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# Increased interest in IPOs

According to Maybank Investment Bank CEO Fad'l Mohamed, Malaysia's capital market activity is on track to improve in 2021, with fundraising across some sectors showing a return to pre-pandemic levels. The investment bank had observed increased interest from first-time issuers or initial public offerings (IPOs) across three categories in the equity market. They were companies that had benefited from the pandemic, such as gloves and healthcare-related firm, those that had weathered the pandemic well and shown resilience, such as finance and fintech-related firms and companies that were initially impacted by the pandemic but had recovered at a stronger-than-expected pace, such as logistics and selected real estate players. The trend from 2020 in terms of primary and secondary placements as well as block trades would continue, as issuers look to fund their recovery momentum and inorganic growth opportunities (in the case of primary placements) and large shareholders look to recycle capital via secondary placements or block trades. In the debt market, activity was expected to match those prior to the pandemic, although corporate fundraising was focused on refinancing and infrastructure, rather than new capacity-building. Malaysia's bond and sukuk markets have been widely tapped for infrastructure projects in recent years and the trend would likely continue into 2021. With the global movement towards clean energy and net zero emissions, there is increased demand and interest in green infrastructure. Maybank is the market leader in capital market large-scale solar photovoltaic projects, having arranged 54% of all solar sukuk issuances from 2017 to 2019. It also provided about RM2.7bil of financing to green energy projects. The recent awards for the fourth large-scale solar programme or LSS4 paved the way for more green financing and investment opportunities. Also active in the debt market are fundraisings by the financial industry sector, including capital-raising by banking groups amid the challenging credit environment. A fair share of maturities this year are expected to be refinanced as corporates are taking advantage of the relatively low interest rate environment to continue extending their liabilities, although the appeal has somewhat diminished over the past three months compared with 2020 where yields were at an all-time low. On mergers and acquisitions (M&As), heightened activity could be expected due to returning confidence to the market. Greater activity is seen in companies whose valuations have been impacted by challenges in 2020 but whose underlying business remains sound, especially in the retail sector. These are opportunities for shareholders to consolidate and reorganise their businesses. M&A is also likely to be driven by ongoing trends of private equity investors looking to monetise their investments and multinational corporations reviewing their scale of operations. The ongoing pandemic of the past 12 months has demonstrated the resilience of Malaysia's capital markets, which will continue to remain broad and deep to support capital raising activity. The successful completion of the RM1.5bil IPO by MR DIY Group (M) Bhd, which continued to see strong aftermarket performance with active participation from foreign institutional investors, and the strong bonds and sukuk volume of RM104bil seen in 2020 provided evidence of ample liquidity in the market. The low interest rate environment continued to support domestic liquidity, as did privatisation deals which put cash back in the hands of the minority investors. While bond yields have trended up sharply in the past three months, they were still lower than the average yield in the last 10 years. Funds are still available and growing as demand for sustainable returns remains strong. This corroborates with the just-released Securities Commission annual report, which highlighted that total funds invested in Malaysia by licensed fund management companies grew from RM620.1bil as at end 2019 to RM649.5bil at end 2020, despite the impact of the pandemic. Barring any unforeseen events such as another wave of infections, vaccine hiccups or political uncertainty, capital market activity is expected to return to healthy levels as

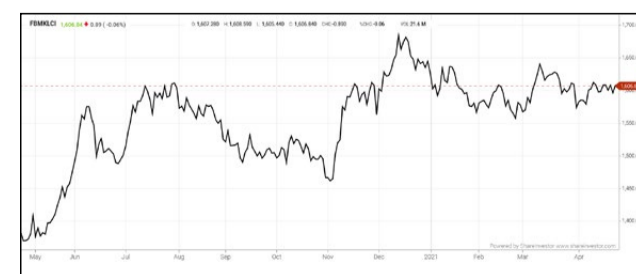
all sectors of the economy forge ahead to rebuild and recover.

### MIER: Consumer sentiments index rises to 10-quarter high in Q1 2021

According to the Malaysian Institute of Economic Research (MIER) in its Q1 2021 Consumer Sentiments Survey Report, Malaysia's Consumer Sentiments Index (CSI) has increased by almost 14 points quarter-on-quarter (q-o-q) to reach a ten-quarter high of 98.9 points in the first quarter of 2021 (Q1 2021). However, the quarterly CSI is still below the 100-point threshold level of optimism, suggesting that while consumers are showing signs of settling down, they continue to remain conservative. The National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme which kicked off in Q1 2021, and recovery in both the domestic and global economies have likely alleviated consumer sentiments lately. On the improved CSI, consumers' financial and employment expectations for six months from now had also improved quarter-on-quarter (q-o-q) and year-on-year. As consumer spending patterns are in line with the expectational component of the overall CSI, the increase in the reading bodes a favourable shift in spending patterns as consumers are somewhat positive about the economy and their financial outlook in the coming months. The report also showed that current finances had improved in Q1 2021, with 15 per cent of 1,002 households surveyed making this claim compared to 11 per cent in the last quarter. Better incomes also expected for Q2 2021, with 26 per cent of respondents looking forward to higher incomes soon. Hiring is also picking up in Q1 2021, with the current employment situation looking the most encouraging since Q4 2019. The proportion of respondents claiming that more jobs were available in Q1 2021 rose to 14 per cent - a five-quarter high; while those who opined that jobs were hard to come by during the quarter have dipped to a five-quarter low of 56 per cent. The report also showed that a higher number of respondents were jittery over higher prices, with 74 per cent expressing their concerns over the matter compared to 65 per cent in Q4 2020 and 57 per cent in Q1 2020. Consumers are planning to shop again in Q1 2021 following expectations of a pick-up in incomes and jobs soon. For the third consecutive quarter, home plans have continued to top the lists, with 14 per cent of respondents divulging plans to go house hunting soon, up from 13 per cent last quarter and nine per cent a year ago. The upcoming Hari Raya Aidilfitri celebrations in May and attractive interest rates offered by banks had likely contributed to consumers' shopping plans as well. With the outlook for home-related spending looking better this time, businesses may be able to trim their top-heavy inventories as soon as they can in the short term. So long as households keep beating a slow tempo, they could help keep the economy treading slowly ahead, at least in the first half of 2021.

### Eye On The Markets

This week, on Thursday (22Apr), the Ringgit was 4.1125 against the USD from 4.1243 on Monday (19Apr). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0959 to the Sing Dollar on Thursday (22Apr). On Monday (19Apr), the FBM KLCI opened at 1608.11. As at Friday (23Apr) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is sideways for the week at 1607.37. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 321.41 points (+0.94%) to 33,815.90 whilst the NASDAQ shed 131.81points (-0.94%) to 13,818.41.

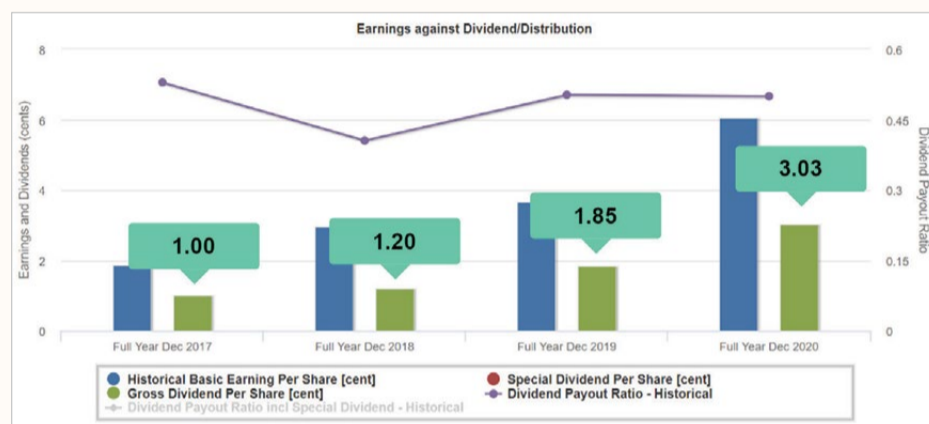

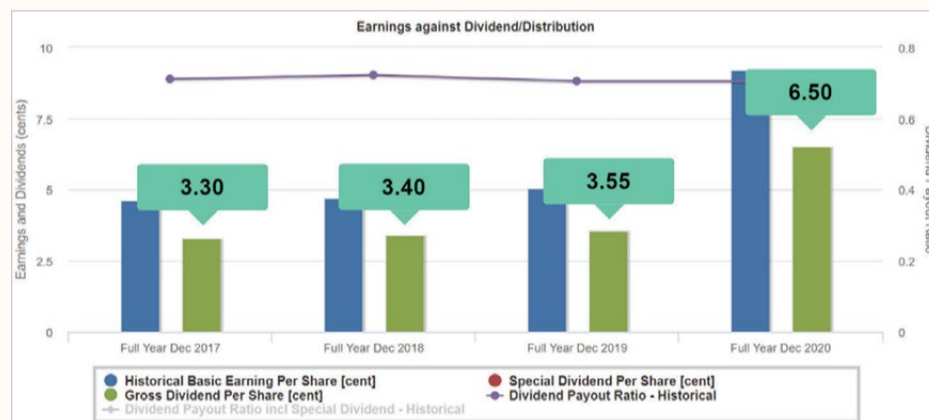


## 2 SHENGSIONG (SGX: 0V8)

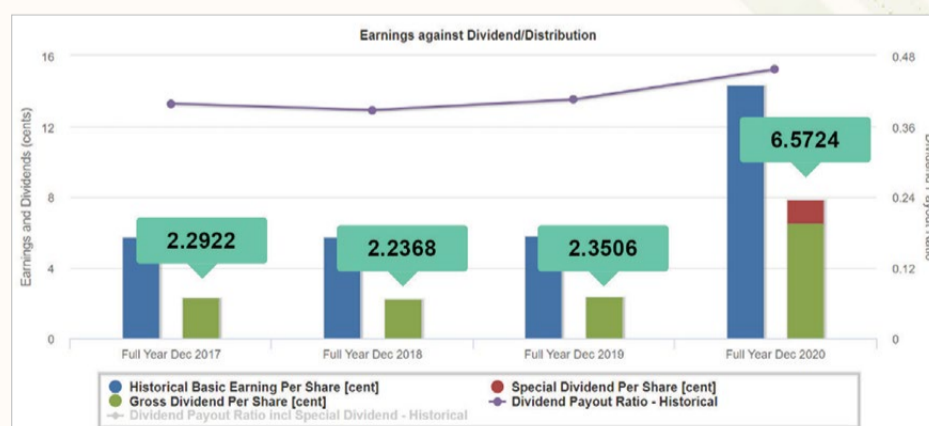


## 3 RIVERSTONE HOLDINGS LIMITED (SGX: AP4)

## Resurging Covid-19 Cases Dampens Sentiment

### Markets

Despite nearly 950mil doses of vaccine rolled-out globally across 170 nations so far, the unabated rise in number of cases this month as well as the mutating nature and multiple variants of the virus came back to haunt markets this week. With the current run rate of more than 748,000 cases per day this month, the number of daily cases on average is at record level and this worries markets as the recovery and growth theme, which has been factored into expectations, may be challenged.

### Economy

Economic data released the past week remained strong. China's 1Q 2021 GDP growth of 18.3% y-o-y was a reflection of the post-pandemic euphoria that global economies will be showing and this trend will be consistent either in the 1Q or the 2Q GDP quarters for most economies. For China, which took the brunt of the Covid-19 impact in the 1Q of 2020 itself, the significant bounce experience in 1Q this year is not totally unexpected. The strength of the Chinese economy is also helping the rest of the world with Japan and Singapore posting 16.1% and 17.6% rise in exports respectively. As expected, Indonesia left interest rate unchanged but surprisingly

lowered the nation's GDP forecast by 0.2% to between 4.1% and 5.1%. US economic data continued to surprise on the upside and the latest was the March retail posting a massive 9.8% y-o-y increase. March record retail sales figures are now more than 17% higher than the pre-pandemic level as consumers spend on fiscal stimulus cheques received.

Headliner for this week for Malaysia was the issuance of US Dollar-based Sustainability Sukuk via the issuance of US\$800mil 10-year and US\$500mil 30-year Trust Certificates. Both were competitively priced at 2.07% and 3.075%, which was 50bps and 80bps above the underlying US treasury rates respectively. Meanwhile, Malaysia's international reserves as at 15th April rose a near 3-year high at US\$109.3bil compared to US\$108.6bil a fortnight ago. Malaysia was also on the foreign direct investment radar as Microsoft unveiled plan to invest US\$1bil over the next 5 years to establish its first datacentre region in the country.

### Corporate

Malayan Cement announced plans to raise fresh funds via private placement with the issuance of up to 85mil new shares worth some RM227mil in gross proceeds. Malaysia Airport meanwhile will invest some RM1.3bil to on a regeneration

development project in Subang Airport and transform the airport into an aviation hub. More land deals were announced this week and among them were Boustead's plan to sell a 6.59 acre site located at Jalan Cochrane, Kuala Lumpur, to Sunway for RM233.4mil or approximately RM813psf. As the 1Q earnings season kicked-off, Kossan Rubber was the first major company to announce their quarterly results. Coming in well above expectations, Kossan is the latest glove company to report quarterly earnings in excess of RM1bil.

### Equity

In terms of equity markets performance, markets generally closed on a mixed note again this week with gains ranging from 0.1% and 1.9% while markets that closed lower were between similar range as well. On Bursa, thanks largely to resurging Covid-19 cases, the rally among glove stocks allowed the KLCI to close little changed on week to week basis. In terms of trading participation, local institutions net buying interest was again strongest for the period between 15th April and 21st April with net buying interest of RM197mil while local retail net buying interest stood at RM148.2mil. This leaves foreigners as net sellers valued at RM345.2mil.

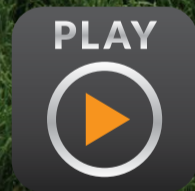

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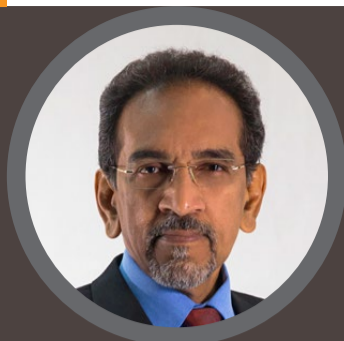
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## The return of the glove and PPE craze

IT all started during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 with many non-healthcare public-listed companies joining the personal protection equipment (PPE) bandwagon as a mean to drum up their share price. Amid much fanfare – which somehow bear semblance to the dotcom era – these minnow companies rolled out impressive business plans and unfortunately not all materialized. This nevertheless caught many newbies and unsuspecting investors off-guard; their joy was short-lived with the stock

prices of many PPE aspirant stocks eventually regressed to pre-announcement level.

### The emergence of PPE 2.0 players

While many of the first batch debutants have vanished into oblivion as the fly by night nature of their venture got better of them, the second-generation PPE (PPE 2.0) players – seem to be doing things by the book compared to their predecessors. This is judging from their clarity in the engineering, explanation and execution

of their business strategies. In fact, it will not be an overstatement to say that some of their business plans sounded both convincing and viable. In all fairness, the recent PPE proposals – as per their Bursa Malaysia filings and media statements – are very systematically drafted with details of how the PPE venture will be executed alongside their partners. In fact, they also showed conformity to regulatory requirements. Below are some recent new PPE ventures whose business details were made public via Bursa Malaysia filings /media statements:

Interestingly, with investors now wary of the PPE hype, there is lesser excitement in the air when a PLC announces its PPE venture. As such, the share price of Luster Industries, Iconic Worldwide and Parlo did not 'shoot up' upon when the three companies publicly announced their ventures.

### Abidance of disclosure guidance

On 12 June 2020, Bursa Malaysia cautioned all listed companies to avoid using "exaggerated", "flamboyant" or "overstated" words in their disclosures on COVID-19-related investments to prevent unwarranted price movements. The disclosure guidance was issued in response to the increased COVID-19-related disclosures where PLCs were taking advantage of the business opportunities arising from the pandemic. These were observed by way of various memorandum of understanding, letter of intent and distributorship agreement by the companies seeking to manufacture PPE devices in the form of face masks, hand sanitisers, gloves, distribution of Covid-19 rapid diagnostic test kits, development/distribution of health supplements, ventilators,

to name a few ventures. Stressing on the need to provide fair and accurate disclosure, Bursa Malaysia said that any disclosure on COVID-19 related investments should contain several material information to aid investors in making an informed investment decision. These include total capital and investment outlay, plans to bring the venture on-stream, impact on its profitability, relevant regulatory approval required, business risks or exposure and prospects of such investments. "Further, listed issuers should proactively monitor and provide regular updates on the COVID-19 related investments, in the event of any material development or on a periodic basis as required under the Main Market and Ace Market Listing Requirements," added the market regulator. In this regard, it seems that the majority of the PPE 2.0 players have taken heed of Bursa Malaysia's disclosure guidance - the ultimate aim of which is to ensure that the players deliver their part of the bargain to investors.

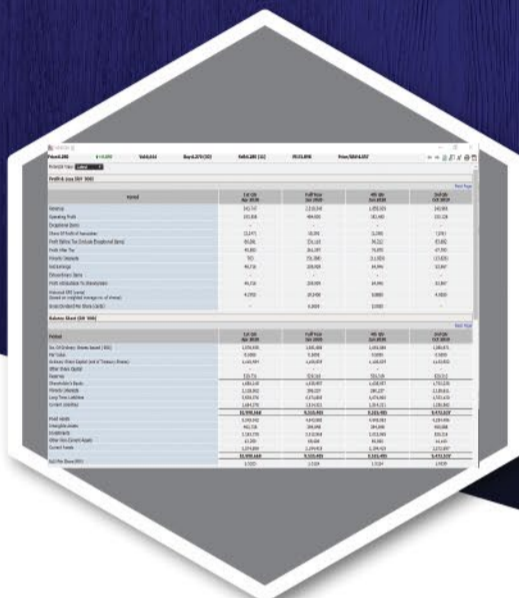
### Once bitten, twice shy

However, investors and minority shareholders

alike are still advised to exercise diligence, for all that glitters may not be gold. They must not trust what they read/see on the surface; they must be able to read between the lines and make informed decisions. Some areas to consider include the company's financial strength, its performance track record and the reputation of the board and major shareholders. Likewise, they must refrain from blindly following the advice of the so-called investment gurus who are out to tempt them with the potential-yet-unviable ventures of the PPE 2.0 players. There is a good chance that these gurus could be wrong or worse still, working in cahoots with other market manipulators. It is best for investors to conduct their own research on the company that they wish to invest in. Whenever there is doubt on the validity of a claim, investors should take further initiative to verify the claims and apply a huge dose of common sense. Often enough when our instinct tells us that something is too good to be true, it is likely to be so.

It is uncanny how often our initial gut-feel is right.

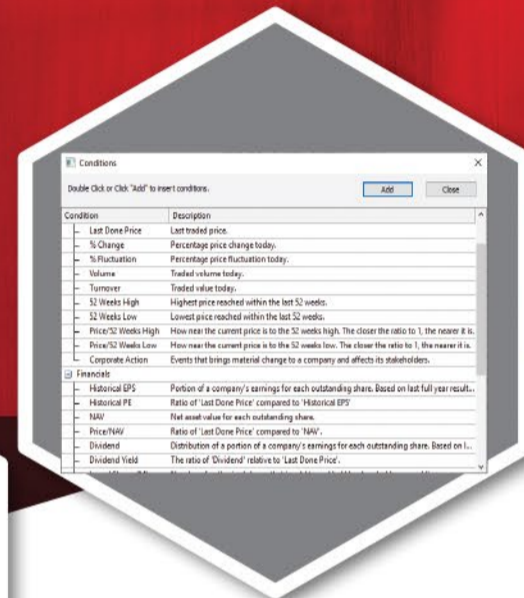

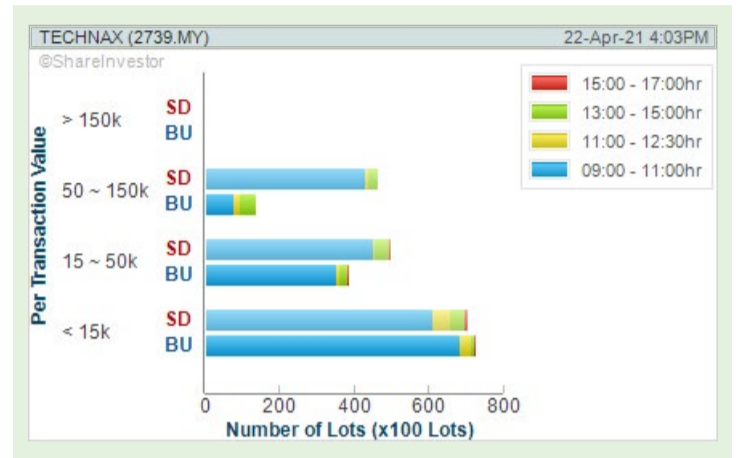
