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RHB IB launches Top 20 Small Cap Companies JEWELS 2021

RHB Investment Bank launched its RHB Top 20 Malaysia Small Cap Companies Jewels 2021 featuring new small cap stock ideas for investors to consider. This 17th Edition is part of a larger RHB ASEAN Small Cap yearly compendium from the bank's research teams in Indonesia, Singapore and Thailand. The 20 companies covered in the publication have a market cap limit of less than US\$1bil, covering seven different industry segments. Selection of these Jewels took into consideration factors including the companies' liquidity spread and size, managements' track record, industry fundamentals, earnings growth potential, the long term sustainability of the industry and their commitment to environmental, social, and governance ("ESG") principles. According to Group Managing Director of RHB Banking Group Dato' Khairussaleh Ramli, the past year has seen volatile equity markets following the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and within that, the adaptability of small cap companies in managing a fluid business environment. Technology, industrial products and services sectors continue to dominate the market, thanks to the inelastic underlying demand and strong investor interest amid the prevailing low interest rate environment. Overall, the small cap index has been encouraging – generating returns of 10.7% YTD as compared to the 9.9% in 2020, and sees this buoyant trend continuing.

The RHB Top 20 Malaysia Small Cap Companies Jewels 2020 Edition outperformed the broader market with a value-weighted holding period return of 100.1%, since its launch in May 2020, against the benchmark FBM70 (+31.1%) and FBMSC (+49.3%). In achieving this, RHB's equity research analysts have been relentless in stock screening initiatives, employing meticulous fundamental analysis and filtering for governance issues amid a backdrop of extreme market conditions. From the selections, 90% were gainers spanning across various sectors and demonstrating the ability to adapt and capitalise on the "new normal" business and economic environment. The RHB Top 20 Malaysia Small Cap Companies Jewels 2021 continues a strong track record spanning the past 17 years in unearthing hidden gems, which has become an RHB trademark garnering a strong investor following. All 20 companies featured in this year's book are outside RHB Research's existing coverage portfolio, as it seeks to uncover even more under-researched gems. The median trailing P/E and ROE of these 2021 Jewels were 21.9x and 4.8% with an average market capitalisation of RM437 mil. The biggest sector representation includes industrial products and services, and consumer.

Stricter movement controls to drag recovery plays - CGS-CIMB

According to CGS-CIMB analysts Ng Lee Fang and Michelle Chia, rising Covid-19 cases, the re-implementation of the movement control order or MCO 3.0 in key cities, together with a slower vaccination pace, will negatively impact

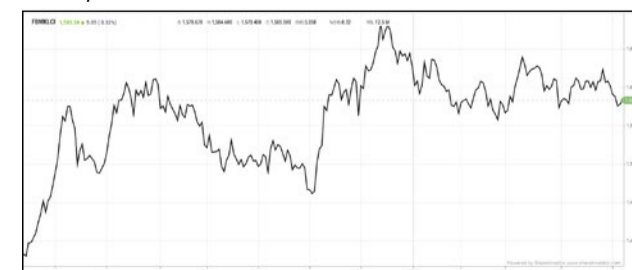

recovery plays. These will pose earnings risks to real estate investment trust (REIT) players with exposure to hotels and shopping malls such as KLCCP Stapled Group, IGB REIT, Capitaland Malaysia Mall Trust, Pavilion REIT and Sunway REIT. It will also drag tourism-related plays (Genting group), due to inter-district and inter-state travel restrictions. The delay in the rollout of the Phase 3 immunisation programme could impact the timeline of when the country can achieve herd immunity and reopen its borders. This could dampen near-term sentiment and prompt investors to profit-take on recovery-play stocks (banks, auto, property, construction and tourism-related plays), on concerns of earnings risks in the near term, and switch to defensive plays (utilities, telco and glove makers). Their KLCI target of 1,699 points is maintained. However, the targeted MCO 3.0 is expected to have a less adverse economic impact compared with MCO 1.0 and 2.0. The MCO 3.0 is likely to be less painful than past iterations, and the daily economic losses is expected to be lower than the near-nationwide MCO 2.0 (loss of RM300 million per day) and marginally higher than the RM150 million per day that was imputed into the baseline scenario under the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO). The extension of wage subsidies and cash transfers to June 2021, as well as existing policy support (targeted repayment assistance, EPF withdrawals, and credit facilities), will partially buffer the impact of the latest movement restrictions. Given the limited downside and conservative assumptions on the recovery trajectory, the gross domestic product growth forecast of 5.7% in 2021 is reiterated.

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3 Singapore REITs with Distribution Yield above 6% for the Past 3 Years

A good distribution yield varies depending on market conditions and the REIT's ability to pay the intended distribution. 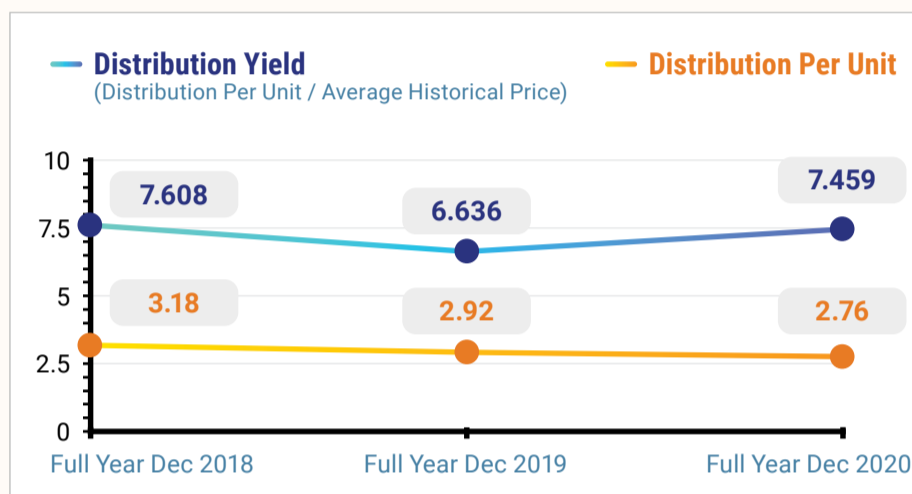

1 SABANA (SGX: M1GU)

For the past 3 financial years, Sabana REIT's total distribution per unit was on a declining trend. However, its distribution yield has risen to 7.4% in FY2020, from 6.6% in FY2019 due to the sharper fall in unit price. That said, investors can look forward to its new opening of NTP+ Mall in 2Q2021. It is a two-story shopping mall opposite Lorong Chuan MRT Station and is part of the ongoing Asset Enhancement Initiative (AEI) at New Tech Park.

Sabana REIT's unit price is last traded at S\$0.425, with a market capitalization of S\$447.56 million.

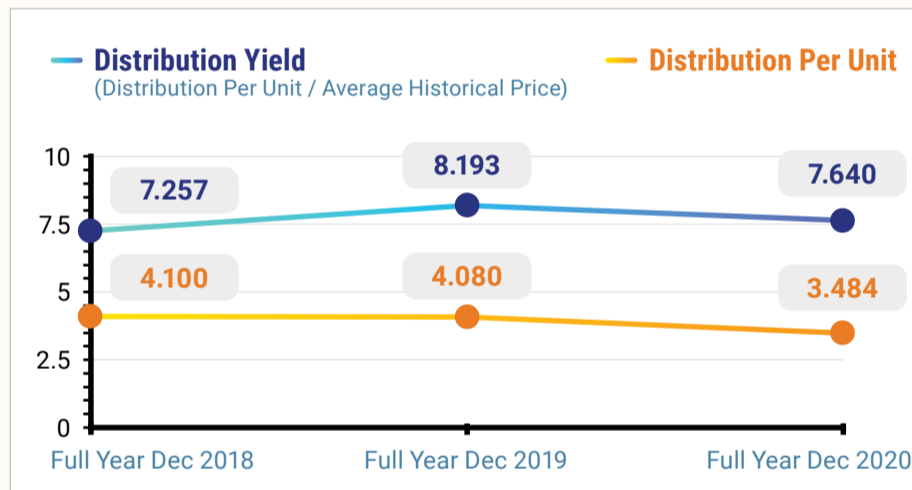


2 CROMWELL (SGX: CNNU)

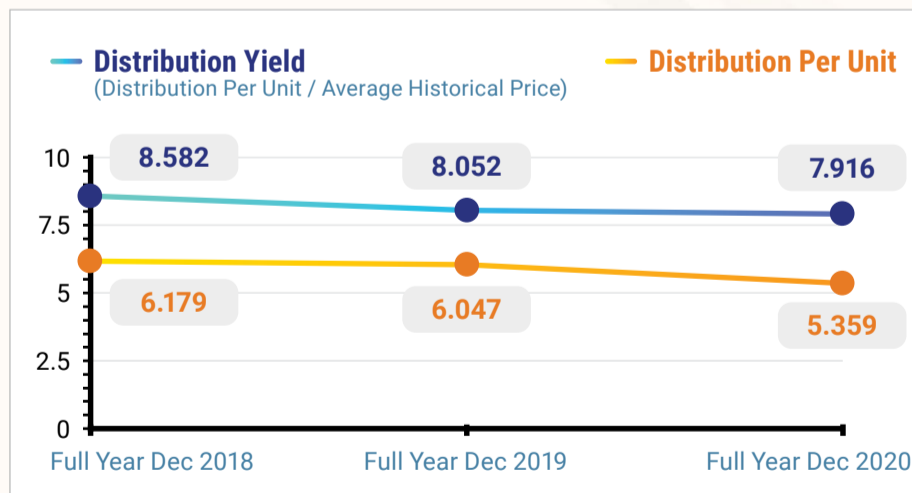


3 EC World (SGX: BWCU)

Rates On Hold – For Now

Markets

With rising inflationary pressure, both from headline and core readings, the market's natural fixation as to the response from the central bank continues to dictate markets' direction. This week was no exception as last Friday's US headline and core Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) jumped to 2.3% and 1.8% respectively. Although the core PCE remained below the Fed's threshold of 2%, the market remained nervous as to Fed's response to rising inflationary pressure. Hence, when Yellen commented that rates will likely rise as government spending is ramped up and the economy responds with faster growth, it sent equity markets into a tailspin. However, the Treasury Secretary later clarified that she was not predicting or recommending rate hikes, a comment that seems to have calmed some nerves. On rates, central banks in Australia, Thailand, Indonesia, and Malaysia left their respective benchmark rates unchanged.

Economy

US 1Q GDP came in slightly below expectations at 6.4%, mainly driven by consumer spending as stimulus cheques fuelled buying interest on durable goods. Other early 1Q GDP data too were strong with Hong Kong's 1Q GDP surging 7.8% y-o-y while Taiwan posted a growth of 8.16% y-o-y. However, Indonesia remained in recession as 1Q GDP contracted by 0.74% y-o-y. A slew of Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) too was released the past week with the notable one being the JP Morgan Global Manufacturing PMI, which rose to the highest in 10 years at 55.8 in April while JP Morgan Global Composite PMI surged to an 11-year high to 56.3. However, it was a rather different story for China this time around as both the official manufacturing and non-manufacturing PMI eased to 51.1 and 54.9 in April from

51.9 and 56.3 in March respectively. The US too was weaker than expected as the Institute of Supply Management (ISM) Manufacturing and Non-Manufacturing PMI eased to 60.7 and 62.7 from 64.7 and 63.7 in March respectively. Also for March, US trade numbers continued to show a worrying trend as the trade deficit rose to another record high of US\$74.4bil as exports, with the deficit against China alone accounting for nearly half of it.

Locally, a slew of economic data was also released the past week, starting with the banking sector statistics which showed loan growth for March 2021 at 3.9% y-o-y as household loan growth accelerated to 5.7% y-o-y while the business segment saw a slower pace of increase of 1.4% y-o-y. Malaysia's PMI came in at its fastest pace since the inception of the index series in July 2012 as the April gauge rose to 53.9 from 49.9 in the preceding month. Similarly, the March IPI too saw a strong surge as the index jumped 9.3%, driven by a 12.7% y-o-y and 10.3% y-o-y rise in the manufacturing and electricity components respectively. Manufacturing data for the month too was strong as sales value leapfrogged 15.3% y-o-y to RM126.9bil.

Corporate

Private placements remain the flavour of the season with Sarawak Consolidated Industries Berhad (SCIB) joining in the crowded space of more placement shares with the proposal to raise up to RM227.8mil based on placement size that represents 20% of its existing share base. In other corporate news, Can-One received a notice of unconditional mandatory takeover offer from its majority shareholder at RM2.50 per share. Two of the KLCI index-linked companies and glovemakers reported record quarterly results. First was Hartalega's 4Q results for the period ended March, 31, which saw their quarterly

results surge to a record of RM1.12bil on RM2.3bil revenue, while Supermax's 3Q results for the same quarterly period saw net earnings of RM1.01bil on RM1.94bil in revenue. Nevertheless, glove stocks came under selling pressure this week on concerns of rising capacity and falling average selling price (ASP), which according to Supermax has dropped between 15% and 25%. Corporate Malaysia also saw some rather unusual events this week. Cahya Mata Sarawak (CMS) suspended its Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for 30 days to facilitate investigation on allegation of financial mismanagement. In other news, little-known Seni Jaya saw the resignation of three independent non-executive directors as the company's share price rose while two largest shareholders disposed of a significant amount of shares.

Equity

In terms of the equity market's performance, markets generally closed on a soft note this week as losses ranged from 0.1% to as much as 3.3% on the Nasdaq Composite Index. Markets that were firmer closed between 0.1% and 1% firmer, while a 1.2% gain on the Dow sent the 30-stock index to yet another record high and for the 22nd time this year. Over on Bursa Malaysia, selling pressure among glove stocks saw the KLCI closing the 5-day trading period down by 1.9%. In terms of trading participation, local retailers emerged as the largest segment of net buyers with net buying interest of RM331.1mil, while local institutions' net purchased some RM275.7mil worth of stocks. This saw foreigners again emerging the largest segment of sellers at RM606.8mil.

Next week is a short market week for Bursa Malaysia due to the Hari Raya holidays but the market will not be without key economic events as Malaysia will be releasing the 1Q GDP data for 2021 on Tuesday, May 11.

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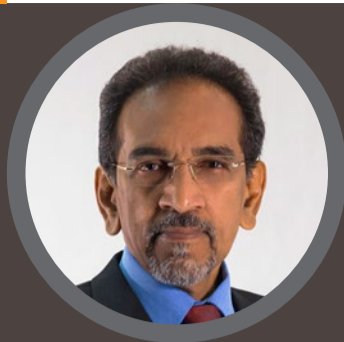

The looser correlation of the FBM KLCI to the US Dow Jones Index?

The US market has always been a dominant factor in predicting the direction of the local market. However, the Covid-19 pandemic has changed this equation. The Dow Jones Industrial Average (DJIA) which had a market capitalisation of US\$8.33 trillion (or equivalent to RM 34.4 trillion) as of 31 December 2020, is simply too big to ignore in terms of market economics. The adage that the “world catches a cold when America sneezes” best describes the symbiotic relationship between the US market and world markets. Since the pandemic became widespread around the globe in March 2020, the DJIA had a sharp correction which saw it falling to around the 19,000 points level. However, the correction was short lived. The Dow recovered as the US government put in a slew of measures to rejuvenate the economy including injecting massive stimuli into the economy. What has been baffling to analysts and economists is that despite the ill effects of the pandemic, the Dow continues its meteoric rise. It recorded its all-time high on 16 April 2021 at 34,200 points. Some pundits have attributed this phenomenon to the expectation that the US economy was on the recovery path and investors were confident with the navigation of economy by the Biden administration.

Another factor that has provided a shot in the arm for the Dow was that corporate earnings were recovering

although not to pre-pandemic levels. This has also prompted investors to enter the market. However, the FBM KLCI which has remained range bound between 1550 and 1650 points currently clearly has not been following the Dow which has been registering new highs very often recently. The FBM KLCI recorded its highest level at 1,896 points in July 2014.

Foreign funds which are crucial to ensure that the Malaysian market is on an upward trajectory have been net sellers in 2021. Since March 2021, foreigners have sold RM1.17 billion worth of Malaysian equities compared to RM5.21 billion worth of stocks in 2020. The local retail market has absorbed this amount which witnessed the volume traded on the FBM KLCI reaching its highest ever levels in 2021.

The current ultra-low interest rate environment around the world has also provided an impetus to the rise in stock market indices. Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) has kept its Overnight Policy Rate (OPR) steady at 1.75% during its last 4 policy meetings. The low interest rate environment has prompted investors to enter the market as the banks interest rates were just not appealing. As in any purchase, the maxim ‘caveat emptor’ or buyer beware is applicable.

Investors should exercise caution in investing in an environment sector where risks are aplenty as the economic rebound from the pandemic is still fragile. Previously, investors could take a cue from US markets to make their investment decisions but as the FBM KLCI is more loosely correlated from its US peer, this is not the case anymore.

They must be more inward looking and studying the fundamentals of the companies they plan to invest in. This has never been more crucial. Investors must exercise caution when investing in a market which is flushed with liquidity.

The recent penny stock rally in the Malaysian market, which is based more on speculative reasons, is a case in point where the rally in a few counters is not based on company’s fundamental strengths.

Although, the valuation of some Malaysian companies seems stretched now, value can still be found by the discerning investor. However, investors must separate the ‘chaff from the wheat’ and have the financial muscle to ride out the volatility in the market. - Ranjit Singh, Manager, Corporate Monitoring.

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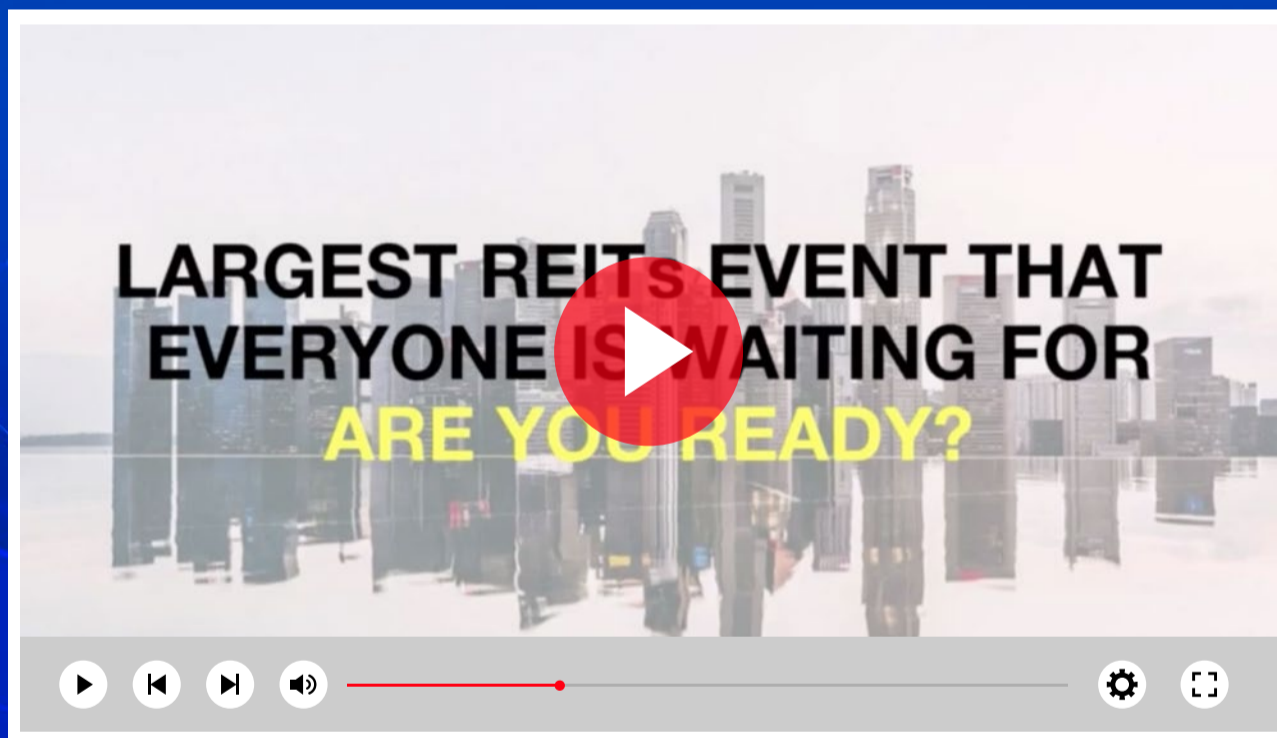

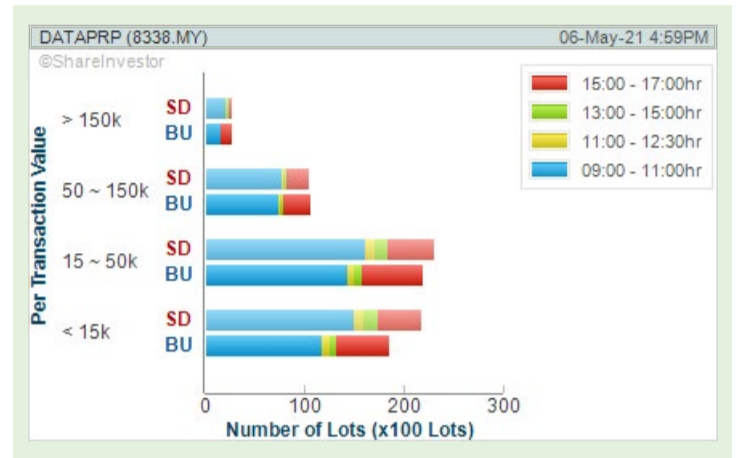

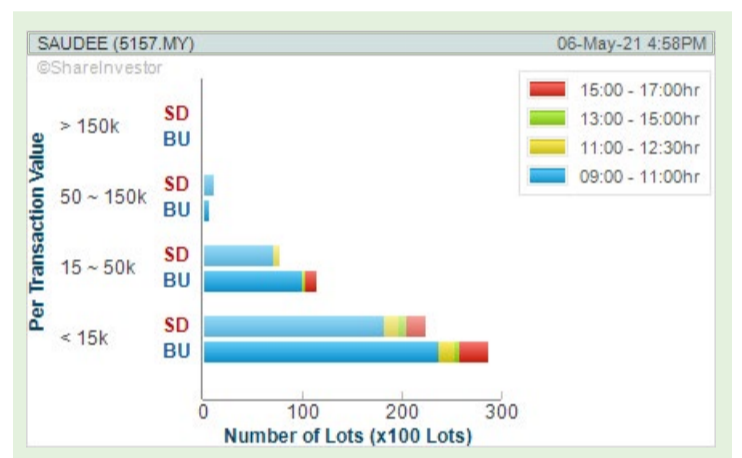
