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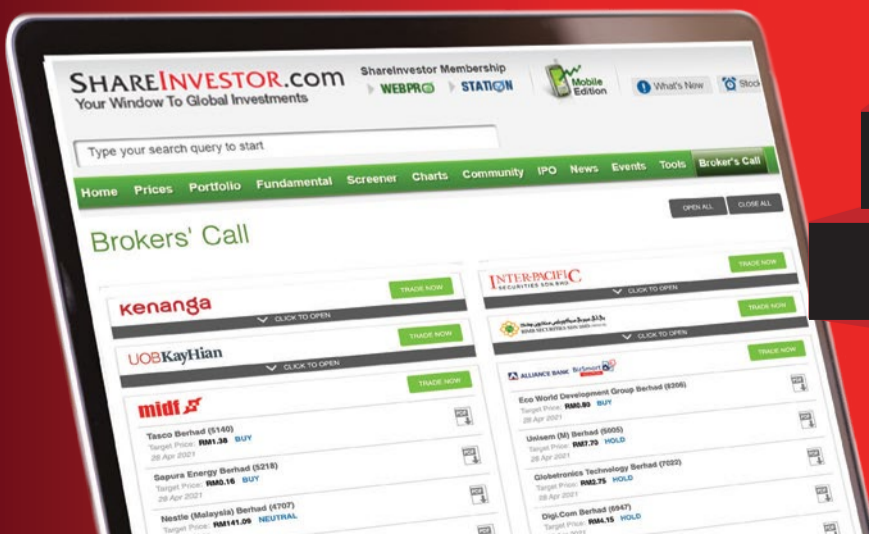
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Bursa Malaysia extends relaxation of rules to help listed companies amid prolonged lockdown

Bursa Malaysia Bhd provides two additional relief measures to help listed issuers cope with the extended lockdown amid the Covid-19 pandemic, which continues unabated. The first is an automatic one-month extension for the issuance of quarterly and annual reports for listed issuers on the Main and ACE Markets, as well as semi-annual and annual audited financial statements for those in the LEAP Market, which are due on July 31 and Aug 31, 2021, respectively. Notwithstanding the one-month extension, listed issuers are reminded to promptly announce any material information to ensure informed investment decisions by shareholders and investors at all times. Such listed issuer will not be classified as a PN17/GN3 listed issuer during this period. The second is a 12-month relief period granted for a listed issuer who, within the same July 1 and Dec 31 period, announces that it has an insignificant business or operations. Both the relief measures will allow an affected listed issuer to reassess its financial condition or level of operations at the end of the relief period before making the requisite announcements to the exchange. These measures are in addition to those introduced earlier this year in February and May, after considering the lingering impact of various movement control orders or and the recent nationwide lockdown.

FTSE4Good Bursa Malaysia review sees 10 changes in constituents

According to Bursa Malaysia Bhd there will be six new entrants to the FTSE4Good Bursa Malaysia (F4GBM) Index, while four companies have been dropped from the index in the semi-annual review. The index, which measures the performance of listed companies demonstrating strong environmental, social and governance (ESG) practices, welcomed DKSH Holdings (M), Heineken Malaysia, Mah Sing Group, MNRB Holdings, Pos Malaysia and Unisem (M). The review will also see the exclusion of George Kent (M), IOI Properties Group, KLCC PROP & REITS - Stapled Securities and Top Glove Corp from F4GBM. The constituent changes will take effect at the start of business on June 21. With the changes, the number of constituents in the index stands at 76, compared with 75 as at the last index review in December 2020 and 74 as of February 2021 (due to the delisting of Chemical Company of Malaysia Bhd). The F4GBM constituents are drawn from the companies on the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index, comprising PLCs from across the small, medium and large market capitalisation segments and the index is reviewed in June and December against international benchmarks. Bursa and its partner, FTSE Russell, have been conducting outreach programmes to encourage and support companies in improving their ESG disclosures and practices. The continuous increase in the number of constituents

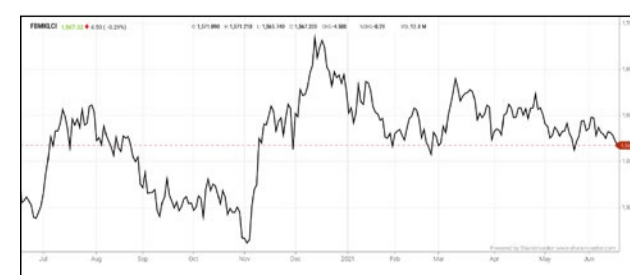
reflects the benefits of these programmes, in addition to other efforts catalysing public listed companies towards ESG best practices.

MCMC focusing on national digitalisation for economic recovery

According to the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), national digitalisation continues to be its main focus to assist the country in providing a solid platform for an economic recovery in line with the National Recovery Plan (PPN). As the regulatory body responsible for the communications sector covering telecommunications and the Internet, post and courier as well as broadcasting, it is committed to continuing to ensure continuity of operations in essential services throughout the movement control order (MCO) period. A phased economic reopening is important for essential services to operate at the required level and adopt the standard operating procedures (SOPs) that have been set in a disciplined manner. The people could utilise Internet connectivity for daily activities, such as e-commerce, working from home (WFH) and home-based teaching and learning (PdPR). This can help the government's effort to reduce infection clusters in the workplace. To achieve the PPN agenda, among the programmes developed with the industry are the National Digital Network (JENDELA) for connectivity, the National Courier Accelerator Plan (PAKEJ) for delivery of goods, the transformation of the state MCMC offices and the development of community Internet centres (PIK). Elaborating on the PAKEJ initiative, more pickup and drop-off (PUDO) points had been set up nationwide. The broadcasting sector had been given permission to continue operating during the MCO period to enable the people to follow current developments safely and comfortably from home, as well as enable them to plan daily activities through authentic and accurate information.

Eye On The Markets

This week, on Thursday (17Jun), the Ringgit was 4.1380 against the USD from 4.1150 on Monday (14Jun). Meanwhile, the Ringgit was 3.0906 to the Sing Dollar on Thursday (17Jun). On Monday (14Jun), the FBM KLCI opened at 1582.46. As at Friday (18Jun) 10:00am, the FBM KLCI is down 16.06 points for the week at 1566.40. Over in US, the overnight Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 210.22 points (-0.62%) to 33,823.45 whilst the NASDAQ added 121.67 points (+0.87%) to 14,161.35.

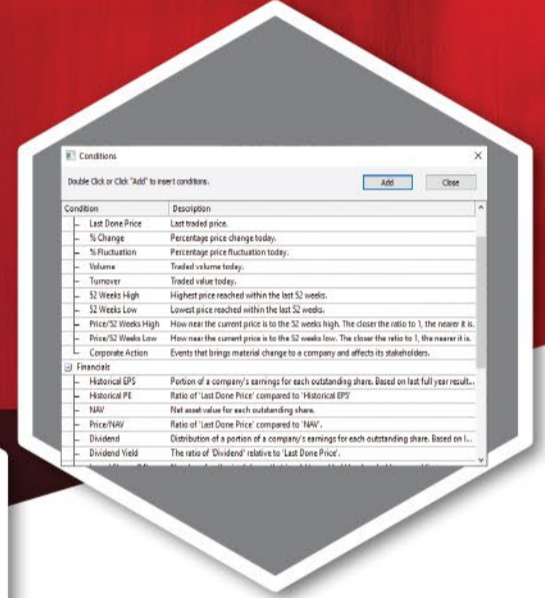

Month of Big Jumps

Markets

With so much liquidity that is being created from the Fed's quantitative easing program, it is of no surprise when we see rising inflationary expectations. According to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York survey, US consumers' expectations of inflation rate in one and three years jumped to 4% and 3.6% in May from 3.4% and 3.1% in April respectively.

As widely expected, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) left interest rates unchanged. Other central banks too followed suit as both the Taiwanese and the Indonesian central banks stood pat as well and left rates steady. However, the Fed turned mildly hawkish with two rate hikes now pencilled in for 2023. The Fed also raised inflation expectations with Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) and core PCE is now expected to increase to 3.4% and 3.0% from the earlier forecast of 2.4% and 2.2% respectively. In addition, the Fed upgraded the US GDP forecast by 0.5 percentage pts to 7% for this year.

Locally, Malaysia announced the long-awaited National Recovery Plan with milestones to be achieved for the economy to be fully opened up towards the tail-end of the year. Following a meeting between the Yang di-Pertuan Agong and the Conference of Rulers, Malaysia will likely see the end of the Emergency period while Parliament too will be called as soon as possible.

Economy

Economic data this week include the US retail sales for May, which rose by a staggering 28.1% y-o-y mainly due to the

low base effect from last year's lockdown period as well as pent-up demand as more Americans get inoculated. However, when compared with last month's reading, retail sales came in worse than expected as it fell by 1.3%. Meanwhile, US Producer Price Index (PPI) surged to an 11-year high to 6.6% y-o-y as commodity prices remain elevated on rising demand and supply constraints.

Vehicle sales in China fell 3% in May from the same month a year earlier, snapping a streak of 13 consecutive months of gains since April 2020. In other Chinese economic data points, retail sales for May surged 12.4% y-o-y but missed expectations of a 13.6% gain. Industrial production too was below forecast, rising by 8.8% y-o-y.

Locally, due to the low base effect when we had full economic lockdown during the first MCO, the April key economic data points showed massive jumps in numbers as Industrial Production Index (IPI) surged 50.1% y-o-y, driven by a 68% y-o-y surge coming from the manufacturing index, while both electricity and mining indices too were higher, rising by 22.9% y-o-y and 14.3% y-o-y respectively. Meanwhile, the wholesale and retail trade sales grew by 66.2% y-o-y to RM111.1bil as volume jumped 71.5% y-o-y. Manufacturing sales too echoed the other economic sectors as value surged 72.5% y-o-y to hit RM130.6bil in April 2021.

Corporate

Serba Dinamik was back in the news this week as it appointed Ernst & Young Advisory Services to review audit matters that were highlighted by its external

auditor, KPMG PLT. The company also raised its number of board members by appointing three additional independent non-executive directors. In other news, Berjaya Corporation unveiled its 3-year business plan that will see it focusing on five key sectors while non-core assets will be divested, which will enable the group to pare down its debts and return to profitability. Meanwhile, Sunway expressed its interest in applying for one of the five digital banking licences to be issued by Bank Negara.

Equity

Global equity markets closed mix to firmer the past week with markets that trended higher experiencing gains of between 0.1% and 1.4% while markets that fell eased between 0.5% and 2.4%. The KLCI closed the week 0.6% lower at 1,570.86 pts. For the week, net foreign outflow amounted to RM266.9mil as retailers and local institutions again maintained their net buying interest of RM230.1mil and RM36.7mil respectively.

Eye On Week Ahead

Key US indicators next week, other than the headline and core PCE on Friday, are the May existing home sales and new home sales data to be released on Tuesday and Wednesday with the market looking at an annualized rate of 5.85mil and 863k respectively. On Thursday, the market too will absorb data on durable goods order for May, which is expected to decline by 1.3% m-o-m. Locally, BNM will be releasing the international reserves figure as at June 15, 2021, on Tuesday.

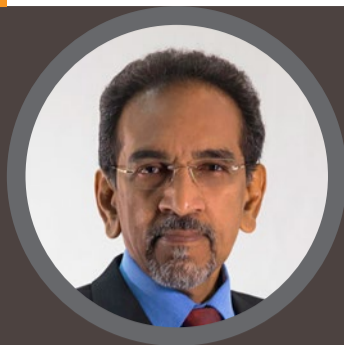

External Auditors, the Audit Committee and the Board

External auditors of public listed companies are appointed by shareholders at annual general meetings to perform their duties of auditing the financial statements of PLCs. The auditors will then report whether the financial statements, for the financial year-end, are prepared according to the prevailing laws and accounting standards and whether, in their opinion, they present a true and fair view. Such are the requirements of the Companies Act 2016. The auditor is also bound by law (the Capital Markets and Services Act 2007) to report issues that may have a material impact on the financial statements of a PLC to the Securities Commission (SC). In such instances, the SC will decide if further investigation is warranted. Typically, the auditors will deal with the company's management (which includes executive chairman/executive directors, chief executive officer, chief financial officer) during their auditing process to iron out issues relating to the financial statements. There are times when auditors are unable to resolve the issues with management and both parties refuse to budge from their respective positions. This is when the auditor will escalate their concerns to the audit committee (AC).

Under the Bursa Securities' Listing Requirements (LR), the AC must comprise non-executive directors, with majority of them being independent directors. Meanwhile, the Step-Up practice in the Malaysian Code on Corporate Governance (MCCG) ups the ante by stating that the AC should comprise solely of independent directors. This means no EC/EDs should sit on the AC. Such requirements are to allow auditors to articulate their concerns candidly, without fear or favour. The LR states, amongst others, that the AC must review with the external auditor, the audit report and

the assistance given by the employees of the audited company to the external auditor. Since the AC is a sub-committee of the Board, the AC reports back to the Board on these matters. It is the prerogative of the auditor to decide when he should address the AC when there are concerns. As stated earlier, concerns will likely be raised to the AC only when communications with management have either broken-down or an impasse has been reached. Under the LR, one of the responsibilities of the AC in relation to auditing a company's financial statements is to focus on significant matters highlighted e.g., financial reporting issues, significant judgments made by management, significant/unusual transactions, and the measures to tackle these issues.

Removal of auditor

The AC can also recommend to the board, the removal of the auditor based on valid reasons. The Board will deliberate on the recommendation, and if it concurs with the AC, approve such a resolution to be tabled for shareholders' approval at an AGM or EGM. But the key ground for the removal of auditors are 'valid reasons'. It is not good corporate governance practice to remove auditors when issues and concerns are festering and remain unresolved. In such circumstances, changing auditors is akin to 'opinion-shopping'. Quite often we hear the grounds given by companies for the removal of their auditors, but rarely do we hear from the auditor. This is probably because the auditor feels that he only needs to communicate through his audit opinion which is included in the annual report. Besides, they will be there at the AGM to address questions anyway. To allow the shareholders to hear the auditor's side of the story, the auditors

should exercise their rights granted under the Companies Act 2016 by presenting their side of the story and requesting the company to circulate it to the shareholders with the notice of the meeting to remove them.

Some red flags for minority shareholders to watch out for

Extending or changing the financial year-end when nearing the report-issuance deadline may be an indication that things are not going well. If the audited financial statements can be released in a timely manner in the past, there should be no reason to extend/change the financial year-end this time around. Of course, there are valid reasons to extend/change a financial year-end e.g., to align the year-ends of all companies within a group to facilitate the preparation of group (consolidated) financial statements. In addition, auditors resigning in the middle of their tenure is also something to watch out for. Some auditors irresponsibly choose to resign when there are issues and concerns rather than discharging their responsibilities to the shareholders who appointed them; an easy way out leaving the company to appoint a more tolerant auditor – a form of 'opinion shopping'.

Another red flag is the removal of an auditor mid-stream during their tenure especially when there are issues and concerns in relation to the audit of the financial statements. Auditors may issue clean audit opinions or modified audit opinions (such as material uncertainty related to going concern).

The risk-averse minority shareholder may prefer to invest in companies that have a clean opinion, and these represent most of the PLCs.
