Attractive Industry, Challenging Economics

**SUMMARY**

- ViaSat, Inc. (NASDAQ:VSAT) has transformed over the past decade from a specialised communications hardware supplier into a global broadband and mobility connectivity platform, significantly expanding its international reach through the Inmarsat acquisition.
- Although the company achieved strong revenue growth from 2015 to 2025, profitability remained inconsistent due to low margins, high fixed costs, and heavy reinvestment requirements. However, recent improvements in contribution margins and operating leverage suggest that ViaSat may be moving beyond its long-standing breakeven position.

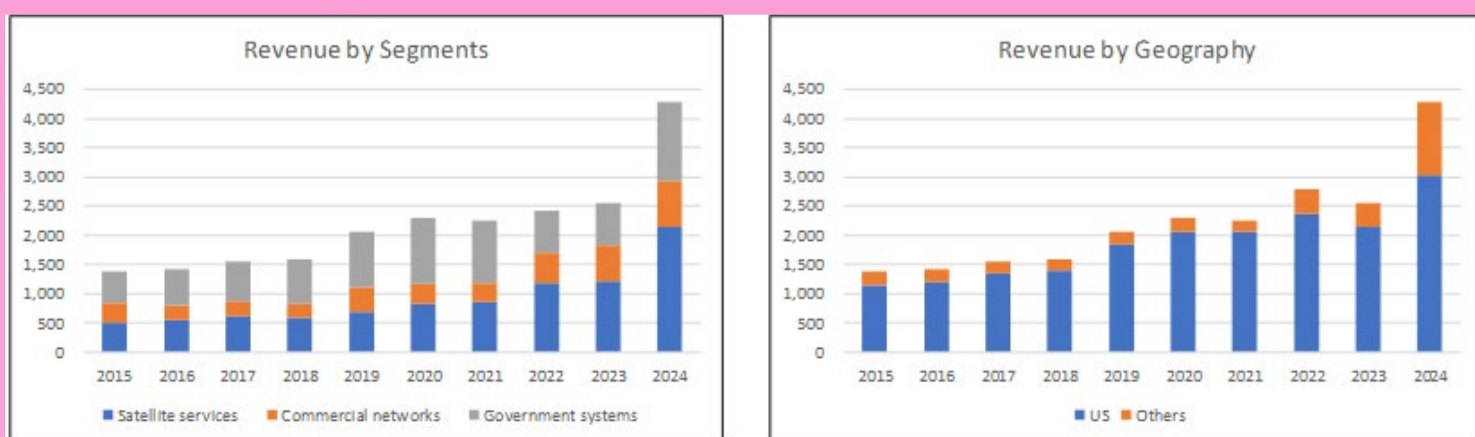
- Compared with peers, ViaSat lagged in key financial metrics such as return on capital, EBIT margins, free cash flow, and EPS, reflecting its history of operating losses and capital-intensive business model. Its financial position remains moderately stretched due to elevated leverage and ongoing reinvestment needs.

## BACKGROUND

Over the last decade, ViaSat has evolved from a specialised hardware supplier into a global communications platform company. Before 2015/16, the company was primarily a technology provider, supplying ground systems, modems, and communication components to satellite and defence customers.

Today, ViaSat operates as a global communications company with three main business segments: satellite services, commercial networks, and government systems. Historically, government systems were the largest revenue contributor, although their share of total revenue has been declining since 2022. **Refer to the left side of Chart 1.**

For most of the past decade, the US accounted for the majority of ViaSat’s revenue. While the acquisition of Inmarsat in 2024 significantly expanded the company’s international presence, the US remains its largest market. **Refer to the right side of Chart 1.**

Building on this transformation, ViaSat today positions itself as a vertically integrated innovator in broadband connectivity. Its competitive advantage lies in owning much of the connectivity infrastructure stack - from satellites and ground networks to end-user applications - enabling it to optimise performance, cost, and flexibility across both commercial and government markets.

I see ViaSat's core addressable markets as satellite broadband, mobility connectivity, and defence communications. These are not sunset industries. Instead, they are strategically important and growing sectors that together represent a multi-billion-dollar global opportunity.

Note that ViaSat's financial year ends in March. Unless otherwise stated, all years referenced in this article refer to financial years. In addition, the 2025 figures cited are based on the December 2024 LTM (last twelve months) performance.

## **BUSINESS PERFORMANCE**

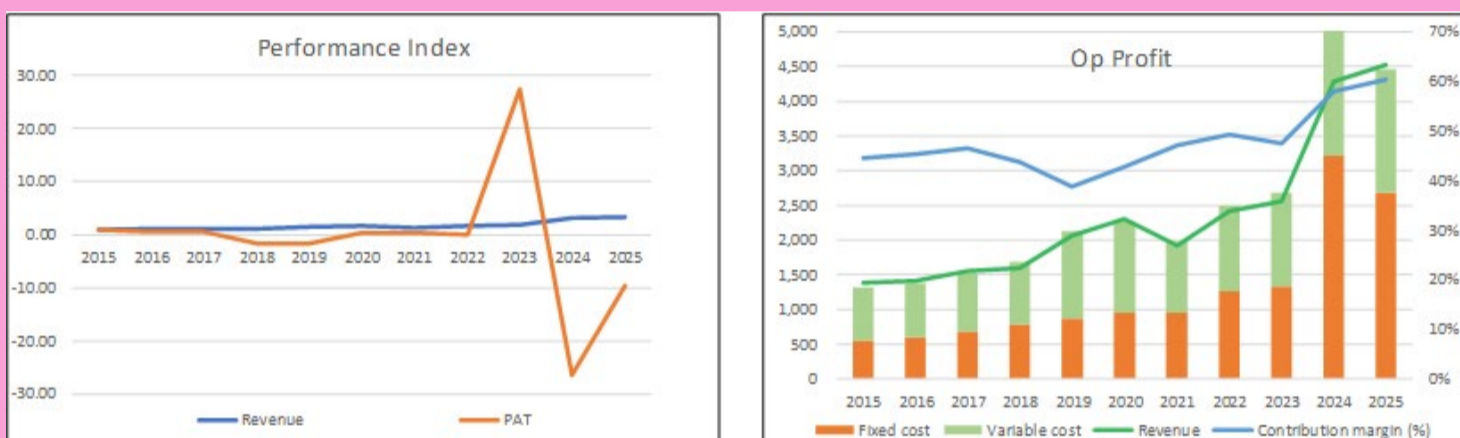
ViaSat achieved a 12.6% CAGR in revenue from 2015 to 2025. However, this growth did not translate into consistent profitability, with the company reporting net losses in several years. Refer to the left side of Chart 2.

The sharp spike in PAT in 2023 was primarily due to a one-off gain from the sale of its Link-16 Tactical Data Links business. Conversely, the substantial net loss in 2024 was largely driven by significant asset impairments, mainly related to the ViaSat-3 F1 and I-6 F2 satellites.

Over the past 11 years, ViaSat recorded operating profits only in 2015 to 2017, 2020, and 2025. The recurring operating losses in the remaining years suggest that the company was operating close to its breakeven level. **Refer to the right side of Chart 2.**

This weak operating performance stemmed mainly from three structural challenges:

- **Insufficient revenue generation:** The company struggled to fully monetise its high-capacity satellites, as customer adoption and network ramp-up took longer than expected.
- **Low operating margins:** Profitability was constrained by subsidised hardware, high upfront customer acquisition costs in mobility markets, and competitive pricing pressures.
- **High fixed cost structure:** Large capital investments in satellite infrastructure and global operations resulted in a substantial fixed cost base, limiting operating leverage during weaker periods.

- Fixed cost = SGA, Depreciation & Amortization, R&D and Others.
- Variable cost = Cost of Sales - Depreciation & Amortization.

- Contribution margin = Contribution/Revenue.

b. In the operating profit chart, the gap between the revenue and total cost (fixed + variable) represents the operating profit.

## GOING BEYOND BREAK EVEN

While ViaSat reported only a modest operating profit in 2025, the more important takeaway is that there are growing signs that the company may be moving beyond its long-standing breakeven position.

Over the past 11 years, ViaSat has achieved double-digit revenue growth, reflecting sustained demand across its end markets. Although part of the recent revenue increase was driven by the Inmarsat acquisition, the long-term outlook for satellite broadband,

mobility connectivity, and defence communications continues to point to structural industry growth.

At the same time, there are indications of improving operating leverage.

Even before the Inmarsat acquisition, ViaSat had been showing gradual improvement in its contribution margins. **Refer to the right side of Chart 2.** In addition, the reduction in fixed costs in 2025 compared to 2024 suggests that integration synergies from the Inmarsat acquisition are beginning to materialise.

Beyond the financial metrics, several operational developments also support the case for improving profitability.

**i) Expanded global reach and market penetration.**

Following the Inmarsat acquisition, ViaSat has evolved from a primarily US-focused operator into a global communications player, with expanded spectrum rights, regulatory access, and customer relationships across Europe, Asia-Pacific, and the Middle East.

**ii) Growing installed base in mobility markets.**

The number of connected aircraft and maritime vessels continues to increase, positioning the company to generate recurring service revenue from these potentially higher-margin mobility segments as utilisation improves.

**iii) Stronger strategic positioning.**

ViaSat now operates across several resilient and strategically important sectors, providing greater diversification by customer, geography, and end market.

Taken together, these financial and operational trends suggest that ViaSat may be entering a phase where it can consistently operate above its breakeven level, potentially laying the foundation for more sustainable profitability.

## PEER COMPARISON

To get an idea of the potential of ViaSat, I considered the performance of several publicly listed companies operating in each of ViaSat's three core sectors - satellite services, mobility connectivity, and defence communications. **Refer to Table 1.**

Excluding the two defence contractors, L3Harris Technologies and Thales Group, ViaSat recorded both the largest 2024 revenue base and the strongest revenue growth among its peers. Admittedly, part of this growth was boosted by the

Inmarsat acquisition.

Despite its strong top-line performance, ViaSat lagged behind its peers across the key operating and financial metrics that I examined.

The company consistently recorded one of the weakest returns on capital and EBIT margins within the peer group. Its levered free cash flow margin and EPS performance were also among the weakest performers.

These relatively poor peer comparisons should not come as a surprise, given ViaSat's long history of operating near breakeven and reporting losses in several years. From this perspective, the peer analysis serves as an "outside view" in the sense described by Daniel Kahneman, providing a broader market-based perspective when assessing ViaSat's valuation and prospects.

## FINANCIAL POSITION

ViaSat's financial position at the end of Dec 2025 reflects a mixed but manageable risk profile, marked by strong operational cash generation, aggressive reinvestment, and elevated leverage.

**Strengths:**

- Viasat generated a total of USD5.3 billion in operating cash flow from 2015 to 2025, consistently positive even during periods of net losses.
- USD1.3 billion cash reserve (about 9% of total assets) gives the company a healthy liquidity buffer.

**Challenges**

- From 2015 to 2025, it incurred an average of USD309 million per year on Reinvestment. I defined Reinvestment = CAPEX & Acquisitions - Depreciation & Amortisation + increase in Net Working Capital. This meant that it had to generate an average NOPAT of about double this to sustain the Reinvestment as well as have excess to return to shareholders.
- As of the end of Dec 2025, it had a high DE ratio of 147%. This may reflect the sector practice as the DE for the peers ranged from 66% to 1320% with an average of 346%.
- It had a challenging capital allocation plan. **Refer to Table 2.** The cash flow from operations over the past 11 years was not sufficient to fund its CAPEX.

Overall, I would rate ViaSat's financial position as moderately stretched but not distressed. This assessment reflects the company's

solid liquidity and strong operational cash generation, which are offset by its capital-intensive operations and elevated leverage.

To transition from moderately stretched to stable, ViaSat will need to

deliver sustained improvements in profitability and asset efficiency,

alongside a gradual debt reduction.

## VALUATION

My analysis showed that ViaSat is transitioning from a breakeven position to a sustainable profit position. The value of ViaSat will, of course, depend on its path to profitability as well as the endpoint.

I thus adopted the following path in valuing the company:

- The base revenue will be the 2025 revenue, growing at 11% in Year 1. The growth rate will reduce proportionately to the 4% long-term GDP growth rate in Year 6 (terminal year).
- The base contribution margin will be the average 2024/25 margin. This will improve proportionately to be 12% higher in Year 6 (terminal year). I derived this based on the 2% improvement between 2024 and 2025.
- The base fixed cost will be the 2025 value, and this will grow at 3.5% CAGR such that at the terminal year, the fixed cost margin will be about the peer average value. This is to reflect both the increasing cost due to bigger operations, offset by further cost synergies from Inmarsat.
- The base Reinvestment will be derived from the past 11 years' average Reinvestment margin. This will improve such that at the terminal year, the Reinvestment rate (Reinvestment/NOPAT) will be the one given by the fundamental growth equation,  $\text{growth} = \text{Return} \times \text{Reinvestment rate}$ .
- The tax rate will be based on the past 11 years' average rate.
- I also assumed that ViaSat would be able to roll over/refinance its borrowings as they come due.

Based on these assumptions, I obtained an intrinsic value of USD2.36 per share compared to the market price of USD35.34 per share (as of the end of Dec 2025). You can see that there is no margin of safety.

## CONCLUSION

Through organic expansion and the acquisition of Inmarsat, ViaSat has evolved from a niche communications hardware supplier into a global broadband and mobility connectivity platform serving commercial, mobility, and government markets.

The company operates in industries with favourable long-term demand drivers. At the same time, ViaSat's expanding global reach, growing installed base in aviation and maritime connectivity, and improving contribution margins suggest that the company may finally be moving beyond its long-standing breakeven position.

However, the investment case is constrained by several factors. Despite achieving strong revenue growth over the past decade, ViaSat has struggled to convert this into consistent profitability. Its peer comparisons remain weak, and the business also remains highly capital-intensive.

My valuation assumes that ViaSat can gradually improve margins, achieve better operating leverage, and sustain long-term growth while benefiting from Inmarsat integration synergies. Even under these assumptions, the estimated intrinsic value is significantly below the current market price.

# Malaysia's April 2026 exports recorded 36.9%, a new highest value - DOSM

**M**alaysia's external trade performance showed a strong growth trajectory and recorded the highest value in April 2026 despite facing global uncertainties. Total trade increased 28.6 per cent or RM74.9 billion to reach a value of RM336.7 billion, compared to April 2025. This growth was driven by significant increases in both exports (+36.9%) and imports (+20.0%). Exports increased by RM49.2 billion to RM182.7 billion, while imports rose RM25.6 billion to RM154.0 billion, y-o-y.

Consequently, the trade balance recorded a surplus valued at RM28.8 billion, up RM23.6 billion compared to April 2025. Monthly comparison also recorded double-digit increases for exports, imports, total trade and trade balance, up by 22.8 per cent, 23.9 per cent, 23.3 per cent and 17.4 per cent respectively compared to March 2026.

Malaysia recorded a trade value amounting to RM1.1 trillion, an increase of 15.3 per cent for the January to April 2026 period compared to RM977.5 billion in the same period of 2025.

Domestic exports also increased and recorded 11.2 per cent or RM11.2 billion to RM111.1 billion and contributed 60.8 per cent to total exports. Meanwhile, monthly comparison showed exports increased 22.8 per cent or RM34.0 billion, while re-exports and domestic exports rose 88.9 per cent and 0.2 per cent respectively. Based on month-on-month seasonally adjusted terms analysis, exports also rose 32.2 per cent to RM187.4 billion.

# SC Issues Revised Guidelines on Recognized Markets for Digital Asset Exchange

**T**he Securities Commission Malaysia (SC) has enhanced the Guidelines on Recognized Markets (Guidelines), marking a significant step in the evolution of the regulatory framework for Digital Asset Exchange (DAX). The enhancements will bolster the competitiveness of regulated DAX operators while fortifying investor protection and the overall resilience of Malaysia's digital asset segment.

This aligns the local digital asset landscape with global developments amid growing institutional participation in this asset class. The revised Guidelines aim to:

- Speed up product launches on regulated DAX platforms by streamlining the approval process, while holding DAX operators to higher standards of accountability.
- Fortify investor protection by strengthening client asset safeguards and enhancing the governance framework.
- Enhance operational resilience of regulated DAX platforms by raising requirements for financial stability, shareholding and management proficiency.

In addition, DAX operators will be included as members of the Financial Markets Ombudsman Service (FMOS) in 2026, giving investors access to a formal dispute resolution avenue.

Furthermore, the SC is tightening regulatory action against unregulated digital asset activities with administrative action taken

against four DAXs for operating without registration. Meanwhile, the SC has also worked with technology companies such as Google to limit unregistered DAX from promoting their services to Malaysians via social media platforms and channels, starting 14 April 2026.

This enhanced DAX framework is in line with the Capital Market Masterplan's 2026-2030 goal of increasing Malaysia's capital market size to RM5.8 - RM6.3 trillion by 2030. The growth of digital assets is a key pillar in building a more vibrant, inclusive and resilient market ecosystem.

The SC Chairman Dato' Mohammad Faiz Azmi said the digital asset industry must evolve and embrace the institutional discipline required of a mature capital market. He said, "Our enhanced guideline demands resilient and credible partners within Malaysia's financial market ecosystem. As the market grows more inclusive and innovative, it must be balanced with the highest standards of governance."

Malaysia's digital asset market continues to record steady growth, with total trading value on regulated DAXs increasing to RM17.14 billion in 2025, representing a 23% increase from RM13.93 billion in 2024.

Besides enhancing the regulation of DAX platforms, the SC continues to bridge the gap between traditional and alternative markets. This includes issuance of a Practice Note clarifying digital asset broking services and an updated Guidelines on Exchange-traded Funds (ETF) to enable the offering of digital currency ETF.

These initiatives will significantly broaden investor access to digital assets while maintaining the integrity of Malaysia's capital market.

The amendments in the Guidelines take effect on 20 May 2026.

The revisions take into account the SC's findings following a benchmarking exercise, engagement with key stakeholders and feedback from public consultation conducted last year.

# HEINEKEN Malaysia announced its financial results for 1QFY2026.

In the first quarter ended 31 March 2026, the Group's revenue decreased by 13% y-o-y, mainly due to softer consumer sentiment, alongside a deliberate and proactive reduction of the Group's sales ex-brewery to align with the challenging market dynamics, laying a foundation for stronger underlying momentum going forward. Profit Before Tax (PBT) and net profit were 15% lower, in line with the reduced revenue base and supported by effective revenue management initiatives and continued cost discipline.

Martijn van Keulen, Managing Director of HEINEKEN Malaysia, said, "Following strong 4QFY25 results, 1QFY26 performance reflects a more challenging operating environment, with softer consumer sentiment and geopolitical developments that influenced spending patterns. We continue to be firmly focused on a targeted consumer-led approach to strengthen our growth fundamentals and further improving our productivity through revenue optimisation and structural cost efficiency. While external conditions remain evolving, these actions strengthen our resilience and position us to capture opportunities as market conditions improve, supporting long term value creation under our EverGreen 2030 strategy."

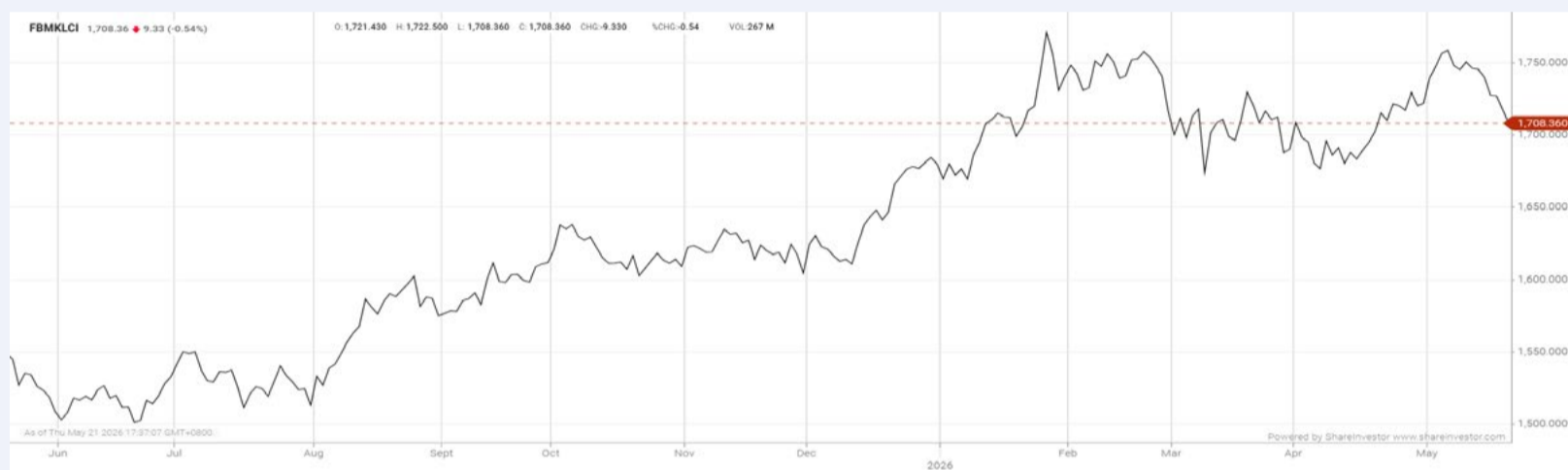

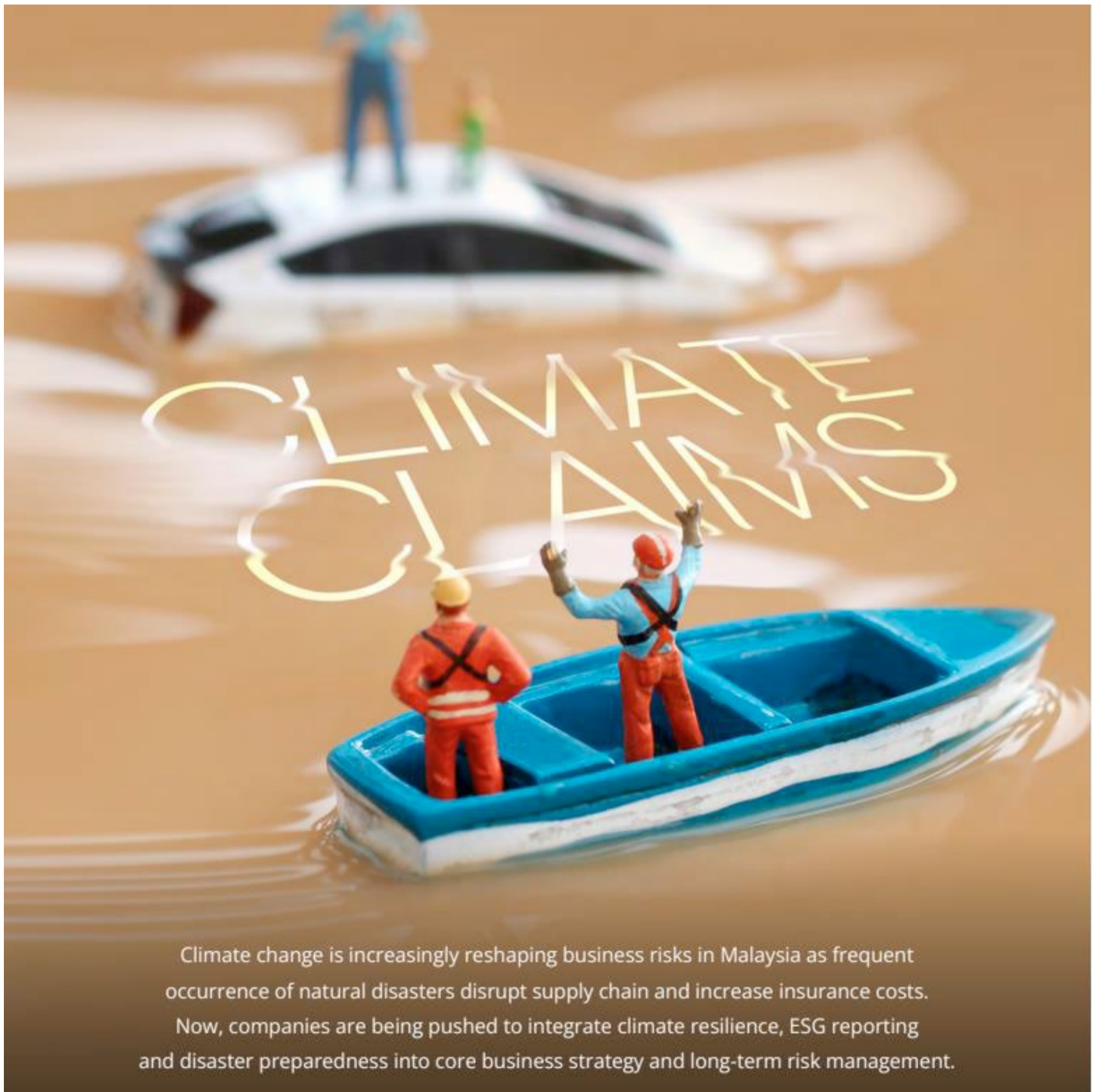

Climate change is increasingly reshaping business risks in Malaysia as frequent occurrence of natural disasters disrupt supply chain and increase insurance costs. Now, companies are being pushed to integrate climate resilience, ESG reporting and disaster preparedness into core business strategy and long-term risk management.

## **THE BANE OF CLIMATE CHANGE: NATURAL CATASTROPHES ARE NOW MALAYSIA'S TOP BUSINESS RISKS**

Climate change acts as a risk multiplier for businesses by impacting operations, supply chains and financial performance through both physical disruption and the mandatory or market regulator-driven transition process to a low-carbon economy.

At a glance, extreme weather events such as floods, hurricanes, wildfires and sea-level rise can cause direct damage to factories, offices and infrastructure.

This can trigger supply chain disruptions by creating bottlenecks, delays in production or even cancellation of shipment of goods and raw materials.

In essence, a surge in climate-induced disasters has led to higher insurance premiums and in some cases, difficulty in obtaining coverage for commercial properties or even prediction lines.

## FLASH FLOODS BECOME RAMPANT

Climate change hazards in Malaysia are characterised by increased intensity and frequency of extreme weather events, with flooding, rising temperatures, and sea-level rise acting as the most synonymous risks to the nation.

These hazards are mostly driven by rising temperatures which are projected to inch up by 1.9°C to 2.1°C by end of the century. Welcome to the United Nations +2

Of the three concerns, intense flooding emanating from monsoon floods and flash floods are the most common occurrences:

**Monsoon Floods:** The Northeast monsoon (October-March) has reportedly been bringing excessive and intense rainfall which results in severe flooding, especially in the East Coast of Malaysia (affecting states such as Pahang, Kelantan and Terengganu).

**Flash Floods:** Rapid urban development combined with erratic rainfall has made flash flood a common phenomenon in urban areas locales like Klang Valley which boasts large concentration of production/industry zones.

Often enough, flash floods – although deemed as natural disaster – has human-made inklings, notably clogged drainage stemming from littering or over development/deforestation which destroy natural water flow by speeding up water runoff and reduce the ground or river's ability to absorb heavy rain.

Retrospectively, Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) has recorded over 50 natural disasters – predominantly floods – between 1998 and 2018 which caused RM8 billion in damages.

## INSURERS BRACE UP

Interestingly, while manufacturers tend to face the direct brunt of natural disasters in the like of flooding with their production plant potentially inundated by rising water level which could damage their machinery/equipment or even indirectly with their raw material supply, insurers are not spared the ordeal either.

General insurer LPI Capital Bhd (through its subsidiary Lonpac Insurance Bhd) has faced and continues to face earnings impacted by rising number and severity of flood events in Malaysia although they maintain robust reinsurance to mitigate the net impact.

The Group has acknowledged that the increased frequency and severity of weather events, particularly flooding, challenge its underwriting results and profitability.

The severe flood events of December 2021 – touted as the biggest flood event that Lonpac has encountered – caused a "normalisation of claims ratios," leading to a 20.6% lower pre-tax profit in its 4QFY2021 financial results.

In its [61st AGM Question and Answer \(Q&A\)](#), LPI revealed that Lonpac received more than 4,300 flood claims as of end-March 2022 with an estimated total gross claim of RM329 million.

These are mainly flood claims under fire insurance with 3,410 cases involving residential risks, 751 cases of commercial risks and 57 cases of industrial risks. There were also flood claims reported under Engineering, Miscellaneous Accident, Marine and Motor classes of insurances.

In recent times, Lonpac continues to face pressure in underwriting profitability with an increase in the number of claims including floods and large commercial fire losses, leading to a lower Insurance Service result (ISR) in FY2025. The higher claims was reflected in Lonpac's Claims Incurred Ratio which increased to 45.4% from 40.4% the previous year.

In response to shareholders' questions at the recent general meeting, LPI executive director and Group Chief Executive Officer Tan Kok Guan said that flooding events are becoming more frequent, though the scale of these events is not as substantial as before.

As part of the group's risk mitigation exercise, LPI has begun to monitor its flood exposure regularly while maintaining strong reserves and "adequate and well-structured" reinsurance programs to limit net claims.

## **NATURAL CATASTROPHES TOP BUSINESS RISKS IN MALAYSIA**

Alluding to climate change, Allianz Malaysia has pointed to the fact that natural catastrophes are the top risk for businesses in Malaysia for 2026 – rising from #5 last year – as revealed by the Allianz Risk Barometer.

“Weather events and disasters that were considered rare or historic in the past are now common occurrences which leaves communities with very limited reaction time while a portion of the population remains unprepared or underestimates the risks,” observed Allianz General Insurance Co (M) Bhd's chief underwriting officer Rafliz Ridzuan.

“Governments in our region should be investing more in climate adaptation to minimise the impact as well as enhancing resilience to such events in future.”

Inevitably, natural catastrophes are the most significant concern for businesses in Malaysia. Throughout 2025 alone, floods in Malaysia affected more than 15,000 people in seven Malaysian states where low-lying villages in Kelantan, Perlis and Kedah were submerged for days, leaving homes structurally damaged and families stranded.

The scale of the disaster was evident insofar as the rivers are concerted where 10 major rivers swelled to reach dangerous levels by end-November 2025. Losses incurred reached up to US\$10.3 million with majority of the damage involving paddy crops.

All these developments eventually point to rising insurance premiums which means businesses will have to brace for a significant jump in the cost of doing business while profit margins get squeezed, thus forcing firms to alter their operational strategies.

As of early 2026, premium hikes are being driven by increased claims frequency, rising medical costs and heightened catastrophe risks with projections indicating further, persistent increases from climate change impacts and geopolitical tensions which increase reinsurance costs and consequently, direct premium rates.

## **EMBRACING NATURAL RISKS**

At current times, corporate readiness for natural disasters and climate change is transitioning from a voluntary sustainability reporting exercise to a core, financially material risk management function.

While awareness is high – with over 80% of businesses having expressed concern about climate impacts – preparedness levels remain uneven and are often trailing behind the rapid acceleration of physical risks<sup>1</sup>.

What is certain today is that climate risk is increasingly recognised as financial material that affects asset valuations, insurance deductibles and capital expenditures.

Experts estimate physical climate risks could directly impact cash-flow projections whereby in some cases, eroding 5%–25% of EBITDA in vulnerable sectors like manufacturing, property and agriculture<sup>2</sup> in the near future.

On this note, mandatory ESG reporting in Malaysia will be extended to a broader cohort with companies below RM2 billion in market capitalization beginning climate-first reporting aligned with the IFRS S2 standards.

Boards are now required to oversee climate-related financial disclosures and ensure that climate risk is integrated into long-term strategy rather than treated as a peripheral issue. Good practice involves reviewing climate-related matters in financial statements and conducting post-disaster reviews to strengthen resilience.

Beyond that companies are mapping "critical exposure points" (e.g. single-supplier dependency or flood-prone warehouses) and strengthening operational resilience to handle increased catastrophe loss years.

While investment in climate resilience still lags behind energy transition spending, there is growing momentum for integrating early warning systems and sustainable, resilient infrastructure
