SUMMARY

- Cuscapi Berhad (BURSA:0051) has repositioned itself towards higher-margin digital solutions and expanded regionally, but long-term revenue growth has been weak and inconsistent.
- Margins, cost structure, and profitability have improved, with the company returning to profits in 2024, driven by better efficiency and a shift in revenue mix.
- Sustainability remains uncertain. Recent 2025 results show declining revenue and profits, while historical cash flow has been weak, raising doubts about whether the turnaround is structural or temporary.

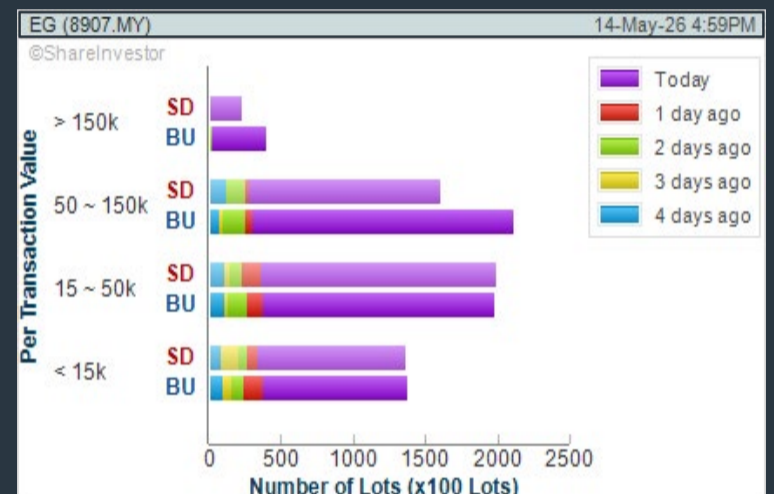

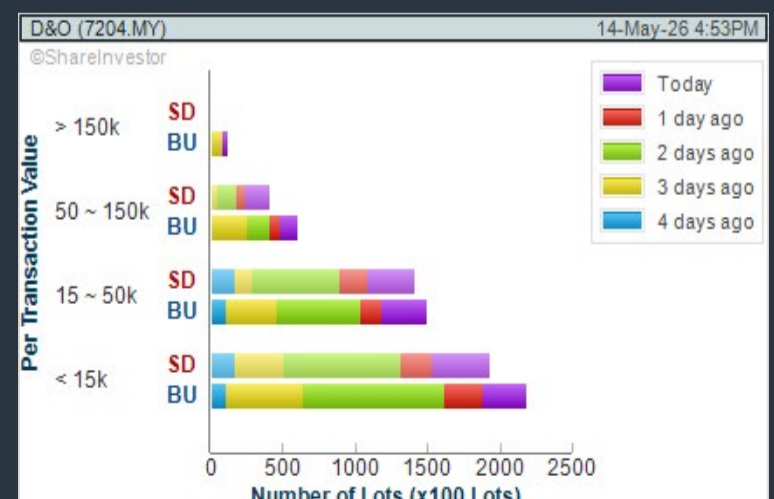

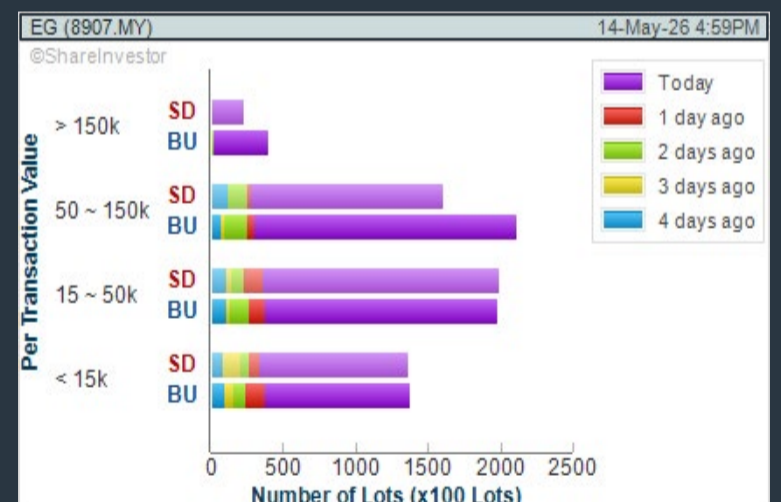

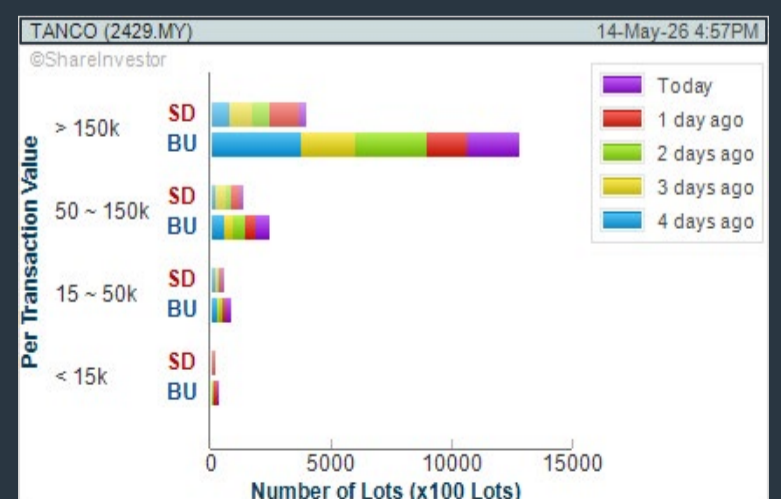

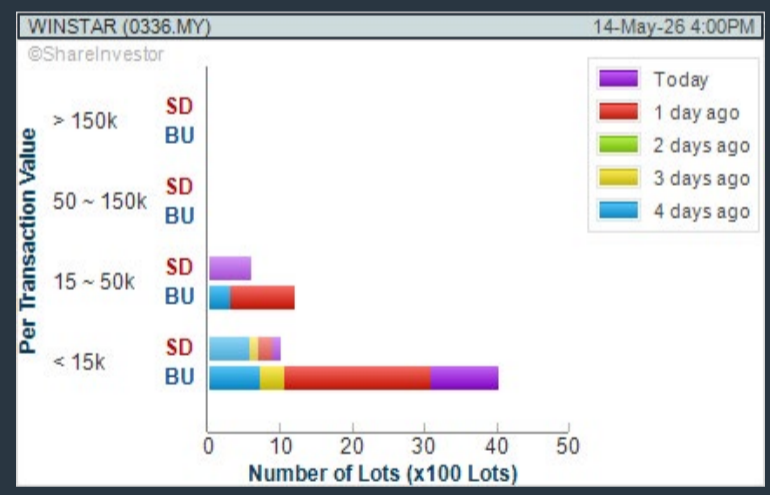

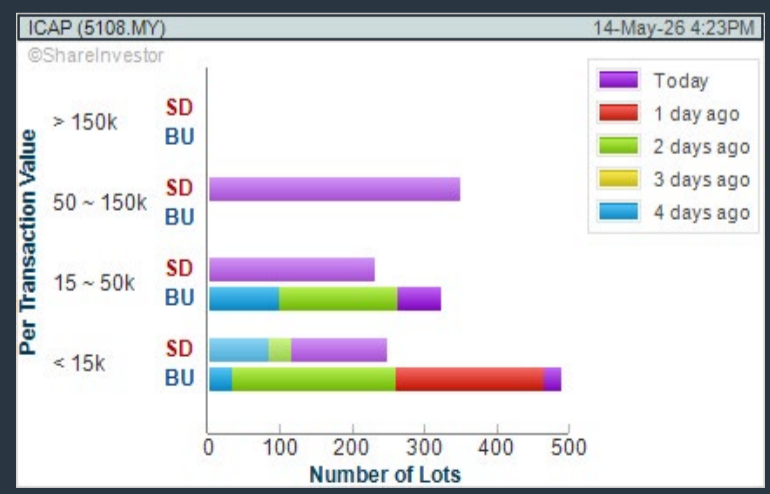

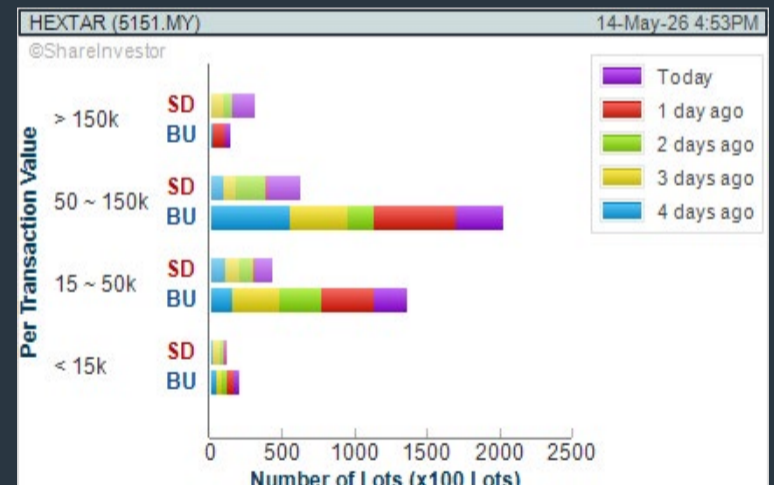

Cuscapi: Turnaround Narrative vs Reality

SUMMARY

- Cuscapi Berhad (**BURSA:0051**) has repositioned itself towards higher-margin digital solutions and expanded regionally, but long-term revenue growth has been weak and inconsistent.
- Margins, cost structure, and profitability have improved, with the company returning to profits in 2024, driven by better efficiency and a shift in revenue mix.
- Sustainability remains uncertain. Recent 2025 results show declining revenue and profits, while historical cash flow has been weak, raising doubts about whether the turnaround is structural or temporary.

BACKGROUND

Over the past decade, Cuscapi has transitioned from a traditional IT solutions provider into a niche-focused group leveraging digital technologies to drive growth and value creation in selected industries. This transformation has involved both broadening its product offerings and expanding geographically. Today, its operations extend across Southeast Asia, China, and other markets.

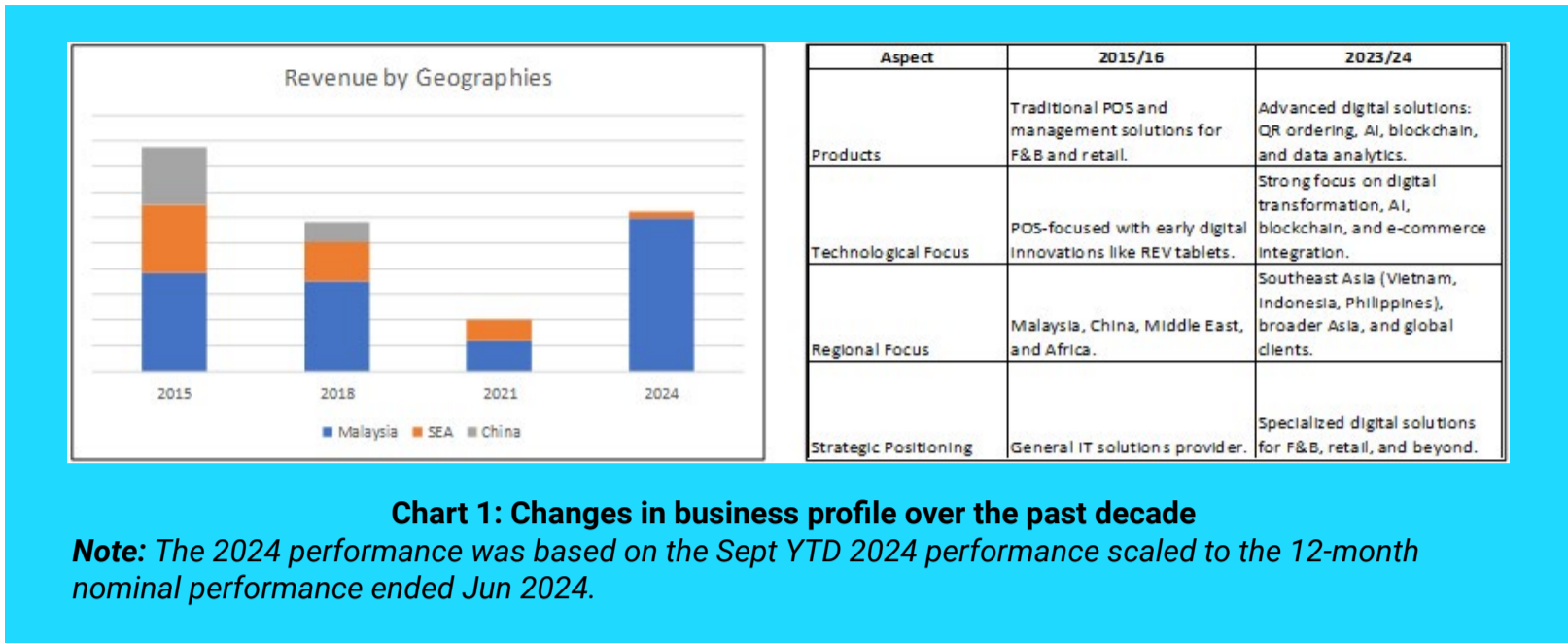
Key milestones over the period include:

- Expansion into emerging markets such as Vietnam, Indonesia, and the Philippines
- Introduction of the REV self-ordering system to improve operational efficiency in the F&B sector
- Early adoption of blockchain-related solutions for payments and loyalty programmes

These initiatives have helped reposition the Group within the evolving IT solutions landscape, particularly in segments tied to digitalisation and automation.

Chart 1 summarises these developments. Notably, Malaysia contributed a significantly larger share of revenue in 2024 compared to prior years. However, as the company does not disclose revenue by product, it is not possible to assess the relative contributions of its various solutions and technologies.

It is also worth noting that in 2024, Cuscapi changed its financial year-end from June to December. To enable like-for-like comparisons, I have estimated the 12-month results to June 2024 as a proxy for its “normalised” 2024 performance. Unless otherwise stated, all references to 2024 in this article are based on this adjusted figure.



OPERATING PERFORMANCE

You can see from the **left part of Chart 2** that there was a general decline in revenue from 2015. But this trend seemed to have reached the bottom around 2021/23 with a turnaround in 2024.

Cuscapi operates within the broader IT solutions market, focusing on several higher-growth niches:

- Restaurant and retail management systems.
- AI-driven customer analytics.
- Blockchain-based payment and loyalty platforms.

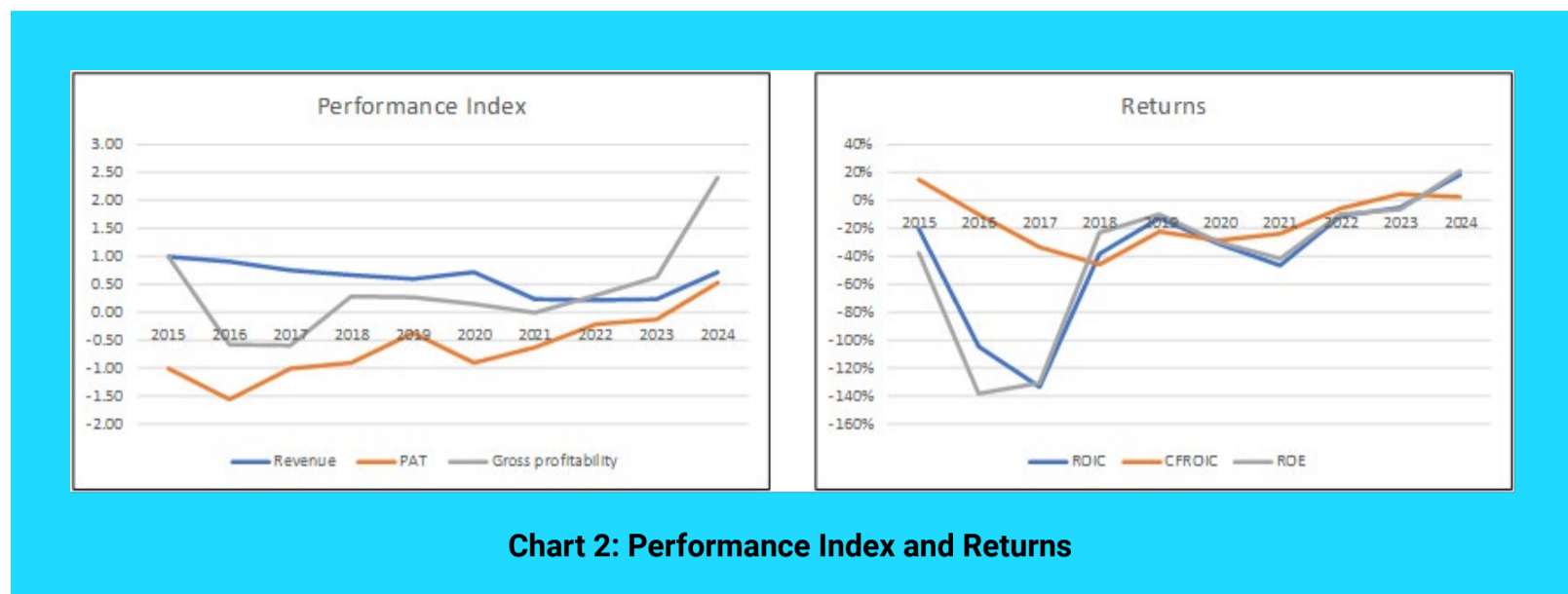
Growth in these segments is driven by increasing demand for automation, data-driven decision-making, and integrated payment solutions, particularly within the F&B and retail industries.

Market research reports show that the broader market backdrop remains favourable, with high single-digit growth rates to double-digit ones over the next 5 years or so.

Given this background, while its historical topline growth has not been exemplary, there is potential for improvement.

The positive sign is that profits are improving. They went from losses for most of the past decade to profits in 2024. We see similar

improving trends for the various return metrics, as shown in the **right part of Chart 2**.



Cuscapi attributed its turnaround to several interrelated factors:

- **Shift in revenue mix** - Greater emphasis on higher-margin technology offerings, particularly QR-based ordering solutions.
- **Improved operational efficiency** - Ongoing cost optimisation efforts translated into better margins and profitability.
- **Streamlining of operations** - Rationalising activities and eliminating non-essential expenses helped contain costs.
- **Resolution of legacy issues** - The Group addressed longstanding legal and financial obligations, removing a key overhang.

Chart 3 provides some support for this narrative. The improvement in operating performance appears to have begun around 2021. This is reflected in the expansion of gross profit margins and a decline in SGA intensity. At the operating level, there was a rising contribution margin alongside a reduction in fixed costs, pointing to better cost discipline and operating leverage.

Taken together, these trends suggest that the post-2021 recovery was driven by a combination of a pivot towards higher-value technology solutions and tighter operational execution.

There was also an alignment with longer-term industry trends such as digital payments, cloud deployment, and automation. The introduction of more recurring, subscription-based revenue streams is also a positive structural shift, as it can enhance revenue visibility and reduce earnings volatility.

ARE THESE GAINS SUSTAINABLE?

There is, however, an important caveat. Much of the formal explanation above originates from the company’s 2023 Annual Report. As such, it reflects management’s perspective at a point in time.

From an analytical standpoint, the more relevant question is whether the underlying metrics support the narrative. In this context, you should note the following 2025 results.

- Revenue of RM28.1 million in 2025 compared to RM43.6 million for the corresponding period in 2024.
- PBT of RM4.4 million in 2025 compared to the RM13.7 million for the corresponding period in 2024.

In other words, is the turnaround sustainable?

PEER COMPARISON

I compared Cuscapi's performance with several Bursa-listed companies that operate in the software or IT services sector.

- GHLSYS (GHLSYS) offers payment solutions, including e-wallets, point-of-sale systems, and online payment gateways.
- Microlink Solutions (MICROLN) provides software development and IT solutions for banking, retail, and other industries.
- Mesiniaga (MSNIAGA) is a systems integrator offering IT solutions and managed services, including cloud services, enterprise security, and digital transformation.
- Willowglen MSC (WILLOW) develops industrial monitoring and control systems, focusing on SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) software.

You can see from **Table 1** that Cuscapi's 2023 revenue is the lowest among its peers. It was also the only one with a negative revenue growth rate.

I looked at the trends of 4 metrics – ROC, EBIT margin, Free Cash Flow margin, and EPS - to get a sense of how well the company performed compared to its peers.

Cuscapi's performance is the worst among its peers on all the metrics. While there were improving trends post-2021, Cuscapi's performances were still worse than those of their peers.

FINANCIAL POSITION

I have concerns about Cuscapi's financial position. While it has some positive points, they were offset by the negative points. The positive

points were:

- As of Dec 2025, it had a 2.7% debt-equity ratio. This has come down from its 2021 high of 21.1%.
- Over the past decade, it has had an average Reinvestment of RM2 million per annum. This is about 11% of the 2024 NOPAT. Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisitions – Depreciation & Amortization + increase in Net Working Capital. A low Reinvestment rate meant that a big part of NOPAT could be distributed to shareholders.

The negative points included the following:

- As of Dec 2025, it had RM2.3 million in cash. This is equal to 3% of its total assets.
- It did not generate enough cash flow from operations over the past decade. It had to resort to issuing new equity to fund its CAPEX. **Refer to Table 2.** The only positive point is that the company was sensible not to pay any dividends or buy back its shares.

In addition to having a cumulative loss over the past decade, it generated a cumulative negative cash flow from operations, **as shown in Table 2.**

VALUATION

The value of Cuscapi would depend on the assumptions made about how it can sustain its growth. Rather than take this route, I reverse-engineered its market price to see what it represented. **(Refer to the original article for details of the valuation).**

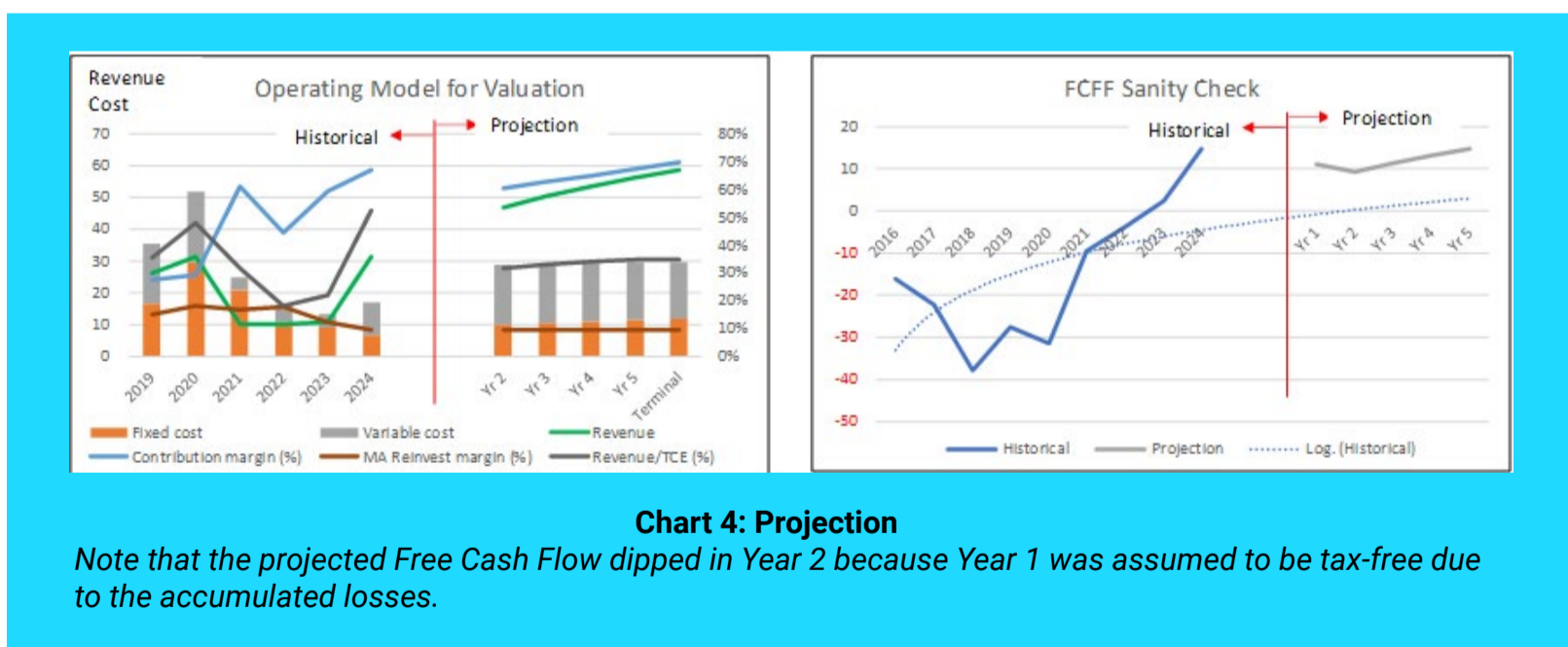
The market price of Cuscapi as of 24 Jan 2025 was RM0.23 per share. My valuation model showed that this price could be

represented by the following assumptions:

- A base revenue of RM39 million as per the LTM Sep 2024 revenue.
- A revenue growth rate of 12% in Year 1 that reduces proportionately to 4% in the terminal year (Year 6).
- Continuing improvement in the operating efficiency. The base contribution margin would be the 2021 to 2024 average margin that would improve by 20% in the terminal year.
- The Group stated that it had RM25 million in tax assets as of FYE 2023. I assumed that these would result in zero taxes for Year 1. Thereafter, the tax rate would be 24%.

I would consider the reverse-engineering assumptions a bit on the optimistic side based on the **picture shown in Chart 4**. You can see that the projected Free Cash Flow is higher than the projected log-normal historical trend line. Furthermore, the terminal revenue is much higher than the 2024 revenue.

As such, I would consider that the market price then reflected the business value.



CONCLUSION

Over the past decade, Cuscapi has undergone a strategic repositioning from a traditional IT solutions provider to a more focused digital solutions player. This included a pivot towards higher-

margin offerings, regional expansion, and alignment with long-term industry trends.

Operationally, there are signs of a turnaround. Since around 2021, margins have improved, cost structures have been rationalised, and the Group returned to profitability in 2024. These trends suggest that the business has achieved some degree of operating leverage and better execution discipline.

However, the recovery is not without concerns. The recent 2025 results show a decline in both revenue and profits, raising questions about the sustainability of the turnaround. This is compounded by a weak long-term track record.

From a competitive standpoint, Cuscapi continues to lag its peers across key performance metrics such as returns, margins, and growth. While there has been improvement post-2021, it has not been sufficient to close the gap.

The financial position also presents a mixed picture. Although leverage is low and reinvestment needs are modest, the limited cash reserves and weak historical cash generation constrain financial flexibility.

In summary, while Cuscapi has demonstrated early signs of a turnaround, the evidence does not yet support a clear conclusion that this is a sustainable, long-term structural recovery.

I am a long-term value investor who has held onto stocks for more than 5 years. My analysis and valuation are from such a perspective. I consider quarterly results "noisy" and focus on long-term trends.

Malaysian banks set for resilient 1Q earnings with dividend surprises in store - CIMB Securities

According to CIMB Securities, the 1Q2026 earnings season for Malaysian banks is expected to show resilience, underpinned by steady net interest income and domestic liquidity tailwinds.

In its research note, it said that 1Q2026 banking sector results are expected to remain resilient, supported by steady net interest income driven by robust business loan growth of 2.9% q-o-q, household loan growth of 1% q-o-q, and stable funding conditions.

This points to scope for marginal net interest margin (NIM) expansion (vs 4Q2025 of 2.0%; 1Q2025 of 2.01%), despite a competitive landscape.

The absence of any meaningful buildup of excess liquidity in the system is easing funding cost pressures, with Hong Leong Bank Bhd poised to report higher NIM in 1Q2026 as its deposit costs normalise after lagging peers.

Meanwhile, non-interest income resilience is being driven by strong transactional liquidity and hedging activities, with higher M1-led cash management flows boosting trade finance and forex-related fee income.

Wealth-related income and card fees are also reinforcing recurring non-interest income, with larger wholesale banks such as CIMB Group Holdings Bhd and Malayan Banking Bhd expected to benefit disproportionately from higher capital markets activity.

On the credit front, the research house projects a potential y-o-y decline in net credit charge, as industry provisions fell 5.4% y-o-y as of March 2026. However, on a sequential basis, annualised net credit charge is estimated to edge up by four basis points in 1Q2026.

CIMB Securities also maintains a conservative net credit charge assumption of 17.3 basis points for the calendar year 2026, citing possible downside risks from supply chain pressures and fragilities that may emerge later in the year.

Meanwhile, AMMB Holdings Bhd may pay a higher fourth-quarter final dividend per share of roughly 20 sen, while Alliance Bank Malaysia Bhd's final dividend per share for the same period is estimated at about 10.6 sen. The sector's broader shift towards capital efficiency rather than relying solely on earnings growth is reinforcing sustainable dividend outlooks across the board.

Among individual names, RHB Bank Bhd stands out as the top yield play at 6.5% to 6.8% for the financial year ending Dec 31, 2026 (FY2026) to FY2027, with potential upside from cost optimisation and lower credit charges.

Public Bank Bhd is primed for a capital efficiency uplift of at least 100 basis points under the Basel 3.1 framework, while Hong Leong Bank offers diversified growth from digital improvements and above-industry loan growth.

CIMB Securities forecasts a core net profit growth of 5.6% for 2025, 5.3% for 2027, and 6.0% for 2028 for the sector, maintaining its "overweight" call.

Key downside risks to watch include prolonged supply chain disruptions, delayed capital expenditure plans, sustained margin compression, and potential global bond sell-offs that could trigger mark-to-market losses on banks' debt securities holdings.

Perodua sees auto TIV hitting one million by 2030

Perodua has projected Malaysia's automotive total industry volume (TIV) to be about one million by 2030. President and CEO Datuk Sri Zainal Abidin Ahmad said, "We think by 2030, 20% of the total volume will be electric vehicles (EVs) or XEV, which includes hybrids." He was speaking at a press conference in conjunction with Japan Ambassador to Malaysia Noriyuki Shikata's Perodua factory tour.

He pointed out that car buyers replacing their vehicles are projected to constitute about 40% of the total car market, first-time buyers about 30% and that first-time car buyers will be from the younger generation.

He added that Perodua will strive to maintain its 45% market share of the total car market and hopes to set Malaysia as a base country for Daihatsu for future expansion. He said that Perodua can learn from Daihatsu to do a full upper body design.

He also encouraged companies from Japan to invest more in Malaysia and to produce their final products here saying that it will help address supply chain issues regarding vehicle parts. Daihatsu holds a 20% share in Perodua.

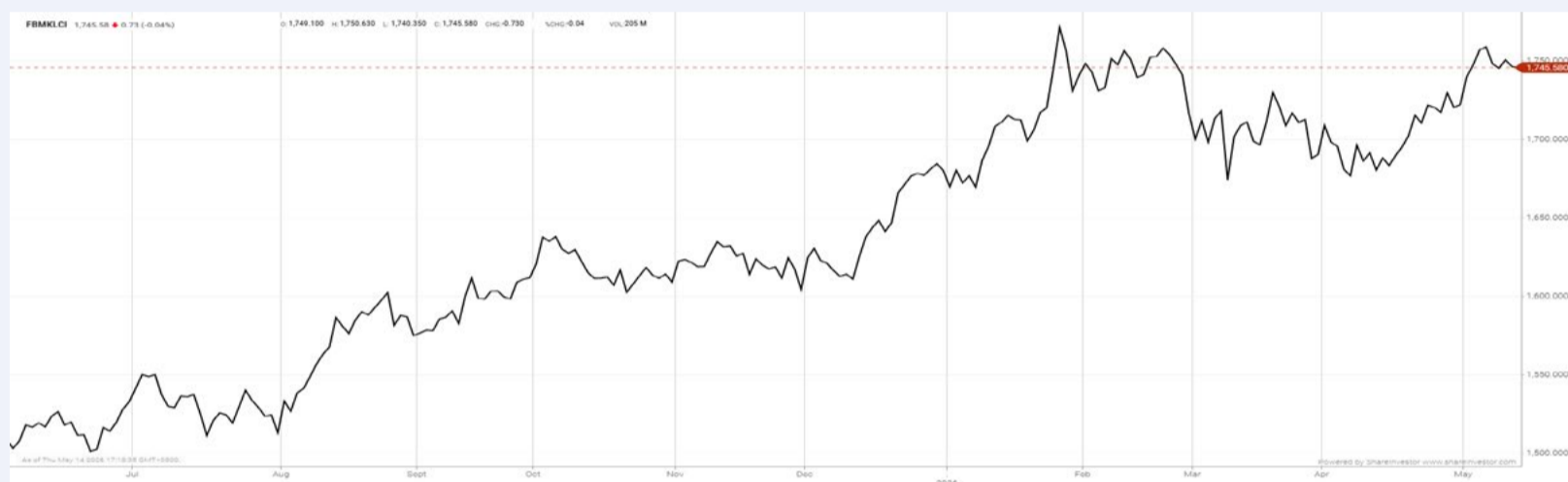

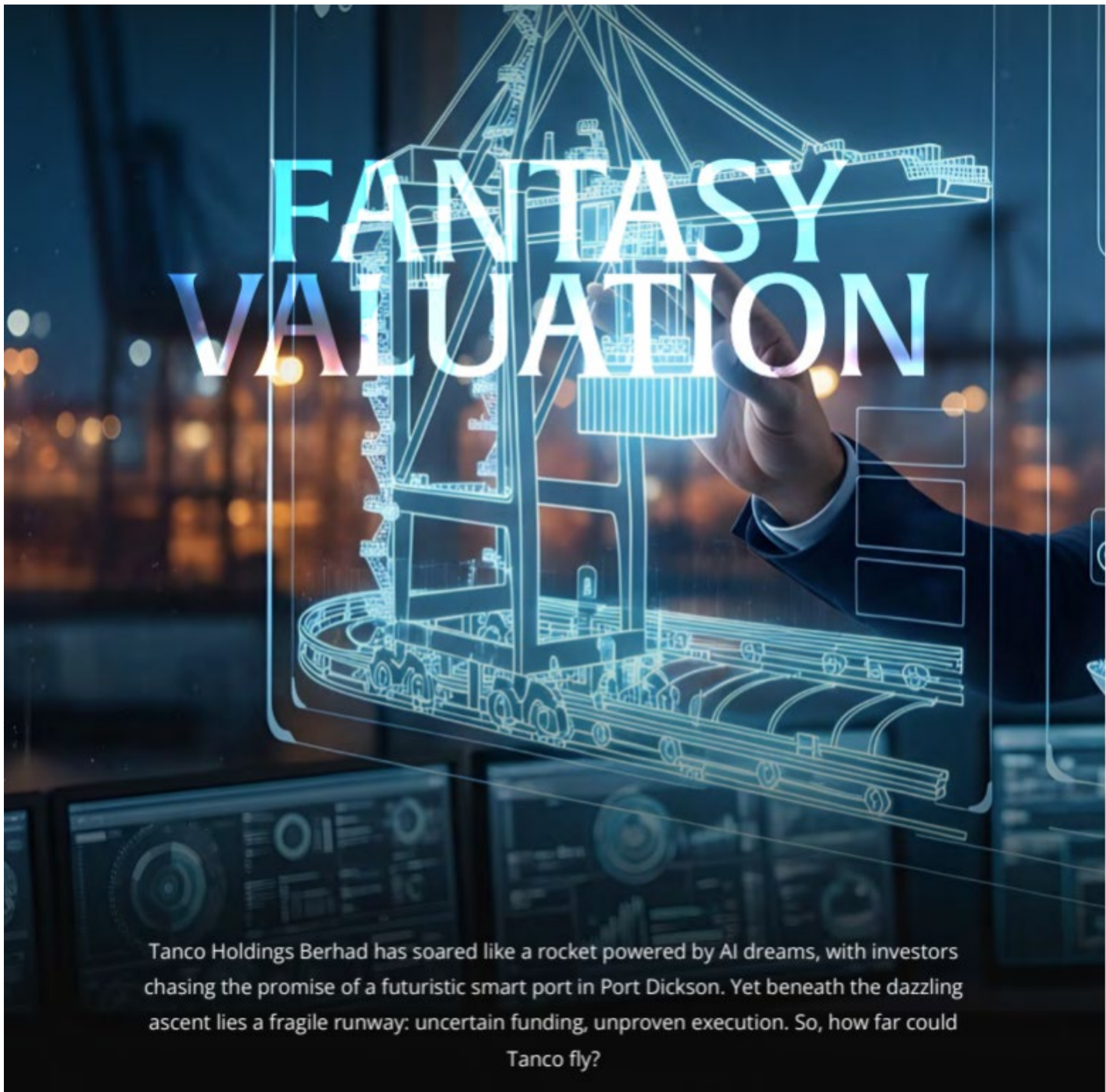

VALUATION DOESN'T MATTER – UNTIL IT DOES

If the sky is the limit, there goes Tanco Holdings Berhad's market value, at least for now.

Since early 2024, the small property developer has been a darling of some, with its share price rising steadily despite broader market volatility. The stock traded at around 20 sen in January 2024; since then, it has surged to RM1.62, an increase of roughly 700% in just two years after adjusting for a seven-for-five bonus issue in April 2025.

Despite a recent pullback from a record high of RM1.69 on 19 April, the stock still traded at RM1.62 (as of 5 May 2026), giving it a market capitalisation of RM9.94 billion. This implies a trailing price to earnings (P/E) multiple of 984.8 times, a level that is unprecedented on Bursa Malaysia.

Based on its latest financial year net profit of RM7.88 million, the implied P/E multiple would be even higher at 1,261 times, compared to the FBM KLCI benchmark trailing P/E ratio of 15x to 16x.

Tanco's market capitalisation now exceeds that of established property players like Eco World Development Group Berhad, OSK Holdings Berhad, and S P Setia Berhad.

A near-1,000x earnings multiple is not just elevated, it sits in a realm typically reserved for early-stage technology disruptors with exponential growth potential, often seen on the NYSE or NASDAQ. As a perspective, Tesla Inc. once traded at a peak valuation of 1,500x P/E in March 2020.

Yet Tanco is a small developer, generating approximately RM128 million in revenue and RM8 million in net profit. That said, its share performance appears to defy gravity, challenging the conventional wisdom of fundamental valuation.

So, what exactly is the market pricing in against the lofty valuation? Is the narrative sustainable to back such a valuation?

THE GAME PLAN

The central narrative underpinning Tanco's remarkable rally revolves around the Artificial Intelligence (AI) theme, particularly through its proposed smart AI container port.

In January 2024, Tanco announced that its 79%-owned subsidiary, Midports Holdings Sdn Bhd, had received approval-in-principle from the Ministry of Transport (MoT) for the proposed development of a smart AI container port in Port Dickson.

A month later, Midports entered into a JV agreement with Menteri Besar Negeri Sembilan (Pemerbadanan) (MBINS) to jointly develop

and operate the port. The project involves reclaiming approximately 180 acres of submerged land in Port Dickson¹.

In October 2024, Midports secured approval from Malaysia Marine Department (MMD) for marine activities and port construction. In the same month, Tanco unveiled plans for the Port Dickson Free Zone (PDFZ), a 600-hectare bonded logistics and industrial estate adjacent to the proposed port, also in collaboration with MBINS².

Fast-forwarded to December 2025, Tanco signed a Heads of Agreement (HoA) with CCCC Dredging Group Co., Ltd to outline the development aspects of the proposed port. Under the HoA, the sea port component is expected to be constructed over 3.5 years with a maximum contract value of RM3.52 billion. CCCC is appointed as the EPC contractor for the sea port component³.

Midports also signed an Operational Management Agreement with Ocean Bridge International Ports Management Co., Ltd. (OBIPM), wherein OBIPM will operate and manage the smart AI container port and related terminal assets⁴.

On 23 April 2026, Midports varied the commercial structure of its proposed smart AI container port in Port Dickson, replacing an earlier long-term lease arrangement signed last November with a port development concession (PDC) model. The revised framework formalises the concession while preserving the planned payment structure and tenure of up to 98 years.

The ownership and ultimate disposal rights of the terminal assets will remain with Midports, which will also bear all profits and losses arising from the port's operations.

THE MISSING PUZZLE PIECES

Despite the flurry of announcements, crucial information that is central to assessing the feasibility and value of the project, i.e.,

construction commencement date, funding structure, and expected timeline for commercial operations, is missing from the story.

Notably, Midports has not finalised definitive agreements with its international partners, nor has it secured the development order and operating licence pending finalisation of port designs.

Funding is another pressing issue. The proposed smart AI container port is estimated to cost over RM3 billion with Tanco effectively holding an 80% stake through Midports. The scale of financial commitment is immense relative to its size. With a meagre cash and bank balances of just RM11 million and a negative operating cashflow of RM17 million, it is unclear how Tanco intends to finance a multi-billion infrastructure project.

On the other hand, execution risk looms large. Large infrastructure projects are inherently complex, often plagued by cost overruns, delays, and regulatory bottlenecks that even established players are not spared from. The challenge is significantly amplified for players like Tanco which has zero experience in port operations.

Even assuming successful completion, its commercial viability and earnings visibility remain uncertain. Port development depends on trade volume, shipping demand, connectivity to logistics ecosystems and competitive market positioning. Port Dickson is not currently a major container hub compared to Port Klang. How does Tanco attract sufficient throughput?

The near 1,000x P/E suggests that the market is pricing in success today for a project that involves substantial capital investment, a long gestation period and yet to break ground. Even under a best-case scenario, meaningful contribution is likely several years away. But the current valuation already reflects near-perfect execution, leaving little buffer for underperformance.

The narrative has been so compelling that even Tanco appears to view its astronomical share price as largely news-driven despite the absence of tangible and material developments on the AI port.

In its reply to Bursa Malaysia's unusual market activity (UMA) query

in April, Tanco attributed the recent surge in its share price to media reports, heightened market attention on its soaring valuation, and development surrounding the AI container port. It also denied any fresh undisclosed corporate developments behind the unusual trading activity.

This explanation appears to sidestep the active trading of its shares by controlling shareholder and managing director Datuk Seri Andrew Tan Jun Suan. Since 2024, there have been over 1,000 filings on Bursa Malaysia detailing changes to his shareholding interests, with transaction sizes escalating from millions to tens of millions of shares over time. Could such sustained and sizeable trading activity have played a more material role in supporting the share price?

THE PSYCHOLOGY OF EXUBERANCE

The stock market is not short of examples where stocks staged meteoric ascents only to gravitate back toward fundamental value over time.

The case of Tanco is as much a study in market psychology as it is in corporate fundamentals. Periods of exuberance tend to draw investors toward outlier narratives about transformation, reinvention, or exposure to the next big theme. When enthusiasm is high, valuation discipline takes a back seat, giving way to momentum and speculation.

The real question is not *if*, but *when* the music stops. Markets can remain detached from fundamentals far longer than expected particularly when liquidity is ample and optimism feeds on itself.

Yet the market has its way of restoring discipline. As John Bogle observed, what goes up must eventually come down. Over time, returns tend to converge with the underlying economic reality. But when the day comes, the adjustment is rarely gentle.
