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Capital Market Masterplan – SC launches 5 year masterplan

According to SC chairman Datuk Syed Zaid Albar, the Securities Commission’s third Capital Market Masterplan (CMP3) will serve as a strategic framework for the growth of Malaysia’s capital market over the next five years. Both Capital Market Masterplan 1 (2001-2010) and Capital Market Masterplan 2 (2011-2020) had successfully expanded the capital market while ensuring market stability and integrity over the last two decades. As such, the new master plan now seeks to leverage the strengths and potential of the Malaysian capital market to accelerate economic growth that is sustainable and inclusive. Malaysia is now at a critical juncture in its post-pandemic journey. It is imperative for the capital market to continue to support the economy’s transition into an inclusive and sustainable nation. The progress in the capital market cannot be measured solely by growth and size as it also has to serve underlying needs and aspirations of the country and its people. The CMP3 takes into consideration global megatrends that will shape the recovery and growth of global and Malaysian economies as it steers the capital market towards three desired outcomes, namely being relevant, efficient and diversified. Malaysia now has a well-diversified capital market, with an equity market that has over 900 listed companies, a bond market that is the third largest in Asia, an Islamic capital market that is innovative and well-regarded globally, a derivatives market that leads in crude palm oil (CPO) price discovery and a unit trust industry that is one of the largest in the region. Governance strategies implemented during the previous master plans had ensured robust regulatory oversight to enhance confidence in the integrity of Malaysia’s capital market. The Malaysian capital market regulatory framework is benchmarked and ranks highly internationally with regard to, among others, investor protection standards, corporate governance and enforcement capabilities. The CMP3 will build on this solid foundation to pave the way for the next stage of Malaysia’s market evolution and growth. To achieve these desired outcomes, the CMP3 outlines six key development and regulatory thrusts that will collectively serve as pillars in developing strategic initiatives over the next five years.

The first development thrust is facilitating fundraising for competitive businesses through a diverse market and intermediation ecosystem. The CMP3 also aims to empower all Malaysians to invest for their future and promote digital inclusion and protection for vulnerable investors. Furthermore, through the Sustainable and Responsible Investment (SRI) and Islamic Capital Market (ICM) pillars, the CMP3 aims to shape a stakeholder economy by mobilising more capital towards

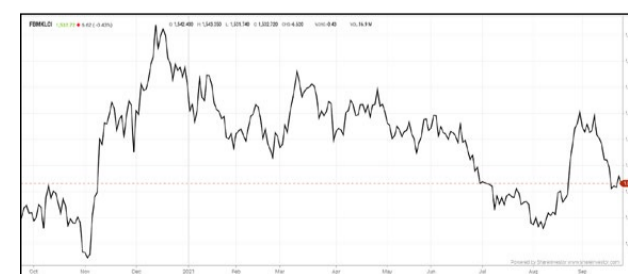
sustainable businesses. In tandem, the SC’s regulatory approach will also evolve in response to changing trends and the market landscape, with the CMP3 striving to embed greater shared accountability within the capital market, particularly corporate responsibility to stakeholders beyond short-term profitability. It also aims to achieve a more efficient regulatory outcome and greater efficiency in investor protection through swift, effective and targeted enforcement and supervision approaches. In addition, as the industry becomes more digital, the CMP3 envisions greater use of technology — both regulatory technology (RegTech) and supervisory technology (SupTech) — for greater efficiency and deeper insights.

Bursa Malaysia aims to be carbon neutral by 2022

According to Bursa Malaysia chairman Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar, Bursa Malaysia is targeting to become carbon neutral by 2022 and achieve net zero emissions by 2050 across its entire operations, in line with the global drive for decarbonisation. The stock exchange operator would systematically manage its carbon footprint across the exchange’s entire business activities, while reducing emissions in line with a net zero future. Bursa Malaysia will participate in global campaigns, “Business Ambition for 1.5°C” and “Race to Zero”, to support the transition to a climate resilient and inclusive economy. Climate change poses a significant threat to the planet and society. It is in everyone’s best interests to work towards a systemic change that prevents a climate catastrophe. He believes it is important for all companies regardless of size, industry and operating models to scale-up their climate contributions with firm commitments and concerted actions towards achieving a climate-resilient future. Climate change has always been a priority for Bursa Malaysia.

Grande Plans

Markets

The Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC), which ended its two-day scheduled meeting, has now clearly laid out the much-talked-about tapering plan, which will begin in November this year and end in 1H of 2022. The rather ambitious plans suggest that the Federal Reserve may start to reduce its bond purchase program at an average pace of between US\$20bil and US\$25bil per month before the economy is taken off the support program. The Fed has also hinted that post the tapering move, there may be a greater inclination for the Fed to raise rates thereafter. In fact, half of the FOMC members now expect to start raising interest rates next year and believe that interest rate should rise to at least 1% by the end of 2023 – a sign that we may see one rate hike in 2022, and followed by three more in 2023. The Fed also revised economic data points from its earlier projection with the US economy now expected to grow by 5.9% from the earlier estimate of 7%. Growth for 2022 is now expected to accelerate to 3.8% from the earlier forecast of a 3.3% growth. US unemployment is now projected to fall to 4.8% this year and to be back to its pre-pandemic level of sub 4% in 2022, with a projected rate of 3.8%.

Global equity markets experienced some form of a contagion effect from the fallout of China's Evergrande Group as it missed payments to its creditors and after S&P Global commented that the multi-billion debt-ridden company was likely to default. Nevertheless, the company's announcement that it has negotiated a plan with onshore bondholders to repay the interest that was due yesterday helped to calm sentiment to a certain extent. Even news of China and Taiwan agreeing to join the 11-nation Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-pacific Partnership (CPTPP), was overshadowed by what was going on in China and the Evergrande Group's near collapse under a pile of liabilities.

Meanwhile, the Chinese President, in a pre-recorded speech to the UN General Assembly, said that China will stop construction and financing of coal-fired power plants abroad and instead help nations to build green energy plants. China has been involved in as many as 44 coal-fired power plants worth some US\$50bil across countries like Vietnam, Indonesia, Bangladesh, and South Africa. In other news, Fitch Ratings lowered their economic forecast for this year for China to 8.1% from 8.4% previously, while the forecast for 2022 was cut to 5.2% from 5.5%, on the back of a slowdown in the property market.

Locally, the government is said to be contemplating introducing capital gains tax on shares as well as a one-off higher tax rate for companies that have benefitted from the pandemic with extraordinary profits. Meanwhile, the Securities Commission launched the next 5-year phase of the capital market development plan with its Capital Market Masterplan 3 (CMP3), to take the Malaysian capital market to the next level and to accelerate economic growth that is sustainable and inclusive.

Economy

Out of the US, the August Housing Starts and Building Permits rose to 1.615mil and 1.728mil annualized rate, which was well above the consensus view of an annualized rate of 1.55mil and 1.6mil respectively. However, previously owned homes came in relative weak as data for August was 2% lower m-o-m at an annualized rate of 5.88mil.

In other news, IHS Markit reckons that global GDP growth will hit 5.6% this year, a 0.1 percentage point lower than previously estimated, and slow down to 4.5% in 2022. This is on the back of the return of consumer spending and business investments. In related news, the IHS Markit Eurozone Composite Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for September fell to a 5-month low of 56.1 from the preceding month's print of 59.0, mainly due to supply chain bottlenecks and concerns over the ongoing pandemic.

Meanwhile, Indonesia had bumper external trade data for August as exports and imports surged 64.1% and 55.3% y-o-y respectively, driving the trade balance to a record high of US\$4.7bil. However, external trade figures from down south were less rosy as Singapore's non-oil domestic exports for August rose by just 2.7% y-o-y. On interest rates, as expected, both the Indonesia and Philippines central banks left their rates unchanged at 3.5% and 2% respectively.

Locally, Bank Negara reported that Malaysia's international reserves as of Sept 15th stood at US\$116.2bil compared to US\$116.3bil a fortnight ago.

Corporate

Last Friday, Top Glove reported their full financial year-end August 2021 results, which showed a sharp decline in the 4Q results as topline and bottom-line fell by 49.2% and 70.1% respectively as the business operations were impacted by lockdowns, softening demand, and falling average selling

price for gloves. For the year, Malaysia's largest glovemaker reported revenue and net earnings of RM16.41bil and RM7.87bil. Meanwhile, IOI Properties has emerged as the sole bidder to acquire a 7,817.6 square metres leasehold land located at Singapore's Marina View enclave for a staggering sum of S\$1.508bil or RM4.68bil. This translates to a price tag of S\$14,838 per square metre based on the maximum gross floor area of 101,629 square metres. In other deals, Pan Malaysia Corporation (PMC) has entered into an agreement to acquire a 51% stake in A&W (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. for RM21mil, to be satisfied via RM11.6mil in cash and 63.1mil existing PMC treasury shares at a transfer price of RM0.15 per share.

Equity

World equity markets were shaken by news of Evergrande troubles and naturally, most markets closed on a softer note. Markets that closed lower dropped by between 0.1% and 2.3% while selected markets that were firmer week-on-week, gained between 0.1% and 1.3%. Ironically, it was the Shanghai Composite Index that posted one of the biggest gain among all the markets with a gain of 1%, despite the rippling effect from Evergrande. On the local bourse, the KLCI closed the week 15.92 pts lower at 1,539.34 pts as selling pressure on selected index-linked stocks took its toll on the market.

For the holiday shortened-week ended Sept 22, after five consecutive weeks of net inflows, foreigners turned net sellers with an outflow of RM86.7mil. Local institutions too were net sellers with an outflow of RM215.6mil, leaving the retail participants as sole net buyers with an inflow of RM302.3mil.

Eye on Week Ahead

Later today, the August New Home Sales data will be released while Monday will be the Durable Goods Order's turn. The Conference Board will be releasing data for US Consumer Confidence for Sept on Tuesday, Sept 28th. The official Chinese Manufacturing and Non-Manufacturing PMI for Sept is due to be released on Thursday, Sept 30th.

Locally, the Department of Statistics will be releasing the August inflation data today, while next week Tuesday will see the release of August external trade figures. Producers Price Index is due on Thursday, Sept 30th and the same day, Bank Negara will be releasing the August monthly statistical bulletin, including the performance of the banking sector.

Ambiguous reasons for HB Global ED's resignation

With just seven months into the job, HB Global Limited director Lee Ping Wei ("Lee") announced his resignation from his role as an executive director (ED) of the Company with effect from 18 August 2021. In the announcement on Bursa Malaysia website, HB Global said the reason for Lee's resignation was due to other personal commitments which required his full attention. Aside from Lee, it is also worthwhile noting that on 12 July 2021, the company's chief financial officer, Ang Kong Siang, had also resigned due to other personal commitments which required his full attention (similar to Lee's reason).

Strangely, HB Global had on 6 September issued a media release stating that Lee has repeatedly failed to dedicate adequate time and resources towards the company, resulting in unacceptable performance as expected from his position. Thus, the board had no choice but to accept Lee's voluntary resignation effective 18 August 2021.

Minority shareholders are left wondering how to reconcile the reasons for the resignation - whether it was due to other personal commitments which required his full attention or that he failed to dedicate adequate time and resources towards the company. Resignation due to other commitments is a common reason for board members to relinquish their position, at least for HB Global, where the resignation of the CFO was accompanied with a similar reason. Looking beyond Lee's resignation, one may also wonder what has prompted HB Global's action of issuing a press statement three weeks

later to highlight Lee's departure. Besides the reason for his resignation, the purpose of the media release was also to inform the market that Lee no longer had the authority to act, represent or bind the company in dealings, negotiations, and discussions. The Company repeatedly stressed that Lee ceased to have any relationship with the Group, whether as a principal and agent or employer and employee.

Such announcement should have been made on a timely manner to avoid any risk of unauthorized dealings with the Company by Lee. Unauthorized dealing with third parties could happen even in days, let alone a period of three weeks.

Speculation of 'board tussle', or something similar, is inevitable judging from the re-designation of Keh Chuan Seng, 49, as the company's executive chairman from the non-independent non-executive chairman position on the same day that Lee resigned from the Company. After all, Keh's emergence in HB Global has been quite meteoric, to say the least. He emerged as the single largest shareholder of the Company in July 2020 after he acquired 150 million shares (at two sen each) or a 32.1% stake from HB Capital's co-founder and CEO Shen Hengbao via an off-market transaction. He reduced his shareholding to 27.67% about two months later. Suffice to say that, following Keh's emergence as a controlling shareholder, HB Global also saw a new lease of life injected into the Company.

This April, HB Global announced that it planned to acquire a 60% stake in Forward Resources & Construction Sdn Bhd (FRC)

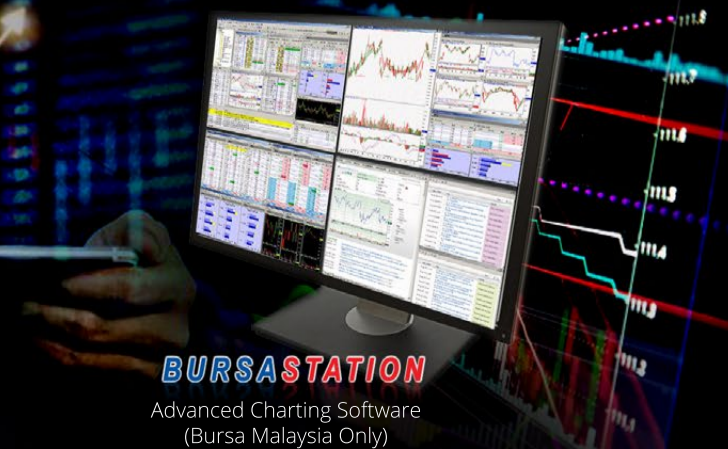
for RM66 million, to be satisfied via 208.41 million new shares representing a 27% stake in HB Global, at an issue price of 25.91 sen apiece, to the two vendors of FRC, together with RM12 million cash. Founded in 1993, FRC is mainly involved in the provision of construction and engineering solution services, including fifth-generation (5G) infrastructure, for the telecommunications industry. HB Global was previously known as a gourmet convenient food producer that specialised in frozen vegetables and ready-to-serve duck meat products.

Financial performance-wise, it had done well in the 2QFY2021 with a net profit of RM5.85 million (2Q FY2020: net loss of RM1.91 million) while its revenue jumped 68% to RM22.1 million (2Q FY2020: RM13.13 million). This enabled HB Global's 1H FY2021 earnings to hit RM10.18 million from a net loss position of RM8.45 mil in the corresponding period a year ago while its revenue rose 75% to RM38.37 million (1H FY2020: RM21.96 million).

The turnaround financial performance is akin to light at the end of the tunnel for minority shareholders after years of sub-performance. Inevitably, ambiguous announcements lead to speculation among the investing fraternity, resulting in uncertainty which may impact the share price. The share price of HB Global has tanked 27% from a high of 35 sen (the day of Lee's resignation) to close at 25.5 sen on 15 September despite significant improvement in the earnings for 1H2021.

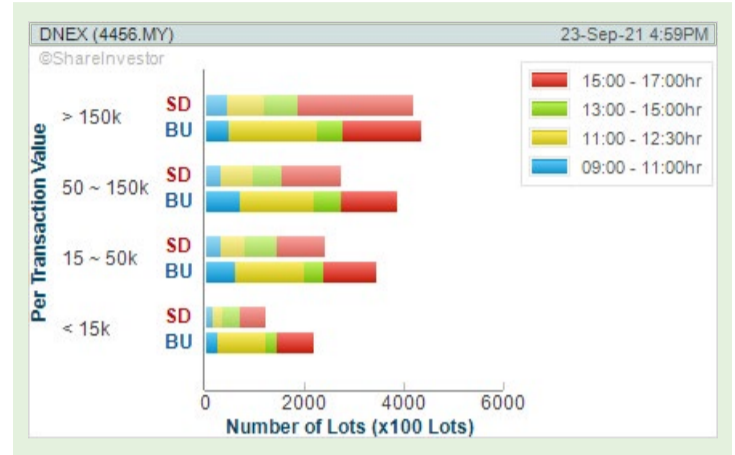

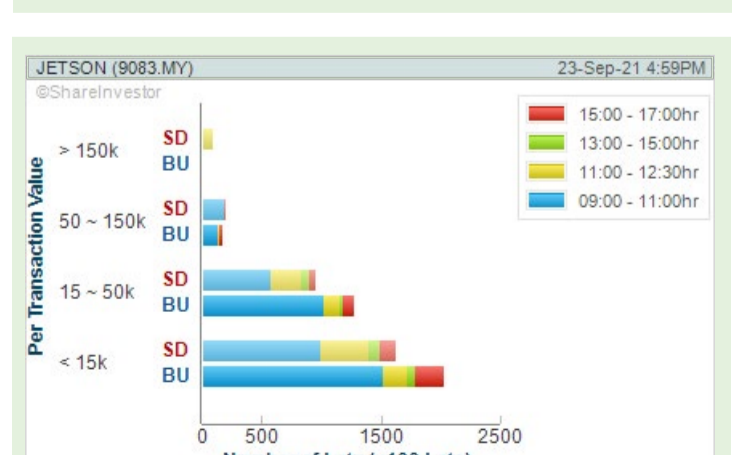
