Businesses need to bolster digital economy, make it inclusive

According to prime minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, the adaptation of digital economy and continuous innovation have proven to be the need of the time to generate jobs and for businesses to remain relevant amid the unprecedented challenges following the health pandemic. Innovation and digitalisation are fundamentals within this context, as these enablers not only facilitate efforts to reinvigorate economic activities, but also safeguard the health and well-being of the people. The Covid-19 pandemic has shown that technology can step in and sustain communities even when the movement is restricted. Without sufficient infrastructure and close cooperation between the public and private sectors, there is the risk of excluding vulnerable groups due to their lack of access to digital tools. Promoting digital inclusion and narrowing the digital divide by increasing investments in ICT (information and communication technology) infrastructure for these groups is a must. Currently APEC economies comprise approximately 60% of global gross domestic product (GDP), half of the world's global trade and 40% of the world's population.

Covid-19 vaccine deployment could generate demand for up to 18 billion pieces of gloves a year

According to RHB Investment Bank Bhd analyst Alan Lim, Covid-19 vaccine deployment could be a new demand source for rubber gloves at up to 18 billion pieces a year assuming that 60% of the world's population of 7.5 billion people will get the vaccine in two doses annually. As each contact with a person should lead to the usage of one pair of disposable gloves, a vaccine deployment will generate demand of 18 billion pieces per annum in the short term. If the vaccine protection period is only up to a year, this 18 billion pieces per annum demand will recur on an annual basis. This is equivalent to 6.8% of the 263 billion pieces per annum global gloves demand in 2019. RHB maintained its "overweight" call on the rubber glove sector as the long-term demand outlook for gloves remains positive. As an example, after the H1N1 influenza outbreak ended between 2009 and 2010, glove demand dropped slightly in 2011 on a year-on-year basis by 1.3% or two billion pieces to 148 billion pieces a year. A vaccine deployment itself could boost global gloves usage by up to 7%.

Ministry committed to roll out 5G technology by end-2022

According to the Minister of Communications and Multimedia Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah, the ministry is committed to roll out 5G technology by the end of 2022 or early 2023, with connectivity being one of the government's top priorities. The implementation would be with detailed planning and targets as stated in the National Digital Network Plan (Jendela). Implementation of this 5G network project included availability in terms of connectivity, people's readiness to receive the network, regulatory and industries' preparedness. In terms of connectivity, it is useless to have 5G in some areas, when even 4G or others are not available in the rural and interior areas. There ought to be availability of access to avoid the digital divide. On industry accessibility, it is expected that 70% of 5G deployment will be for the use of industries while the remaining 30% will be among the general public. The 5G demonstration project showed an achievement for example, in the oil and gas industry sector, when robots were used to replace engineers, it could help solve two problems in the industry especially at the offshore platforms in terms of employee safety and increased efficiency. In addition 5G technology was also beneficial to the tourism sector where tourists from within and outside the country had the opportunity to explore new experiences using virtual reality technology, which provides 360-degree views of tourist destinations and attractions, through live streaming of HD video to VR lens or 360-degree LCD panels. Based on the positive feedback, the ministry has decided to extend the implementation period of the 5G demonstration project to Dec 31, 2020. The extension coincides with the introduction of Jendela as announced by Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin last August. Jendela, aimed at accelerating improvements to coverage and quality of communication services experience, would be implemented in phases nationwide with a target to give priority to 4G mobile broadband coverage to 96.9 per cent in populated areas as well as improving broadband mobile speed to 35Mbps by the end of 2022. Jendela, implemented in a bid to improve the country's digital communications

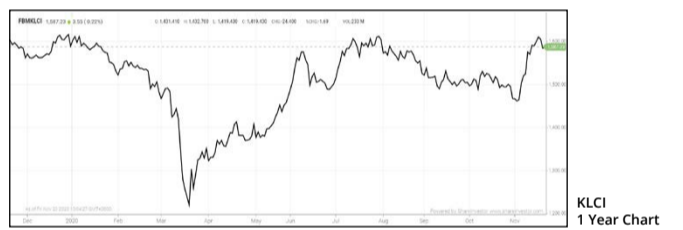

The Dow Jones Industrial Average added 44.81 points overnight (+0.15%) to 29,483.23 and the NASDAQ Composite index gained 103.11 points (+0.87%) to 11,904.71.

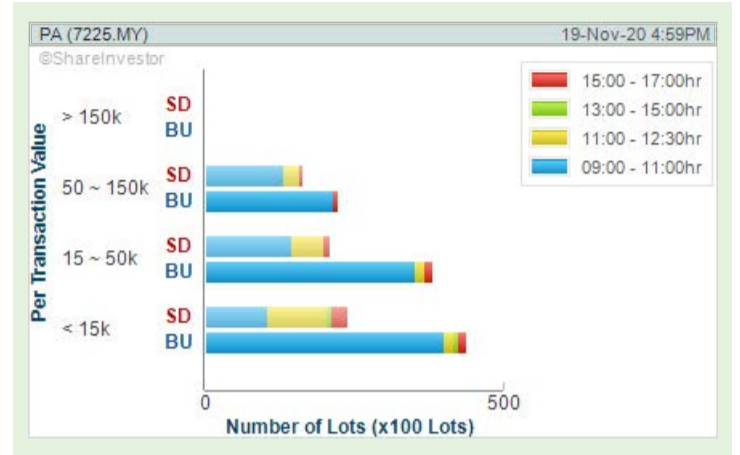
