SUMMARY

- New Hoong Fatt Holdings Berhad (NHF) (Bursa:7060) operates in a low-growth automotive parts market. From 2013 to 2024, revenue grew at 2.8% CAGR, below market growth. Profit growth was higher but uneven, and long-term returns remained below the cost of capital.
- Management has consistently emphasized cost control and manufacturing efficiency. While some metrics improved (e.g., operating margins, cash conversion cycle), others deteriorated (e.g., gross profitability, asset turnover), indicating uneven execution and persistent asset-utilization challenges.
- The Group is debt-free, cash-rich, and consistently cash-generative, with good cash-flow conversion and disciplined capital allocation. These characteristics reduce financial risk and support sustainability despite limited growth.

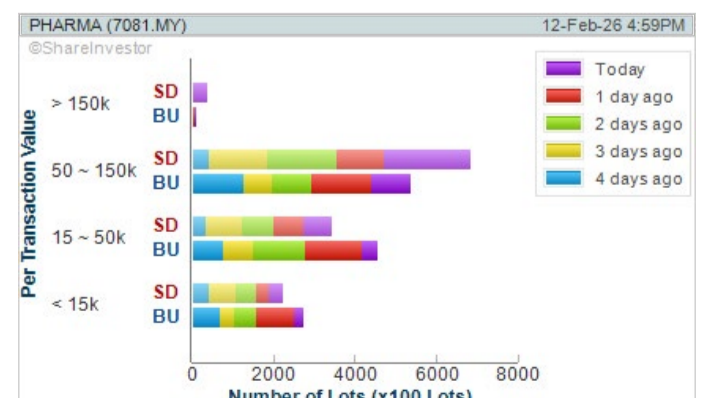

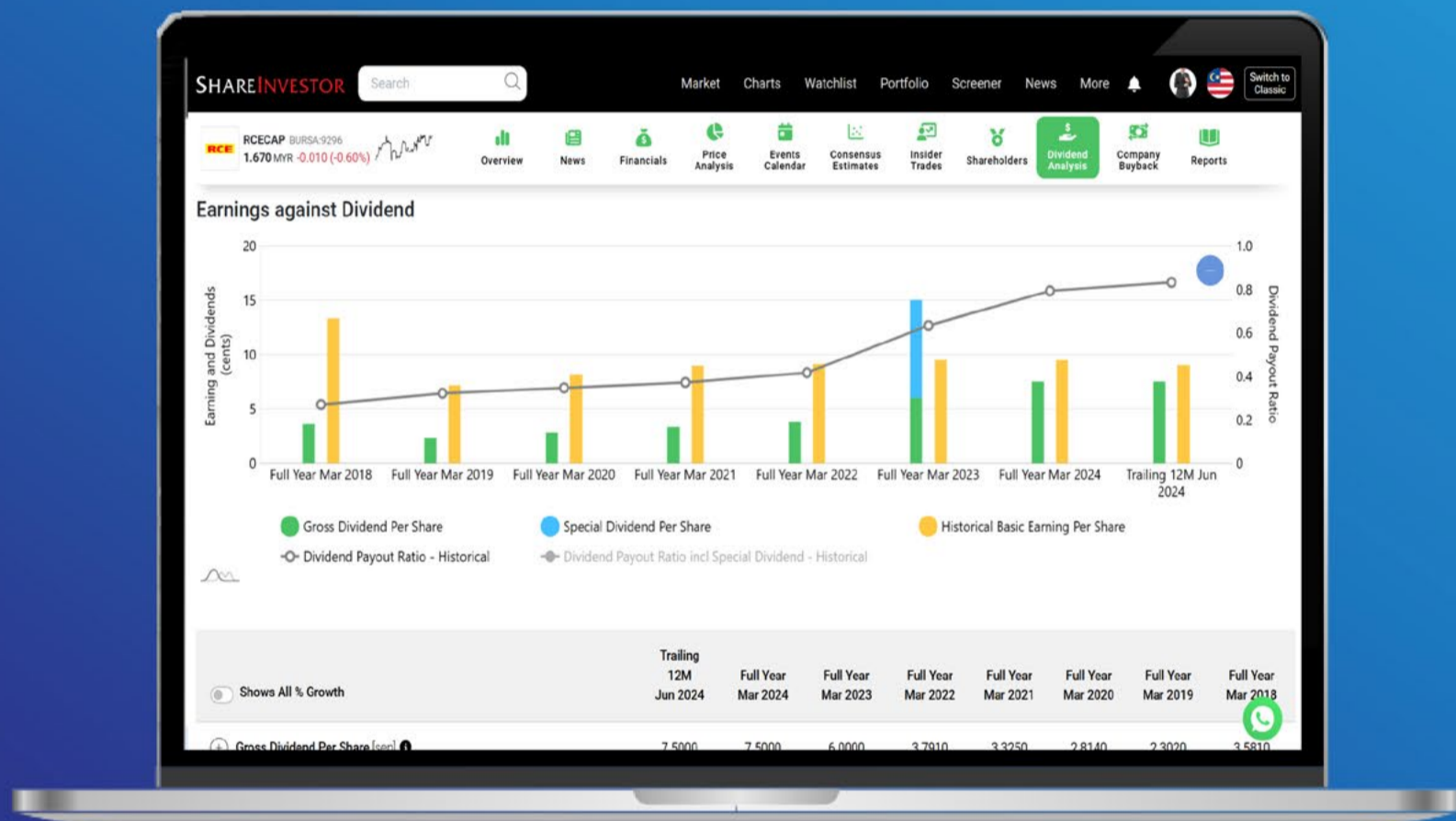

- New Hoong Fatt Holdings Berhad (NHF) (**BURSA:7060**) operates in a low-growth automotive parts market. From 2013 to 2024, revenue grew at 2.8% CAGR, below market growth. Profit growth was higher but uneven, and long-term returns remained below the cost of capital.
- Management has consistently emphasized cost control and manufacturing efficiency. While some metrics improved (e.g., operating margins, cash conversion cycle), others deteriorated (e.g., gross profitability, asset turnover), indicating uneven execution and persistent asset-utilization challenges.
- The Group is debt-free, cash-rich, and consistently cash-generative, with good cash-flow conversion and disciplined capital allocation. These characteristics reduce financial risk and support sustainability despite limited growth.

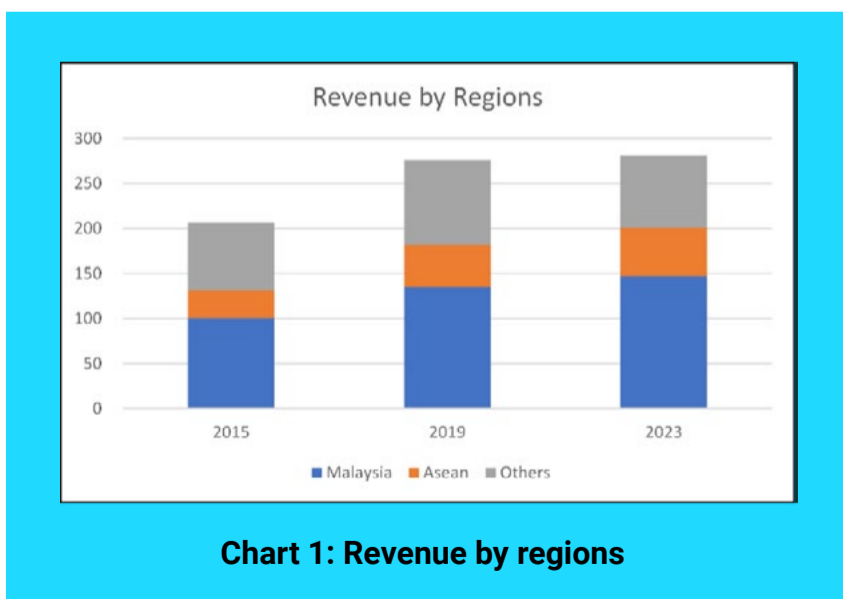
BACKGROUND

NHF began operations in 1977 as a trading company selling original and alternative automotive parts. Over time, it grew into one of Malaysia’s leading automotive parts distributors. In 1989, the Group expanded into manufacturing, producing metal and plastic components such as doors, hoods, fenders, and bumpers. Supported by modern production facilities and in-house design capabilities, NHF became a major player in Malaysia’s alternative car parts market.

The Group was listed on the Second Board of the Malaysian Stock Exchange in 1998 and transferred to the Main Board of Bursa Malaysia in 2001. In 2011, NHF expanded internationally with subsidiaries in Jakarta, Indonesia, and Shanghai, China, focusing on the trading and distribution of automotive parts.

NHF today serves more than 1,000 wholesalers and retailers nationwide and exports to over 50 countries across Asia, Central and South America, Europe, and Africa.

Before 2017, the Group reported its performance under manufacturing, trading, and investment segments. From 2017 onwards, manufacturing and trading were combined into a single operating segment, with performance presented by geographic region. As shown in **Chart 1**, Malaysia contributes roughly half of the Group’s revenue.



Since 2016, NHF has articulated its key strategic thrusts in its Annual Reports, summarized in **Table 1**. Overall, the Group’s stated direction reflects consistency and adaptability, a clear focus on strengthening its core business, and a long-term commitment to operational excellence and workforce development.

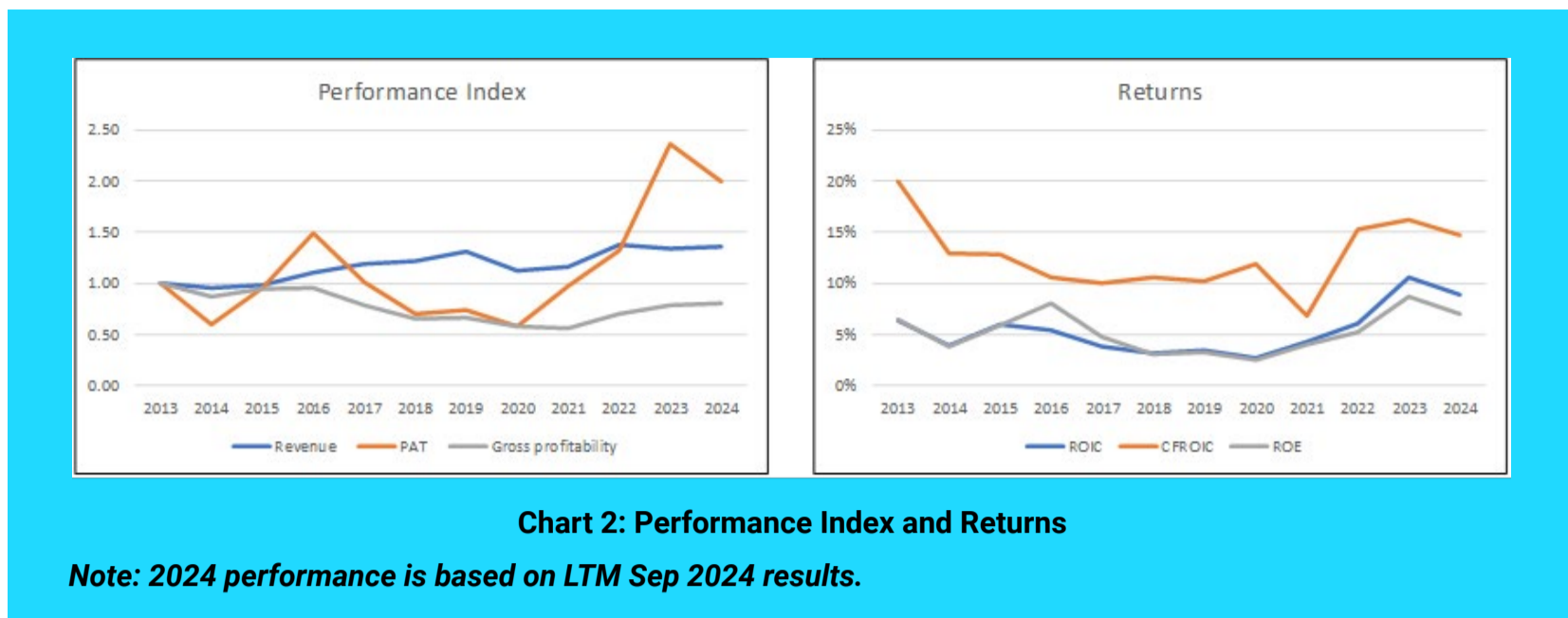
OPERATING PERFORMANCE

From 2013 to 2024, NHF’s revenue grew at a modest 2.8% CAGR. The automotive parts and accessories market in Malaysia is mature, with single-digit growth. Regional growth trends are broadly similar.

When benchmarked against industry growth projections, this suggests that NHF accounts for well below 1% of the total addressable market. More importantly, assuming that projected market growth broadly reflects historical trends, NHF’s revenue growth lagged the market, implying a loss of market share. This is not an encouraging outcome, given that market growth has been one of the Group’s stated strategic thrusts.

The more positive development is that profit after tax grew at a higher 6.5% CAGR over the same period (**see left panel of Chart 2**). However, profit growth was uneven.

The sharp spike in 2016 was attributed by management to stronger revenue, improved production efficiency, and favourable foreign exchange movements. This performance proved unsustainable, with profits declining in 2017 due to rising raw material costs and adverse currency effects. Despite continued revenue growth thereafter, PAT only recovered to its 2016 level by 2022/23.



Given the profit trajectory, it is unsurprising that returns followed a similar pattern (**right panel of Chart 2**). While returns have shown signs of recovery following the Covid-19 period, long-term performance remains weak. Over the past 12 years, ROIC averaged 5.4%, and ROE averaged 5.2%, both below the estimated cost of capital. This indicates that the Group has not created shareholder value.

EFFICIENCY AND EXECUTION

In a low-growth environment, improvements in efficiency are critical. Management has consistently emphasized this focus in its Annual Reports over the years, highlighting initiatives to improve manufacturing efficiency, optimize costs, and reduce waste.

To assess whether these efforts translated into measurable outcomes, I analysed:

- The breakdown of operating profits into fixed and variable costs (**Chart 3, left panel**);
- The decomposition of ROIC into its key drivers (**Chart 3, right panel**); and
- The long-term trends in operating and capital efficiency metrics. (**Chart 4**)

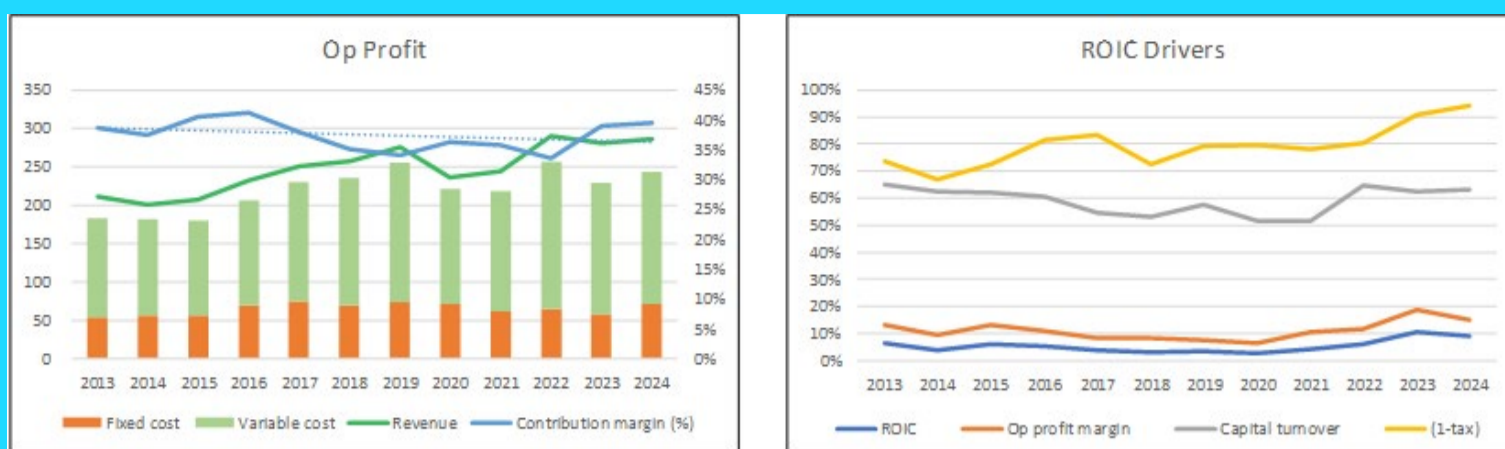


Chart 3: Operating Profit and ROIC Drivers

Note to Op Model: I broke down the operating profits into fixed costs and variable costs.

- **Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization and Others.**
- **Variable cost = Cost of Sales that excluded Depreciation & Amortization.**
- **Contribution = Revenue – Variable Cost.**
- **Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.**

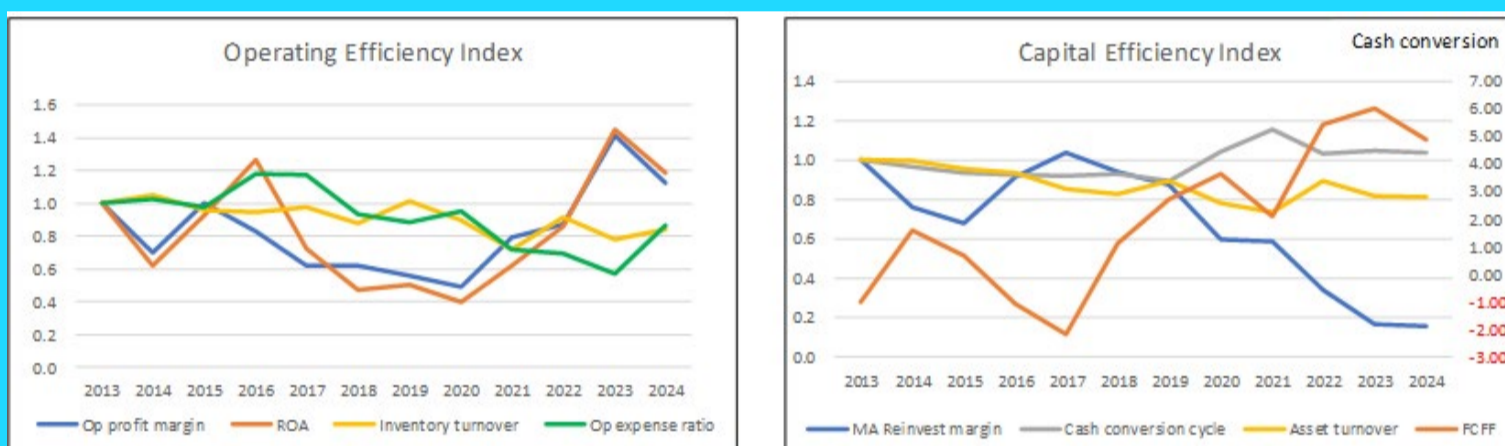


Chart 4: Efficiency trends

The results have been mixed over the past 12 years. As can be seen from these charts, while there were improving trends (e.g., operating profit margin and cash conversion cycle), there were also declining ones (e.g., gross profitability and asset turnover)

The improving metrics point to better operational discipline and incremental efficiency gains. However, the declining trends raise concerns about cost structure and asset utilization, particularly in manufacturing and inventory management. The flat SGA margin suggests stability, but not meaningful leverage.

Overall, I would have expected more consistent improvements given management’s long-standing emphasis on efficiency. That said, it is reasonable to argue that without this strategic focus, operating performance might have deteriorated further.

Despite the mixed signals, the Group appears better positioned today than it was 12 years ago. The number of improving metrics outweighs the declining ones, and the clarity of its strategic thrusts should help maintain management focus. As such, there is a reasonable basis to expect future performance to improve relative to the past, provided the Group can arrest the declining trends in profitability and asset efficiency.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate the Group as sound financially based on the following:

- As of Sep 2025, it had RM156 million in cash. This is equal to 24% of its total assets.
- As of Sep 2025, it had a zero debt-capital ratio.
- From 2013 to 2024, it generated positive cash flow from operations every year. During this period, it generated RM632 million cash flow from operations compared to the total PAT of RM276 million. This is a very good cash flow conversion ratio.
- It has a low average Reinvestment rate of 23% over the past 12 years.
- It had a good capital allocation plan. (Refer to Table 2). The cash flow from operations was sufficient to fund its CAPEX, with excess being returned to shareholders.

VALUATION

I valued NHF as a mature business with limited growth prospects, with the following assumptions. Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.

I applied a perpetual growth

rate of 2.8%, in line with its historical revenue CAGR. The base revenue was derived from the 2024 level, using a best-fit log-normal trendline to smooth year-to-year volatility.

I assumed no improvement in operating or capital efficiency. The valuation, therefore, used the 2013–2024 average contribution margin, capital turnover, and reinvestment margin as steady-state inputs. I also assumed that tax incentives have fully lapsed and applied a normalized tax rate of 24%.

On this basis, the intrinsic value is estimated at RM2.85 per share, compared with a market price of RM1.96 as at mid-2025 implying a margin of safety of more than 30%.

The implied operating outcomes are reasonable. The model generates an ROIC of about 6%, slightly above the 12-year historical average of 5%, and an average EPS of RM0.17 compared with the past five-year average of RM0.14.

Overall, the assumptions are conservative rather than aggressive.

CONCLUSION

New Hoong Fatt is a mature automotive parts company operating in a low-growth and competitive market. Over the past decade, the Group has delivered modest revenue growth that has lagged the market. While profitability has grown faster than revenue, earnings have been volatile, and long-term returns remain below the cost of capital, indicating that shareholder value creation has been inconsistent.

That said, NHF is financially sound. This provides resilience and downside protection, particularly important in a mature industry with limited growth prospects. Operationally, efficiency initiatives have produced mixed results, but the balance of evidence suggests that the Group is better positioned today than it was 12 years ago.

From a valuation perspective, the stock appears undervalued as at mid-2025. Overall, NHF does not appear to be a high-growth

compounder, but neither does it fit the profile of a value trap. The key risk remains the Group's ability to arrest declining efficiency trends and translate its strategic intent into sustained improvements in returns.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

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Bursa Malaysia and Teraju collaborate to propel Bumiputera companies towards IPO

Bursa Malaysia Berhad has entered into a Memorandum of Collaboration with Unit Peneraju Agenda Bumiputera (TERAJU) to jointly support and facilitate the participation of Bumiputera companies in the Malaysian capital market through IPO listings. As the national exchange, Bursa Malaysia serves as a vital bridge between businesses, capital and investors. In line with this aspiration, the collaboration seeks to empower Bumiputera companies and enhance market diversity, unlocking new opportunities for investor engagement and economic growth.

Under the MoC, Bursa Malaysia will collaborate with TERAJU to guide and equip high potential Bumiputera companies towards the compliance of the IPO listing requirements and getting these companies ready for IPO. This includes providing IPO-related advisory support, facilitating networking opportunities with capital market intermediaries, and delivering targeted capacity-building programmes.

Meanwhile, TERAJU will play a vital role in identifying promising Bumiputera companies for participation in IPO readiness programmes, facilitating access to essential funding and incentives to support their transition to the public market, and coordinating with various stakeholders - including government agencies, financial institutions, and industry experts - to provide a holistic support system throughout the listing process.

Dato' Fad'l Mohamed, Chief Executive Officer of Bursa Malaysia said, "We look forward to collaborating with TERAJU to strengthen Bumiputera companies' representation in the capital market. This initiative aligns with national ambitions under Pelan Transformasi Ekonomi Bumiputera (PuTERA35), which targets 30% Bumiputera equity ownership by 2035, signalling a broader and more inclusive economic future. There is considerable untapped potential among Bumiputera companies, and we are committed to supporting them in taking the next step towards becoming listed companies."

He added, "This collaboration underscores the Exchange's proactive approach in building a strong IPO pipeline through deliberate and sustained engagement with potential issuers, working hand-in-hand with ecosystem partners such as TERAJU."

Junady Nawawi, Chief Executive Officer of TERAJU said, "The MoC marks a strategic and firm commitment to supporting Bumiputera companies on their journey towards a successful IPO - a process that requires guidance, planning, and strong discipline. This initiative focuses on addressing the missing middle - mid-sized Bumiputera companies with strong growth potential that often fall between existing support frameworks. Through this collaboration with Bursa Malaysia, we are opening pathways for more Bumiputera companies to participate and thrive in the capital market through the implementation of targeted programmes and initiatives."

In addition to this MoC, Bursa Malaysia's subsidiary, Bursa Malaysia RAM Capital Sdn Bhd, has separately entered into a Letter of Collaboration with TERAJU to support financing facilitation

and capital market readiness initiatives for eligible Bumiputera enterprises. This initiative complements the broader ecosystem objectives of the MoC, enabling Bumiputera companies to scale up their businesses and develop a stronger, more IPO ready pipeline for listing on Bursa Malaysia.

Dividend upside more likely in large banks as capital management becomes key driver - MBSB Research

According to MBSB Research, dividend upsides will likely come from larger-to-mid-sized banks, as smaller banks are constrained by their aggressive business development. Smaller banks' need to retain more capital to support growth, and are likely to limit their ability to raise dividends.

In a note, the research house said the industry's gross impaired loan (GIL) ratio is at a record low, meaning banks currently have very few bad loans and their asset quality is strong. Because credit risk is low, banks may be able to operate with slightly lower common equity Tier 1 (CET1) ratios - the core capital buffer used to absorb losses - without risking financial stability.

It also noted that loan growth has been weaker than expected, largely dragged by weakness in business loans. Slower growth reduces the need for capital to support new lending, creating additional room for capital returns to shareholders - similar to what was seen in calendar year 2025. It added that ultimately it would be Bank Negara Malaysia's decision to make. Even with slower loan growth, the research house remains positive on the sector, pointing to how banks manage their capital is becoming the main driver of share price gains.

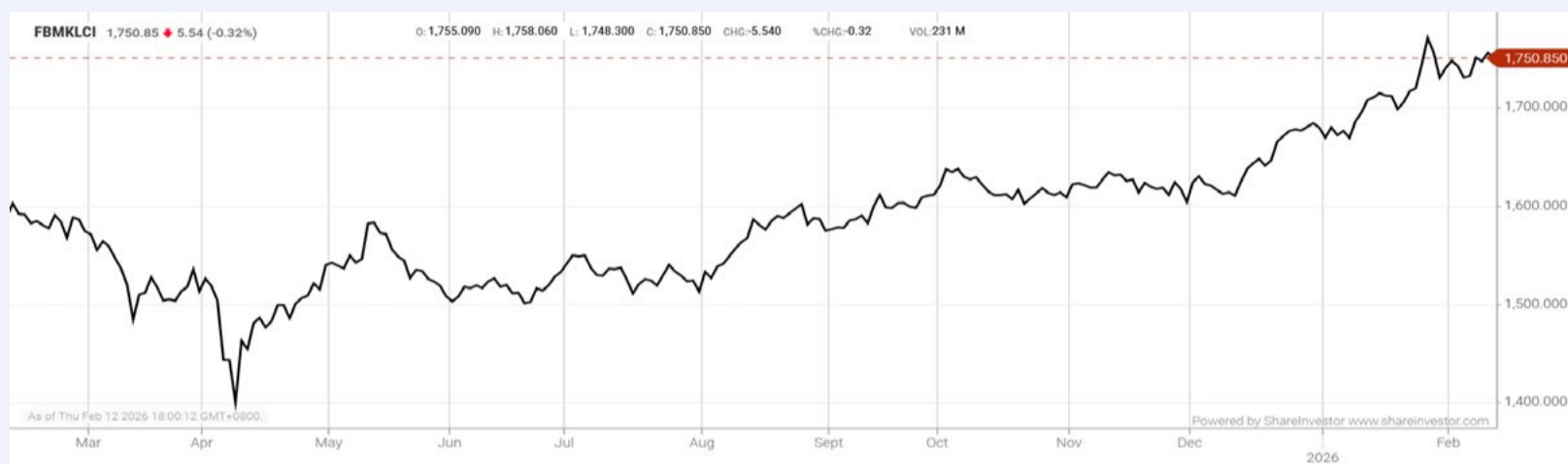
MBSB Research is of the opinion that CIMB's surprise dividend announcement last quarter spurred the rally. With momentum tapering as of late, it looks at further dividend allocations and guidance in this quarter for other catalysts of a similar nature. Banks that it is most optimistic about are CIMB Group Holdings Bhd, RHB Bank Bhd and AMMB Holdings Bhd.

The research house noted that CIMB set the tone after announcing RM2 billion in special dividends to be distributed across 2025 and 2026. The group's approach combines a sustainable 55% regular payout ratio with a flexible special dividend component, allowing it to release excess capital without permanently committing to a higher base payout. MBSB Research is of the view that this structure is a more effective and regulator-friendly mechanism for capital distribution compared with dividend reinvestment plans. It added that the banking sector still maintains solid fundamentals, though share valuations are less attractive.

SCRUTINISING THE SCRUTINEERS

You may not notice it, but they are always there.

Their presence might be overlooked by many. Standing quietly at the edges of general meetings, often behind registration counters or near the polling booths, scrutineers are a constant presence, yet rarely acknowledged and questioned.

To many shareholders, they fade into the background. But, without them, the integrity of voting at general meetings would rest on far shakier ground.

Scrutineers are an essential, if understated, part of the mechanism that underpins transparency at shareholders' meetings. Appointed to act independently and impartially, they are meant to ensure that voting outcomes genuinely reflect shareholders' wishes. They are the quiet guardians of vote integrity, critical to governance, yet their presence and roles are largely undiscussed by the investing public.

WHAT SCRUTINEERS ACTUALLY DO

A scrutineer is an independent party appointed by the company ahead of general meetings to validate poll results. Their work begins well before the meeting is called to order.

Often, they can be seen closely examining registration procedures, scrutinising proxy documentation, and keeping a watchful eye on ballot forms. Their task is to ensure that votes cast by shareholders are accurately matched to shareholdings and that no vote carries more or less weight than it should.

But their roles go far beyond this.

Before the meeting doors open, scrutineers work with the poll administrators to understand the voting method to be used in the meeting, whether electronic voting via handheld devices, kiosks, or traditional manual ballots.

They ensure the integrity of ballot forms, electronic devices and polling procedures, and stay alert to weaknesses that could expose the process to error or tampering.

They also validate proxy forms, verifying proxies' identities, shareholdings, form submission deadlines and compliance with procedural requirements. This includes liaising with the share registrar to ensure that the Record of Depositors is accurate and up to date – 48 hours prior to the general meeting.

Once the meeting is underway, the scrutineers' role becomes more visible, though still largely out of sight. They observe how voting is conducted, how ballots are distributed and collected, or how votes are submitted electronically. They ensure that voting follows the prescribed procedures and the chairman's instructions.

This is where their role can become particularly critical. Scrutineers are expected to identify duplicate voting, monitor abstentions and ensure exclusions are properly applied, such as in related party transactions. When disputes arise over events like shareholders' or proxies' eligibility to vote, the scrutineer is expected to step in and address the issue.

After voting closes, together with the poll administrator, scrutineers count and verify votes, reconciling ballots cast against issued share capital and valid proxies. They verify votes for, against, and abstentions, resolution by resolution, before confirming the final voting results for chairman's announcement.

Once announced, the voting results bearing the stamp of the scrutineer are uploaded to Bursa Malaysia's website and recorded in the meeting minutes. For regulators, investors, and the public, that confirmation is treated as a seal of procedural credibility over the general meeting held.

THE UNEASE BENEATH THE SURFACE

The presence of scrutineers is beyond procedural. Their appointment is mandated under Bursa Malaysia Listing Requirements (LRs) to serve as a governance safeguard, more so when voting outcomes are tight, contested, or voting transparency is in question.

A case in point involved South Malaysia Industries Berhad, whose outcomes of its adjourned 53rd AGM held on 8 December 2025 intrigued us. Voting results shown 74.3% of the total shares voted (or approximately 105.08 million shares) were disqualified for Resolutions 1 to 5, on the grounds that "these votes refer to holders who have pre-determined abstained from voting in the proxy form or holders refrained from voting due to conflict of interest."

The explanation raised more questions than answers. First, if these shareholders had indicated an intention to abstain prior to the meeting, their shares should have been categorised and disclosed as "abstain", rather than later disqualified. Likewise, shareholders with conflicts of interest would not have cast votes in the first place.

This apparent contradiction inevitably raises concerns about the poll-voting process and brings into focus the role and effectiveness of the scrutineer in verifying and validating the voting results.

Nonetheless, despite their importance, scrutineers operate in a space that is largely under-defined.

There are no standalone regulatory framework or guidelines governing scrutineers. One source that can be referred to is the Best Practice Guide on AGMs for Listed Issuers, jointly issued by MAICSA and Bursa Malaysia. While helpful, it offers only broad principles rather than detailed standards on how scrutineers should carry out their duties.

The LRs do require scrutineers to be independent of the company, not officers of the listed issuer or its related corporations, and independent of the poll administrator. That said, beyond these general requirements, guidance on their role remains thin.

The crux of the issue is that while most PLCs appoint independent parties such as external firms or poll administrators to act as scrutineers, there remains considerable variability in how independence, competency, and reporting standards are interpreted and applied. In the absence of clear, enforceable guidelines, much depends on individual practice and judgment.

At most general meetings, shareholders are told briefly who the scrutineer is. That is often where disclosure ends. Little is said about the scrutineer's qualifications, experience, or safeguards to ensure independence. Much like their subtle physical presence, their professional standing is largely unknown to shareholders.

It is perhaps for this reason that the Securities Commission Malaysia has sought public feedback on whether clearer minimum expectations are needed to ensure scrutineers are consistently independent, qualified, and effective in carrying out their validation role.

MSWG shares this concern. The existing guidance is not comprehensive enough to adequately equip scrutineers to discharge their responsibilities in an increasingly complex voting environment.

Without a standardised framework, differing voting methods, varying levels of expertise, and inconsistent practices can result in uneven assurance over the robustness of poll validation and the transparency of results. Each scrutineer may develop their own approach to verifying, reconciling, and validating votes.

In practice, the scope of work is typically agreed beforehand between the company and the scrutineers, subject to variations. In the absence of standardised guidance, this arrangement may cause unease among shareholders with the expectation of consistent governance standards across the market.

A CASE FOR STRONGER GUARDRAILS

There is a growing need for clearer, more detailed guidance to strengthen the independence and competency of scrutineers. Such guidance should address verification procedures, reconciliation controls, the handling of proxy and voting disputes, and reporting expectations. Consideration could also be given to accreditation, minimum professional standards, and periodic performance reviews to reinforce accountability and quality.

In practice, however, independence is not always a matter of formality. One real-world concern is the risk of scrutineers becoming overly familiar with the board or management.

While such interactions may be entirely innocent, they raise an uncomfortable question: where should the line be drawn between professional engagement and perceived impartiality? For shareholders, the appearance of closeness can undermine confidence in voting integrity.

For this reason, scrutineers must remain visibly and demonstrably detached from management and controlling shareholders, particularly when resolutions are contentious or voting margins are tight. Independence must not only exist—it must be seen to exist.

After all, scrutineers may operate quietly, but the confidence investors place in general meetings rests heavily on their work. If they are to remain the silent guardians of vote integrity, the system supporting them should stand out.

DEFINITION: Insider Activity shows the trades made by substantial shareholders or directors of the company. Purchases by the directors and company share buyback may indicate the share price is undervalued and brings confidence to the price trend of the share price.

PAT improved 10.1% Y-Y to RM1,530 million underpinned by effective cost discipline as well as lower appreciation and tax benefits. The company closed the year with 20.6 million subscribers. It declared a final dividend of 3.6 sen per share or a FY2025 total dividend of 14.7 sen per share, in line with its sustainable dividend commitment to shareholders.

Excluding this one-off factor, the Group’s underlying profitability would have shown an improvement of approximately 4%.

Maxis Berhad (**MAXIS**) had announced healthy performance for the financial year ended 31 December 2025 with significant profit growth. Profit After Tax grew by 11.8% year-on-year to RM1,561 million.



This growth was underpinned by stronger Earnings Before Interest, Taxes, Depreciation, and Amortisation, which increased by 5.0% YoY to RM4,329 million. This performance marks one of Maxis’ highest ever full-year EBITDA, reflecting sustained gains from disciplined cost management, digitalisation initiatives, and operational efficiencies. Service Revenue grew by 0.5% YoY to RM8,912 million, supported by consistent performance in the Consumer Business and growth in the Enterprise Business.
