Vaccination programmes will boost Malaysian economy, lead to more jobs by 2H21

ccording to Malaysian Employers Federation (MEF) executive director Datuk Shamsuddin Bardan, the rollout of vaccination programmes scheduled for the end of this month will further boost the Malaysian economy and help in creating more jobs possibly by the second half of 2021. Employers would be ready to employ people for a longer term rather than just providing short fixed-term contracts or contract-based jobs as practiced currently. But as for now even with short fixed-term contracts, fresh graduates and the unemployed should appreciate it if employers offer such jobs because the reality is the employers are facing hard times too due to the unprecedented event of COVID-19. The long-term outlook for the businesses are uncertain. MEF has raised with the government the issue of how difficult it is for the employers to offer employment for a period of at least one year as a precondition to be eligible for employment incentive and it hopes that the private sector can still be eligible for the wage subsidy incentive provided by the Social Security Organisation (SOCSO) even if they only offer shorter term jobs. Nevertheless, the private sector will try to do its best to assist the government in providing jobs to the locals during this difficult period. The government has approved a total of RM12.76 billion under the Phase One Wage Subsidy Programme (PSU 1.0) as of Jan 29, 2021. A total of 322,177 employers and 2.64 million employees have received PSU 1.0 benefits under the Prihatin Rakvat Economic Stimulus Package (PRIHATIN) and the National Economic Recovery Plan (PENJANA). For the Phase Wage Subsidy Programme (PSU 2.0) under the Prihatin Special Supplementary Initiative Framework, a total of RM741.16 million has been channelled to 64,345 employers to continue to operate and maintain employment for 518,793 workers as of Jan 29, 2021. This year would see more people to be upskilled and reskilled via the RM2 billion Penjana Human Resources Development Fund (HRDF) initiative launched in June last year. Among others, the initiative aims to upgrade Malaysians through upskilling and reskilling programmes, focusing on workforce marketability and job matching. As this pandemic is a long-term problem for all, a strong partnership is needed between the government and the private sector to break the chain and move forward to improve the economy. At the end of the day, businesses can be sustained and the number of retrenchments be reduced, which is critical at this time, while creating more jobs. On Tuesday, the government said that it aims to create 160,000 new jobs this year via committed investments. It is optimistic that the set targets can be achieved despite the country still being under the Movement Control Order (MCO).

Govt channels RM1.23b under Penjana SME financing scheme

According to Finance Minister Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, the government has approved 6,507 applications involving RM1.23 billion under the National Economic Recovery Plan's (Penjana) small and medium enterprise (SME) financing scheme as of Jan 29. The Penjana SME Financing scheme, which has a RM2 billion allocation, prioritises SMEs that have never received any bank financing previously. For the Penjana Tourism Sector Financing for SMEs and Micro SMEs still impacted by Covid-19 with an allocation of RM1 billion, as of Jan 29, there were 573 applications for this financing and of this total. 277 applications have been approved with a total financing of RM55.4 million. The Bumiputera Relief Financing (BRF), which was introduced by Perbadanan Usahawan Nasional Bhd (PUNB) with a fund of RM200 million, saw 519 SMEs receive funding of RM143.8 million, compared to 494 SMEs receiving a total of RM135.5 million the previous week. Penjana's third objective of stimulating the economy will focus on service tax exemption for hotels up to June 30, to support the tourism sector, of which the value of tax exemption utilised by hotel and accommodation operators has touched RM1.37 billion, an increase of RM533.42 million compared to RM836.56 million in the previous week. Among the initiatives to support the tourism sector are individual tax relief of up to RM1,000 on travel expenses as well as


full exemption on tourism tax for foreign tourists.

As more transactions are done online, users get to embark on The Goal Hunter CNY edition, which introduces users to the Fatt Choy Angpow, a festive cashback voucher. It offers a much wider reward range, up to RM288 and is available for users throughout the month of February. A transaction as low as RM10 earns users a stamp. With two stamps, users may select a reward of their choice from a pool of over 20 vouchers. One user may claim up to five cashback vouchers a month, which essentially gives them five tries at the Fatt Choy Angpow's largest denomination. For users looking to complete their reunion dinner spread, they may order groceries or food and get them delivered by Touch 'n Go eWallet's food delivery partners namely EASI (formerly known as Hungry), Runningman, The Lorry, Riding Pink, MULA Eats, and BungkusIT which award free Yee Sang to the lucky users as well as a chance to win a lucky draw (valued at up to RM888).

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Companies with **Positive Free Cash Flow**

Free cash flow represents the amount of cash a company generates after considering cash outflows for its capital expenditures and net interest paid. Unlike earnings or net income, free cash flow is a measure of profitability that excludes the non-cash expenses of the income statement and includes spending on equipment and assets as well as changes in working capital from the balance sheet.

It is helpful for potential investors or lenders to evaluate how likely the company will be able to pay their expected dividends or interest.

Mindchamps Preschool Limited (SGX: CNE)

MindChamps' free cash flow has been relatively stable across the years. For FY2018, its free cash flow stands at S\$6.6 million and has risen 31% year-onyear on the back of a strong net cash flow from operations and a lower negative change in working capital.

In FY2019, on the back of a 33% year-on-year growth in its net cash from operations and a smaller amount of capital expenditure, Delfi managed to grow its free cash flow by more than 400% year-on-year to US\$24.5 million.

With the commencement of the water treatment plants, Moya Asia has been able to generate cash flow from these plants through the sales of treated water. In FY2018, the group has generated free cash flow of S\$19.2 million and further increased to S\$46.7 million in FY2019.






