SUMMARY

- Iris Group Berhad (Bursa:0010) has transformed from a diversified group into a focused global player in trusted identification, with most revenue coming from its core ID solutions and strong exposure to Africa.
- It operates in a high-growth identity verification market, but its project-based revenue model leads to lumpy performance and dependence on contract wins.
- Post-2020 operations have improved (better margins, lower costs, stronger efficiency), but returns remain below the cost of capital despite a sound balance sheet.

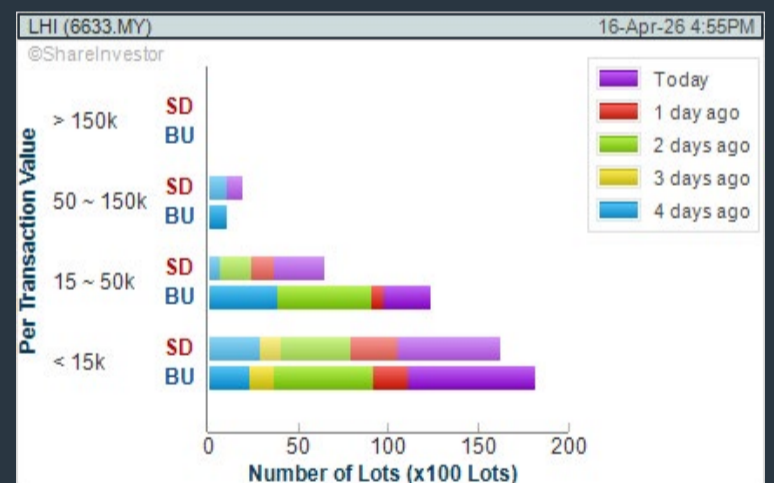

Iris:

From Restructuring to Recovery — Is It Enough?

SUMMARY

- Iris Group Berhad (**Bursa:0010**) has transformed from a diversified group into a focused global player in trusted identification, with most revenue coming from its core ID solutions and strong exposure to Africa.
- It operates in a high-growth identity verification market, but its project-based revenue model leads to lumpy performance and dependence on contract wins.
- Post-2020 operations have improved (better margins, lower costs, stronger efficiency), but returns remain below the cost of capital despite a sound balance sheet.

BACKGROUND

In 2024, Iris positioned itself as a focused global leader in trusted identification solutions, providing secure and innovative technologies to governments and enterprises.

This marks a significant shift from 2015, when the Group operated across diverse sectors including technology, infrastructure, education, and sustainable development. Over time, it streamlined its operations to focus on secure identity management by divesting non-core, loss-making businesses and expanding into biometric and digital ID solutions aligned with global trends.

Today, Iris operates through two segments:

- **The core Trusted Identification segment** delivers end-to-end identity solutions such as e-passports, e-gates, kiosks, and vehicle registration systems.
- **The Sustainable Development segment** focuses on niche environmental projects, but contributes less than 3% of Group revenue.

The Group has a strong international footprint, with Africa contributing about 61% of revenue and Malaysia about 25% over the past five years. Despite being a Malaysian tech company, Iris has limited presence in major tech markets such as the US and China.

Note that Iris has a March financial year-end. Unless stated otherwise, all references are to financial years, with 2025 based on LTM Sep 2024 results.

MARKET CHARACTERISTICS

Iris operates in the identity verification industry, a high-growth global market with a mid-teens CAGR, supported by rising demand for secure digital identity solutions worldwide.

Its business is primarily project-based, with revenue driven by electronic IDs, e-passports, and related trusted identification systems. These are typically tied to long-term government contracts in markets such as Nigeria, Senegal, and Guinea, as well as to domestic projects such as driving licences and payment cards. As a result, performance depends on project wins and execution.

OPERATING PERFORMANCE

Revenue declined over the past decade, bottoming in 2021 before recovering from 2022 as the Group refocused on its core trusted ID business and benefited from market recovery. **Refer to Chart 1, left.**

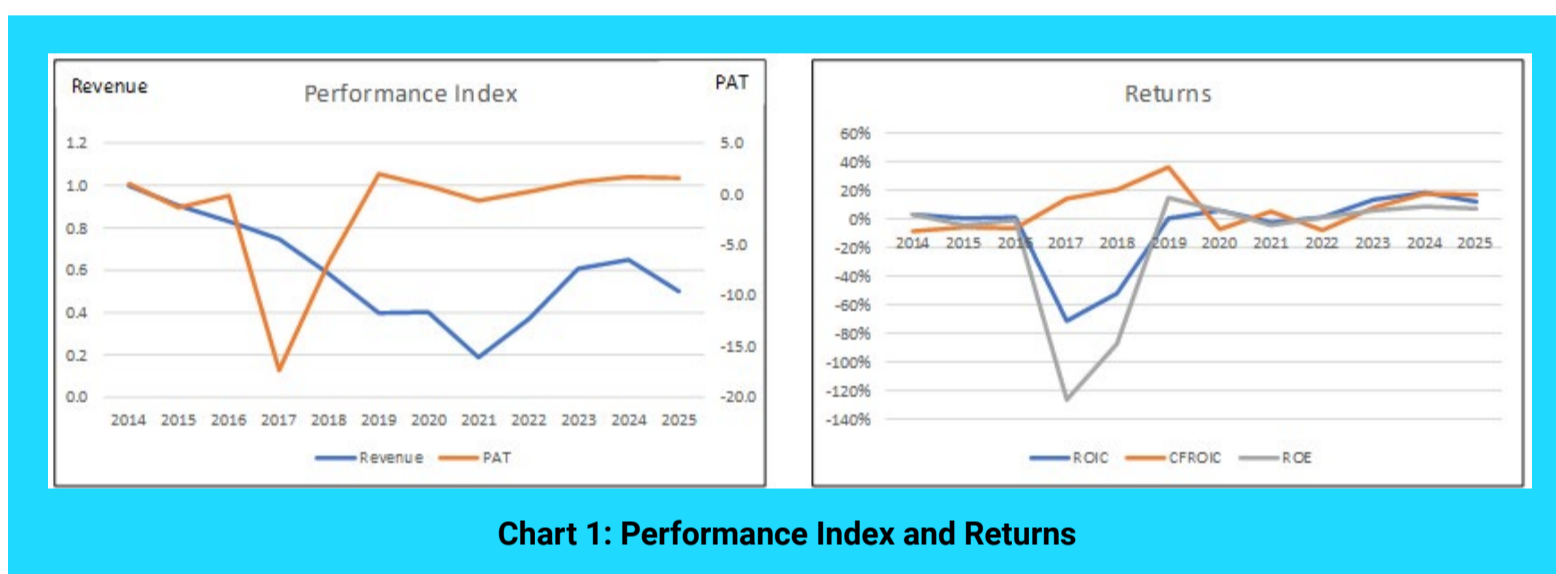


Chart 1: Performance Index and Returns

Profits were comparatively more stable, although 2017 recorded a sharp loss due to a one-off RM247 million impairment from restructuring and the exit of non-core businesses. Given the business reset, post-2020 performance is more indicative.

On this basis, returns remain weak, with an average ROIC of about 8% and ROE of 4% (2021-2025), both below the cost of capital as **illustrated in Chart 1, right.**

That said, operating fundamentals have improved. Gross margins have trended upward while SGA margins have declined, leading to higher contribution margins. At the same time, fixed costs have been structurally lower post-2020 following the restructuring. **Refer to Chart 2.**

These improvements are reflected in better operating and capital efficiency, with gains in cost control, asset utilisation, and resource allocation.



Chart 2: Margins and Operating Profit

- Note to Op Profit:** I broke down the operating profits into fixed costs and variable costs.
- Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization and Others.
 - Variable cost = Cost of Sales that excluded Depreciation & Amortization.
 - Contribution = Revenue – Variable Cost.
 - Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.

PEER COMPARISON

I compared Iris's performance with some of Bursa's tech companies as per Table 1

I looked at the trends of 4 metrics – ROC, EBIT margin, Free Cash Flow margin, and EPS - to get a sense of how well Iris performed compared to its peers:

- Iris started with the lowest ROC. While its ROC has improved over the past few years, it is lower than average.
- It had the worst EBIT margin for most of the time.
- I would rate Iris's levered Free Cash Flow margin performance as average.
- While having the best EPS initially, it became the worst before recovering.

Overall, Iris's performance suggests challenges in profitability, operational efficiency, and overall financial health.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I would rate Iris's financial position as sound based on the following:

- As of Sep 2025, it had RM176 million in cash. This is equal to 28% of its total assets.
- As of Sep 2025, it had a debt-capital ratio of 0.3%.
- Over the past 12 years, it has had an average Reinvestment rate of 33%. I defined the Reinvestment rate as Reinvestment/ NOPAT. Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisitions – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital. A low Reinvestment rate meant that there was a big part of NOPAT that could be distributed to shareholders.
- Despite having a cumulative loss of RM331 million over the past 12 years, it generated a cumulative RM66 million cash flow from operations.
- Although it did not generate enough cash flow from operations, it had a reasonable capital allocation plan. **Refer to Table 2.** Funds raised were used to reduce debt and for CAPEX.

Apart from its low returns, the other negative point is that over the past 12 years, there were only 7 years with positive cash flow from operations.

VALUATION

Given its project-based nature, I based the valuation on the 2022 - 2025 average revenue to smooth out project-driven fluctuations.

I assumed a conservative 4% perpetual growth rate despite the industry's higher growth profile. Margins and capital efficiency were also anchored to their 2022 - 2025 averages, with reinvestment derived from the fundamental growth relationship.

On this basis, the intrinsic value is estimated at RM0.50 per share versus a market price of RM0.27 (Sep 2025), implying an 85% margin of safety. ***(Refer to the original article for details of the valuation.)***

The assumptions are not aggressive. Projected free cash flow broadly follows historical trends, with terminal revenue only slightly above 2024 levels. The model yields an average ROIC of about 11% and an EBIT margin of 11%, both in line with recent performance.

CONCLUSION

Iris has undergone a significant transformation, emerging as a more focused player in the growing identity verification industry. The post-2020 improvements in margins, cost structure, and operating efficiency suggest that the restructuring has had a positive operational impact.

However, the Group has yet to translate these improvements into strong returns. Its ROIC and ROE remain below the cost of capital, and its project-based business model introduces earnings volatility and dependence on contract wins. Peer comparisons also highlight ongoing challenges in profitability and efficiency.

That said, Iris has a sound financial position with low leverage and a reasonable cash buffer, providing resilience as it continues to

execute its strategy.

From a valuation perspective, the stock appears undervalued with a significant margin of safety based on conservative assumptions. But this is a case where the investment thesis depends on whether the recent operational improvements can be sustained and translated into better returns.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

SSB is building a multi-disciplinary engineering and construction platform, capable of delivering complex industrial projects that require integrated technical expertise.

It takes sharp instinct to spot shifting market trends and real resolve to act on them. Gan Yee Hin, CEO and Executive Director of Southern Score Builders Berhad (SSB), shares how the affordable housing builder is strengthening its earnings outlook by pivoting into high-growth industrial sectors such as data centres, pharmaceuticals and biotechnology.

The transformation strategy commenced with its entry into data centre construction through the acquisition of SJEE Engineering Sdn Bhd (SJEE), (See [Inve\\$t Issue 176](#) and [Inve\\$t Issue 230](#)) completed in January 2025. It has now embarked on a second major merger and acquisition exercise, acquiring Nova Pharma Solutions Berhad (NPS) positioning the Group as a turnkey EPCC (Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning) contractor and moving the Group up the construction value chain.

At the same time, the Group continues to preserve its steady income base from the real estate construction segment, particularly in high-rise residential projects, ensuring a balanced earnings profile as it expands into more specialised markets. “We want to build a business that has both stability and growth,” says Gan.

“ Residential construction provides recurring opportunities, but sectors like data centres and pharmaceuticals offer stronger long-term demand and higher technical barriers. ”



STRENGTHENING AN INTEGRATED EPCC PLATFORM

Late last year, SSB embarked on its acquisition exercise of LEAP-listed NPS, marking a strategic step towards its transformation into a specialised EPCC contractor serving high-growth industries. NPS, Gan explained had a pre-existing operational synergy with SJEE, having worked together in the past.

NPS strengthens the Group's capabilities at the earliest stages of the project lifecycle, particularly in feasibility studies, design development, technical documentation and regulatory validation. The company also brings specialised expertise in pharmaceutical and biotechnology facilities, including cleanrooms, cold rooms and controlled manufacturing environments.

SJEE, meanwhile, contributes strong mechanical and electrical (M&E) engineering execution, predominantly for complex infrastructure such as high-tech industrial facilities and data centres. SSB's own core strength lies in construction management and turnkey project delivery.

Together, the three entities form an integrated operating platform that enables the Group to participate across a much broader spectrum of the project value chain, from front-end engineering and regulatory compliance through construction, installation and commissioning.

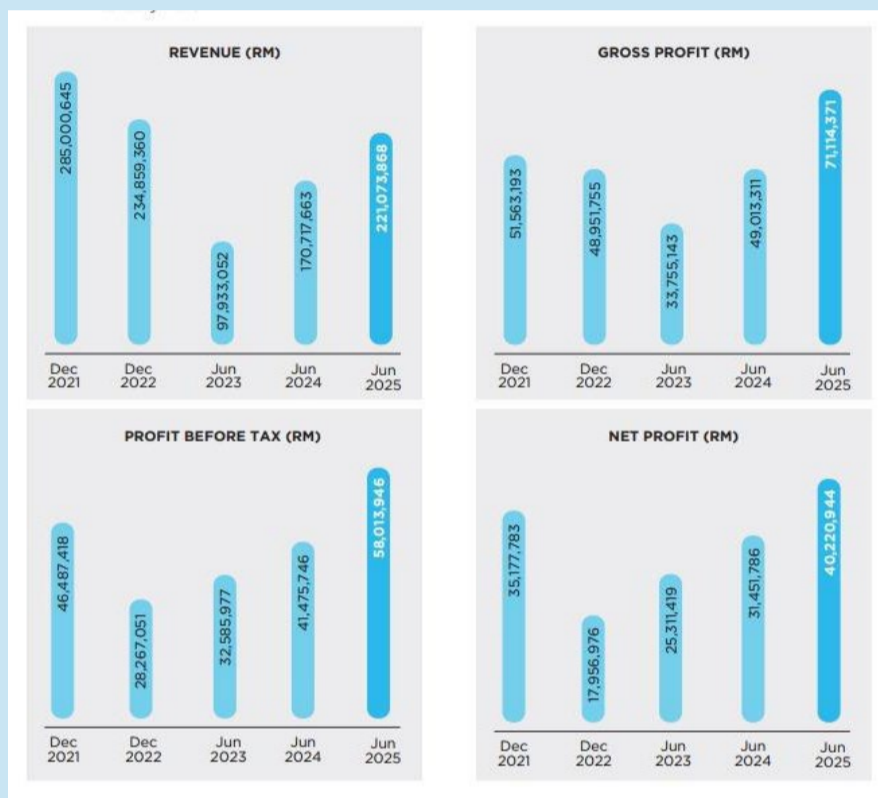
"Nova acts as the project consultant and manager, SJEE delivers the M&E works, and SSB can handle the civil and structural execution," Gan explains. "That allows us to offer clients a full turnkey solution."

SJEE DRIVES EARNINGS AND GROWTH

Within just six months of joining the Group, SJEE contributed RM46.3 million to FY2025 revenue, helping drive SSB to a record net profit of RM40.2 million for the year. Momentum has continued into FY2026, with SJEE contributing approximately RM70 million in the first half alone, accounting for 39% of total Group revenue for the period.

Gan added, “With SJEE’s proven track record in mission-critical



infrastructure, particularly data centres, we are now in a better position to capture opportunities in industries that require highly specialised engineering capabilities.”

Since the acquisition, SJEE has secured five new contracts in 2025 with a combined value of RM271 million, underscoring strong demand for its services.

“ SJEE’s order book stands at RM432.9 million, which includes RM189 million wins in March 2026 with a tender pipeline of approximately RM277 million. ”

Much of this momentum is driven by the rapidly expanding data centre sector, where SJEE focuses on critical low-voltage and medium-voltage power distribution systems within data centre facilities. The company’s more than 30-year track record in M&E engineering, particularly in projects for MNCs with stringent technical standards, has positioned it well to capture opportunities in this growing segment.

“The results speak for themselves. Within the first year of integration, SJEE has already exceeded its RM15 million profit guarantee and

secured substantial contracts, demonstrating both the strength of its capabilities and the growing demand in the data centre sector,” Gan points out. In its latest achievement, SJEE has secured its single-largest data centre contract of RM150 million in March 2026.

BUILDING THE FUTURE THROUGH DIGITAL ENGINEERING

Seeing digitalisation as an edge in complex construction, SSB launched Southern Score Digital to strengthen its engineering capabilities and move into higher-value advisory services.

At the centre of this venture is Building Information Modelling (BIM), a technology that enables greater coordination, efficiency and accuracy throughout a project’s lifecycle. By centralising BIM expertise within Southern Score Digital, the team supports projects undertaken by SSB from pre-tender planning to completion.

“ BIM is critical for high-tech projects such as data centres. It allows us to coordinate resources better, reduce inefficiencies and deliver projects with much greater precision. ”

“By centralising operations, we can support multiple projects and teams far more effectively,” Gan notes.

SSB is expanding beyond internal capabilities to build a high-value advisory business. It is currently working on a digital platform with Singapore’s Land Transport Authority to enable integrated, multi-agency project approvals on a single system.

“The idea is to create a single source of truth where all stakeholder, from regulators to contractors, can work on the same platform,” Gan elaborates. “That transforms how infrastructure projects are managed.”

Gan sees value in replicating this model locally.

EXPANDING FOOTPRINTS

Beyond operational synergies, NPS also brings regional exposure, particularly in Taiwan besides Malaysia, where it has established relationships within the pharmaceutical manufacturing ecosystem.

The acquisition therefore positions SSB to tap into growing demand for high-specification facilities in pharmaceuticals, biotechnology and other regulated industries, while strengthening its ability to bid for technically complex projects.

BALANCING GROWTH AND SHAREHOLDER RETURNS

SSB balances disciplined shareholder returns with growth, anchored by a steady 1 sen annual dividend, while continuing to invest in growth opportunities across its expanding portfolio.

While payouts have been modest, this reflects the Group's reinvestment strategy to drive expansion, including acquisitions in high-growth sectors such as data centres and pharmaceuticals.

"For the past two years, there have been very exciting M&A opportunities," he explains. "So we are balancing between rewarding shareholders and investing in the company's next phase of growth. With stronger earnings coming in, we believe shareholders can expect higher dividends over time."

Alongside its growth strategy, the Group is also preparing to transition from the ACE Market to the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia, a move aimed at enhancing visibility, liquidity and investor access.

An earlier application for relief of the listing transfer requirements of three full financial years of positive cash flow was denied.

"At the point of submission, we only had about two and a half years of track record, so we asked for a relief and this was not granted," he explains. "Our FY2024 and FY2025 results are both positive, and once our FY2026 results are completed, we will meet the three full years requirement."

"The Main Market will provide greater liquidity and exposure as we continue expanding regionally. Our priority is to strengthen our capabilities and build multiple growth engines to deliver resilient, long-term value for our shareholders," Gan asserts.

Positive outlook on Consumer Sector - MBSB Research

According to MBSB Research, retail spending remains resilient despite mild sequential moderation. Malaysia's retail trade rose +7.5% y-o-y to RM70.07b in Feb-26 (Jan-26: RM70.18b), reflecting sustained consumer demand amid a marginal -0.2% m-o-m pullback. Growth remained broad-based across key subsectors, led by non-specialised stores (+10.4% y-o-y), followed by F&B and tobacco (+7.8% y-o-y) and other specialised stores (+7.4% y-o-y), while household equipment expanded +4.3% y-o-y, indicating steady underlying demand across both staple and discretionary-linked categories.

On a sequential basis, spending trends were mixed, with F&B and tobacco (+0.8% m-o-m), non-specialised stores (+0.3% m-o-m) and other specialised stores (+0.2% m-o-m) recording modest gains, while household equipment (-1.2% m-o-m) saw some normalisation.

Cumulatively, 2MCY26 retail trade grew +6.8% y-o-y to RM140.25b, underscoring continued consumption resilience at the start of the year. While the current trajectory remains supported by stable employment and ongoing fiscal assistance, the research house notes that rising external cost pressures, particularly from elevated energy, freight and food-related inputs under the ongoing geopolitical tensions, may gradually weigh on discretionary spending momentum in the coming months, even as staple-driven demand remains relatively resilient

The labour market remains firm while inflation stays manageable. Malaysia's labour market conditions remained stable in early 2026,

with the unemployment rate holding at 2.9% in Feb-26, marking a sustained period below 3.0% and the lowest level in a decade. Employment growth moderated to +0.3% y-o-y but continued to outpace labour force expansion of +0.2% y-o-y, indicating still-tight labour conditions despite some normalisation in hiring momentum.

On the price front, inflation remained contained, with headline CPI easing slightly to +1.4% y-o-y in Feb-26 (Jan-26: +1.6% y-o-y), while core CPI moderated to +2.0% y-o-y, reflecting manageable underlying price pressures. The moderation was driven by softer food and non-food inflation, even as global food prices remained in deflation territory.

Overall, the combination of a tight labour market and moderate inflation continues to support household purchasing power and underpin steady consumption. However, MBSB Research notes that emerging cost-push risks, particularly from elevated energy prices and potential fertiliser and logistics disruptions linked to ongoing geopolitical tensions, could gradually feed into domestic inflation, posing a key watchpoint for consumer spending dynamics in the coming quarters.

FELDA rolls out B100 biodiesel to expand use of alternative fuel

According to the Federal Land Development Authority (FELDA) chairman Datuk Seri Ahmad Shabery Cheek, FELDA will make its settlements nationwide among the earliest locations to use B100 biodiesel, marking a significant step towards expanding the use of alternative fuels in Malaysia.

He said the fuel would be introduced at FGV mill sites in the near future for use in various FELDA-owned vehicles, including four-wheel drives, lorries, plantation machinery and excavators. Speaking at a press conference after a briefing session on the B100 Biodiesel Pilot Project, he said FELDA will start using B100 within its ecosystem first, particularly near mills, for testing and logistics purposes before expanding to other areas.

He noted that the production of B100 biodiesel, a fuel made entirely from palm oil without any fossil fuel blending, was a major achievement that would benefit not only FGV but also strengthen Malaysia's standing globally. He said that when it is announced, it will not be seen as a company achievement alone, but as the country's capability to produce biodiesel entirely from its own resources.

He added that the use of B100 in FELDA was also aimed at boosting confidence in its practicality in real operational conditions, while demonstrating Malaysia's ability to reduce dependence on imported fuels. He said that biodiesel use not only benefits the environment through reduced carbon emissions, but it also has the potential to increase income for settlers and smallholders through higher demand for palm oil.

He noted that although Malaysia was the world’s second-largest palm oil producer, with output of about 20 million tonnes a year, domestic use for energy purposes remained low compared with exports. Hence, increasing biodiesel consumption could therefore help reduce reliance on overseas palm oil markets, which were subject to various strict conditions, including sustainability requirements and trade quotas.

In the long term, he said the expansion of biodiesel use nationwide would depend on government policy and increased production capacity, including the construction of more processing plants. He said that it is a start on a small scale in FELDA, but if policies and capacity are enhanced, it is not impossible for it to be expanded nationwide.

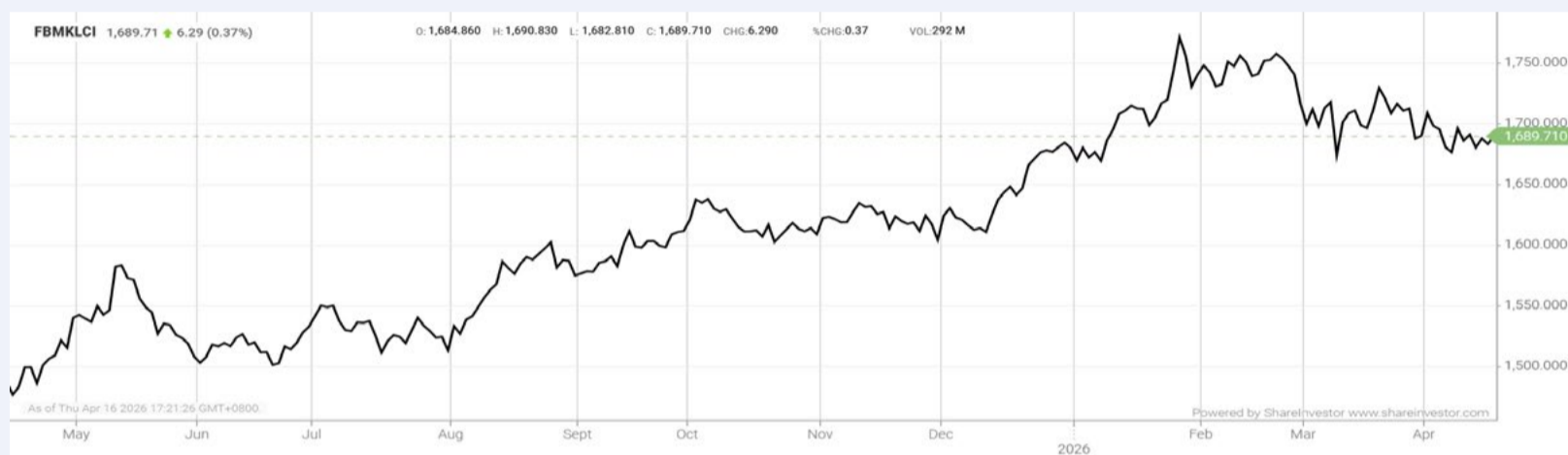

THE IPO LIE: CLOCKS DON'T FLY

THE PART THEY WHISPER IN THE DARK

There is a version of reality on Bursa Malaysia that doesn't make it into the glossy IPO brochures. Why? Because you can't package "standing still" into a rocket ship. It is not about disruption or conquering a summit. It is not even looking forward. It is just... being.

A lot of these companies? They are not growing. They were never meant to, perhaps. They are just clocks that keep time. Tick-tock, tick-tock. In a private room, that's sanity. But then? They hit the gong. Suddenly, the market expects orbit, but they are still just clocks. It is a dance where the market demands a rhythm the company cannot play.

THE "LISTED SME" TERRARIUM

Spend enough time staring at the small-cap screen and the pattern emerges. It is written in the code. Fibon, UMS, RGT; different names, same glass ceiling.

Take Fibon Berhad. It is a classic loop of stagnation—a decade-long flatline where profits hover between RM1.7 million and RM5.0 million. They talk about “strategic initiatives”, but it is just moving furniture in a room that never gets bigger. They are not dying; they have just found their natural size. Which is fine, unless you sold the world a “giant’s story” in your 2008 prospectus.

Look at the gears: last year, they recorded a humble RM4.4 million profit, but RM1.3 million of that was just interest income—money sitting in the bank doing the work the Company won’t. While the business stood still, the executive directors—the family club—gave themselves 11–15% raises, totalling RM4.4 million. It is a private feast held on a public stage; the shareholders are invited to watch the dinner, but only the relatives get a plate. It is not a growth story but a family trust with a ticker symbol.

THE MUSEUM OF YESTERDAY'S MONEY

Then there is the mountain—a pile of uncashed tickets worth RM42.8 million. It is sitting there, gathering dust and spiders, representing twice the Company’s annual revenue just frozen in time. If there is no plan or “big move”, then why are we all standing in this lobby? A measly 1.1 sen dividend (or RM1.1 million in total) is a crumb from a Main Market Company. If the goal is to perform corporate taxidermy behind a velvet curtain, then pull the plug. Take it private. Let the market move on to a future that actually breathes.

You can’t survive on yesterday’s blueprints forever. By refusing to deploy that cash, you are not building a launchpad; you are just a night watchman guarding a tomb. In the real world, “holding steady” is just a slow-motion decay. While you are busy polishing the brass on a display case that nobody visits, the competition is a wrecking

ball at the front door.

Sitting on RM42 million until the currency itself becomes a relic is not a strategy. For a business with no path to the stars, that is not a failure. It is a mercy.

THE COST OF THE COSTUME

Being public is a heavy suit of armour. You have got the auditors, the compliance officers, and the regulators—all chanting their requirements. They call it “essential”, but for the little guys, that armour is too heavy. It eats the lunch and drinks the water. The listing stops being a ladder and starts being a leash.

Then there is the mandatory piece—the “Independent Directors”. In a small-cap world, independence is often just a high-priced wig. You pay a premium for a hollow performance, bleeding cash just to keep the label pinned to the suit. If the person in the wig doesn't read the family's script, they are a “hindrance”. So, the same friendly faces stay the full 12-year limit as they fit the budget, they know the lines and they never miss a cue.

THE SPOTLIGHT OF DISSECTED

Once you are listed, the curtains never close. You are performing an eternal autopsy on your own bank account while the audience screams for more. Scrutiny? In this room, it is the price

of admission—a public dissection where reasonable question feels like a finger pressing into a fresh bruise. You have traded your privacy for a ticker symbol and now the minority shareholders are poking at the capex with needles.

And the “Investor Relations” circus? That's just standing in the middle of a hurricane, rehearsing the same tired script about continuing to monitor the market and charting a better path while the engine will soon cough up black smoke. It is a lullaby for a room full of people who have not cracked the spine of the Annual Report in a decade. They are the “Freebie Hunters”, more interested in the

quality of the door gifts and how much extra food they can shove into a plastic bag than the actual P&L.

HOW STAGNATION POISONS THE WELL

This is not just a quirky corporate habit but a slow-motion car crash for the Malaysian equity market. When companies like Fibon decide to become living monuments to “yesterday’s money”, they are not just standing still. They are actively sucking the oxygen out of the room. It institutionalises the “Valuation Discount”, a life sentence in which being “undervalued” is not a bargain; it is a warning that the story will never move.

And for the minority shareholders? The reality is even more twitchy. You are there for decoration, designed to give the illusion of public participation while the real decisions happen in a family room you don't have the key for. You are trapped in a structurally passive position and watching your capital turn into a fossil.

Most importantly, this flips the entire DNA of the market. It stops being a mechanism for capital allocation and growth and transforms into a glorified container for cash. They are not programming a trajectory for success but making sure the leftovers stay exactly where they left them, neatly sliced, cold and going absolutely nowhere.

THE END OF THE MOVIE

Listing doesn't invent growth. It is not a magic wand. It doesn't change the core nature. All it does is put you in a spotlight that expects you to dance. For the ones built to sprint, the light is great. For the ones built to sit still, the light just shows every crack, every wrinkle, and the fact that you have not moved an inch in a decade.

So ask the question before the clock runs out: Not “Can we list?” But “Once we are on stage, do we actually want to put on a show?”

DEFINITION: Insider Activity shows the trades made by substantial shareholders or directors of the company. Purchases by the directors and company share buyback may indicate the share price is undervalued and brings confidence to the price trend of the share price.
