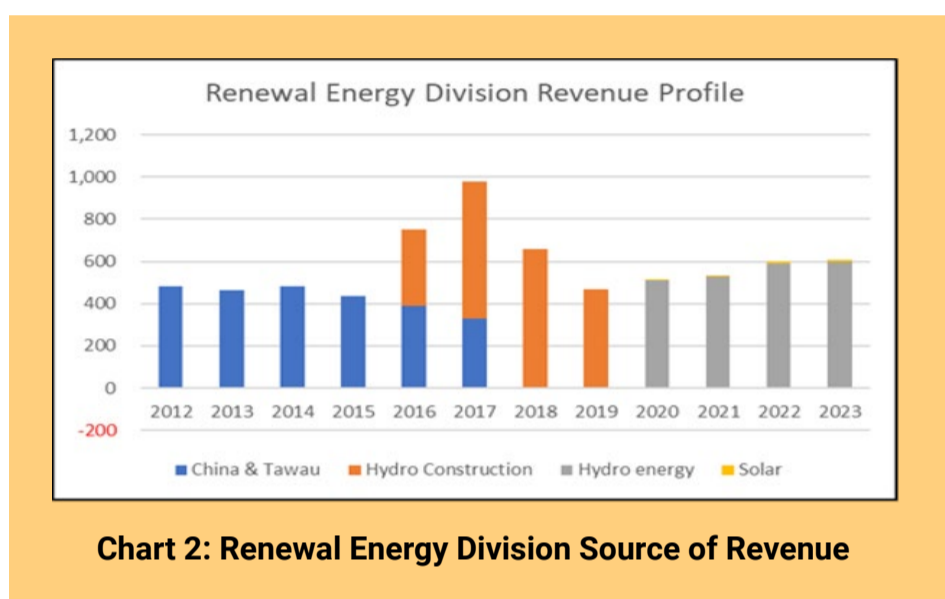
In contrast, the Property division, once a meaningful contributor, has declined in importance and has been subsumed under Investment Holdings & Others since 2020.

The Packaging division, previously reported within Investment Holdings & Others, has grown sufficiently to warrant separate

segment reporting since 2020. The Cambodia agricultural venture remains immaterial and is not separately disclosed.

RENEWAL ENERGY

Mega First’s involvement in power generation predates the Don Sahong project. Earlier contributions came from the China coal-fired plant and a 36 MW diesel-fuelled power plant in Tawau, Sabah, both of which ended in 2017.



During the construction phase of the Don Sahong project, construction-related revenue temporarily supported earnings. Following the project’s Commercial Operation Date on 1 October 2020, power sales from the hydropower plant became the

primary revenue source. **(Refer to Chart 2)**. The concession runs for 25 years until 30 September 2045.

The Group also entered rooftop solar projects in Malaysia in 2020. To date, three solar plants with a combined capacity of 14.5 MW have been commissioned, with additional small-scale projects secured. However, solar remains a minor contributor relative to hydropower.

By 2023, hydropower sales overwhelmingly dominated Renewable Energy revenue and profit. Given the scale of capital deployed and earnings concentration, Mega First is effectively a power producer tied to the Laotian economy. This raises questions about long-term growth, particularly as Laos’ real GDP growth is projected to decline between 2024 and 2029.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

Mega First's business has materially changed over the past decade.

**Please refer to the disclaimer on first page and last page.*

Accordingly, it is more meaningful to focus on the 2020 to 2024 period when assessing historical operating performance. Note that 2024 performance is based on the September 2024 LTM results.

As summarised in Table 1, Group revenue grew at a 16% CAGR from 2020 to 2024, while operating profit grew at a slower 9.3% CAGR. Revenue growth was driven primarily by the Packaging division, whereas operating profit growth came largely from the Renewable Energy division.

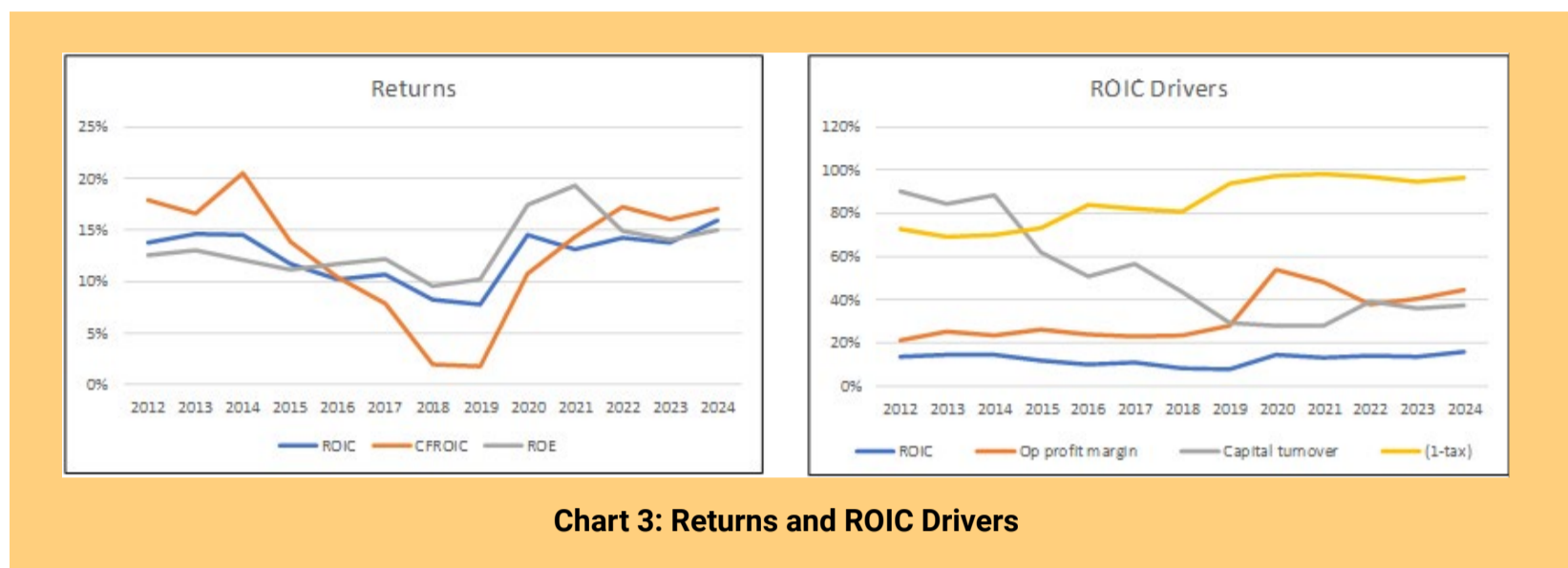

From a return perspective, Renewable Energy delivered the highest return on assets, which is encouraging given that this division accounted for about 60% of total assets in 2024. Overall returns post-2019 were superior to those in the earlier period, as shown in the **left panel of Chart 3**. Further analysis indicates that the improvement in ROIC was driven by higher capital turnover, partly offset by lower operating margins.

A notable feature of the post-2019 period is the sharp improvement in tax efficiency. From 2020 to 2024, the average effective tax rate was just 3.3%, compared with 21.9% over the 2012 to 2019 period. This reflects the tax exemption granted to the Laos hydropower subsidiary, which is exempt from income tax until 1 October 2025, after which it will be subject to a 24% corporate tax rate.

Over the 2020 to 2024 period, ROIC averaged 14%, comfortably above the current WACC of 9%. ROE averaged 16% over the same

period, compared with an estimated cost of equity of 9%. These metrics indicate that Mega First has been creating shareholder value in the post-2020 phase.



PEER COMPARISON

I found it challenging to find Bursa Malaysia peers for Mega First. Power companies such as Tenaga, YTL Power, and Malakoff are not only dedicated power generation companies, but they also have revenue that is very much larger than Mega First. As such, I focused on the smaller companies where power generation is a part of their businesses. The peers are:

- **CyPark Resources** - engages in renewable energy, construction, engineering, green technology, environment, waste management, and waste-to-energy. It produces electricity from solar, biogas, biomass, solid, and organic waste.
- **Ranhill Utilities** - The company offers water supply services. The company also owns and operates two 190 MW combined cycle gas turbine power plants with 380 megawatts total electricity production capacity in Kota Kinabalu Industrial Park.
- **Solarvest** - provides engineering, construction, and commissioning solutions for solar photovoltaic systems to residential, commercial, and industrial users. It owns, operates, and maintains a 1MW solar PV plant located in Pokok Sena, Kedah.

Table 2 compares the revenue of these 3 companies with that of Mega First. You can see that Mega First's revenue is much larger than Cypark's and Solvest's. Mega First also had the best revenue growth over the past 4 years.

Mega First demonstrated exceptional performance compared to its peers in the post-2019 period. Its leadership in return on capital, EBIT margin, free cash flow margin, and EPS growth indicates robust operational efficiency, effective capital utilization, and a strong ability to generate shareholder value.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Mega First as sound financially. The positive points here included the following:

- As of Jun 2025, it had RM382 million in cash. This is equal to 8% of its total assets.
- Over the past 13 years, it generated positive cash flow from operations every year.
- From 2020 to 2024, it generated RM2.6 billion cash flow from operations compared to the total PAT of RM2.3 billion. This is a good cash flow conversion ratio.
- It had a debt capital ratio of 0.24 as of Jun 2025.

- It had a good capital allocation plan. **Refer to Table 3.** The cash flow from operations was sufficient to fund its CAPEX and acquisitions.

My main concern was the reinvestment rate. This metric measures the reinvestment.

Reinvestment rate = Reinvestment / NOPAT.

Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisition – Depreciation & Amortization + net increase in Working Capital.

Over the past decade, Mega First had an average reinvestment rate of 72%. The high reinvestment rate meant that there was not much NOPAT left to distribute to shareholders. I suspect that the high rate was because of the investments in the construction of the hydro plant.

The good news is that the average reinvestment rate from 2020 to 2024 has come down to 51%. It is still a bit on the high side. I hope it can come down further.

VALUATION

I adopted a mature-company framework in valuing Mega First. **(Refer to the original article for details).**

The base revenue was set at the 2024 level and assumed a 4% perpetual growth rate.

In terms of operating assumptions, I did not assume any improvement in operating margins. Instead, I assumed that the Group would gradually reduce its reinvestment intensity. I used the average 2020 to 2024 contribution margin as the steady-state margin and applied a reinvestment margin that resulted in a 51% reinvestment rate.

I also assumed that the tax incentives in Laos would fully expire. Accordingly, a normalized corporate tax rate of 24% was applied in the valuation.

Based on these assumptions, the estimated intrinsic value is RM4.00 per share, compared with the market price of RM3.70 per share (end Jun 2025).

CONCLUSION

Mega First has effectively transformed into a renewable energy-led business, anchored by the Don Sahong hydropower plant in Laos. This asset now dominates earnings, capital deployment, and returns, while the Resources and Packaging divisions provide supplementary diversification.

The post-2020 period reflects a more stable and economically meaningful phase. The Group has delivered solid revenue growth, strong operating cash flow, and returns on capital comfortably above its cost of capital. Capital allocation has been disciplined, leverage remains manageable, and cash flow conversion has been good.

However, the investment case is not without its constraints. Earnings are highly concentrated in a single long-life asset tied to the Laotian economy, which itself offers limited structural growth. Returns over the past five years have also benefited from temporary tax

exemptions that will expire in 2025. While reinvestment intensity has moderated following completion of the hydropower project, it remains relatively high, limiting free cash flow available for shareholders.

In summary, Mega First is a fundamentally sound company with proven execution and value creation in the post-2020 period. However, it has a limited margin of safety.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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Bursa Malaysia to focus on market vibrancy and deepening investor participation – Dato' Fad'l

According to Bursa Malaysia Berhad CEO Dato' Fad'l Mohamed, the exchange will focus on increasing market vibrancy, a robust IPO pipeline and thematic ETFs for greater investor participation as its growth strategy beyond 2026.

During his presentation on the stock exchange's outlook for 2026 and beyond, he said the first key strategic priority is to strengthen vibrancy across all markets while continuing to enhance its product breadth which includes the listing of new thematic ETFs and ensuring a robust and quality IPO pipeline. Large IPOs, defined as listings with a market capitalisation of RM1 billion and above, will be encouraged to boost market depth and trading interest. Another key area is to intensify efforts to scale up SMEs via capital markets through strategic partnerships.

Bursa will also focus on enhancing the market ecosystem through a multi-year, multi-programme initiative that will strengthen corporate performance and increase visibility of Malaysian PLCs.

Growing non-trading revenue streams

In its strategy to expand non-trading revenue streams, he said Bursa will accelerate growth in its data and digital services. He noted that

over the past five years, revenue from the data business grew at a CAGR of 11%, rising from RM48.2 million in 2020 to RM81.4 million in 2025. Bursa will continue to scale its data business beyond traditional market data into newer domains such as sustainability which includes a marketplace offering sustainability tools and solutions, as well as further monetising proprietary datasets using artificial intelligence (AI).

Connectivity as a growth lever

Dato' Fad'l said that connectivity will also be a growth lever, with Bursa exploring potential strategic partnerships and M&A opportunities in 2026 for the acquisition of new distribution channels and technology capabilities.

Strategic Roadmap for 2027-2030

Bursa will explore and evaluate new opportunities as an integral part of its new strategic roadmap for 2027-2030 where potential expansion into the post-trade ecosystem will be considered. Technology resilience and innovation readiness, both described as "mission critical", will include modernising core systems, strengthening cybersecurity and building internal AI capabilities through proof-of-concept initiatives with strategic partners.

KPIs for 2026

Dato' Fad'l also unveiled Bursa's headline KPIs for 2026. These include:

- ROE target of between 27% and 30%;
- non-trading revenue growth of more than 10% from FY2025, reflecting an increase from a previous target of 5%-7%;
- aiming for total IPO market capitalisation of RM28 billion in 2026;
- pledge to cut Scope 1 and 2 emissions by at least 25% from FY2022 levels, having already achieved a 22% reduction in 2025.

He added that on the macro front, the economic outlook for 2026 remains positive, supported by improving indicators, resilient bond

yields, the Ringgit's performance, as well as the government's commitment to fiscal consolidation, with a targeted deficit of 3.5% in 2026.

He noted the FBM KLCI continues to trade at a valuation discount, with a forward PE ratio of 14.7x compared with its 10-year average of 17x, while foreign buying sentiment is expected to remain favourable amid Malaysia's strong current account position and resilient exports. These factors collectively support a constructive outlook for the marketplace as we move into 2026 and beyond.

Foreign funds log third straight week of net inflows at RM510.9m — MBSB IB

According to MBSB Investment Bank Bhd (MBSB IB), last week (Jan 19-23), foreign investors remained net buyers for a third consecutive week, recording RM510.9 million in net foreign inflows. However, in its fund flow report for the week ended Jan 23, it said that the week-on-week decline in inflows marked a moderation from the prior week's RM716.1 million.

It noted that the inflow remained supportive of overall market liquidity, with foreign investors continuing to provide a positive net contribution despite mixed participation from domestic investors. Foreign investors were mostly net buyers during the week, with the largest inflow recorded last Wednesday (RM215.4 million), followed by Thursday (RM167.8 million), Friday (RM132.8 million) and Monday (RM12.4 million). They net sold on Tuesday (RM17.5 million).

The top three sectors that recorded net foreign inflows were financial services (RM407.5 million), followed by industrial products and services (RM148.6 million), and consumer products and services (RM87.8 million). Meanwhile, the top three sectors that recorded net foreign outflows were healthcare (RM141.8 million), construction (RM40.9 million), and utilities (RM19.5 million).

The local institutions returned to net buying, recording RM853.0 million in net inflows, reversing the previous week's net selling of RM588.2 million.

It noted that local retailers were net sellers for the eighth consecutive week, with a net outflow of RM1.36 million last week.

The average daily trading volume (ADTV) saw a broad-based increase - local retailers by 18.4% and local institutions by 0.3% while foreign investors saw a decline of 12.2%.

On the regional front, foreign investors across eight Asian markets saw net foreign selling intensify for a second consecutive week, with total net outflows widening to US\$2.76 billion (RM10.96 billion) in the week under review, from US\$954.6 million in the previous week ended Jan 16, 2026.

This aggregate decline was primarily driven by a massive acceleration in selling from India, which overwhelmed consistent buying across most of the Asean region. MBSB IB added that excluding India and Vietnam, all other tracked markets recorded net foreign inflows during the period.



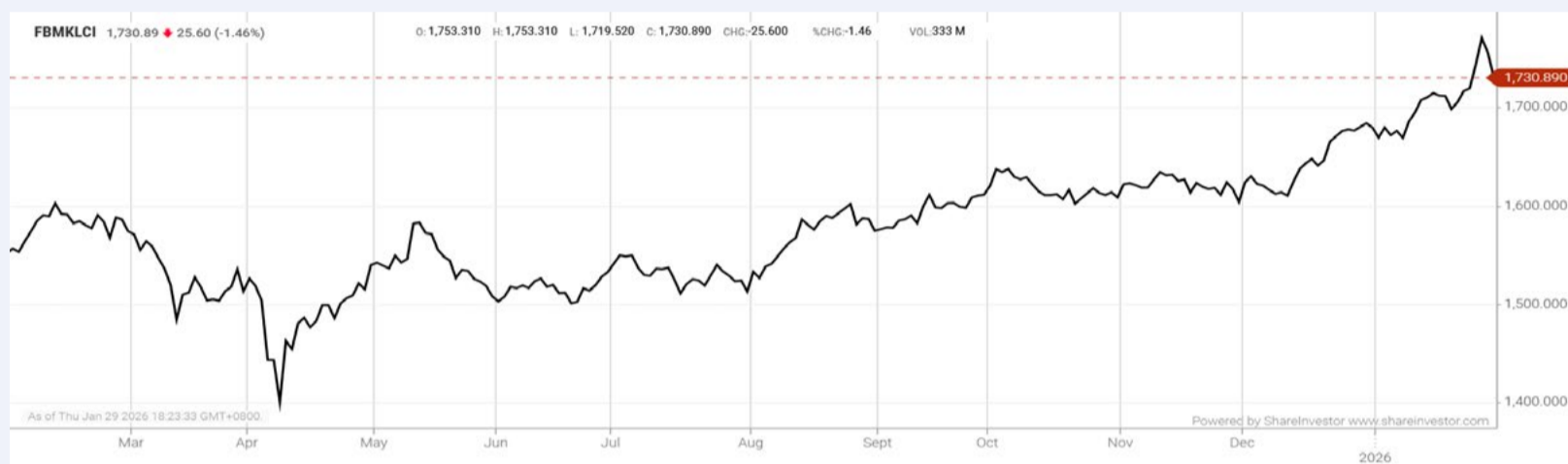
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EYE ON THE MARKETS

UNEXPECTED TWIST AT KAREX'S AGM

At its 13th AGM on 28 November 2025, the world's largest condom manufacturer, Karex Berhad, tabled eight resolutions for voting, seven of which were passed.

The one rejected was "Ordinary Resolution 2", the proposed re-election of Dato' Edward Siew Mun Wai, who was retiring in accordance with Clause 97 of the Company's constitution and had offered himself for re-election. Siew had served as an independent non-executive director (INED) of Karex since November 2020.

What set tongues wagging was not merely the rejection itself, but the peculiar circumstances surrounding it. Despite being formally recommended by Karex's Nomination Committee and the Board ahead of the AGM, Siew was booted out decisively. By contrast, resolutions to re-elect three other INEDs were passed with unanimous shareholder support.

The voting breakdown tells the story. While 103 shareholders representing 109.04 million shares (15.36%) voted in Siew's favour, 22 shareholders with an overwhelming 600.86 million shares—equivalent to 84.64% of total shares voted—blocked the resolution. The message was clear: the seasoned accountant had fallen out of favour with Karex's controlling shareholders.

To add credence to the irony, the board had earlier assured shareholders during the AGM that it was satisfied with the company's board structure and composition, only to dispense with an independent director hours later.

Following what transpired at the AGM, Siew ceased to hold office as a Karex's director, chairman of the Remuneration Committee (RC), and members of the Risk Management, Audit and ESOS Committees.

NOT SHORT OF CORPORATE EXPOSURE

Siew was first appointed to the Karex board on 27 November 2020 as an INED and a member of the AC.

On 29 November 2021, he was redesignated as chairman of the RC and AC before being redesignated from the latter as a member on 2 January 2025. On the same date, he ceased to be a member of the NC.

A check on Siew's professional background suggests that – on paper at least – his experience fits the bill as the 'right man for the job'.

A Fellow Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales (ICAEW), he spent over eight years in public practice in London before returning to Malaysia. After a brief stint with a local bank, he joined HSBC's Hong Kong headquarters.

This was followed by over 26 years of C-suite roles at multinational companies, i.e., the L'Oreal Group, Ciba-Geigy (now Novartis) Group, which entailed managing their subsidiaries in Melbourne, Seoul,

Paris, Bangkok, Singapore, Jakarta, Taipei and Hong Kong.

Following his repatriation to Malaysia on the Talent Corp programme, Siew was the acting global CEO/CFO of Crabtree & Evelyn London until its divestment.

Insofar as PLCs are concerned, from 2011-2014, he was an independent director and audit committee chairman of an ASX (Australian Securities Exchange)-listed junior mining company. Siew presently sits on the board of directors of Malton Bhd and Prestar Resources Bhd as an INED.

In short, this was hardly a novice director cutting his teeth.

CONFLICT OF OPINION?

Against the backdrop of Siew's professional credentials, the voting pattern showed that the rejection stemmed from the founding and controlling Goh family.

The Goh family and their relatives own a direct 47.08% or 495.875 million shares as of 26 September 2025 – a level that is sufficient to determine the outcome of any ordinary resolution.

Insofar as minority shareholders' interest is concerned, INEDs play an important role in corporations with their objective oversight to ensure transparency and accountability while safeguarding shareholders' interests as they are not encumbered by material relationships with the company's management.

It is therefore not uncommon for INEDs, who are often armed with decades of global corporate experience, to challenge or disagree with controlling shareholders, sometimes unknowingly stepping on sensitive toes in the process.

This is very much expected that independent directors who are also professionals in their fields with extensive industry experience, are well-aware of the need for good governance, timely corporate disclosures and compliance with regulations.

Seasoned professionals, particularly those steeped in multinational

governance standards, tend to be acutely aware of the imperatives of transparency, timely disclosure and regulatory compliance—traits that can occasionally sit uneasily with entrenched control.

Such tensions are neither unusual nor unhealthy. In fact, they are often the norm of a functioning board, where independent directors are expected to probe, question and, where appropriate, push back. Ideally, these differences are resolved through robust debate in pursuit of outcomes that serve the company and all shareholders.

AN UNANSWERED QUESTION

Why, then, was an INED with fewer than nine years' tenure—endorsed by the nomination committee and the board—suddenly deemed unsuitable by shareholders holding decisive voting power? What caused the change of mind within a short span of time?

Was the rejection driven by concerns over the director's performance, competence, commitment or independence? If these were indeed the issues, why were they not flagged earlier through the NC and board's evaluation process?

That question is likely to remain unanswered. Minority shareholders are almost certainly to be kept in the dark about the real reasons behind Siew's abrupt exit.

What is clear is that this unexpected voting outcome may be read as more than a routine boardroom reshuffle. To some, it could well be a red flag—an early signal that all may not be entirely harmonious beneath the surface at Karex.
